The ornamental design for a violin support, as shown and described.

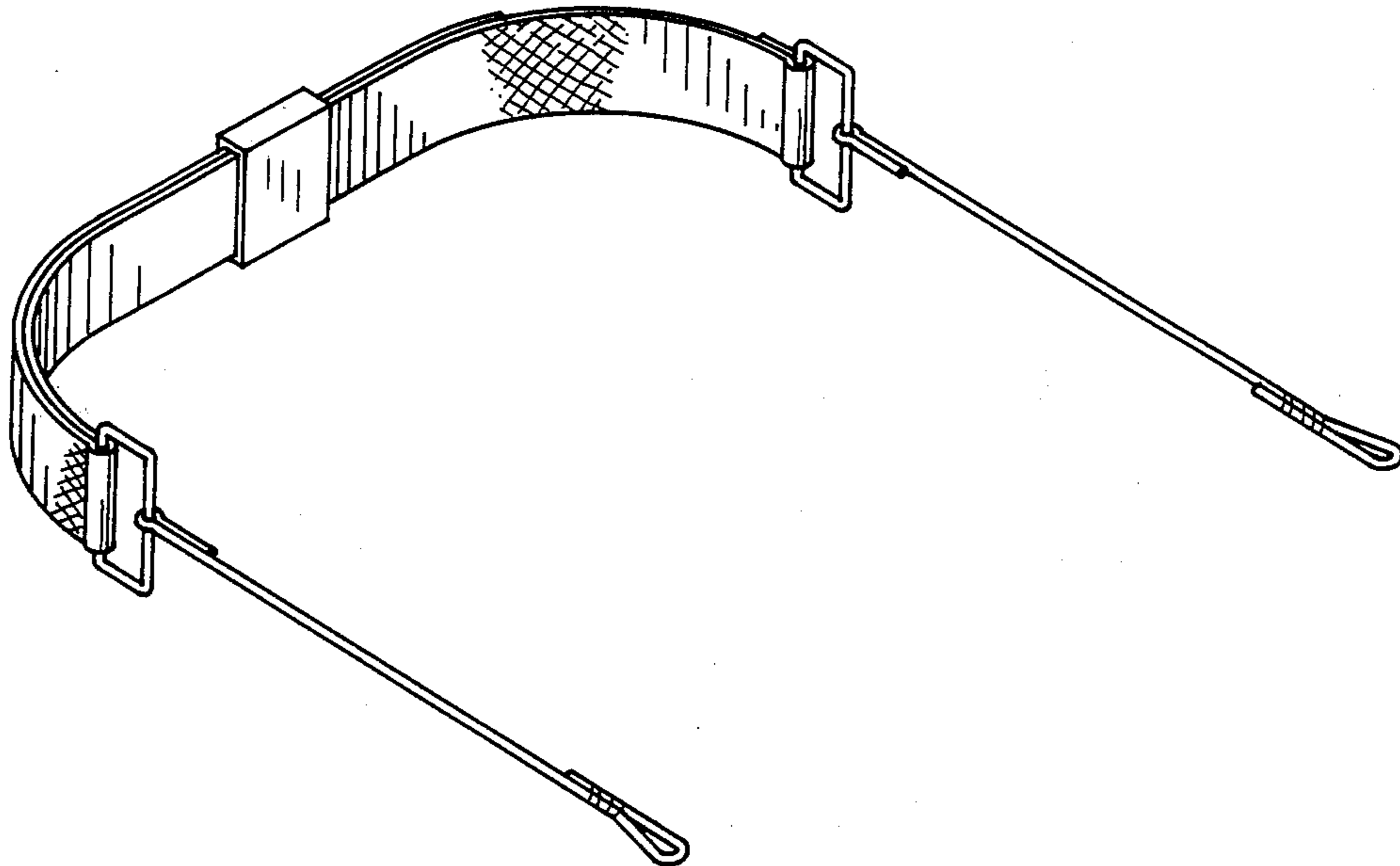
DESCRIPTION

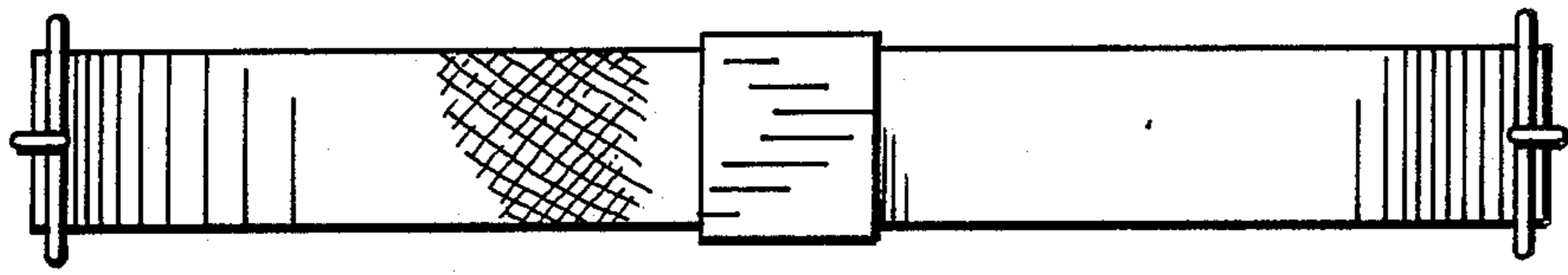

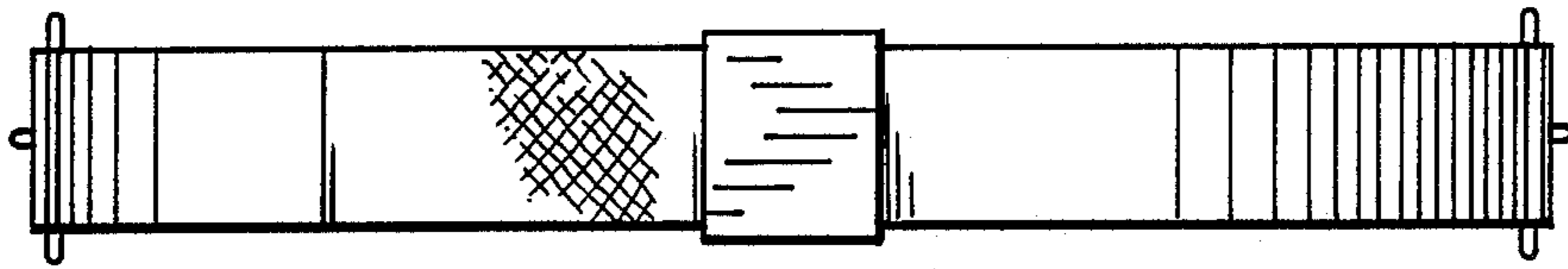

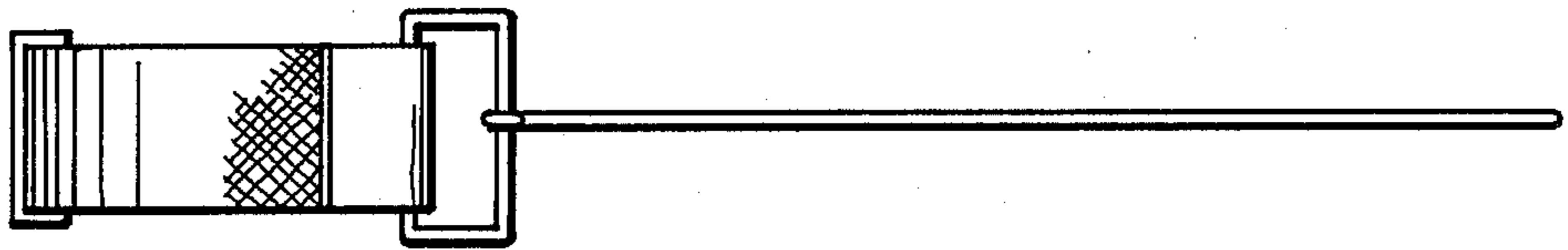

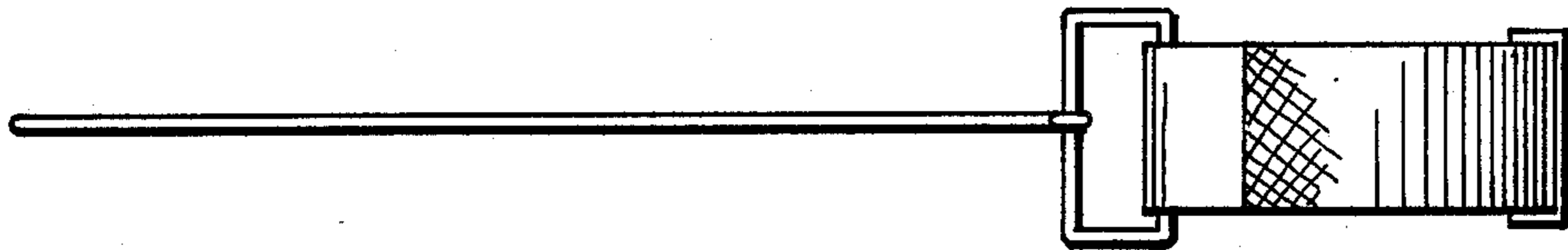

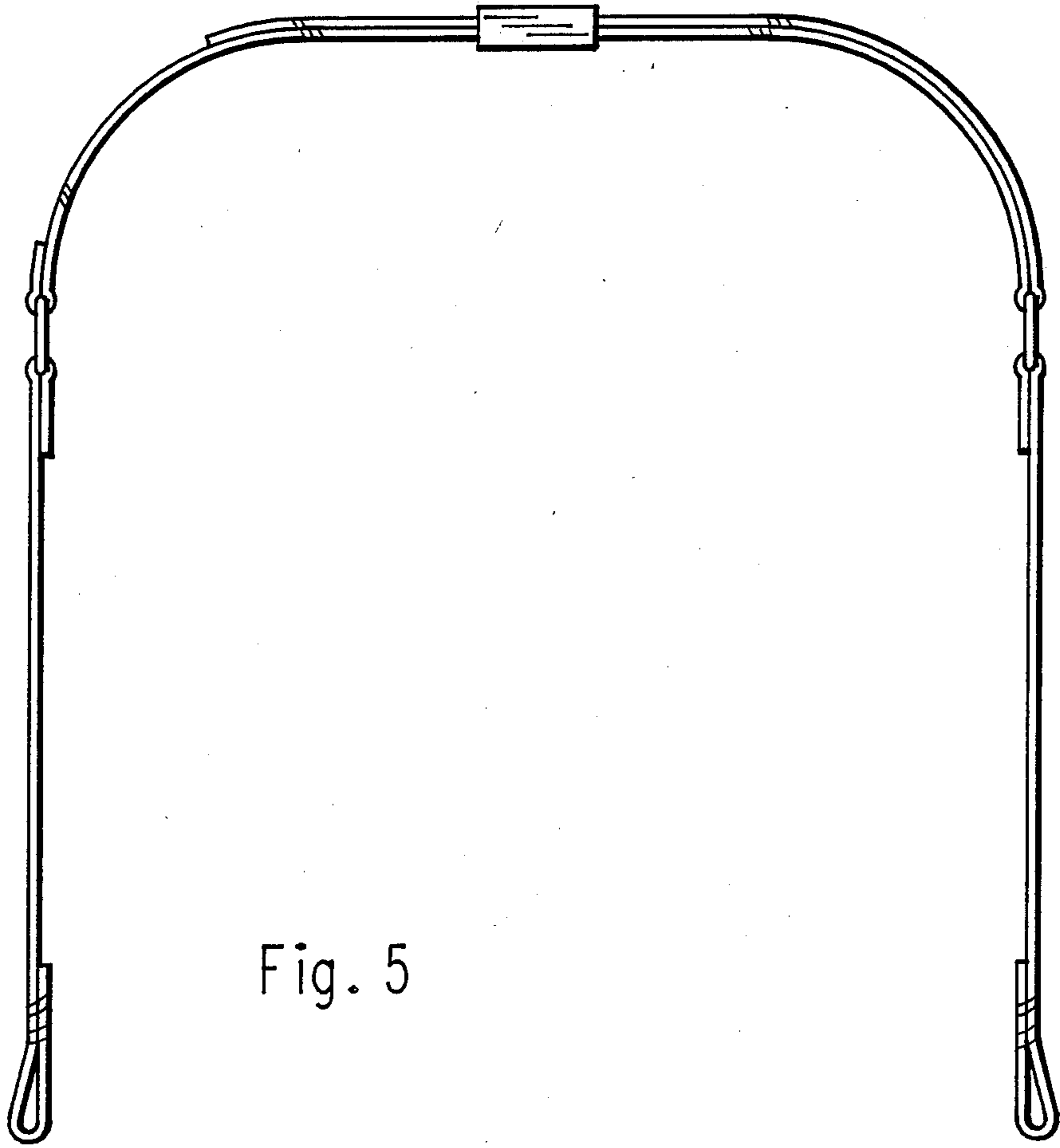

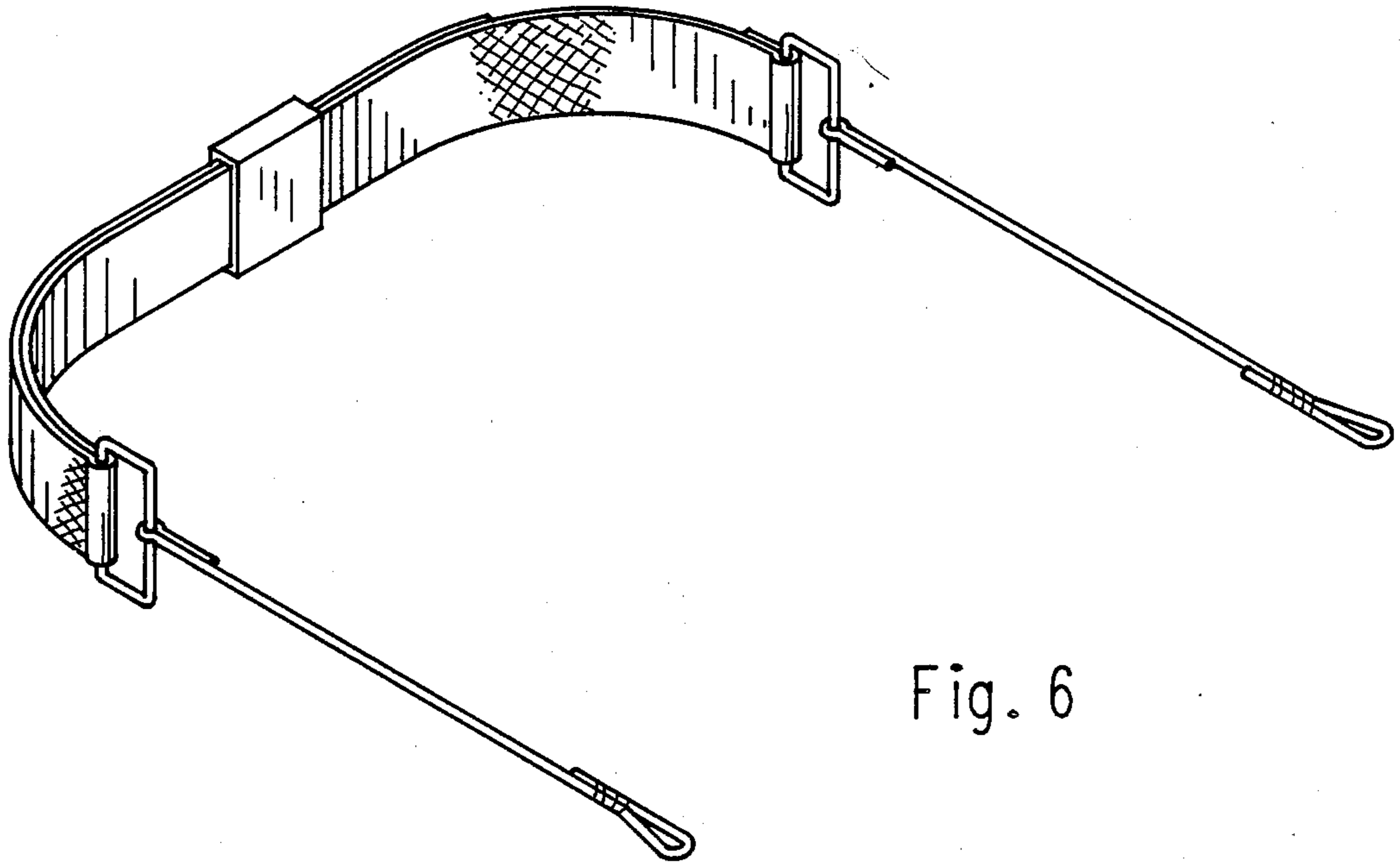
