FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view thereof.

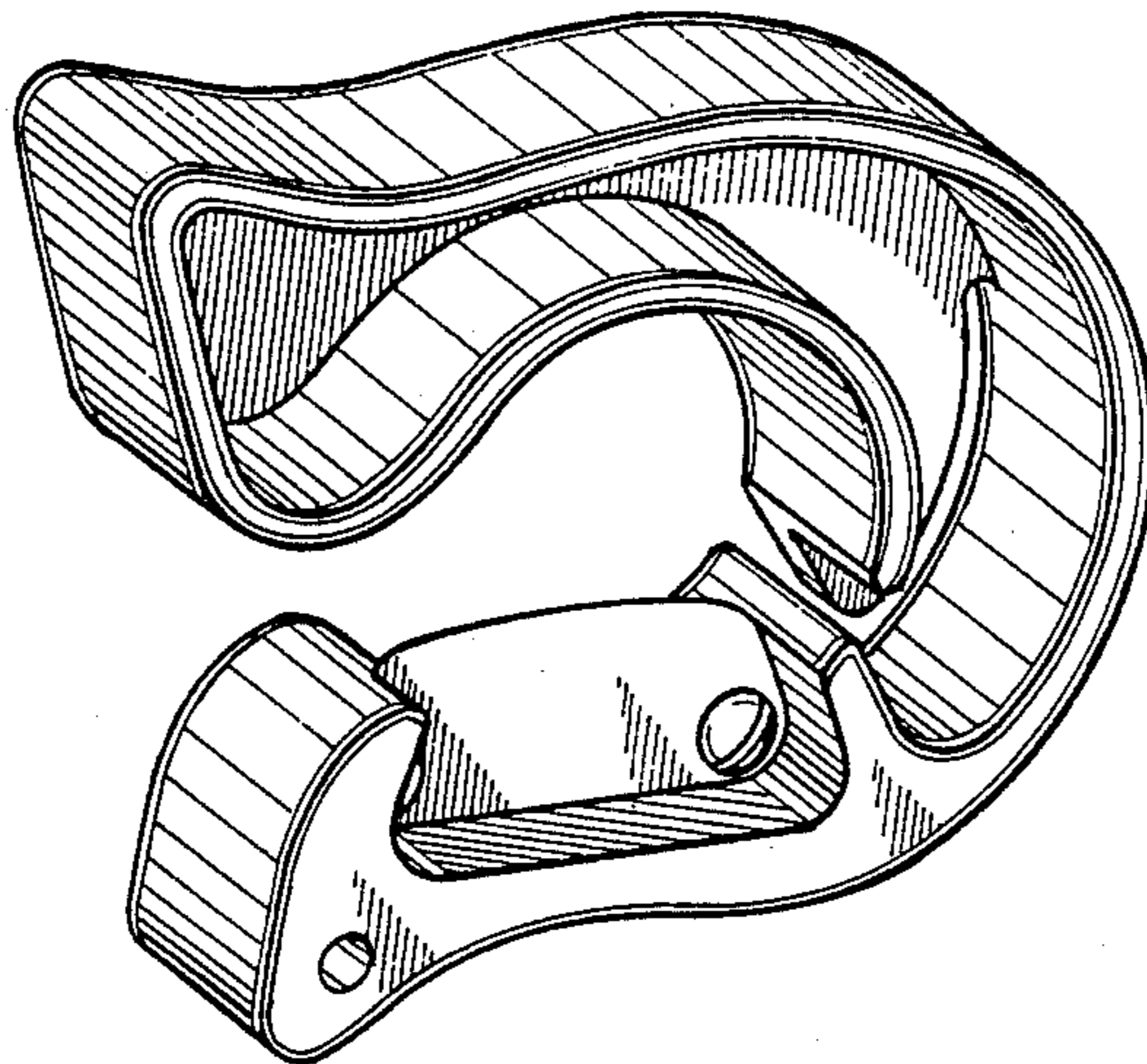

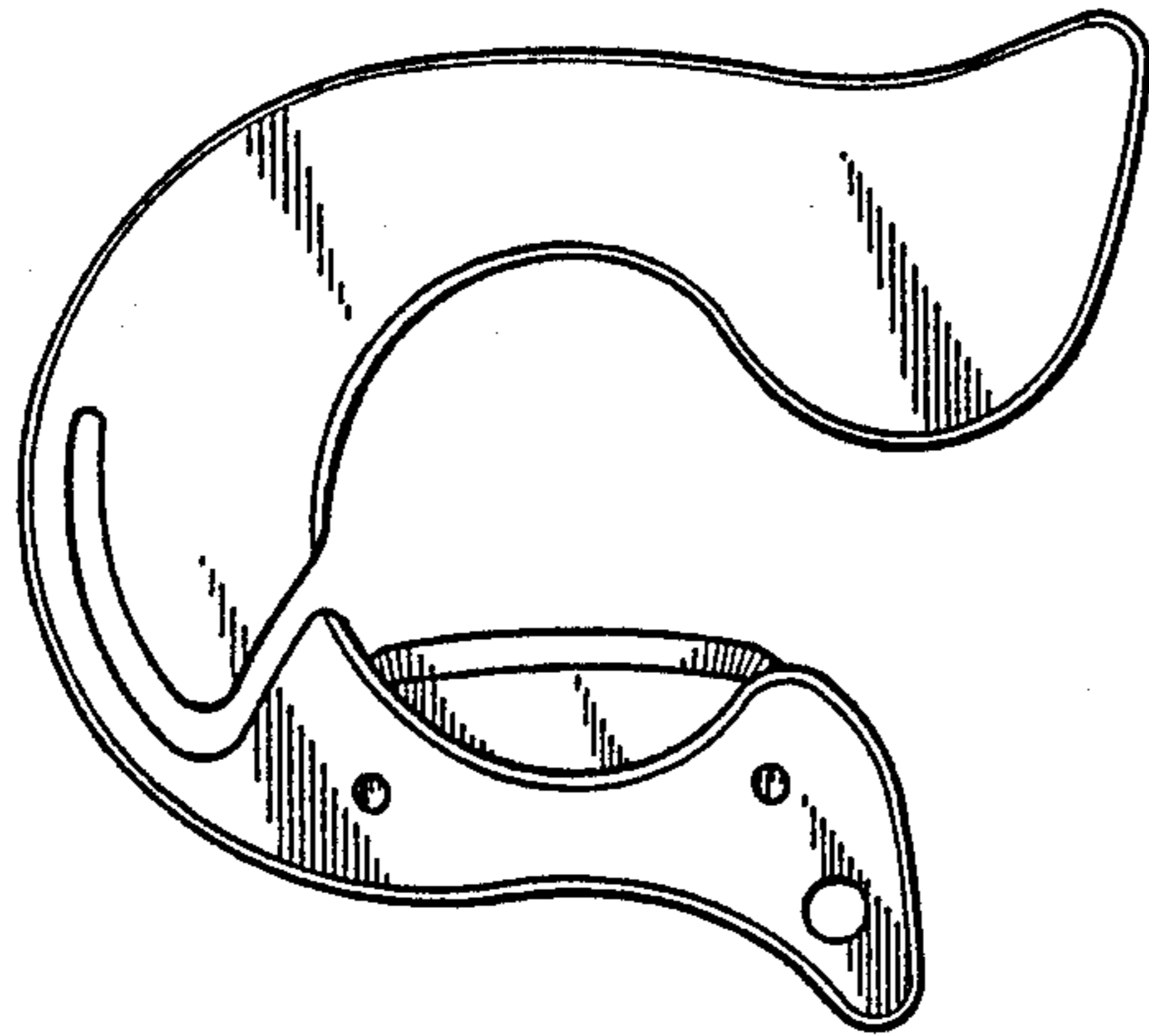

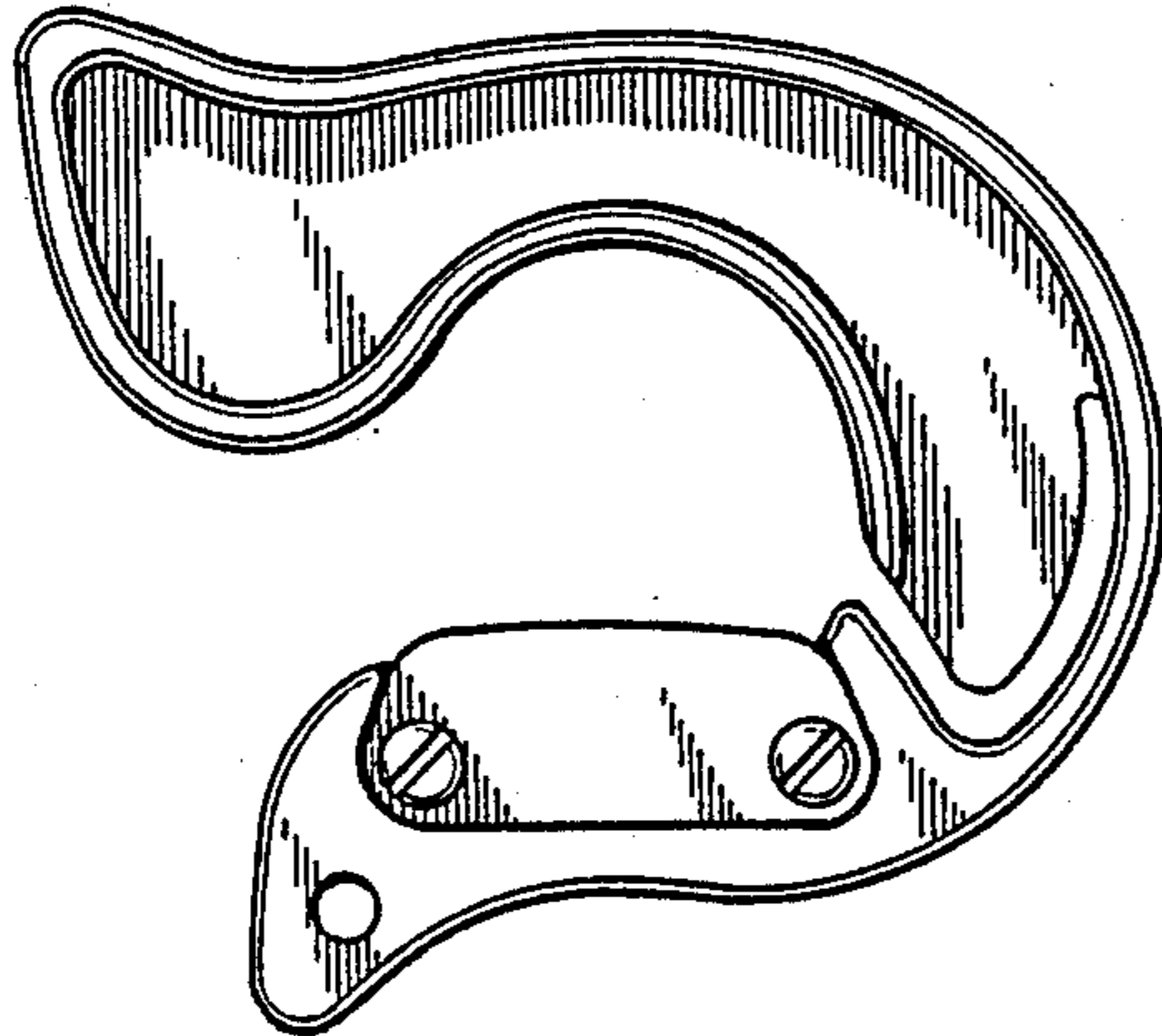

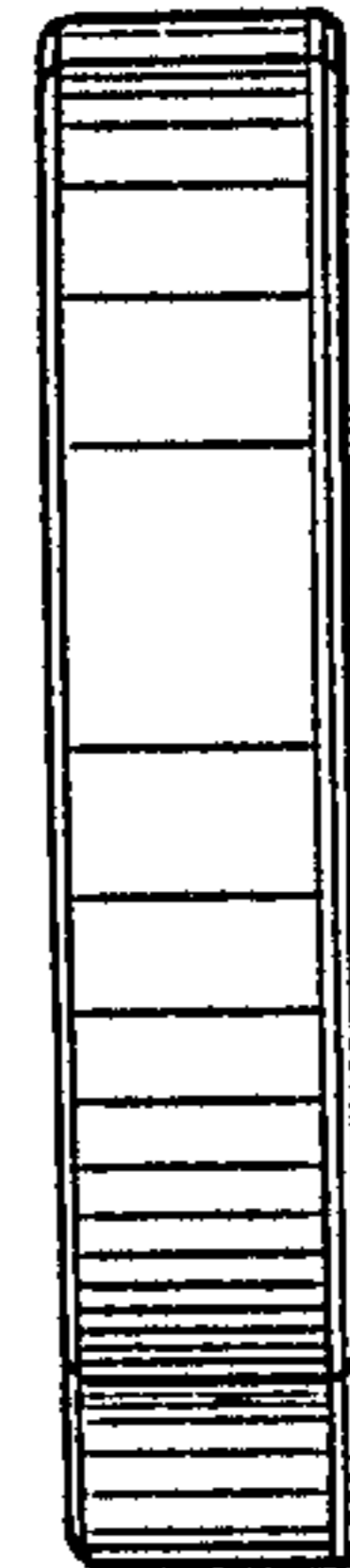

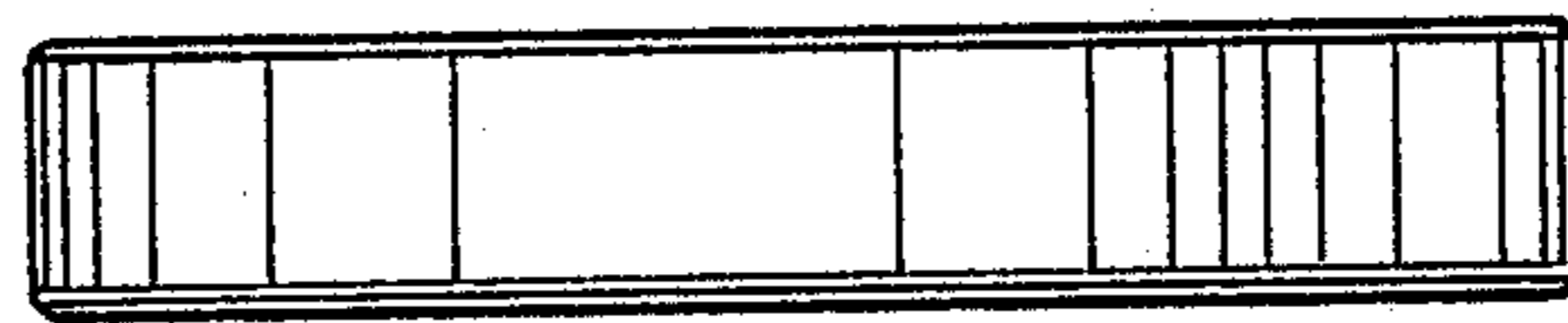

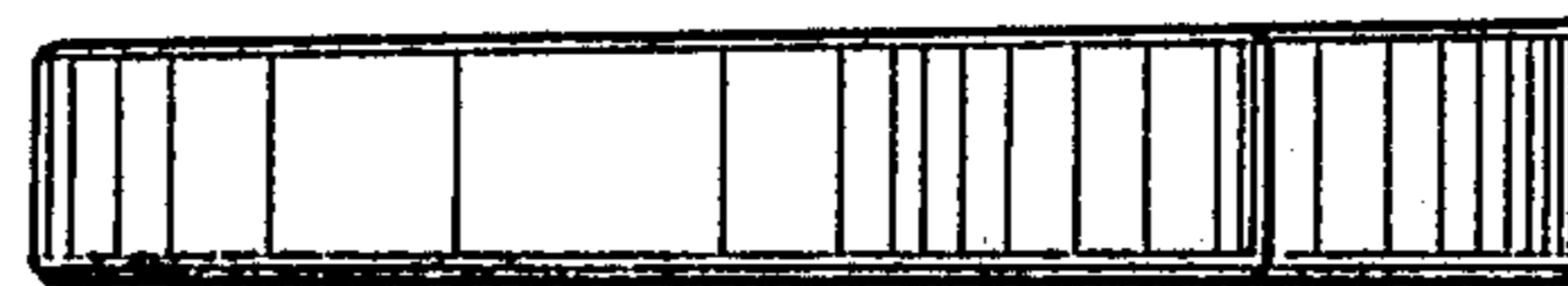
