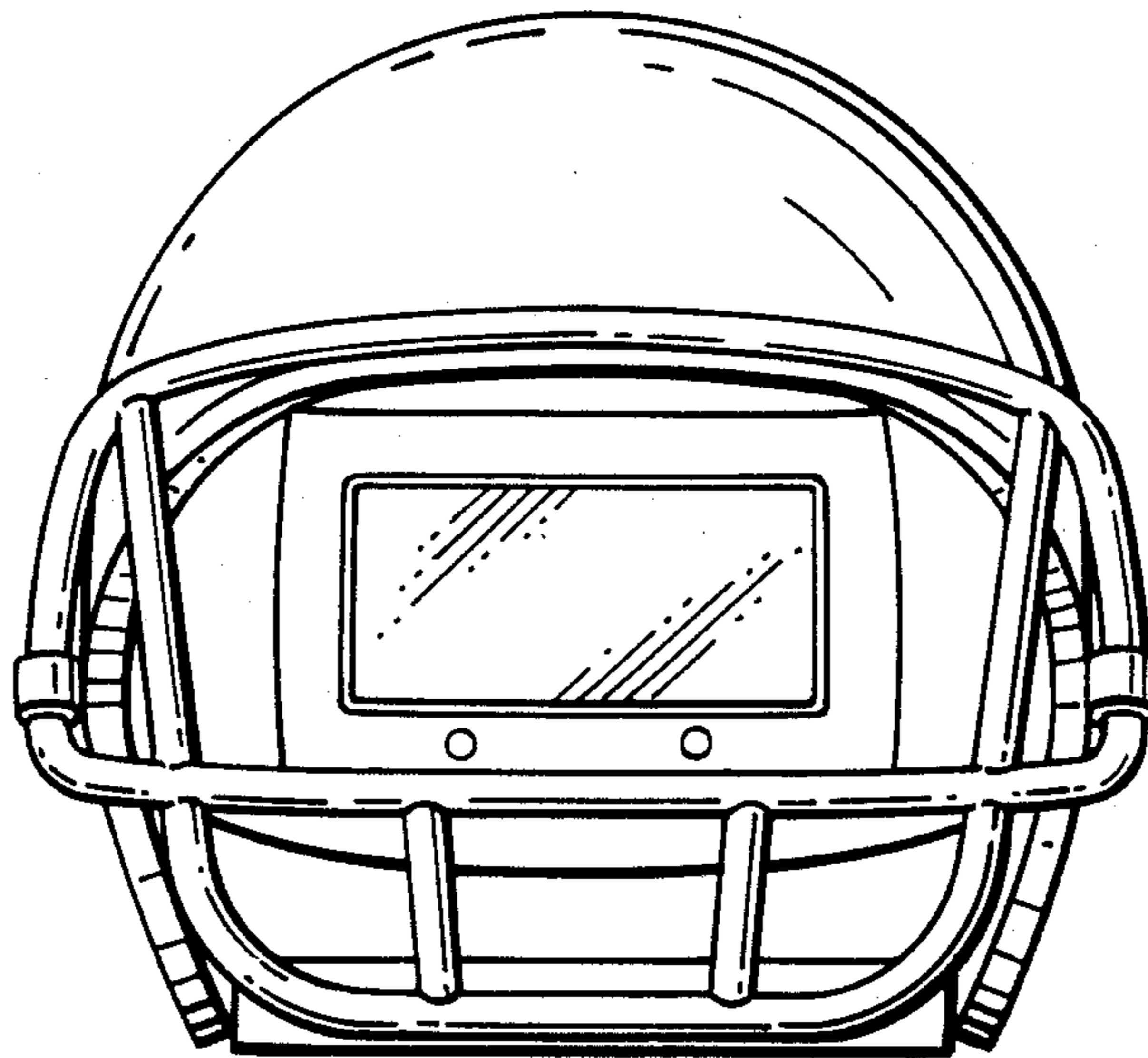
The ornamental design for a simulative clock, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a simulative clock showing my new design, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 1, the bottom base being plain and unornamented.



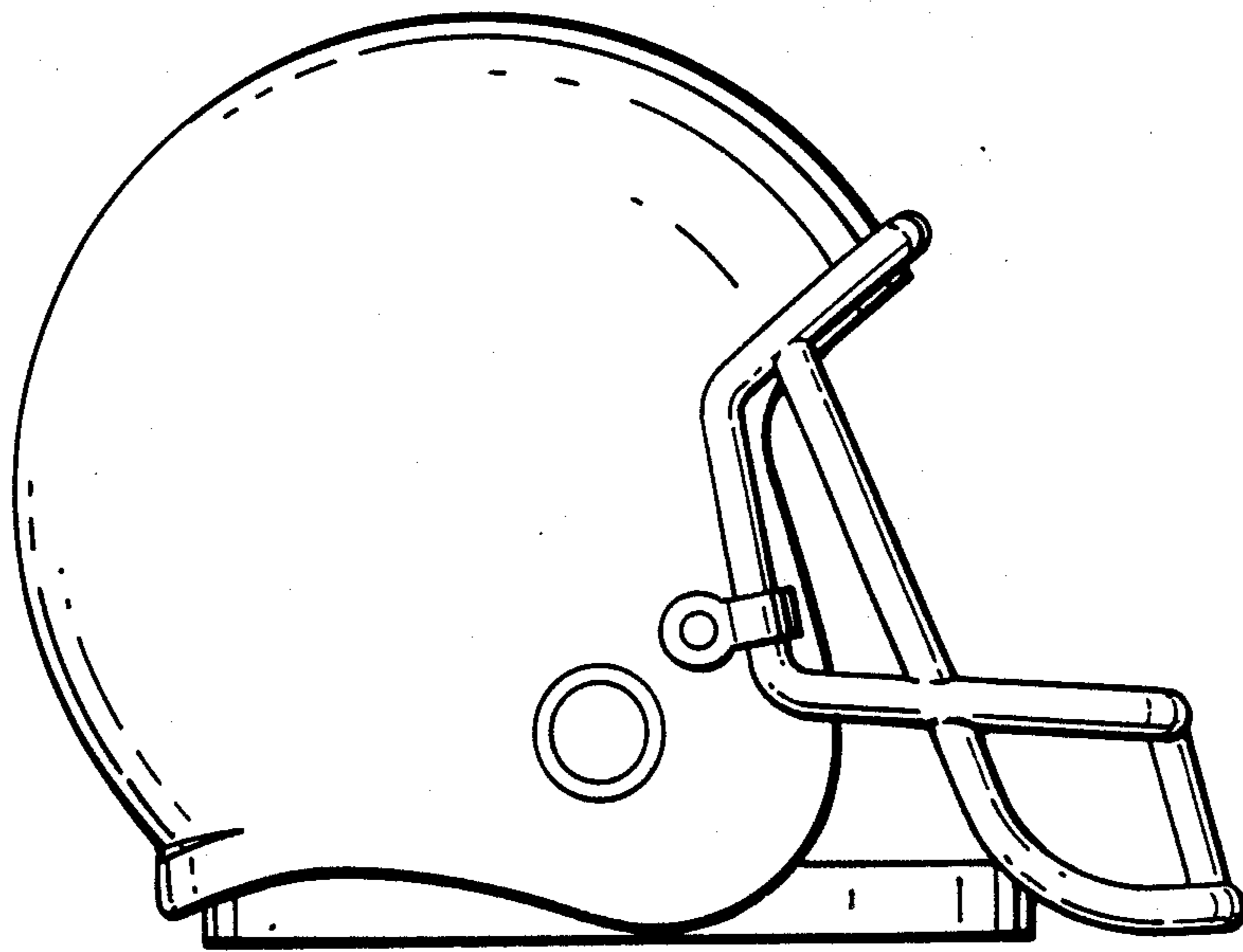

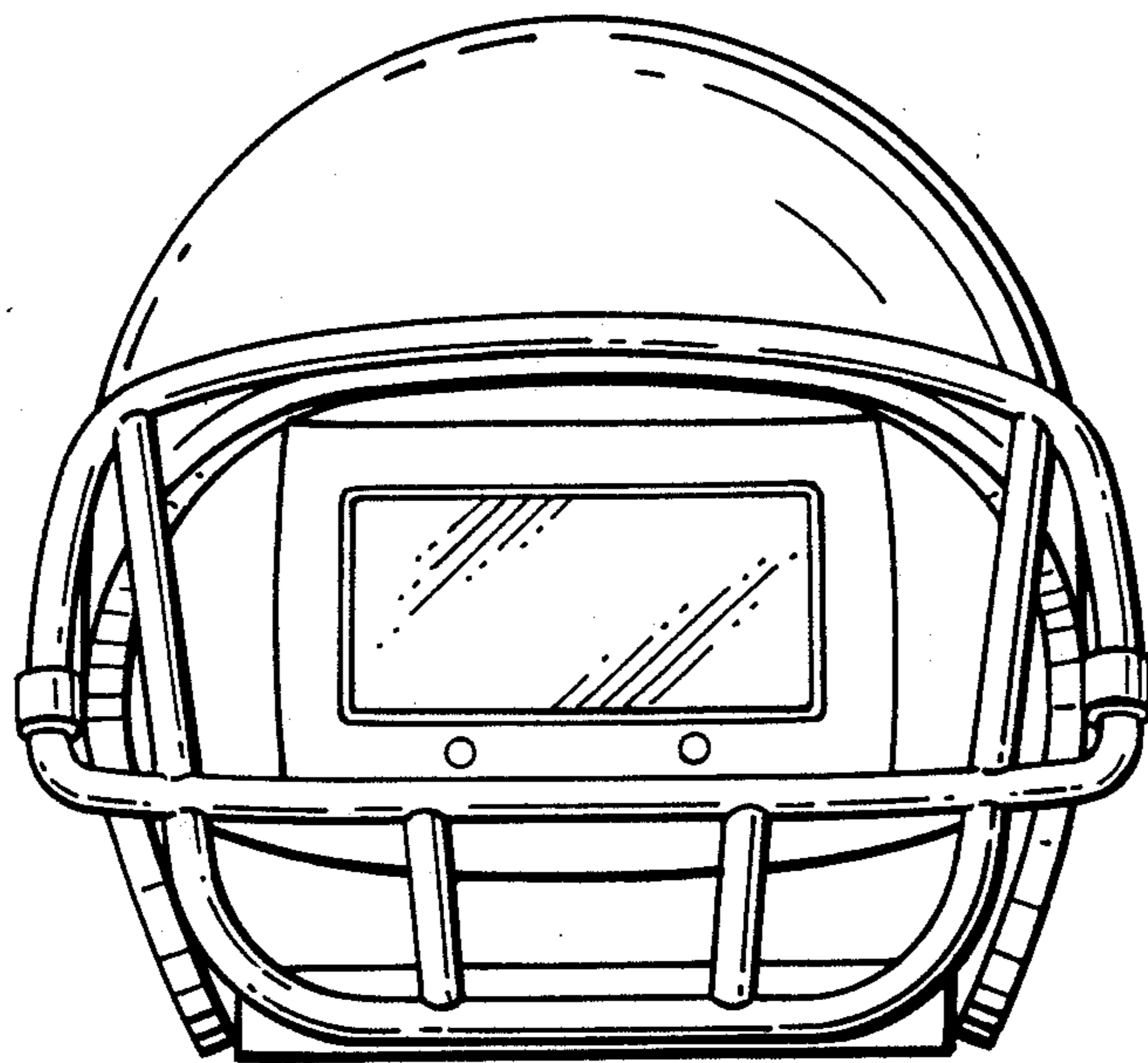
