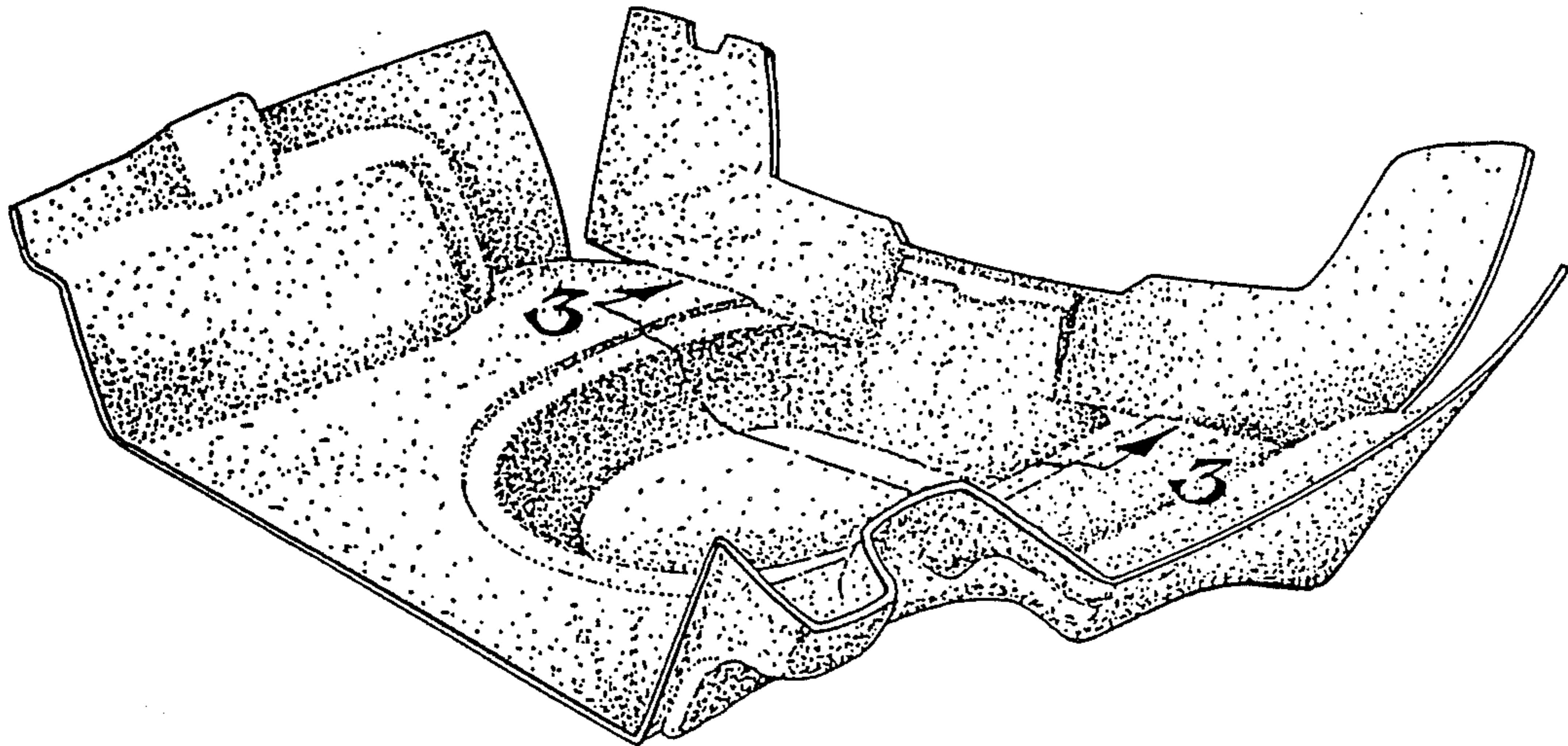

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an automobile trunk liner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the automobile trunk liner;
 FIG. 2 is another top perspective view of the automobile trunk liner but looking from the left side of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view on an enlarged scale taken substantially along line 3—3 in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a top perspective view similar to FIG. 1, but showing the automobile trunk liner installed in the trunk compartment of an automobile;
 FIG. 5 is a top perspective view similar to FIG. 4, but looking in the opposite direction, showing the trunk liner installed in the trunk compartment of an automobile; and
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the automobile trunk liner installed in the trunk compartment of an automobile. The broken line showing of the trunk compartment of an automobile and the rear end of an automobile in FIGS. 4, 5 and 6 of the drawing is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



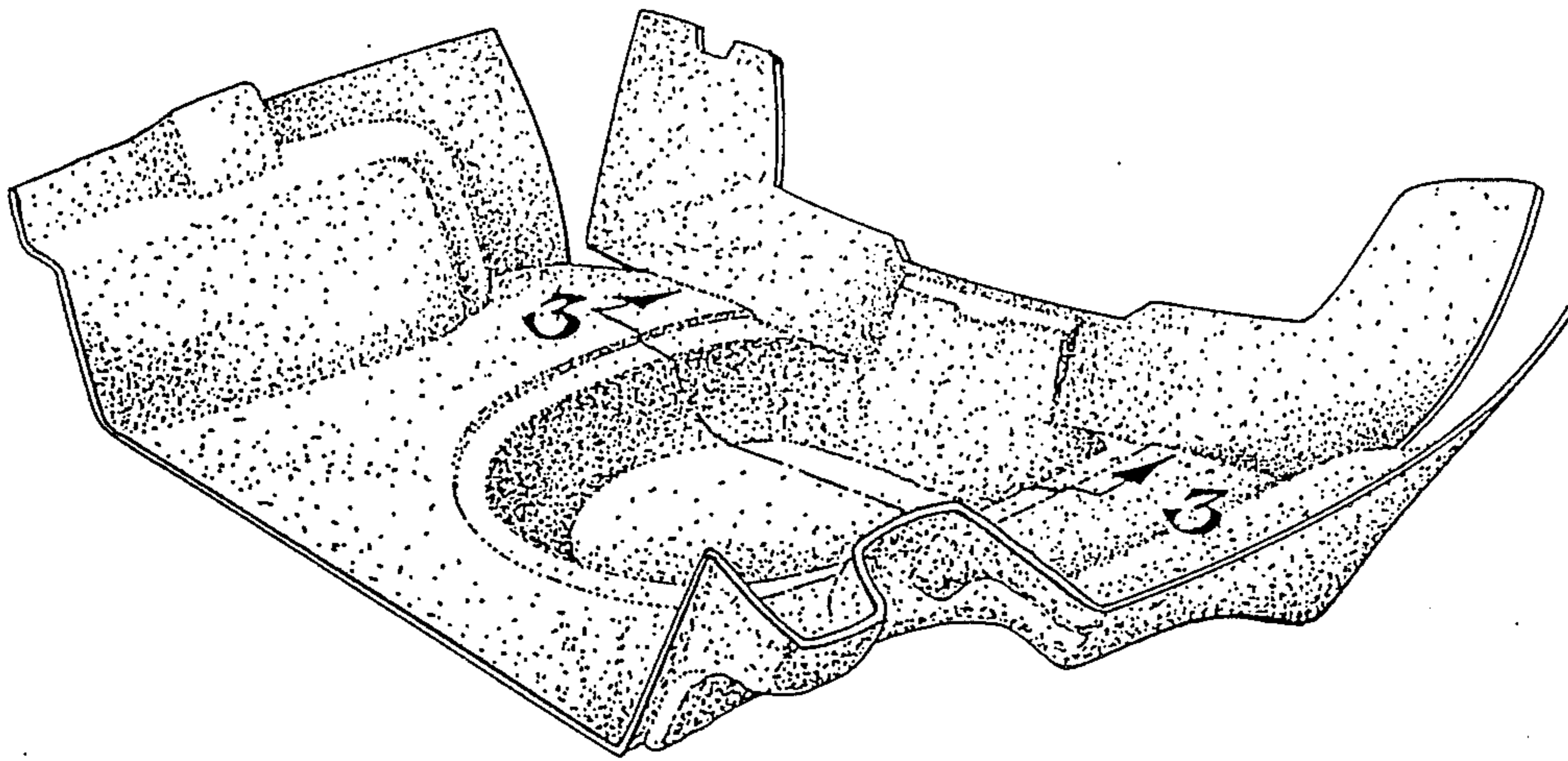

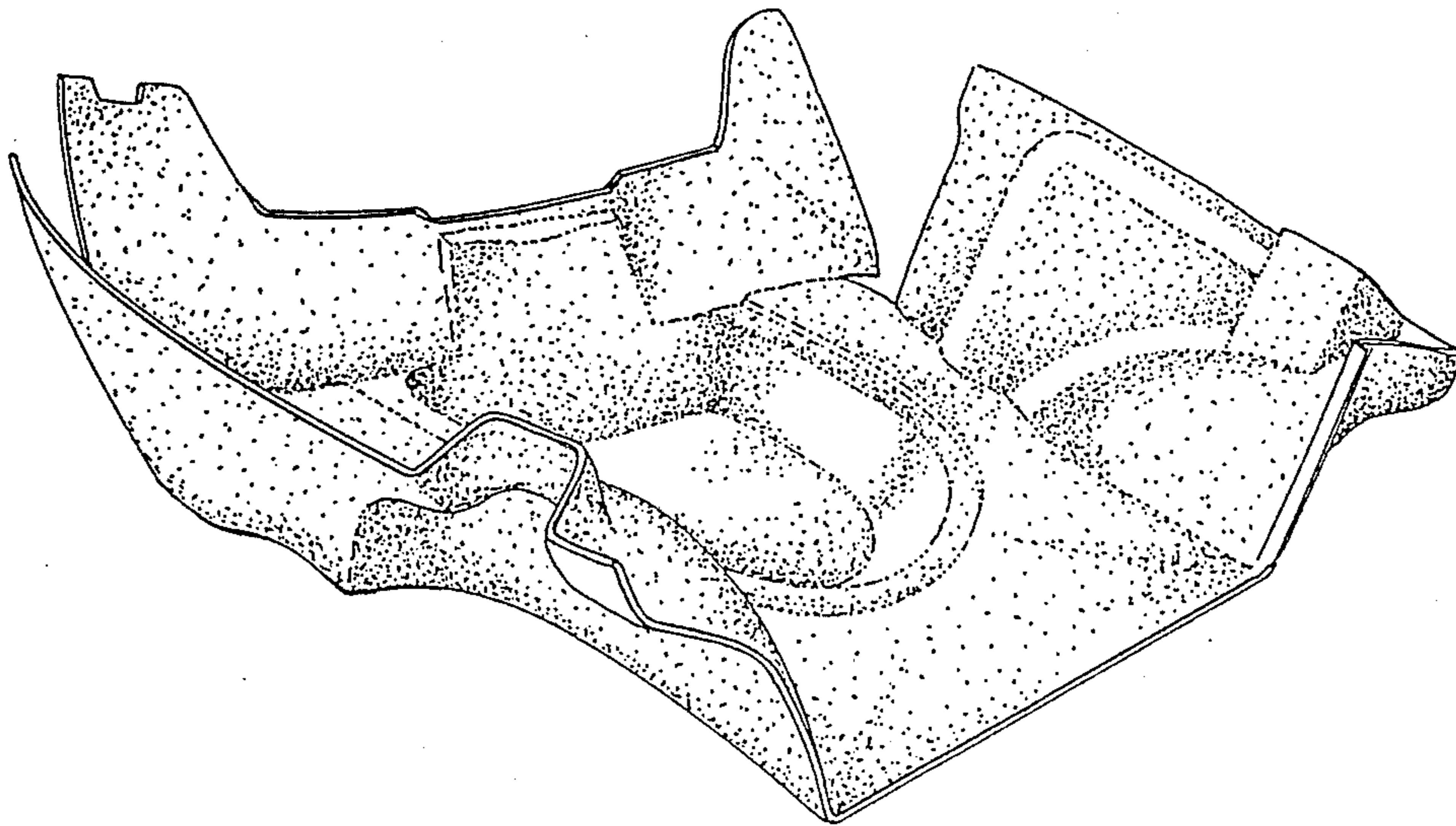
