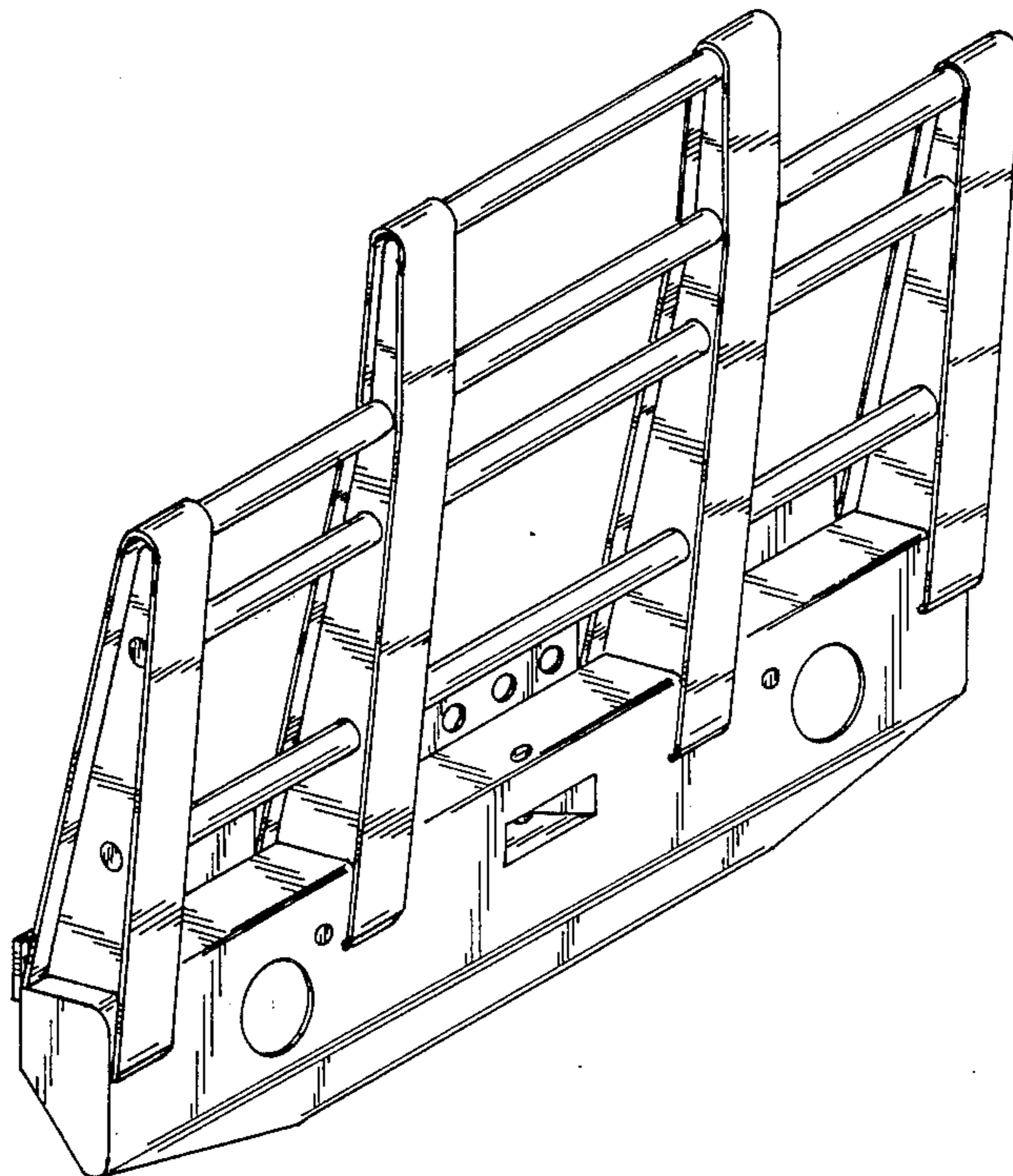

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined vehicle bumper and guard showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown.



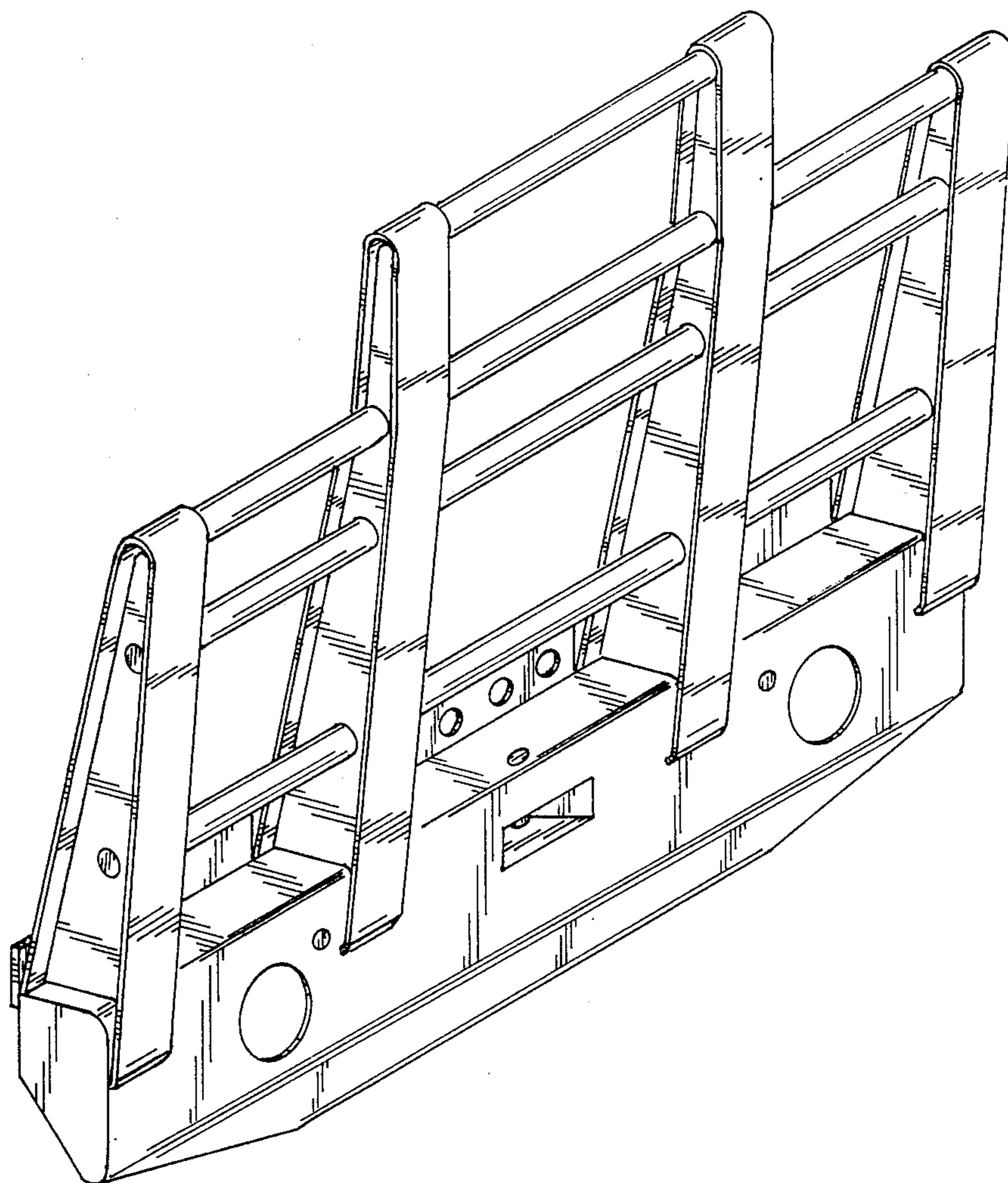

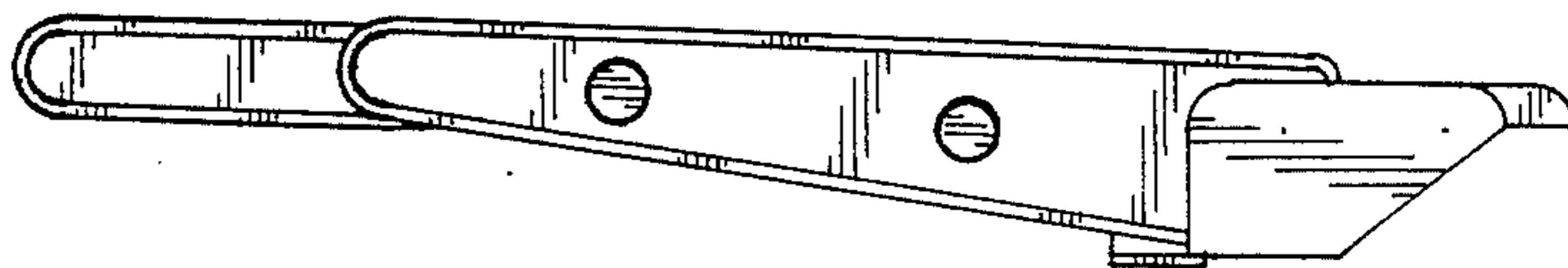

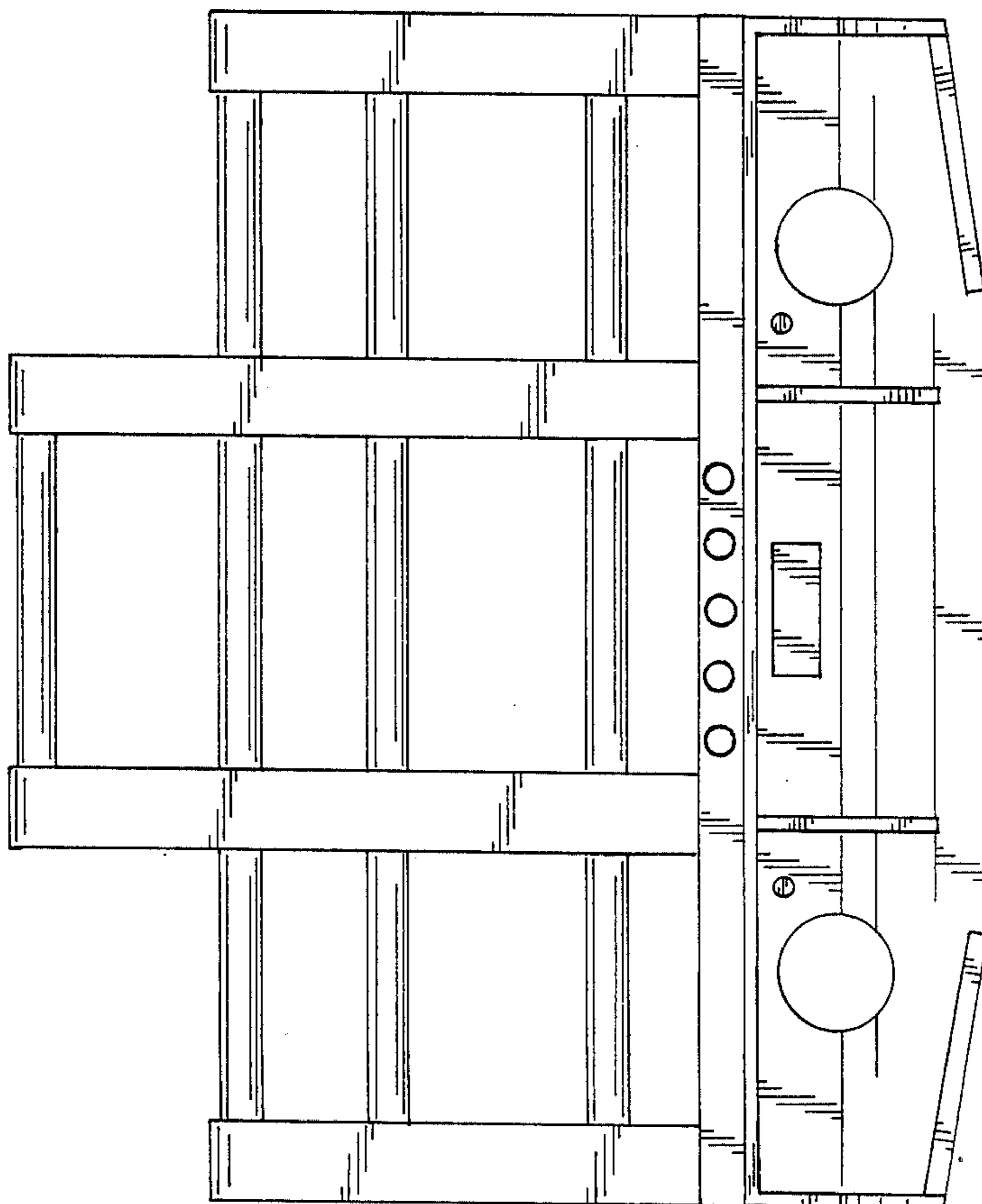
