DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chain link for fences, suspended supports or the like showing my new design, the additional links being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

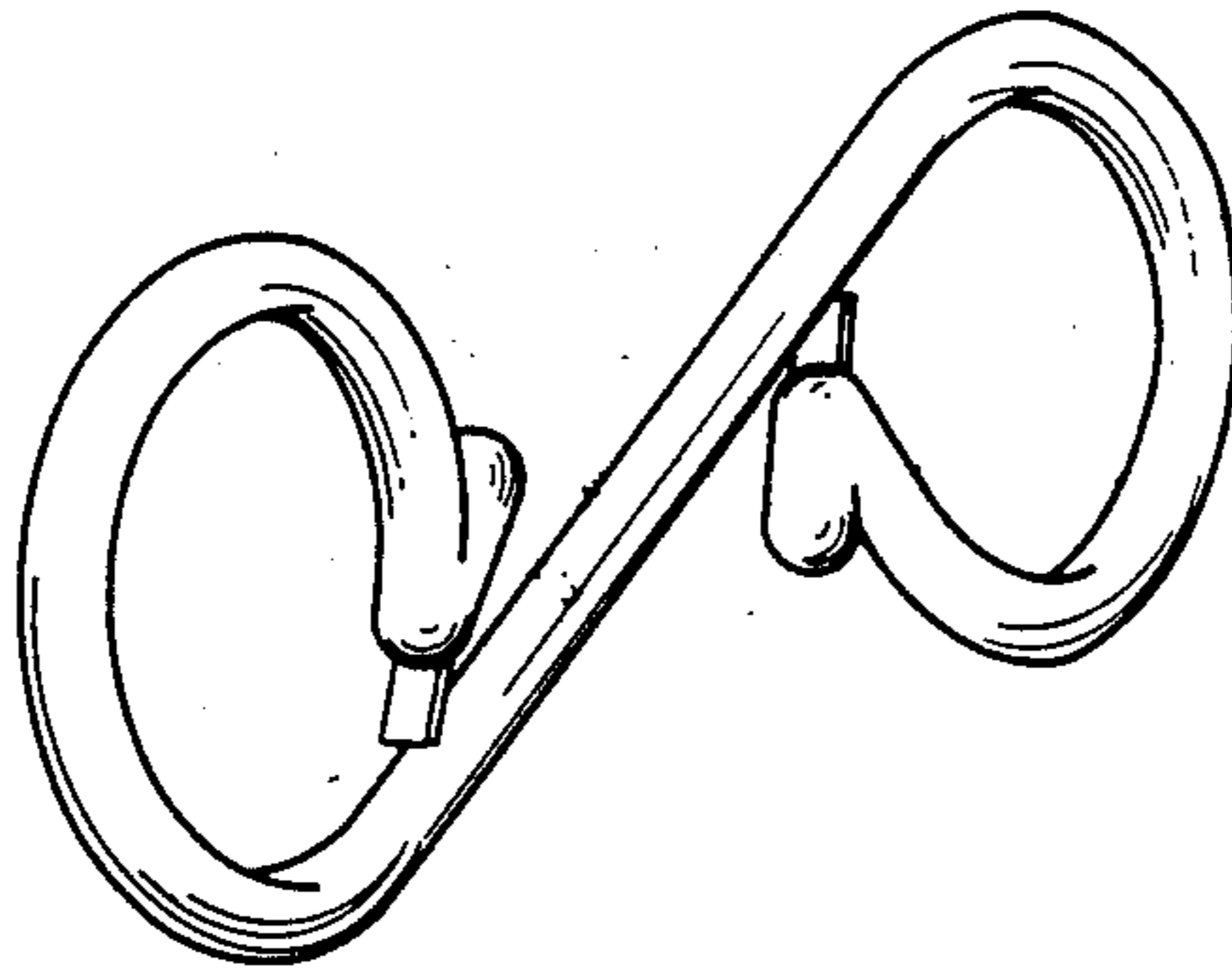
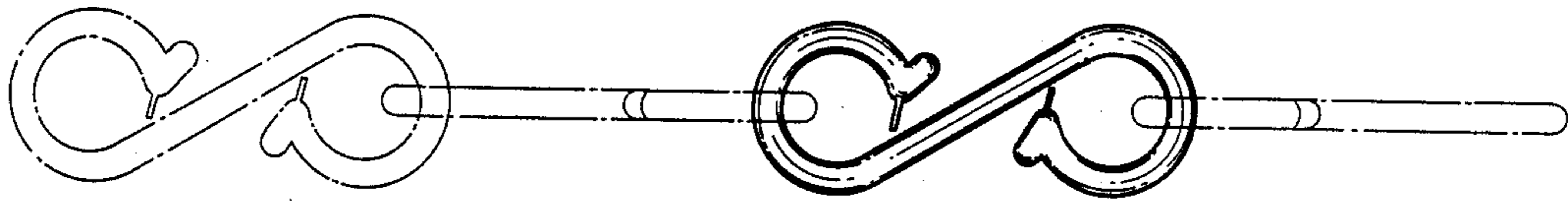
FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 6—6 of FIG. 3.



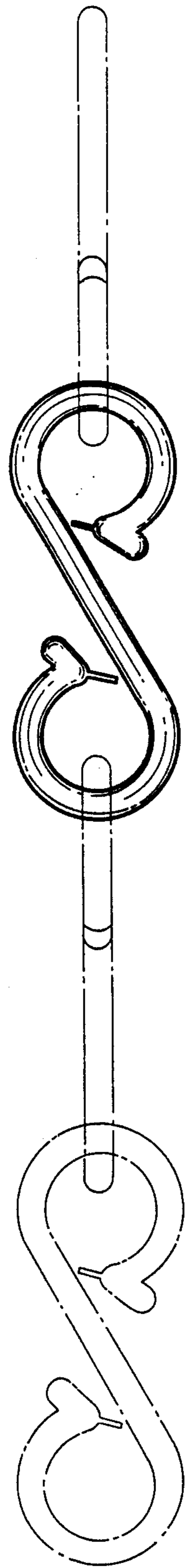

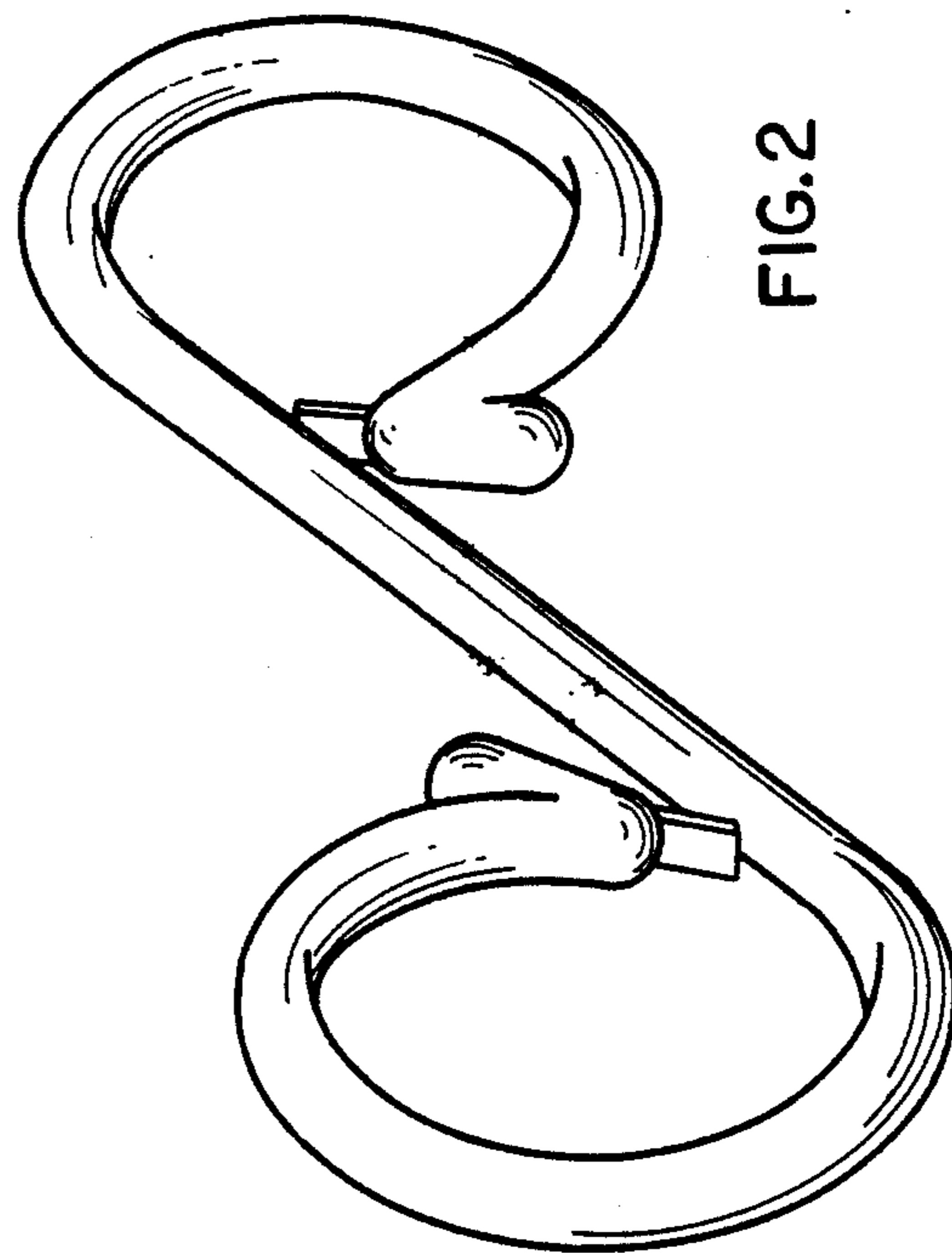

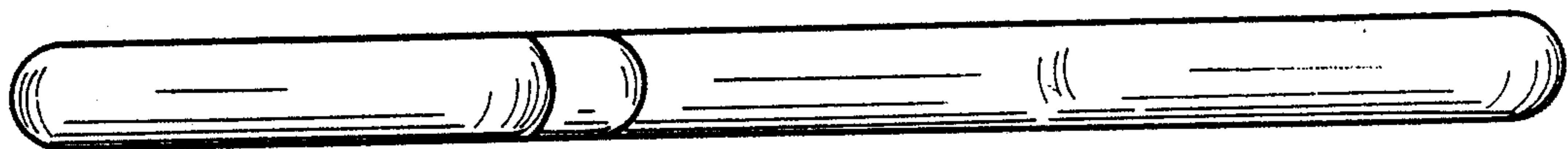
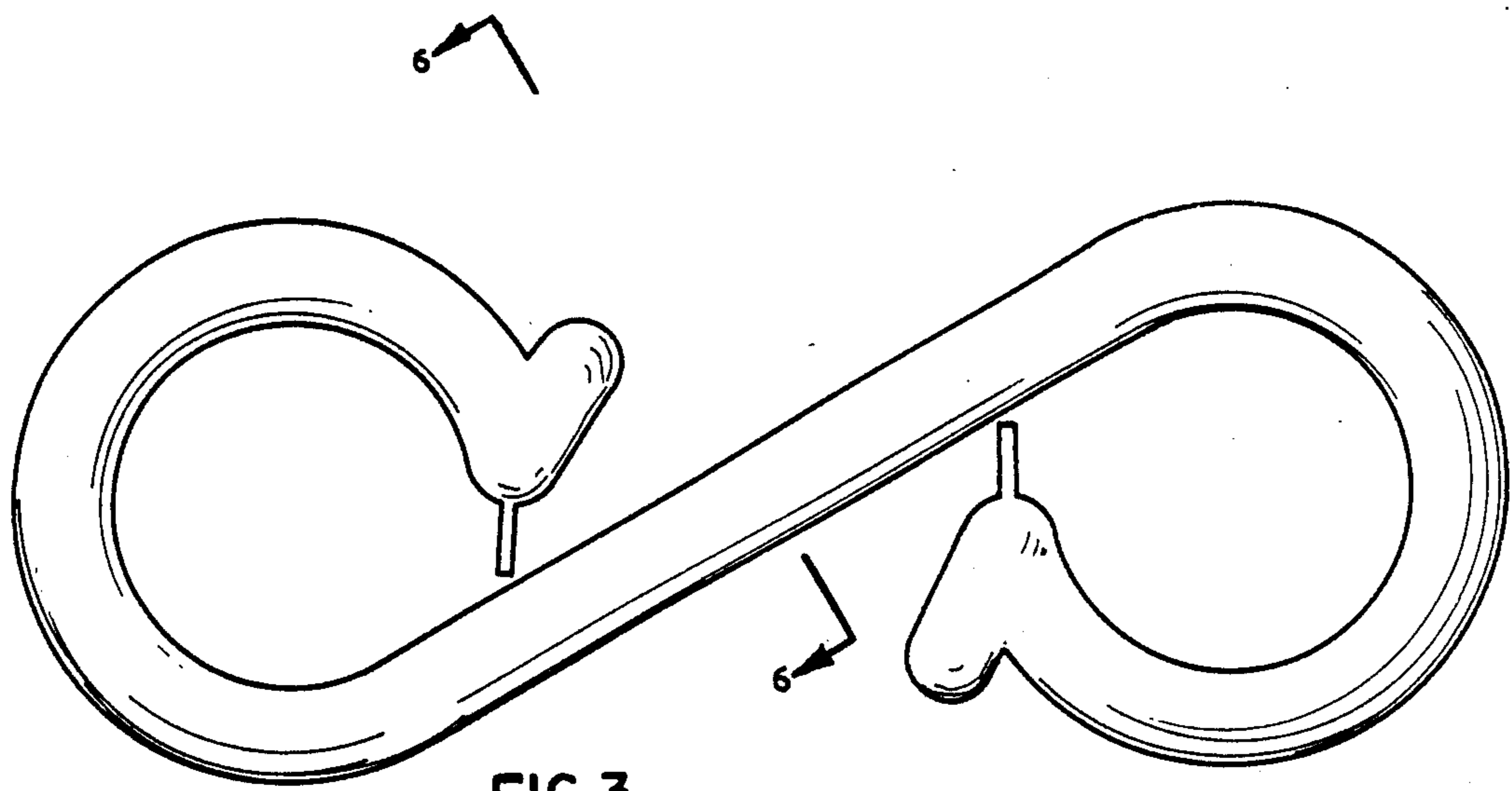
