DESCRIPTION

The broken line showing of an upper in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

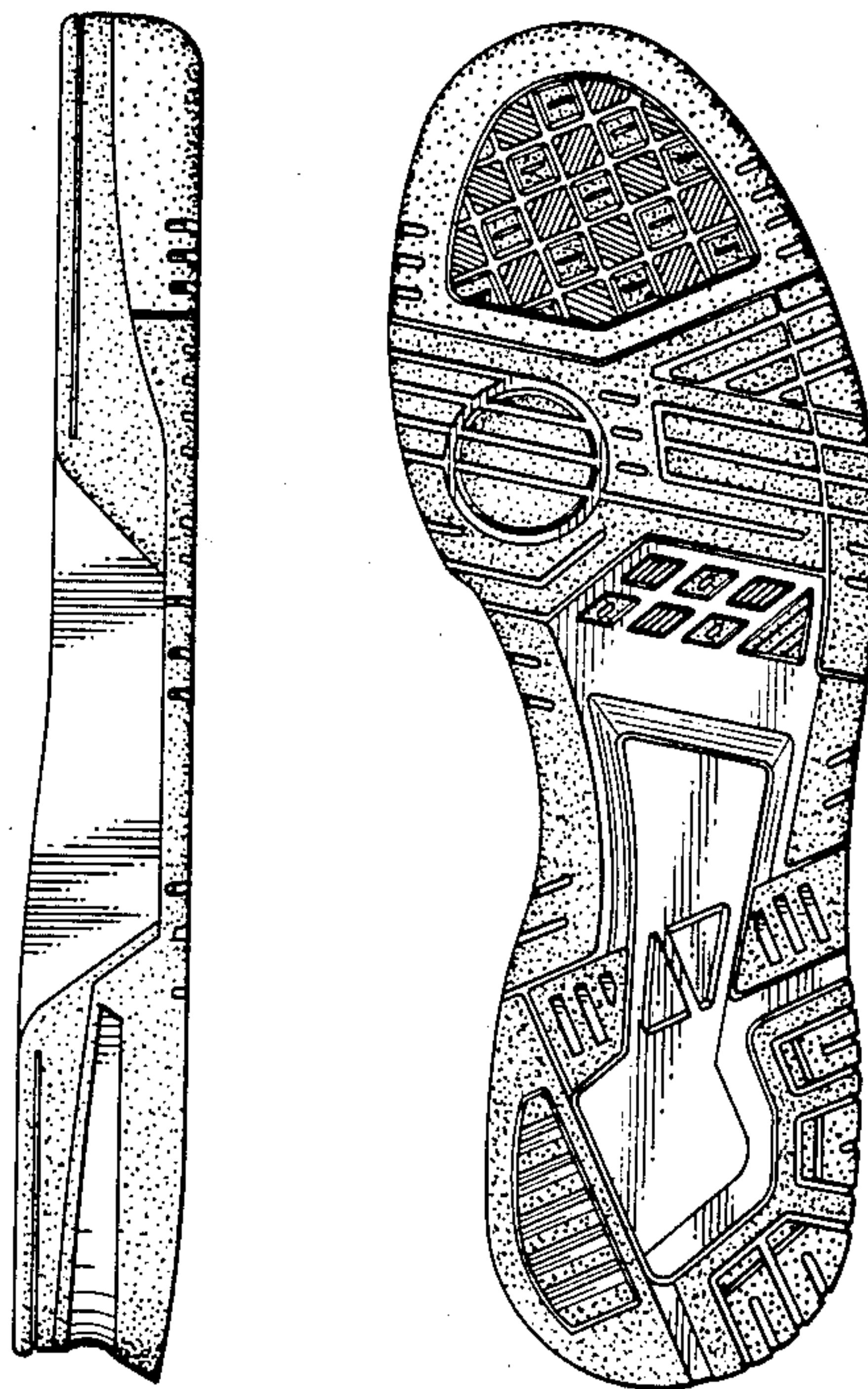

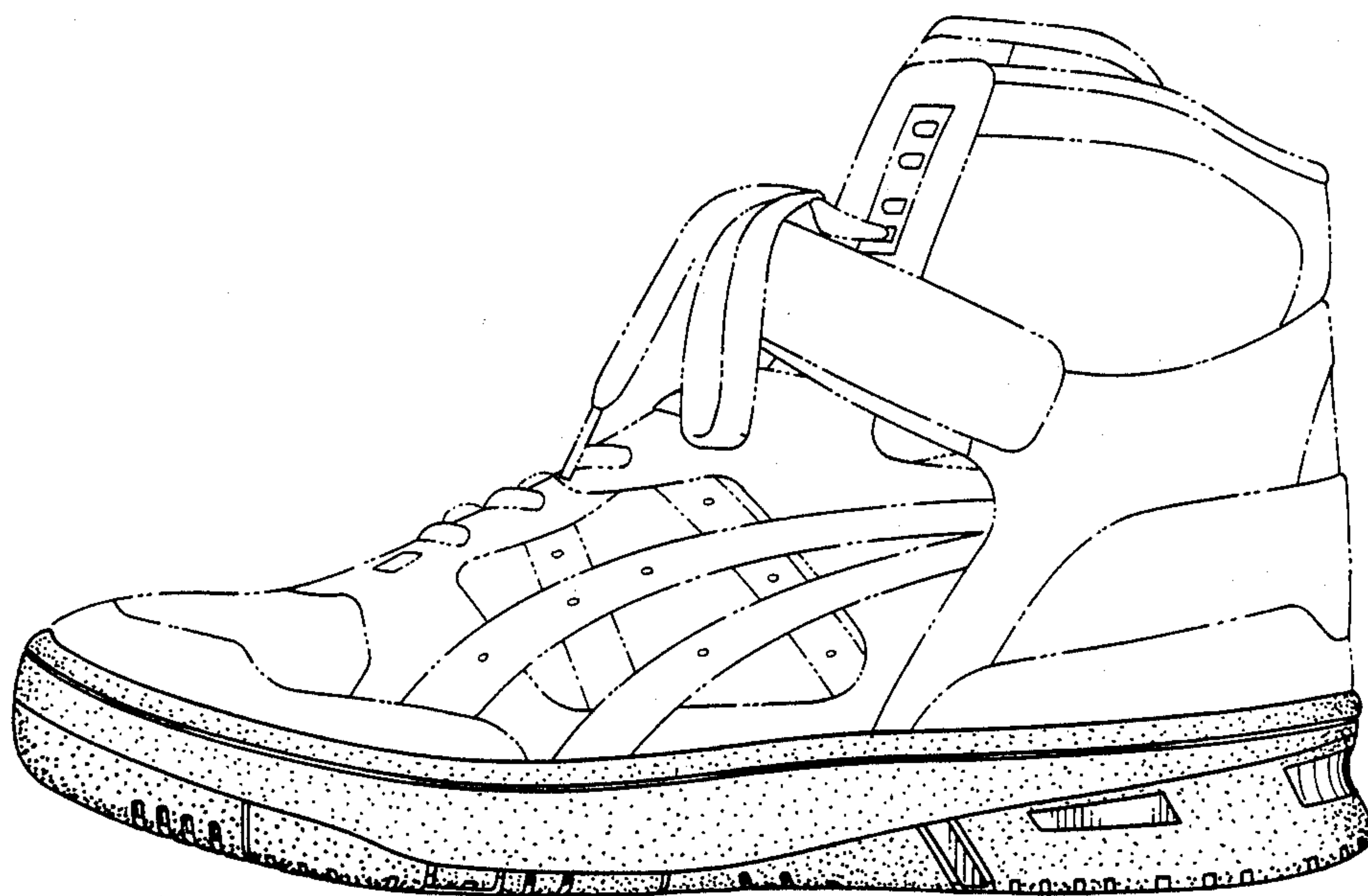

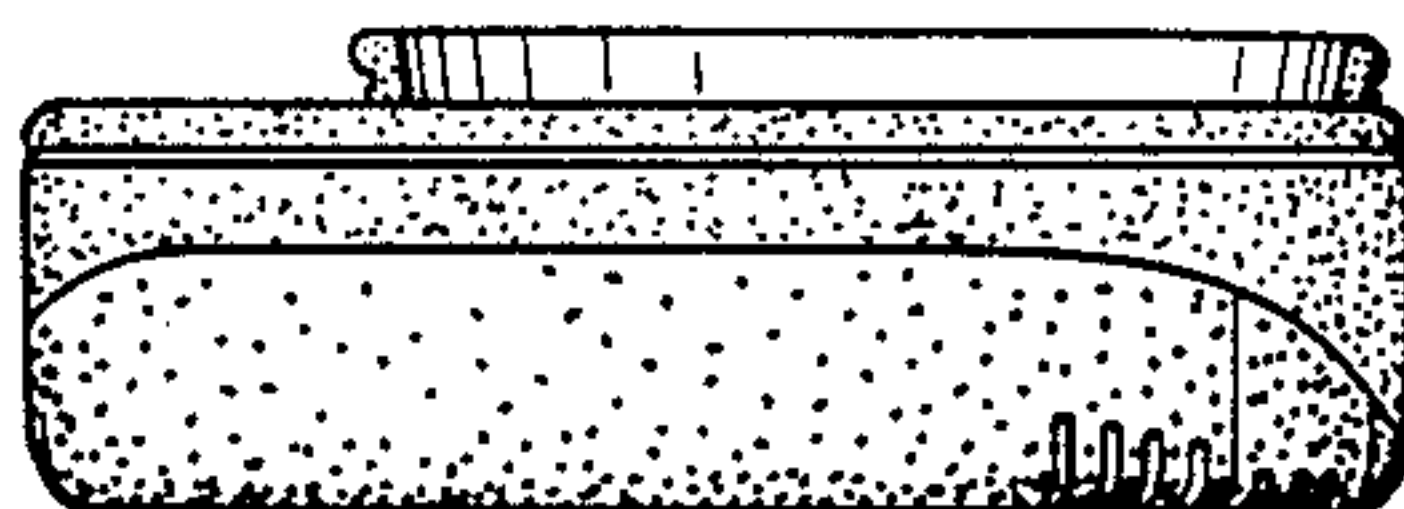

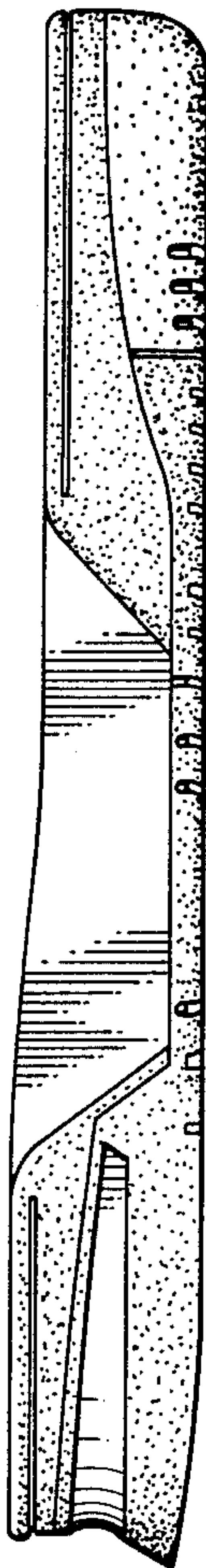

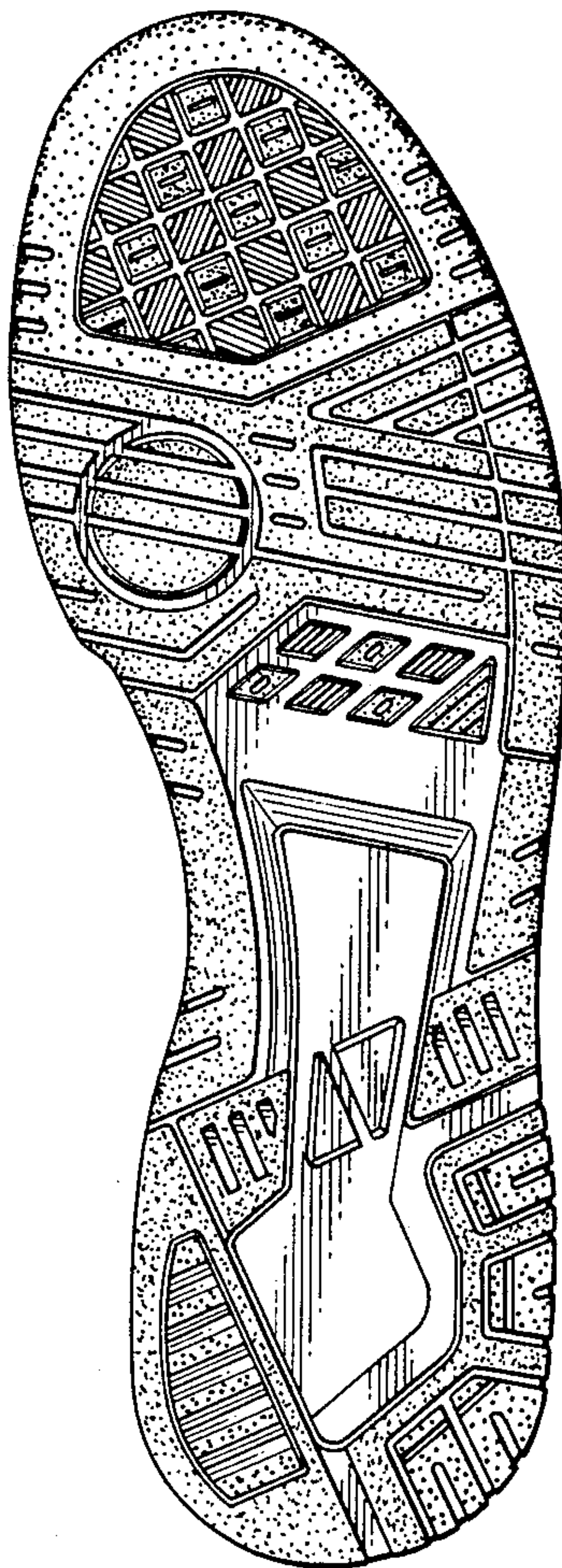

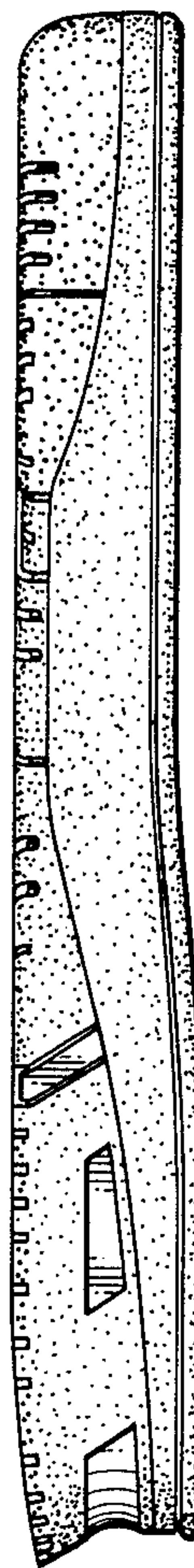

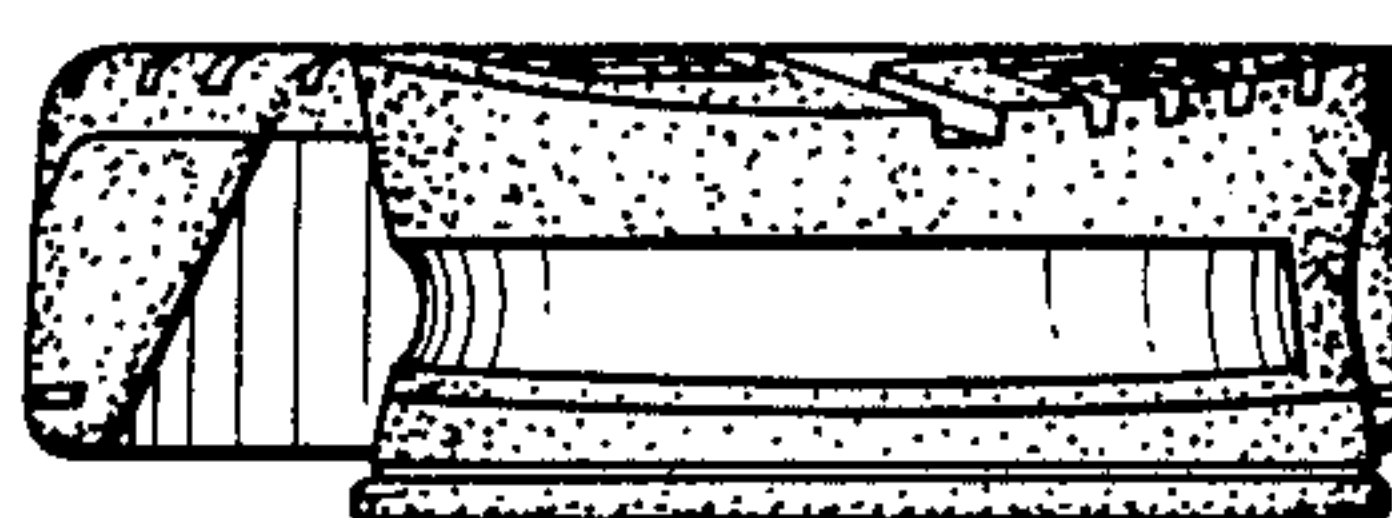
