The ornamental design for an attache case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of an attache case showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 6 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of another embodiment of my new design of FIGS. 1-5;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 10 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereto.

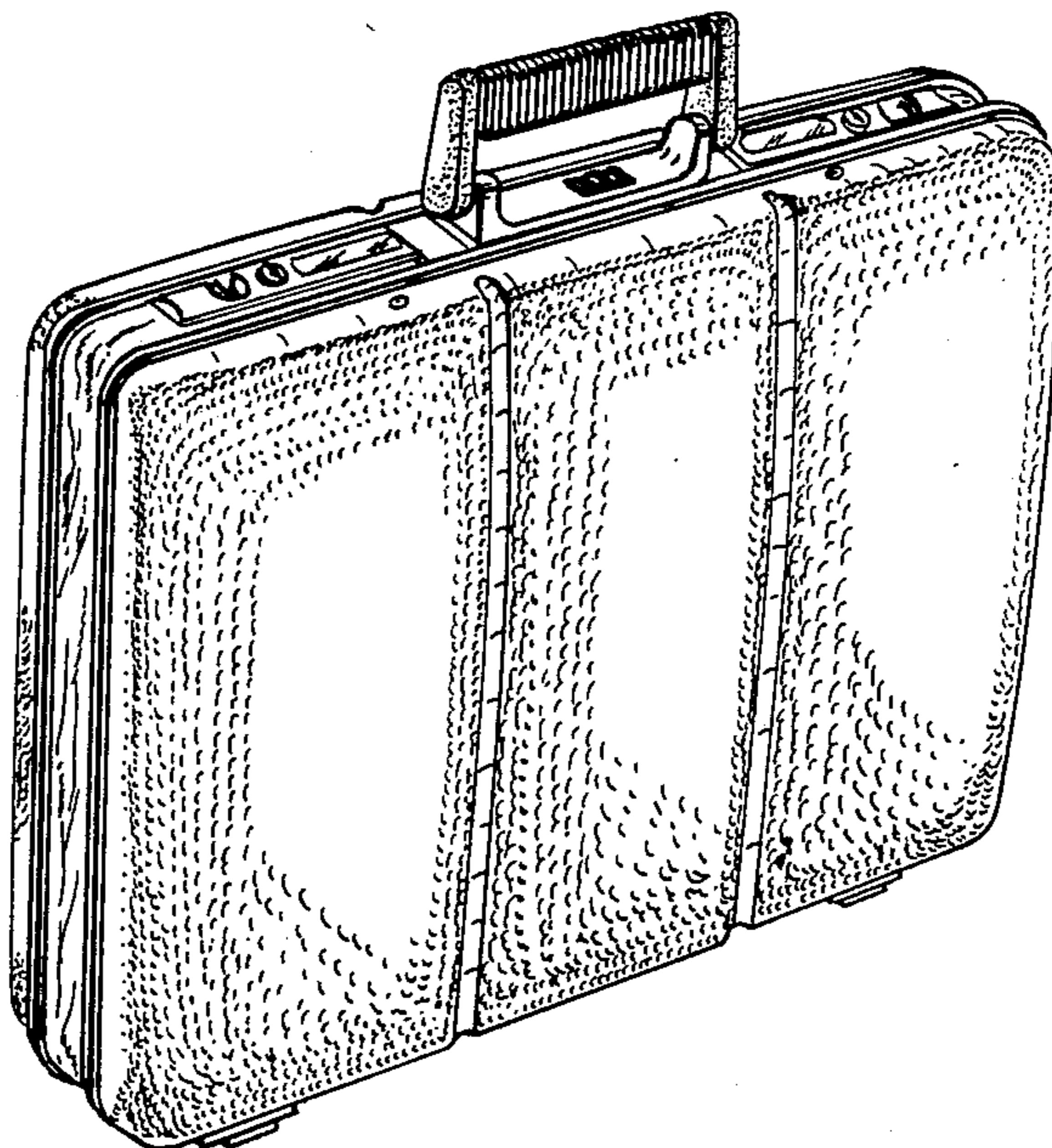

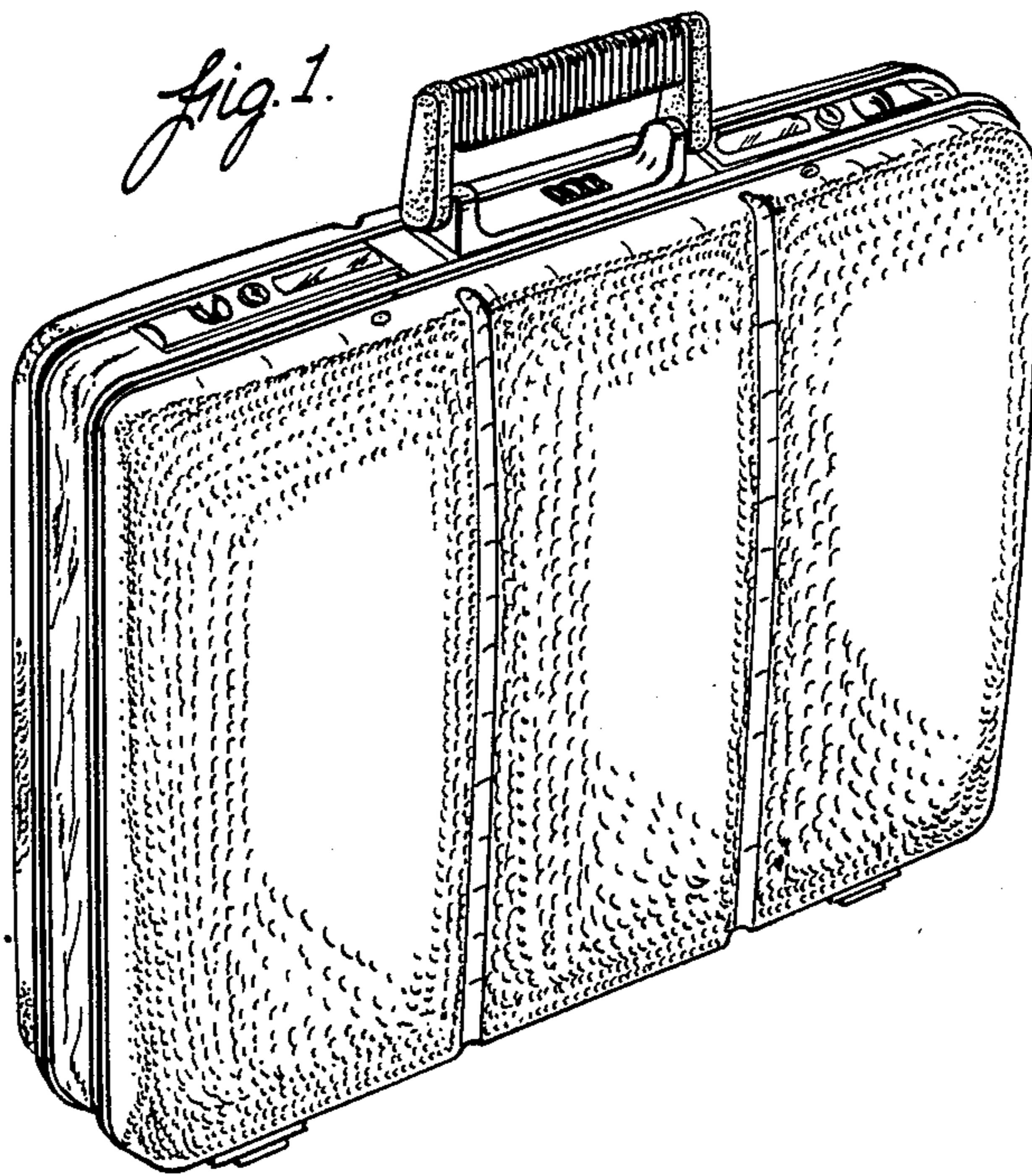

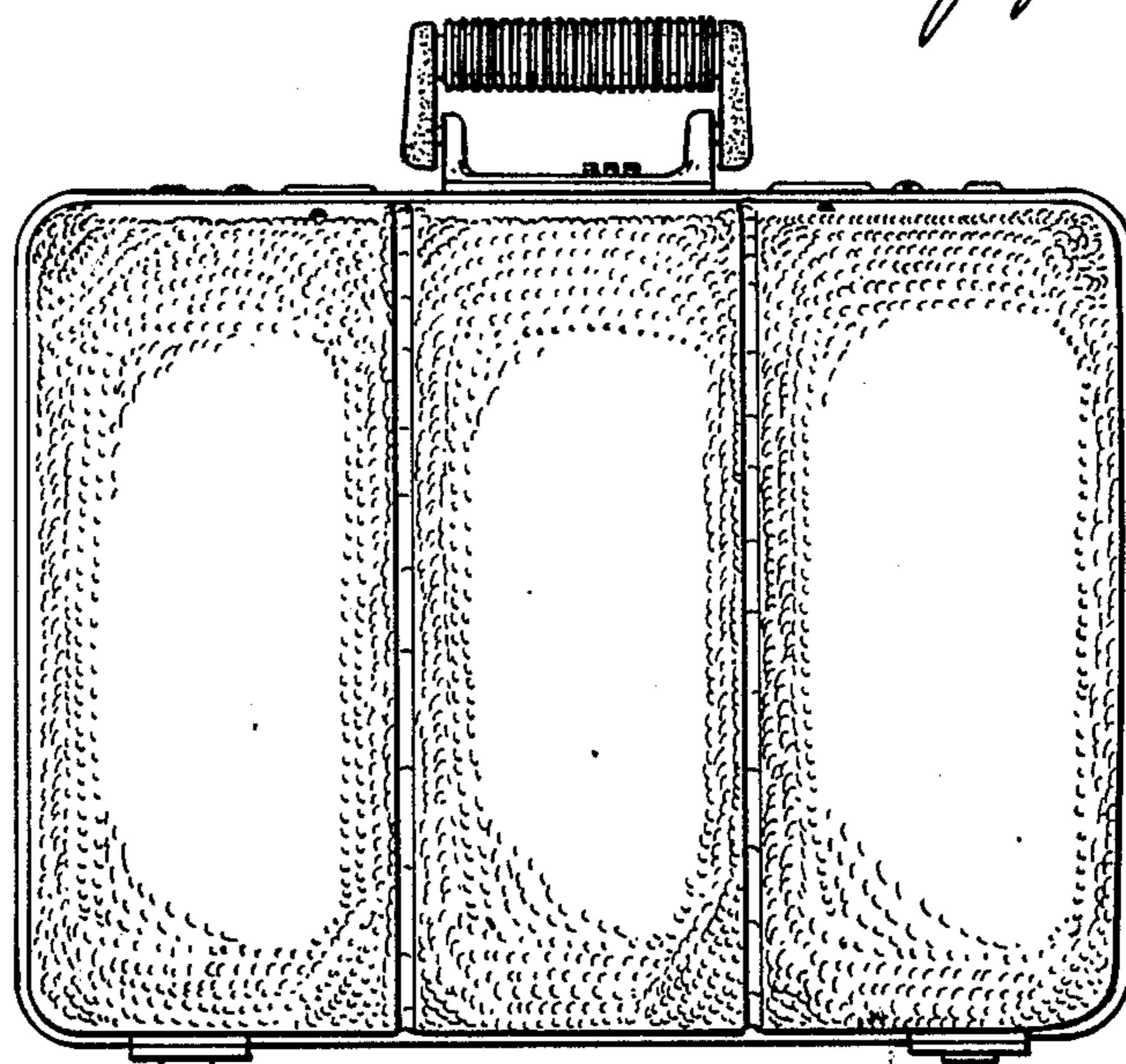

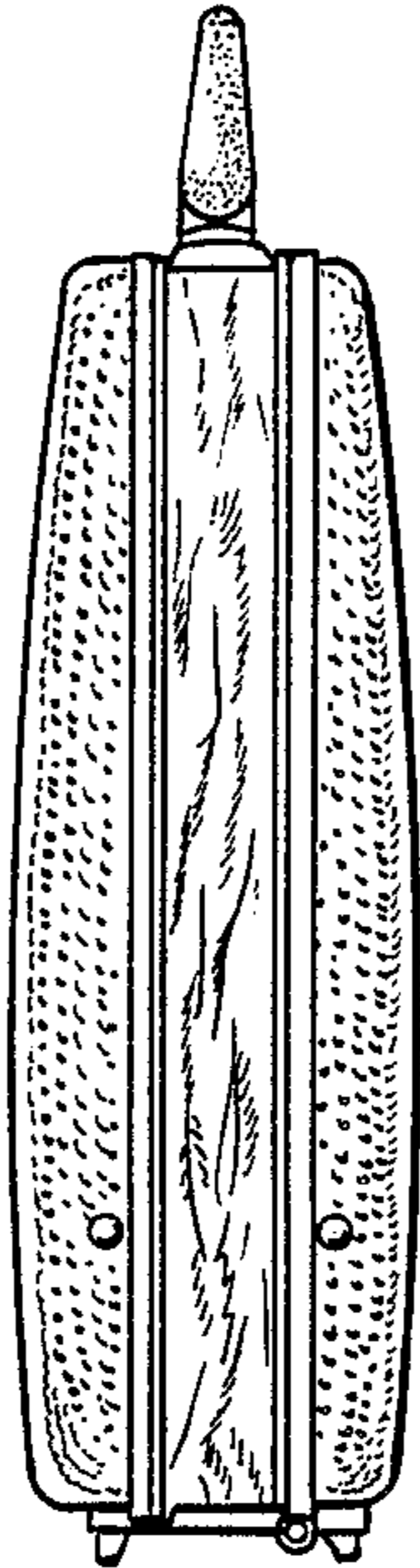

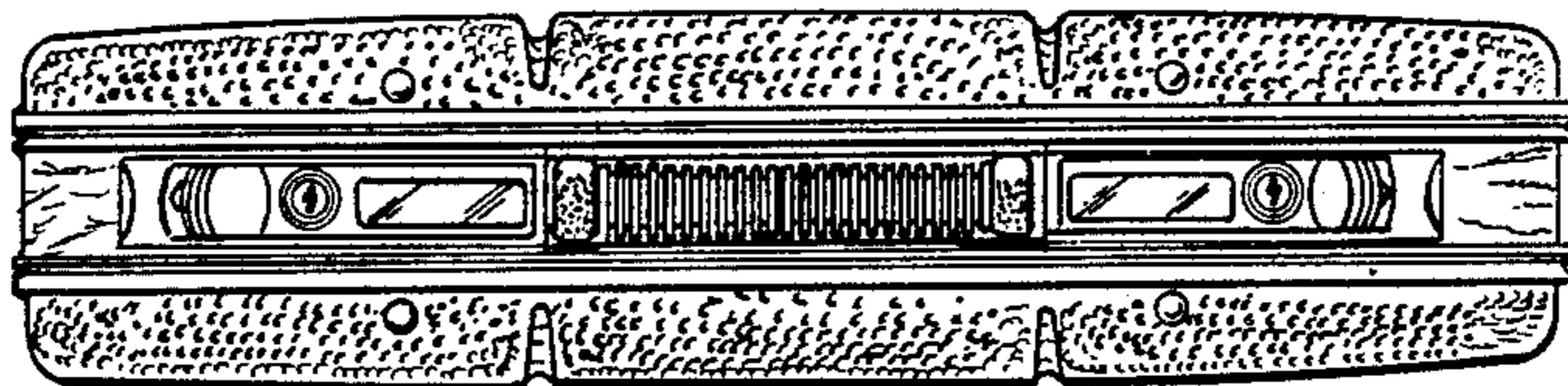
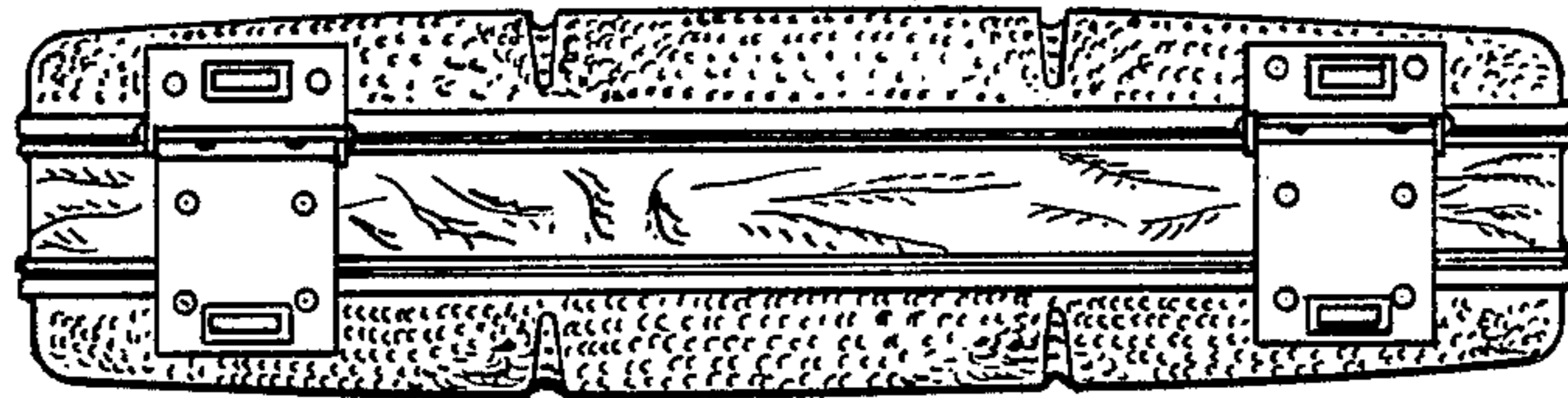

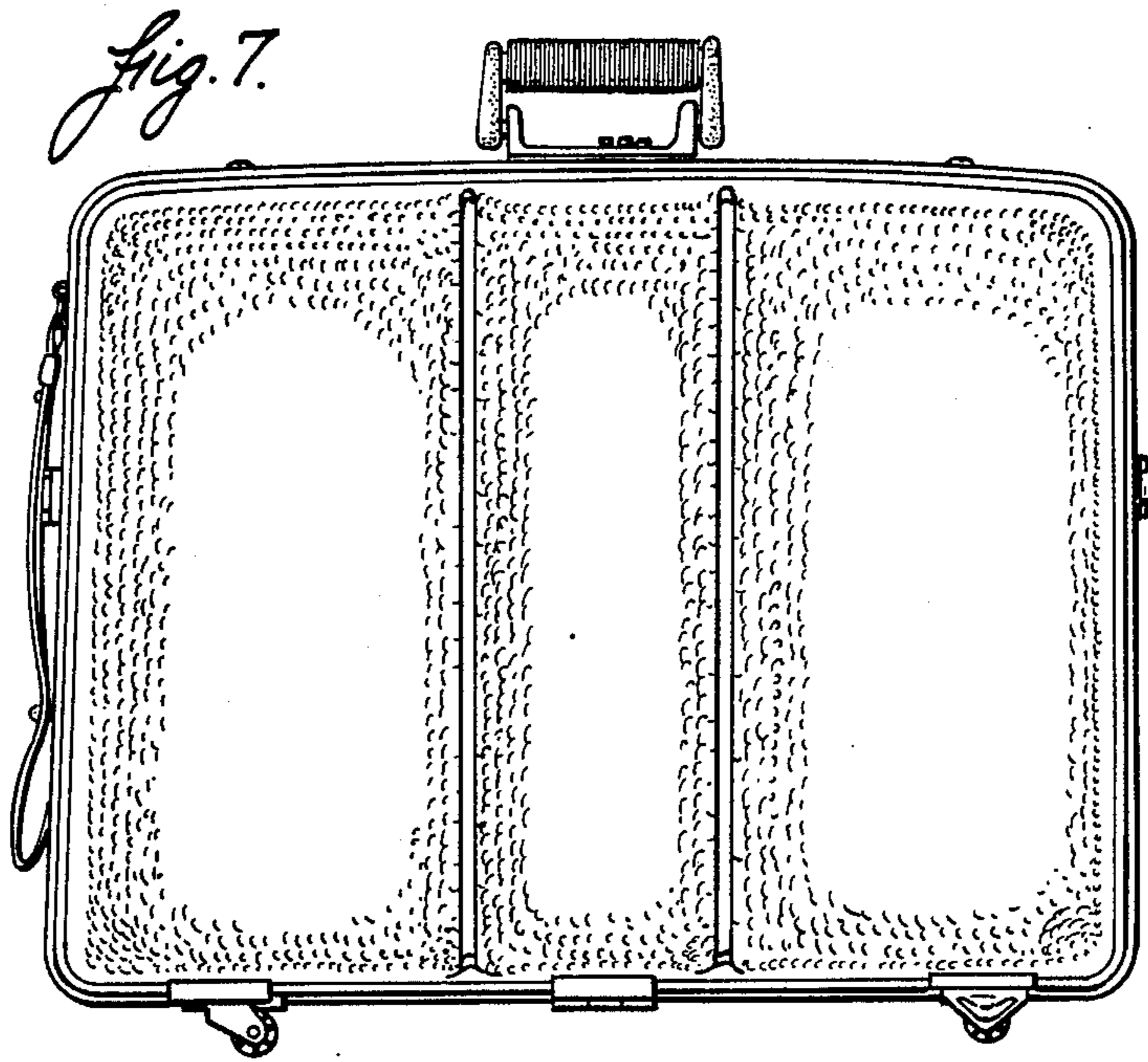
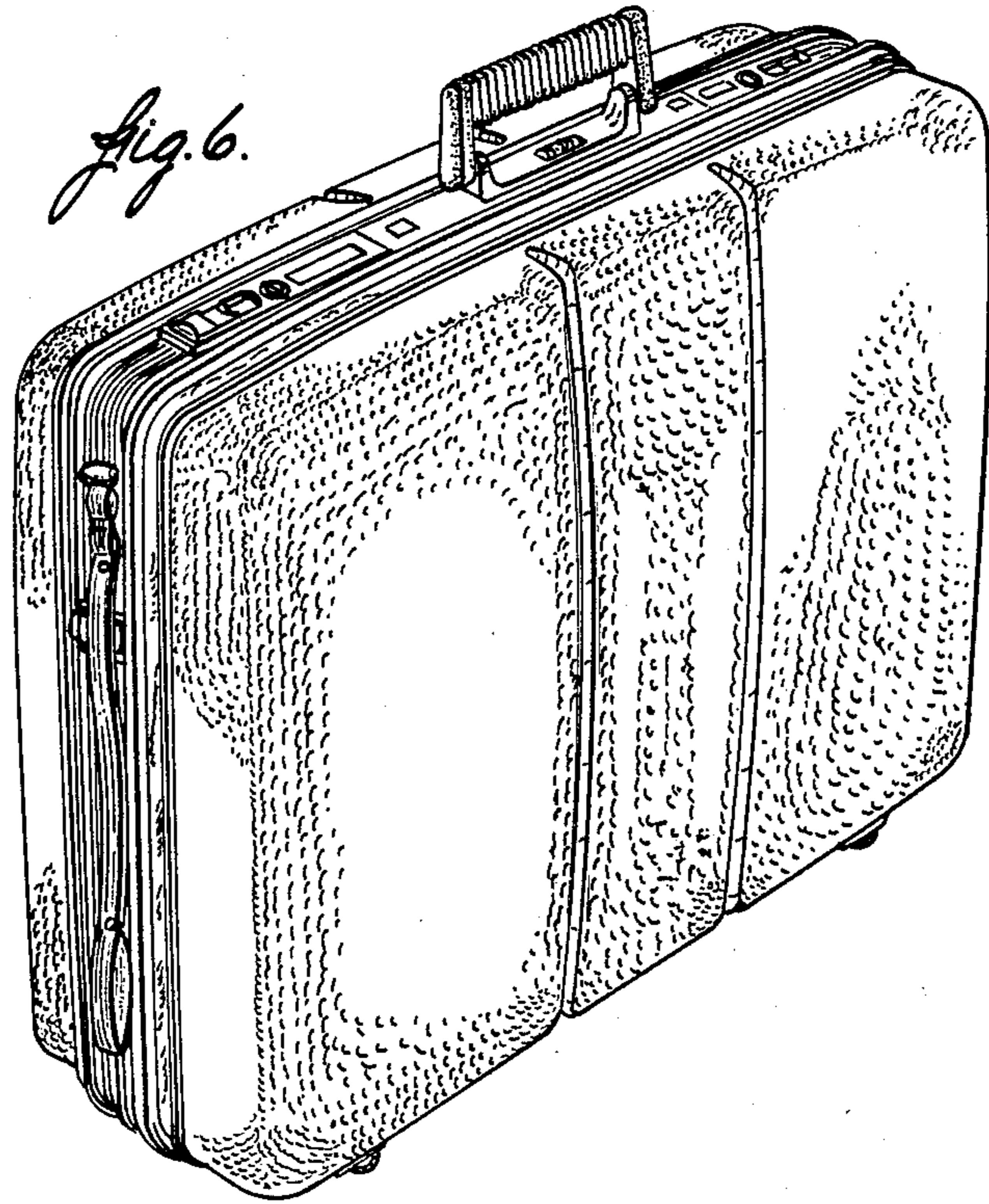

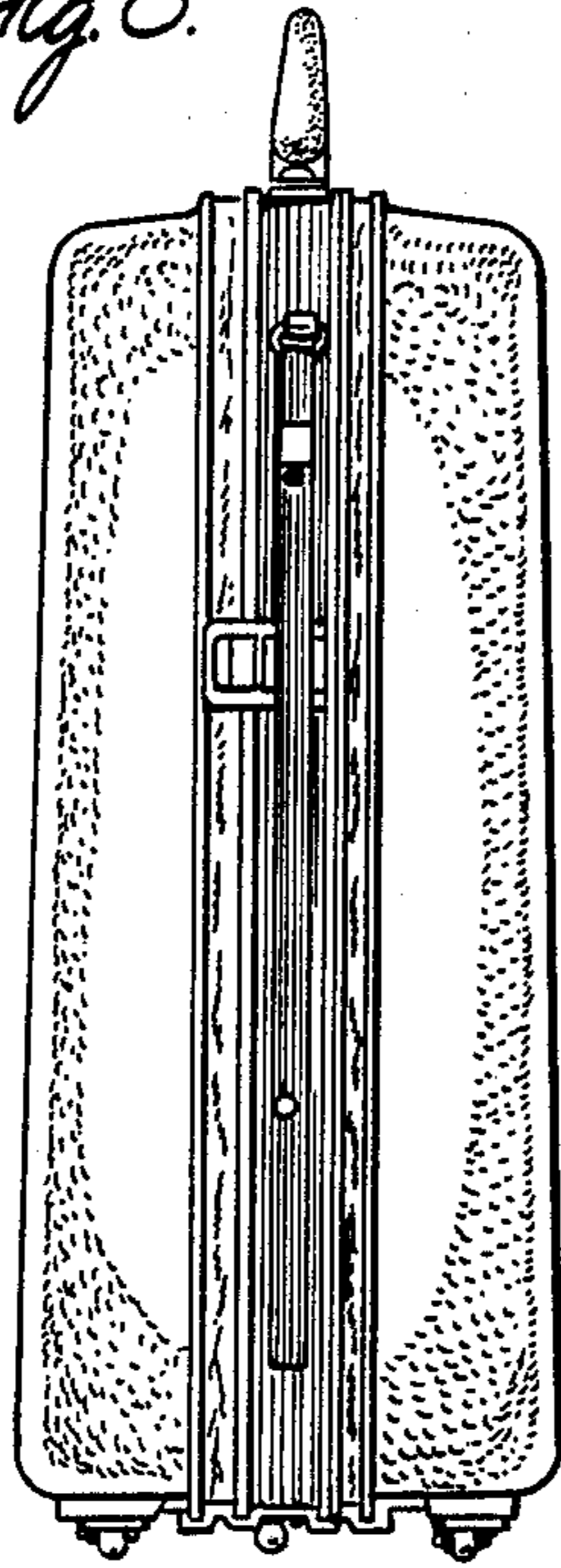

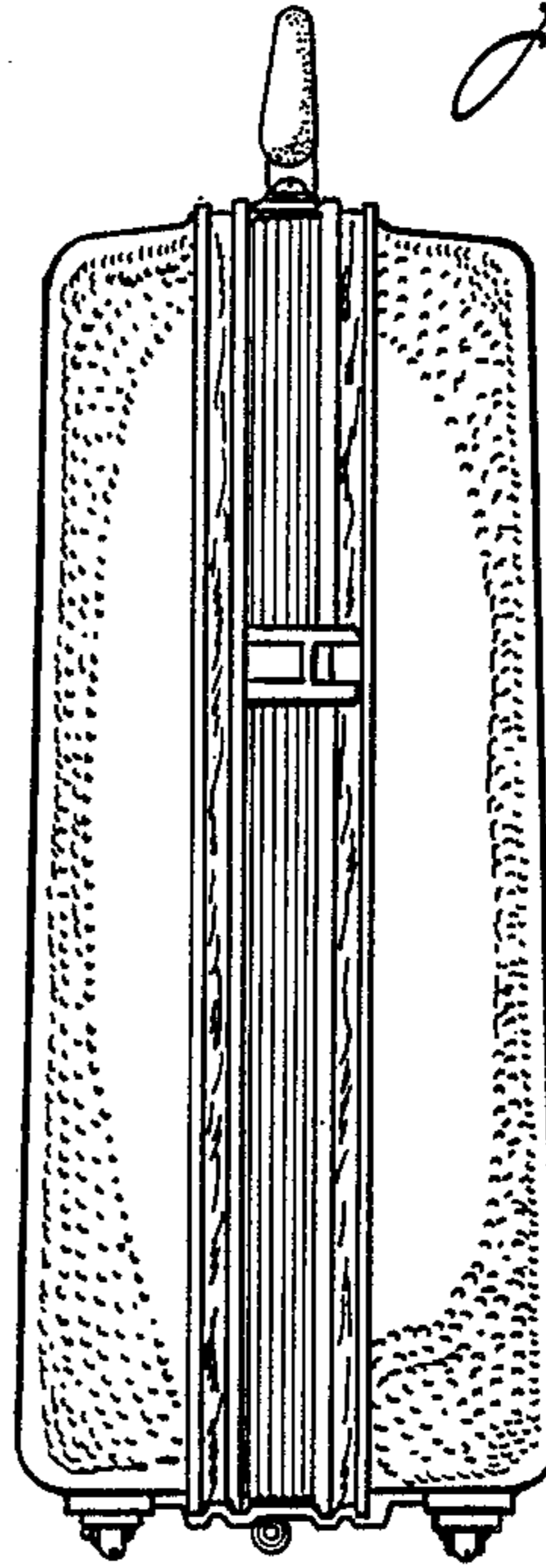

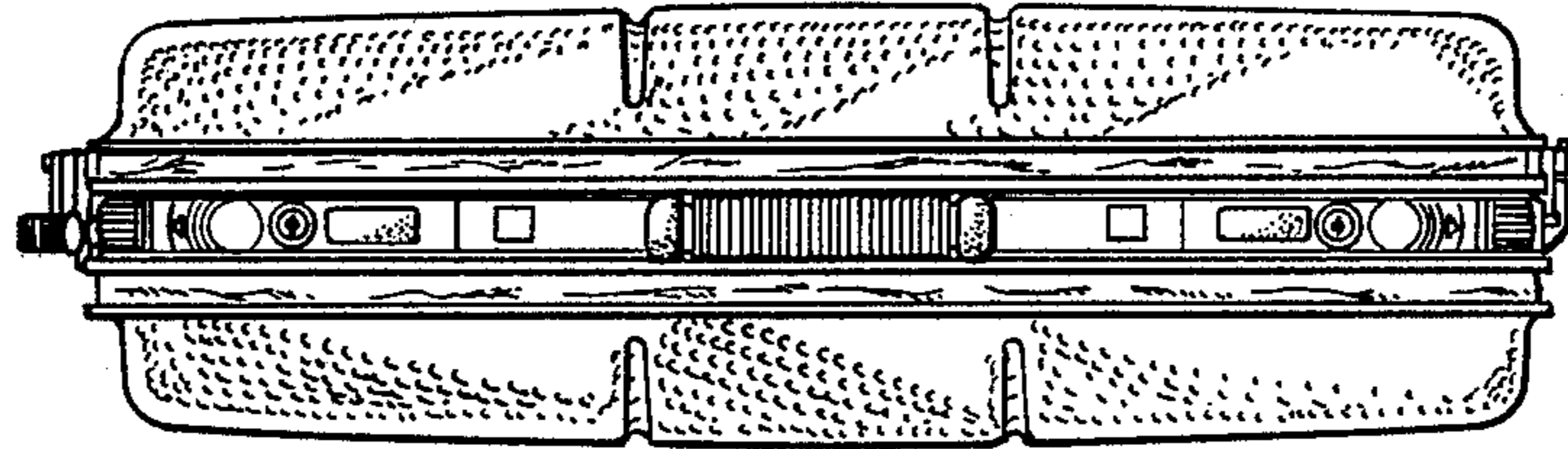
