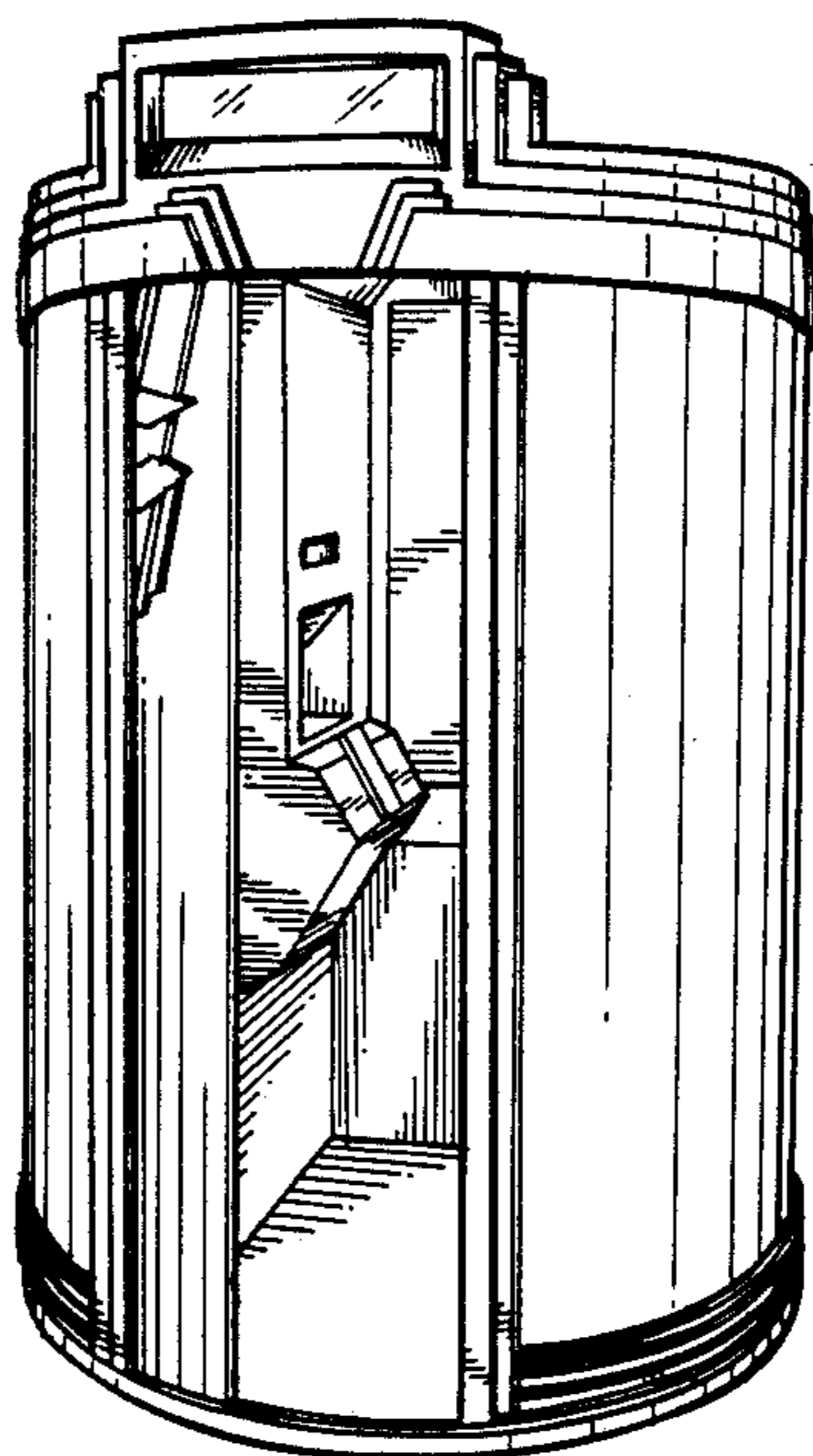
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the design.

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view with door closed.



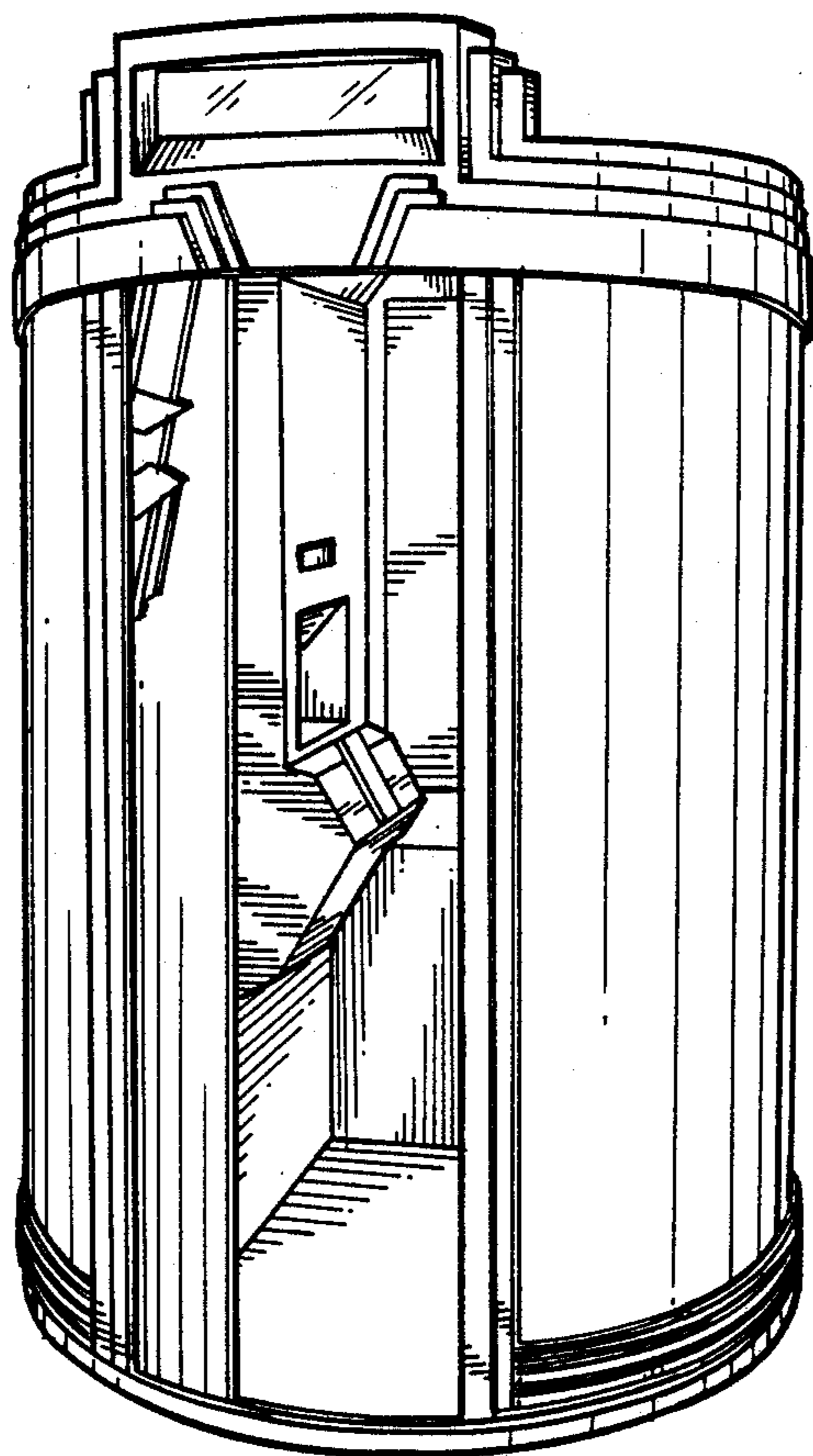

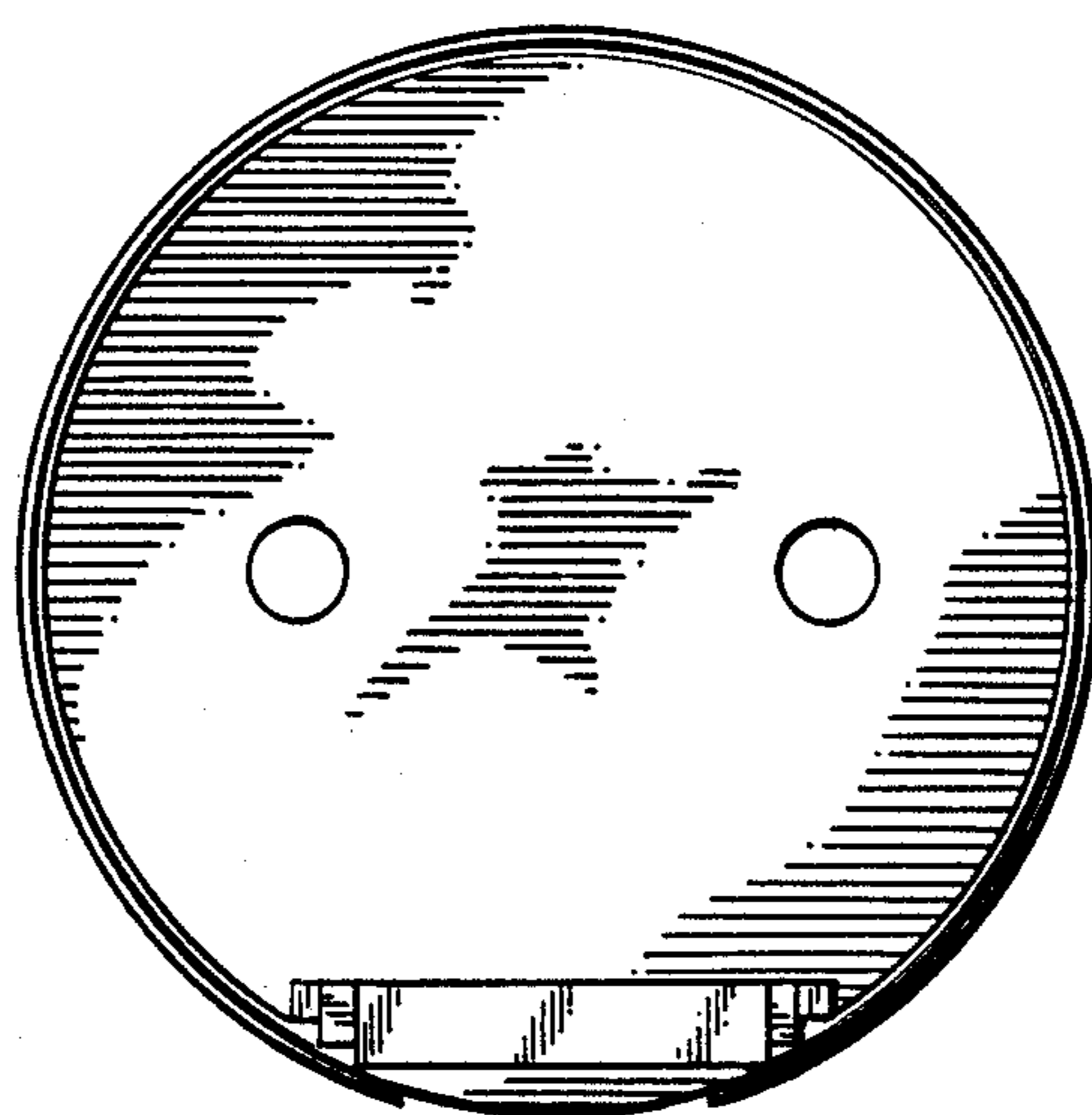

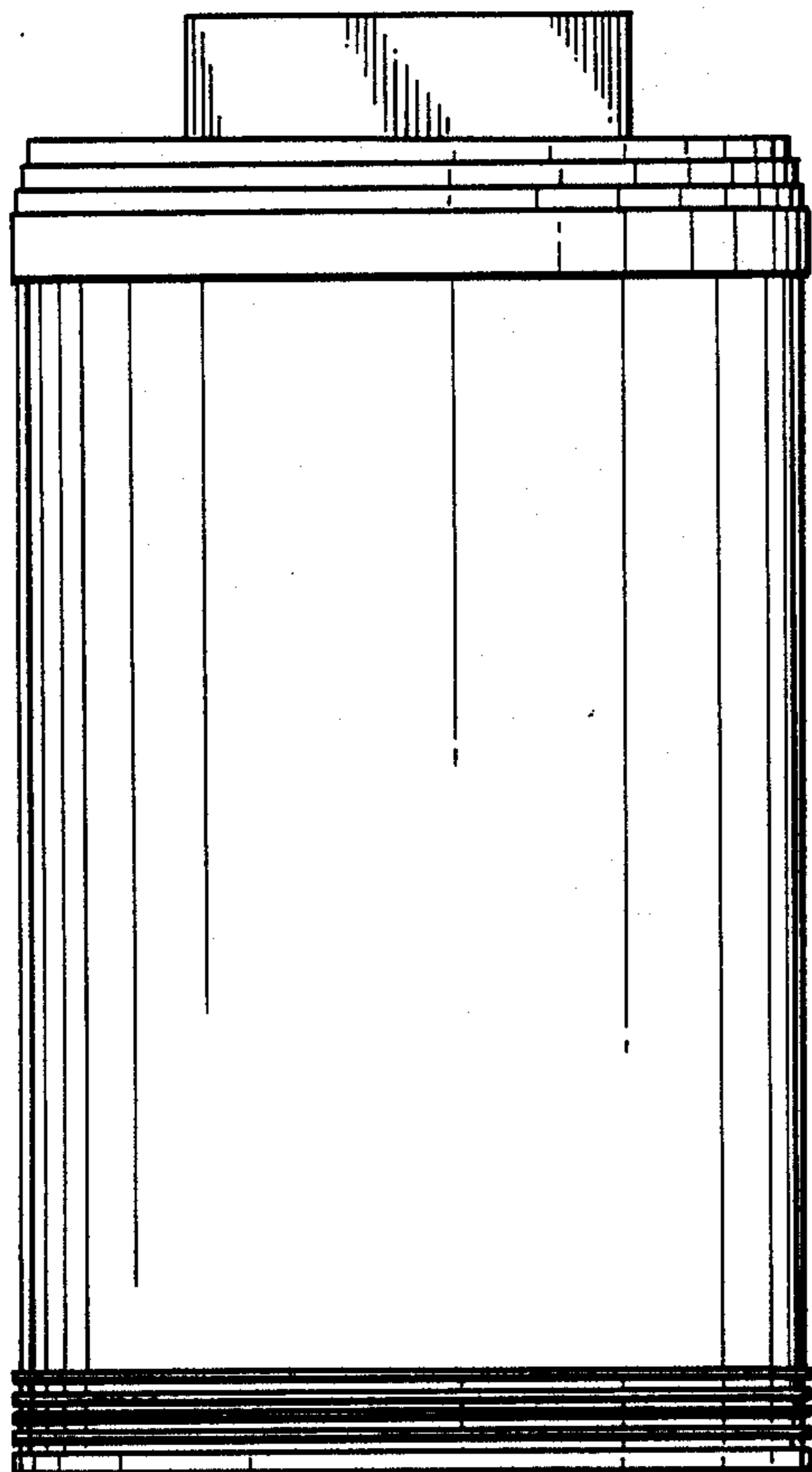

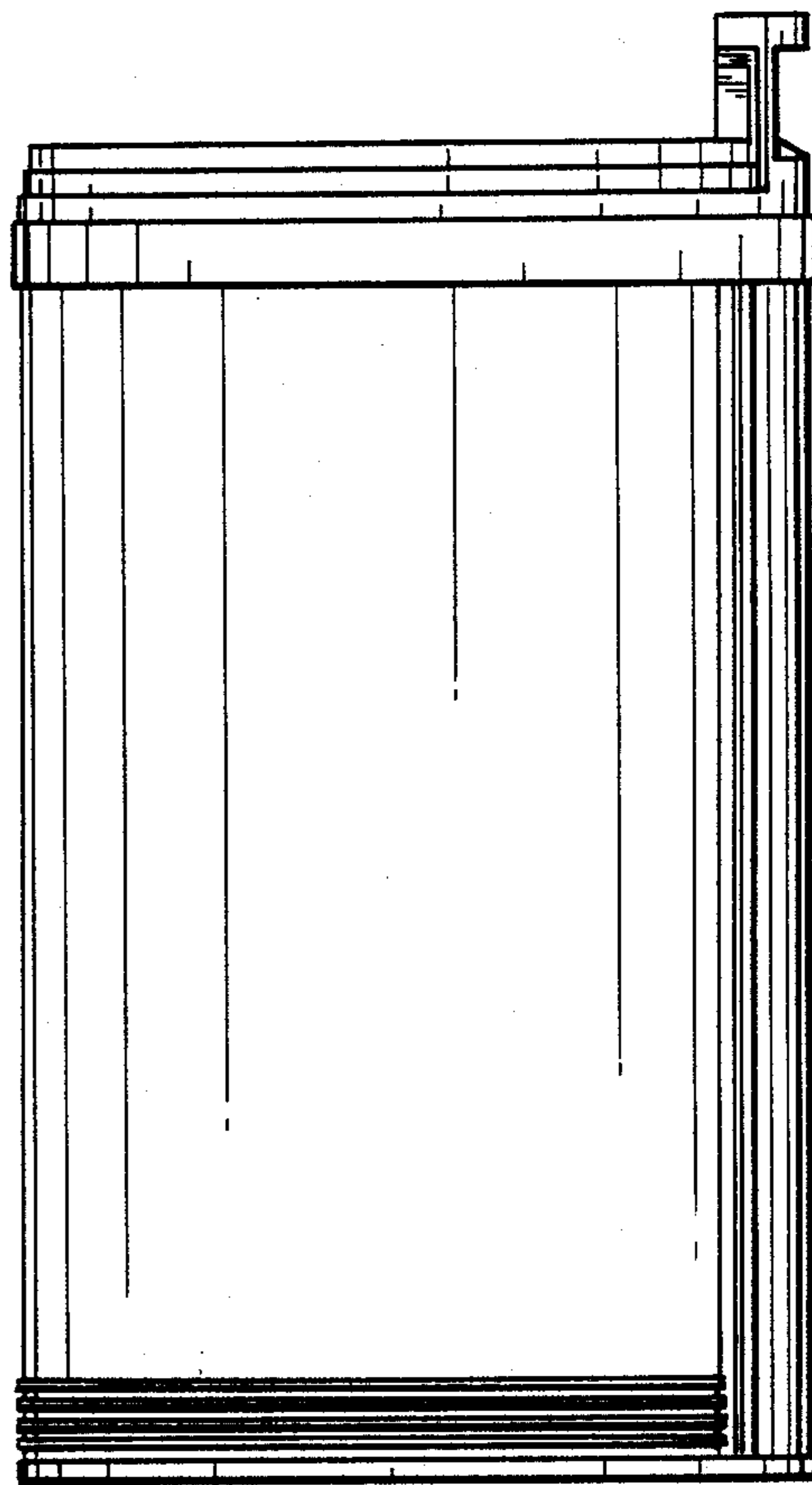

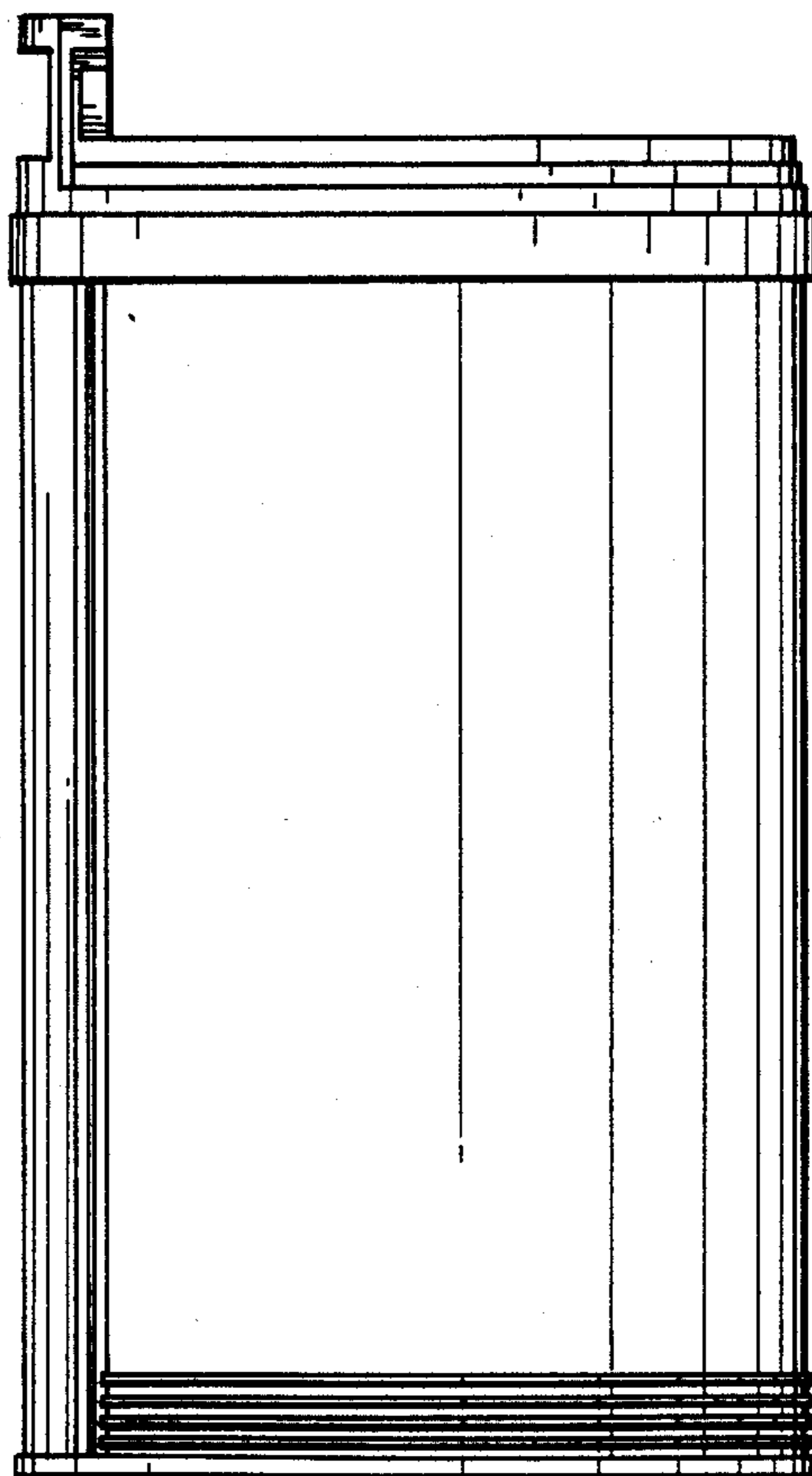

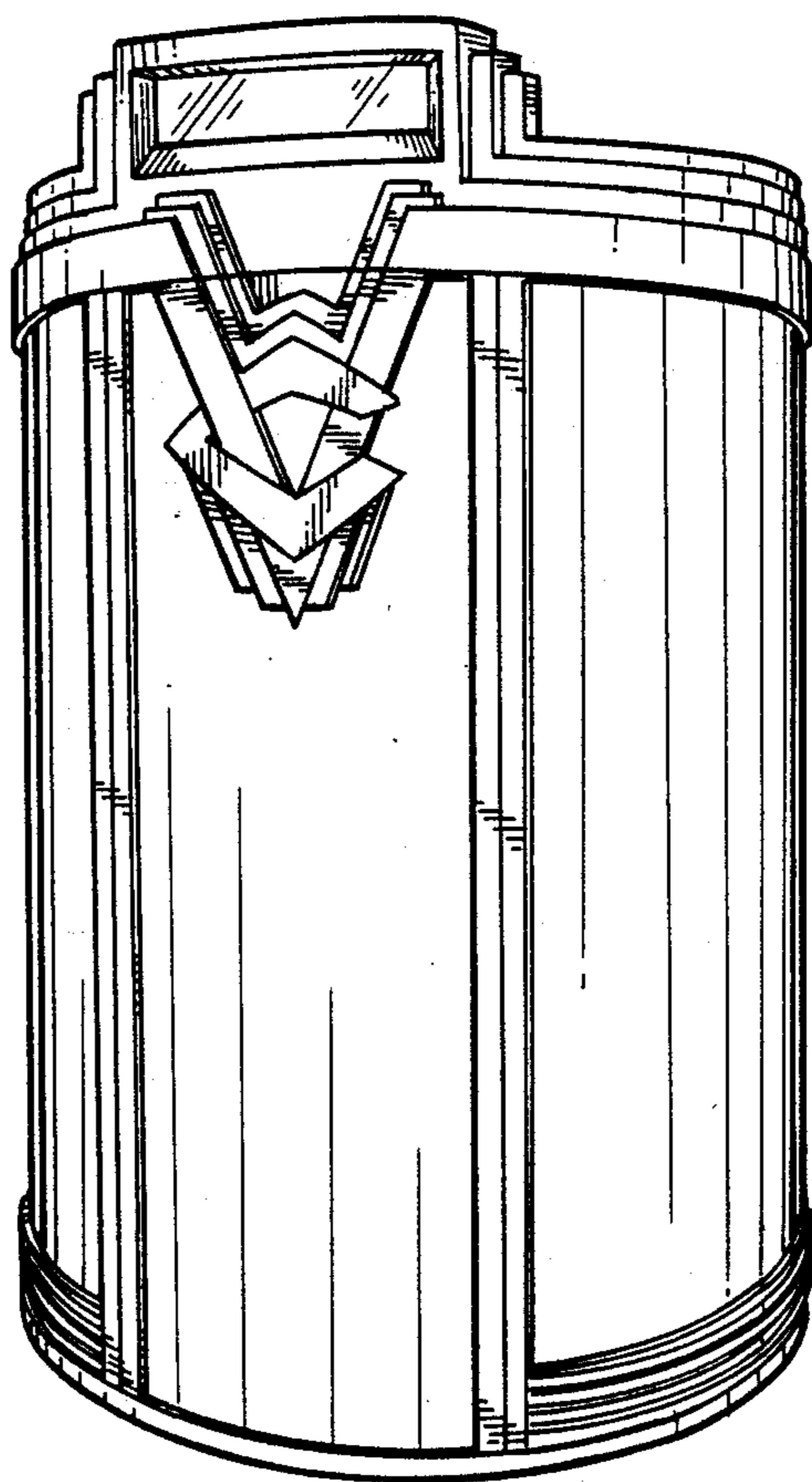
