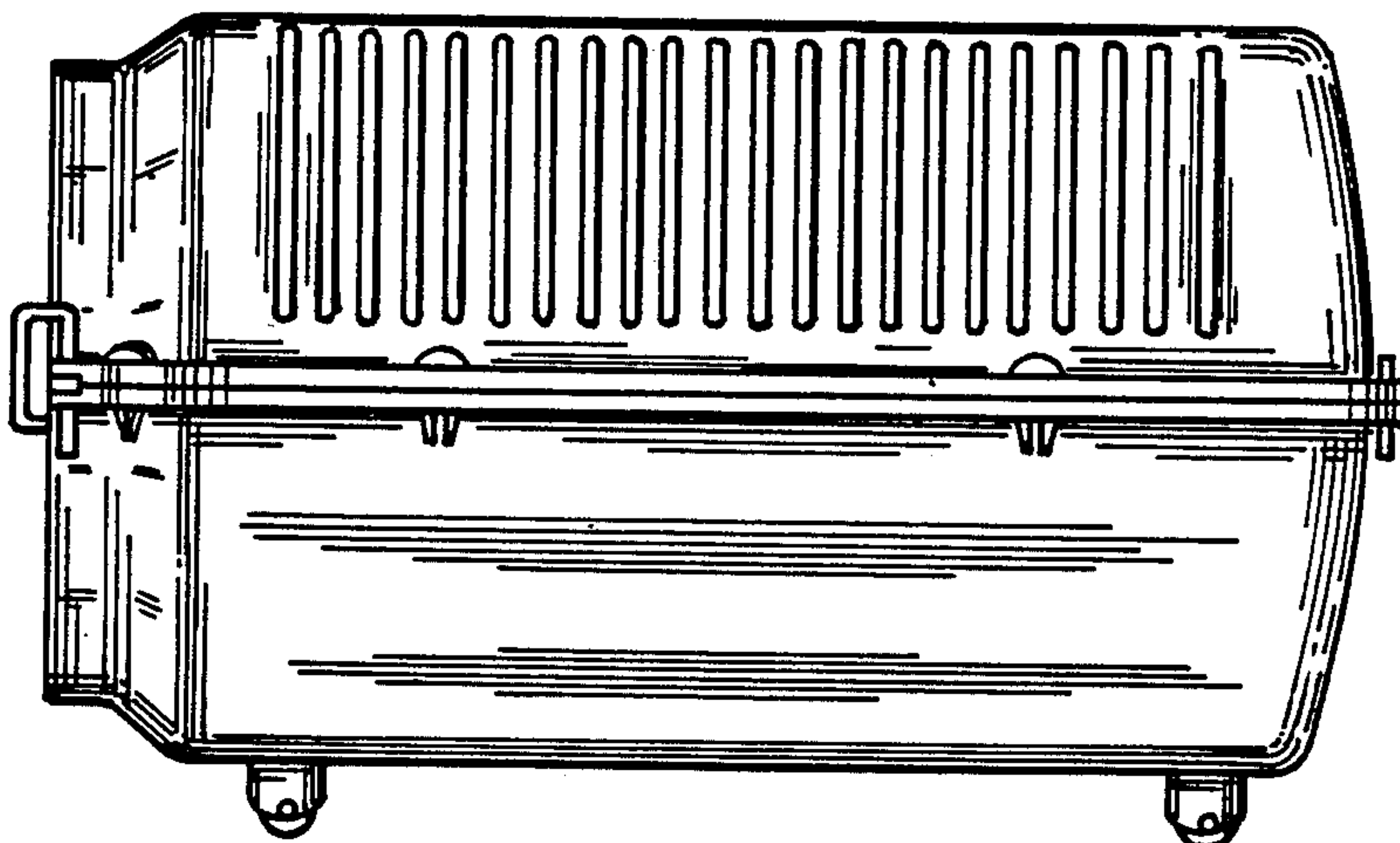
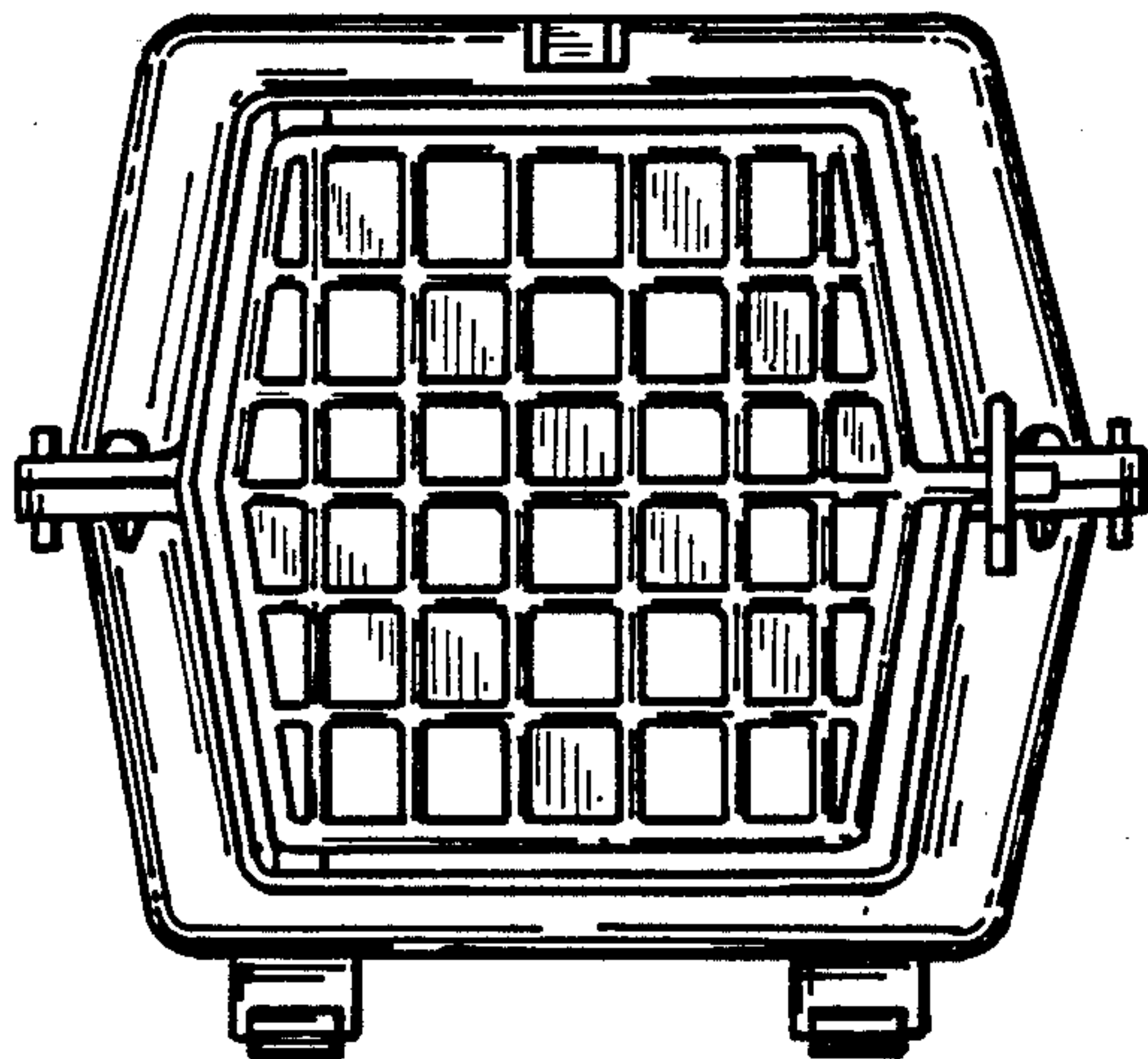

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pet carrier, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a pet carrier show-
ing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left
side being a mirror image of the right side shown;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is another top plan view thereof showing a han-
dle in an operative position.



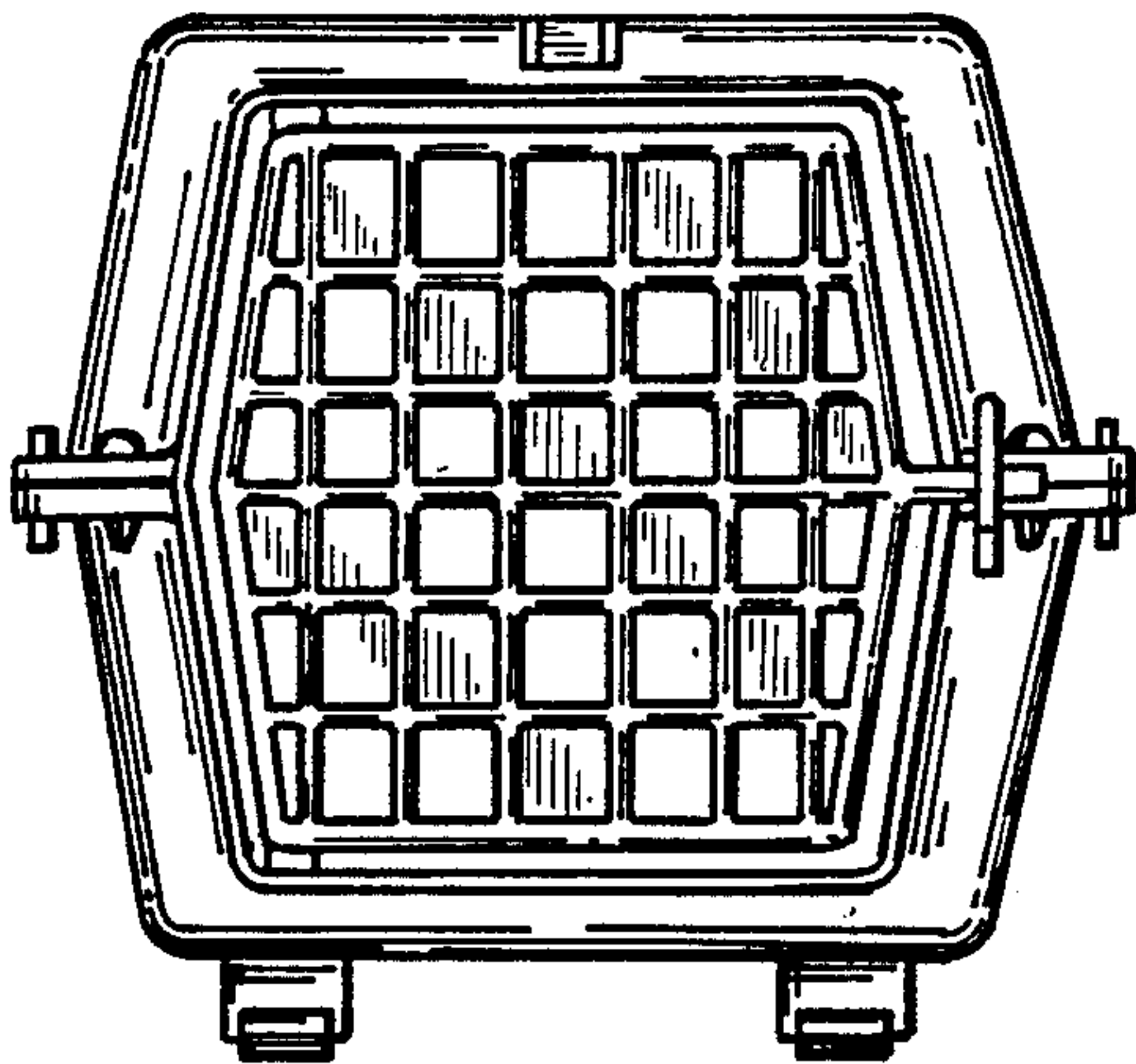

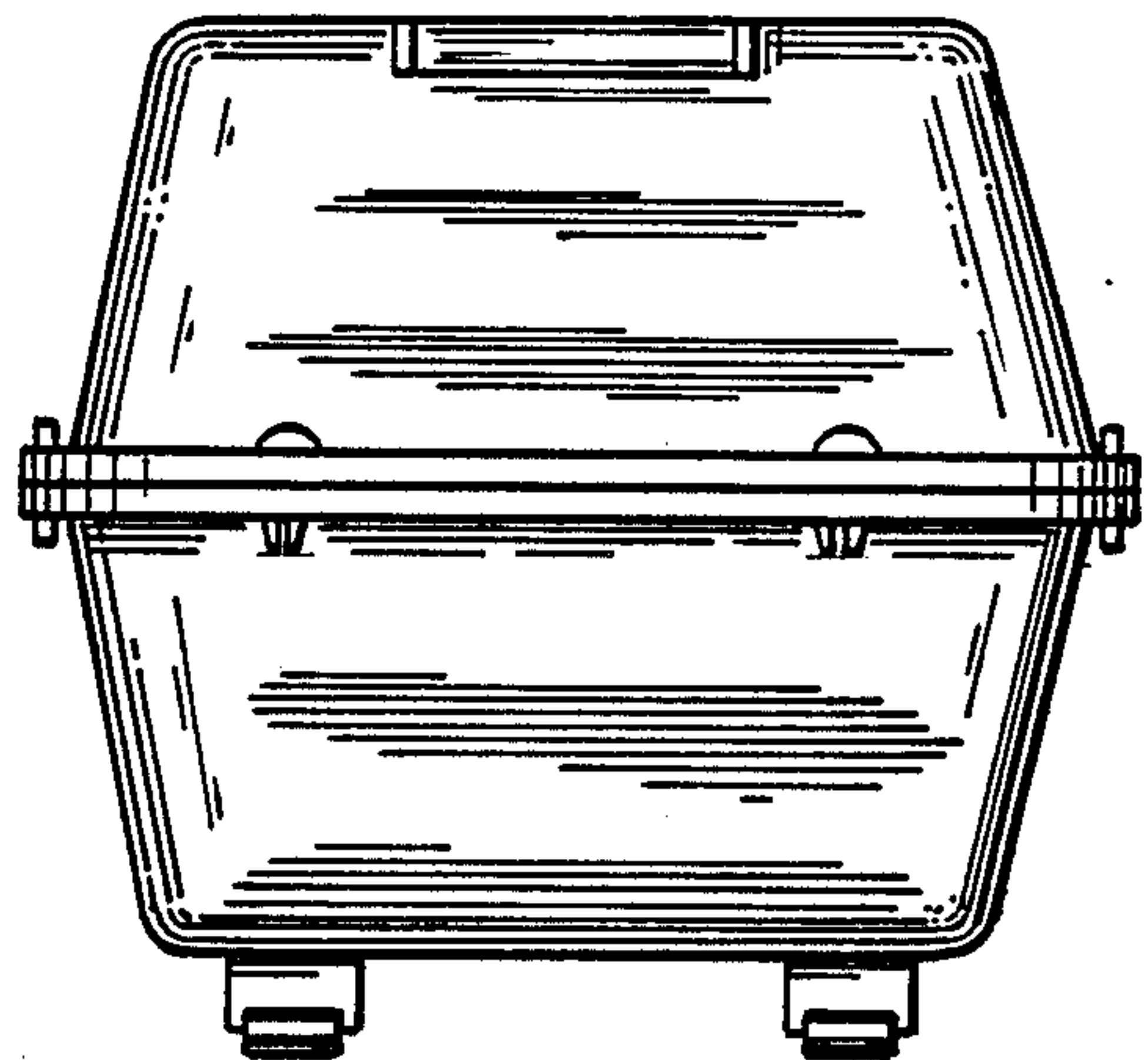

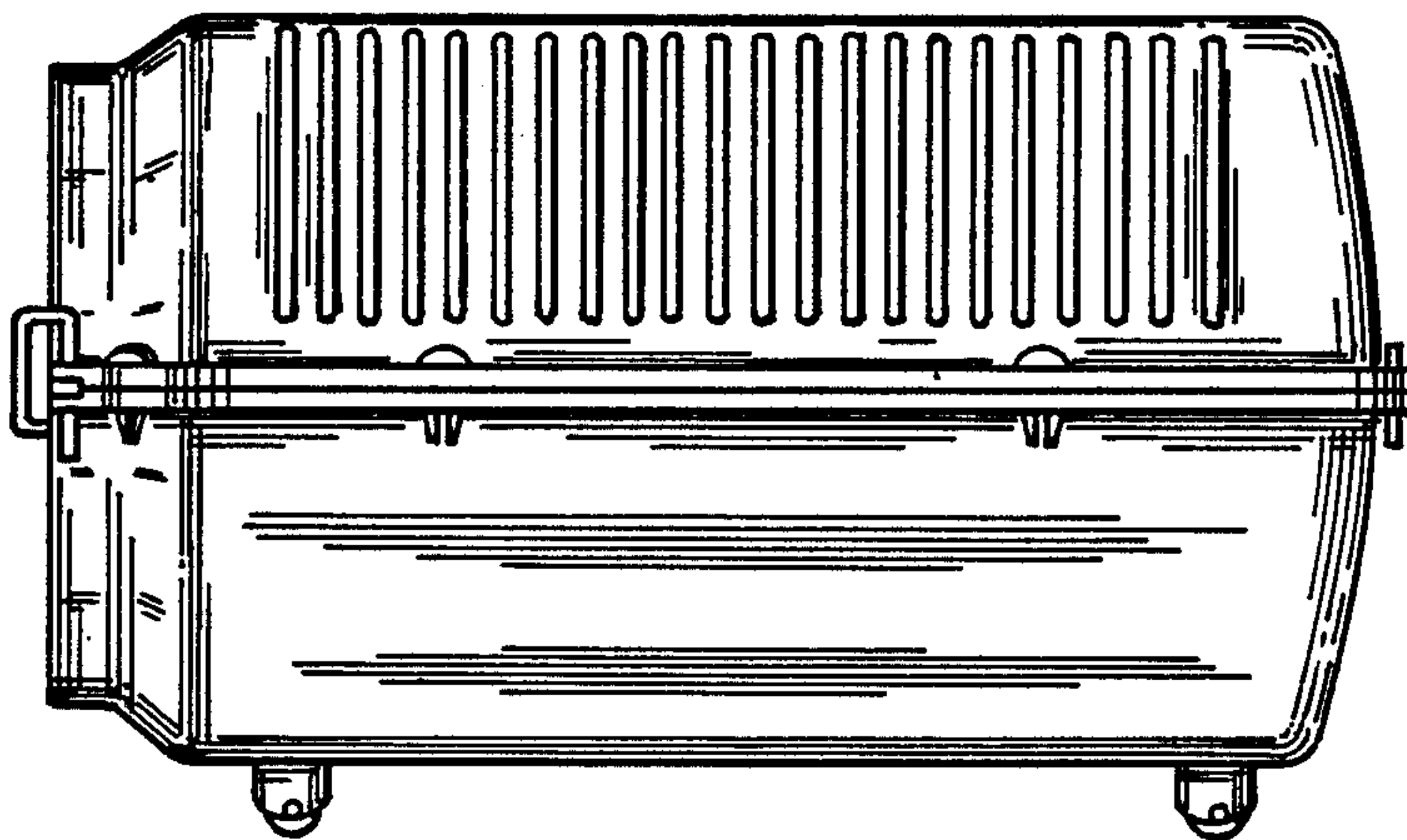

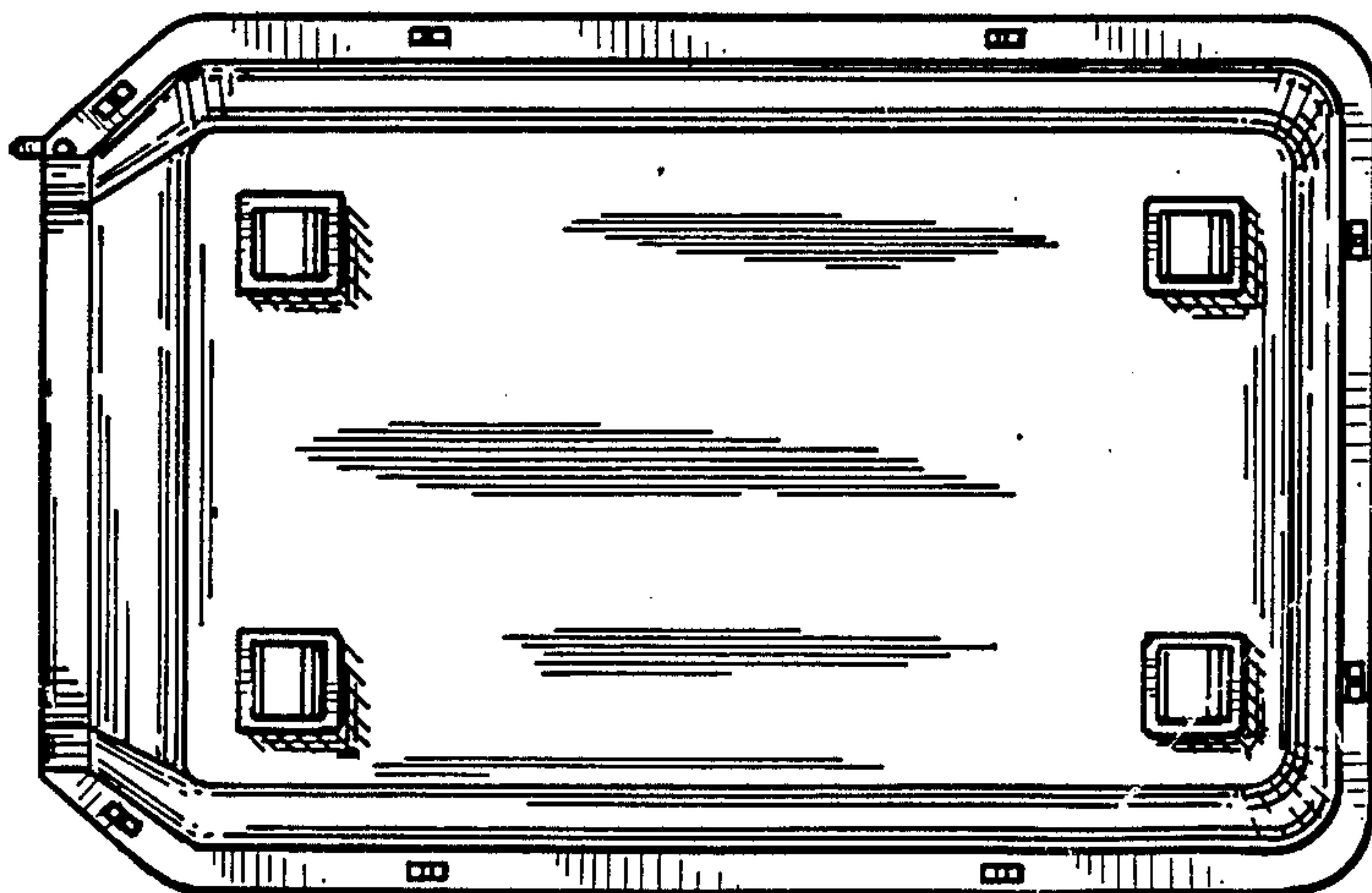

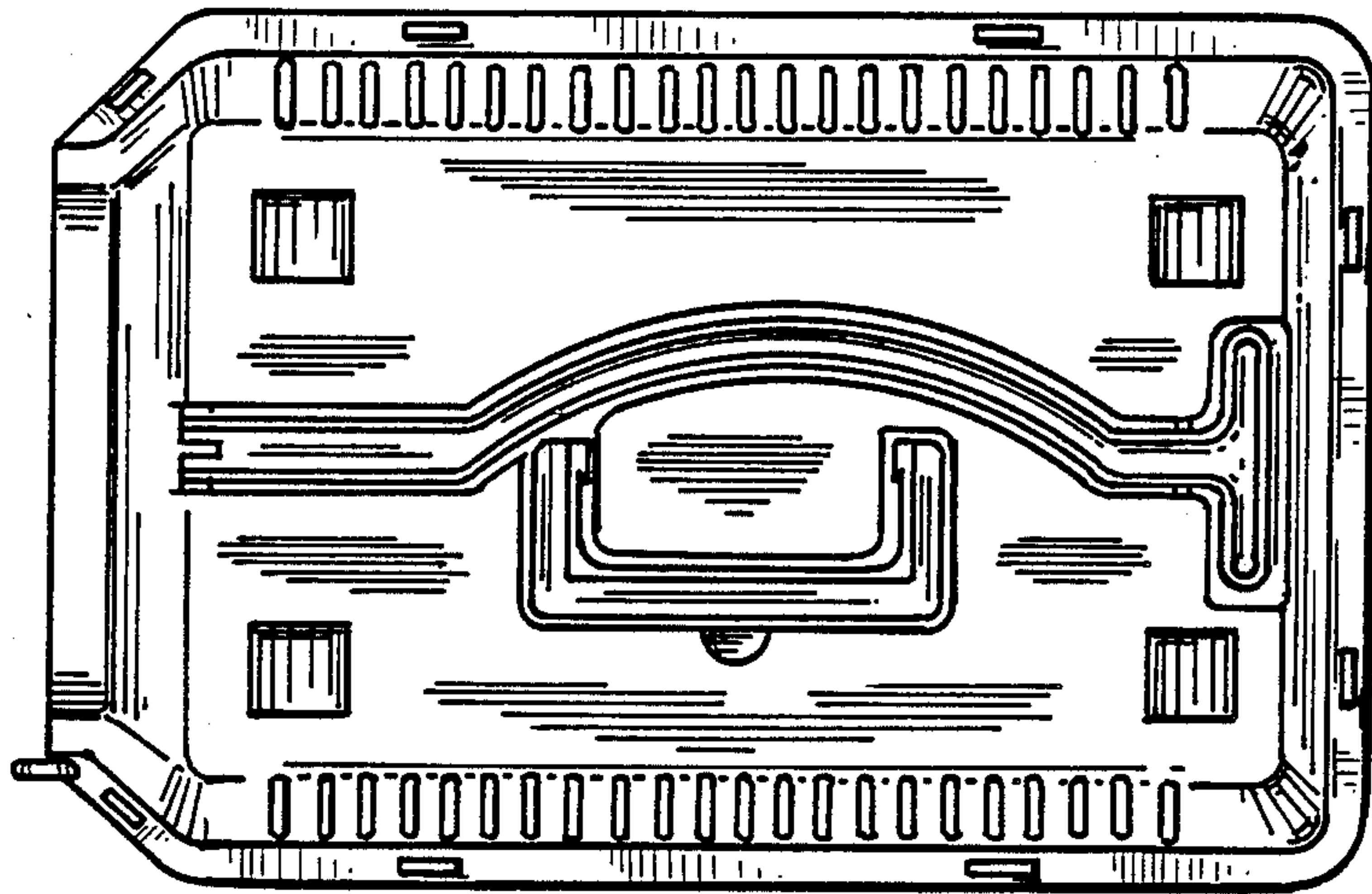

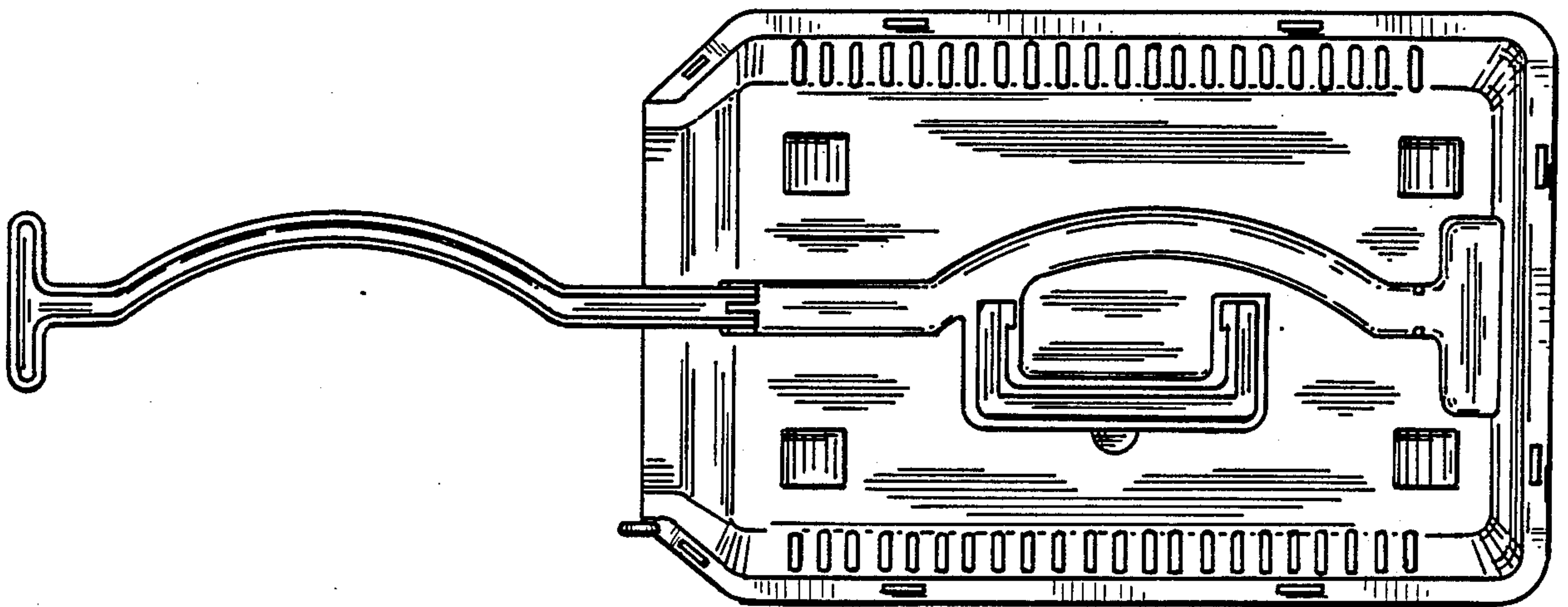
