FIG. 7 is a front and right perspective view thereof.

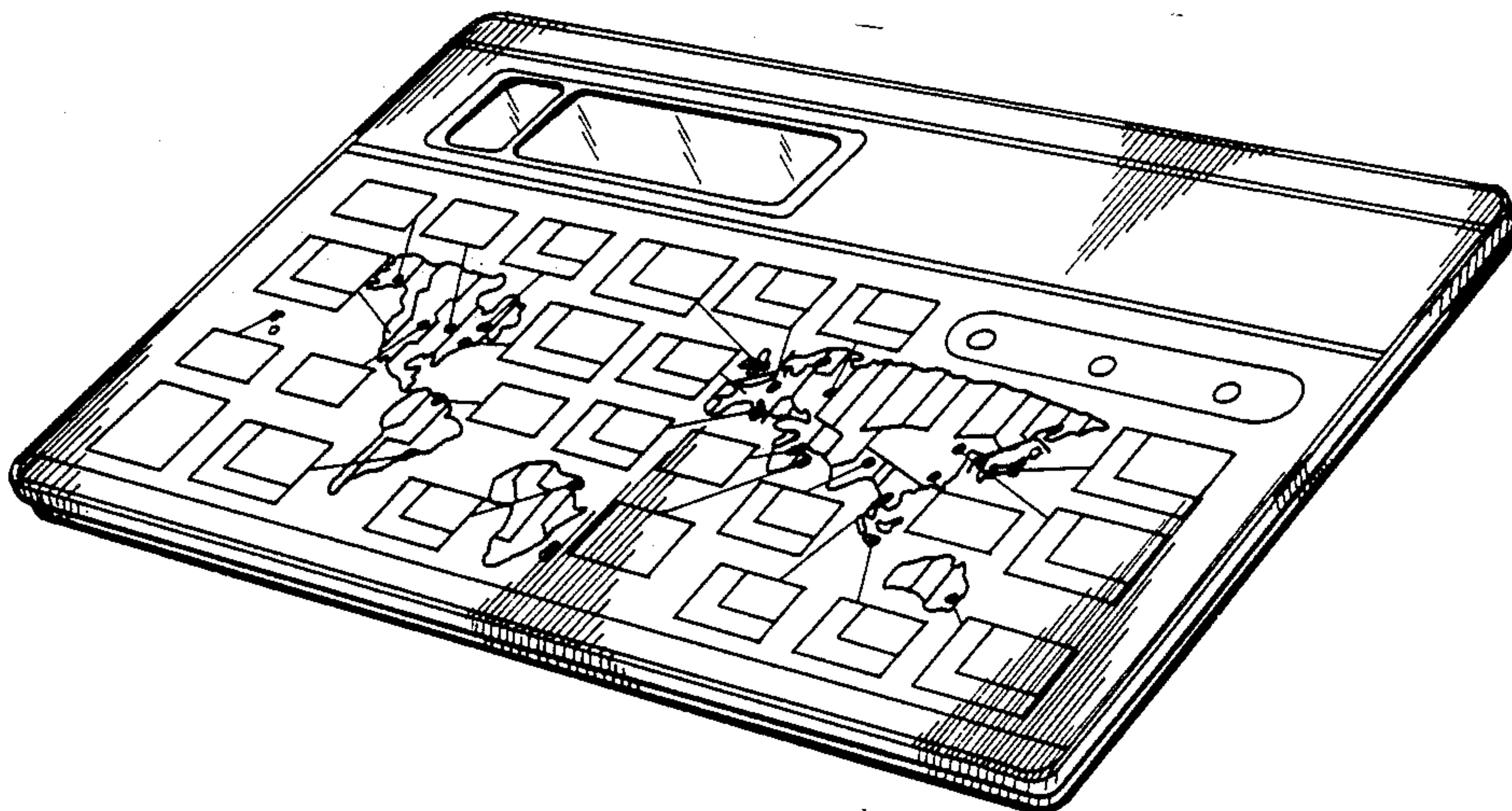

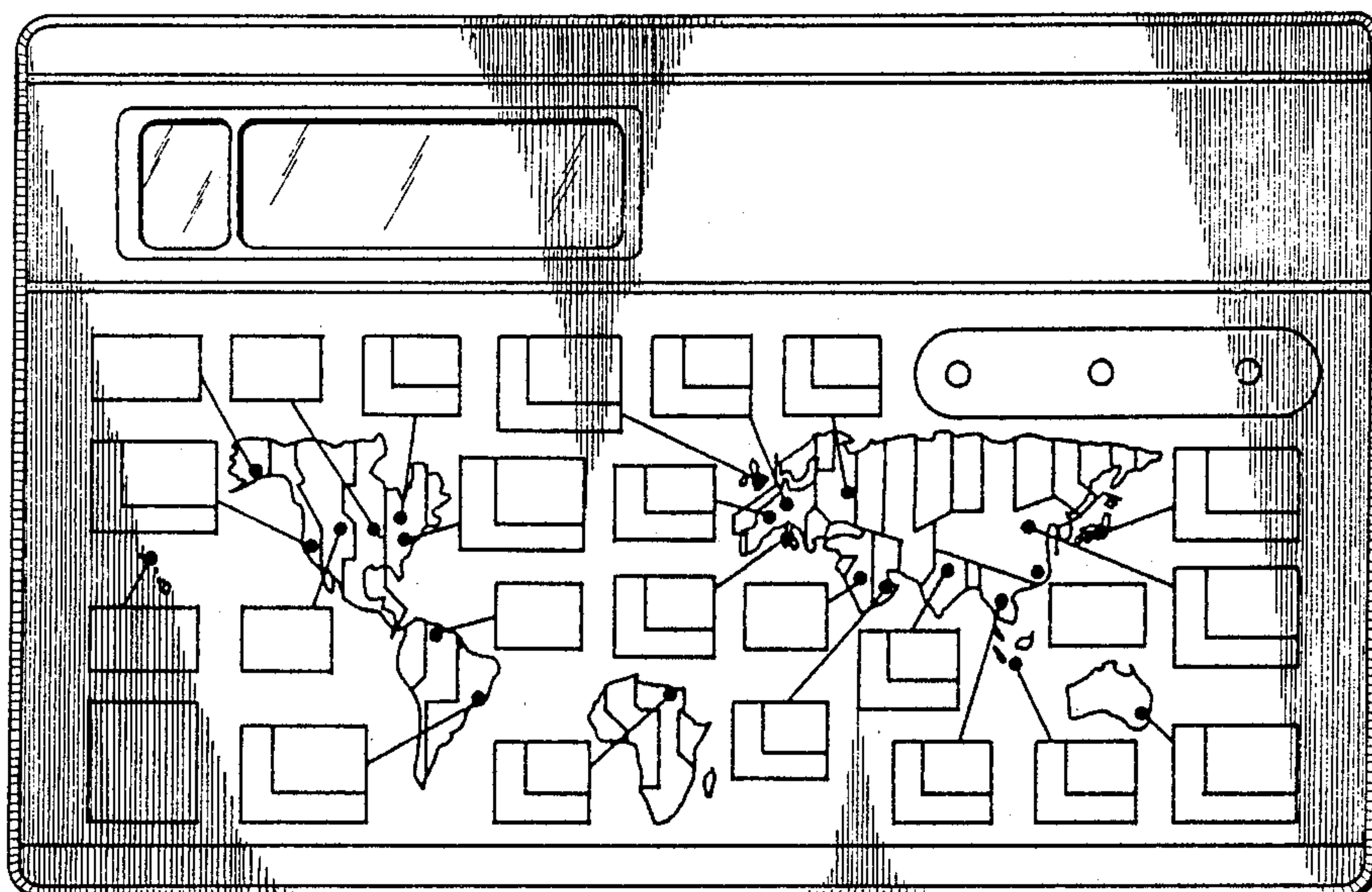

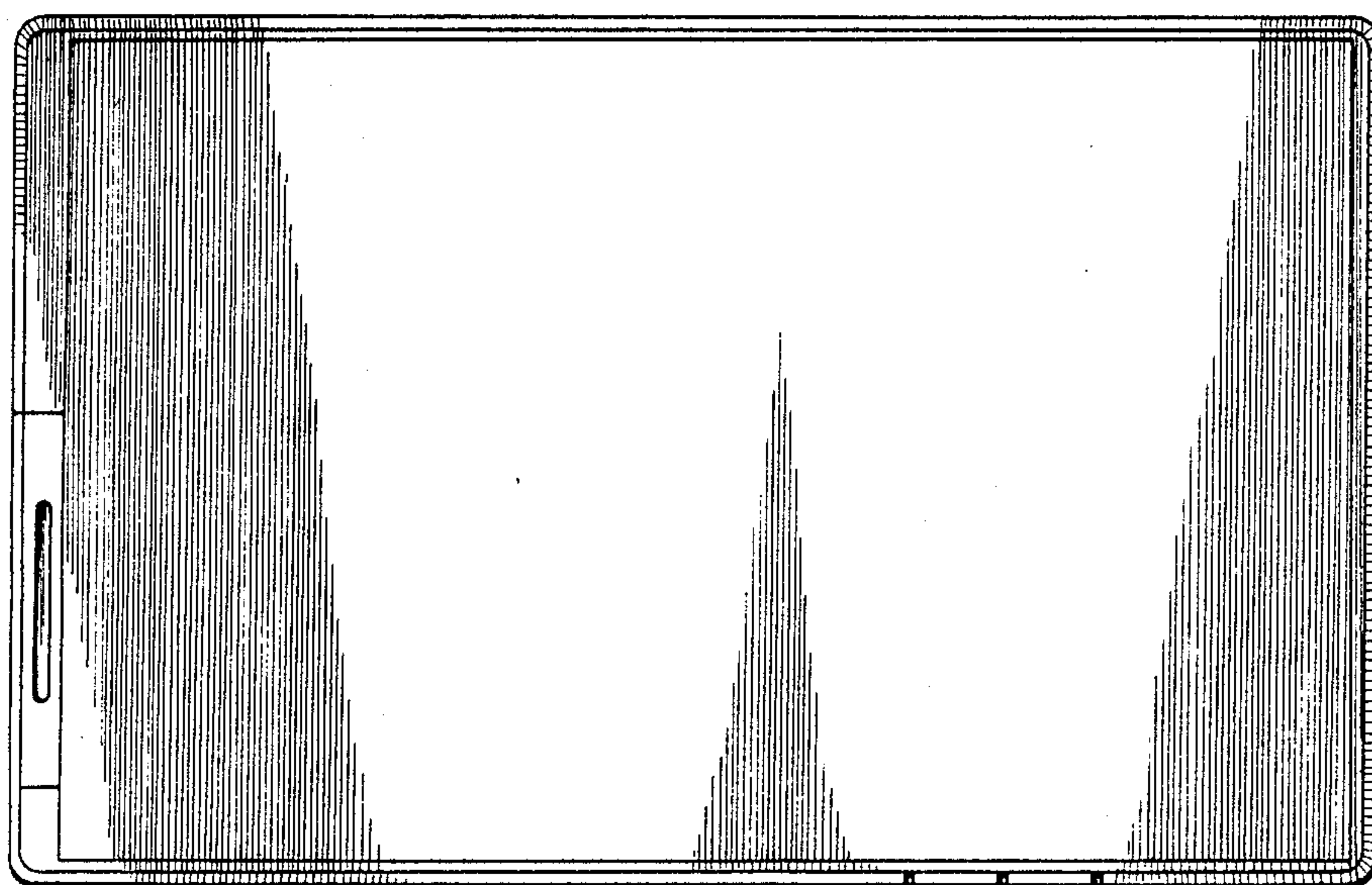

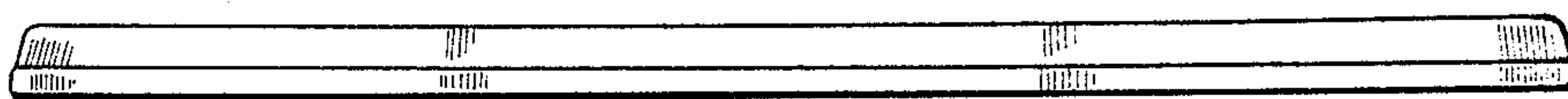
