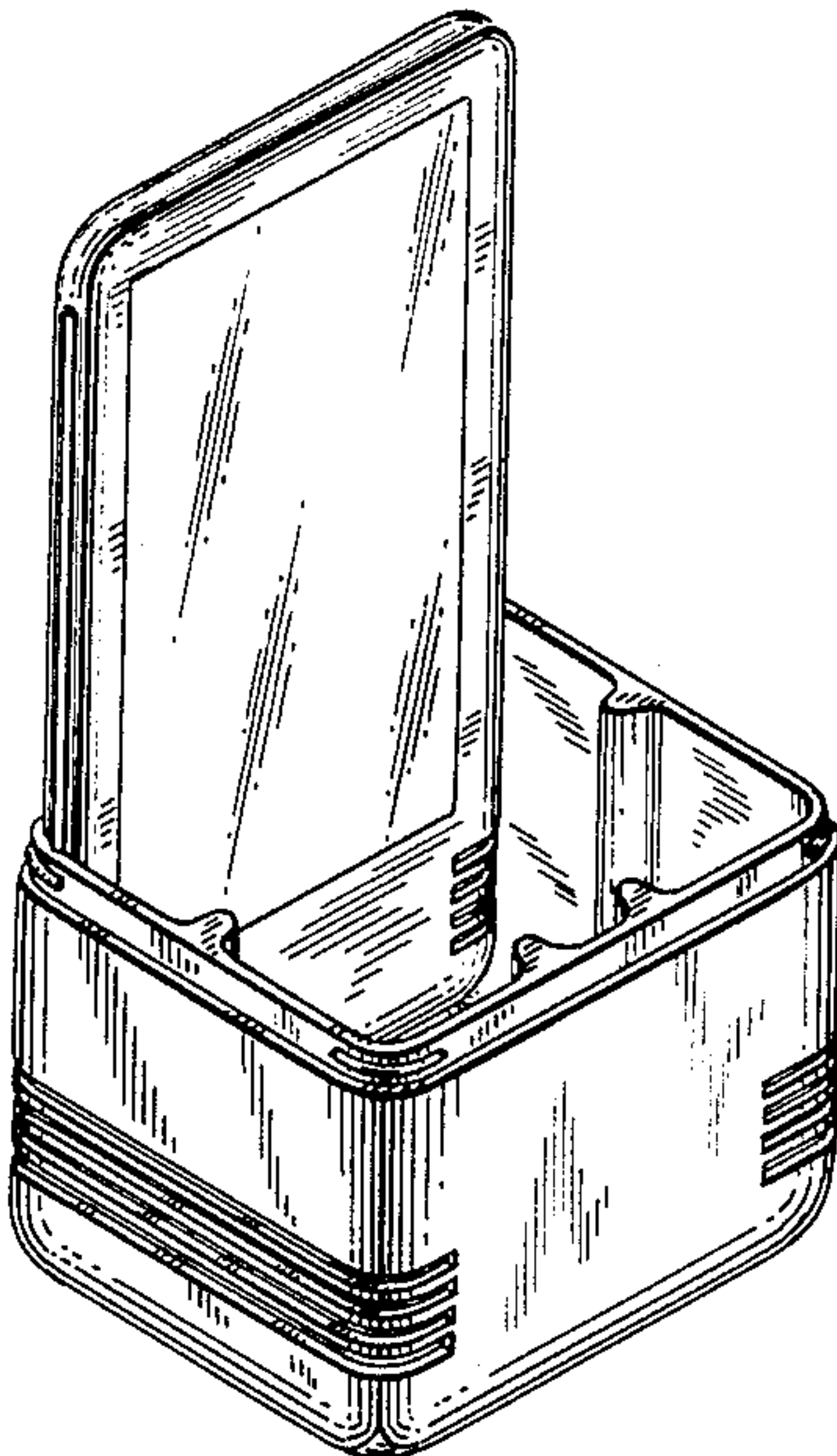
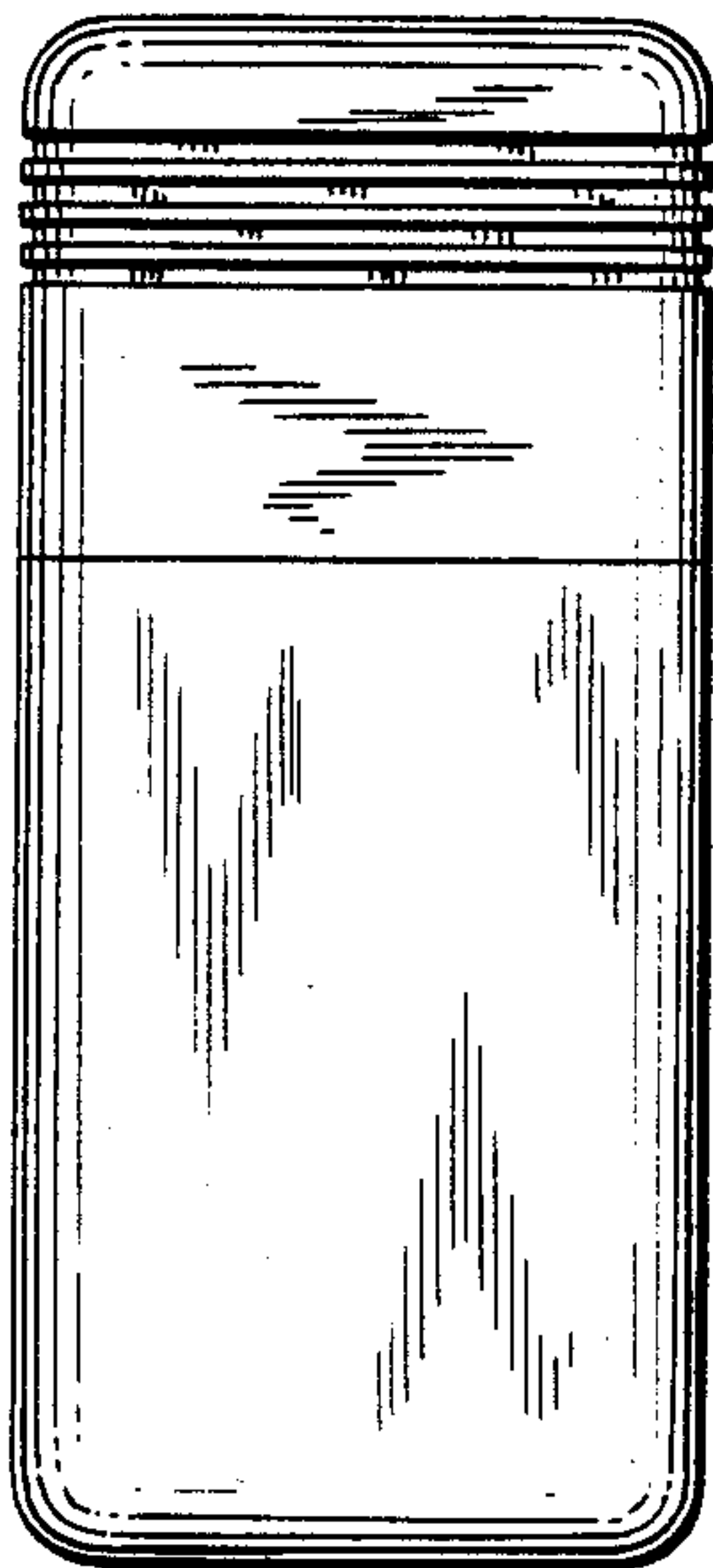

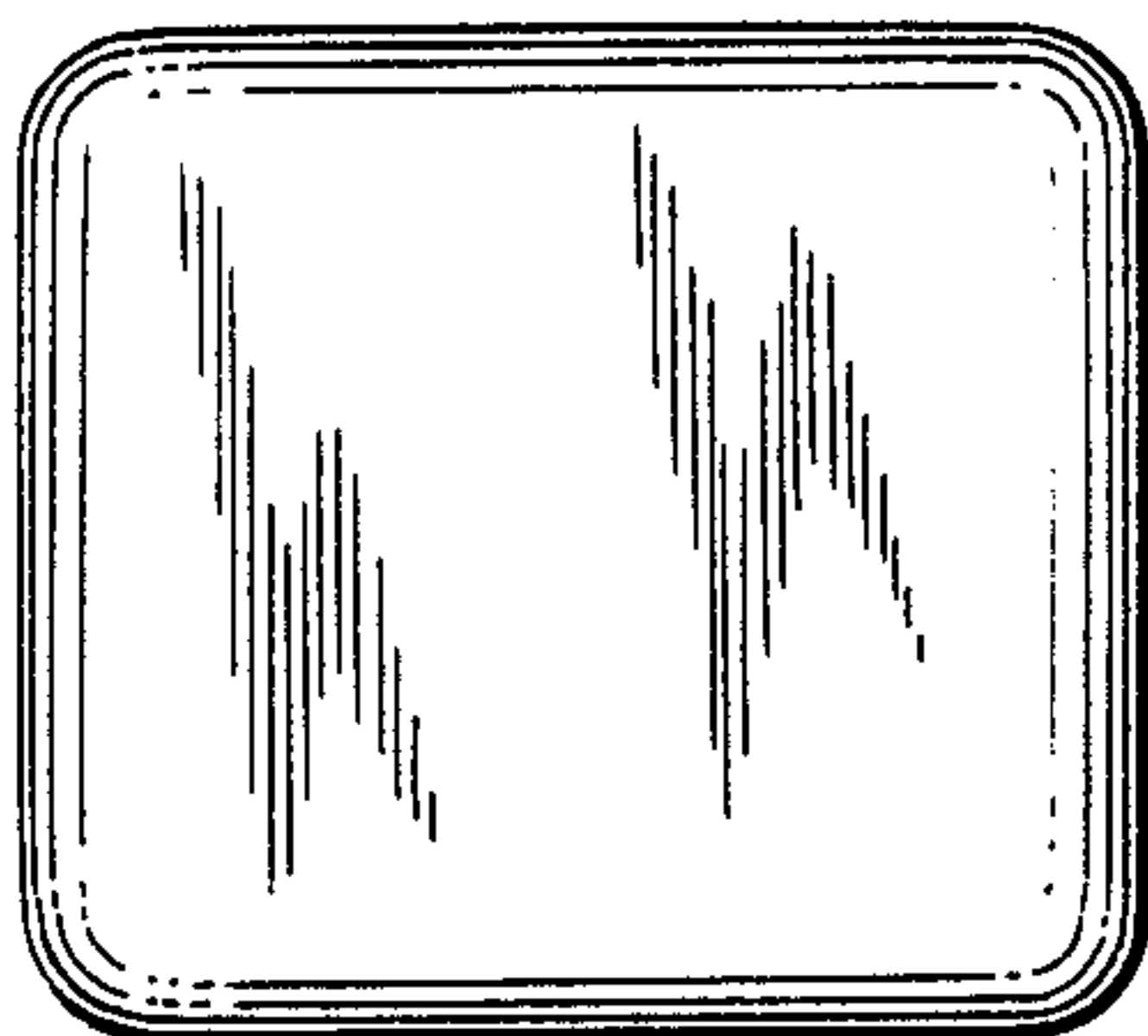

The ornamental design for a cosmetic case, as shown and described.

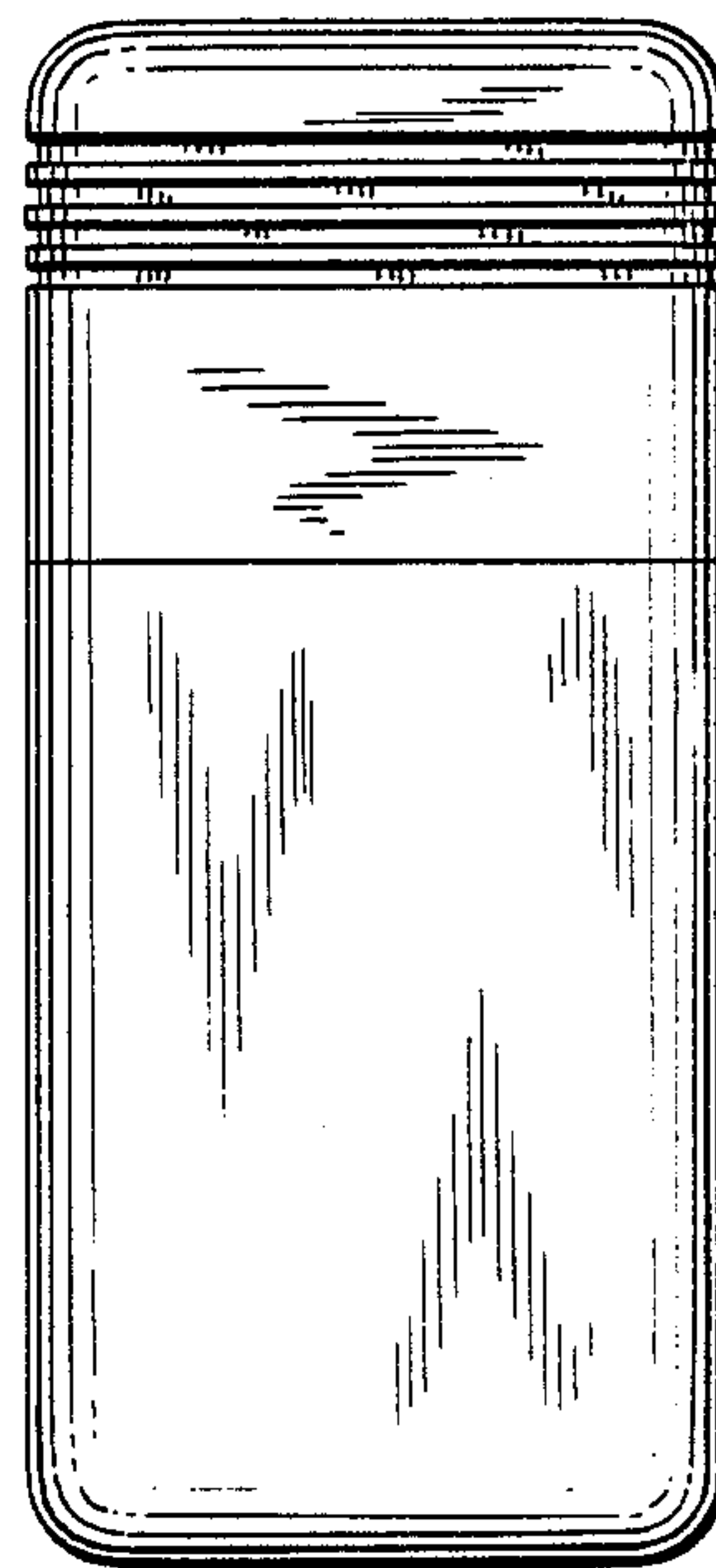
DESCRIPTION  
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a cosmetic case showing my new design, the bottom being identical;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear being identical;  
FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the case with top removed;  
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the top with mirror removed and inverted;  
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the case with the contents removed.  
The rear side of the mirror is plain and the right edge is identical to the left edge.  
The broken line showing of contents in FIG. 4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



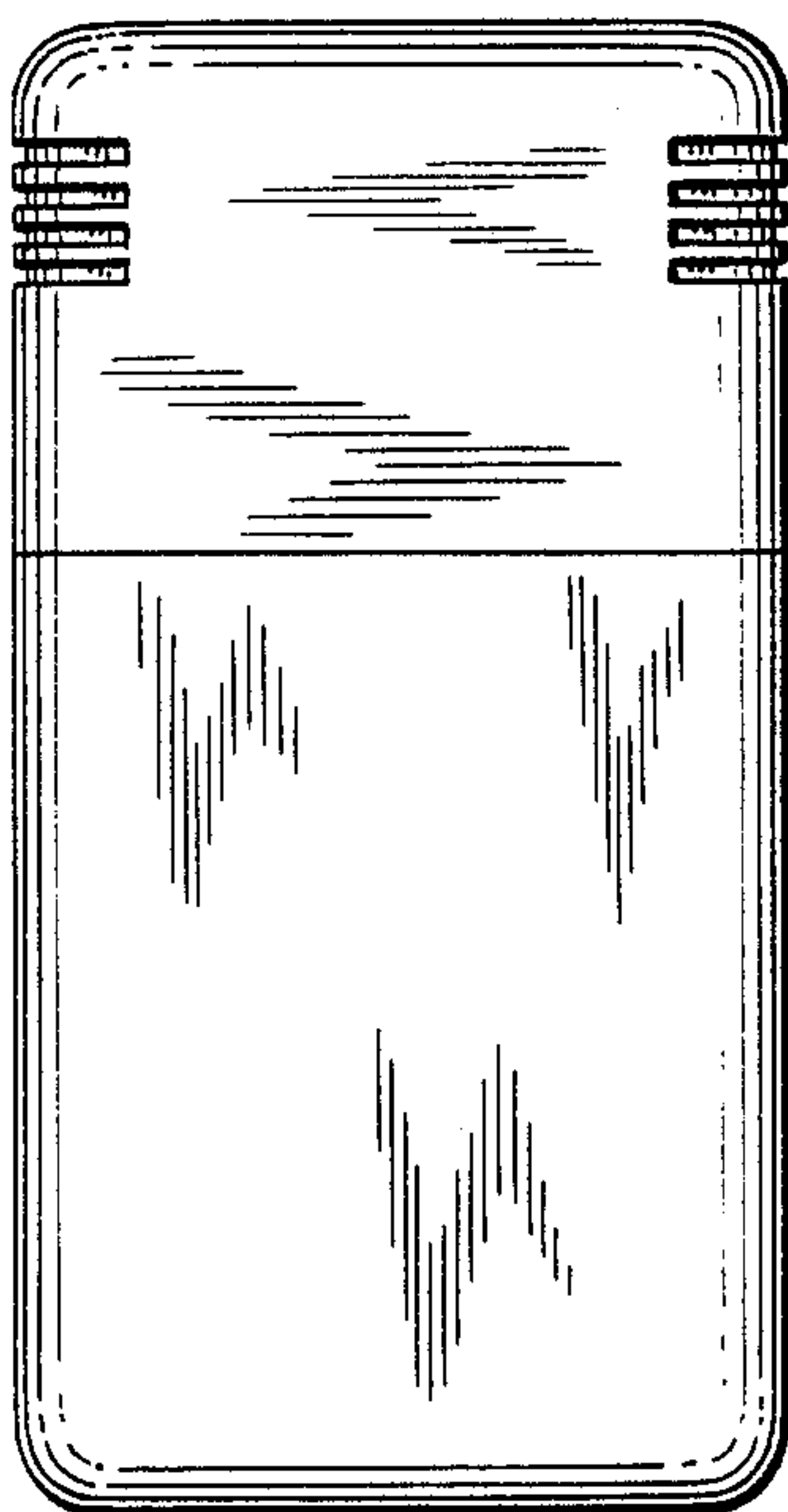

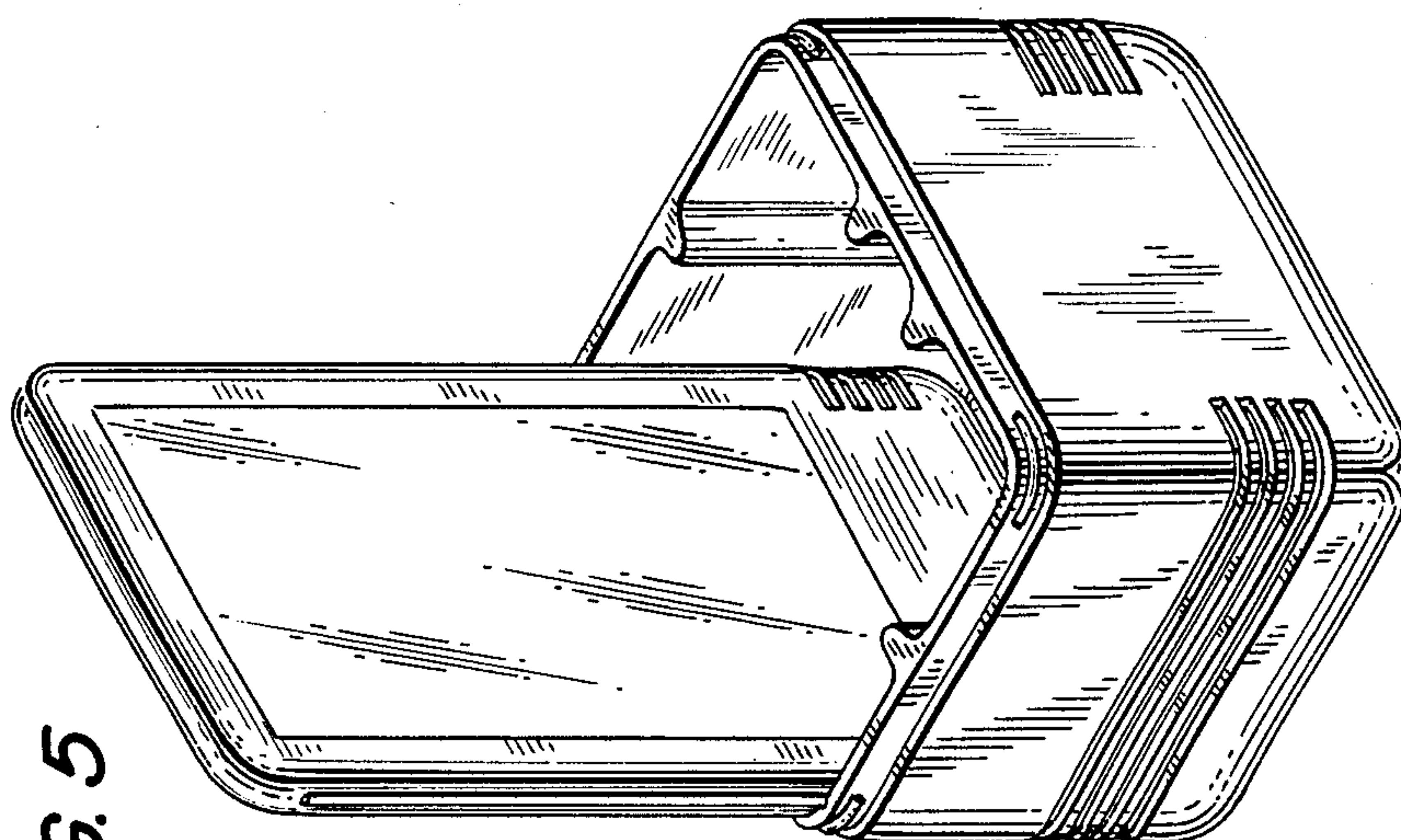

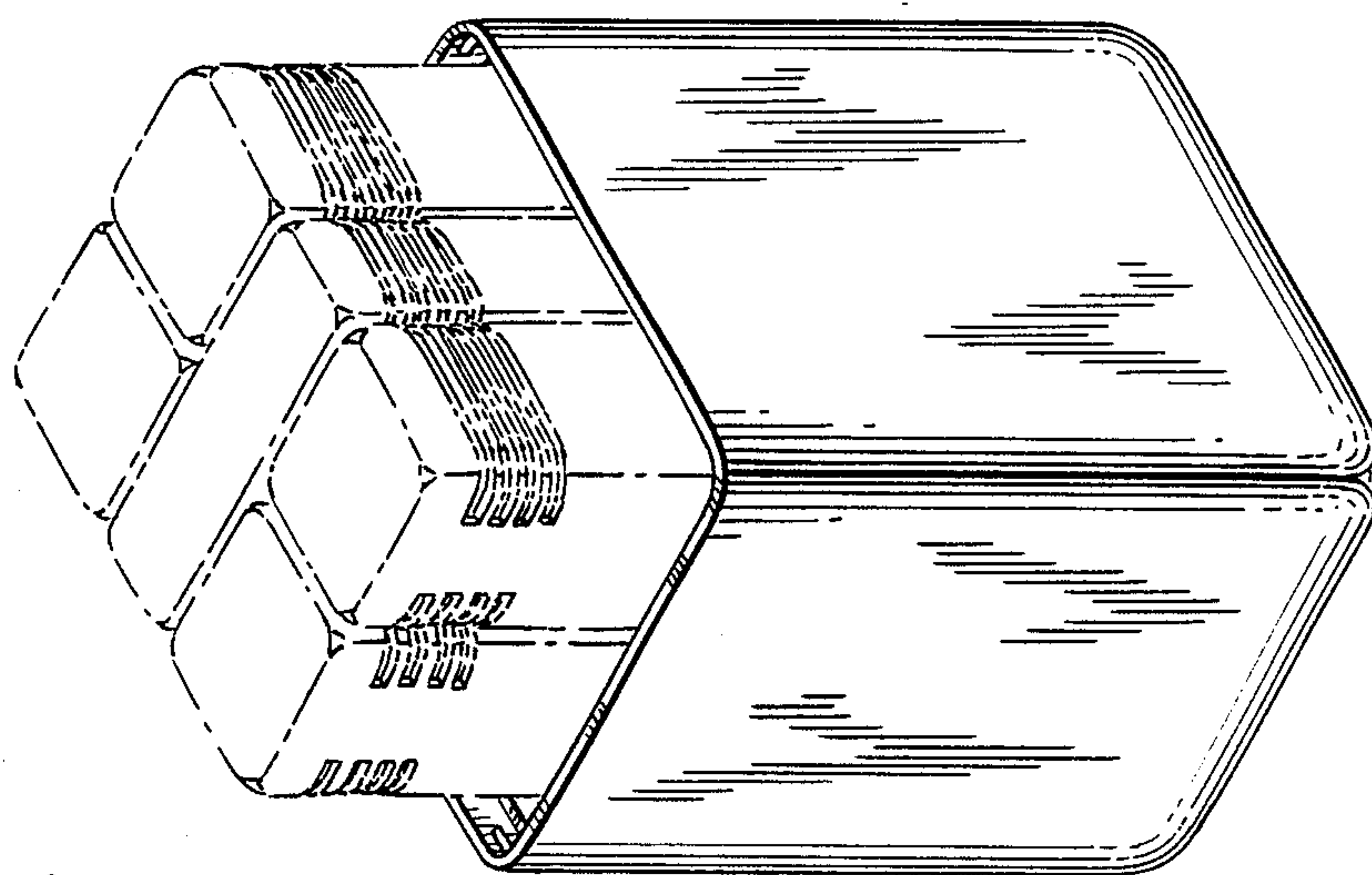
