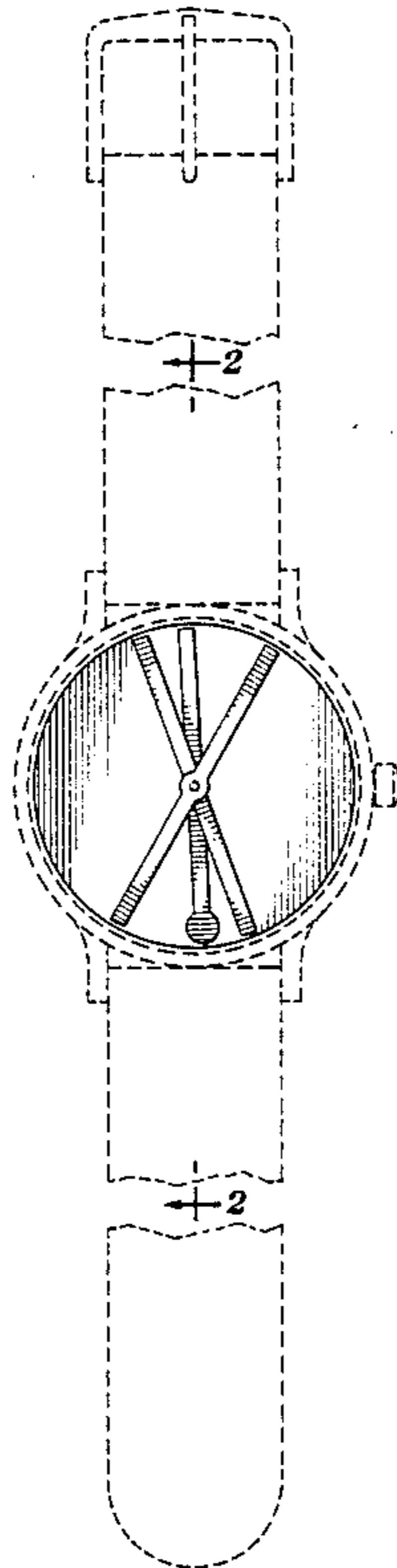

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined dial and hands for a timepiece showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof. The broken line showings of a watch in FIGS. 1 and 2 are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. The rear view, not shown, is plain and unornamented.



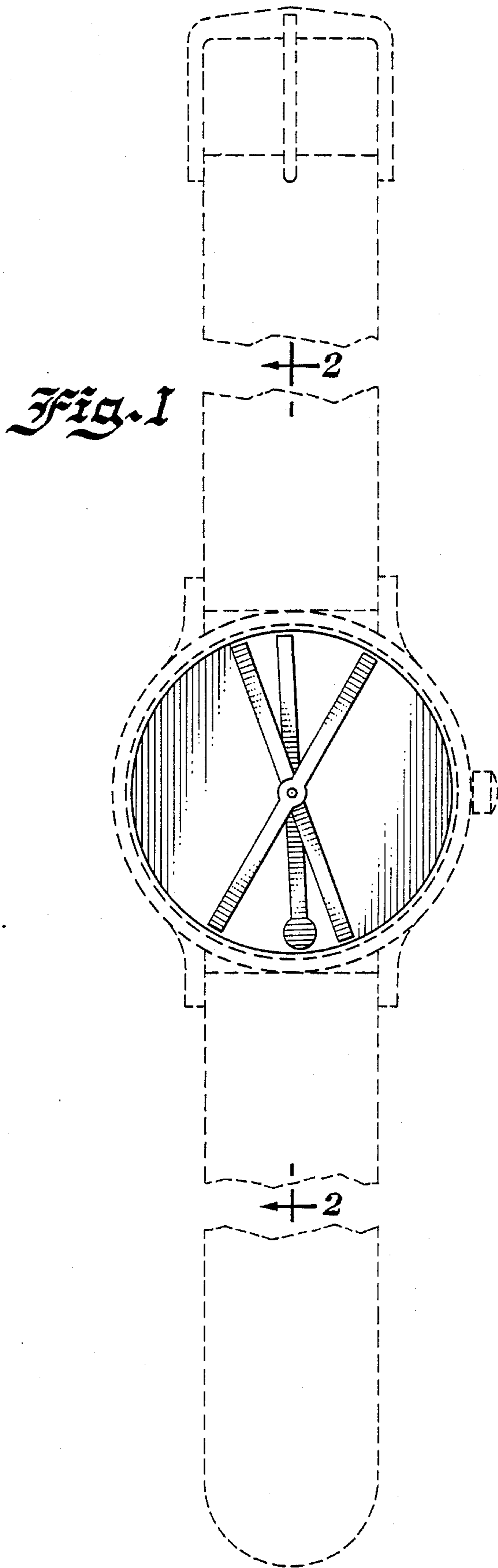
