[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for combined storage rack and toilet paper dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a combined storage rack and toilet paper dispenser showing my new design, the undisclosed right side being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;

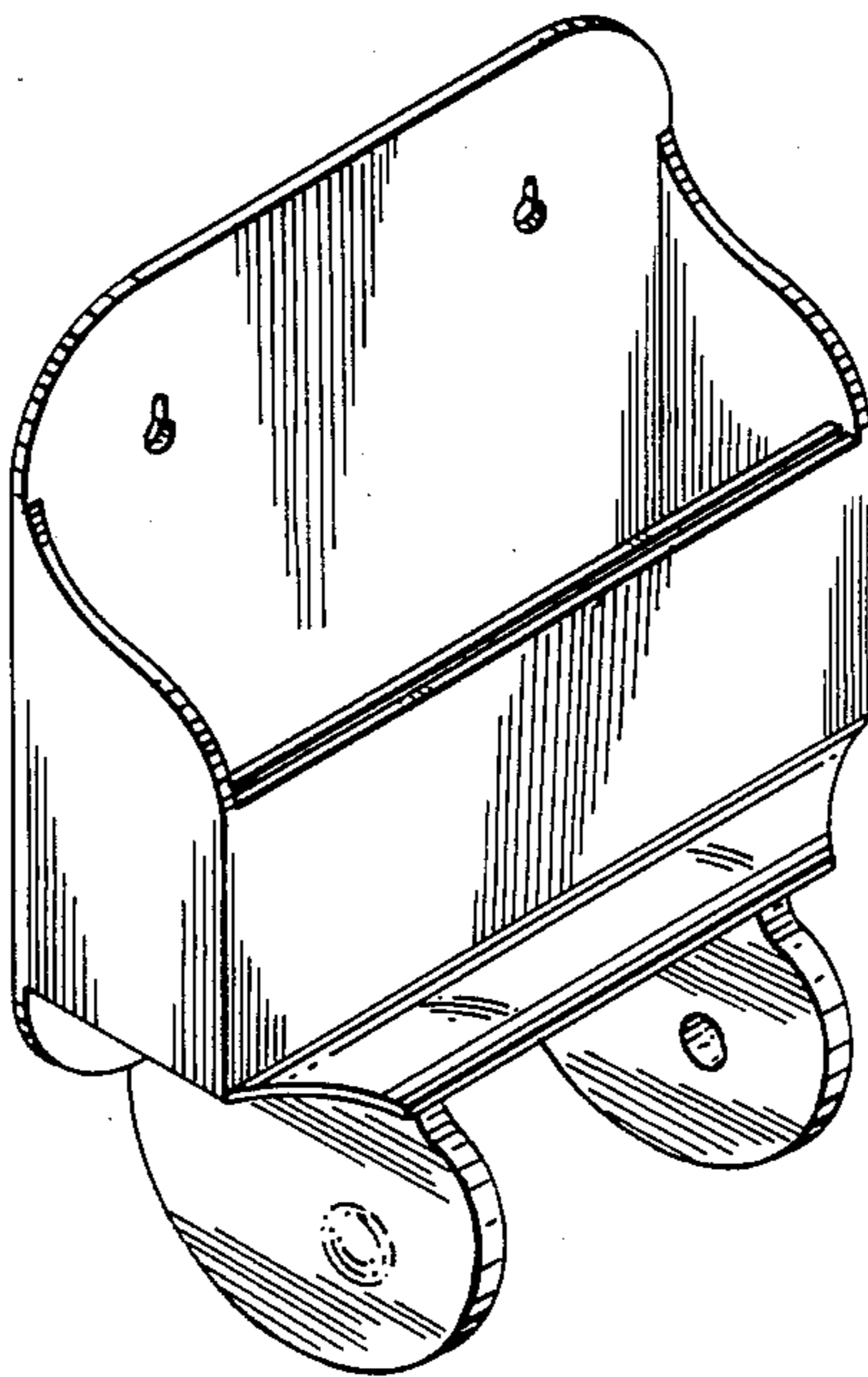
FIG. 3 is an enlarged vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 5;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof.

The broken-line showing of the toilet paper roll holder in FIGS. 2, 5 and 6 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



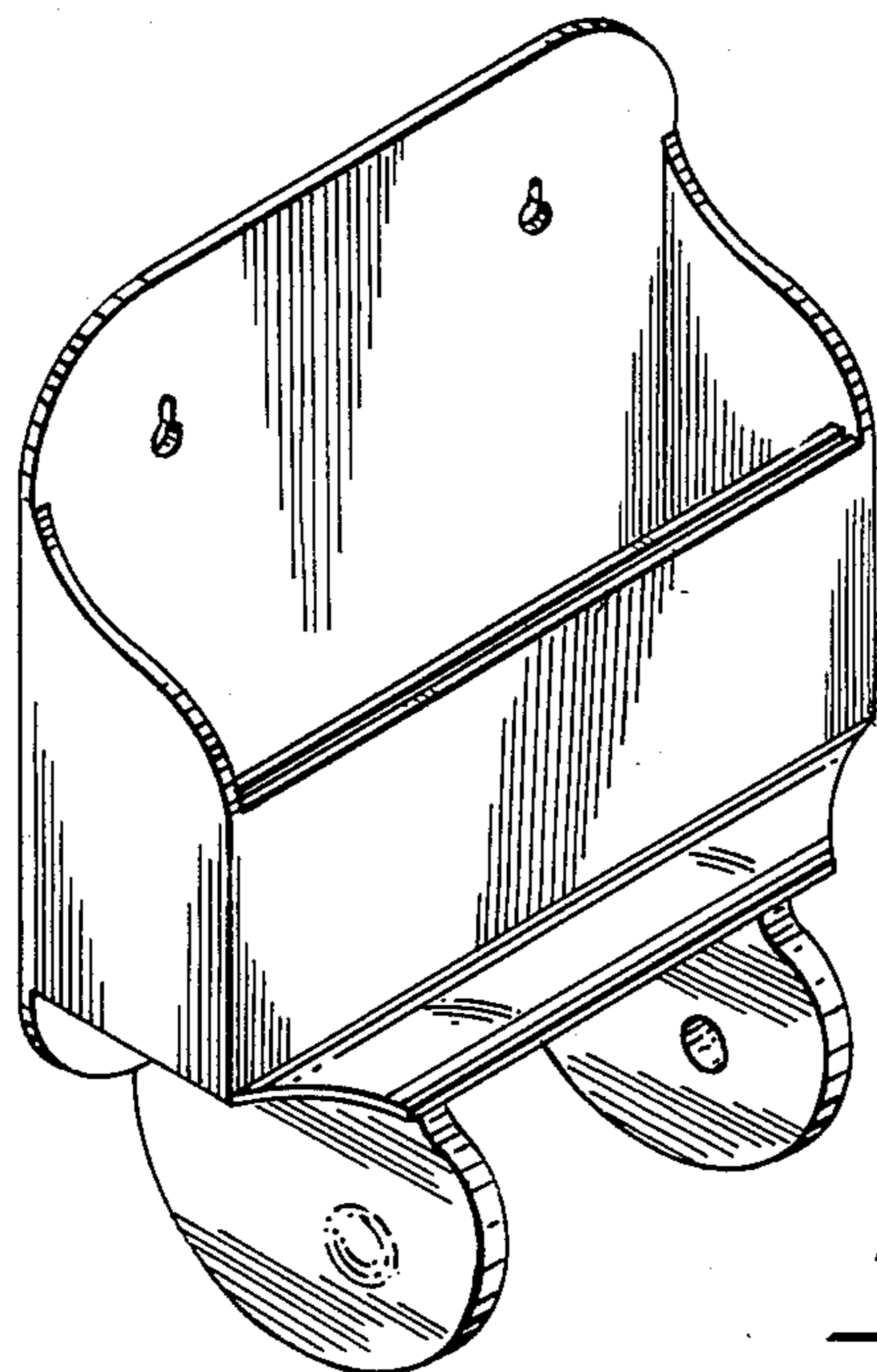

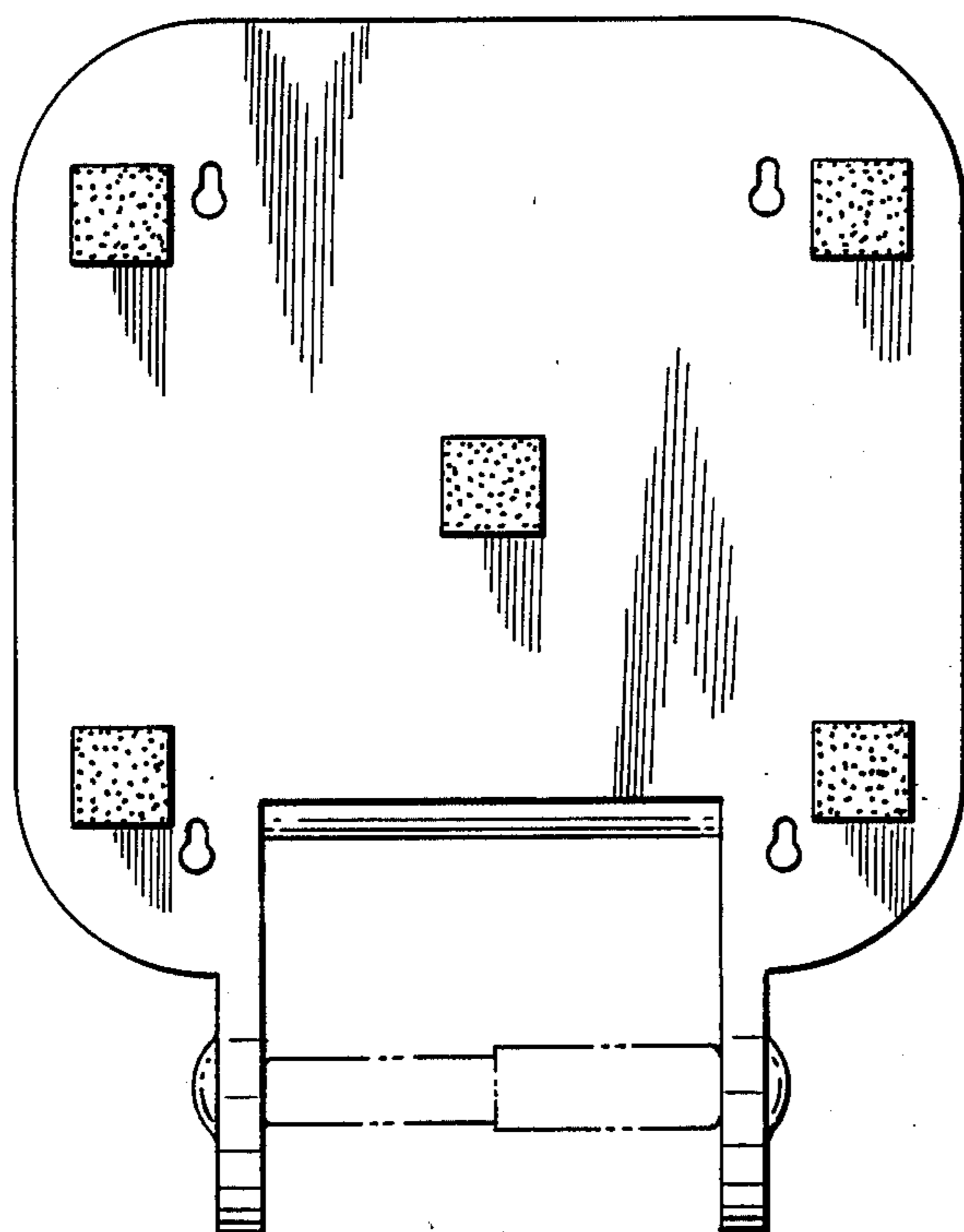

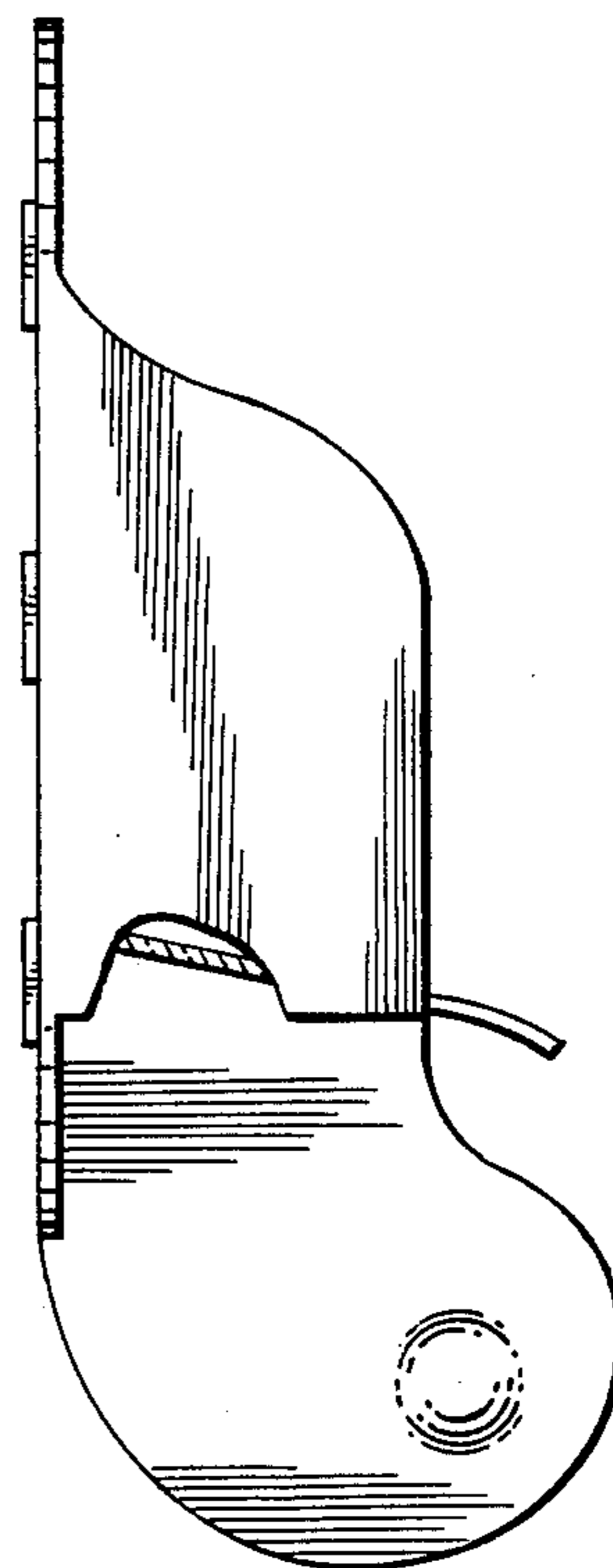

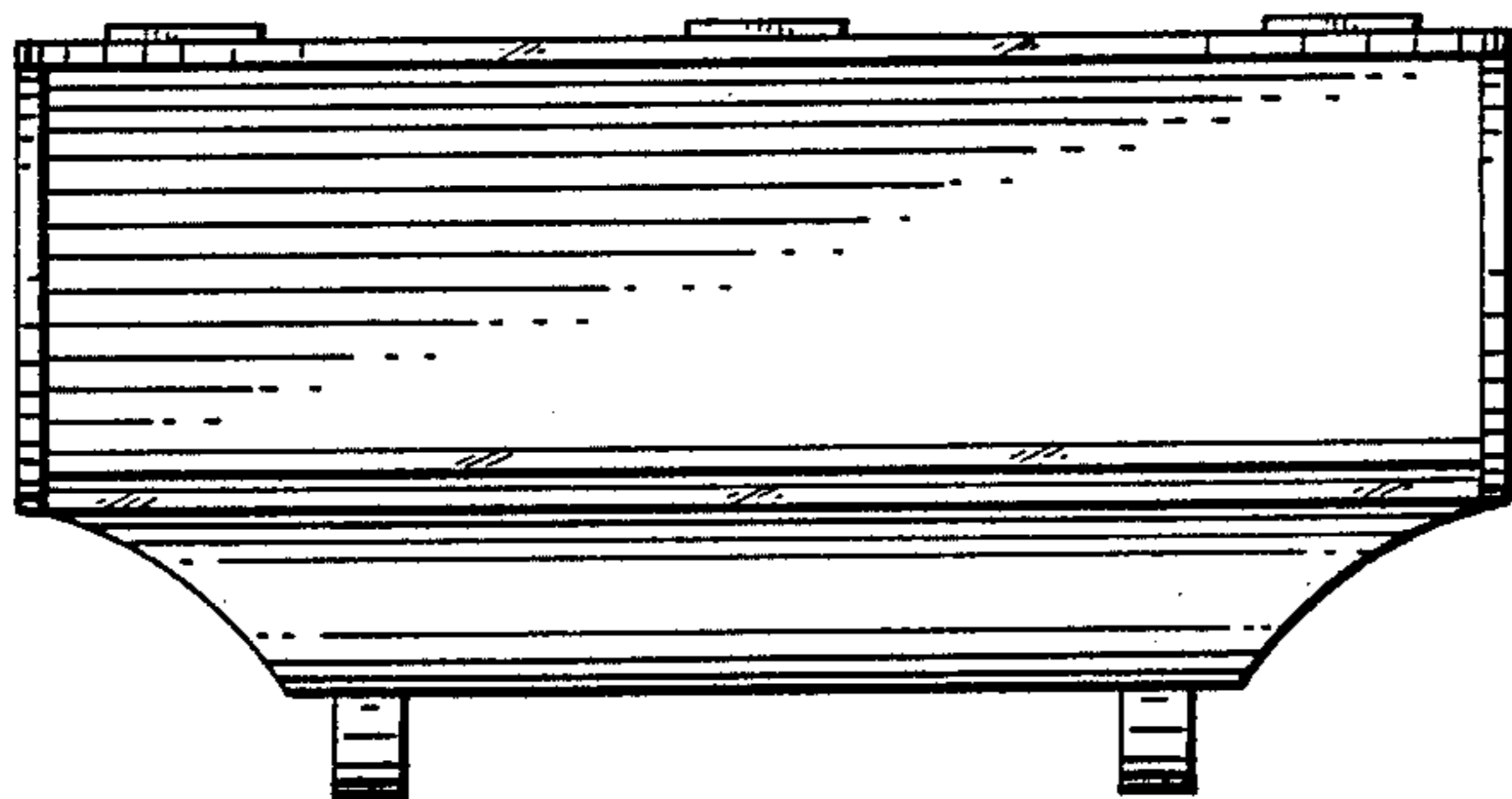

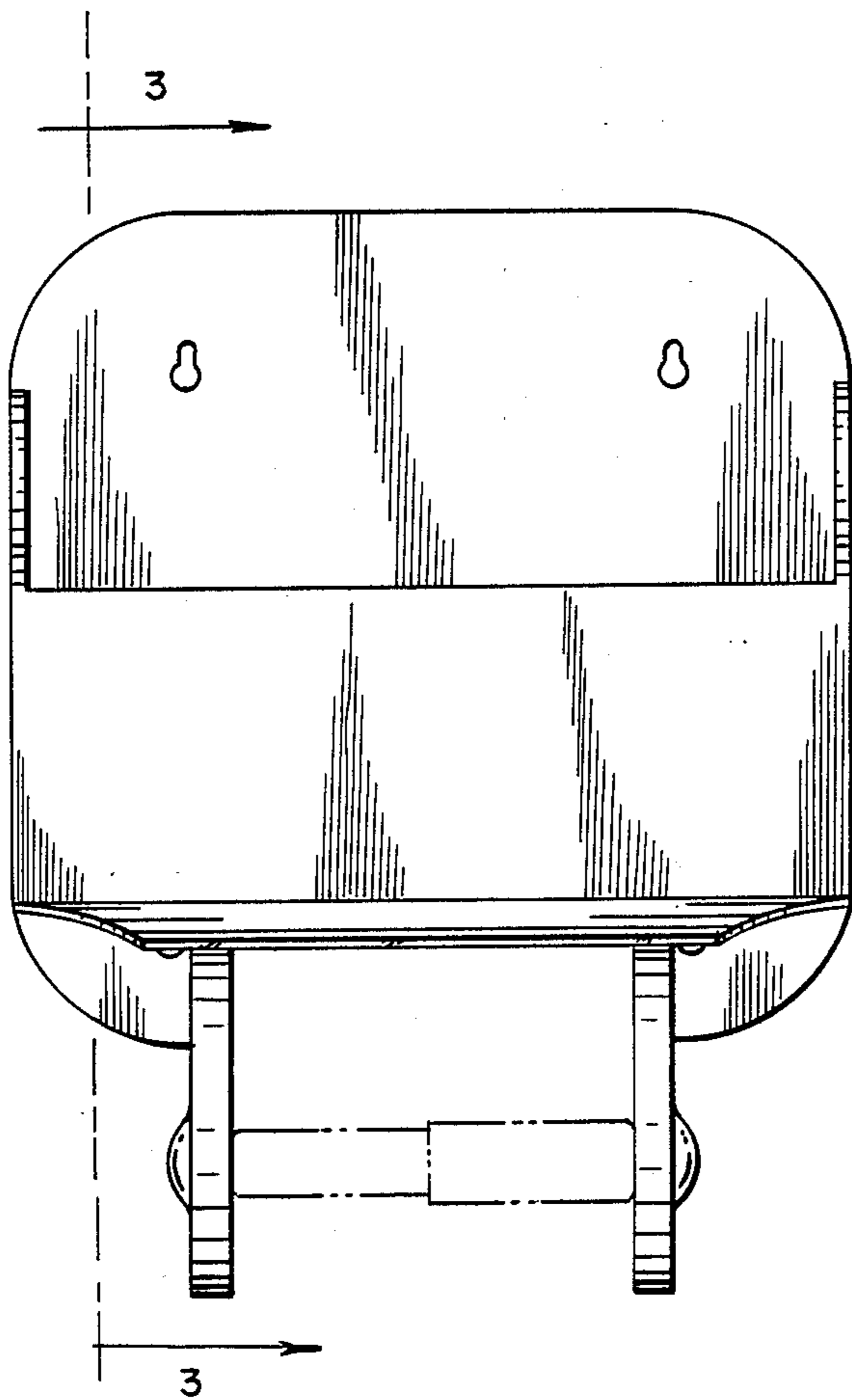

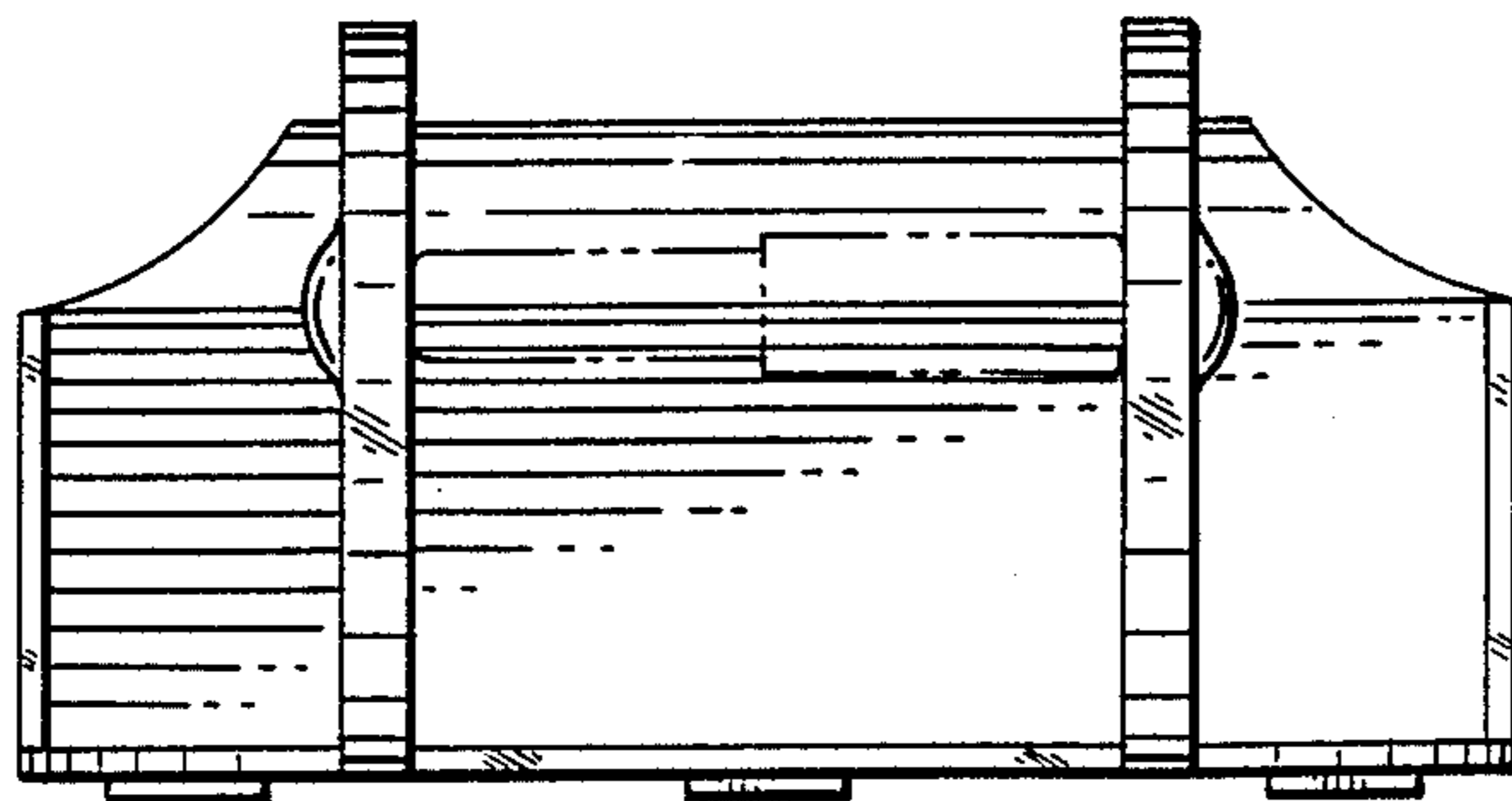
