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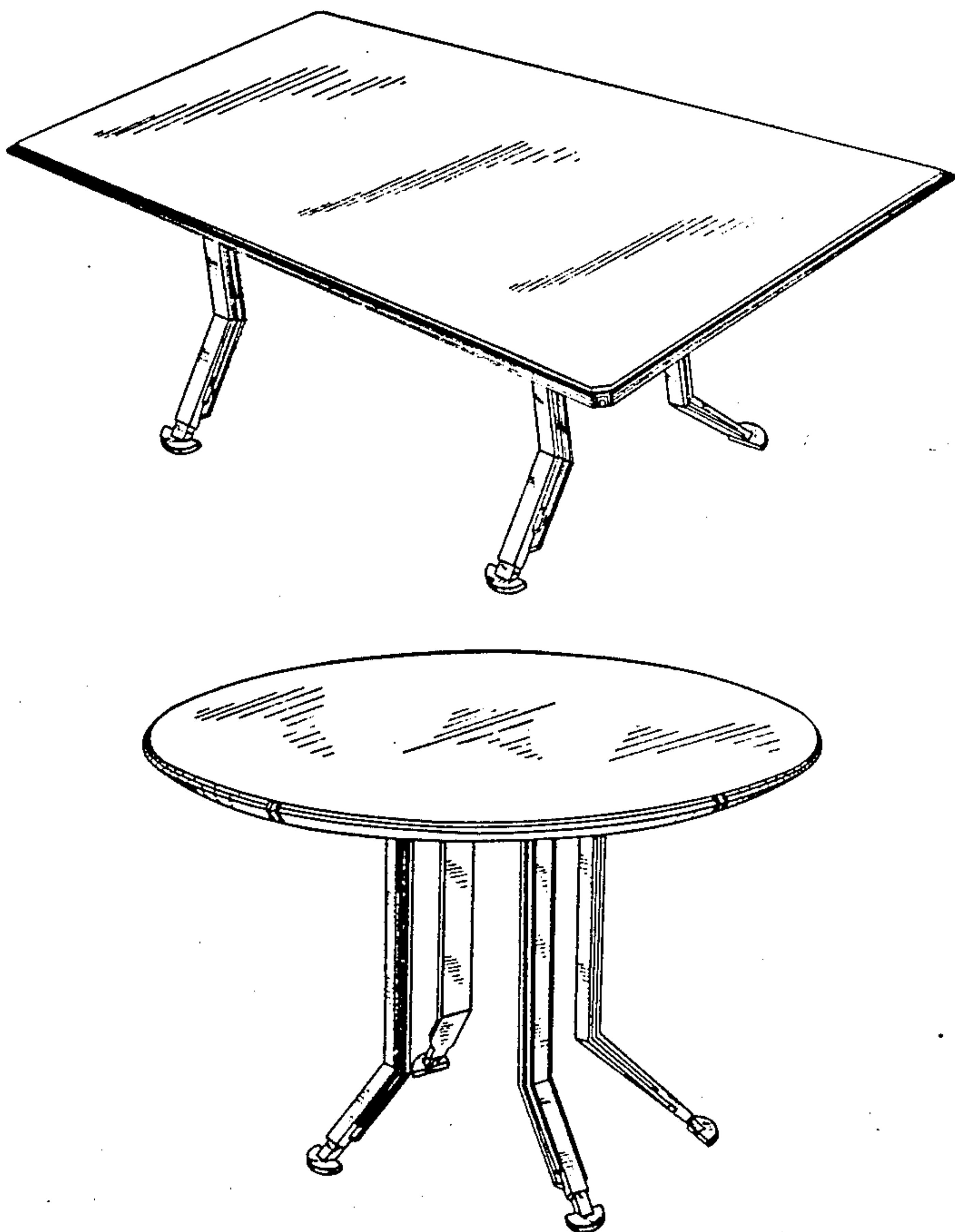

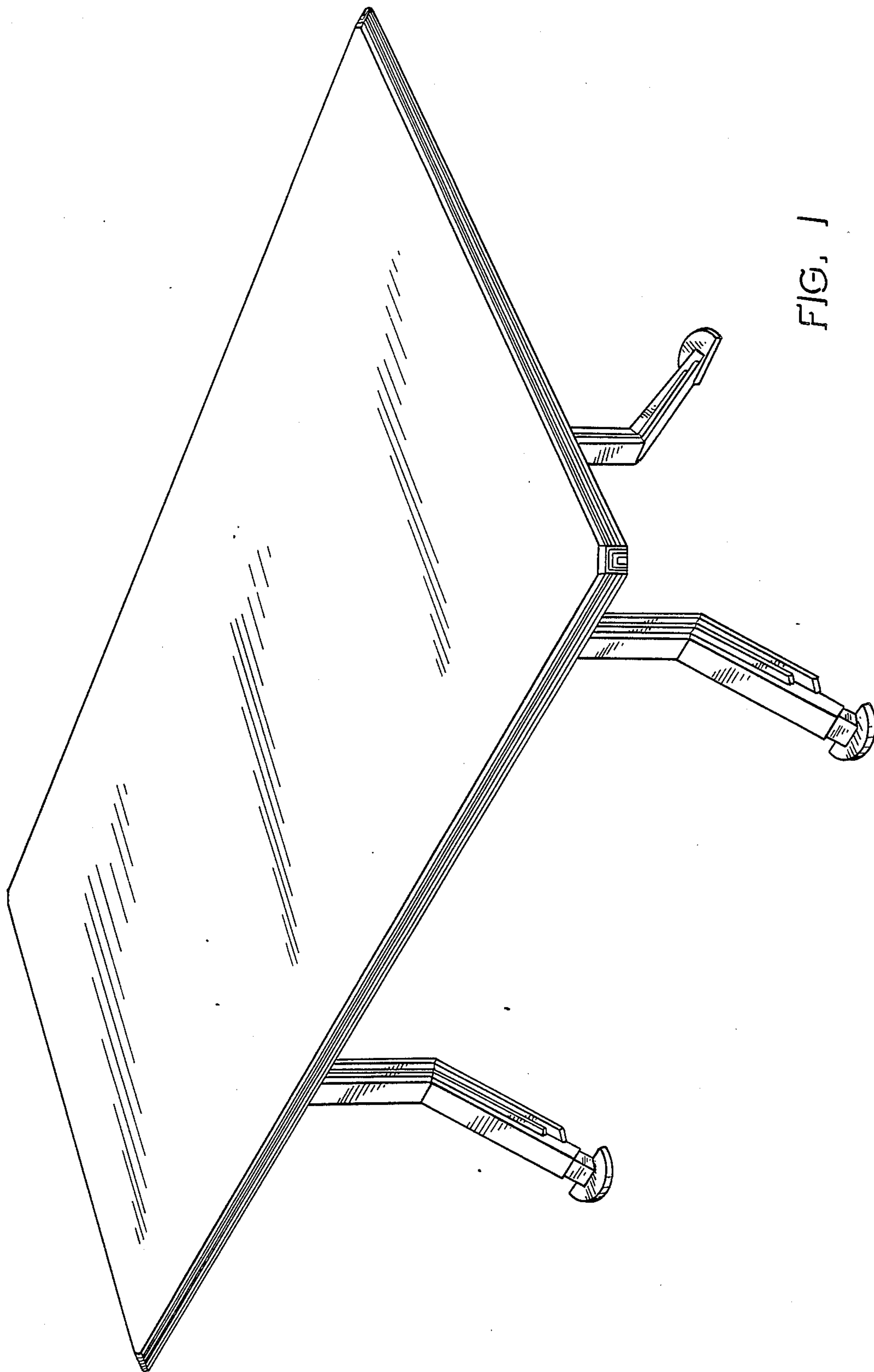
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a table, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a table, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical thereto;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear view being identical thereto;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged detail view of a corner of my table shown in FIGS. 1-4;
FIG. 6 is an enlarged detail view of the lower portion of the table leg;
FIG. 7 is a top perspective view of an alternative embodiment of my table;
FIG. 8 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical thereto; and
FIG. 9 is an enlarged detail view of a portion of the edge of my table shown in FIGS. 7 and 8.





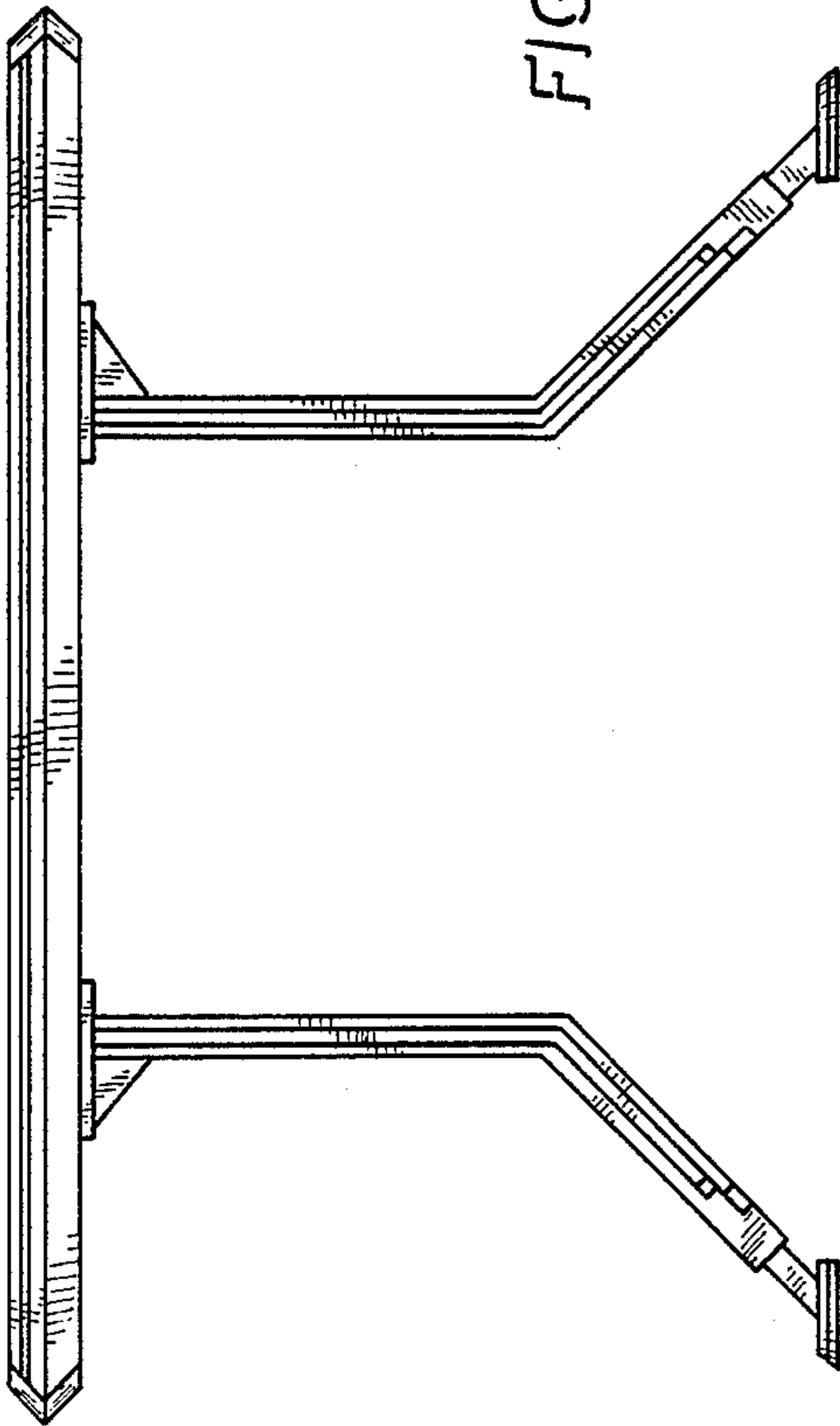

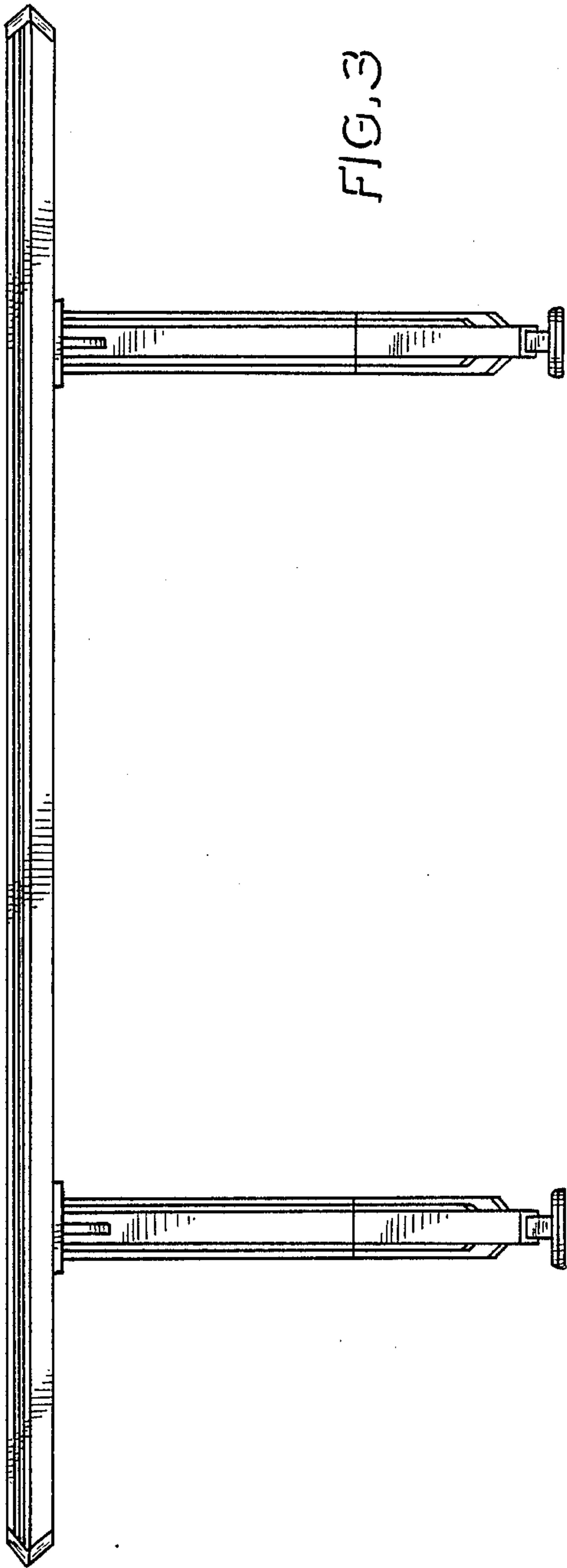

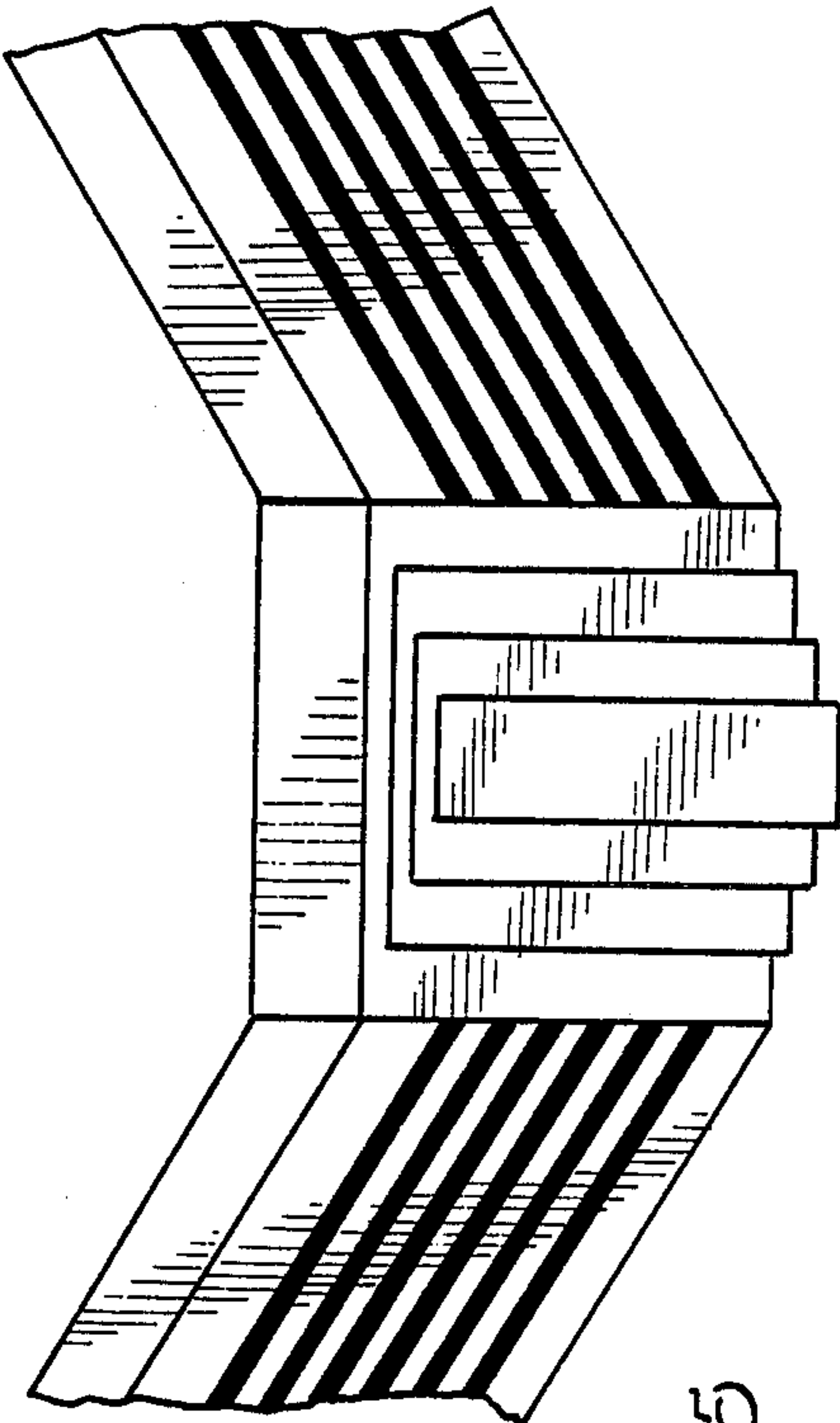
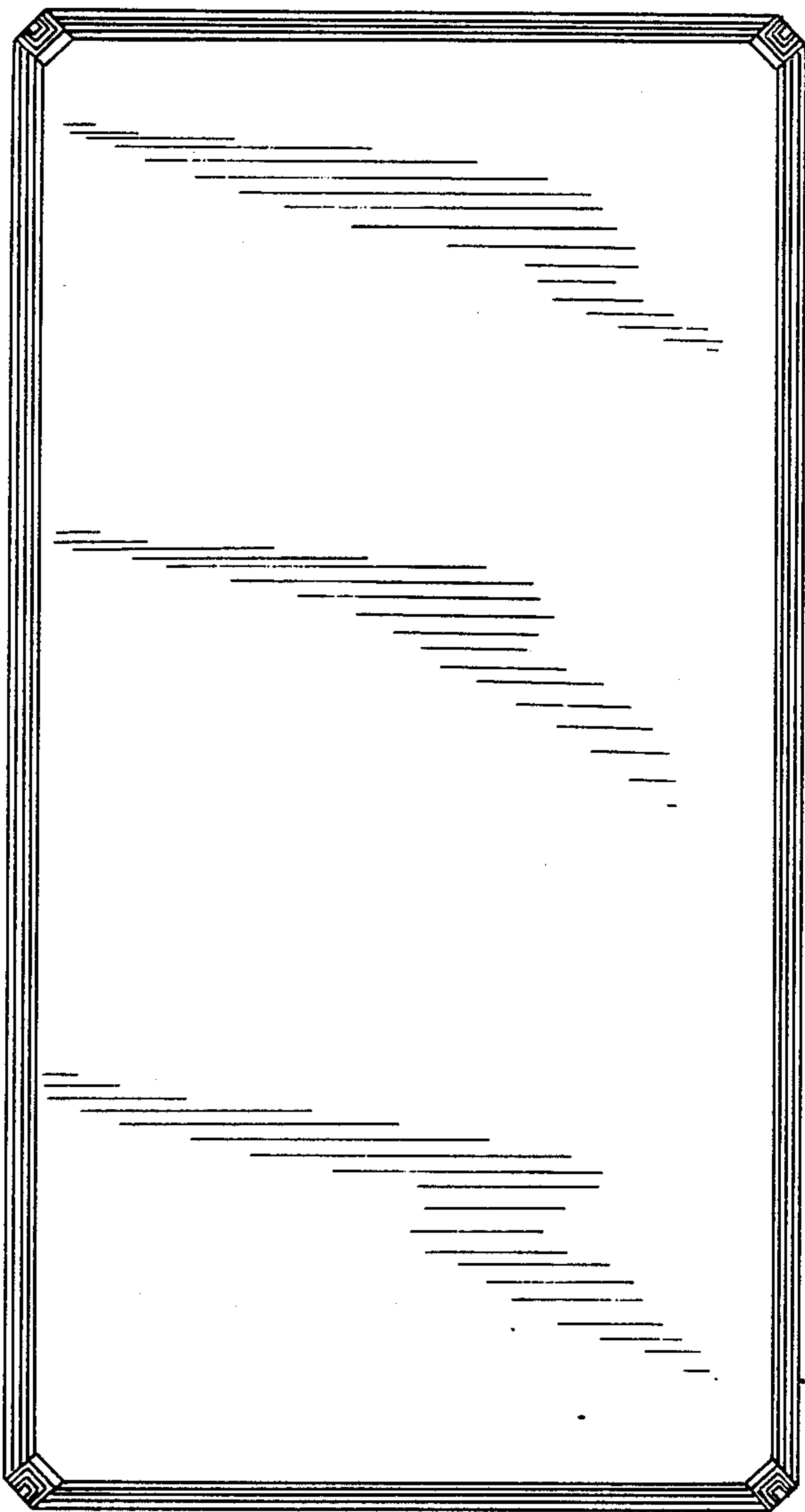
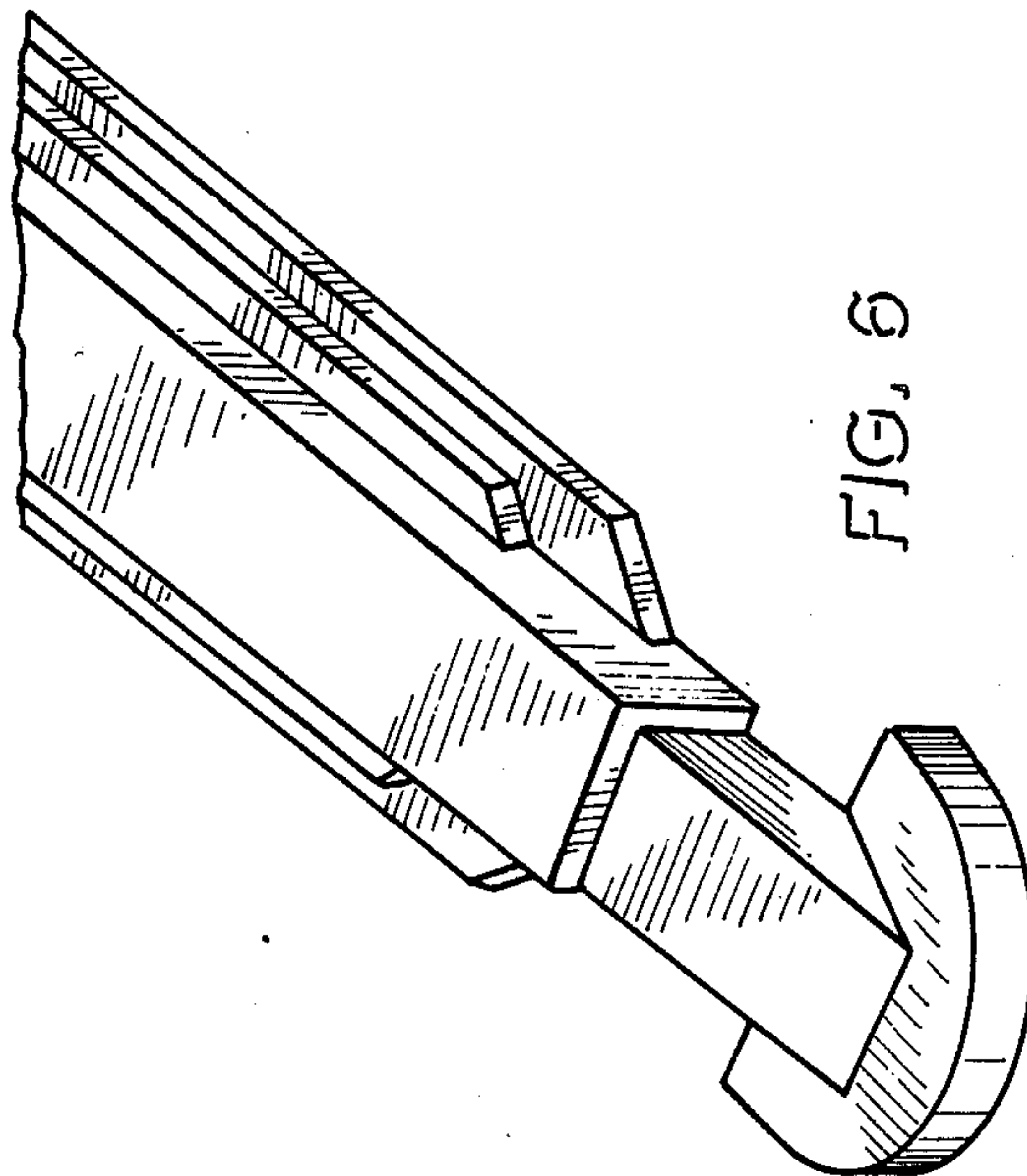
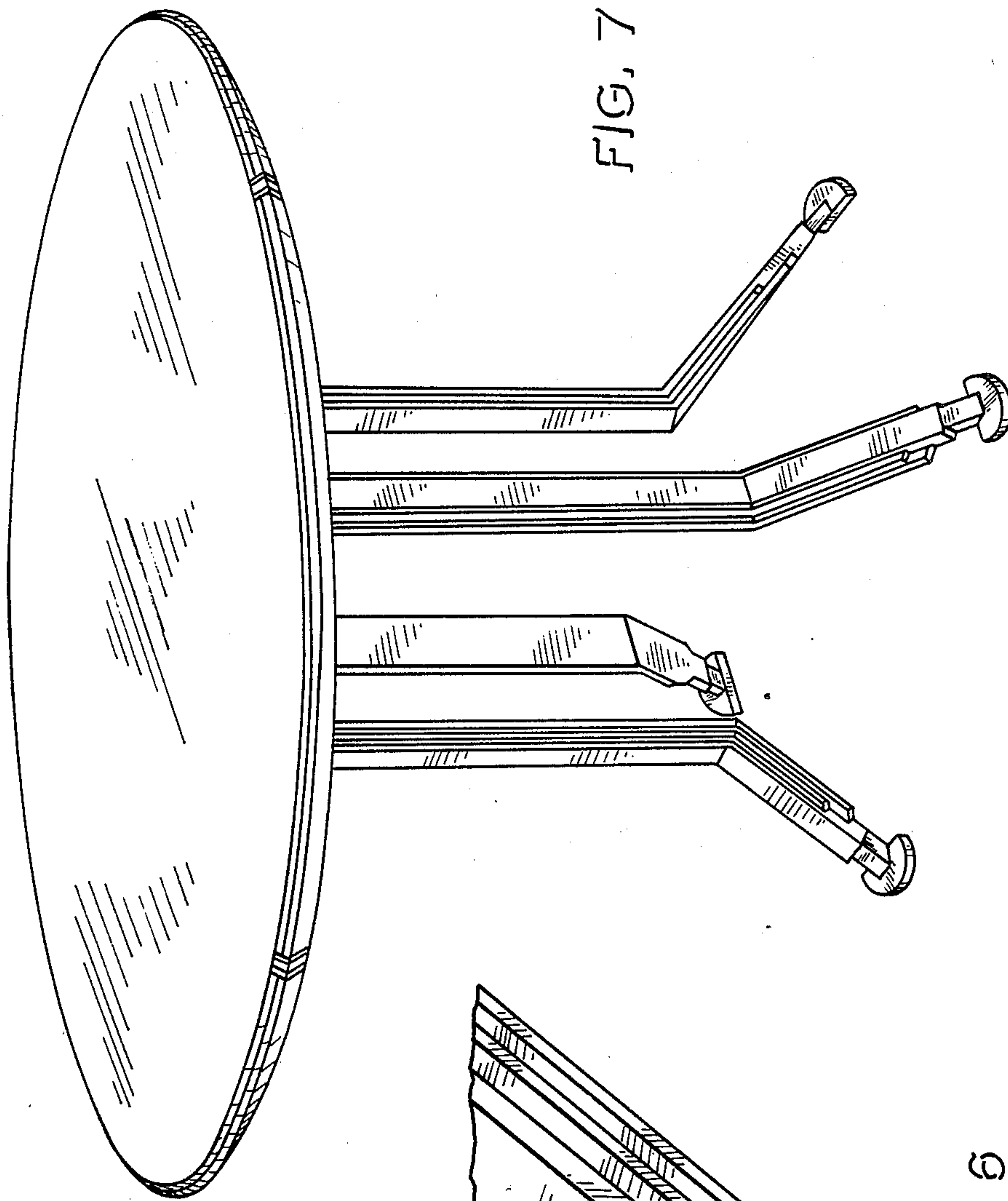

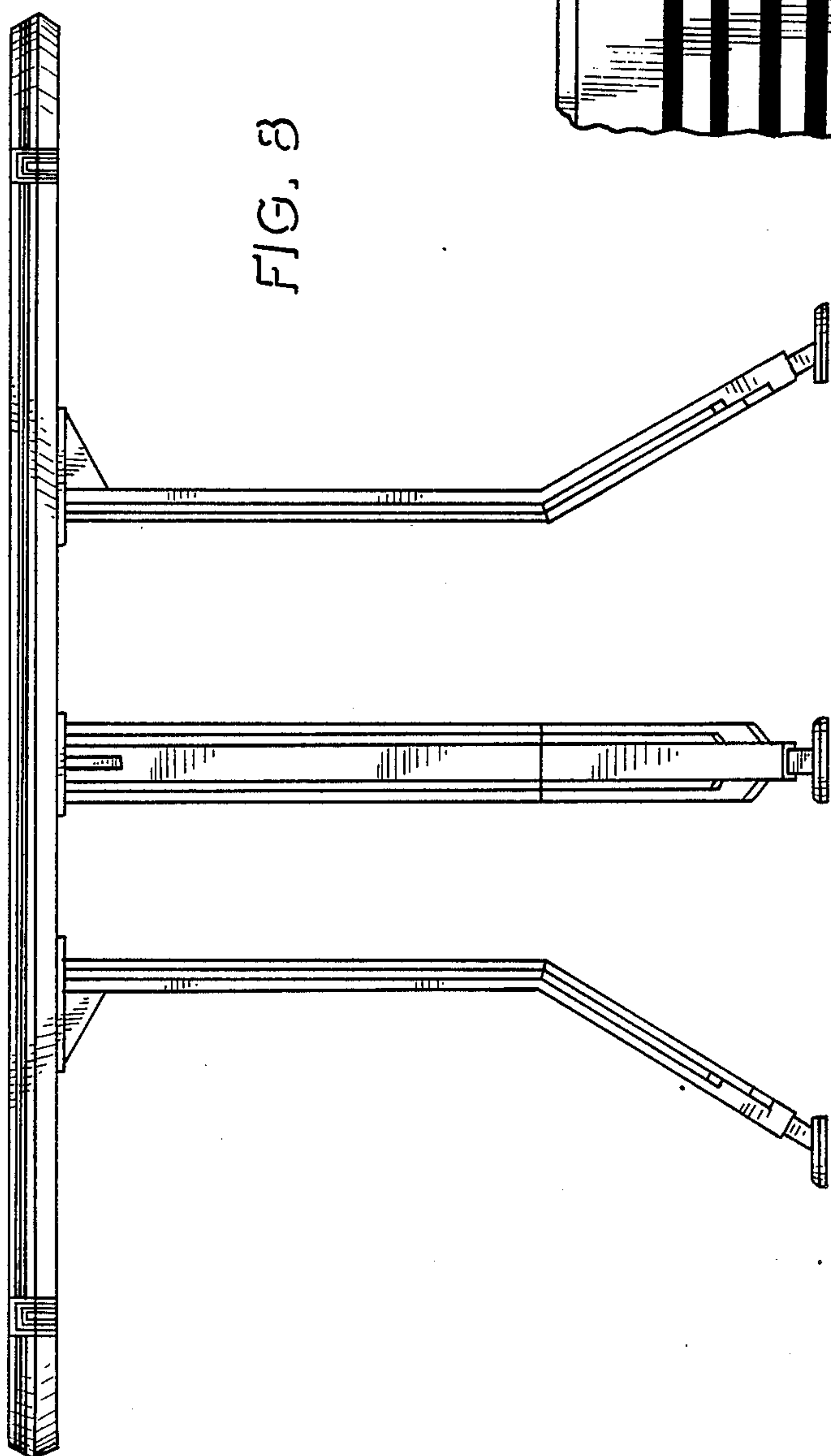

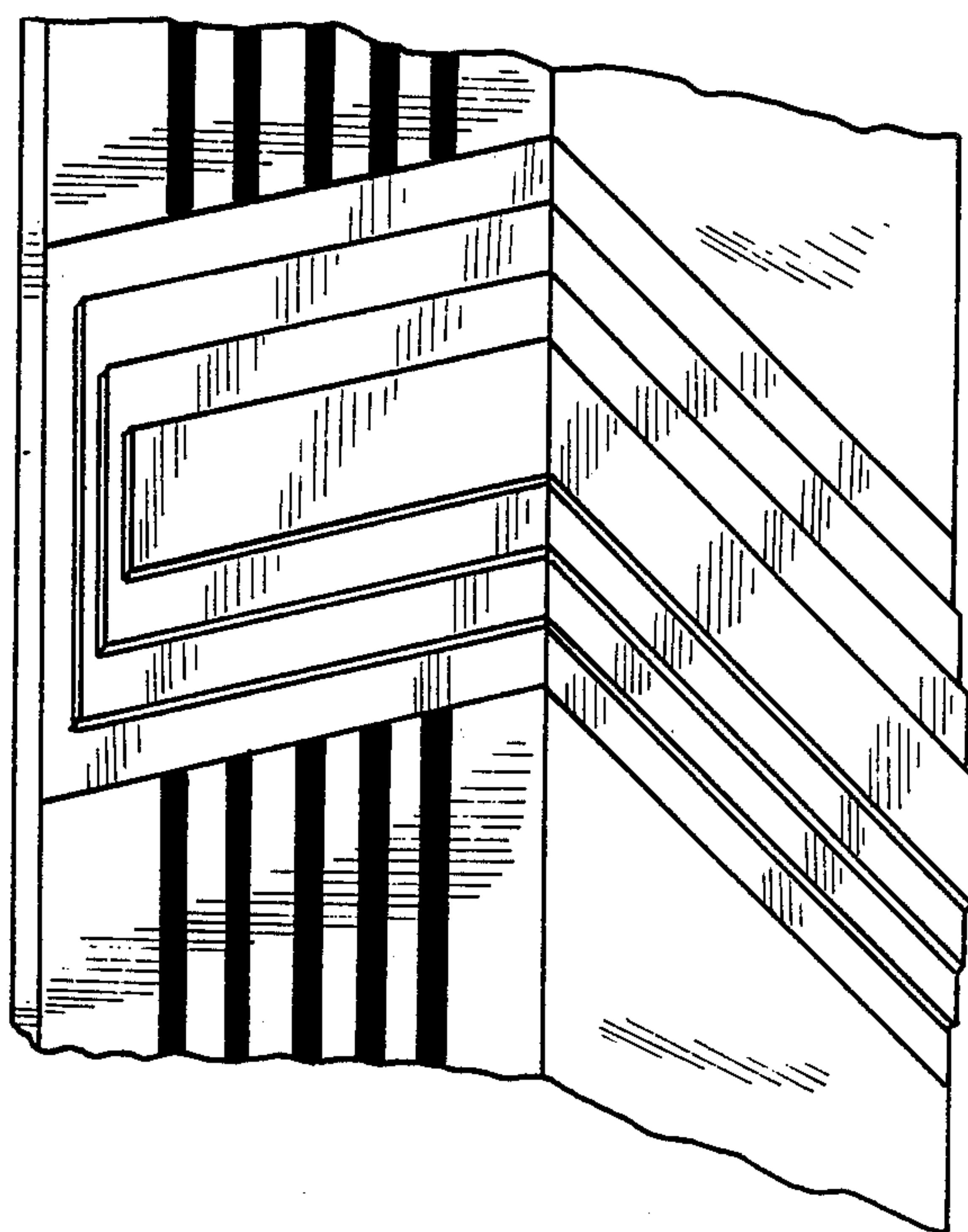
