[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined bottle and closure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a combined bottle and closure embodying my new design, the rear elevation being the same;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof, the opposite side being the same;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

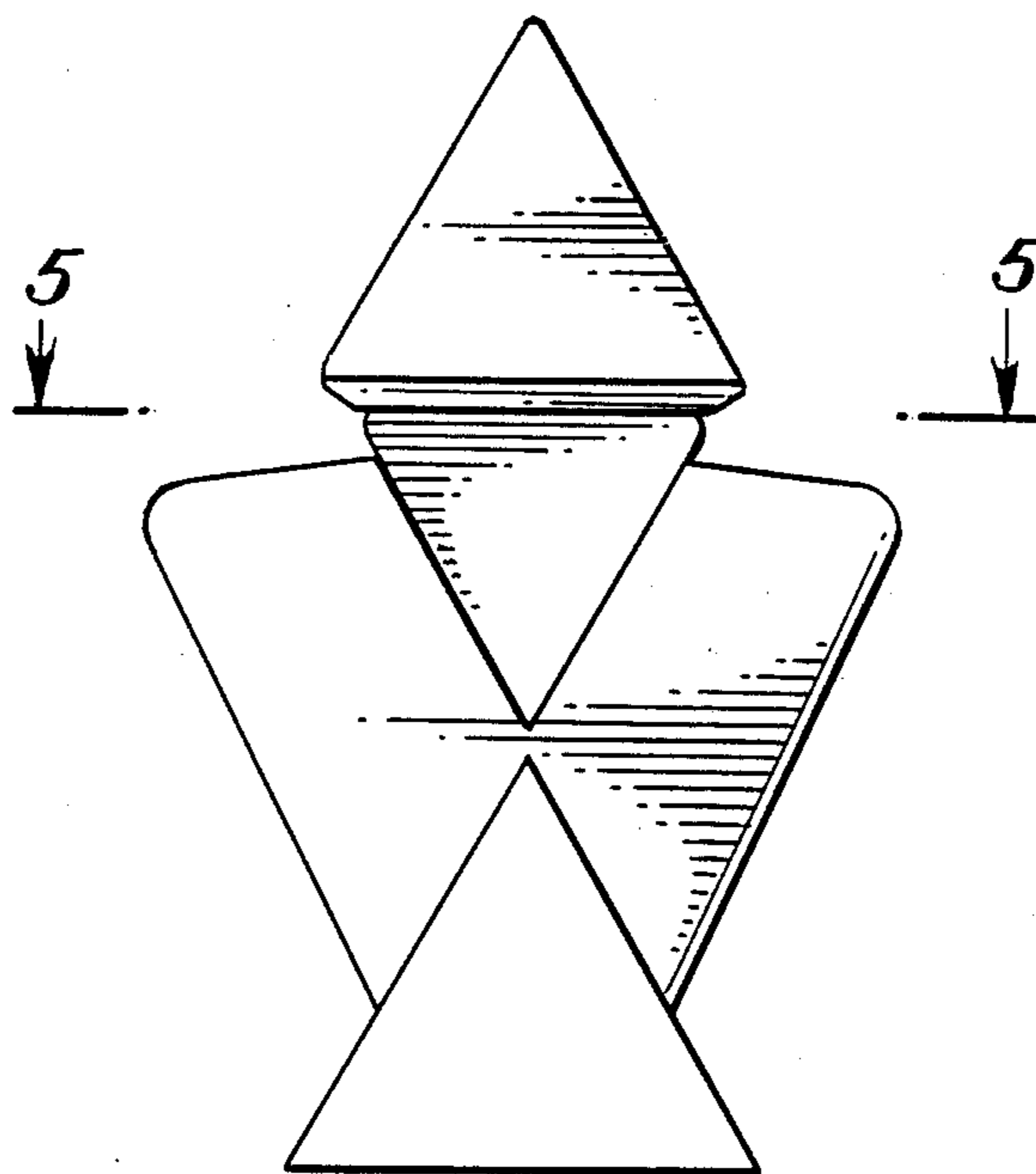

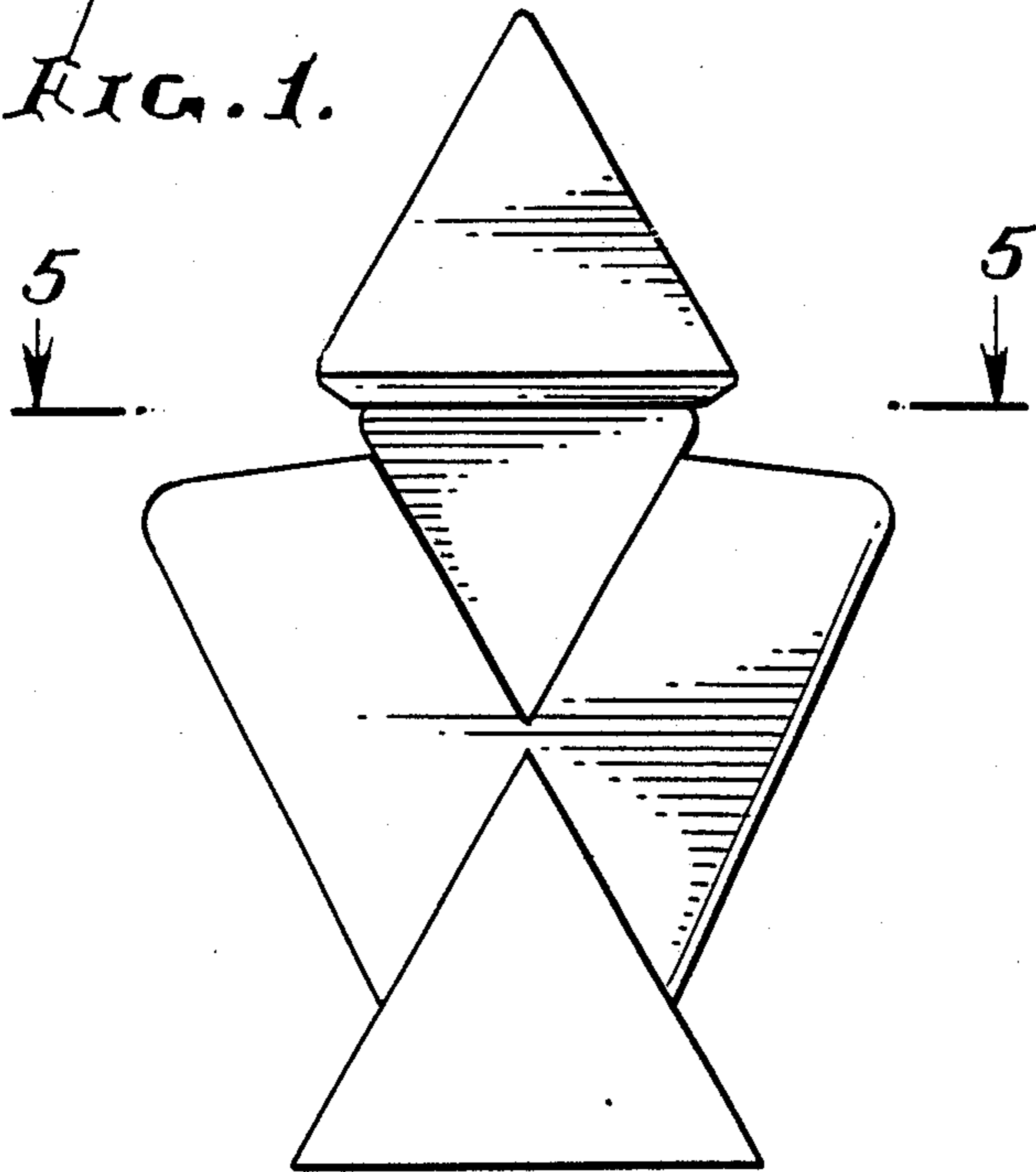

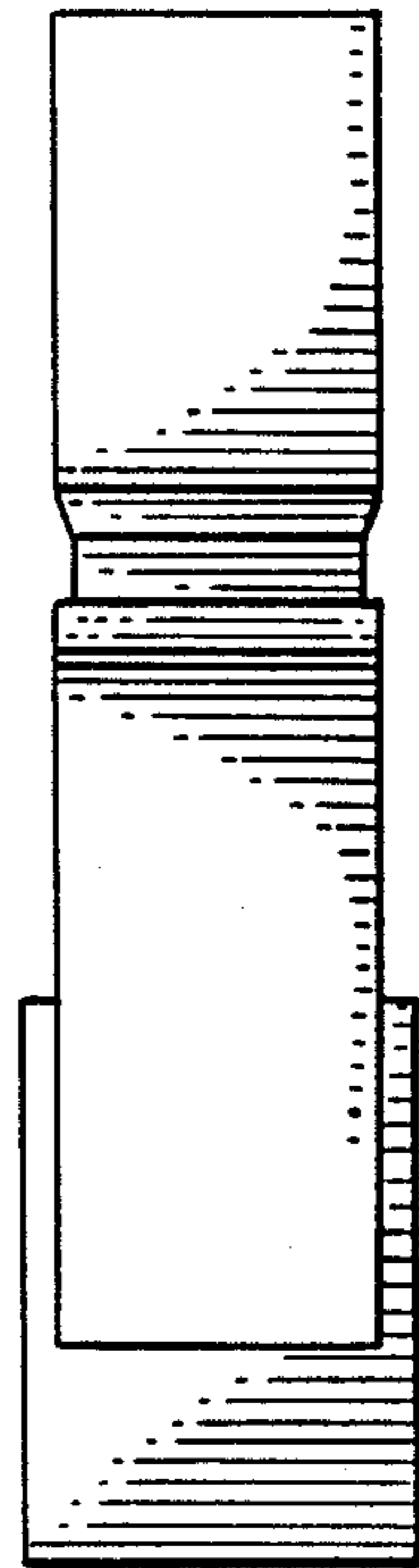

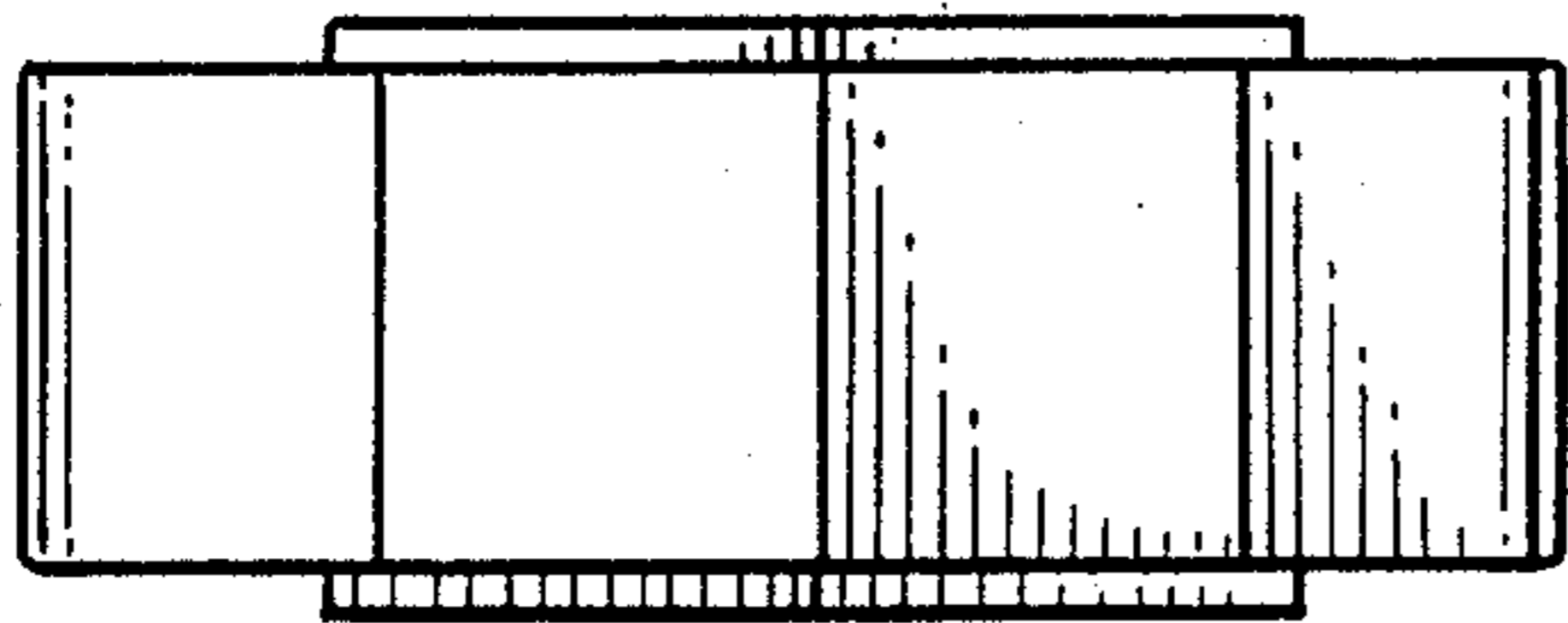

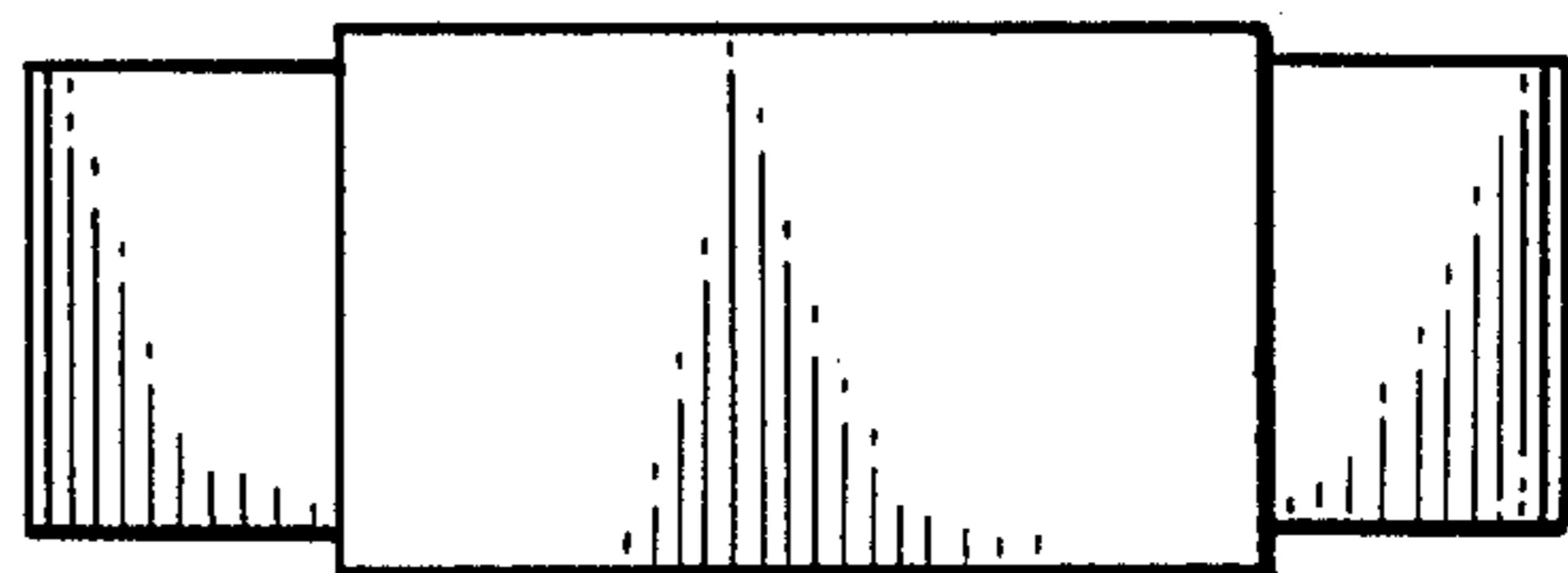
