FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof, taken in the direction of line 5—5 of FIG. 3;

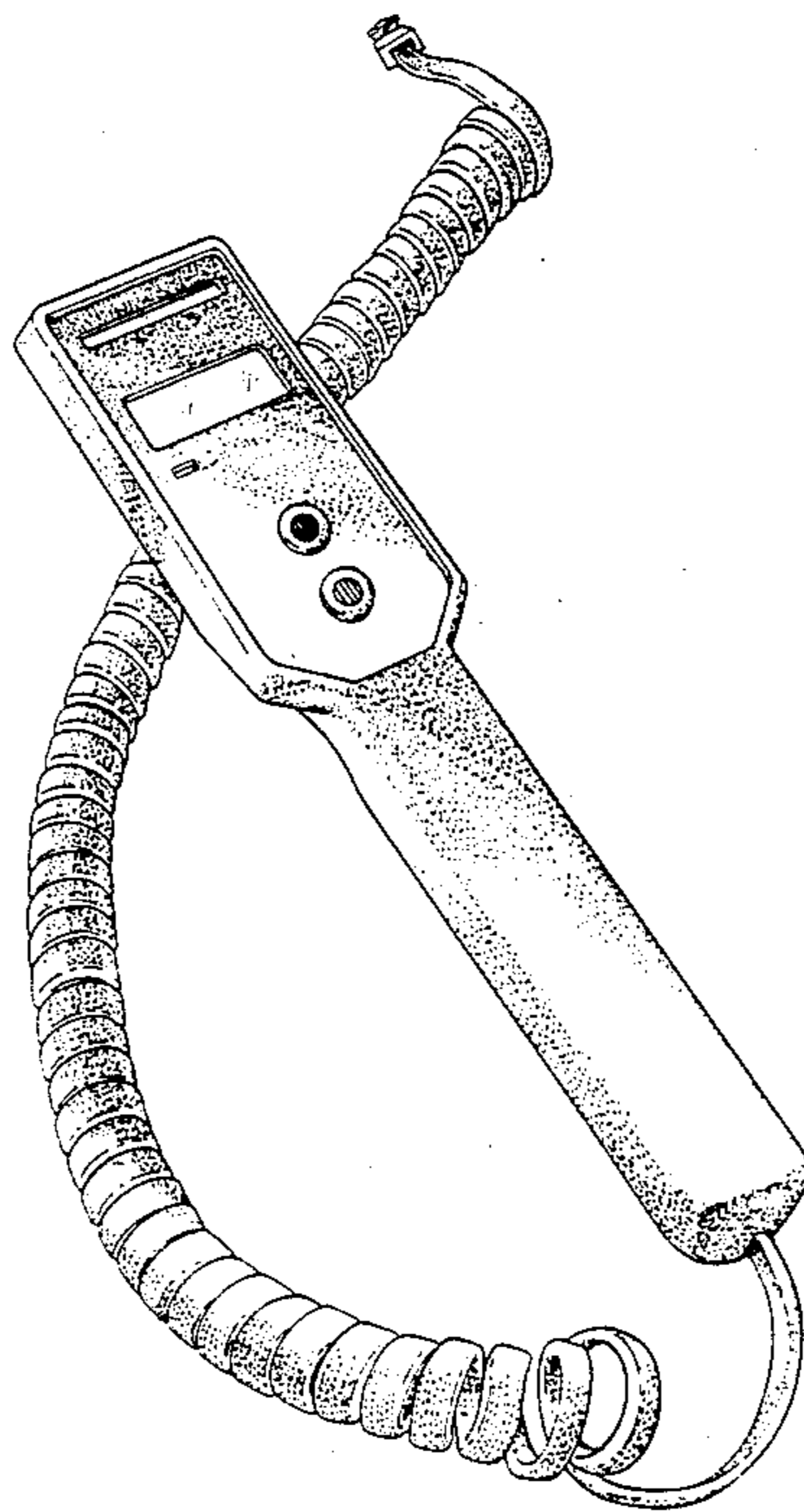
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

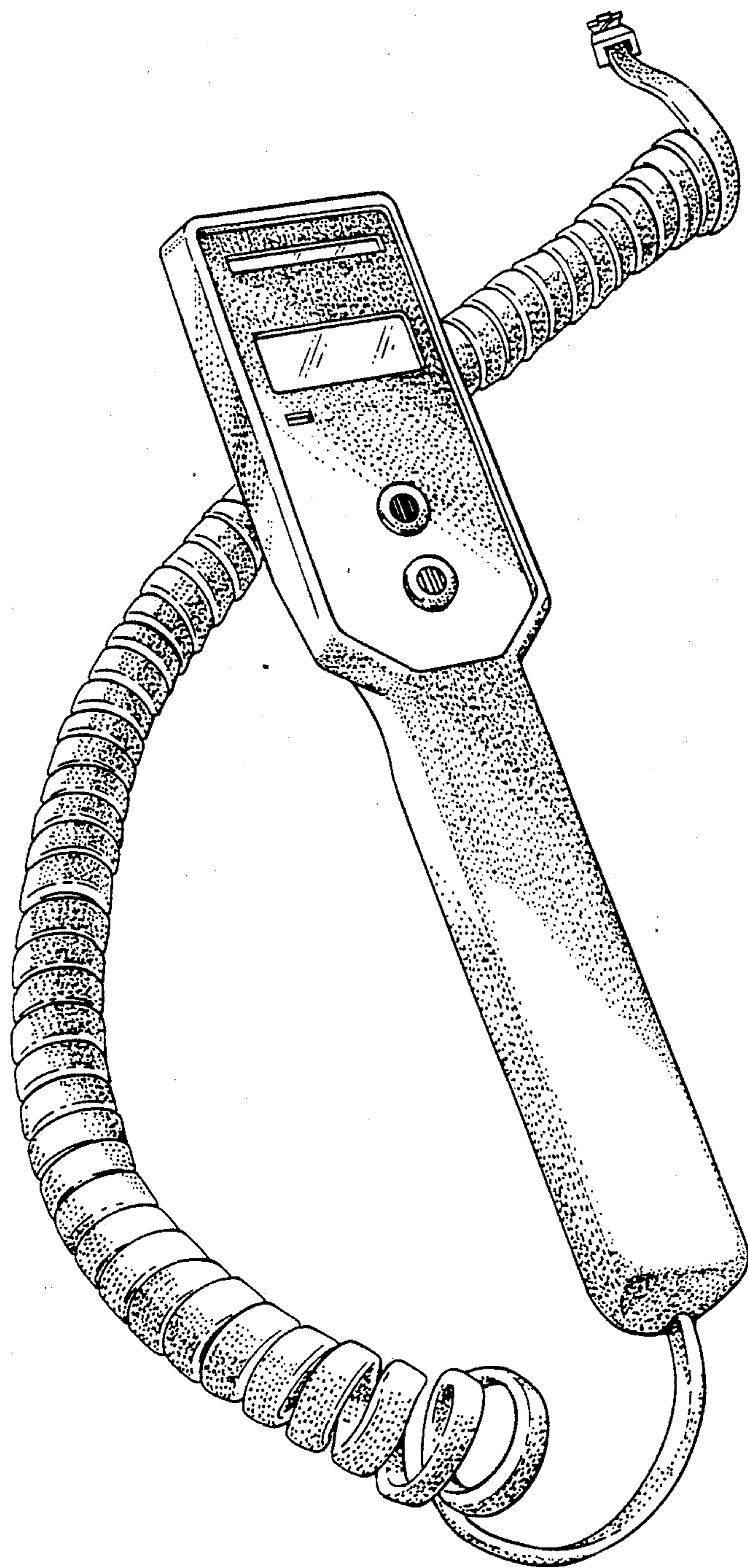

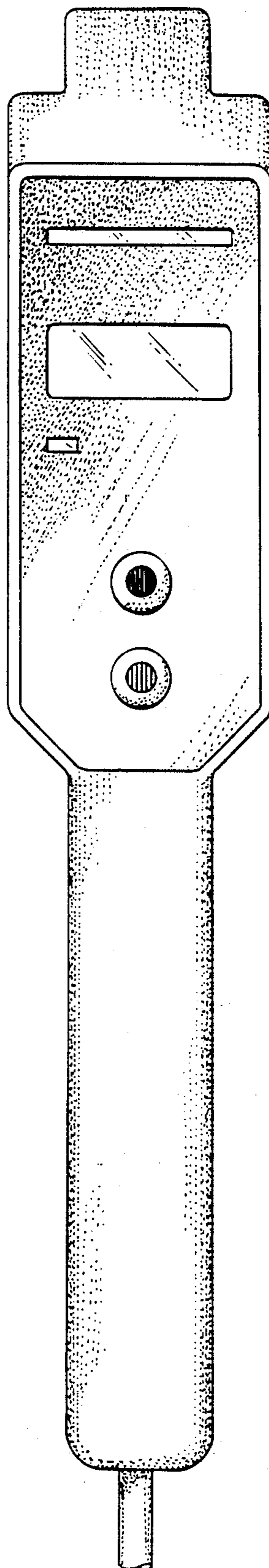

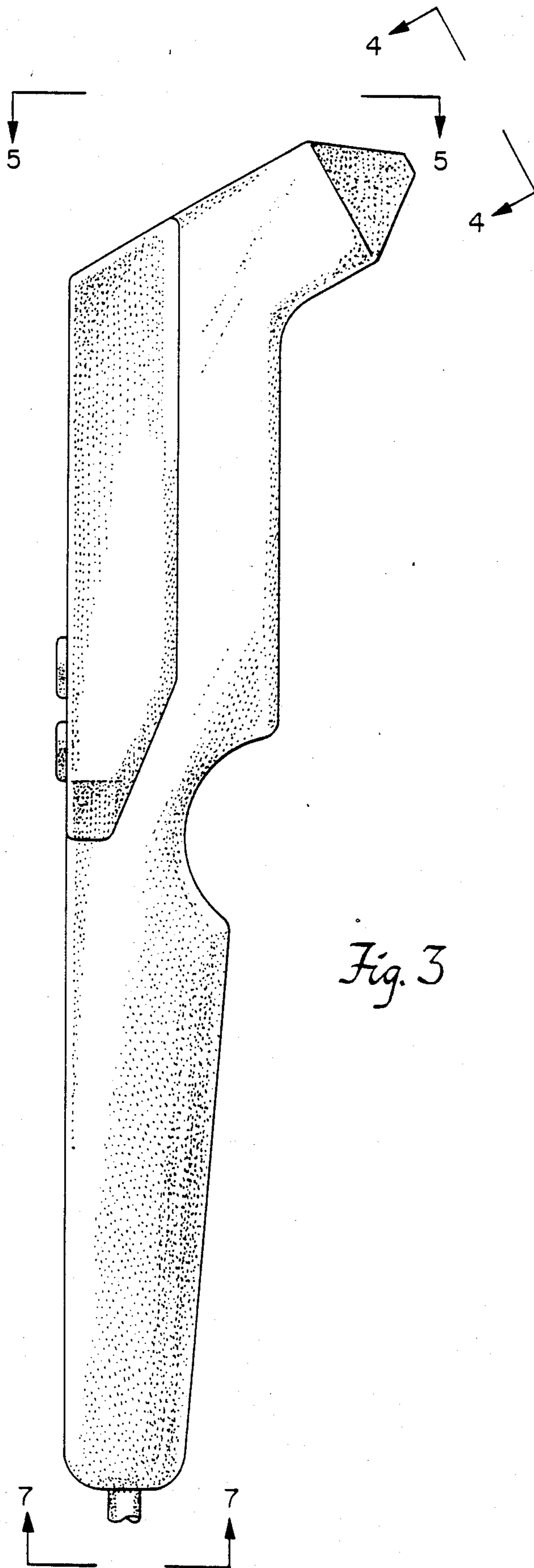

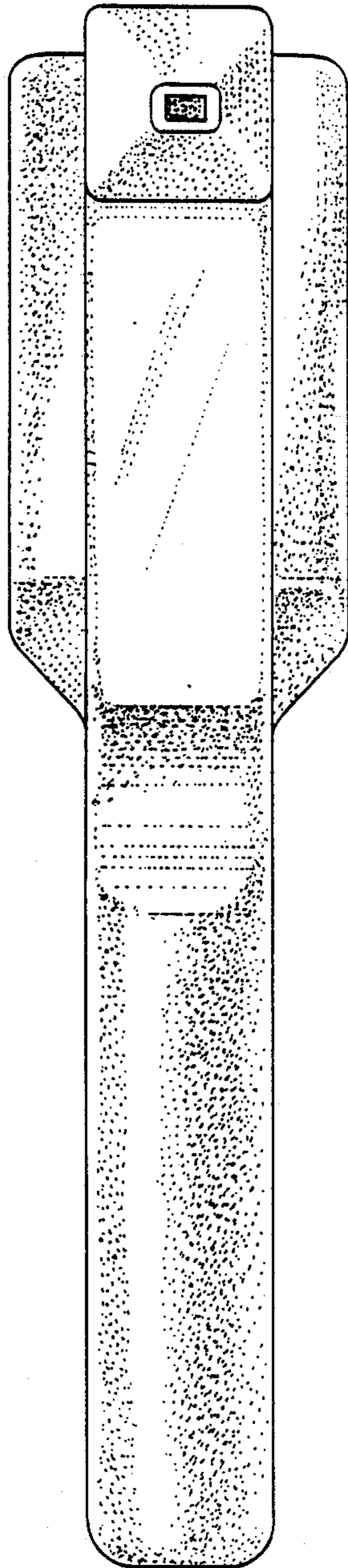

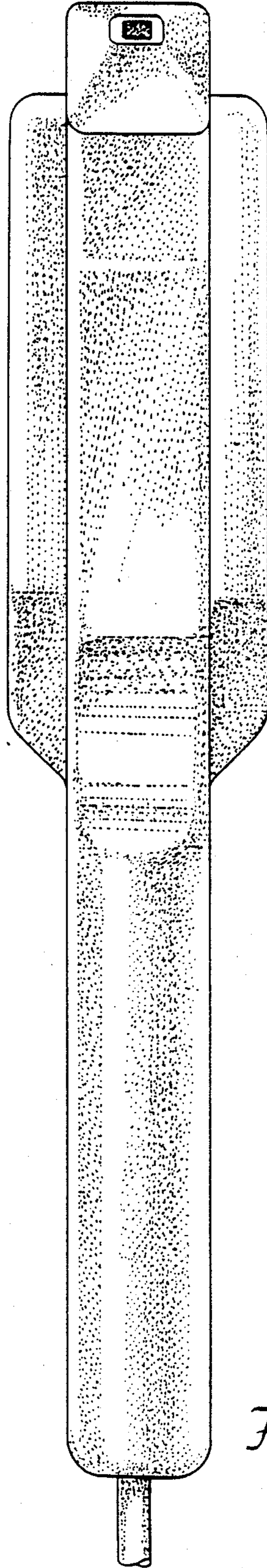

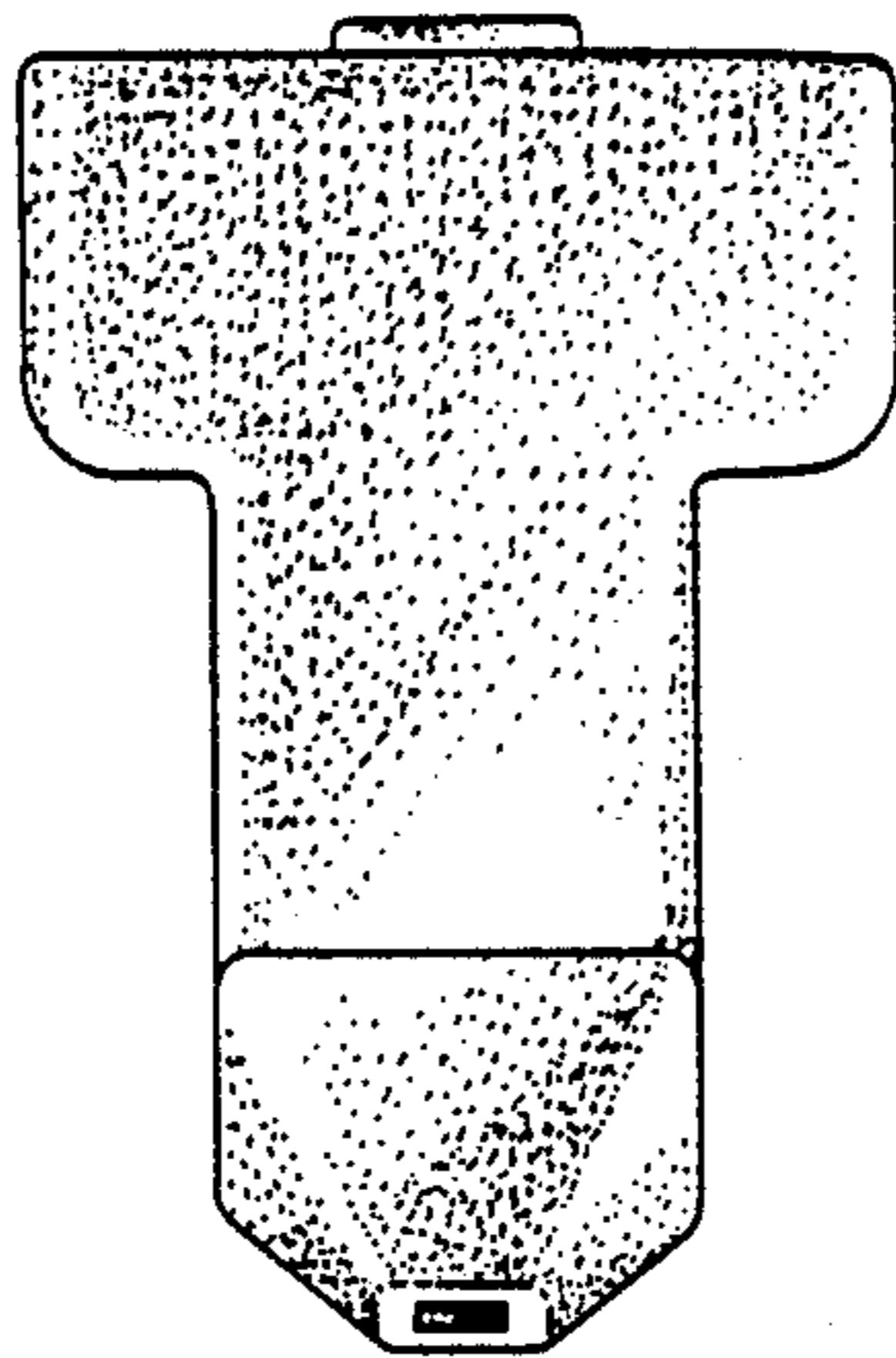

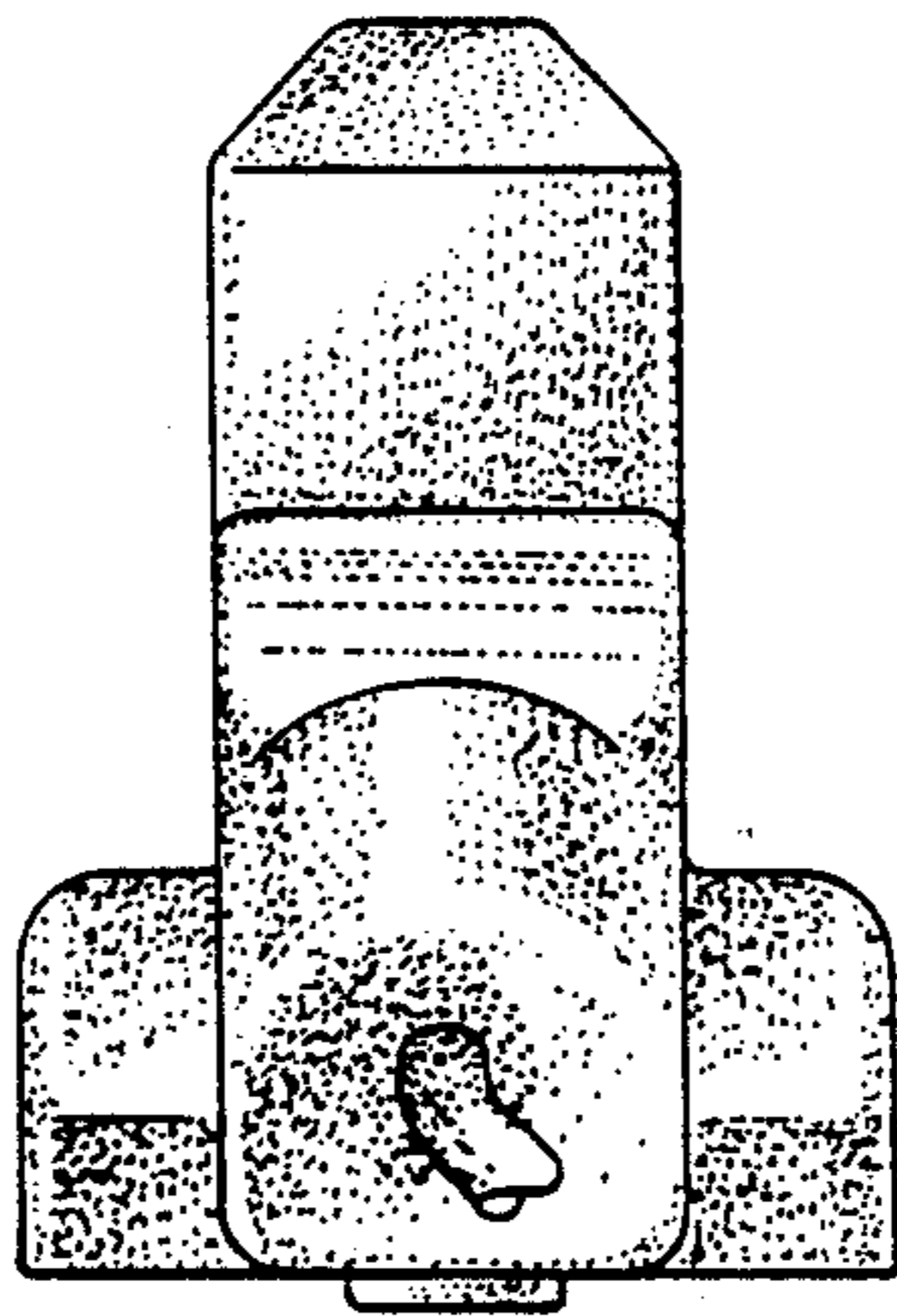

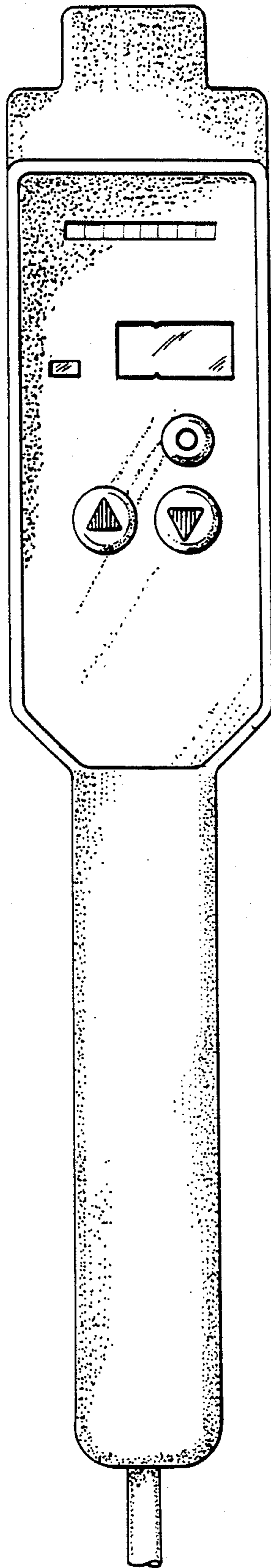
