DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electronic piano showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof with front cover in an open position; and

FIG. 8 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 7 with front cover in a closed position.

















