FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a tape player showing my new design;

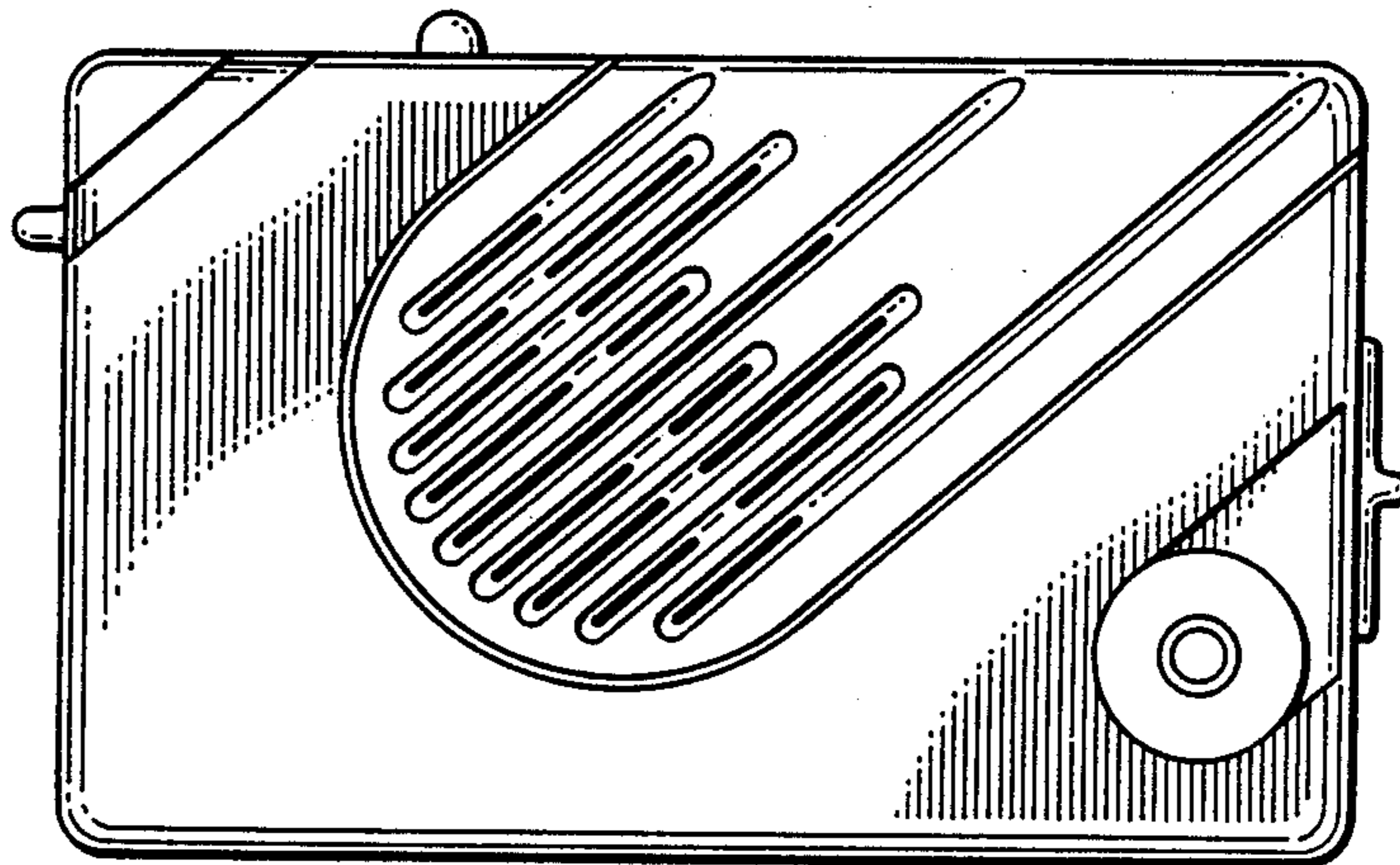
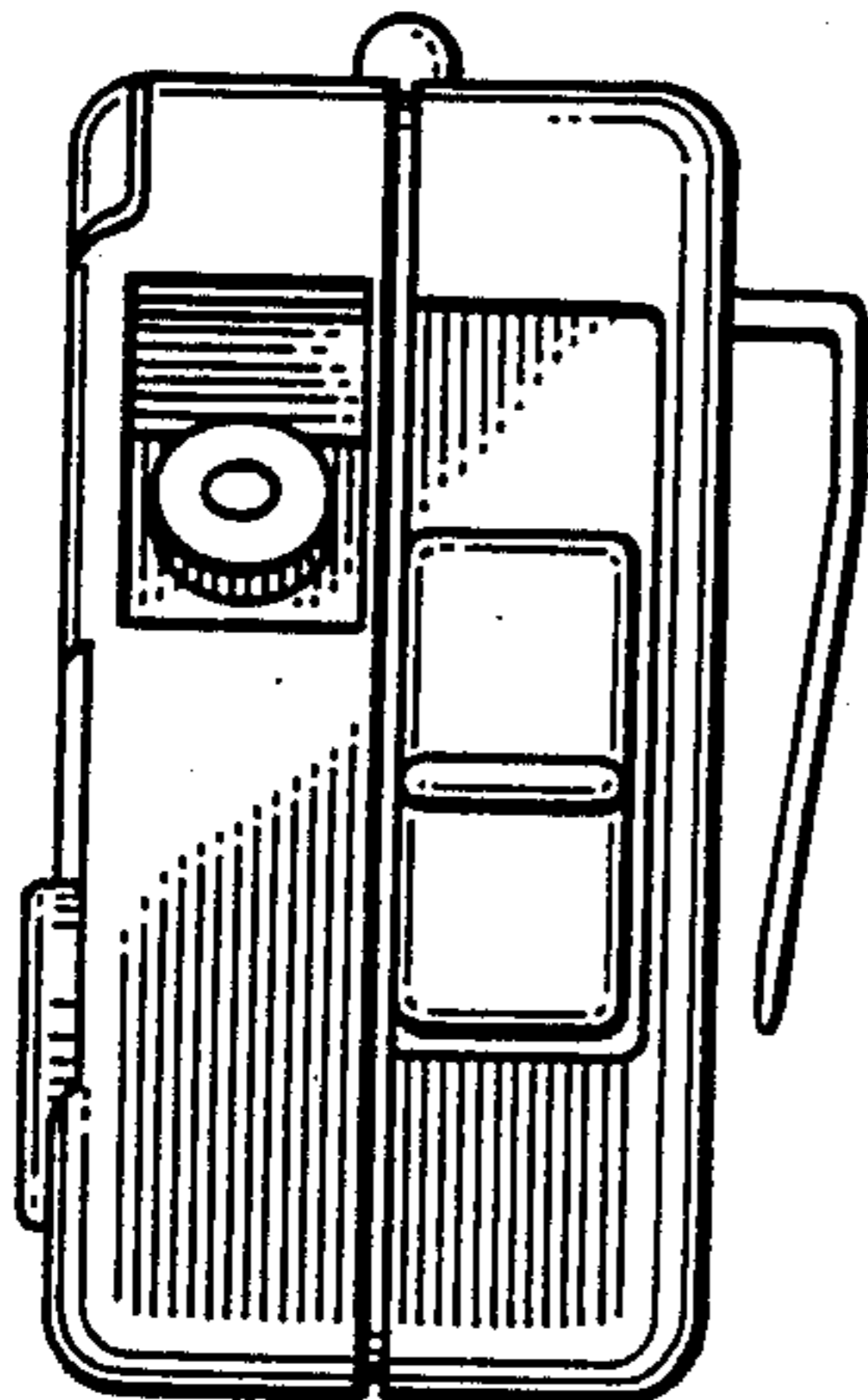
FIG. 2 is a front-elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view thereof.



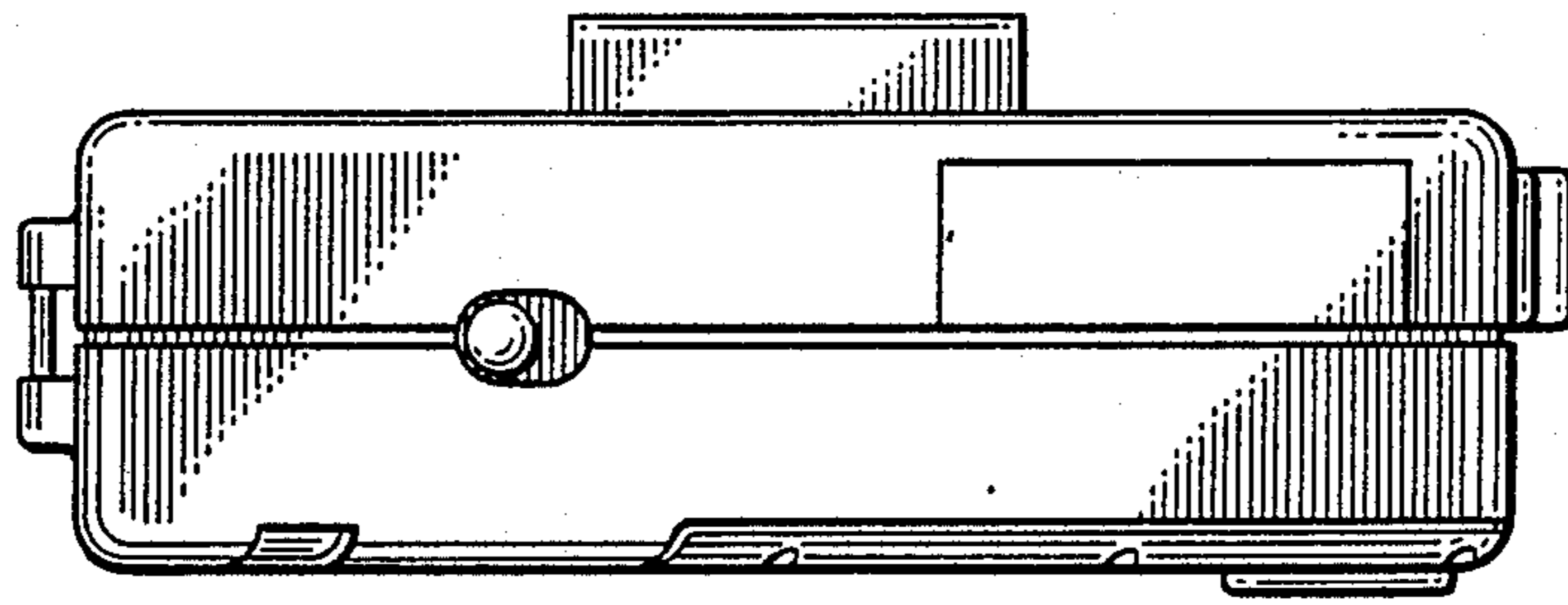

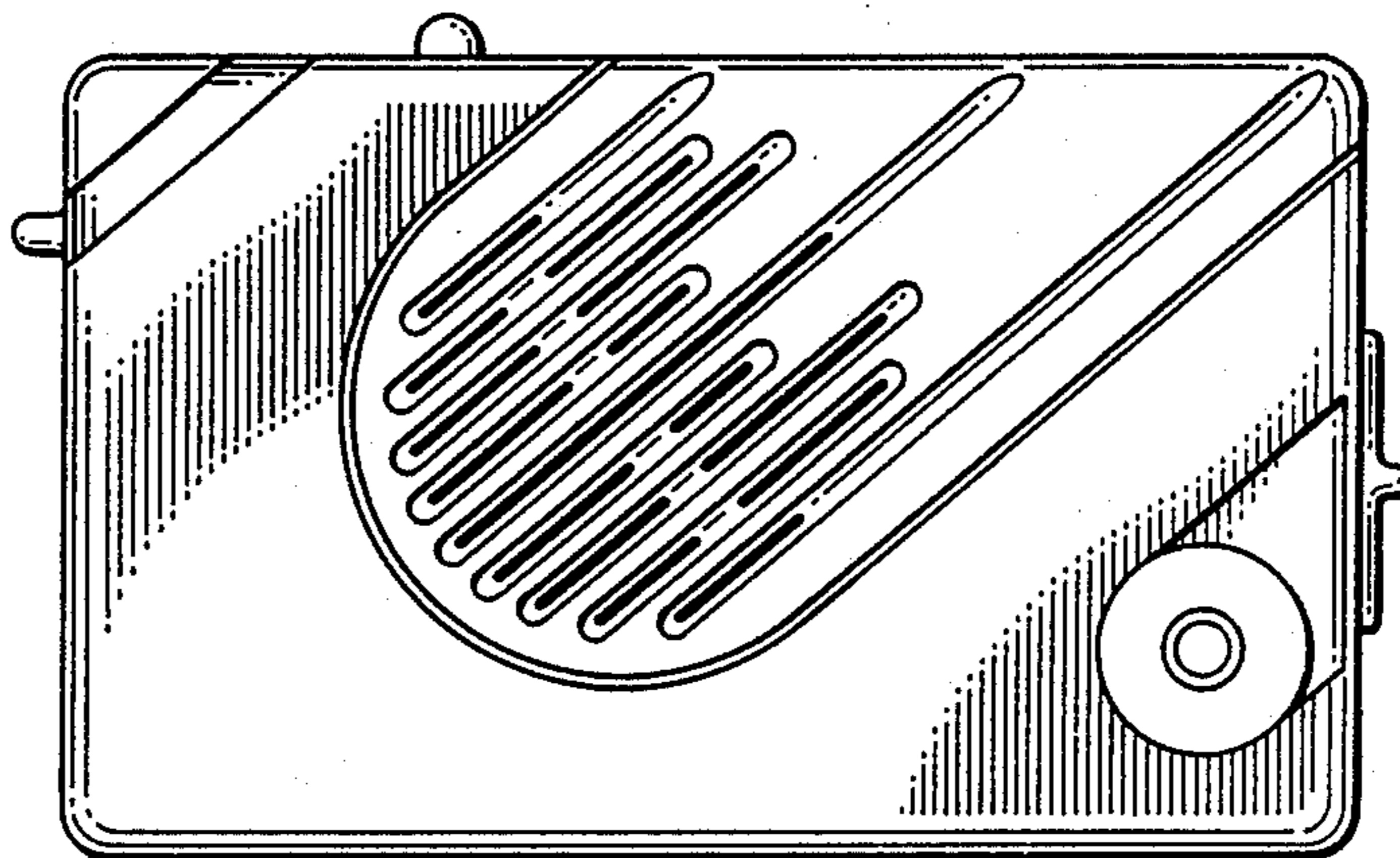

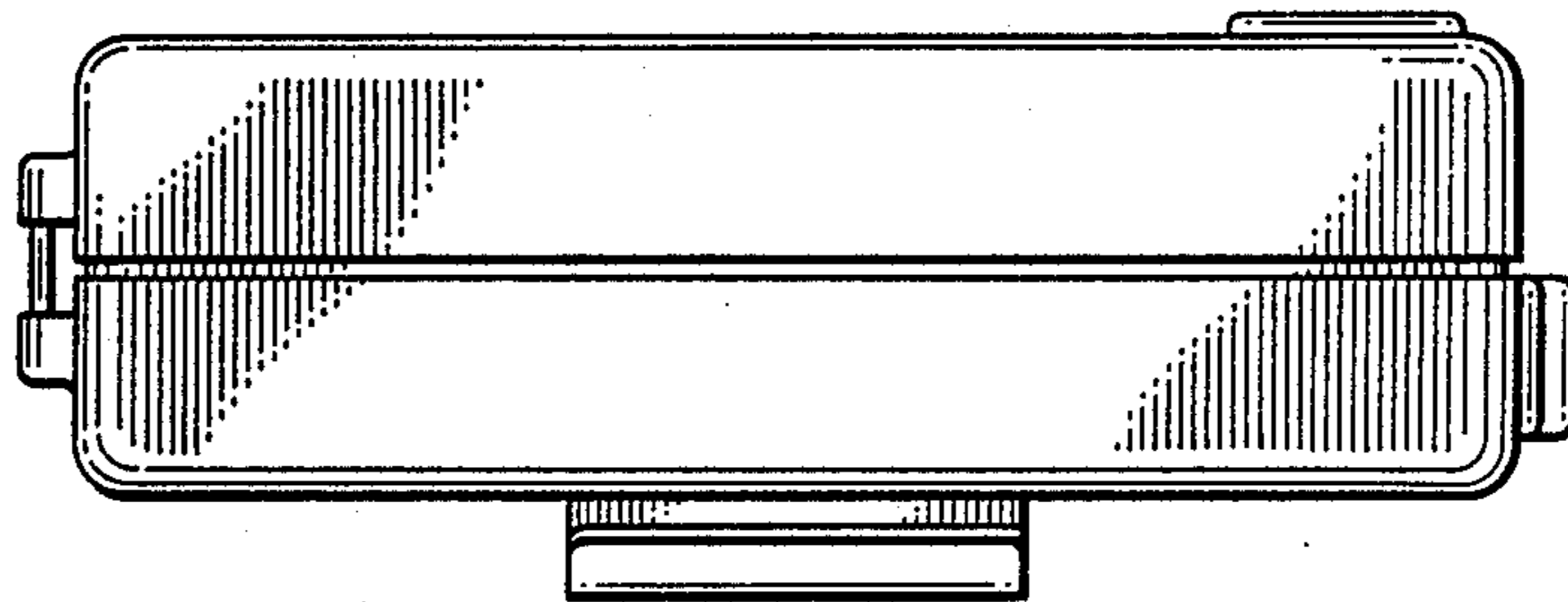

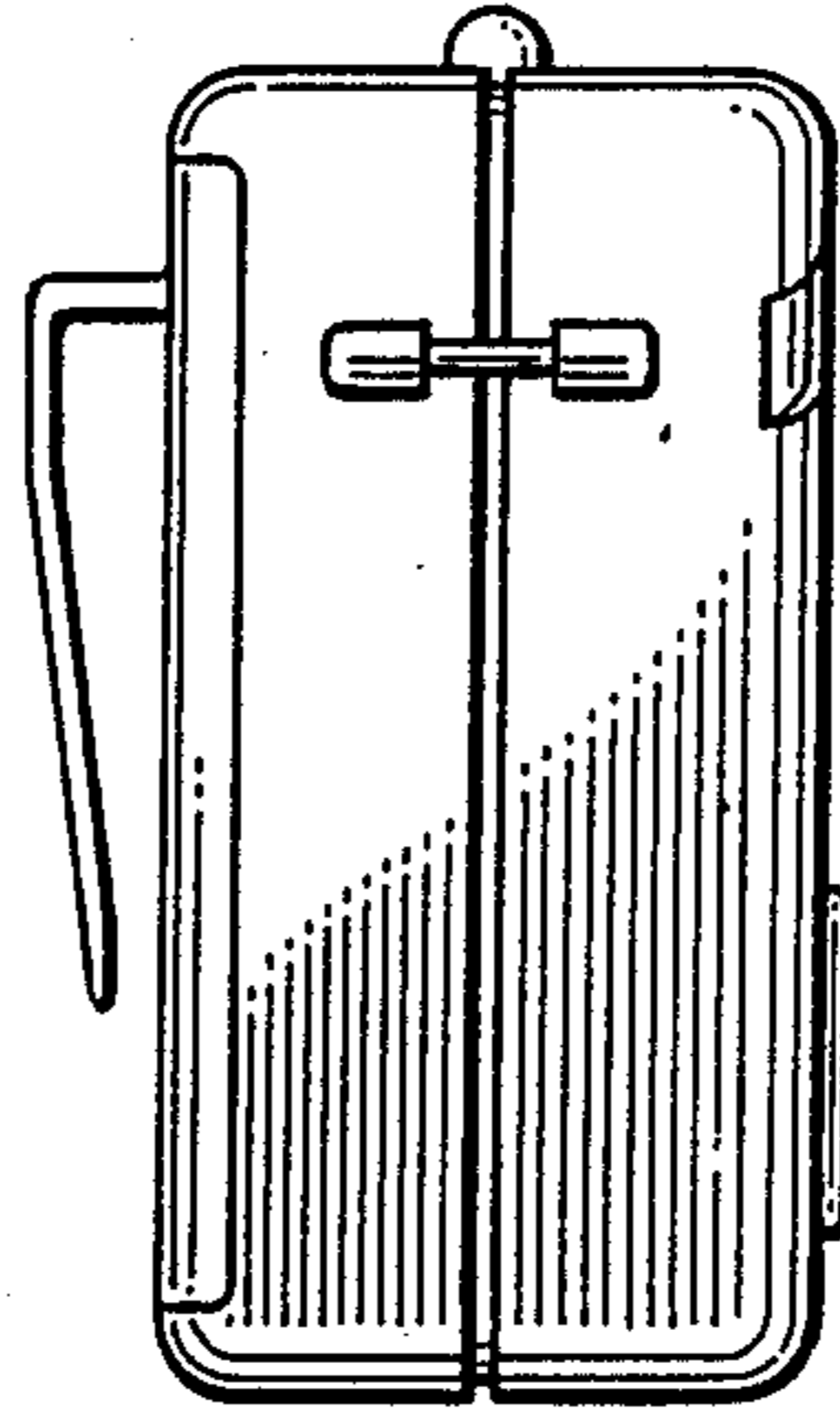

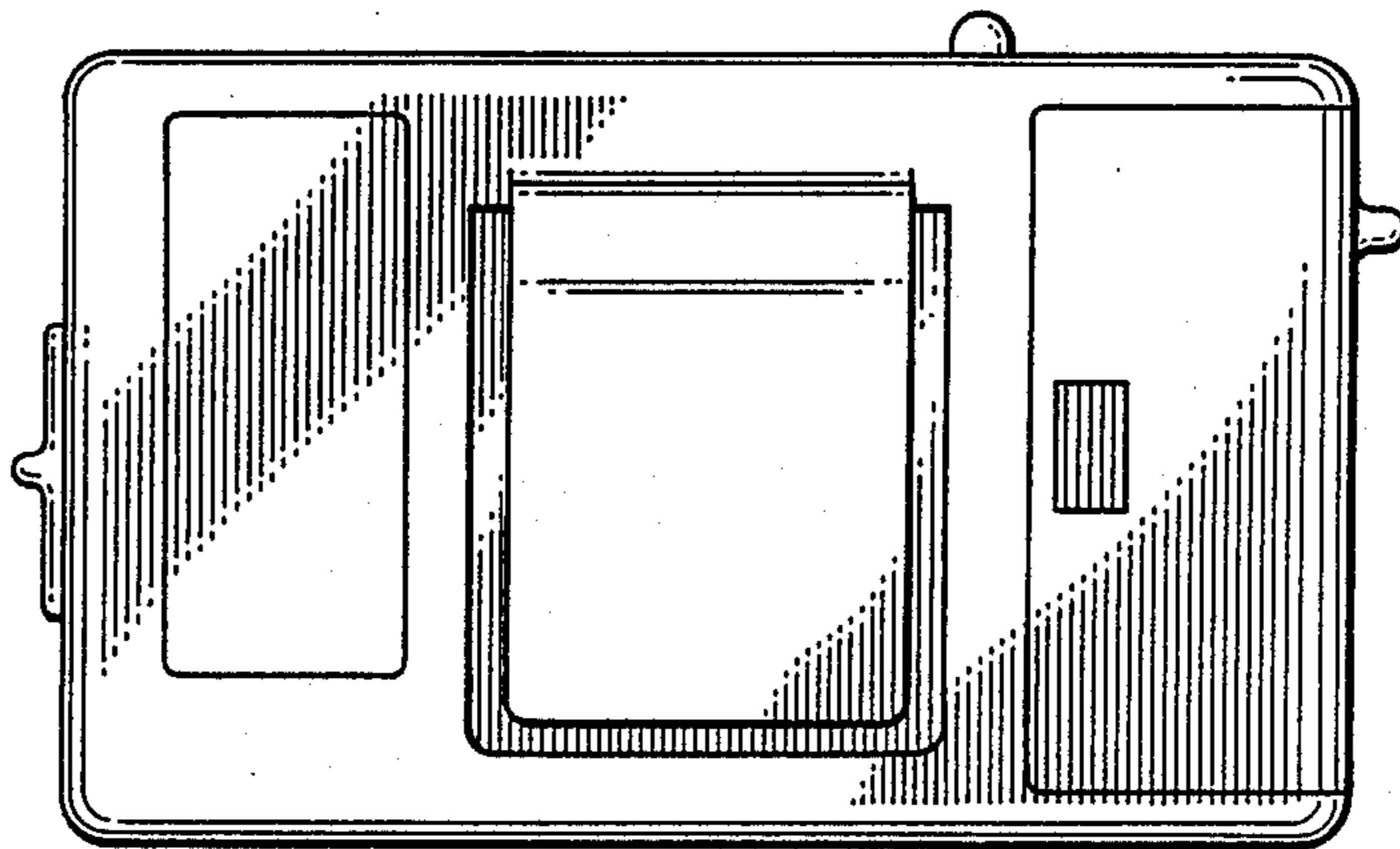

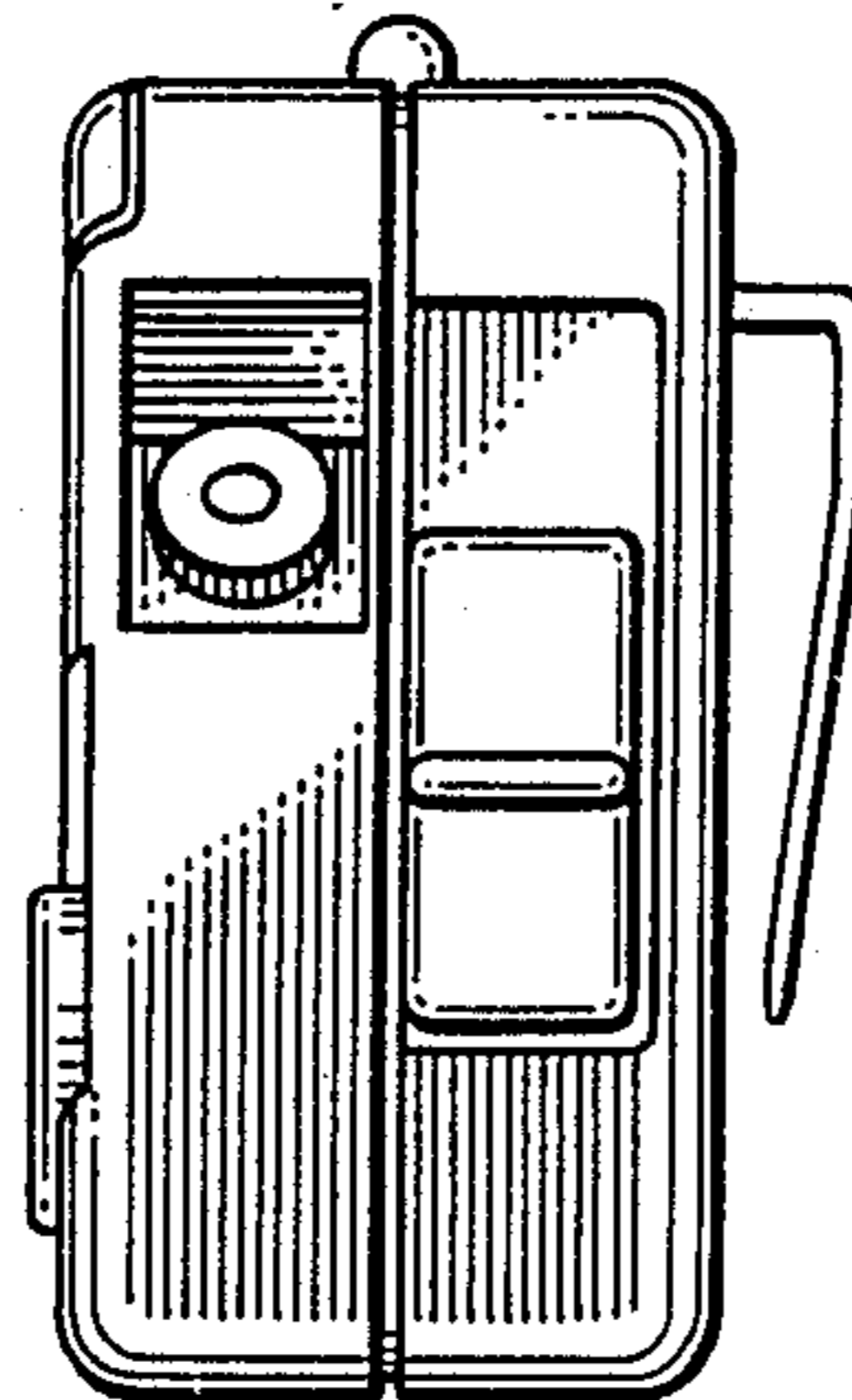
