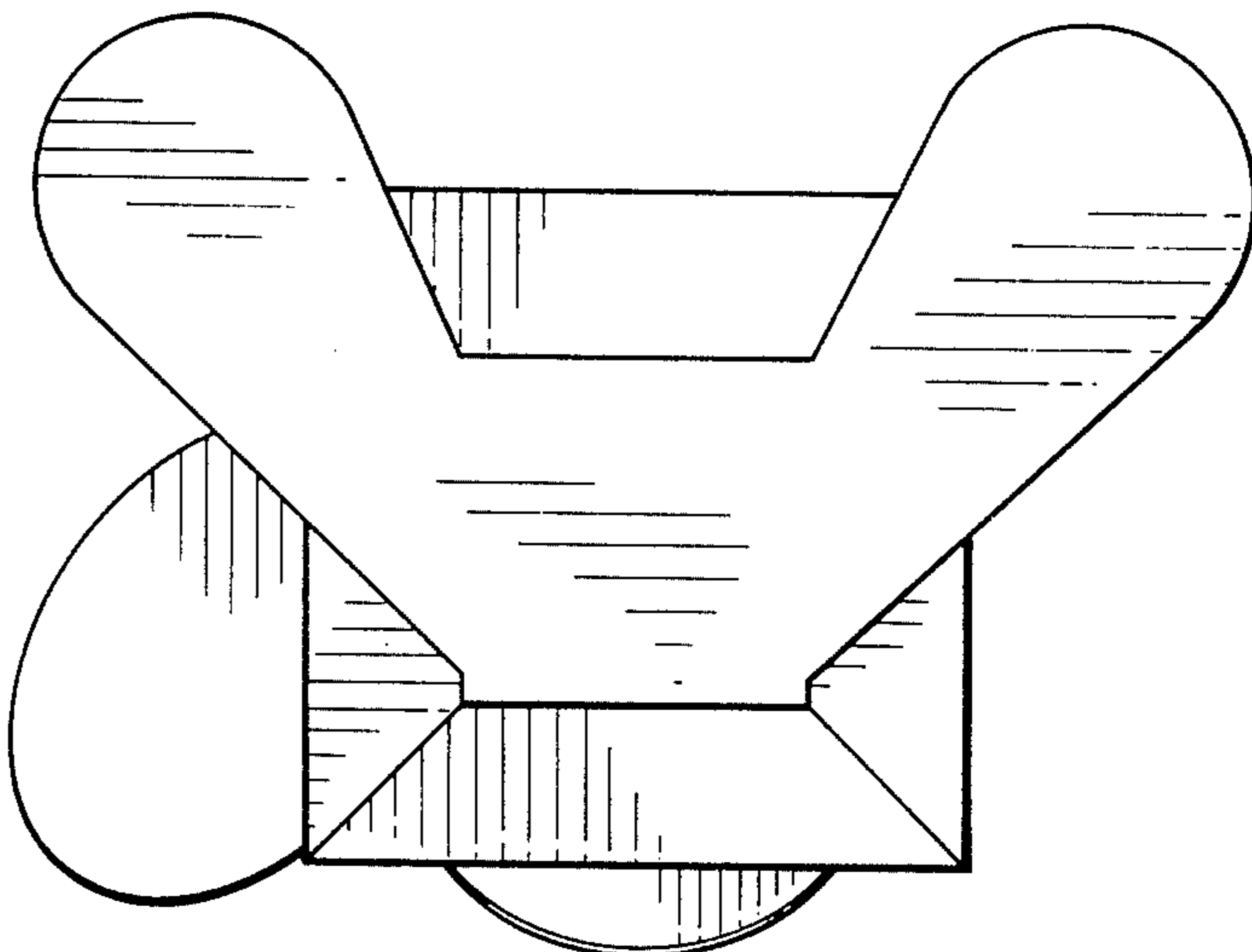
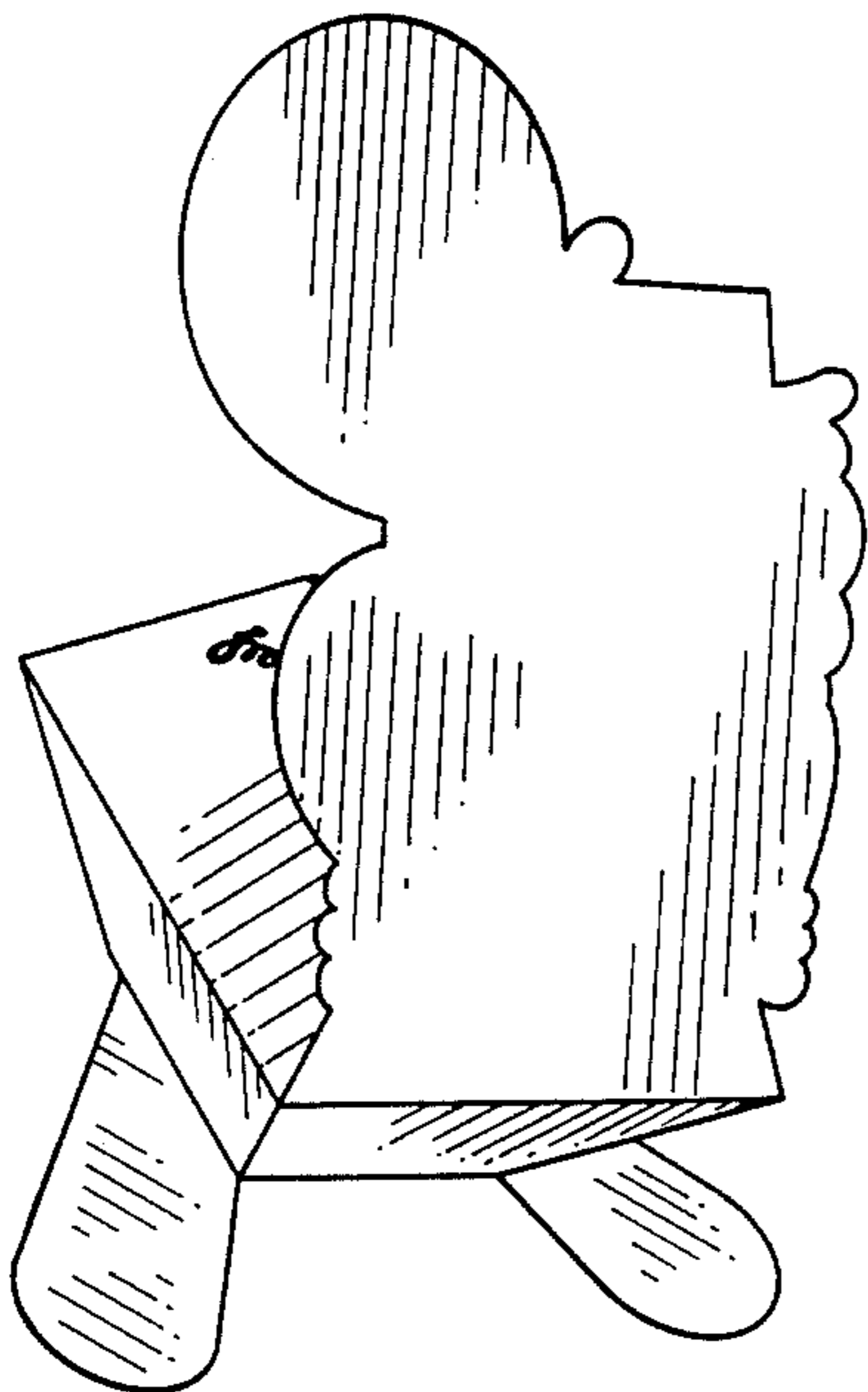

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, in partially collapsed condition.



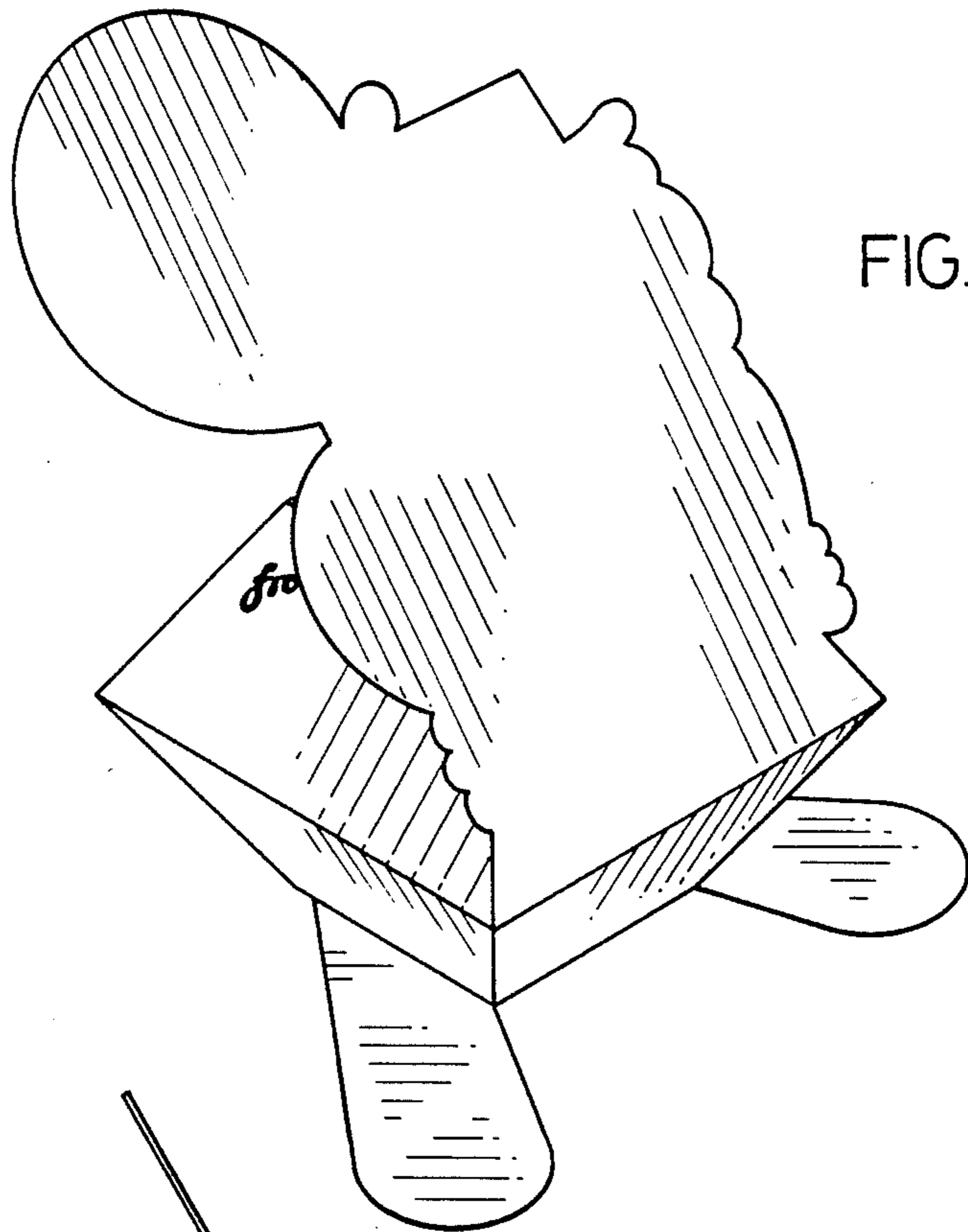

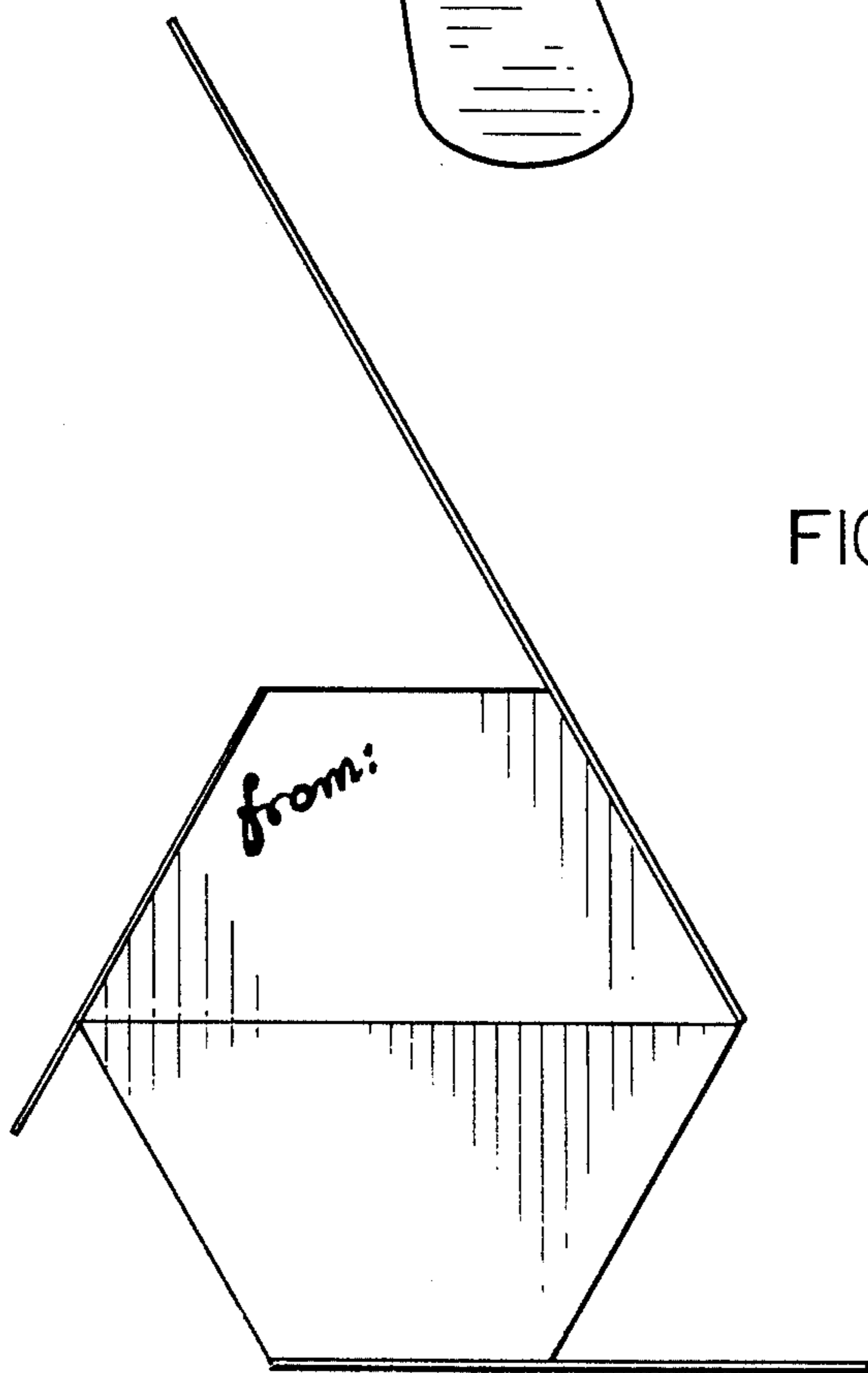

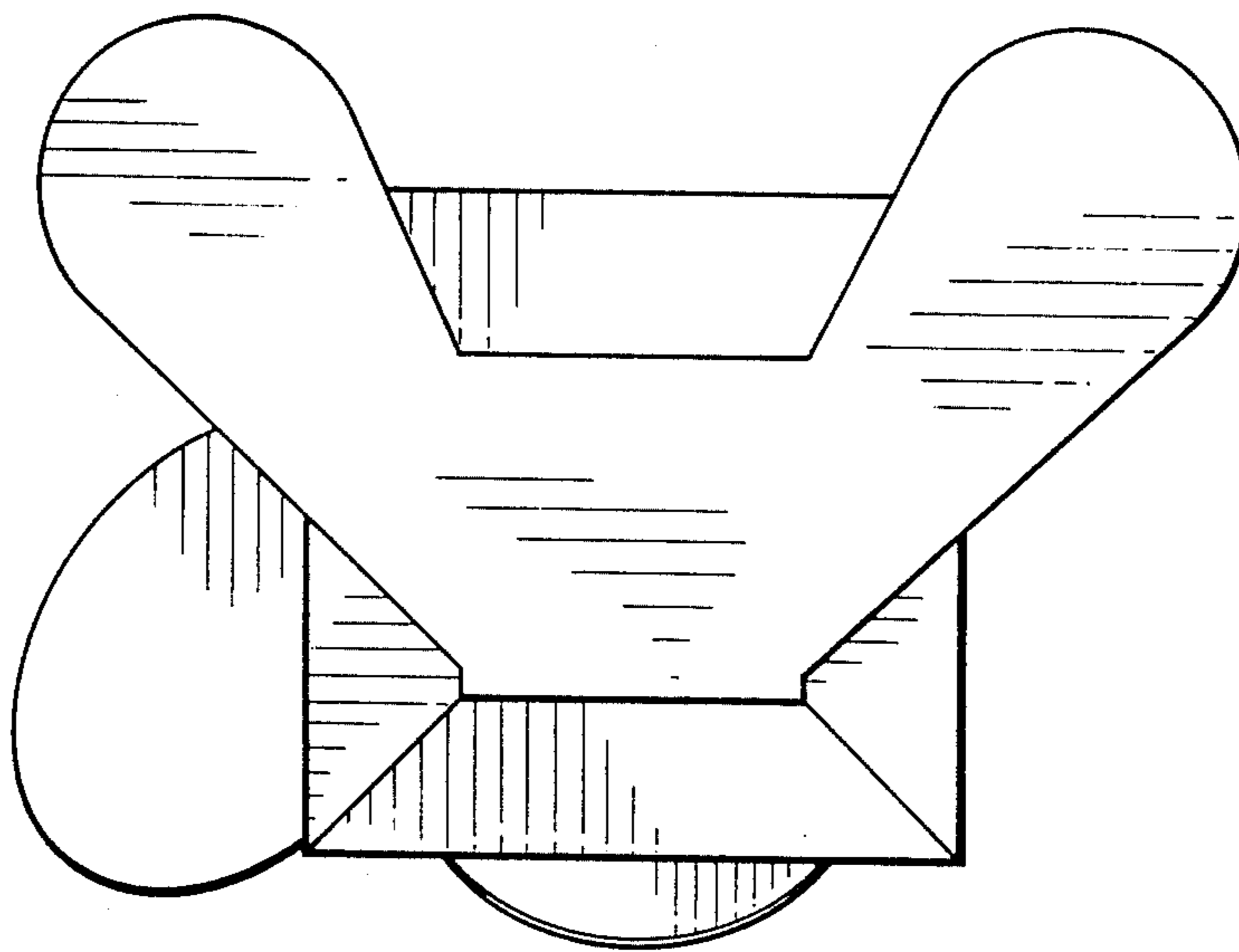
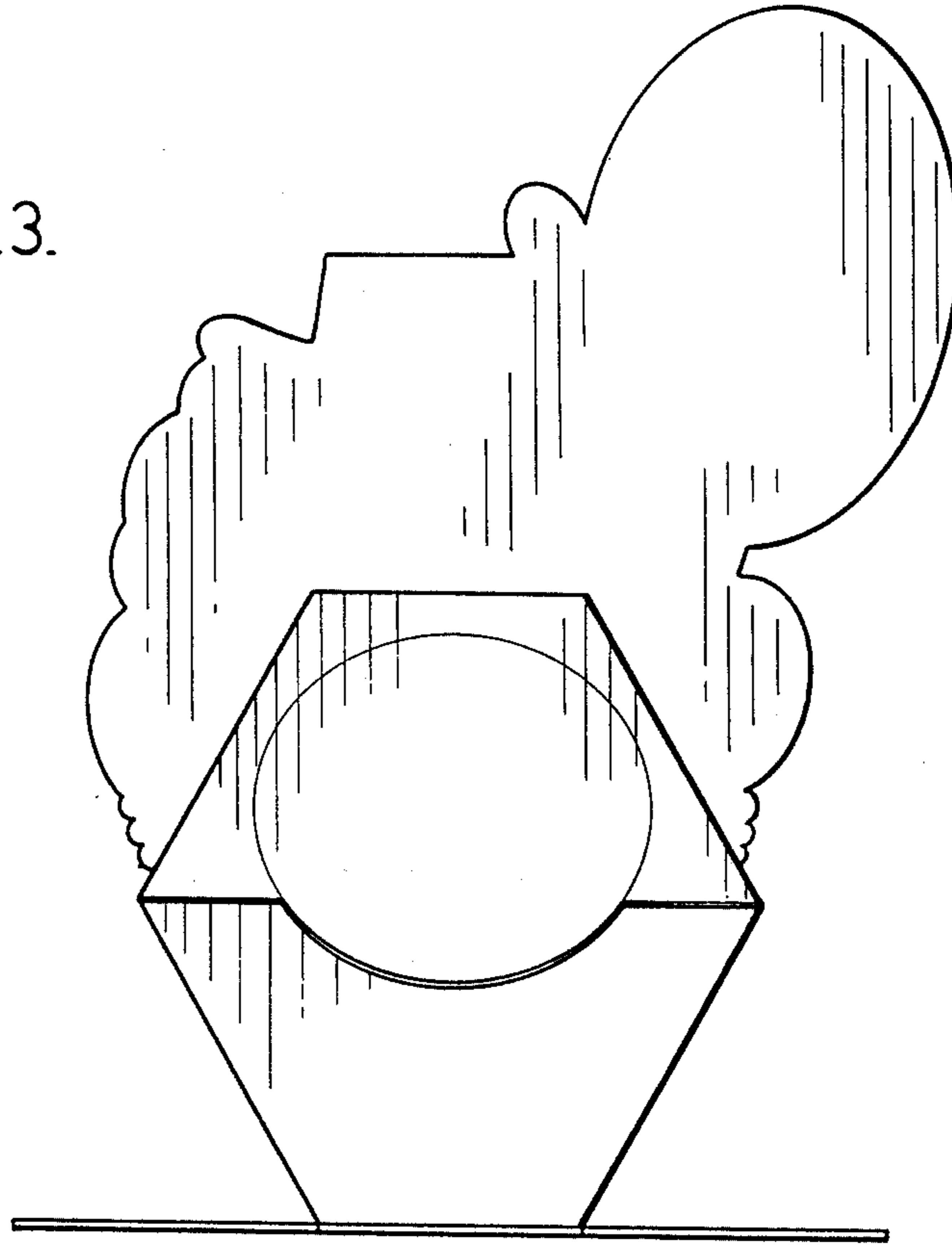

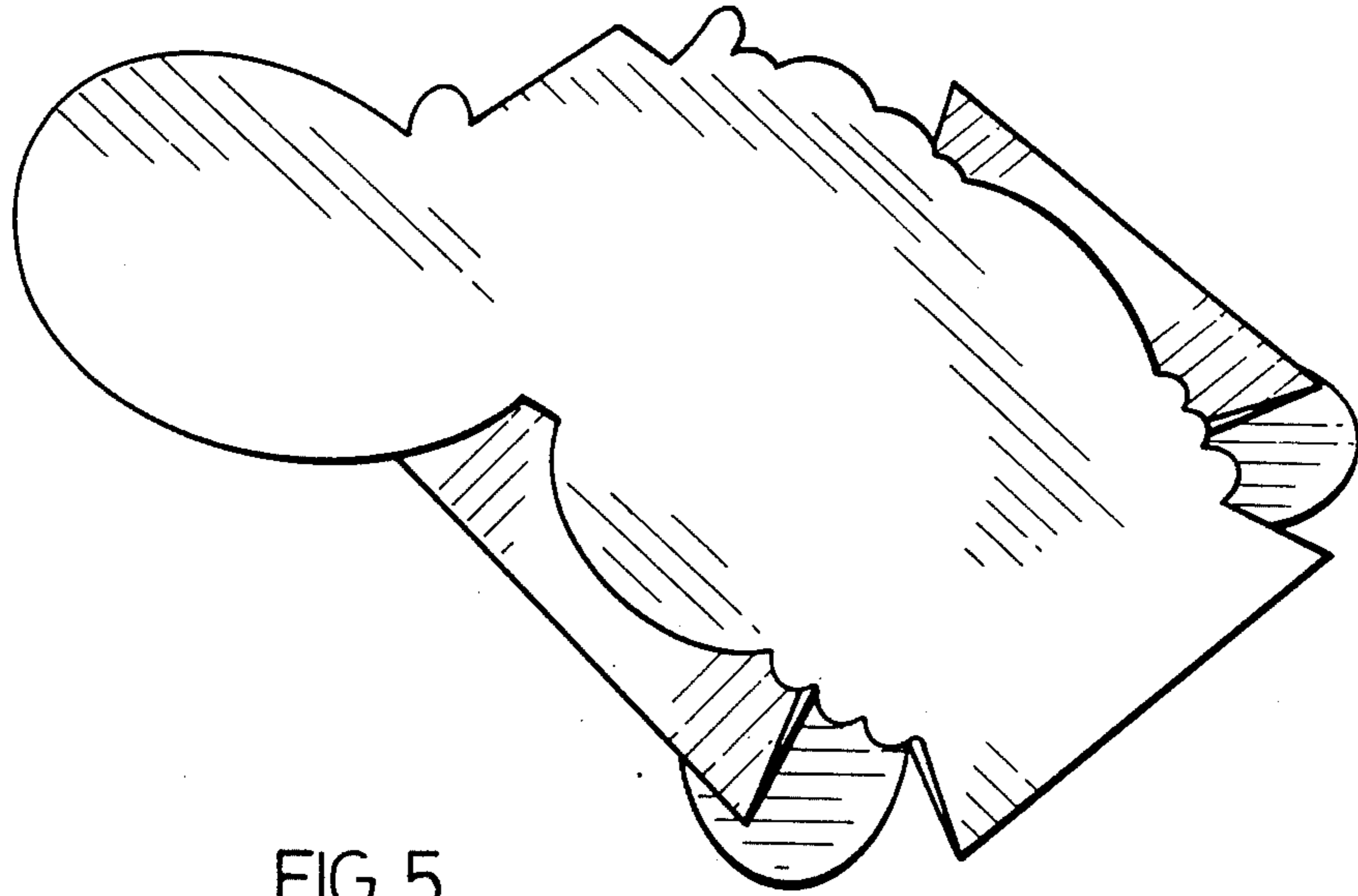
