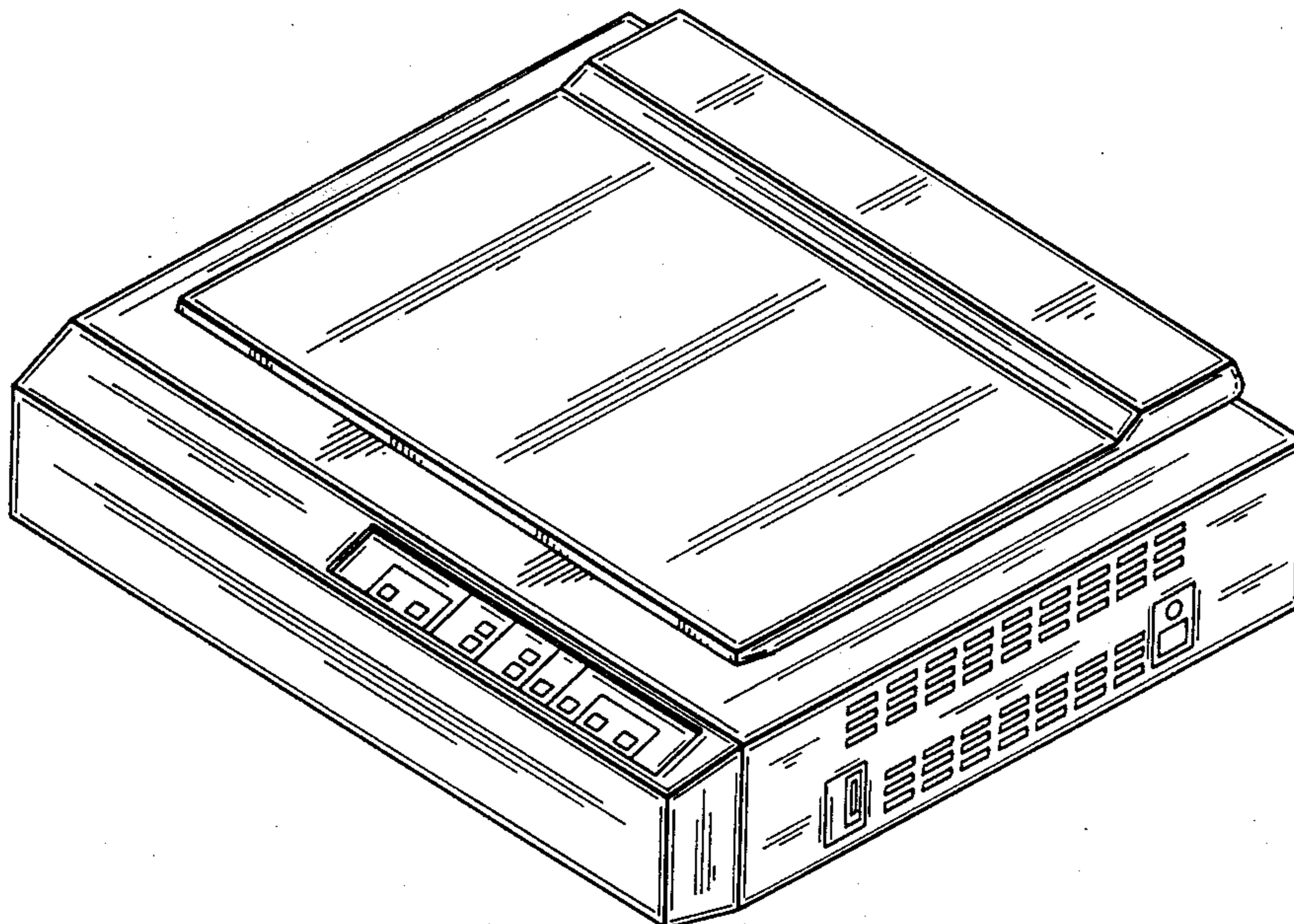

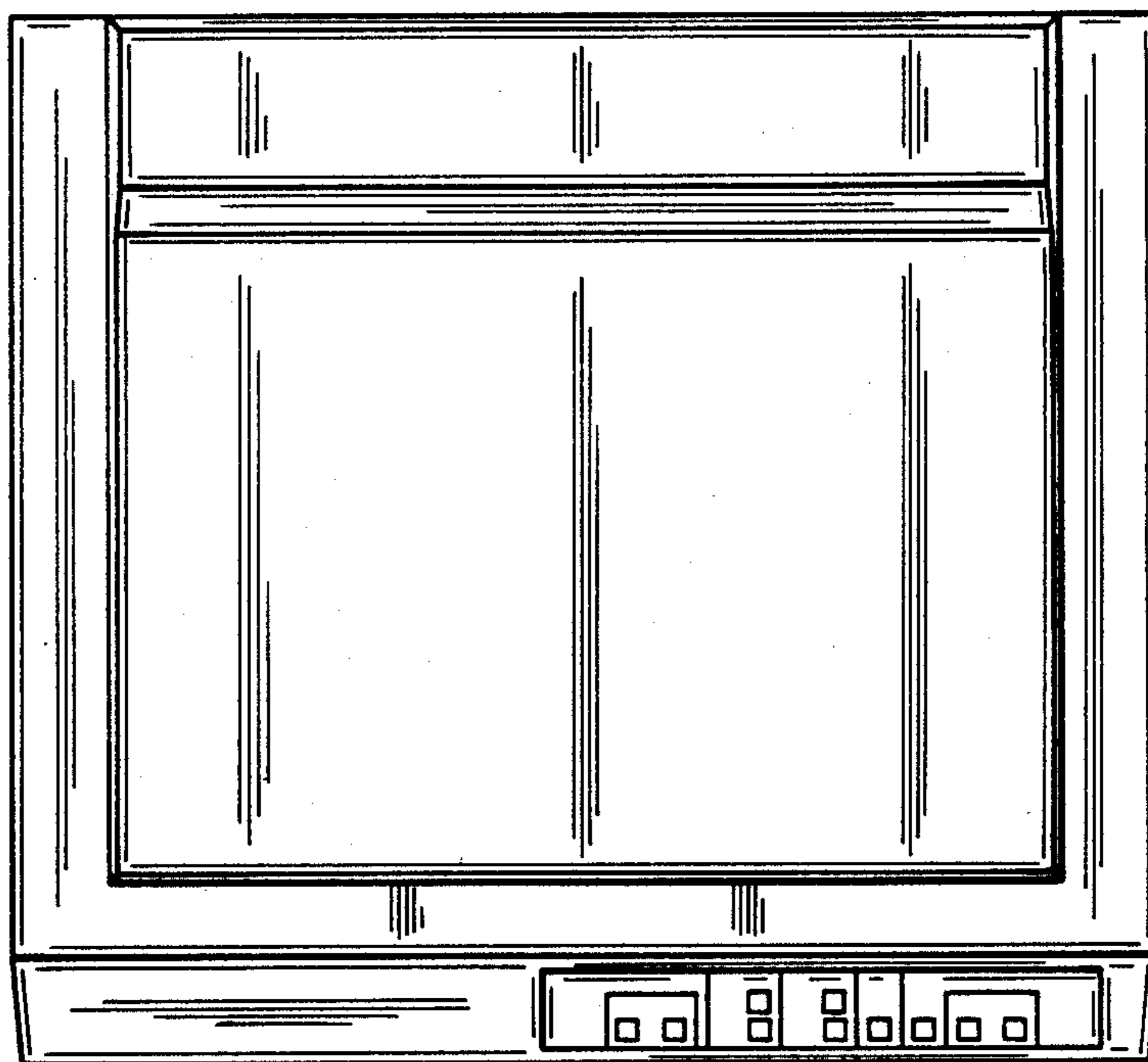
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a reader for electronic filing system, as shown and described.

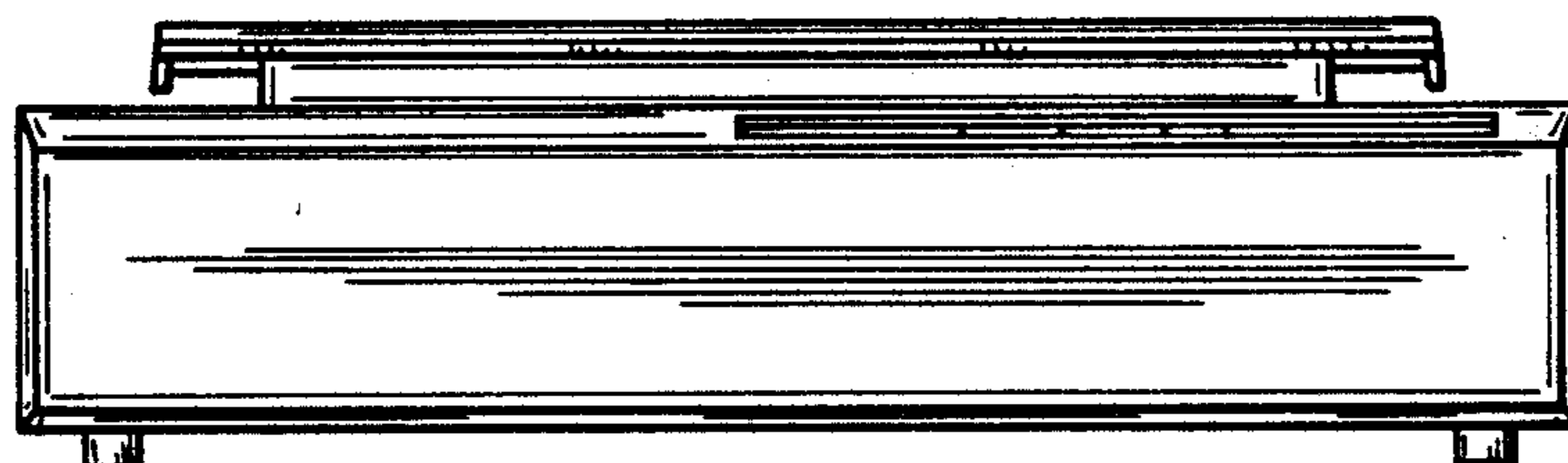
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the reader for electronic filing system showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a top, front, right side perspective view thereof.

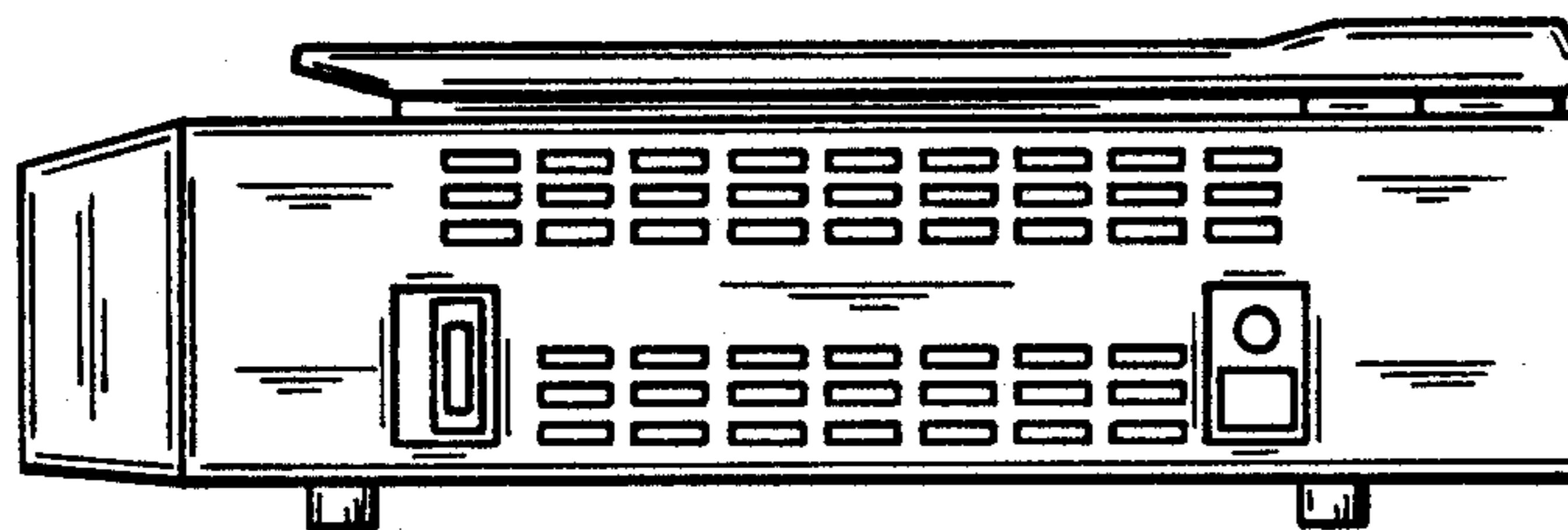




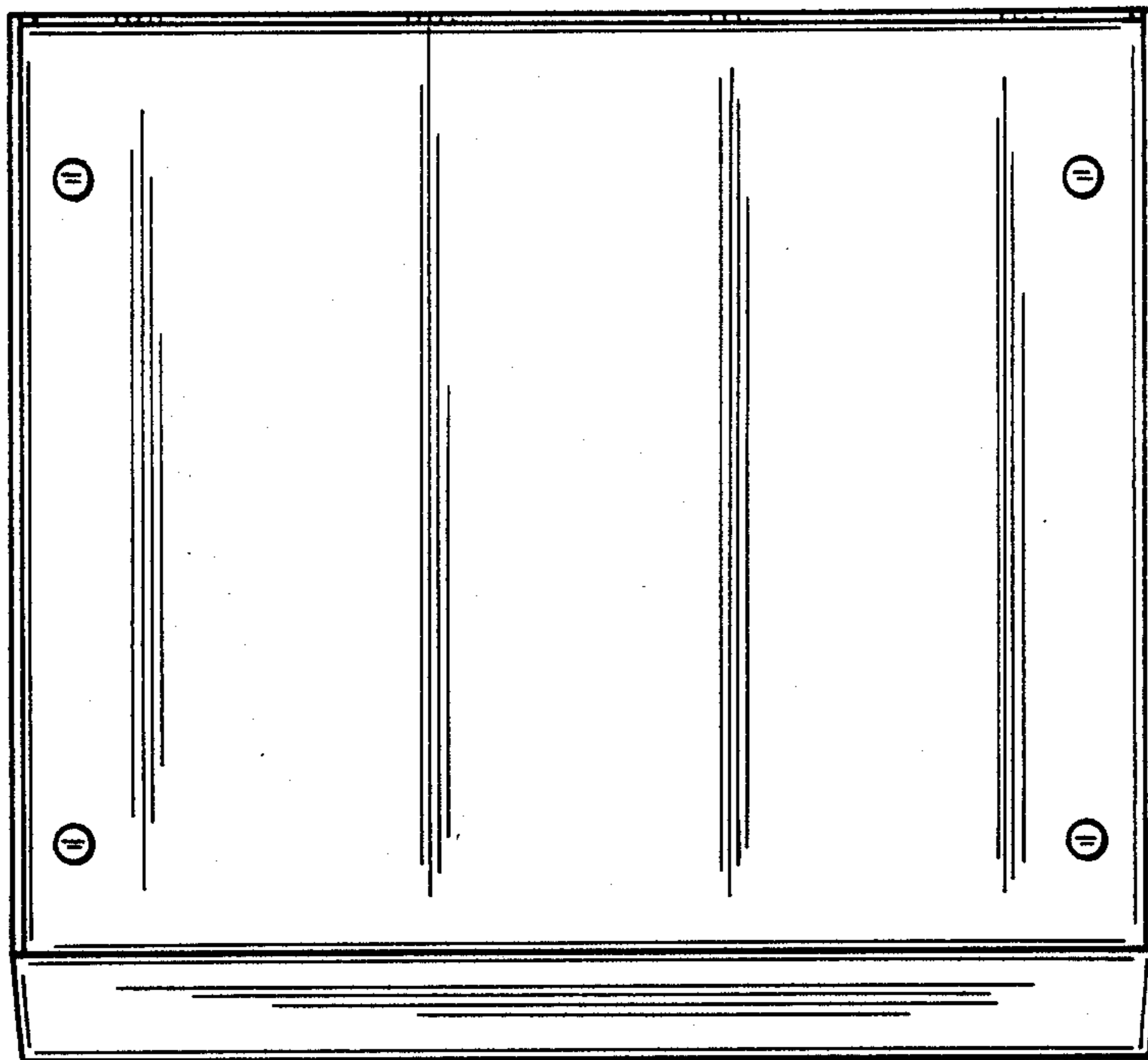

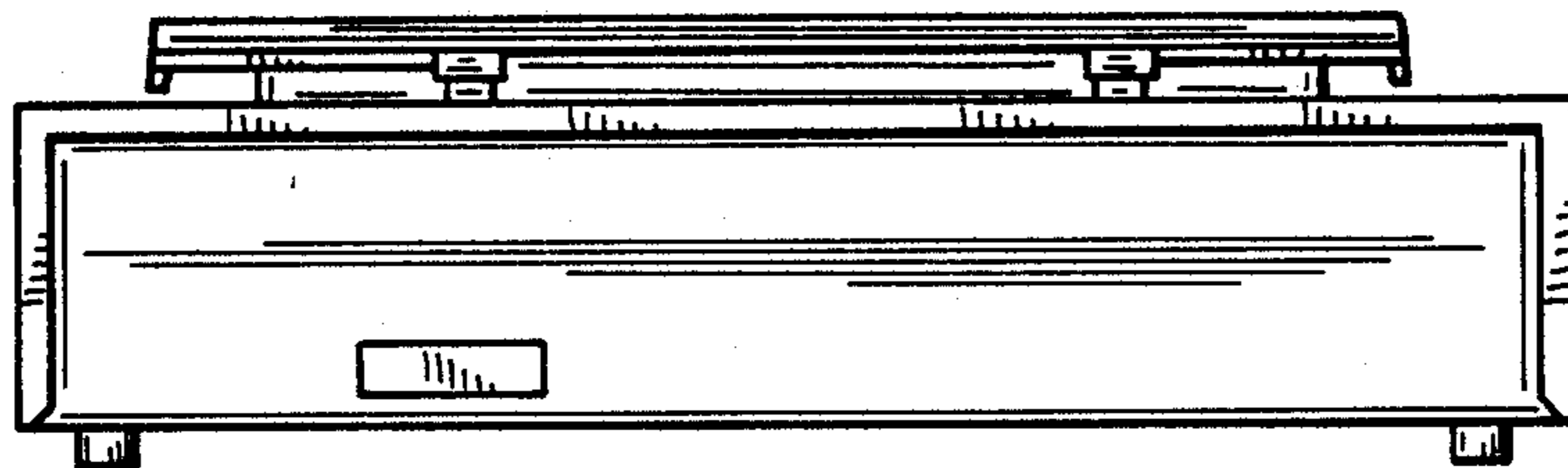

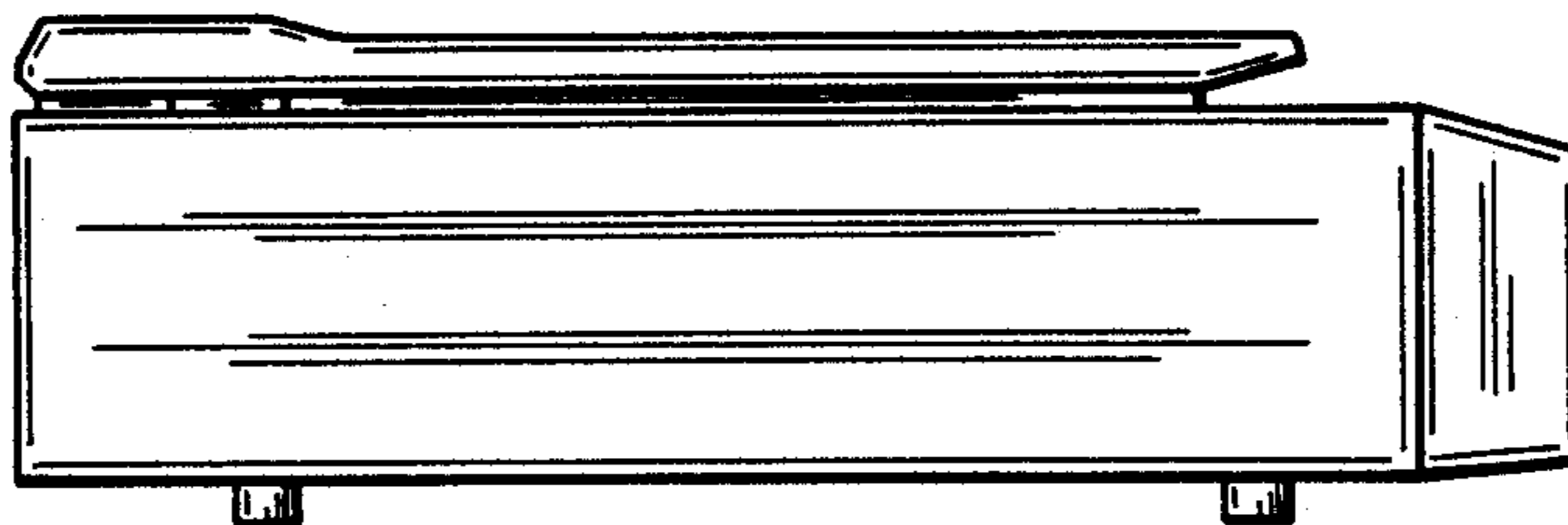

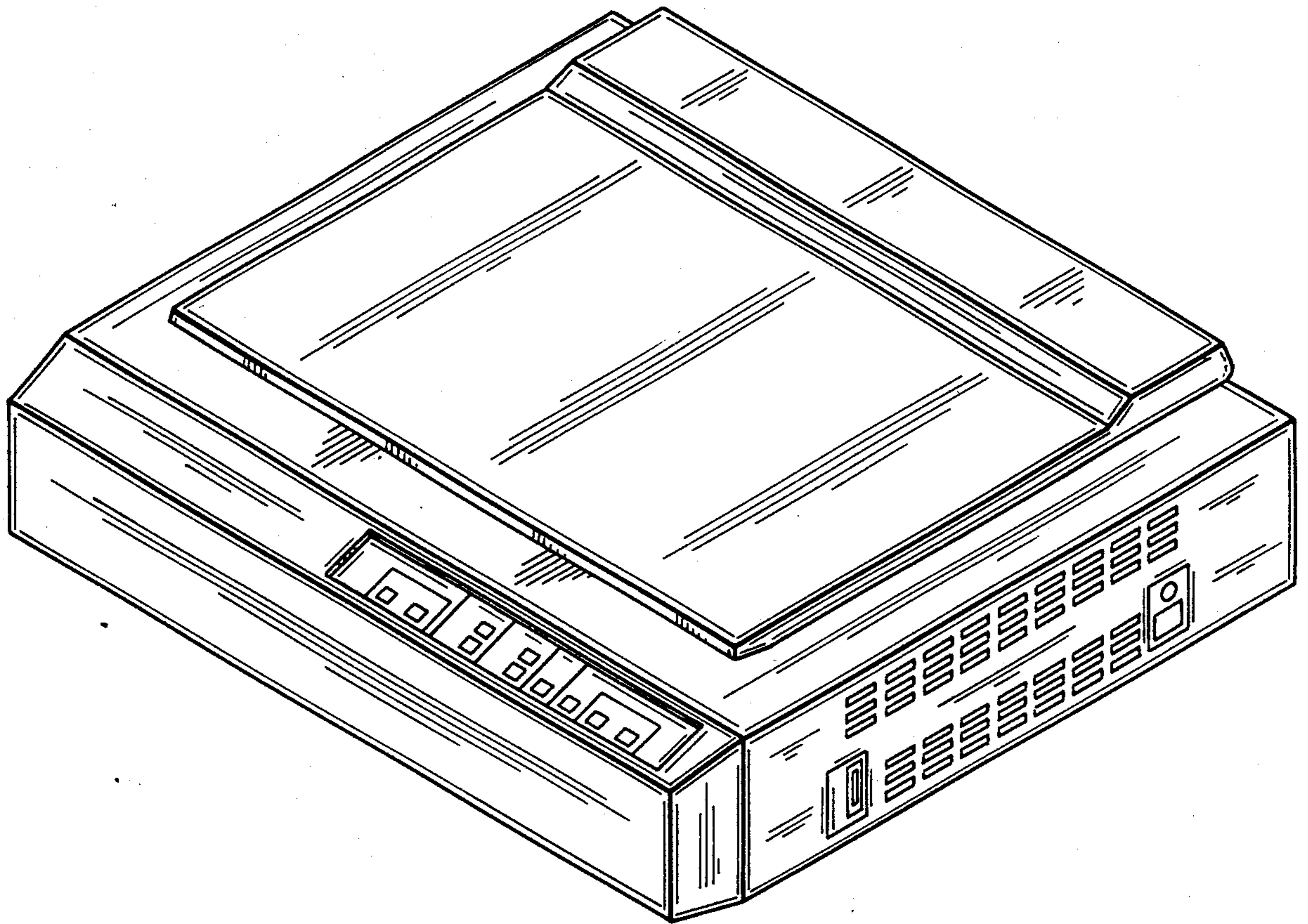
