enlarged scale;

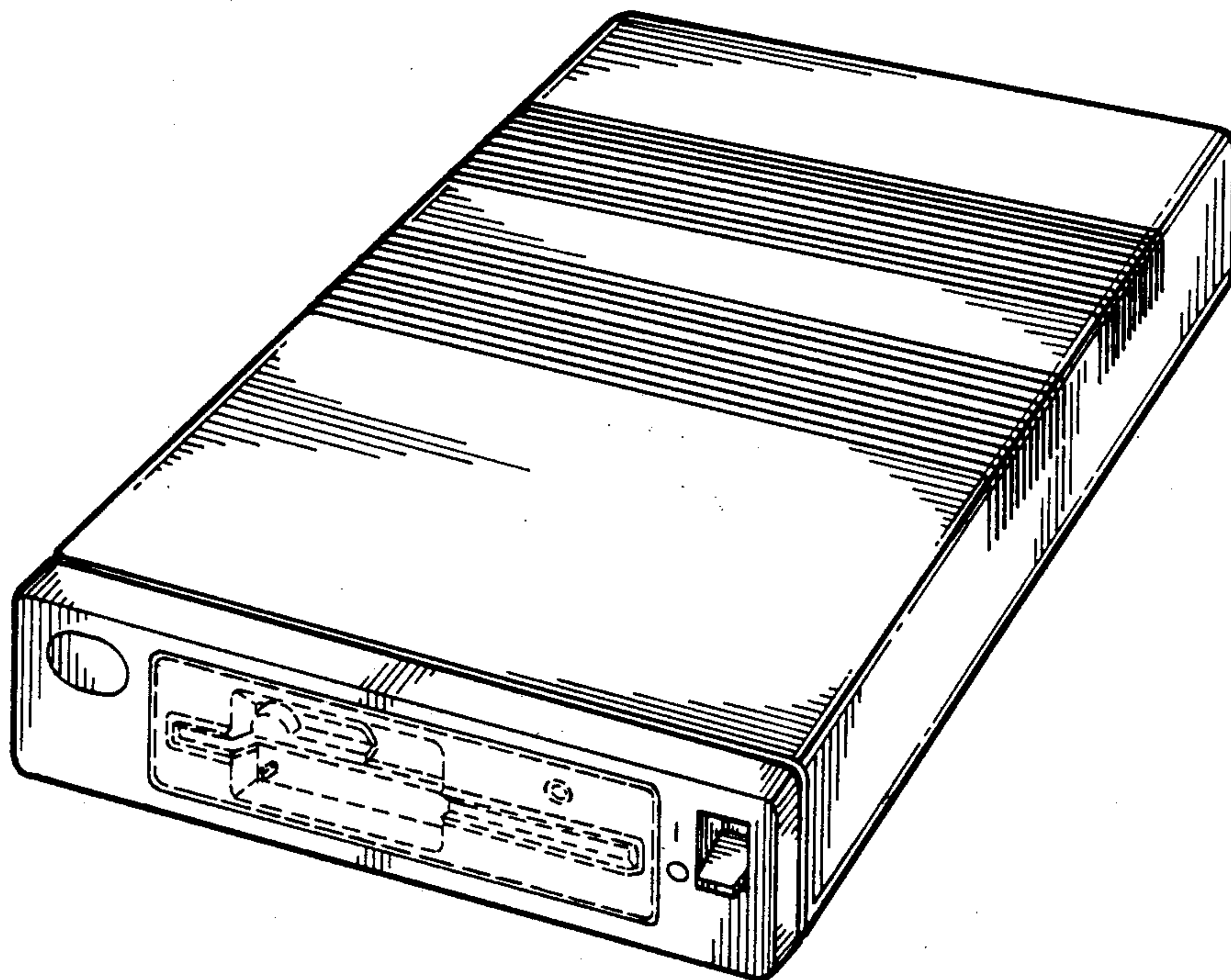
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof on an

poses only.



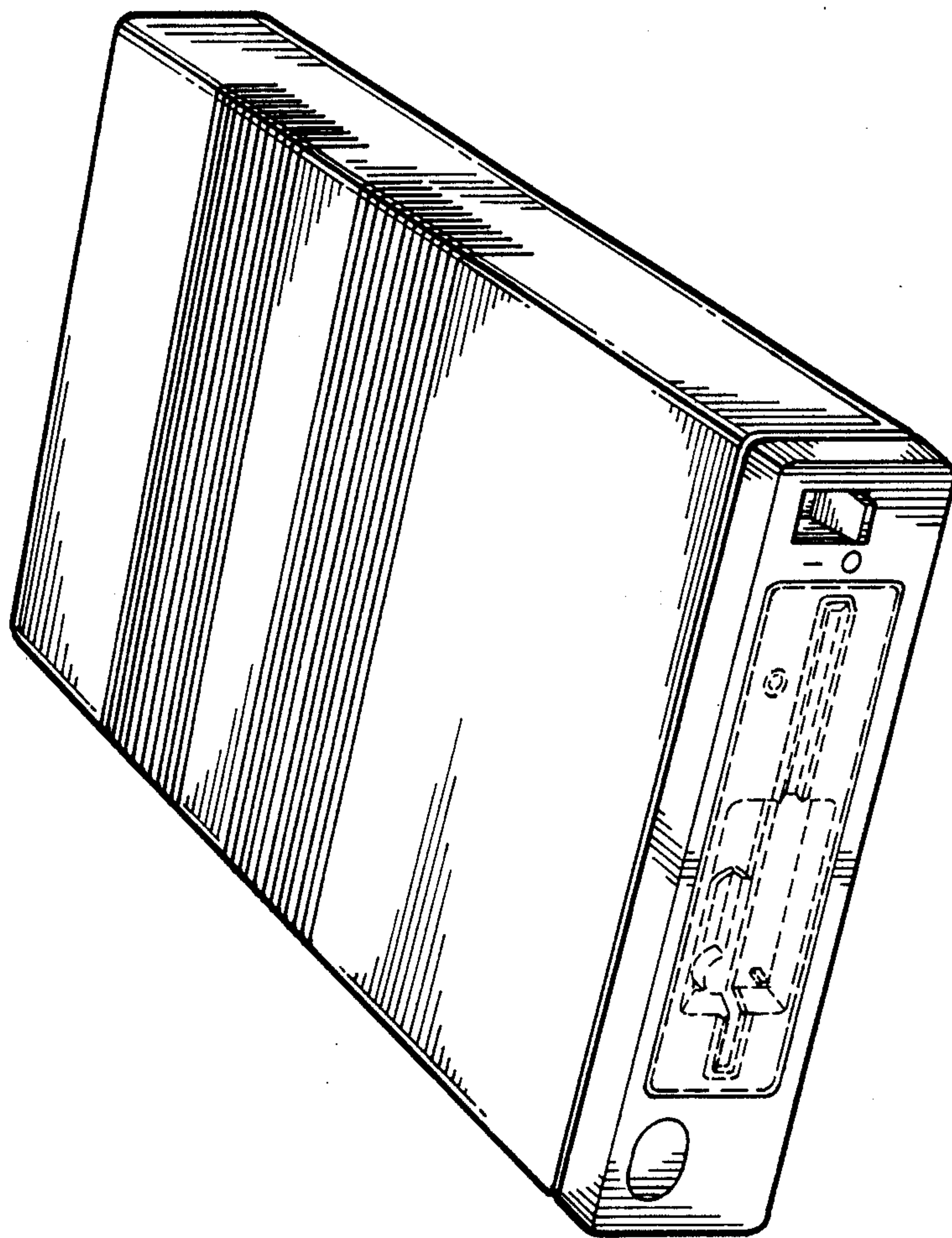

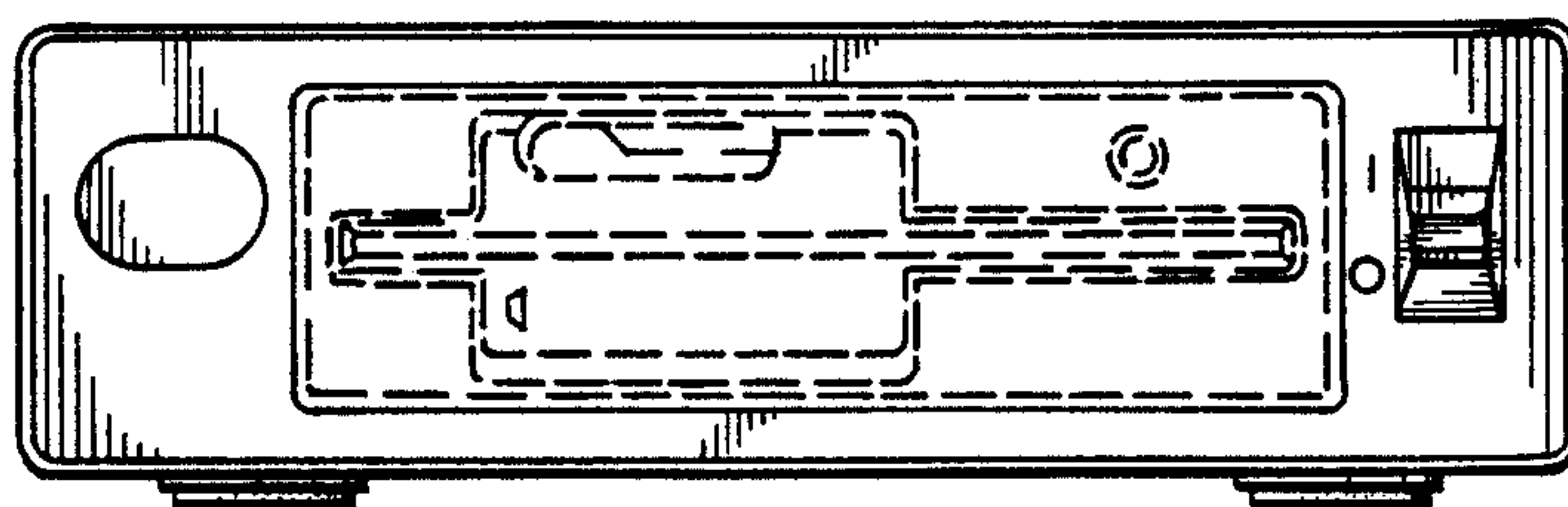

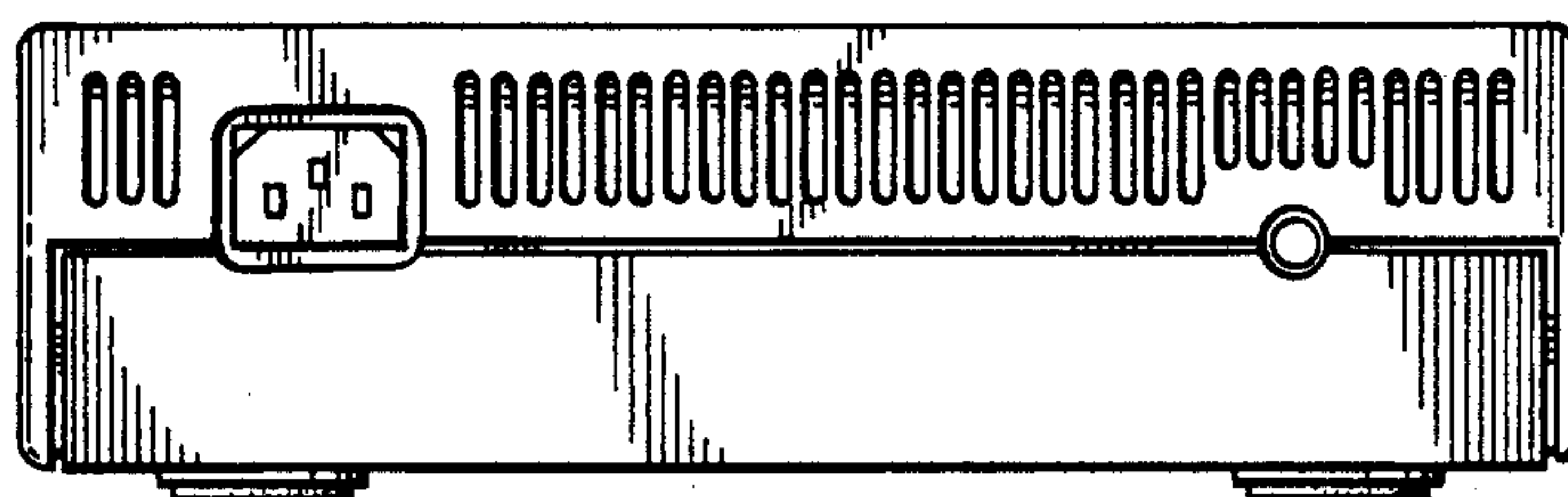

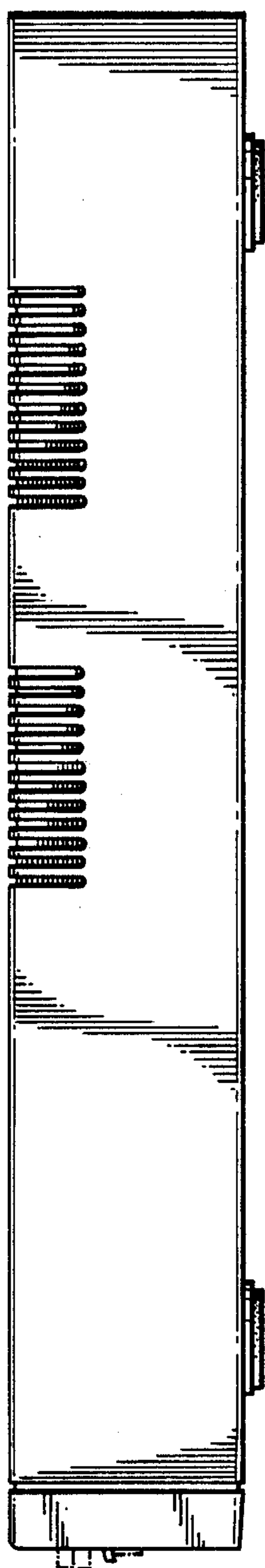

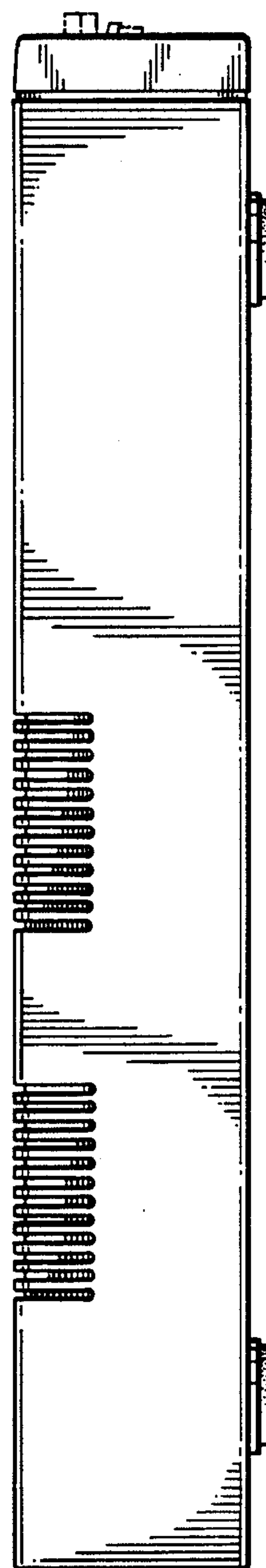

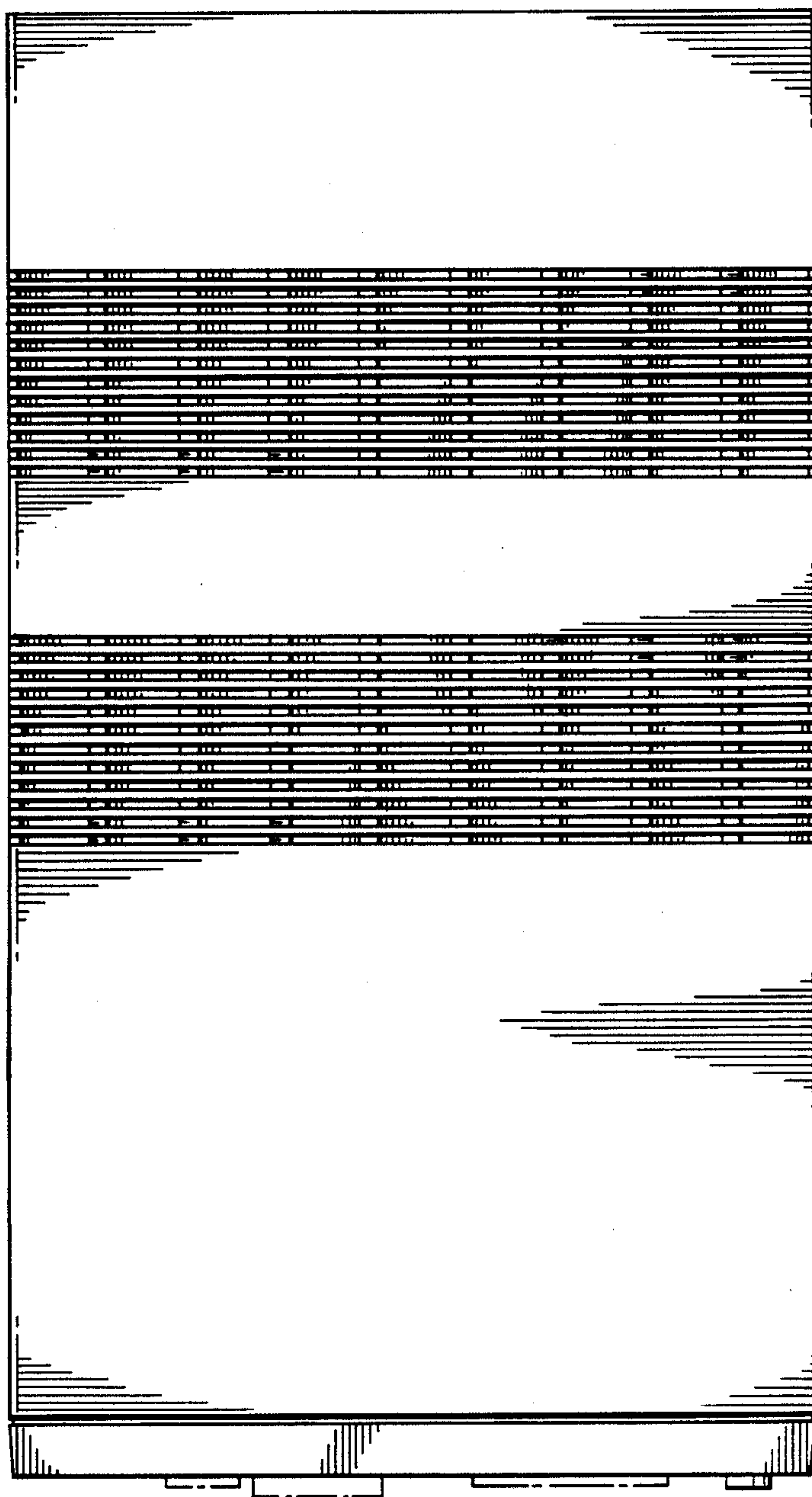

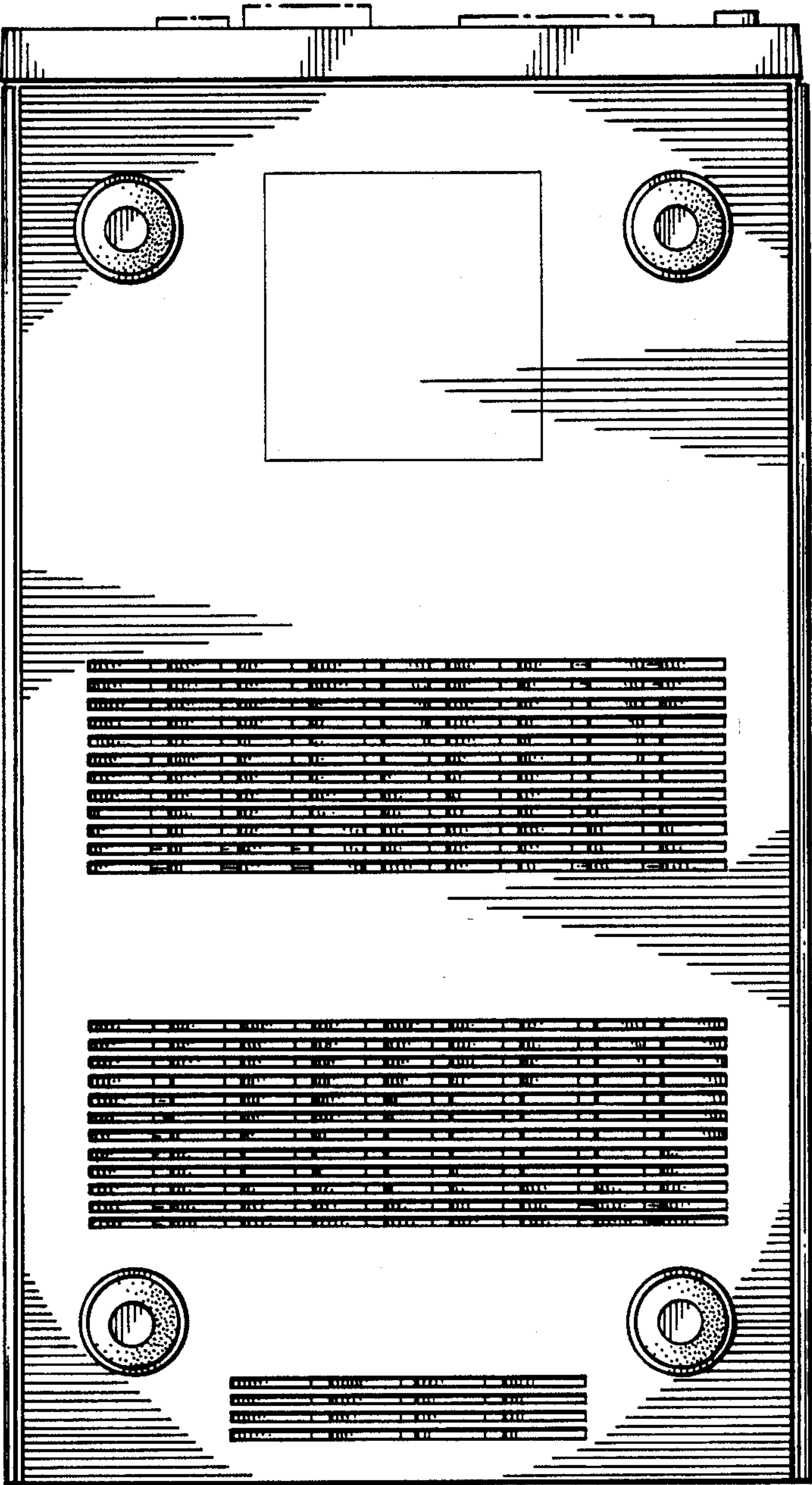
