FIG. 6 is a further enlarged fragmentary view showing a portion of the outer rim.

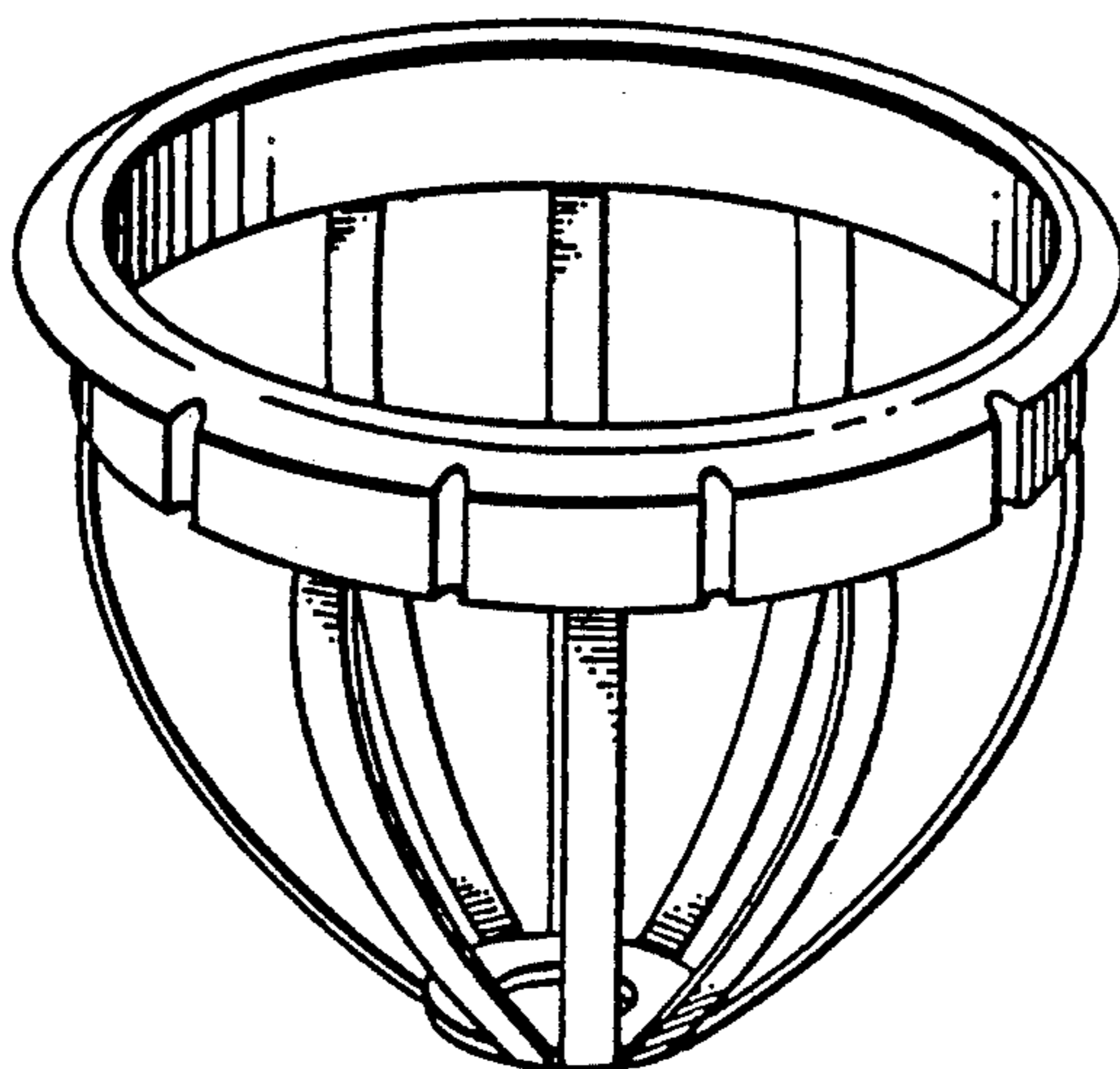

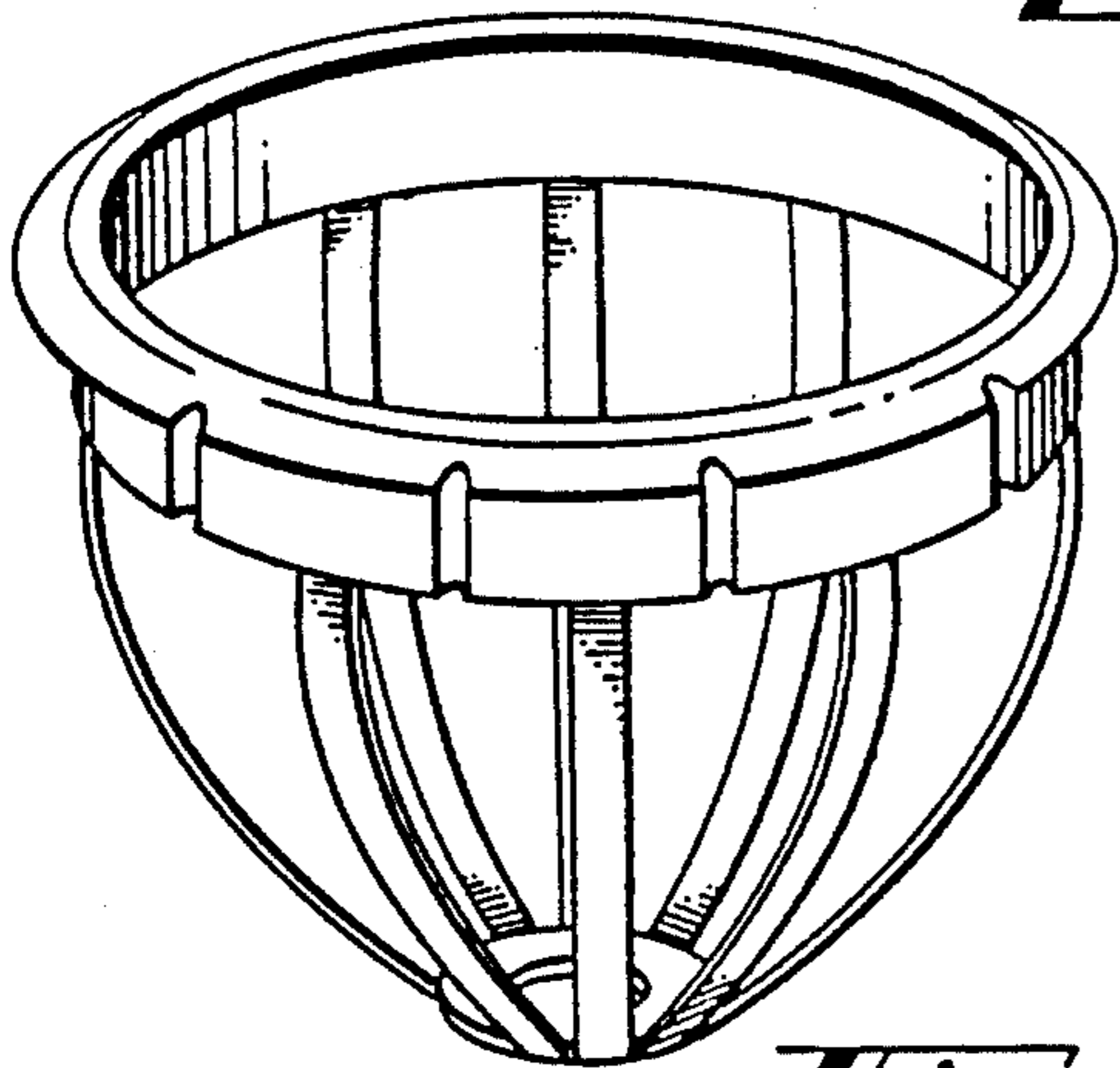

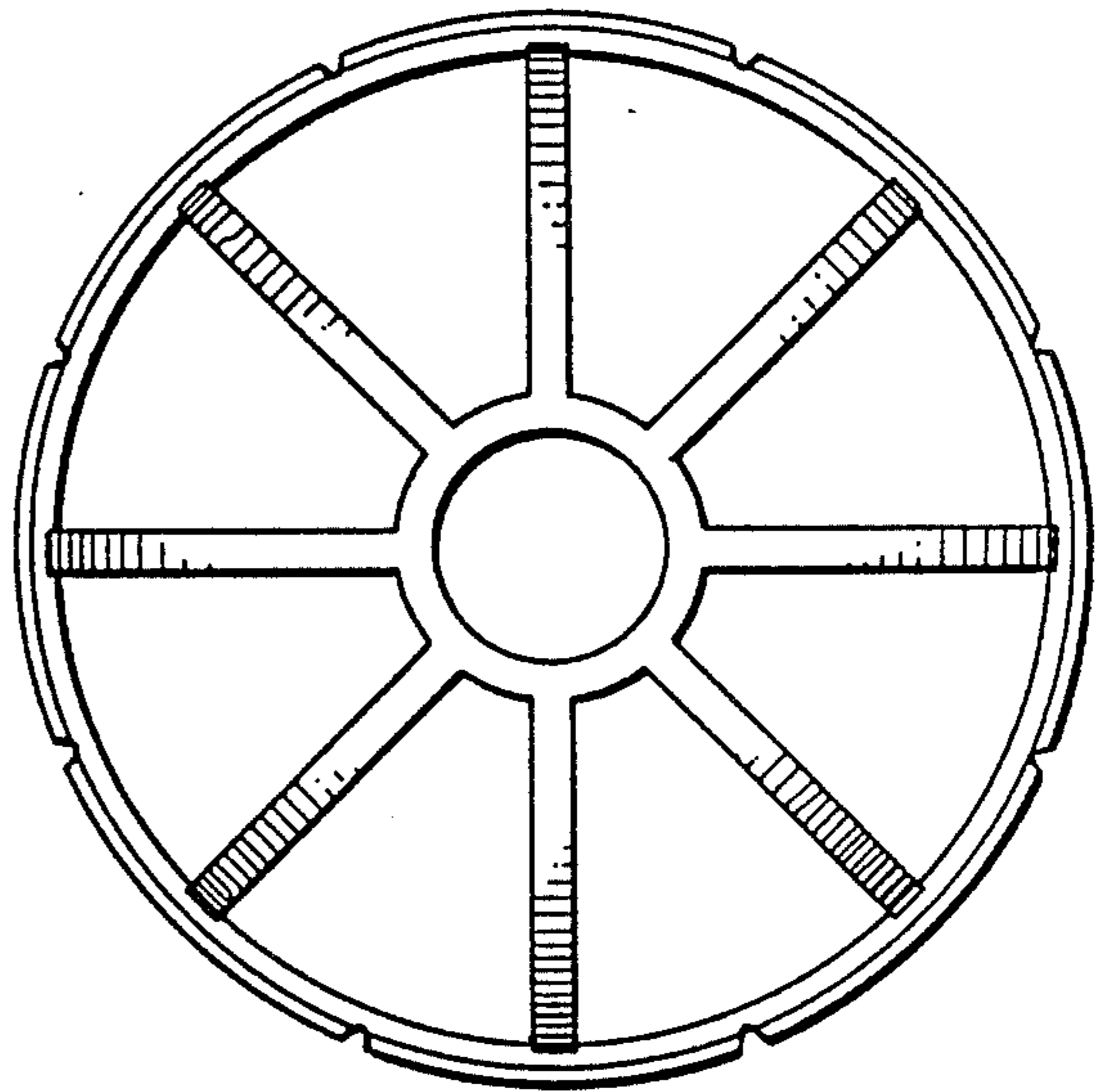

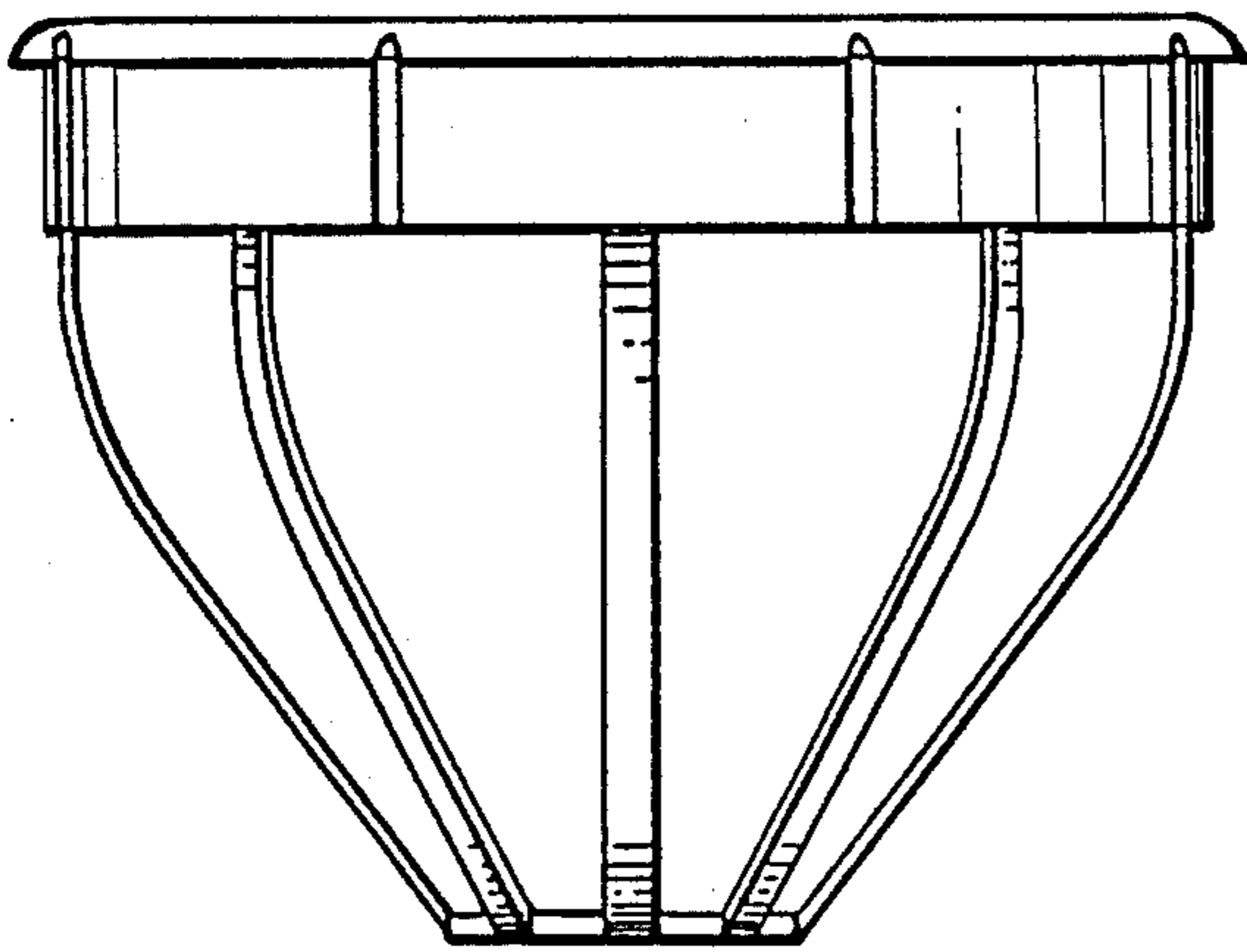

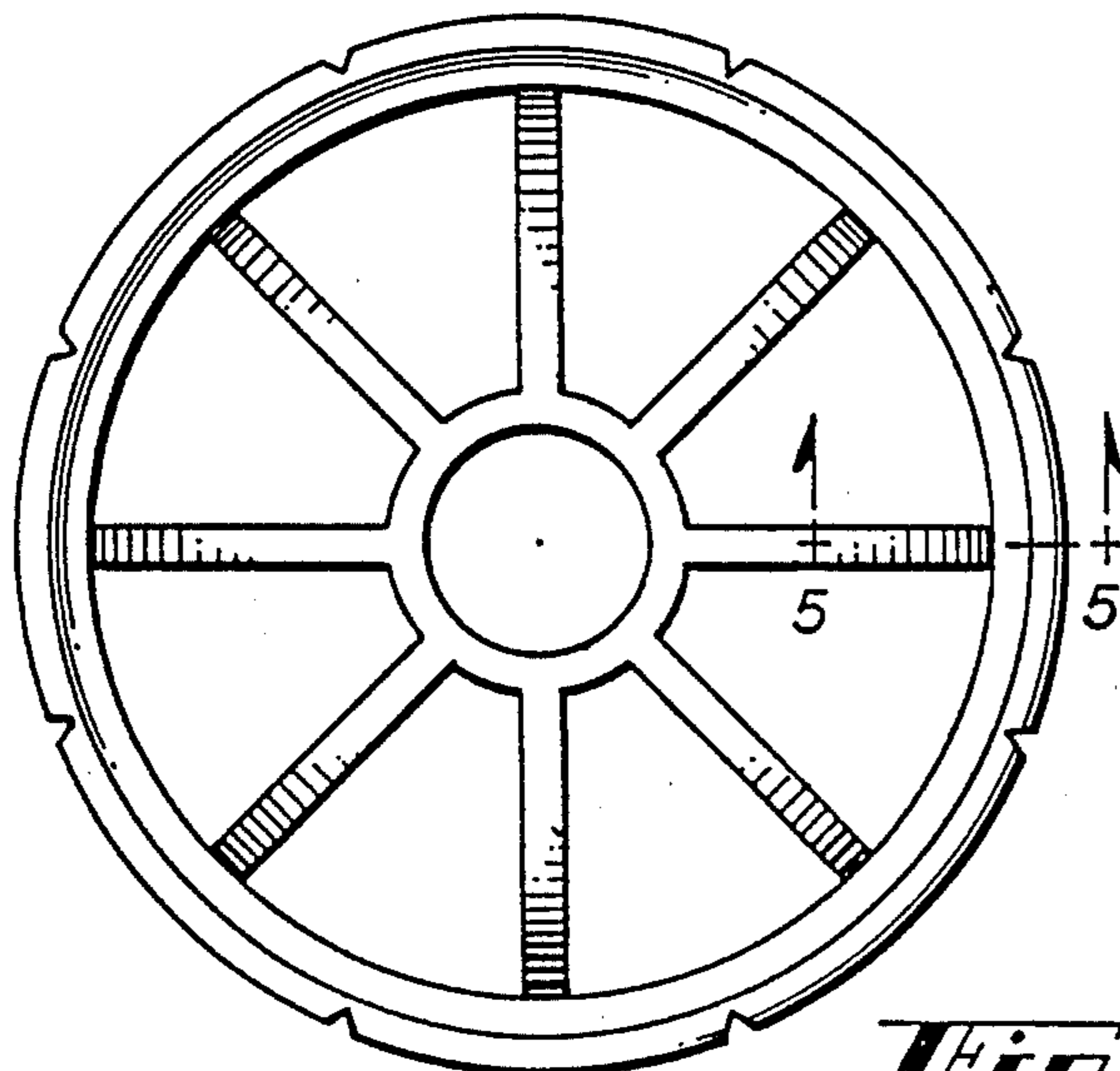
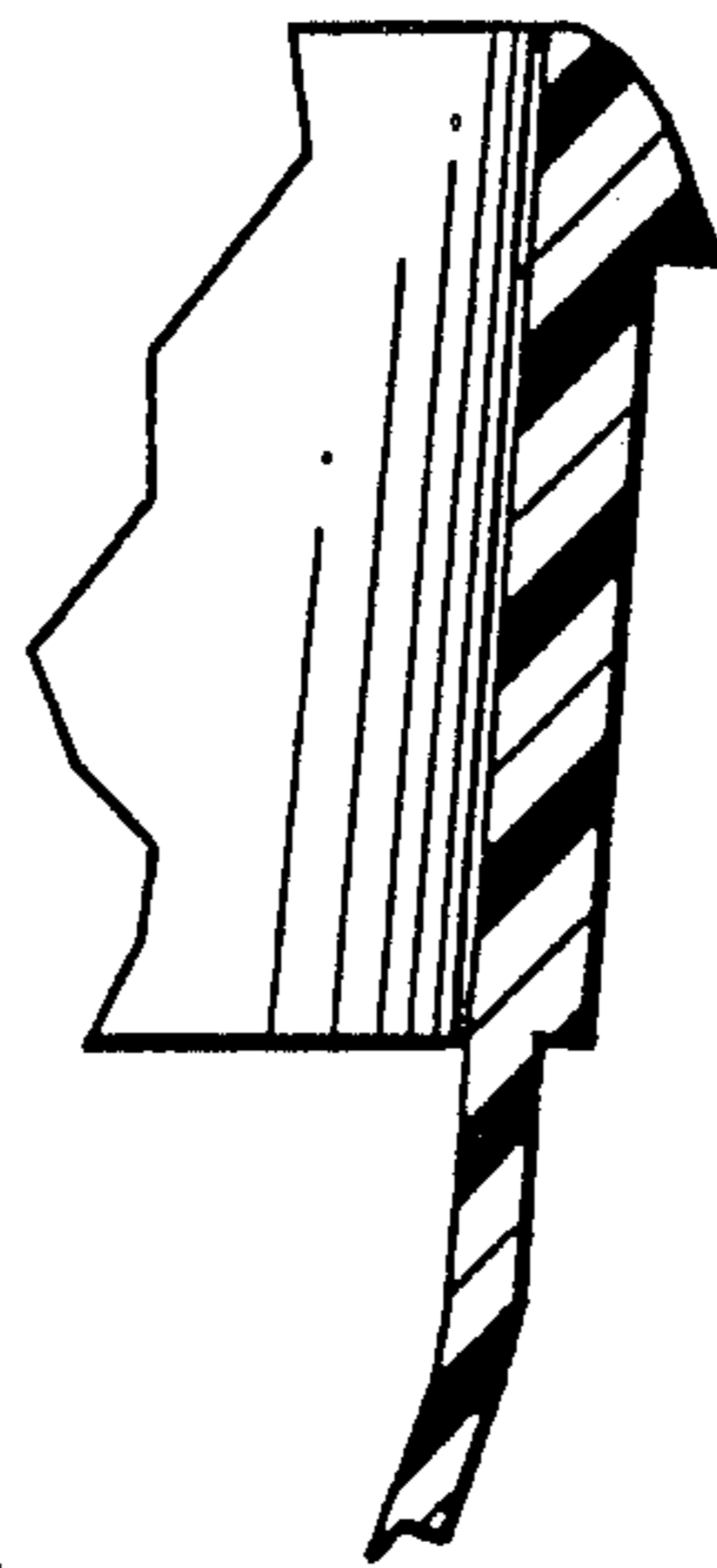

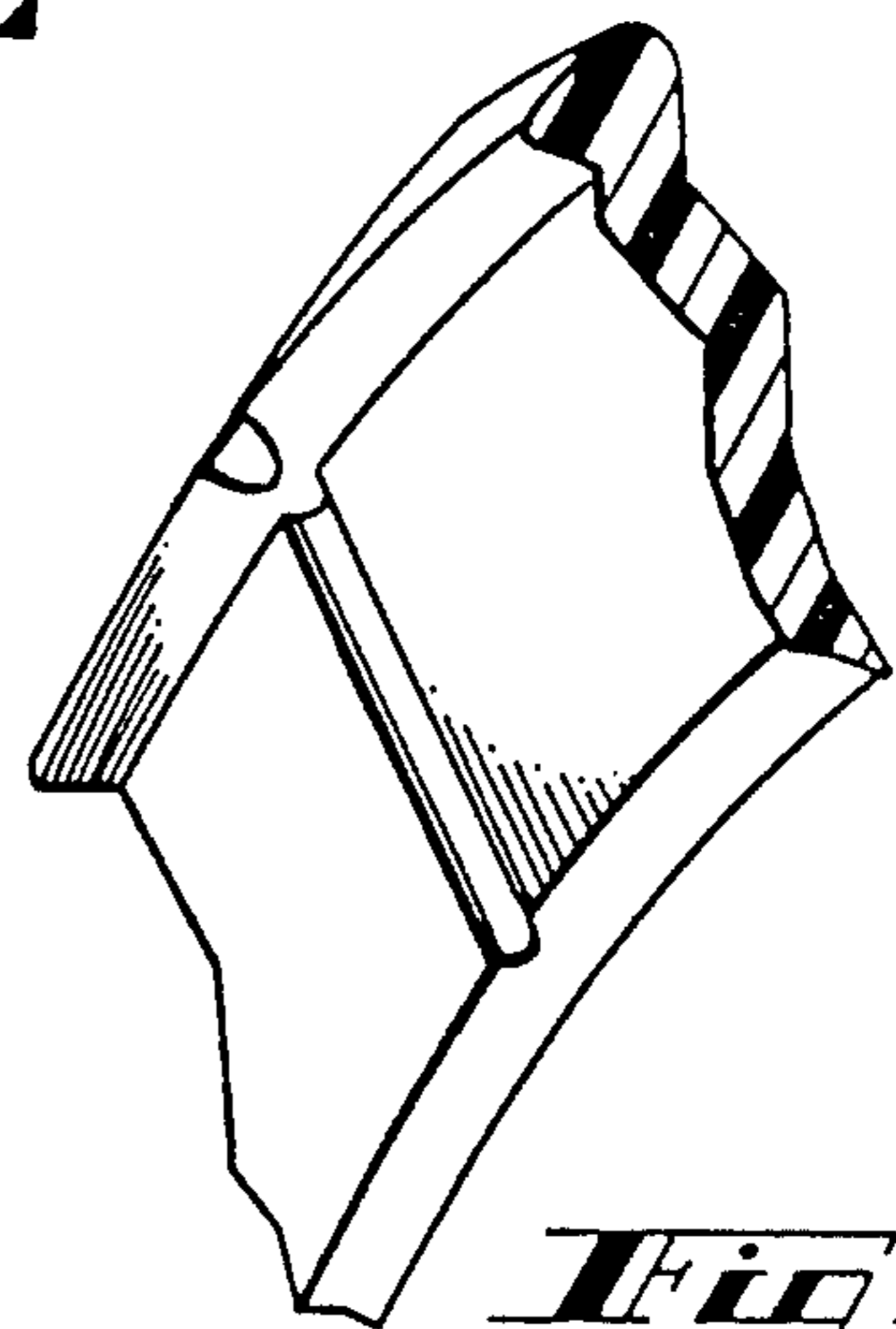
