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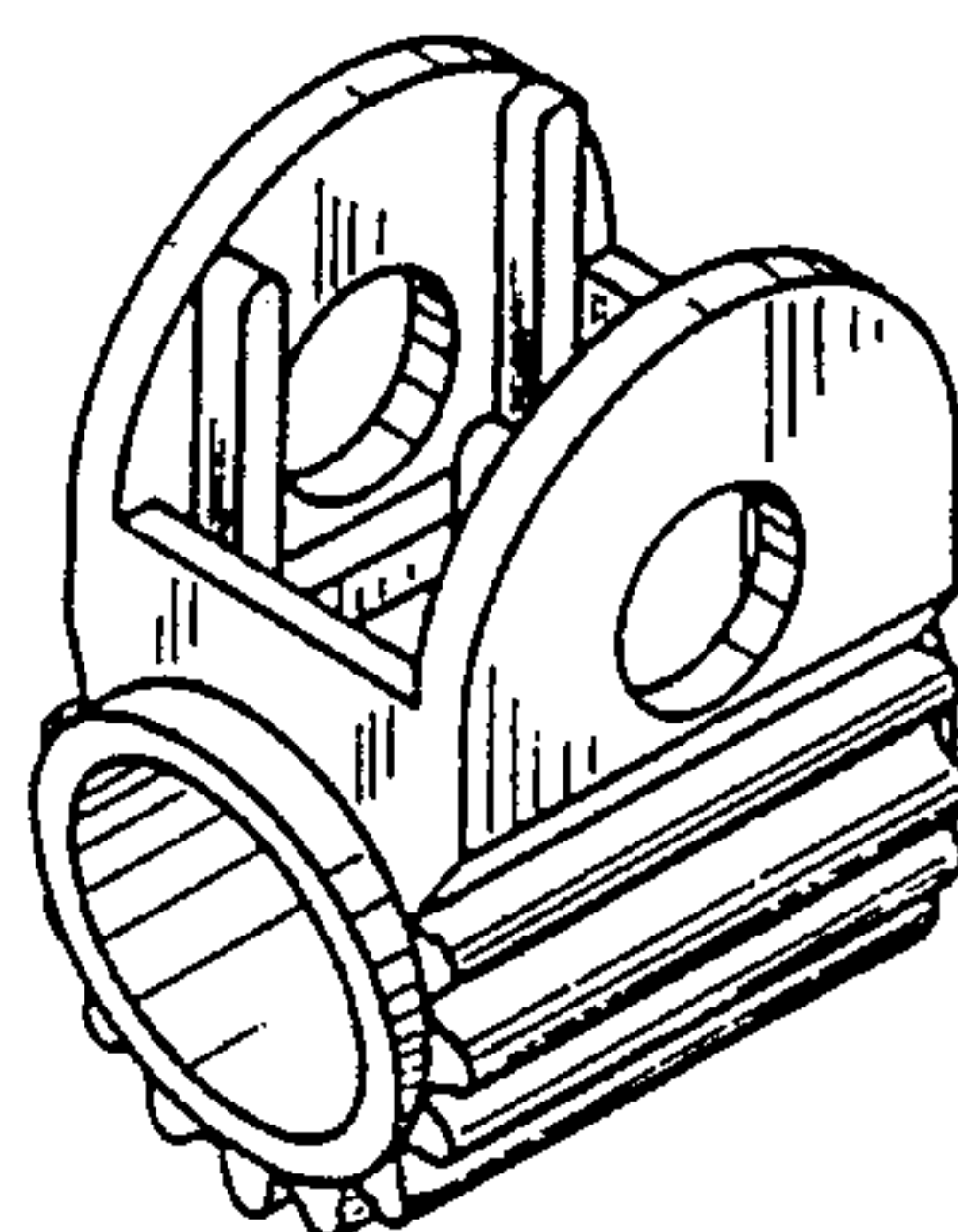
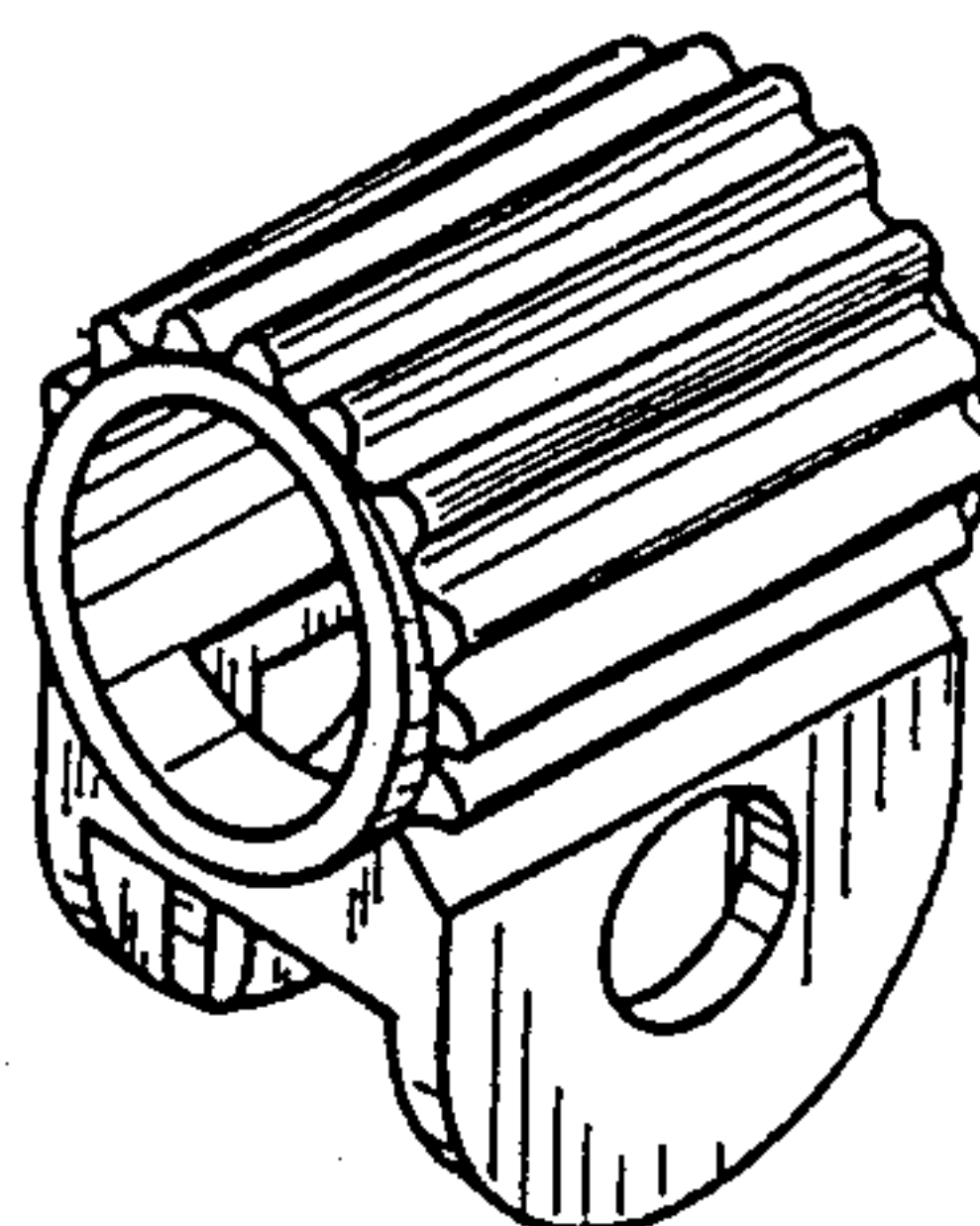

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toy steering gear rod bearing showing my new design,

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



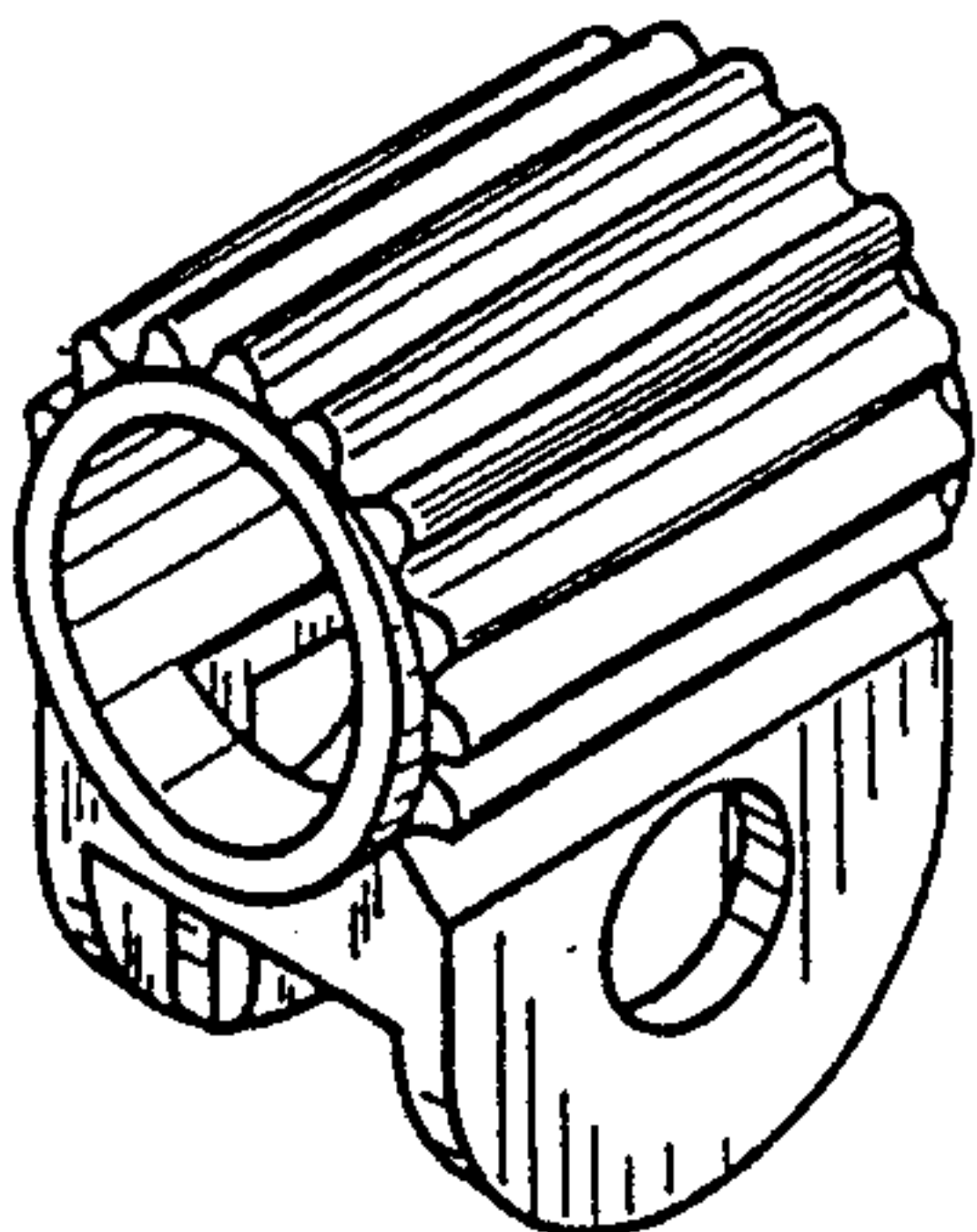

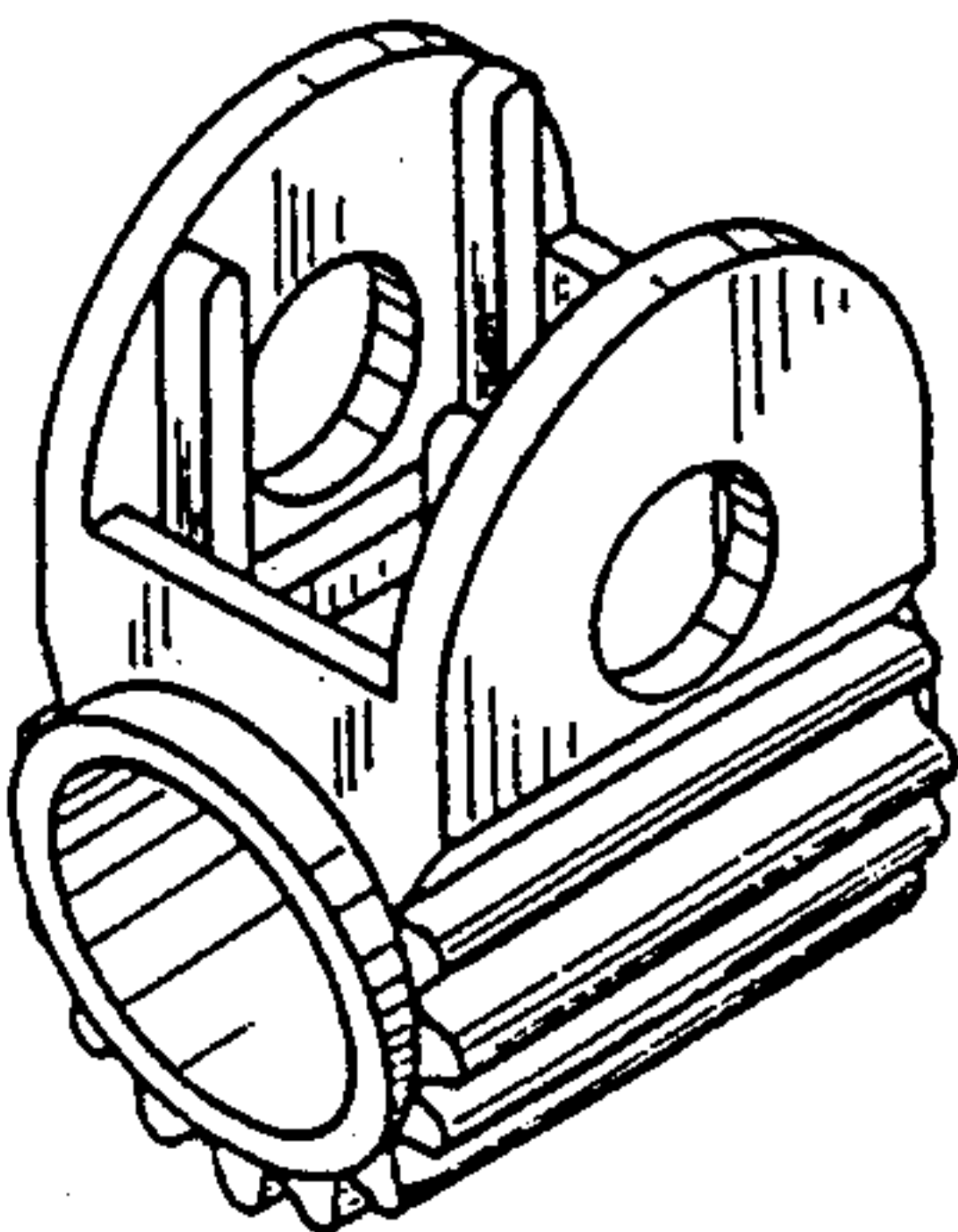

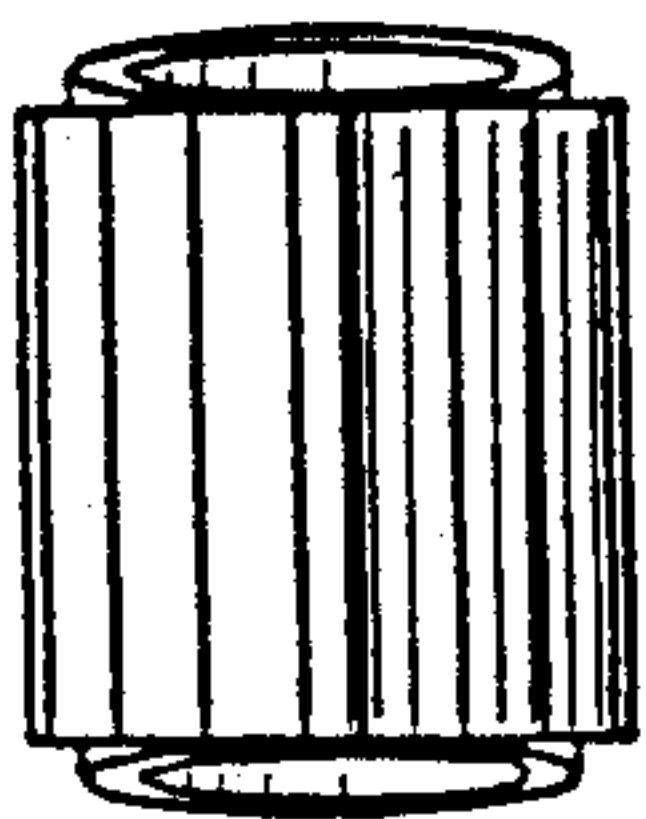

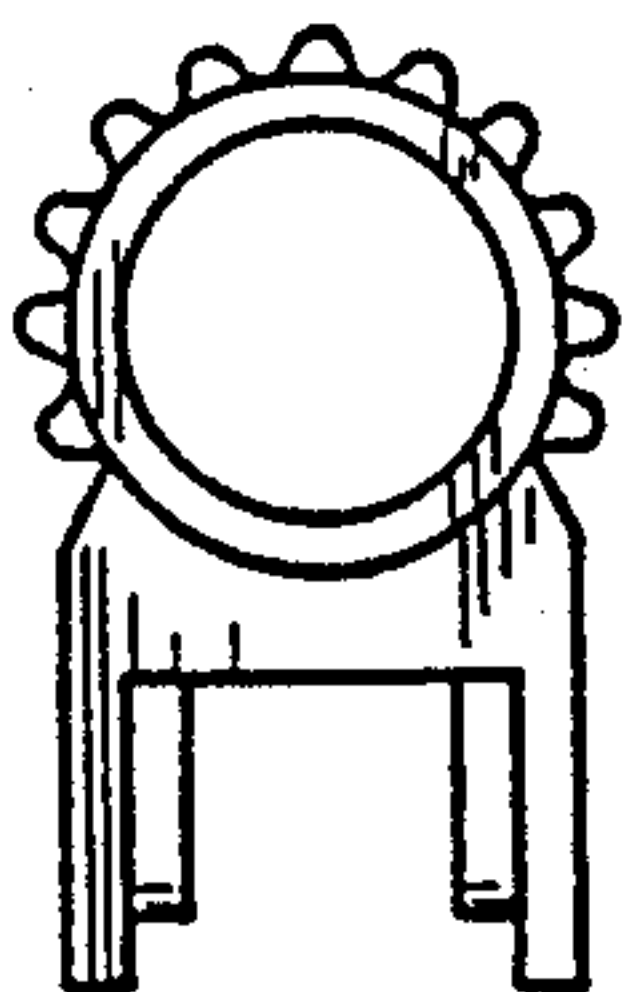

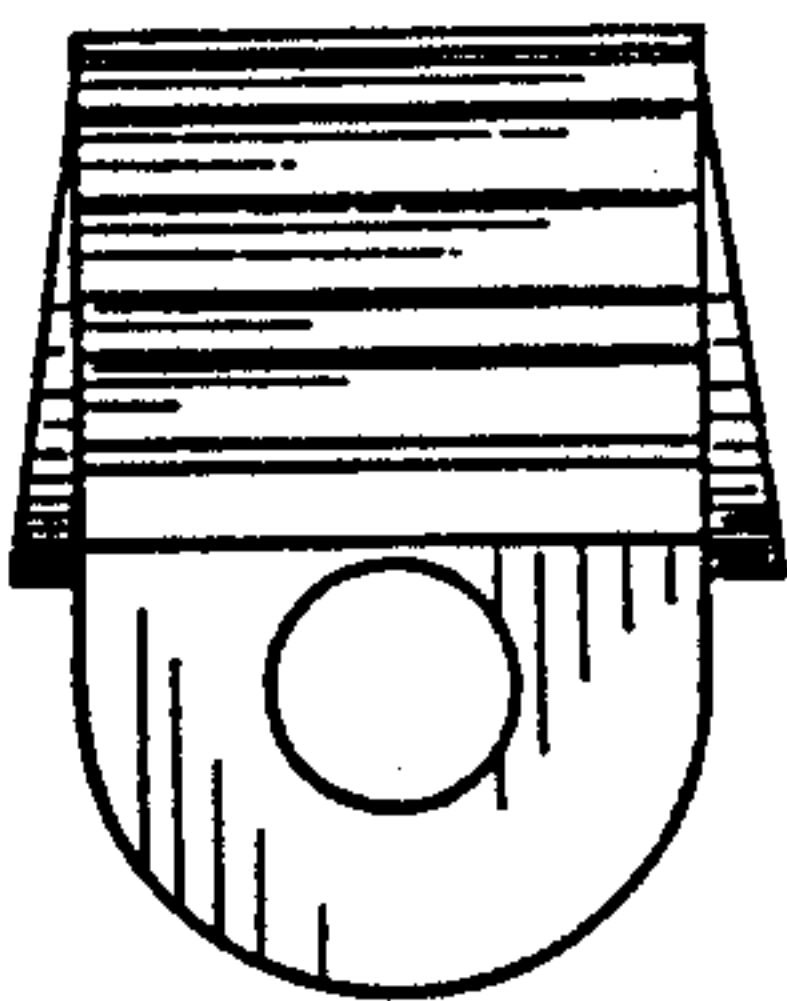

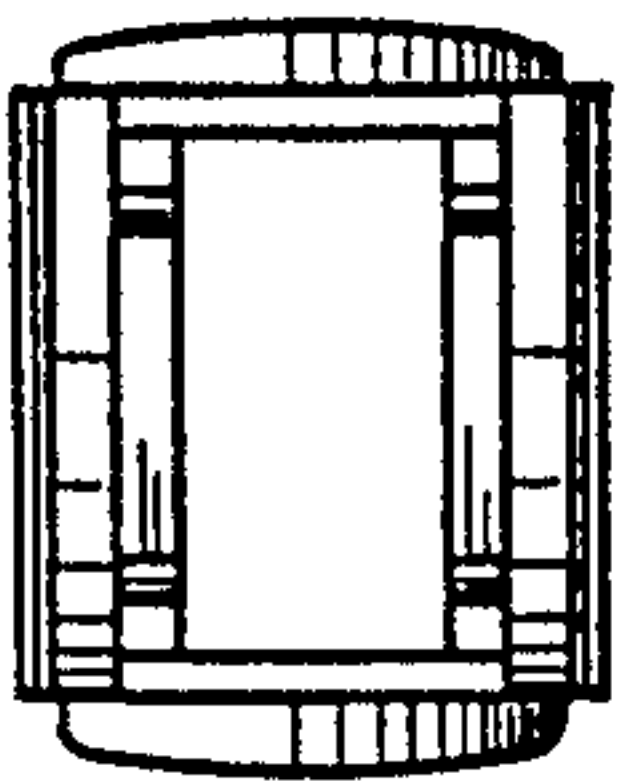
