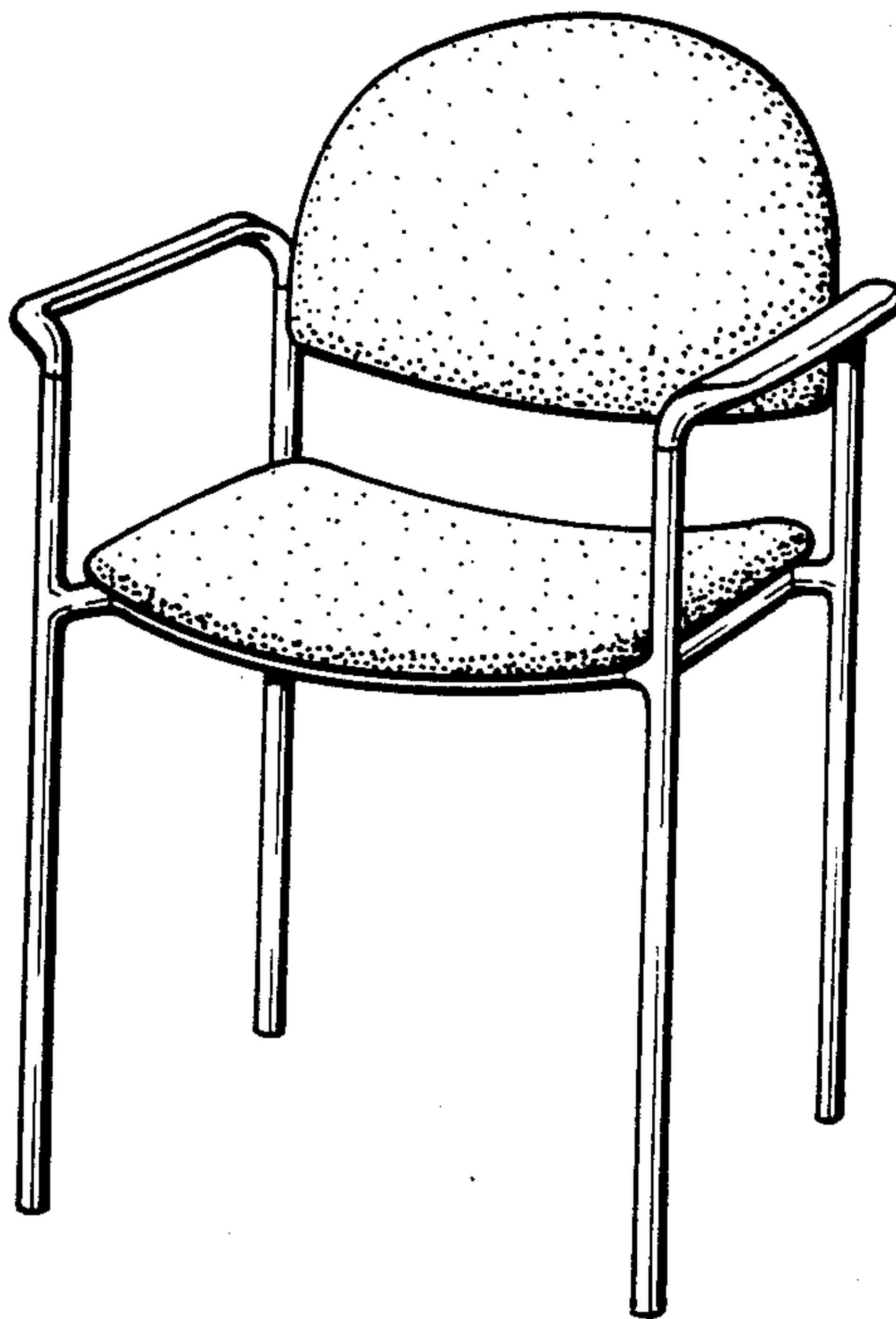

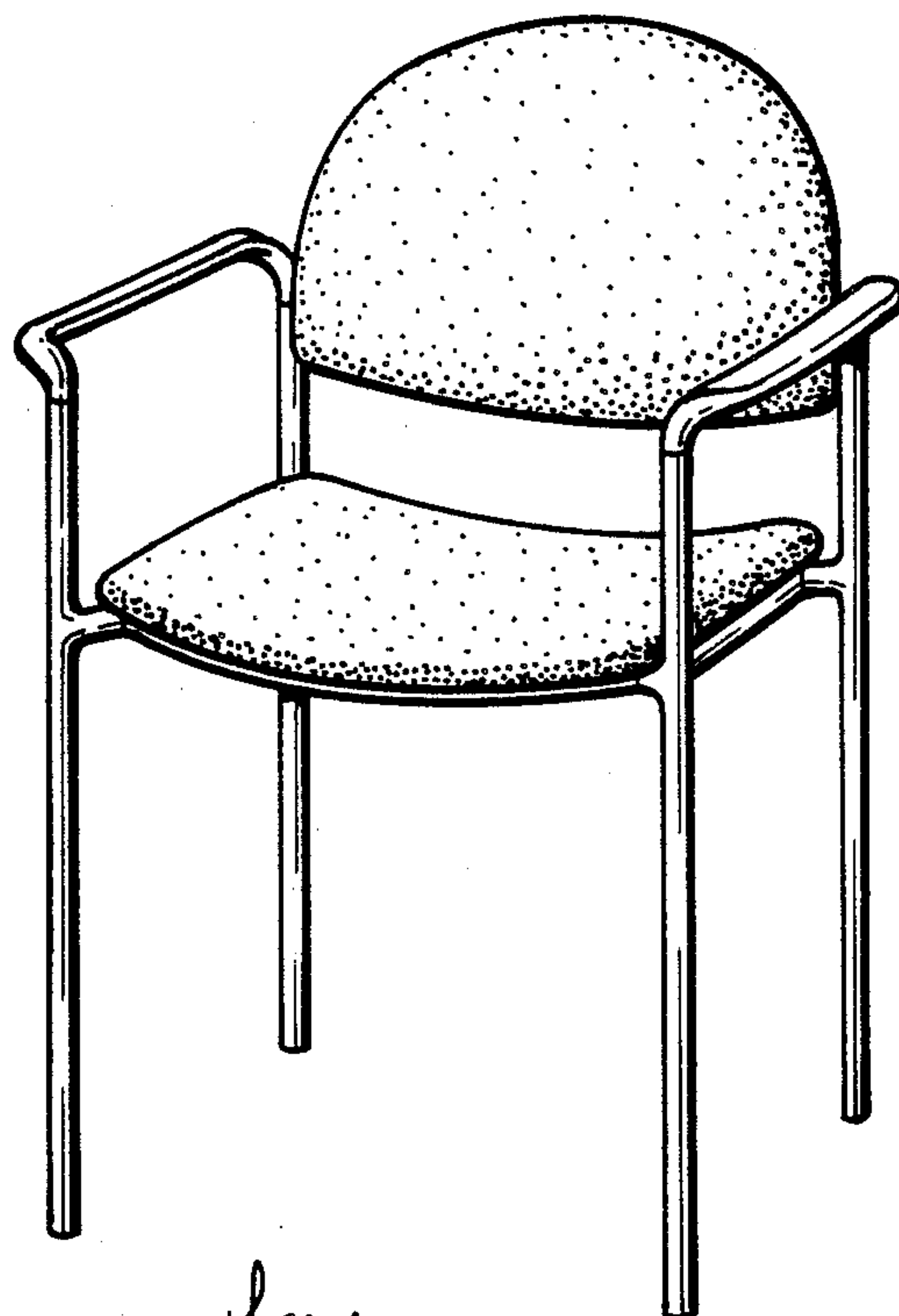
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

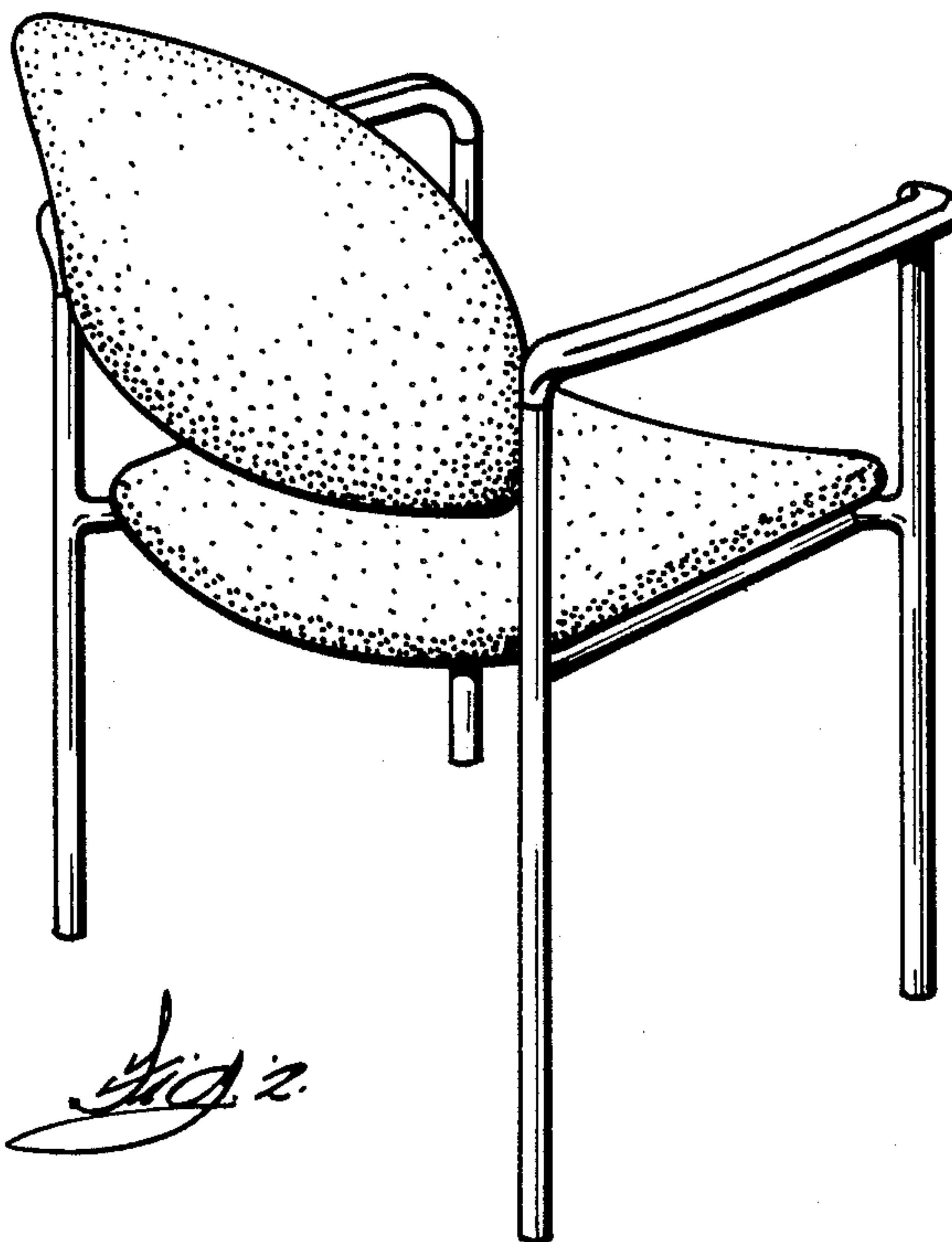
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 10 is a plan view of the chair shown in FIGS. 6, 7, 8 and 9.

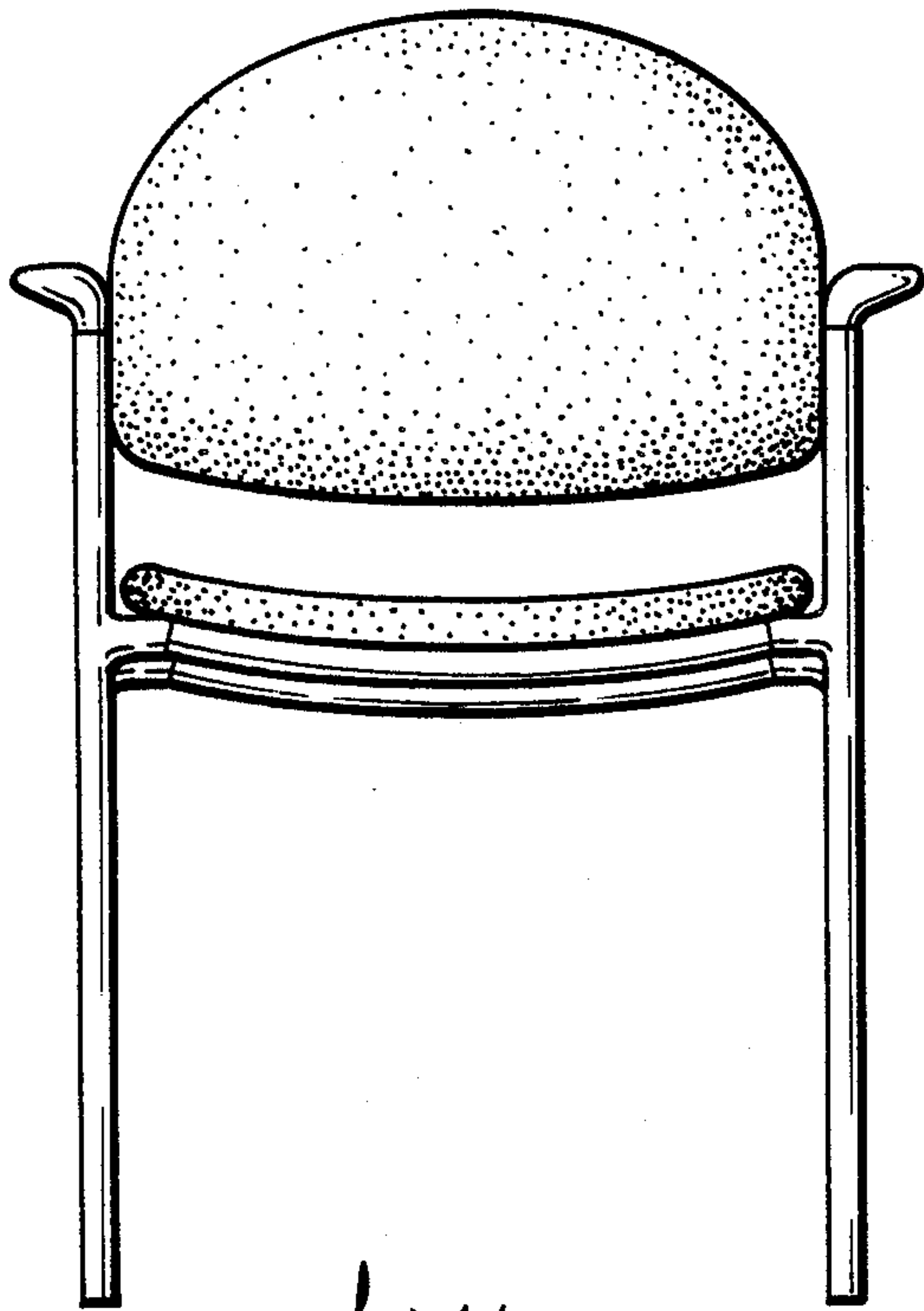




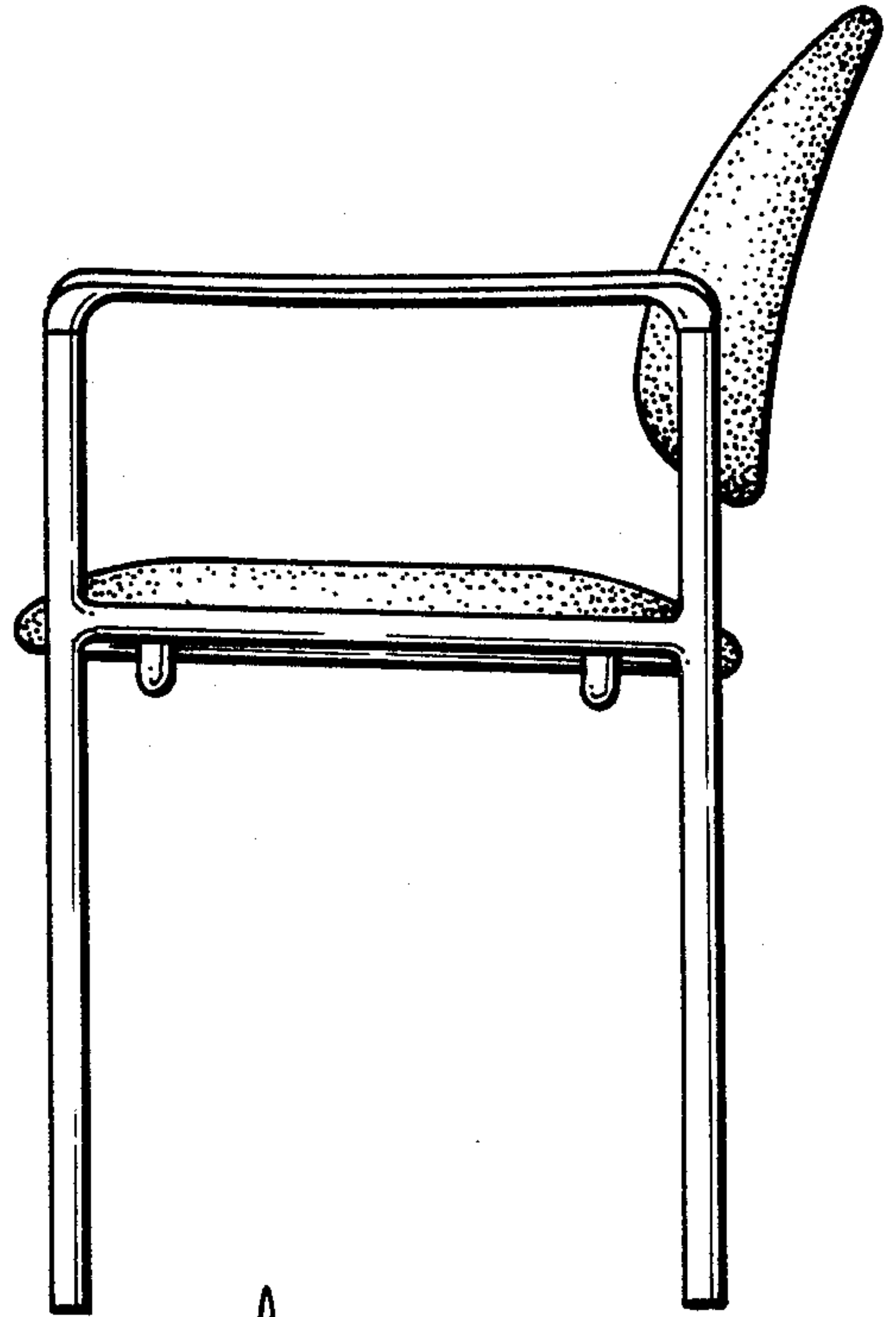

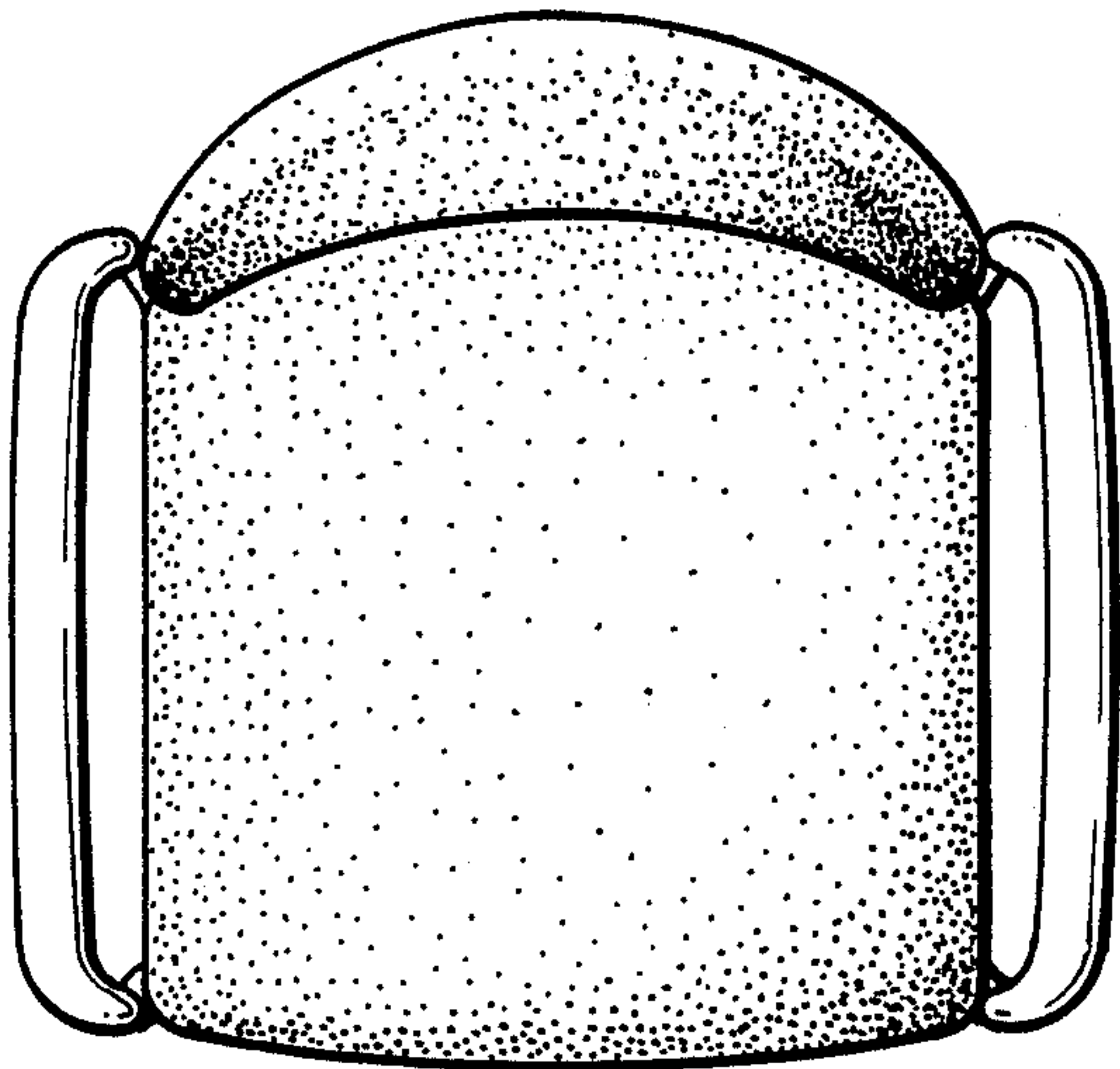

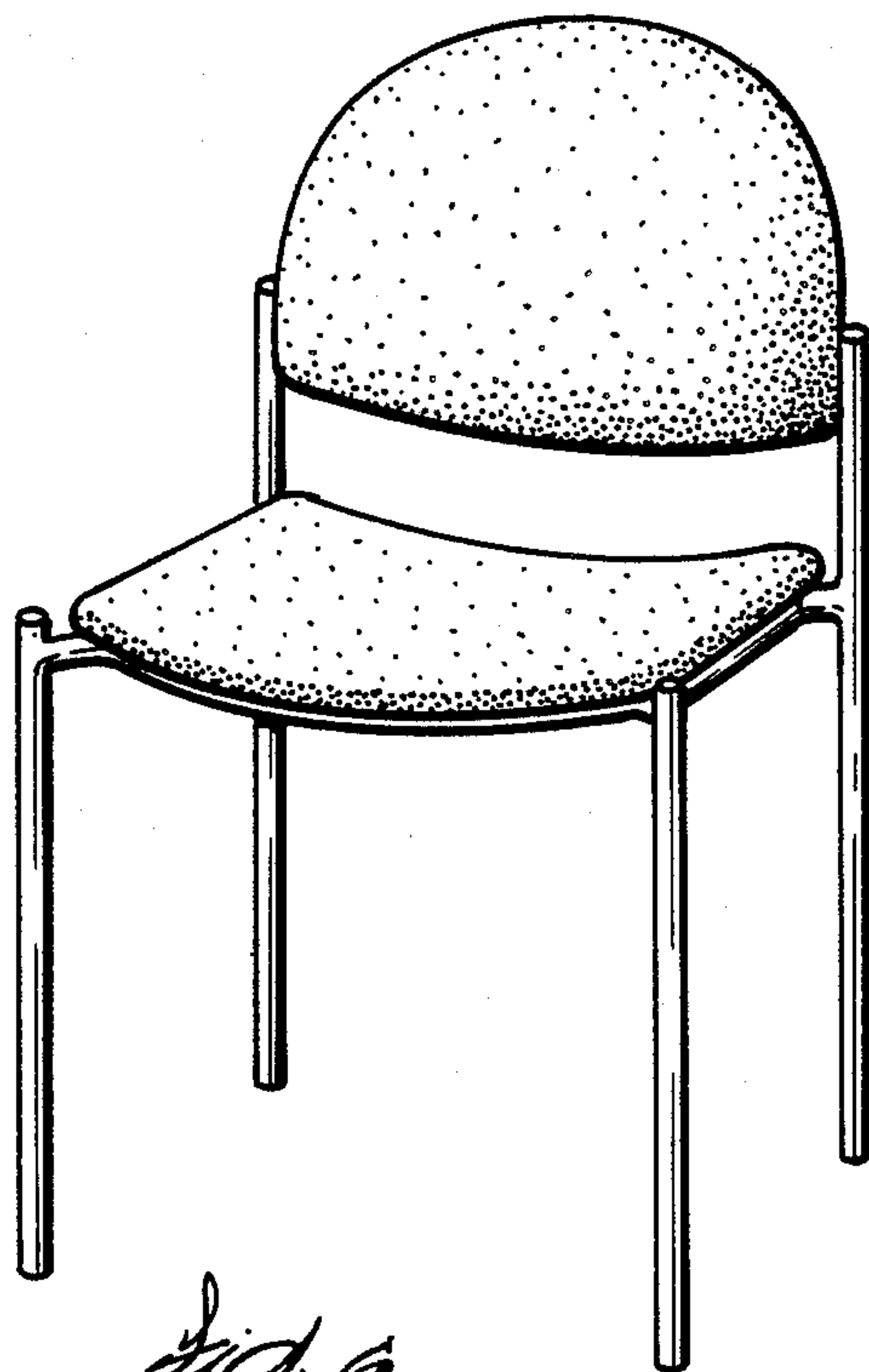

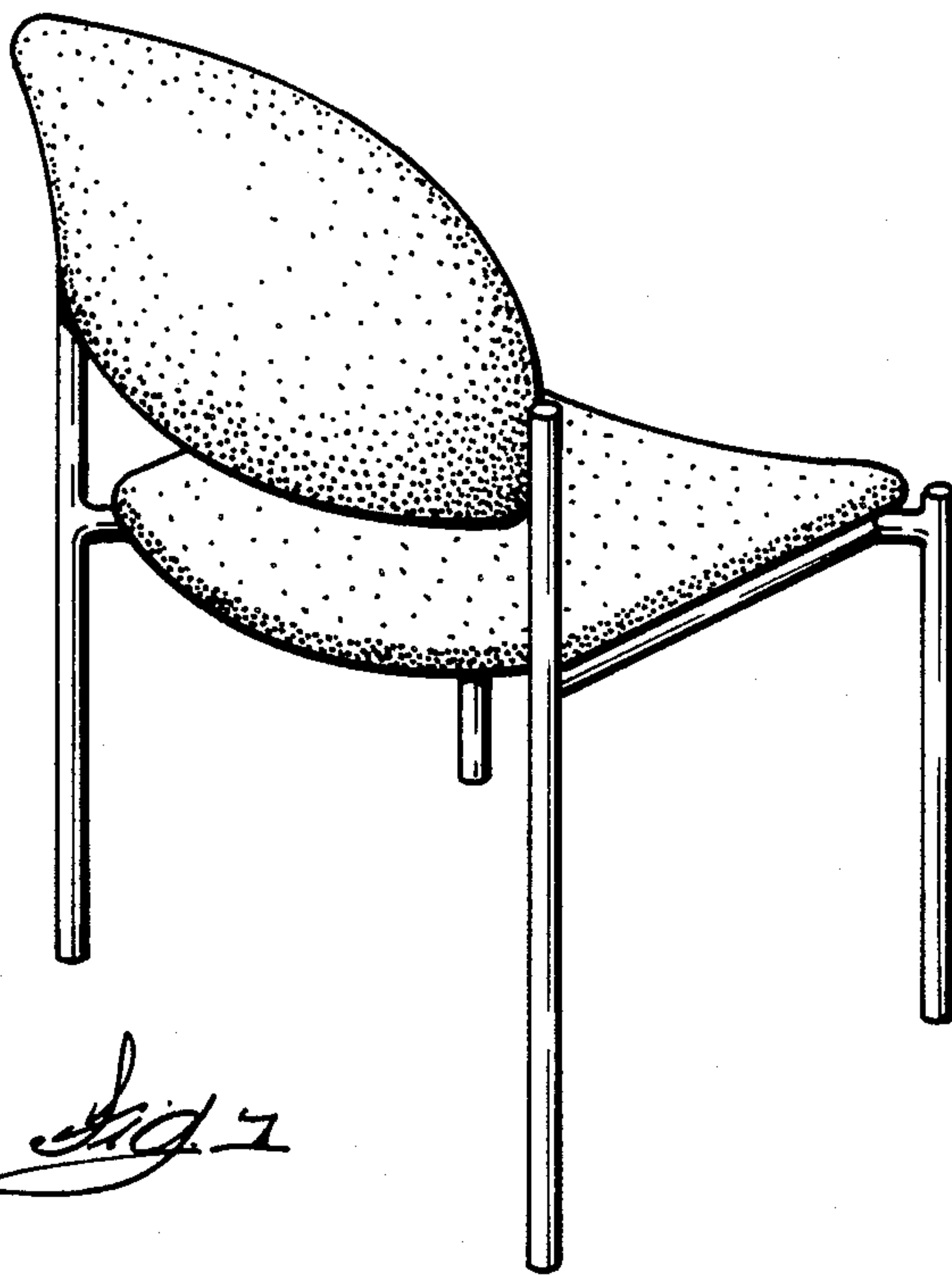

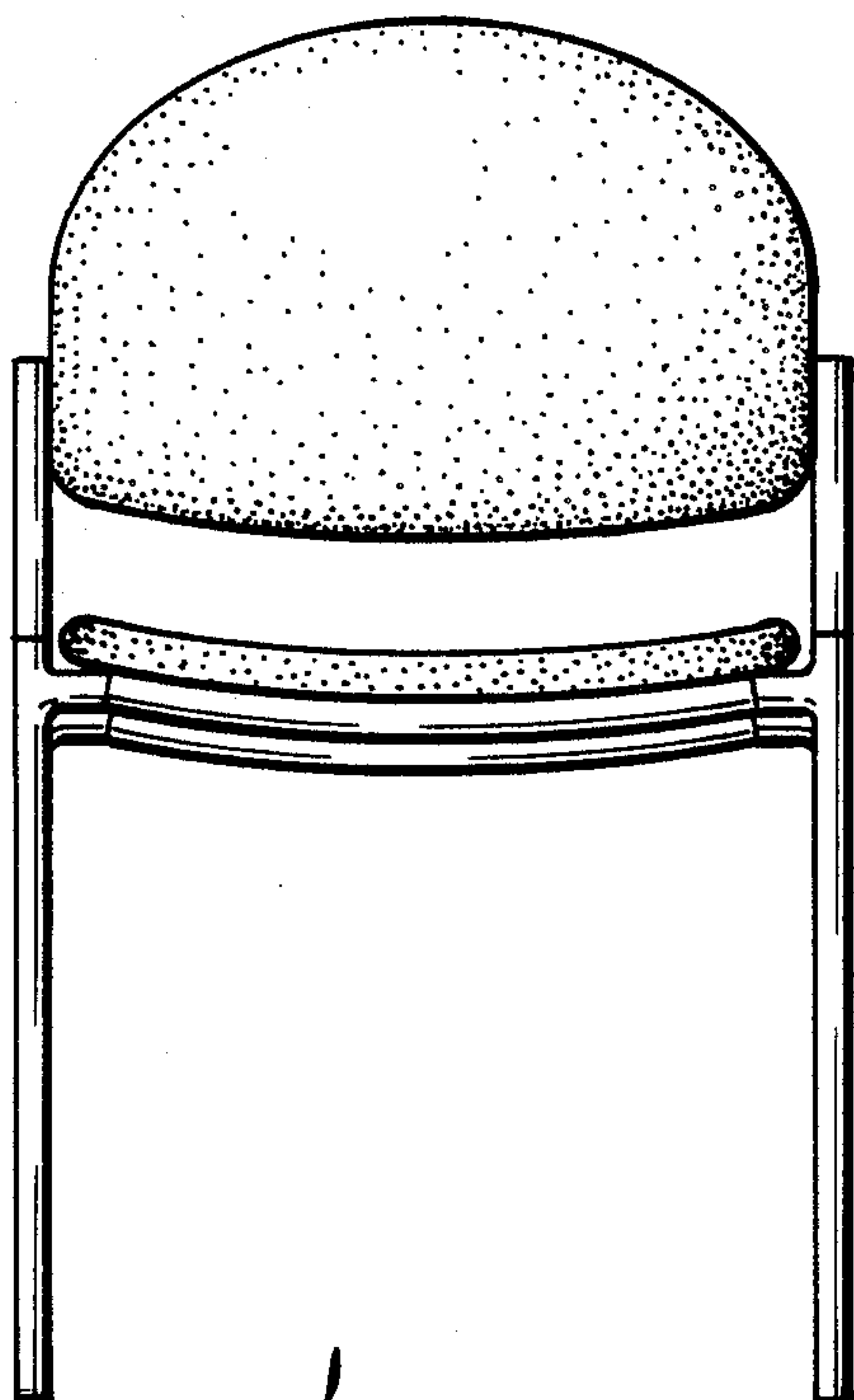

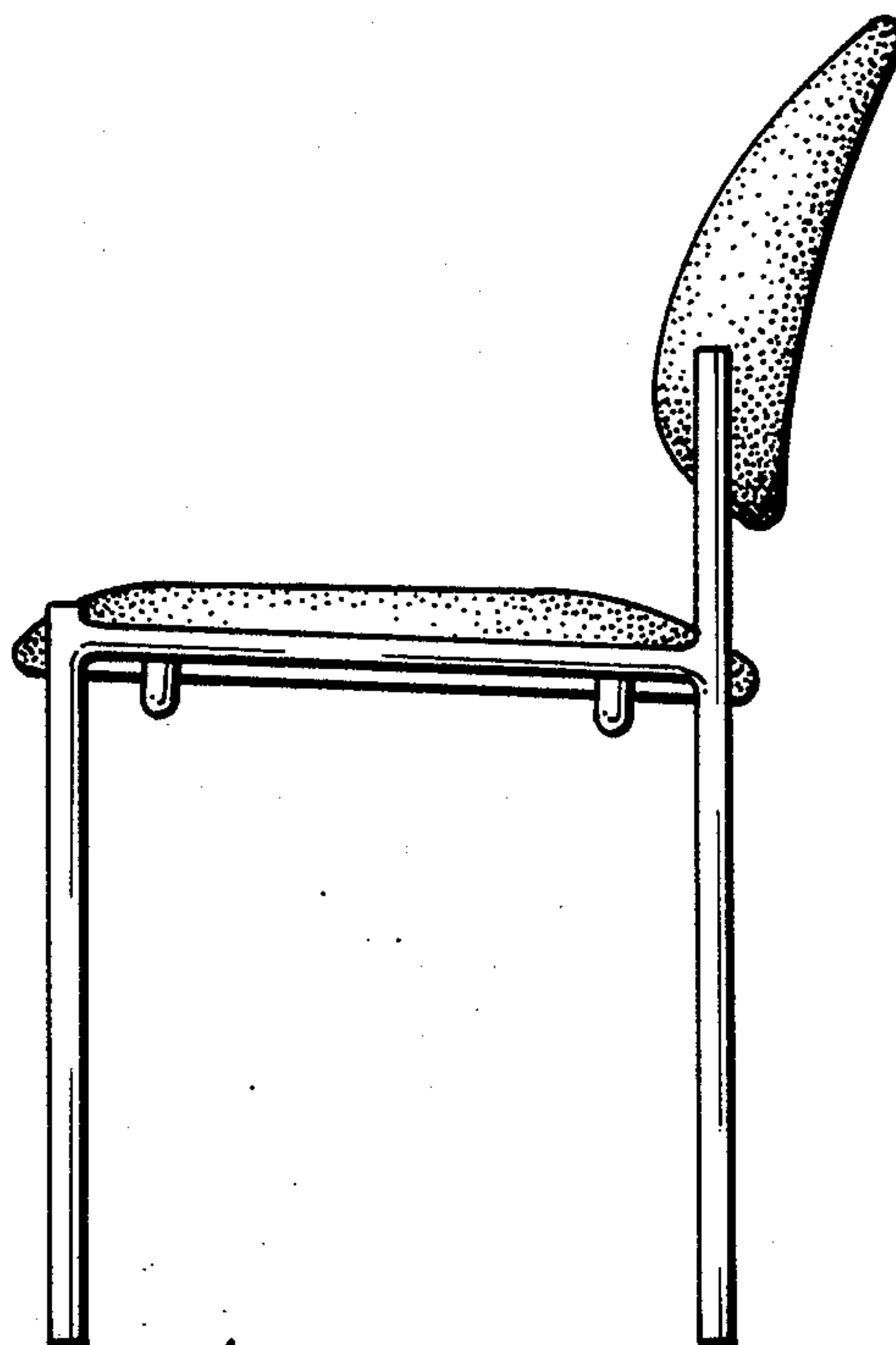

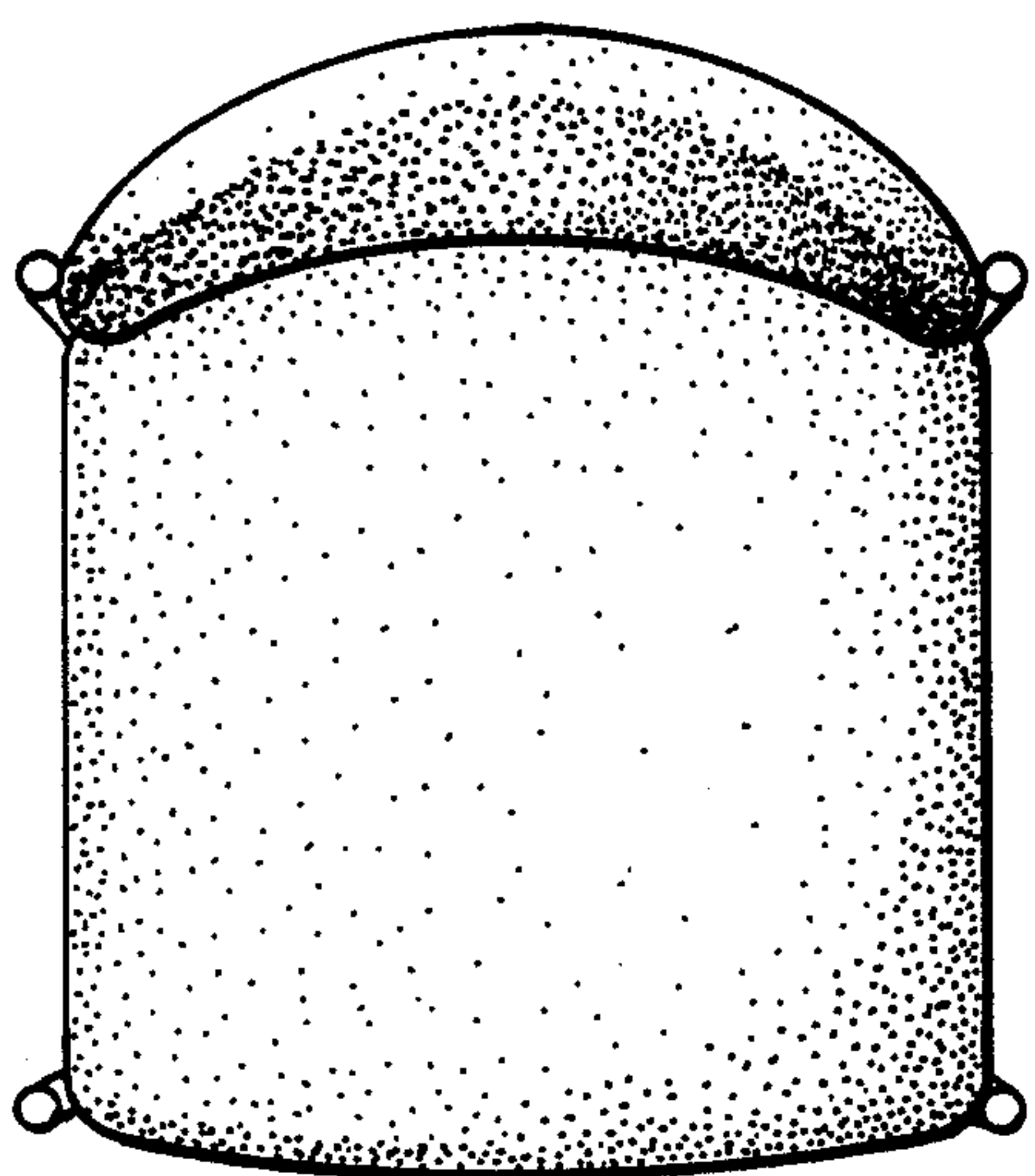
