

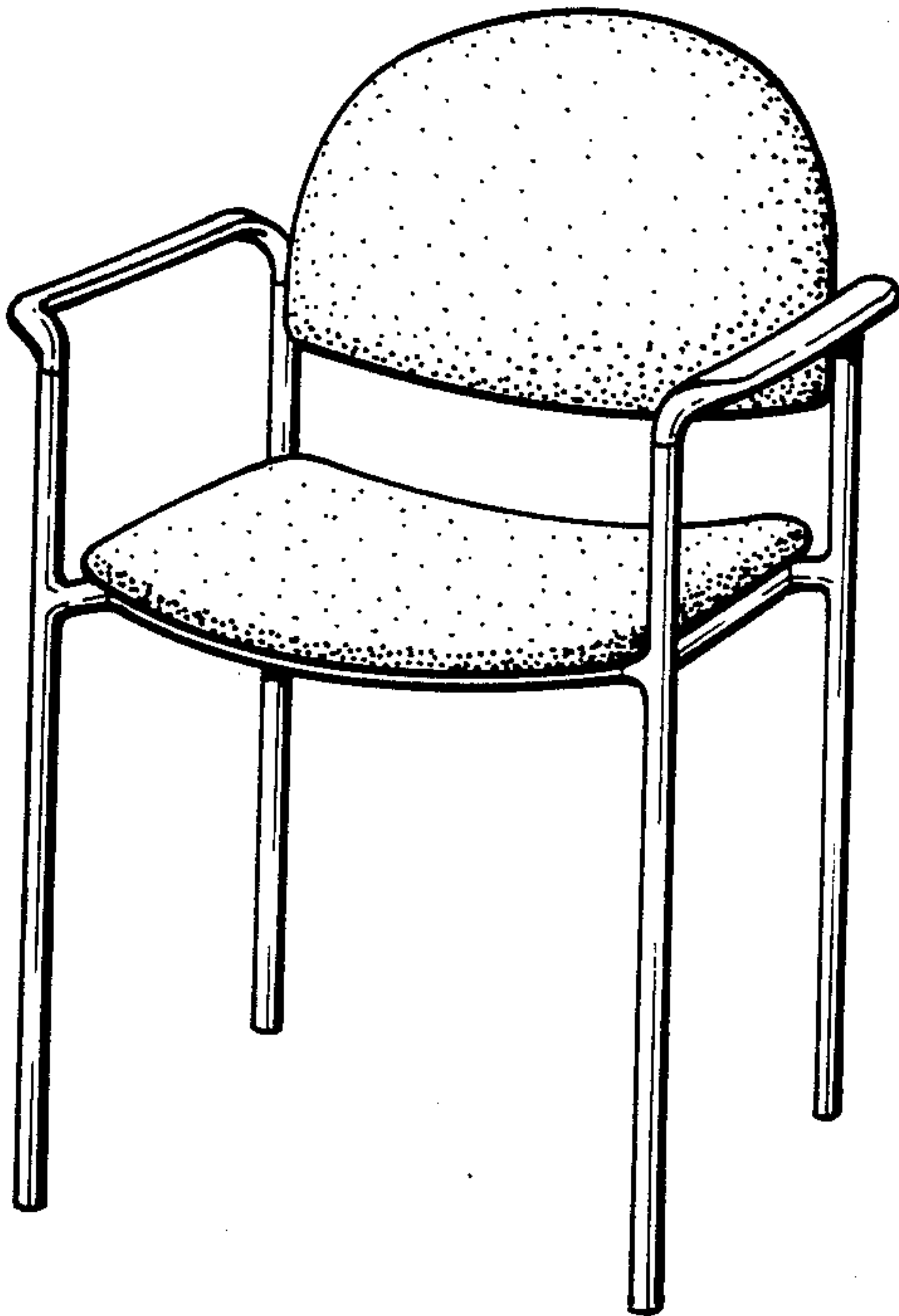

DESCRIPTION

8 and 9.



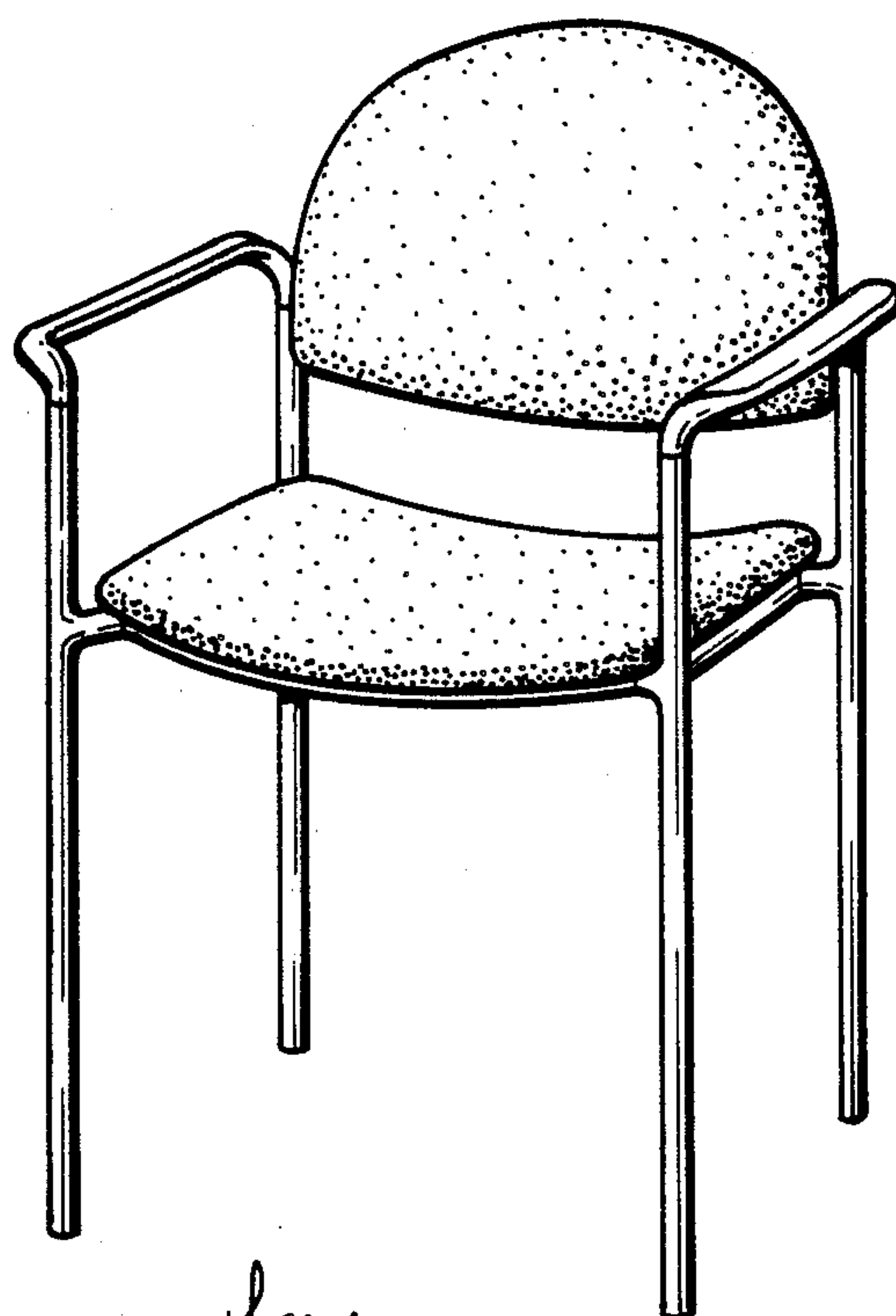

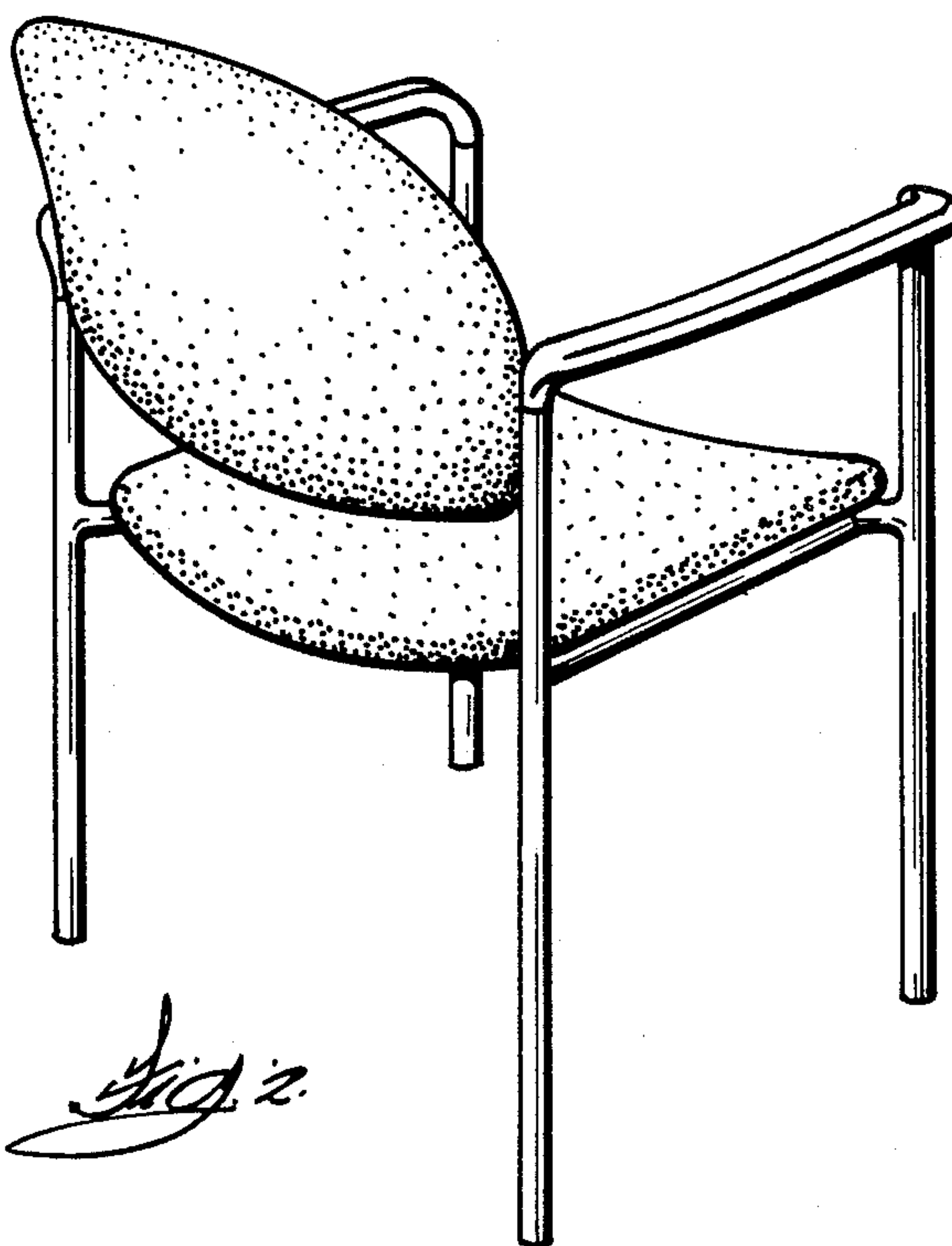

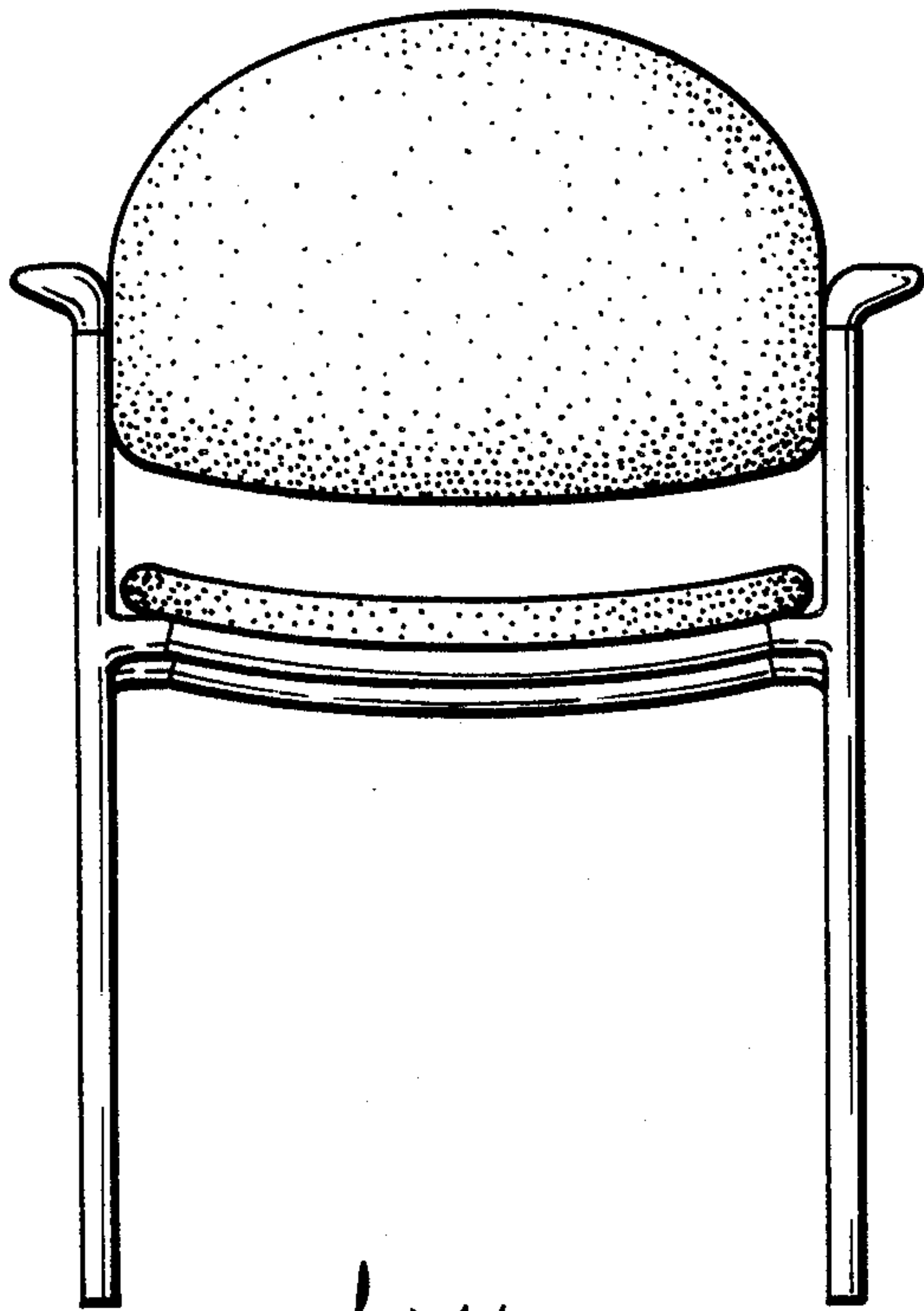

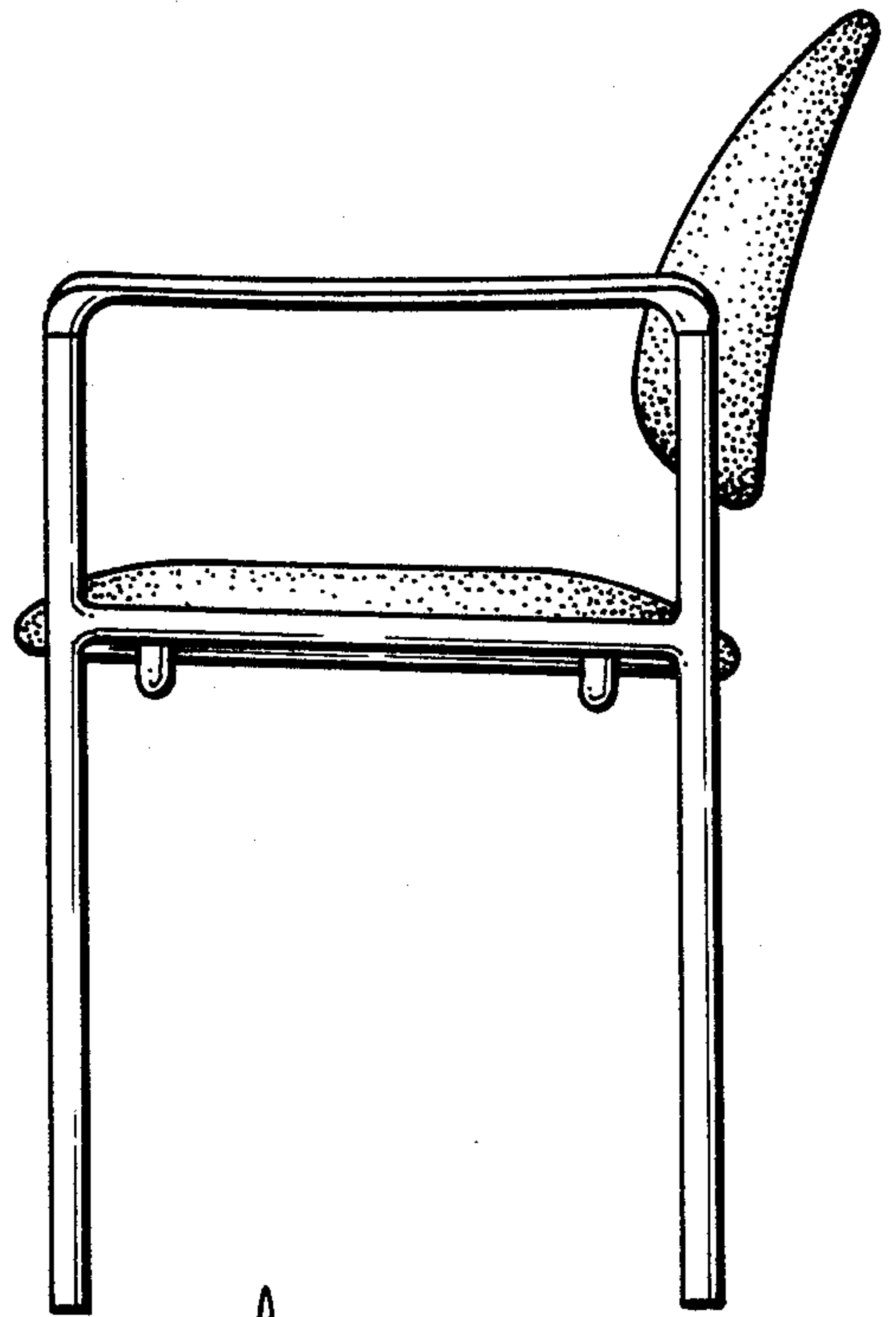

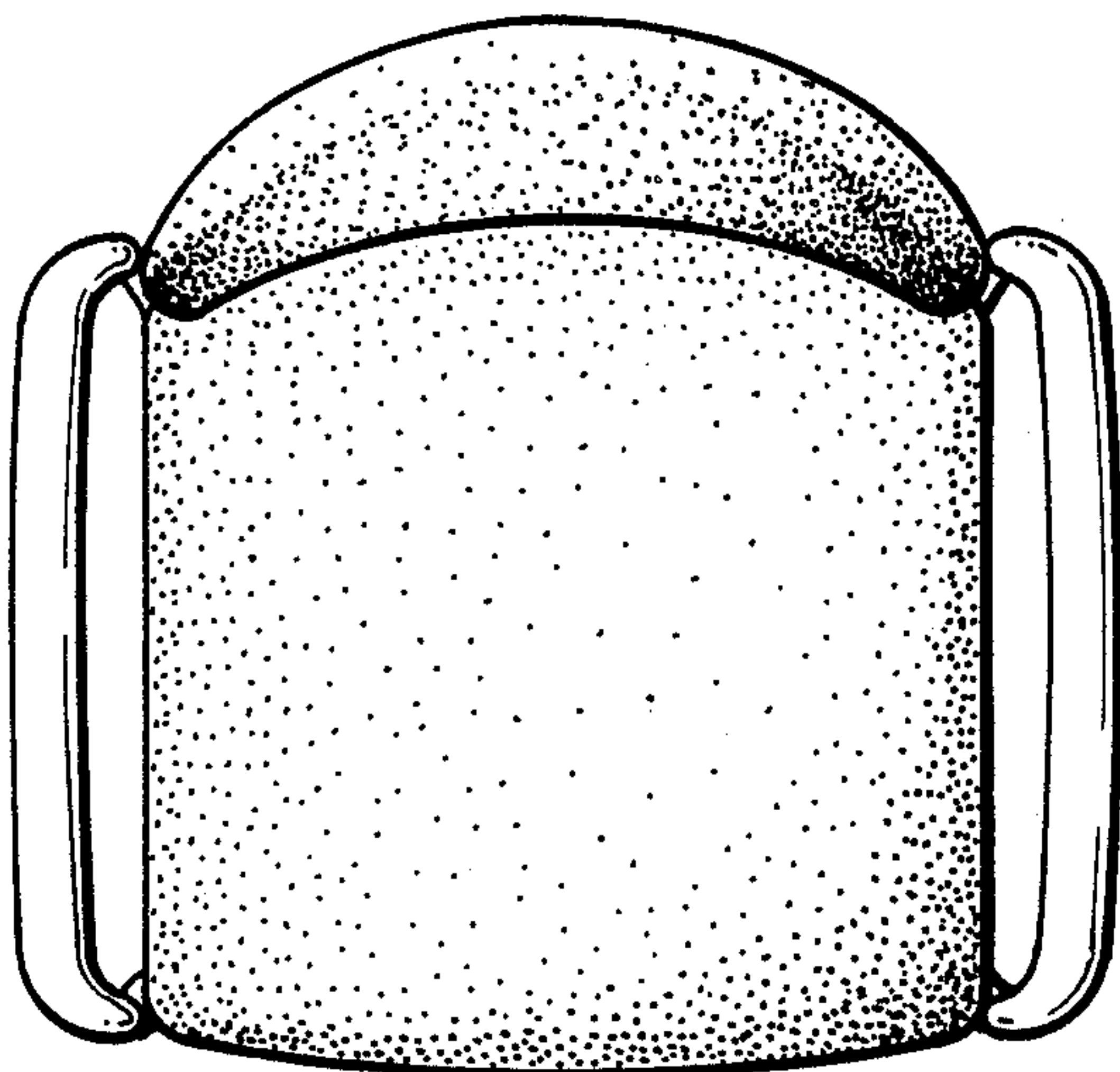

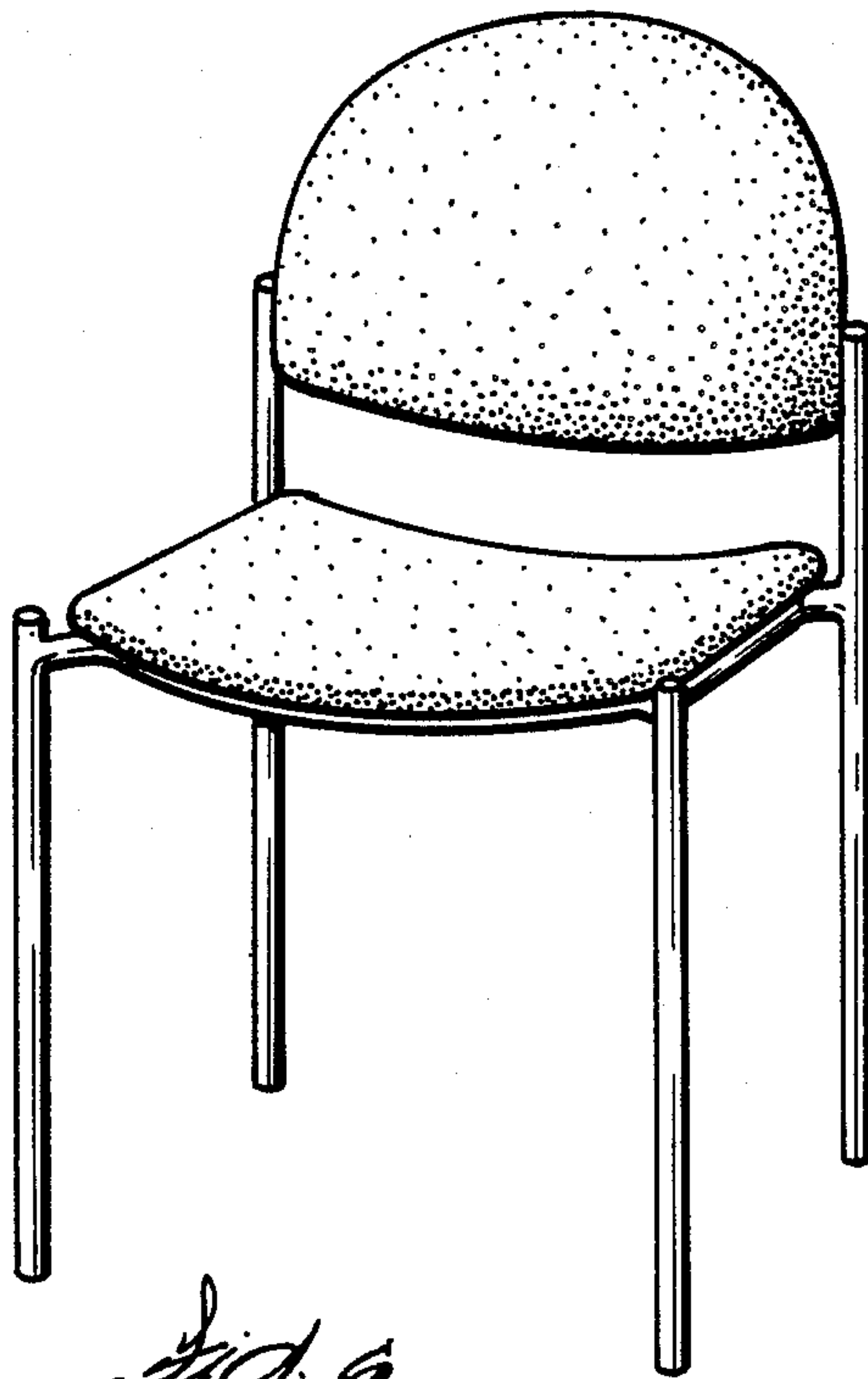

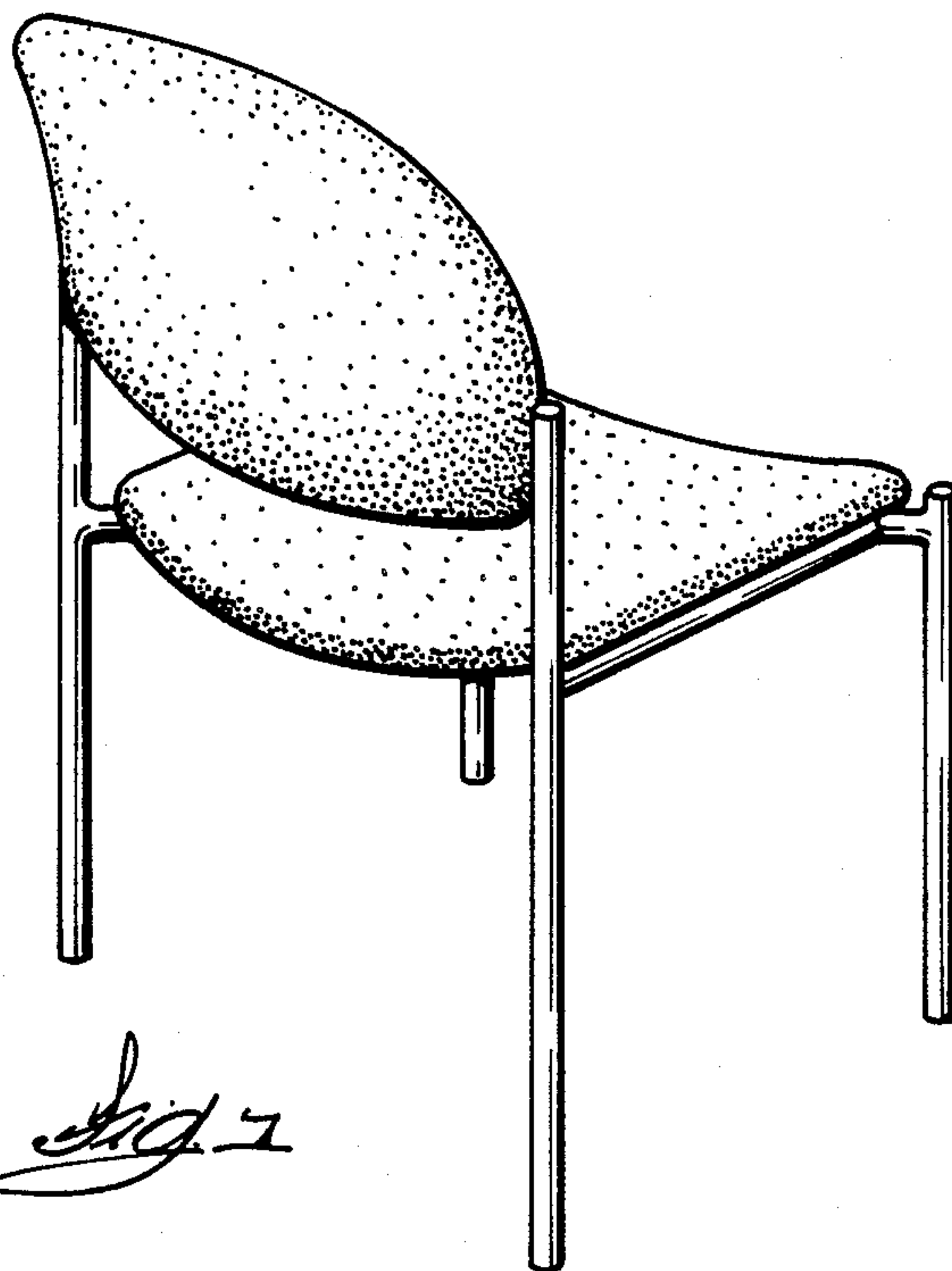

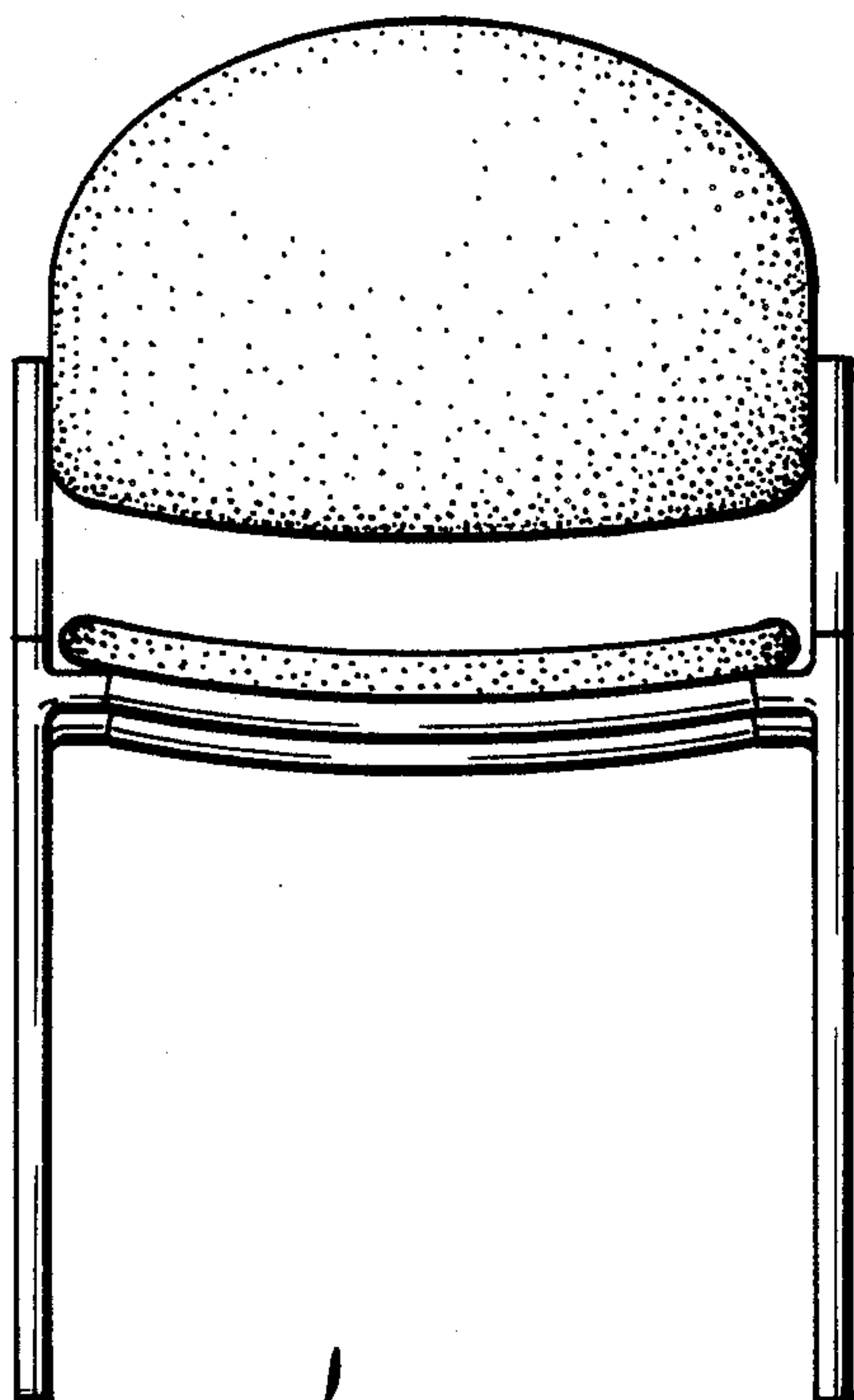

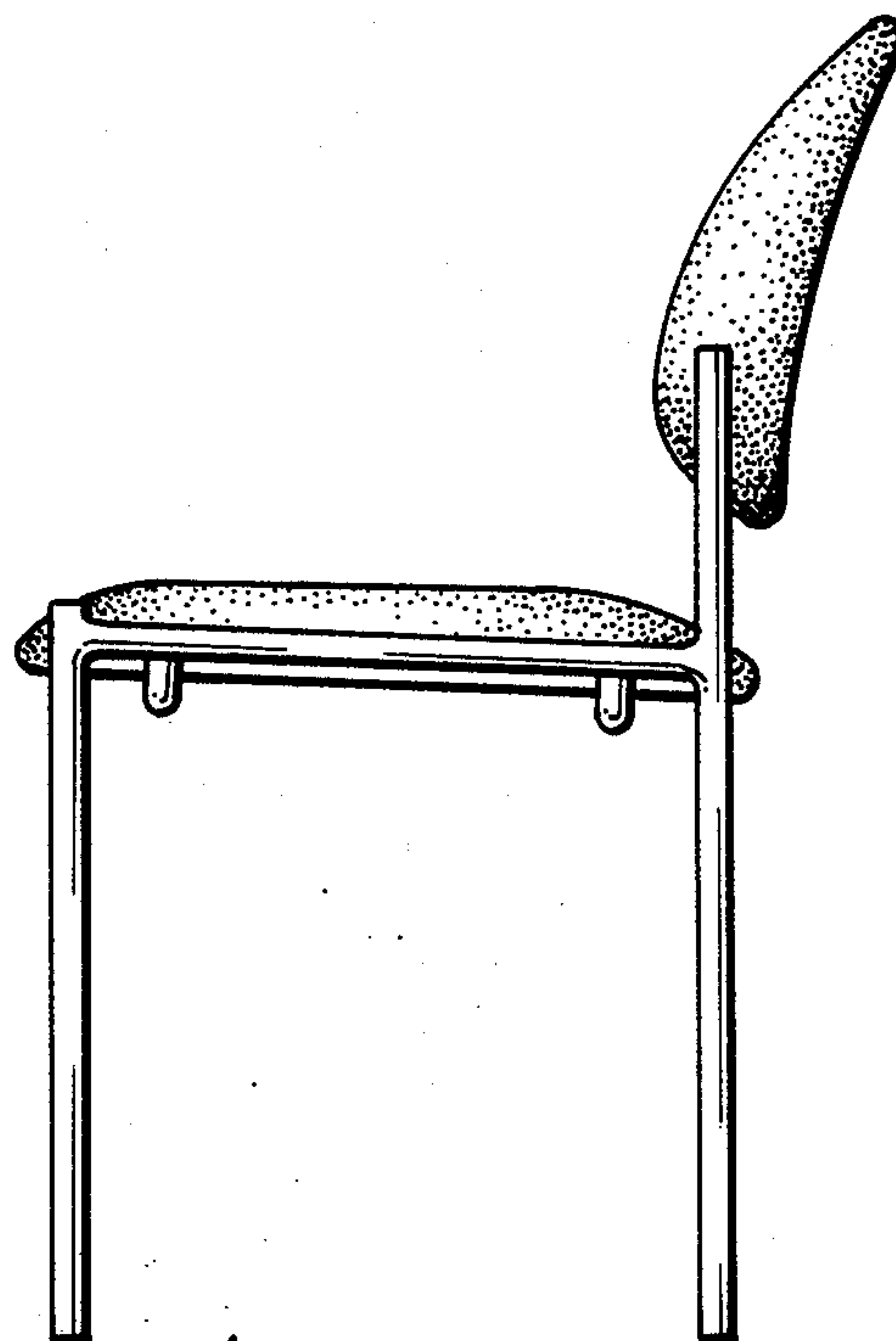

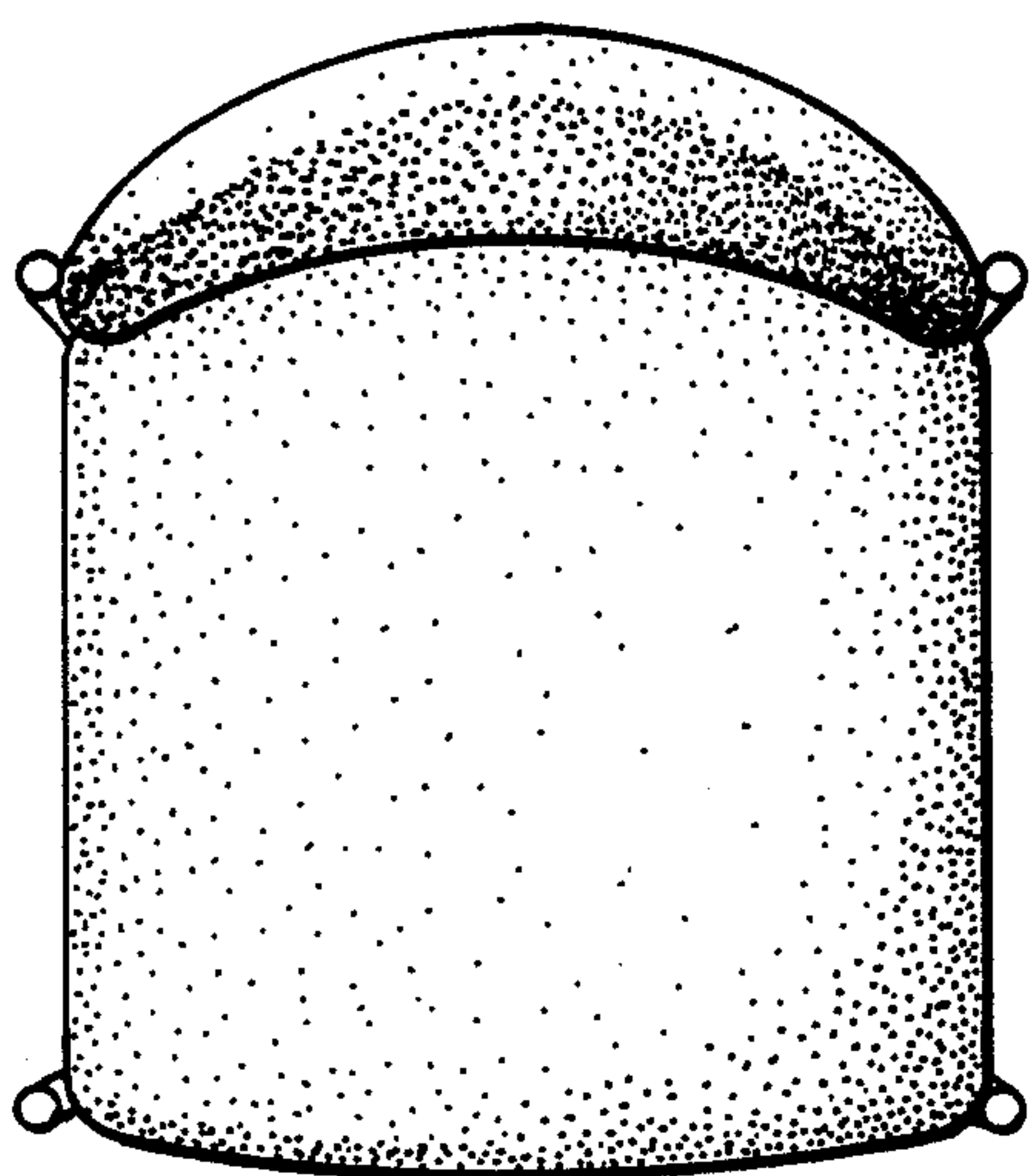
