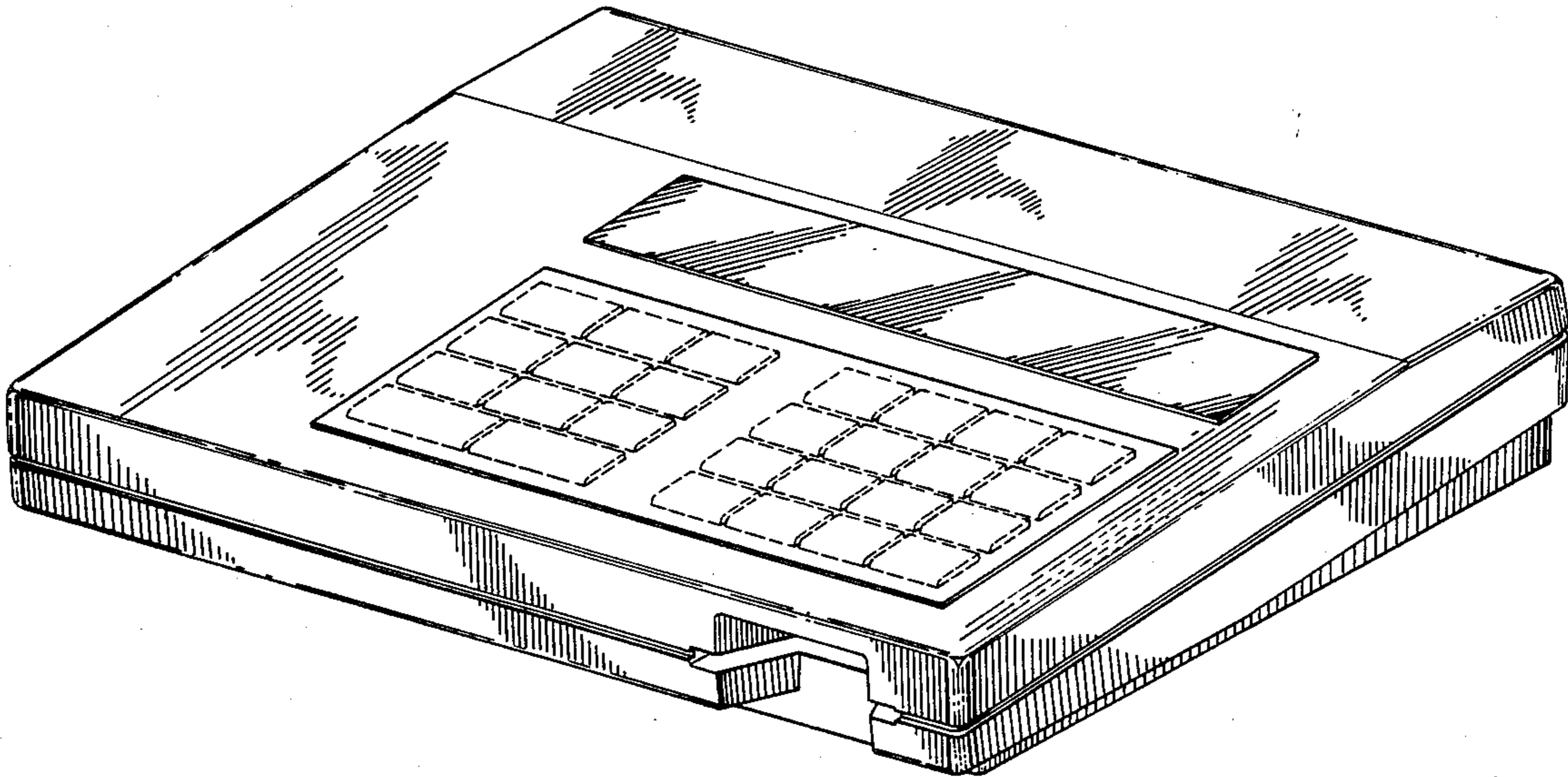

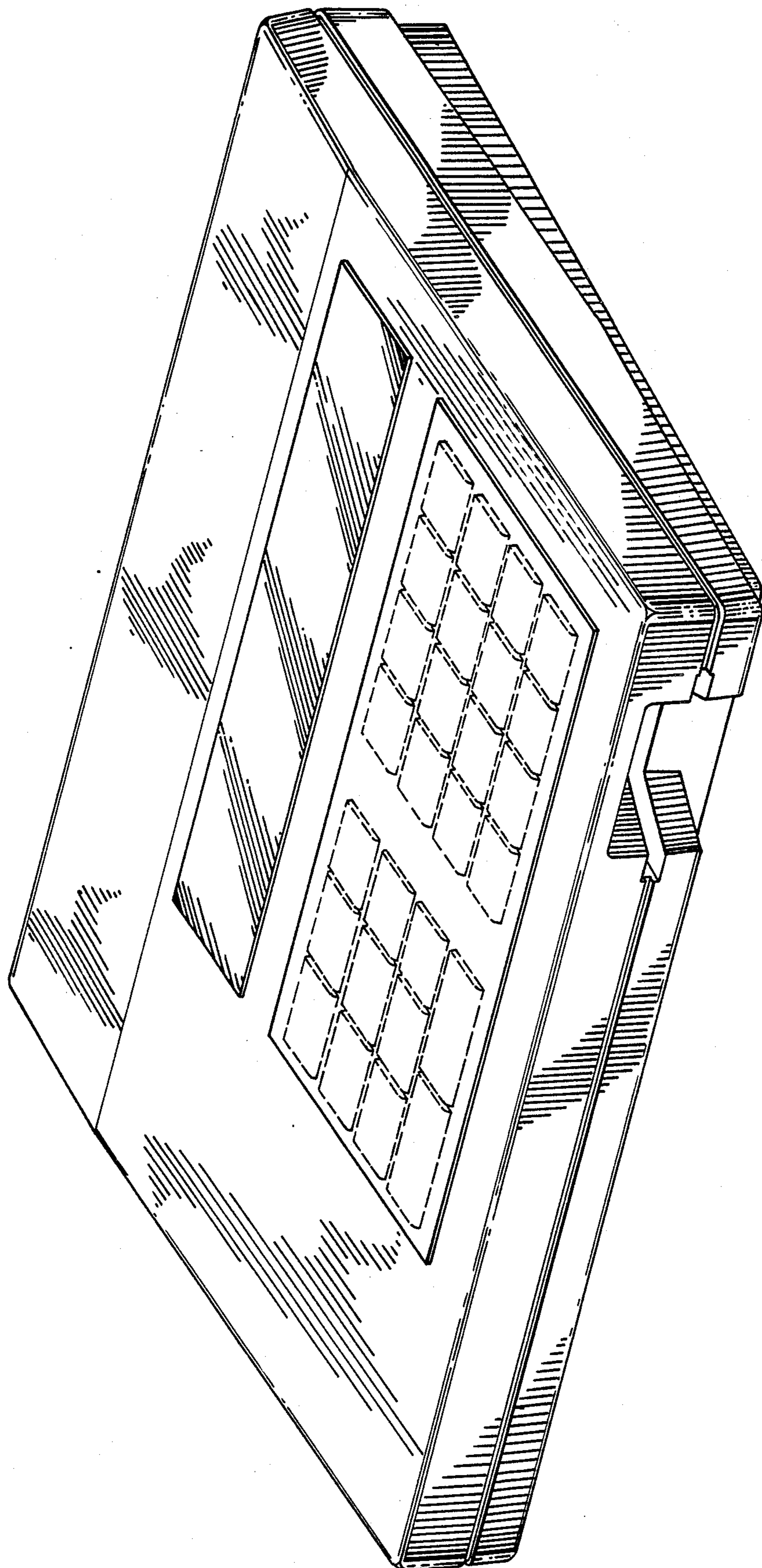
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

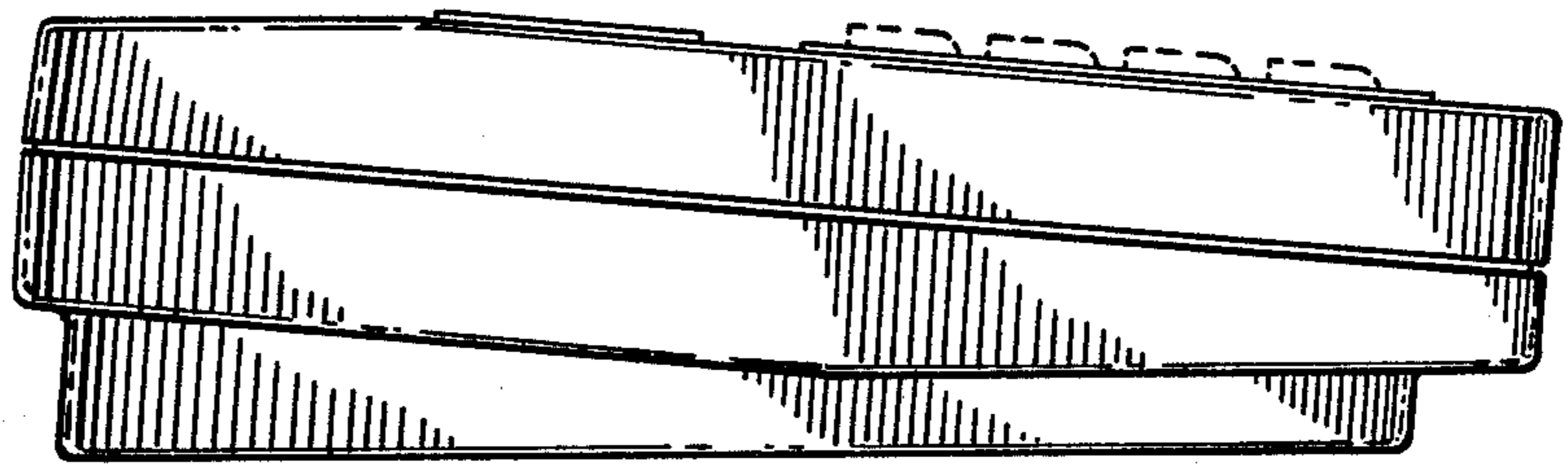
FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right side perspective view of a point of sale terminal showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof. 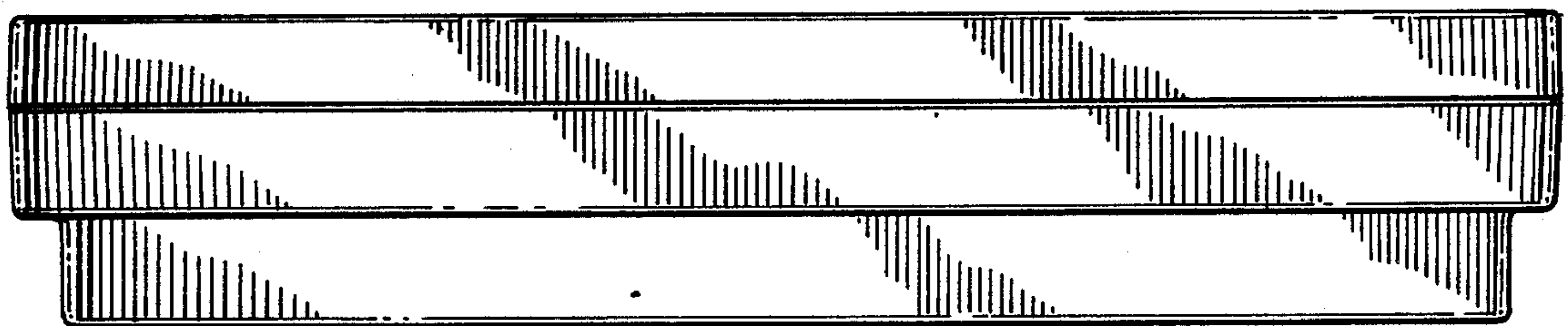
