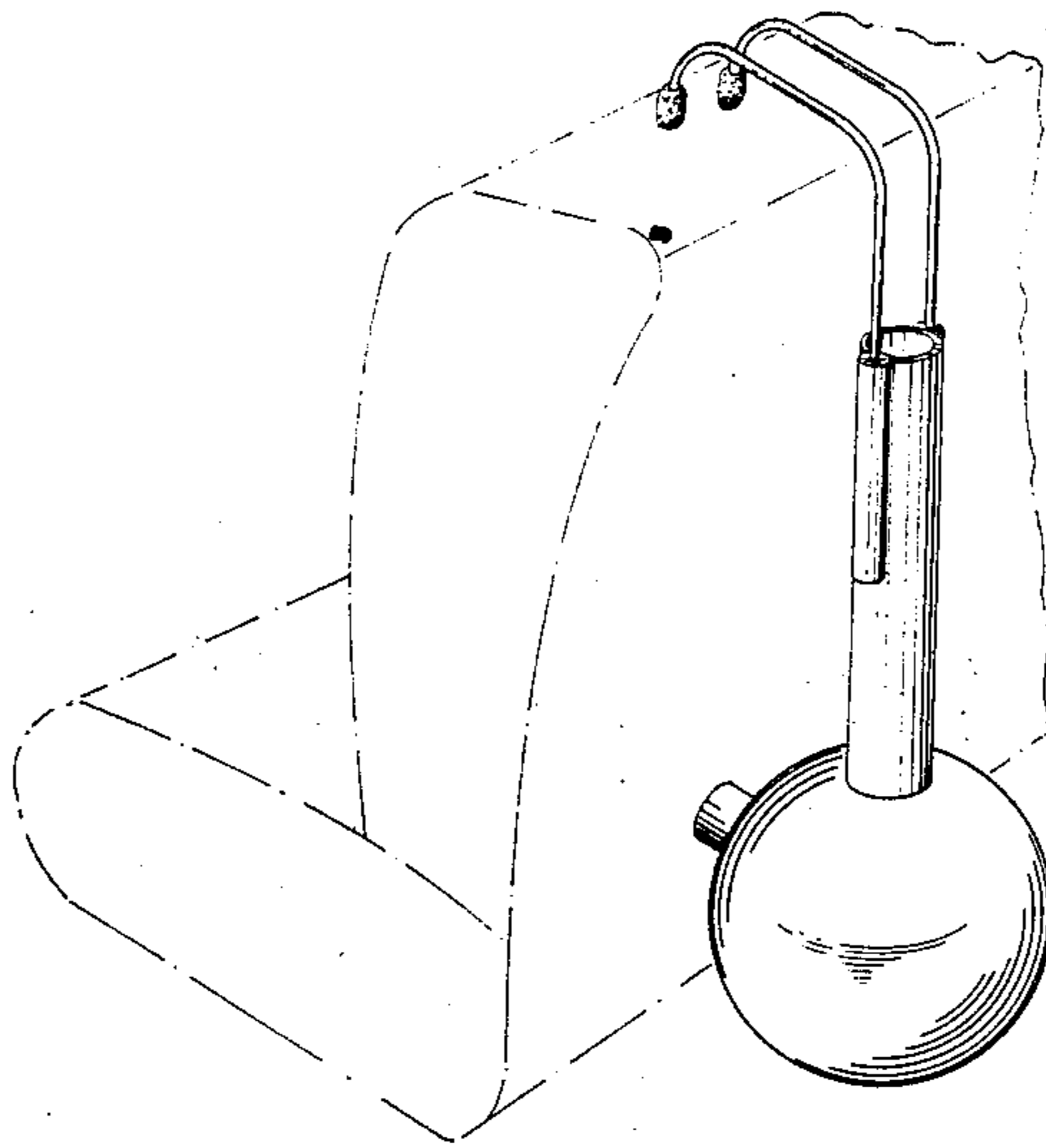
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an umbrella holder for a motor vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an umbrella holder for a motor vehicle showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 3 is a top plan view; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image.

The broken line showing of a motor vehicle seat in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



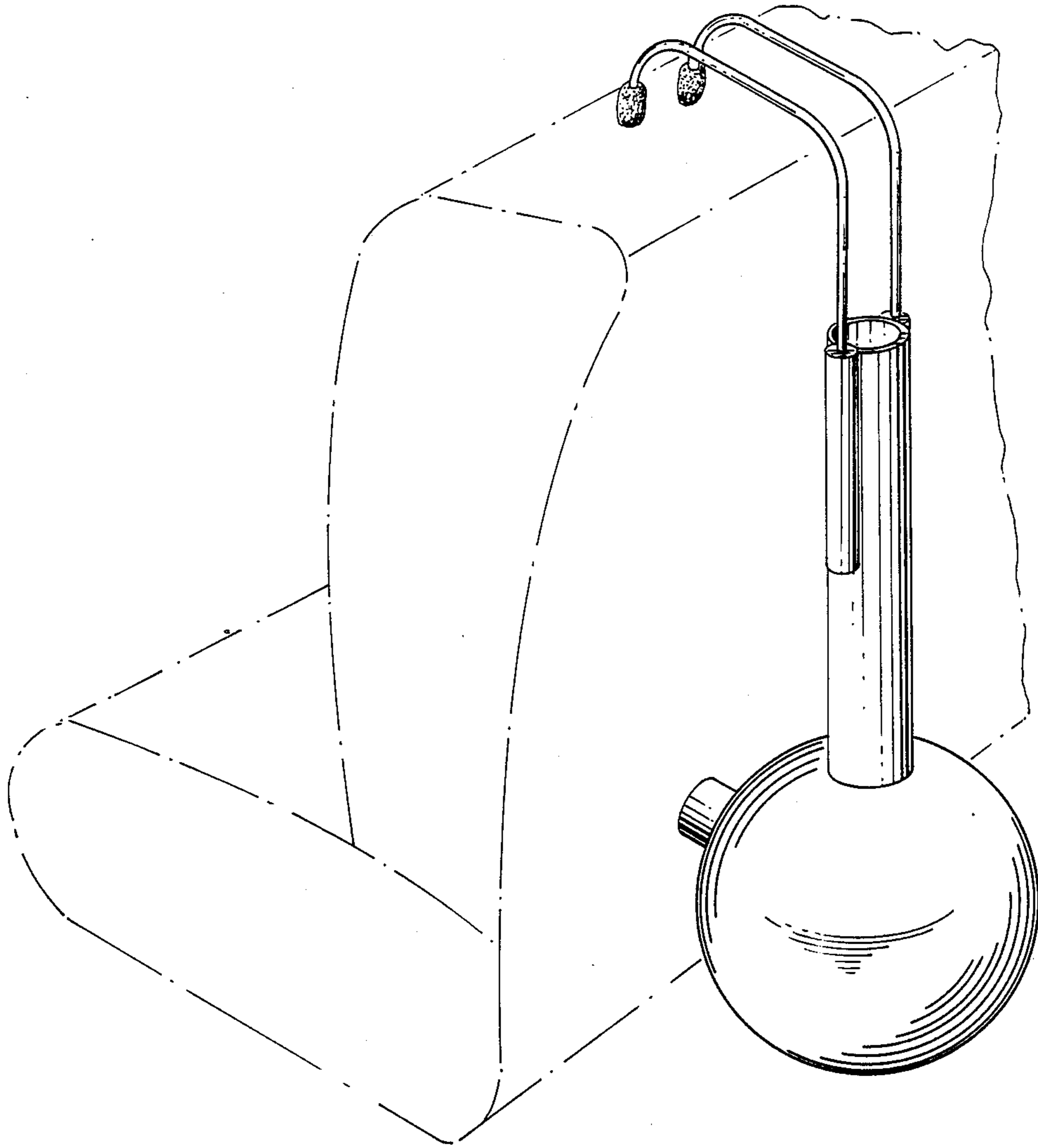

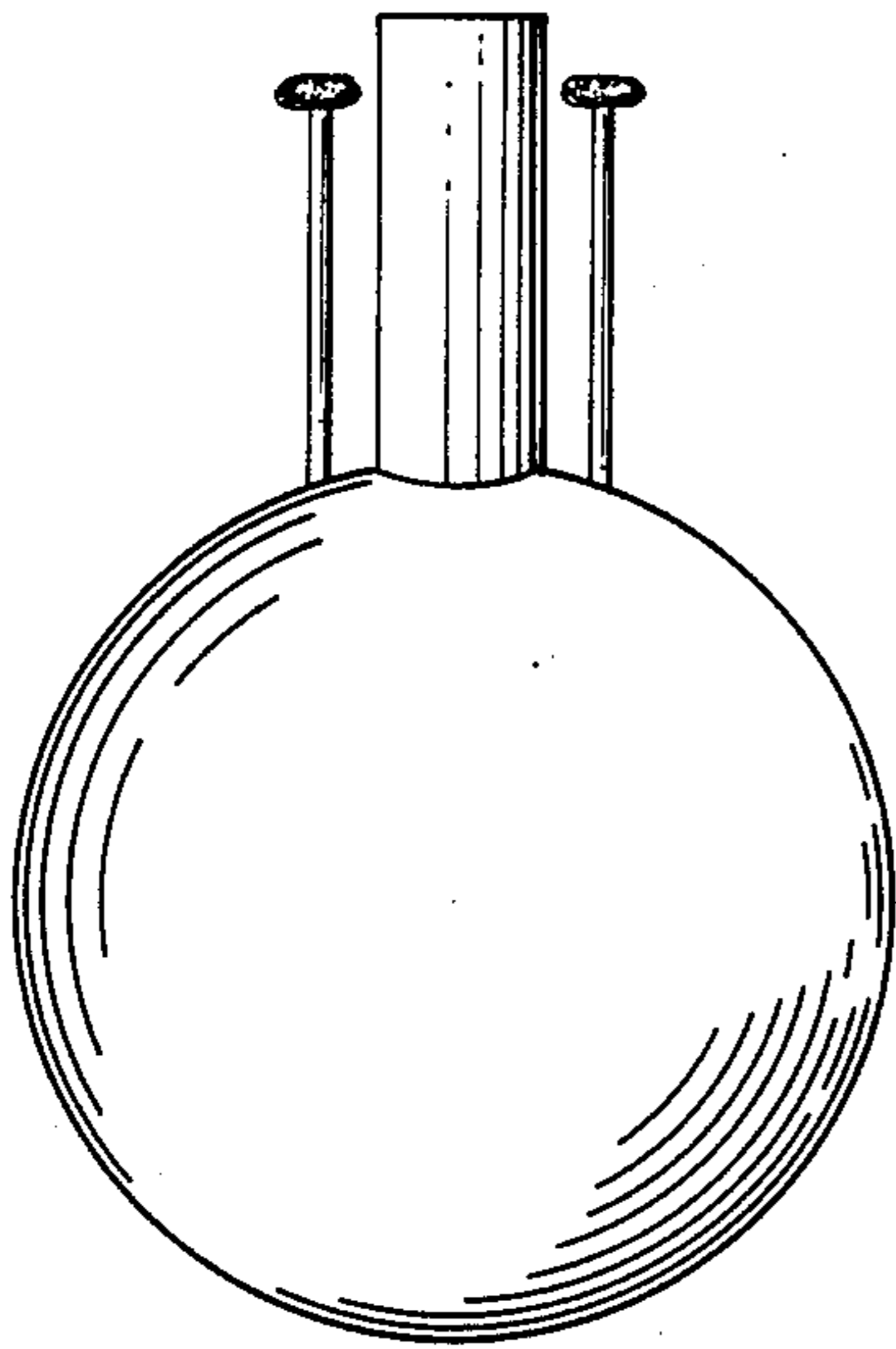

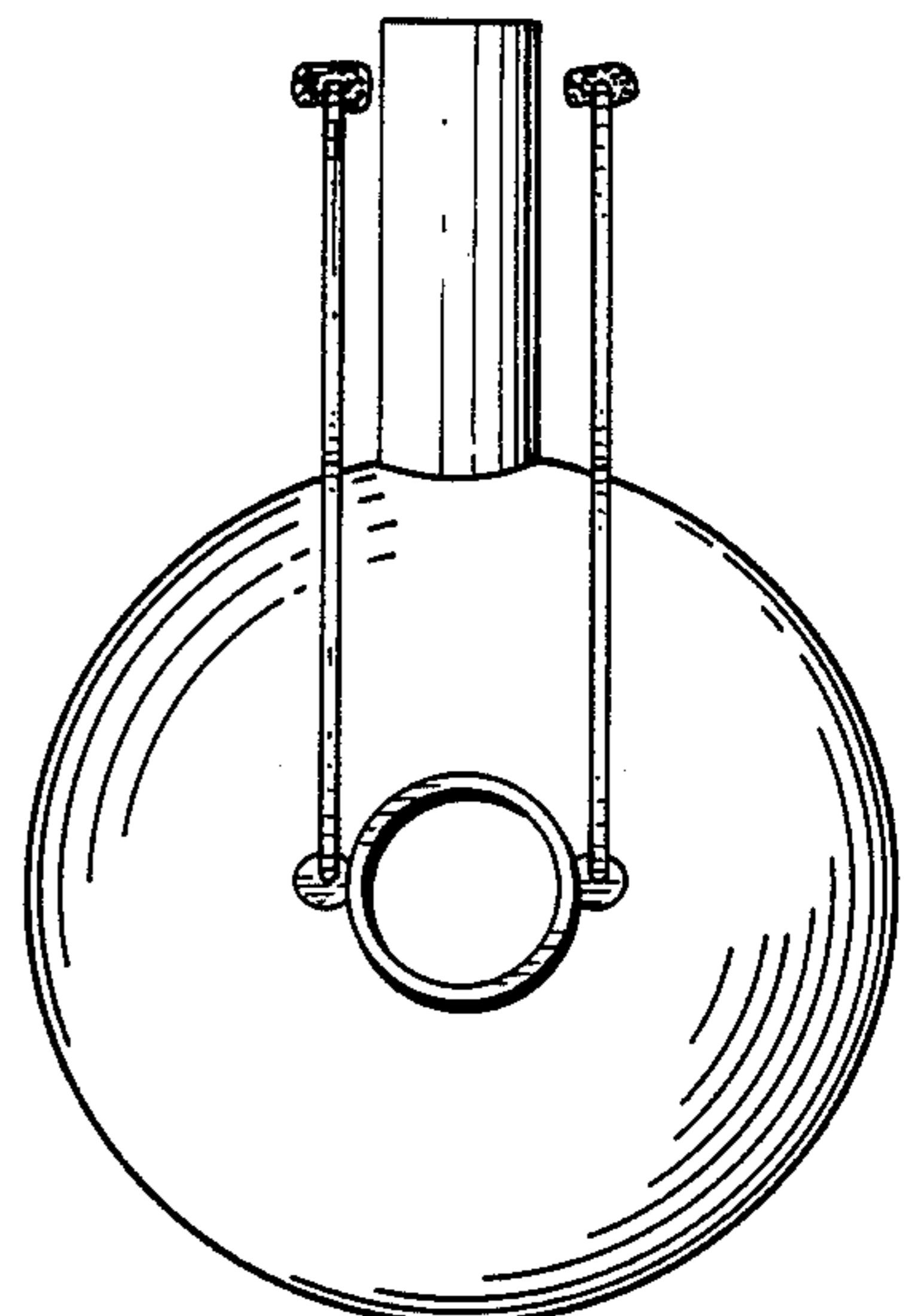

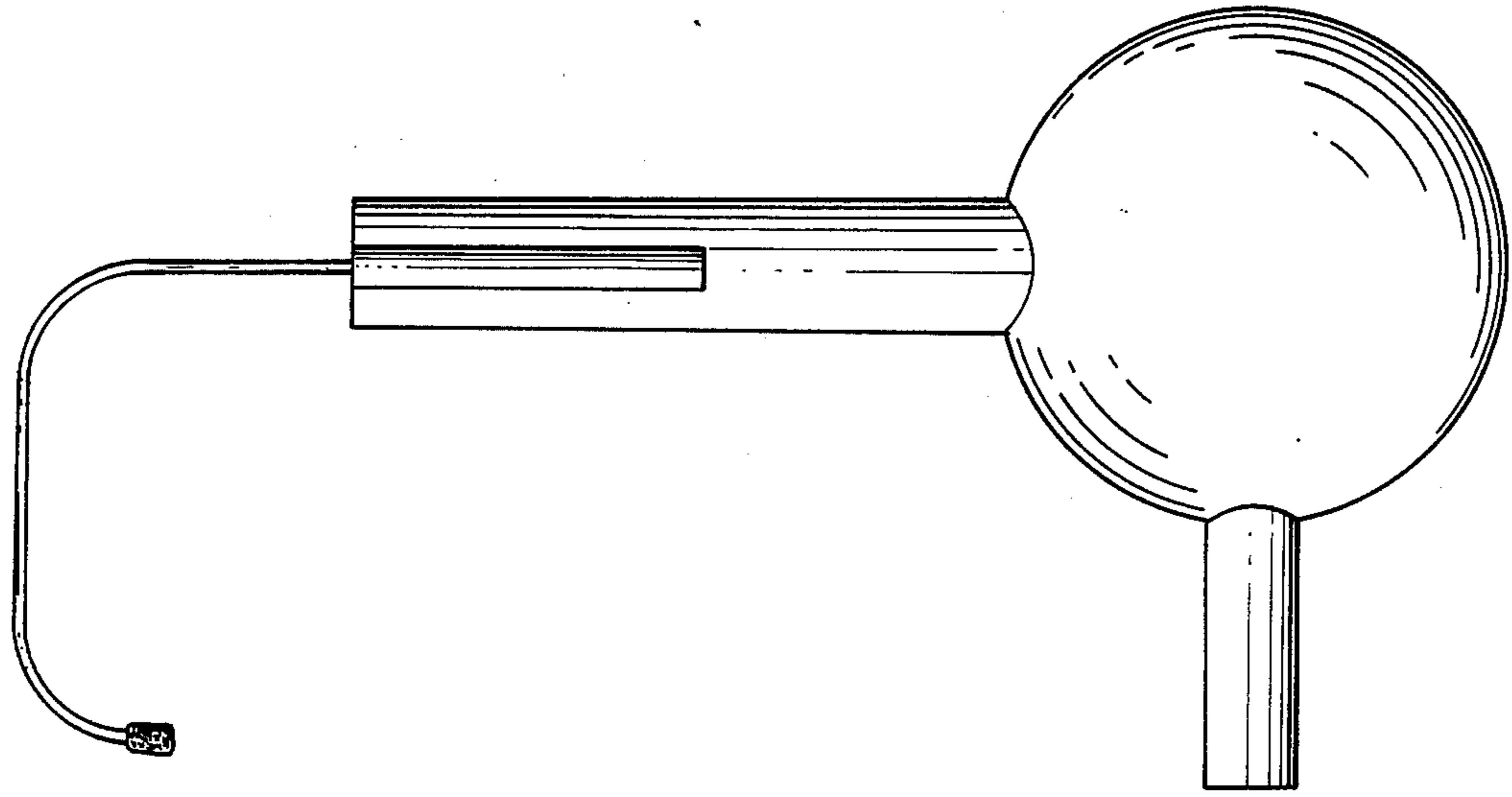

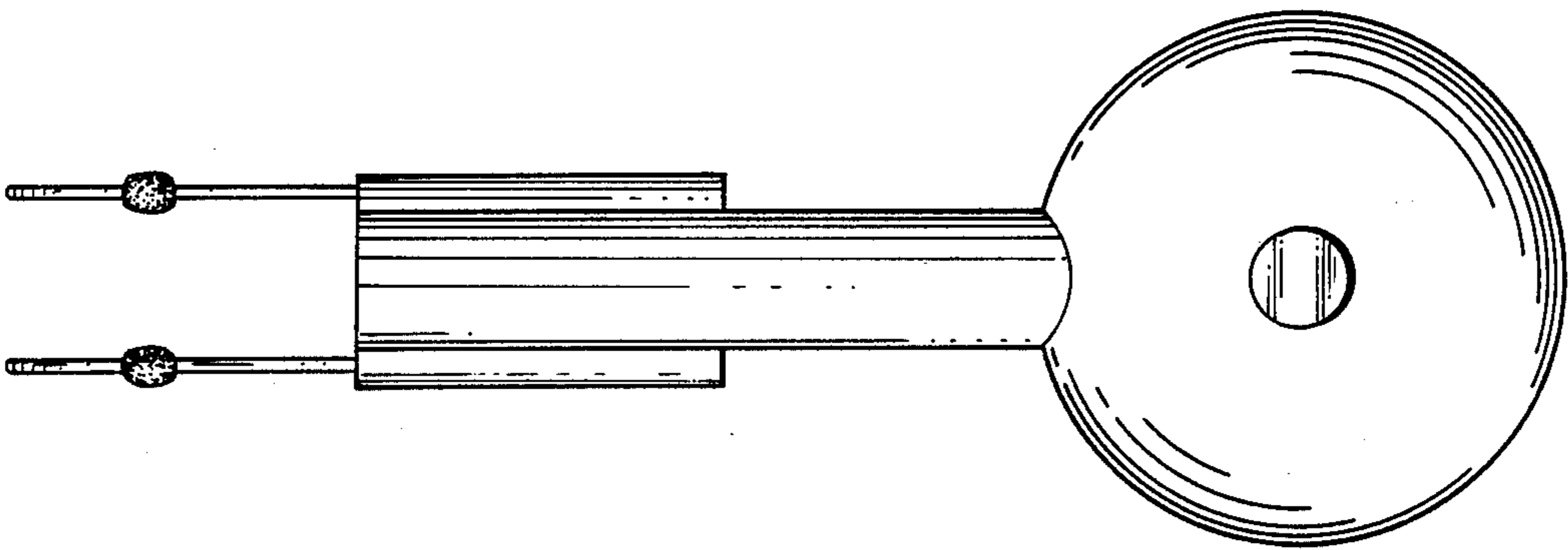

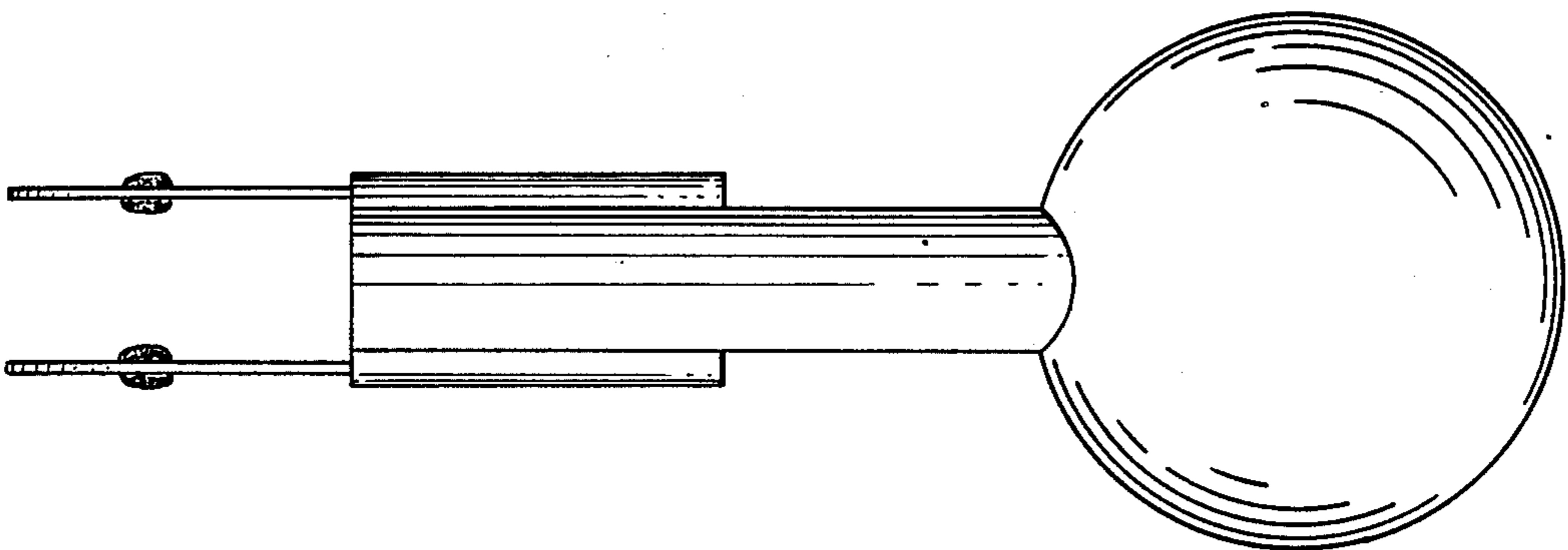
