DESCRIPTION

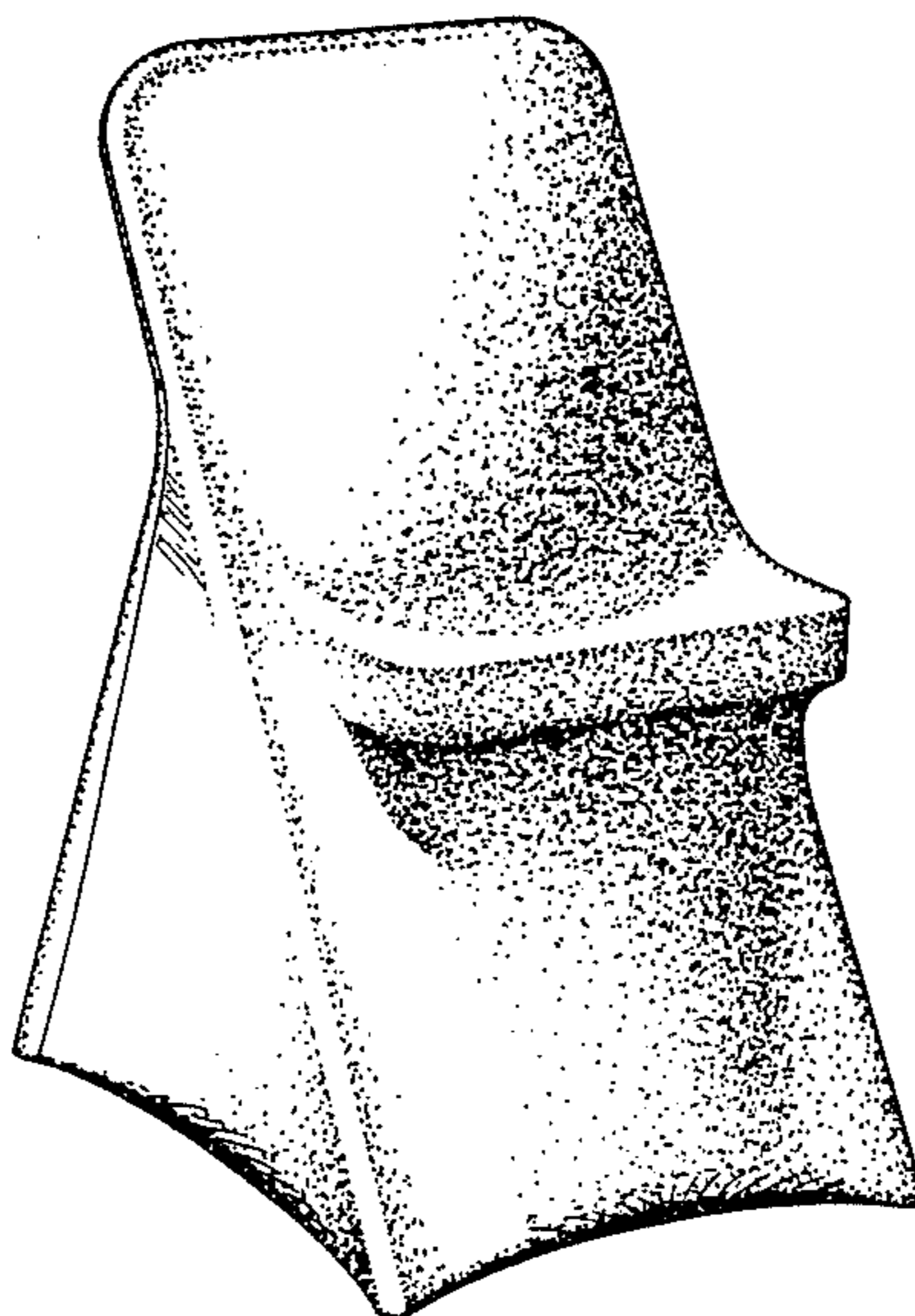
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair cover showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being plain and unornamented.



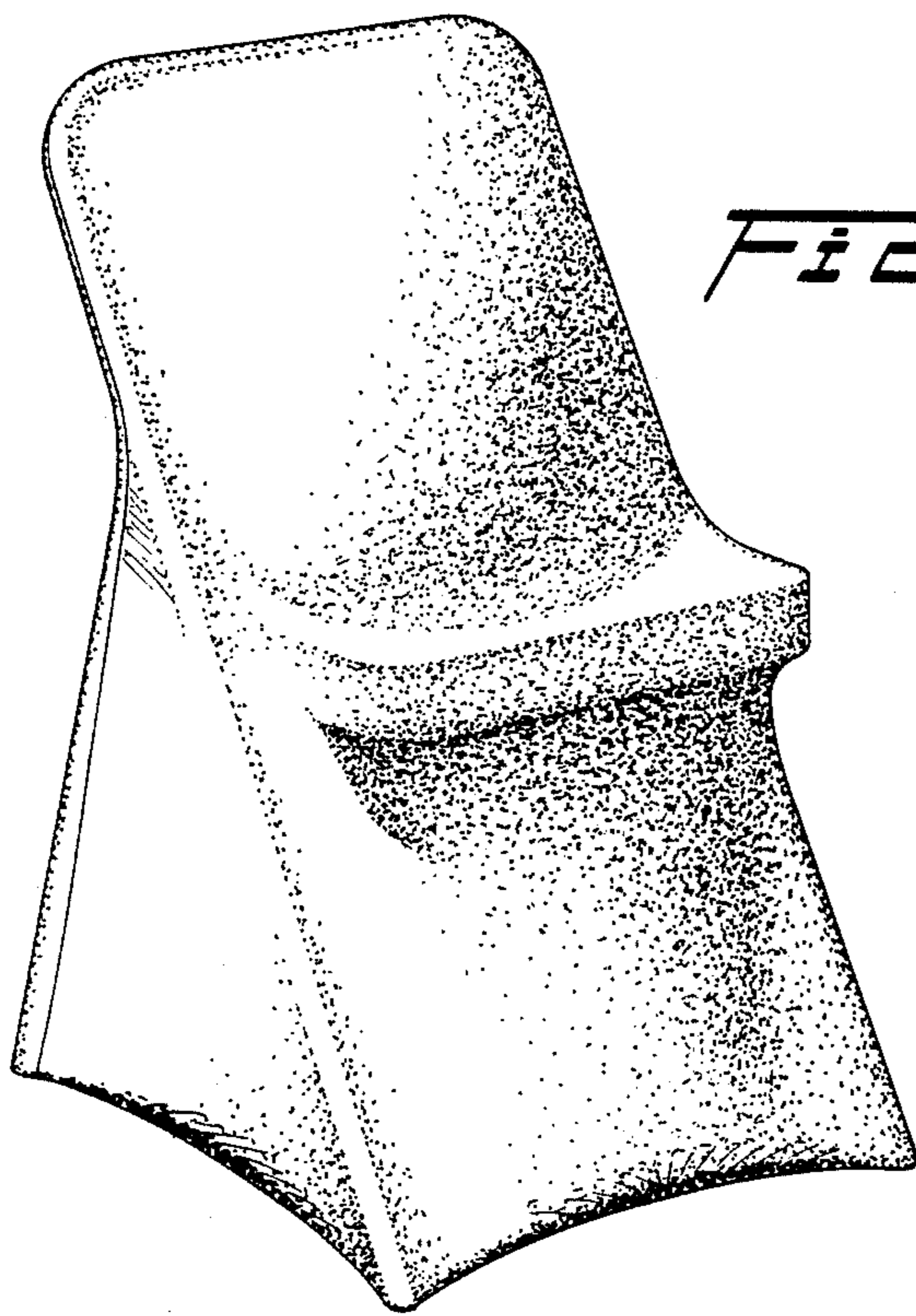

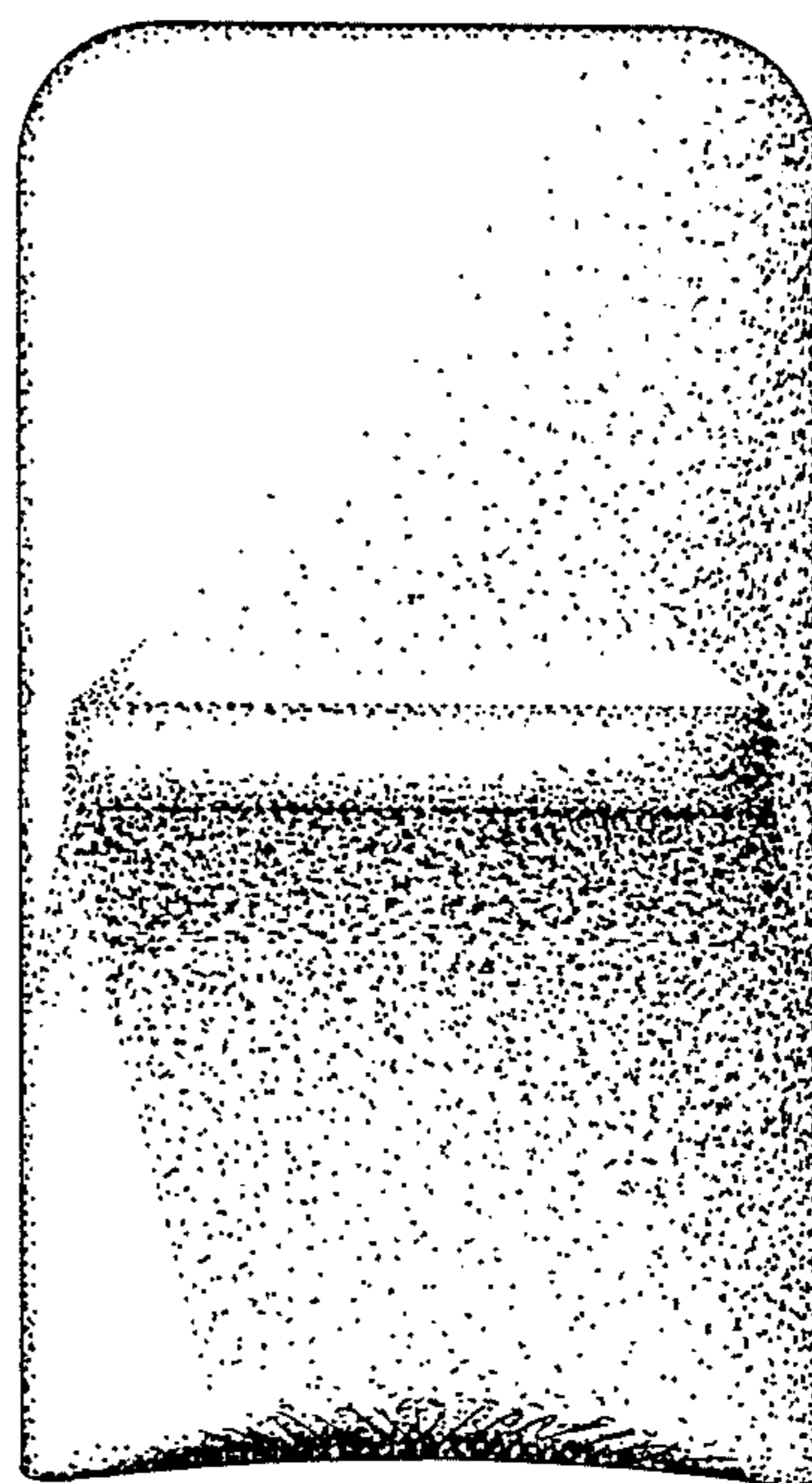

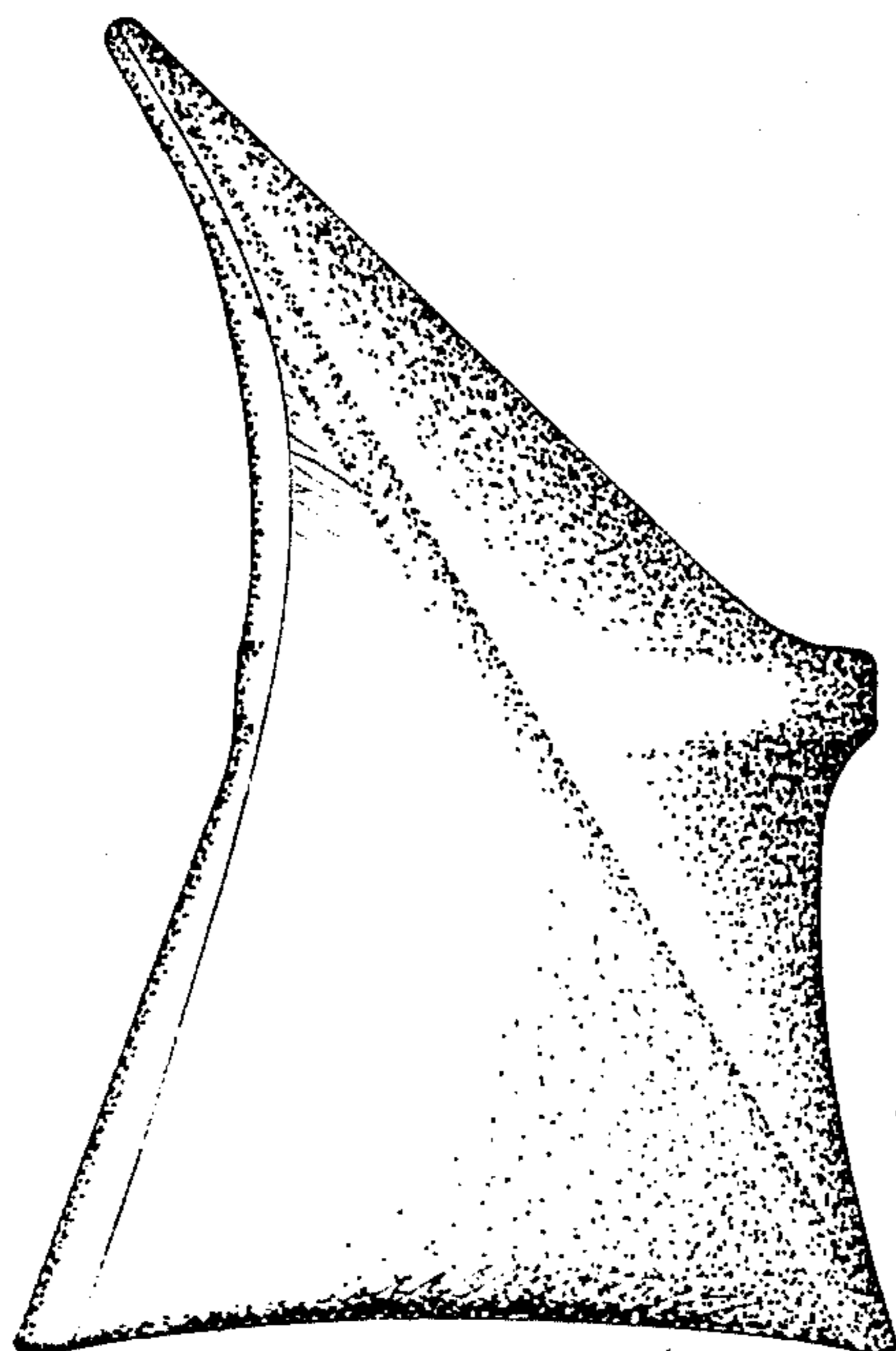

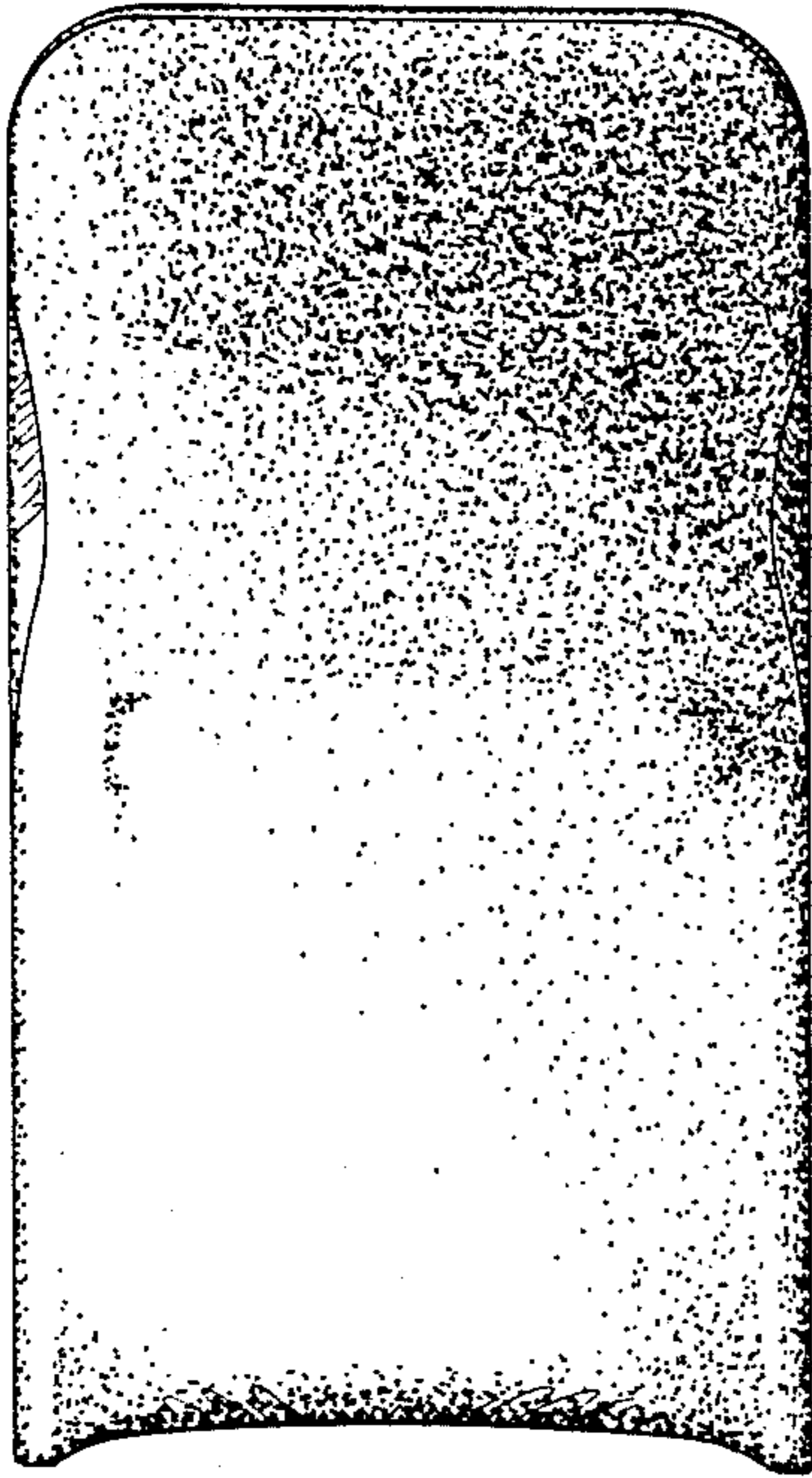

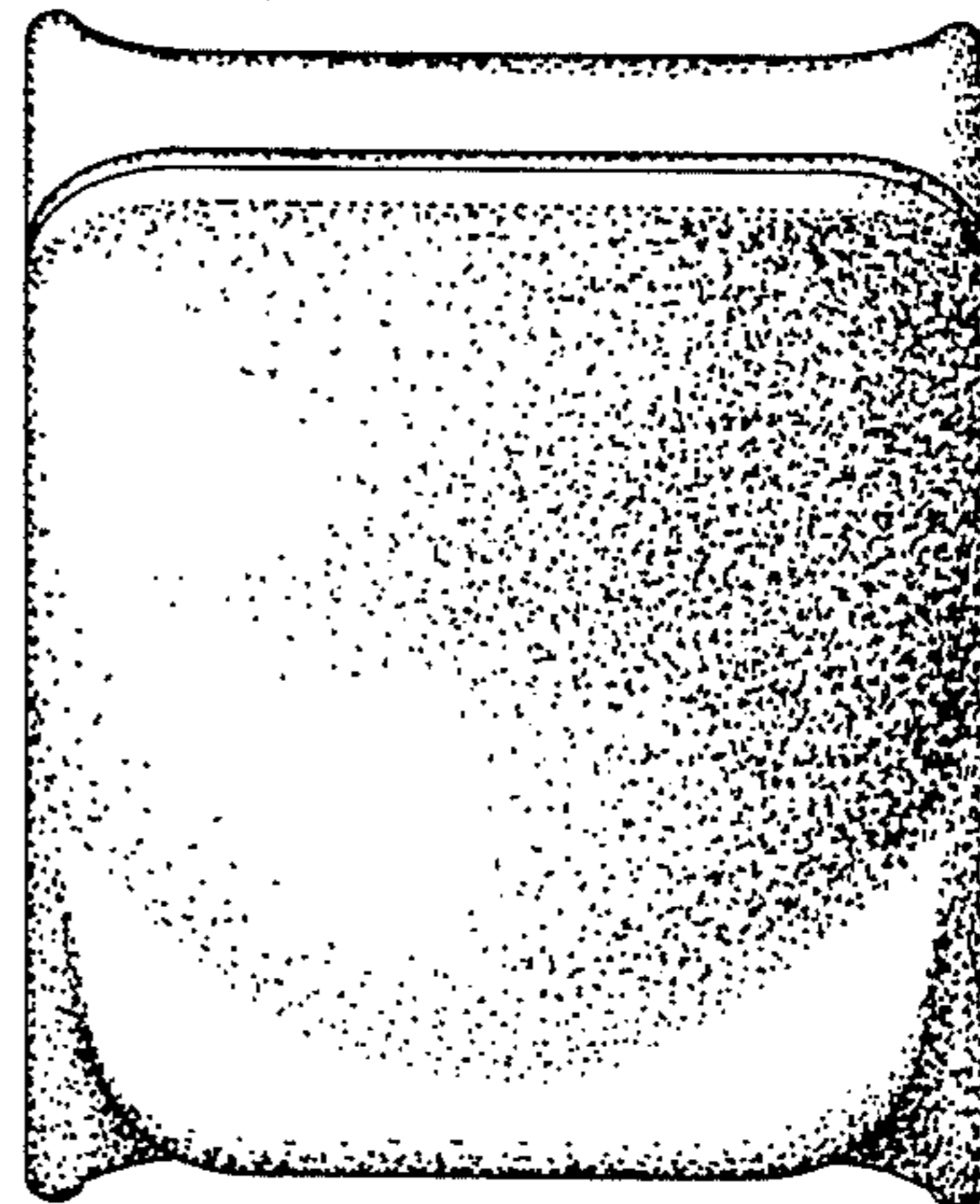
