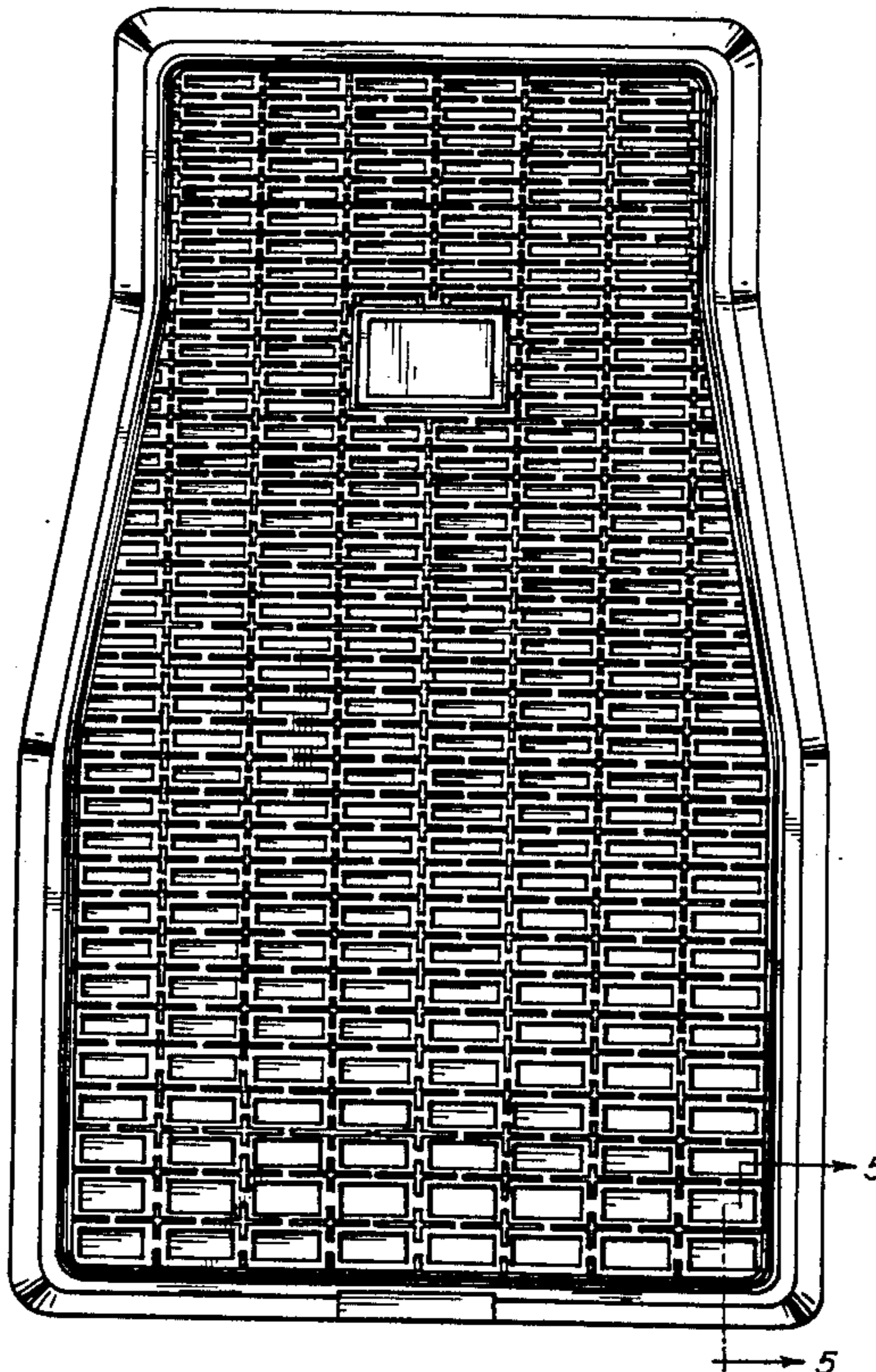

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an automobile floor mat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an automobile floor mat showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof, it being understood that the right side is a mirror image of that shown;
FIG. 3 is a lower end elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary cross section view taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 1.



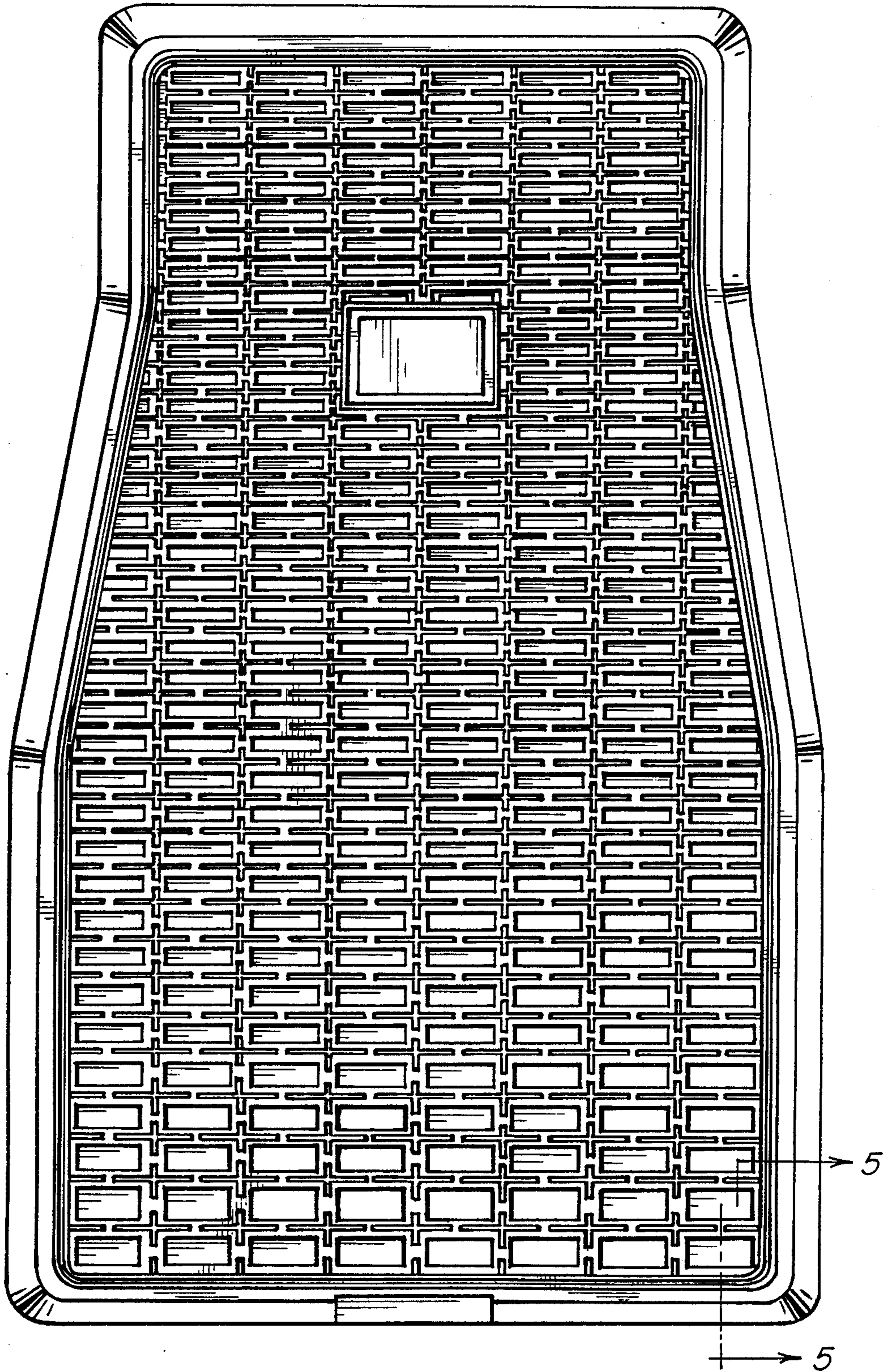

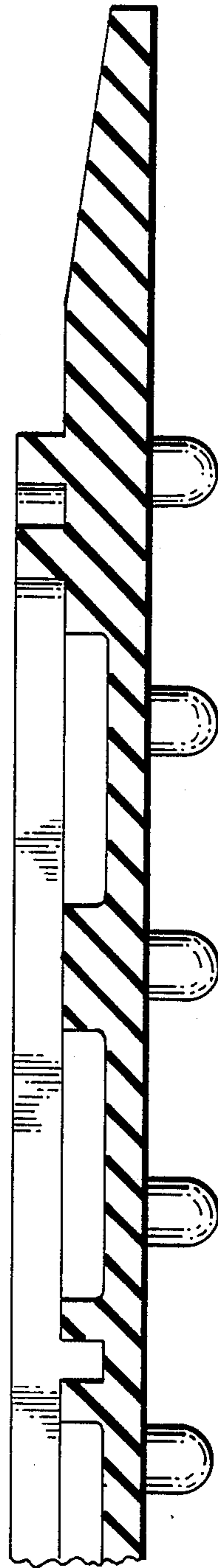

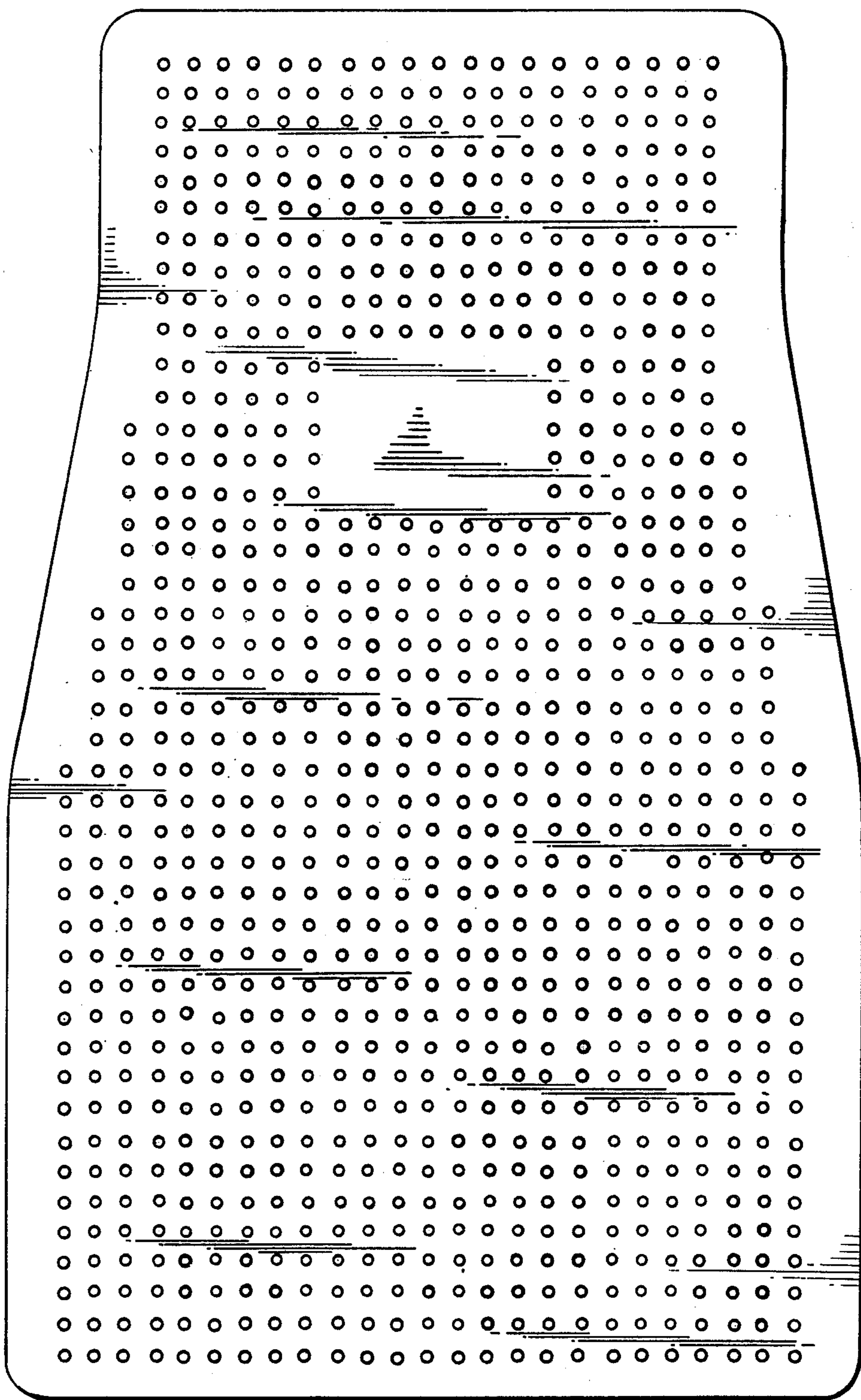
