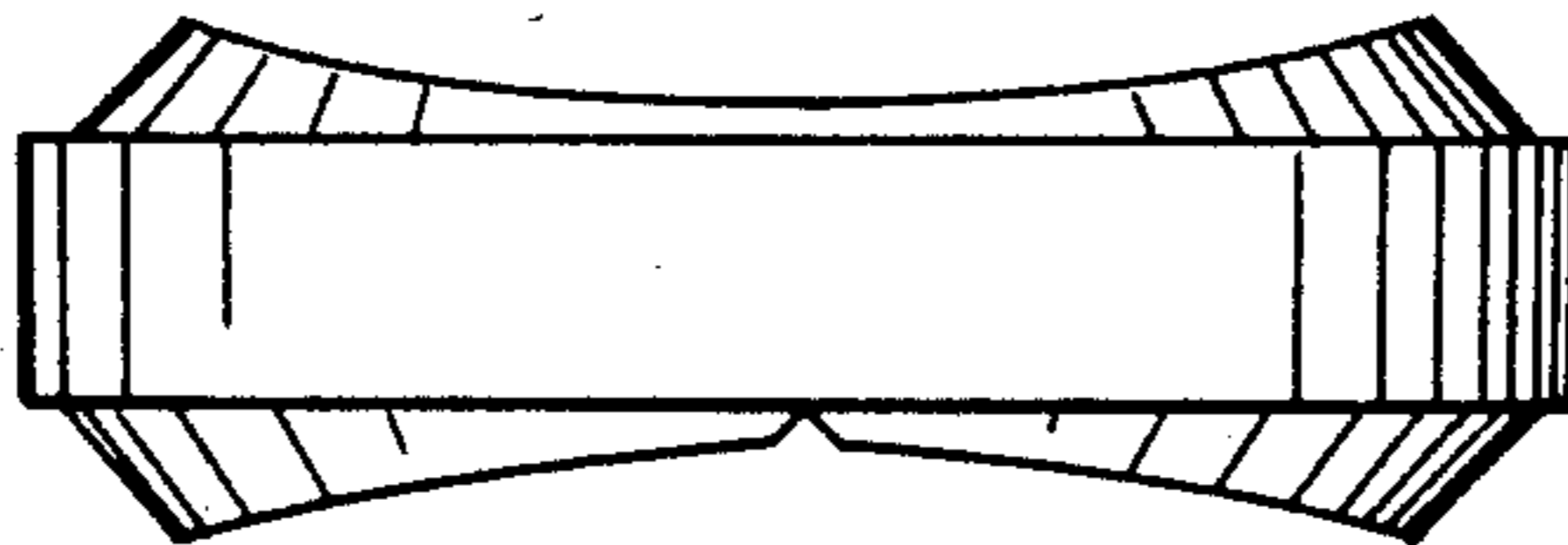
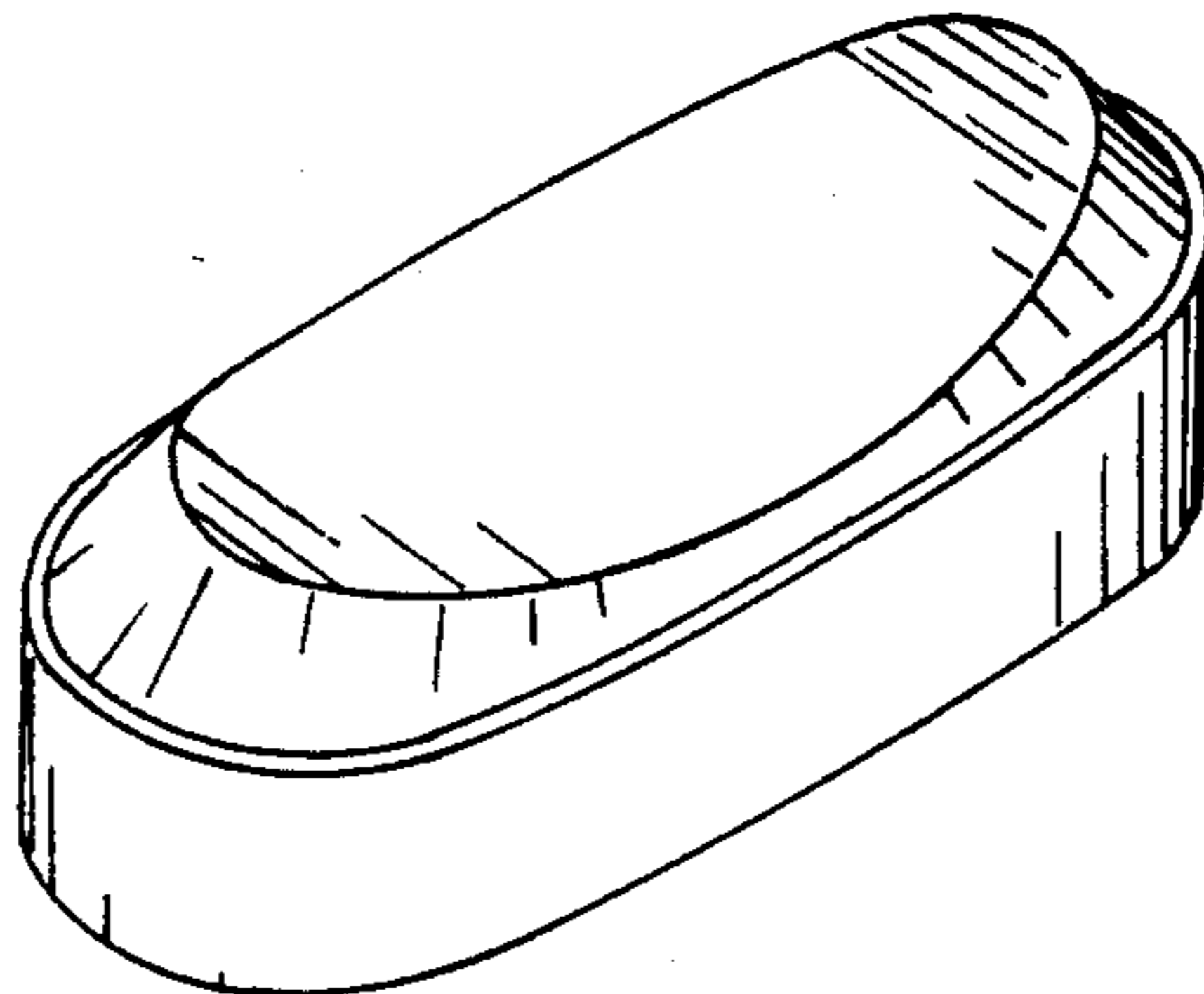

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and front perspective view of a drug tablet showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom and front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical thereto; and
FIG. 6 is a left end elevational view thereof, the right end elevational view being identical thereto.



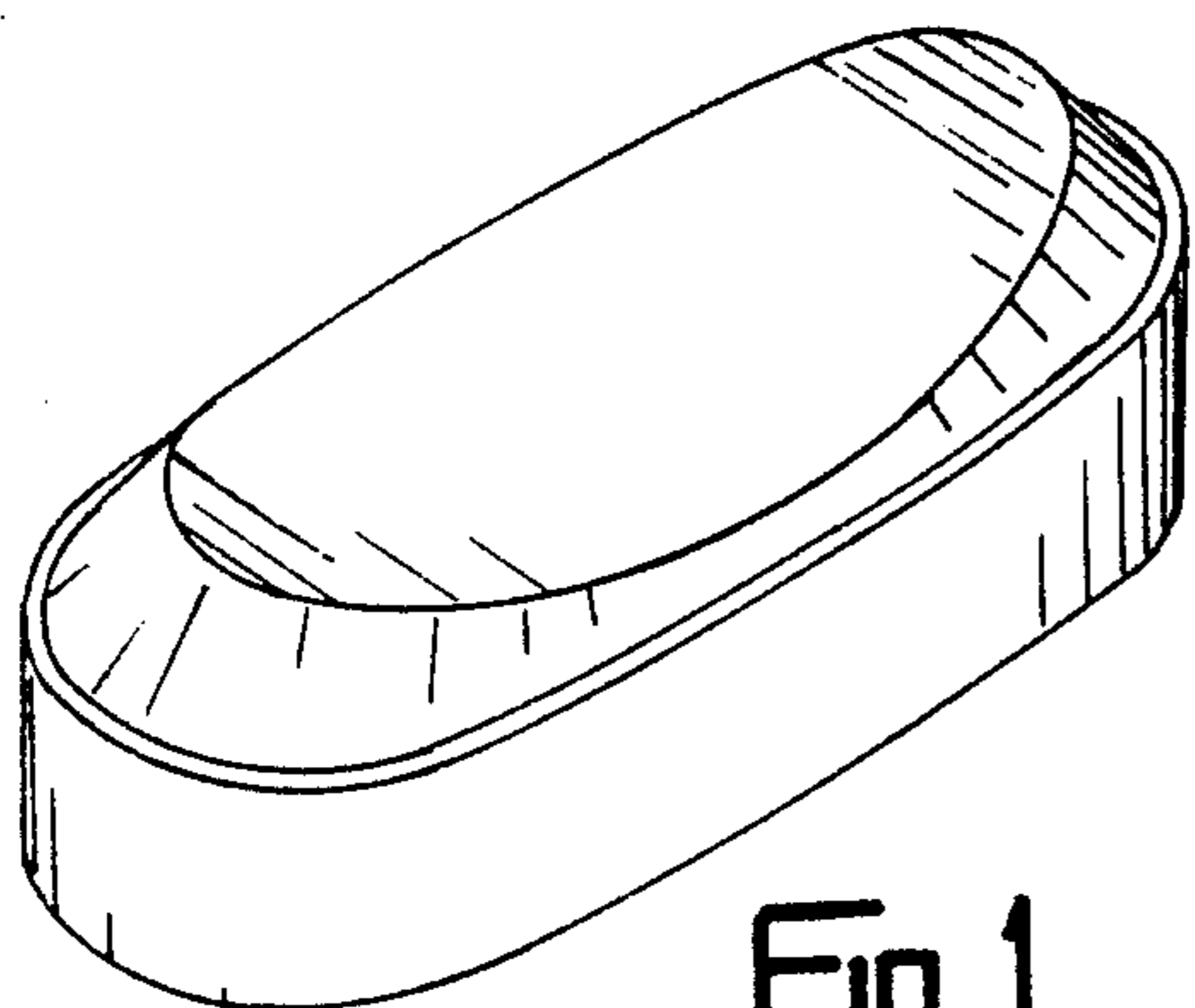

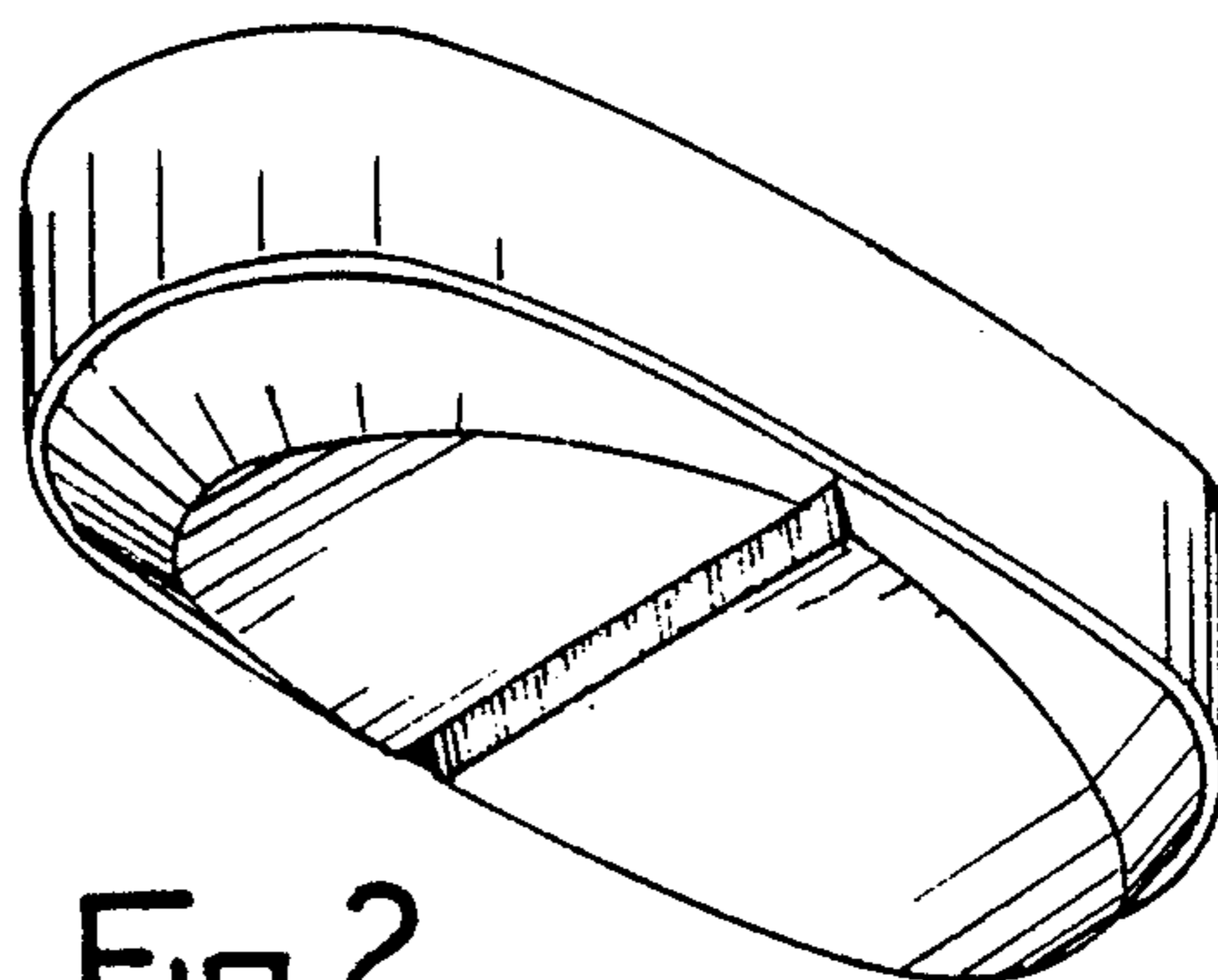

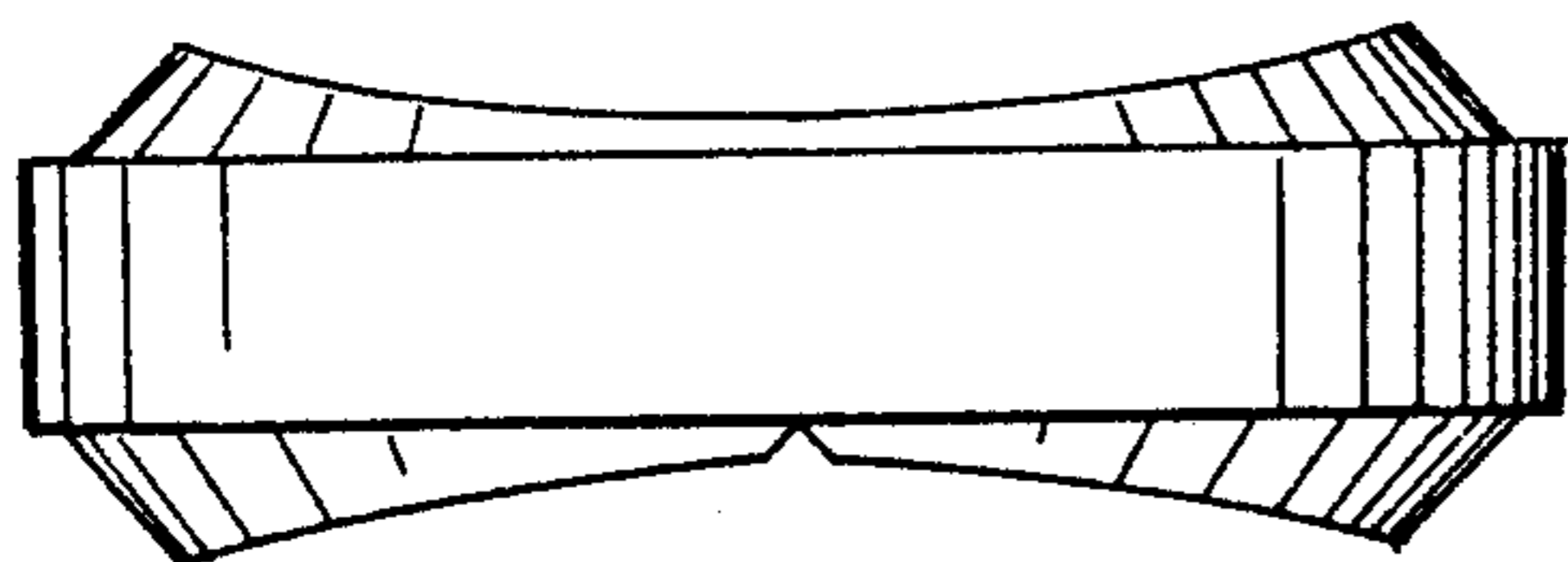

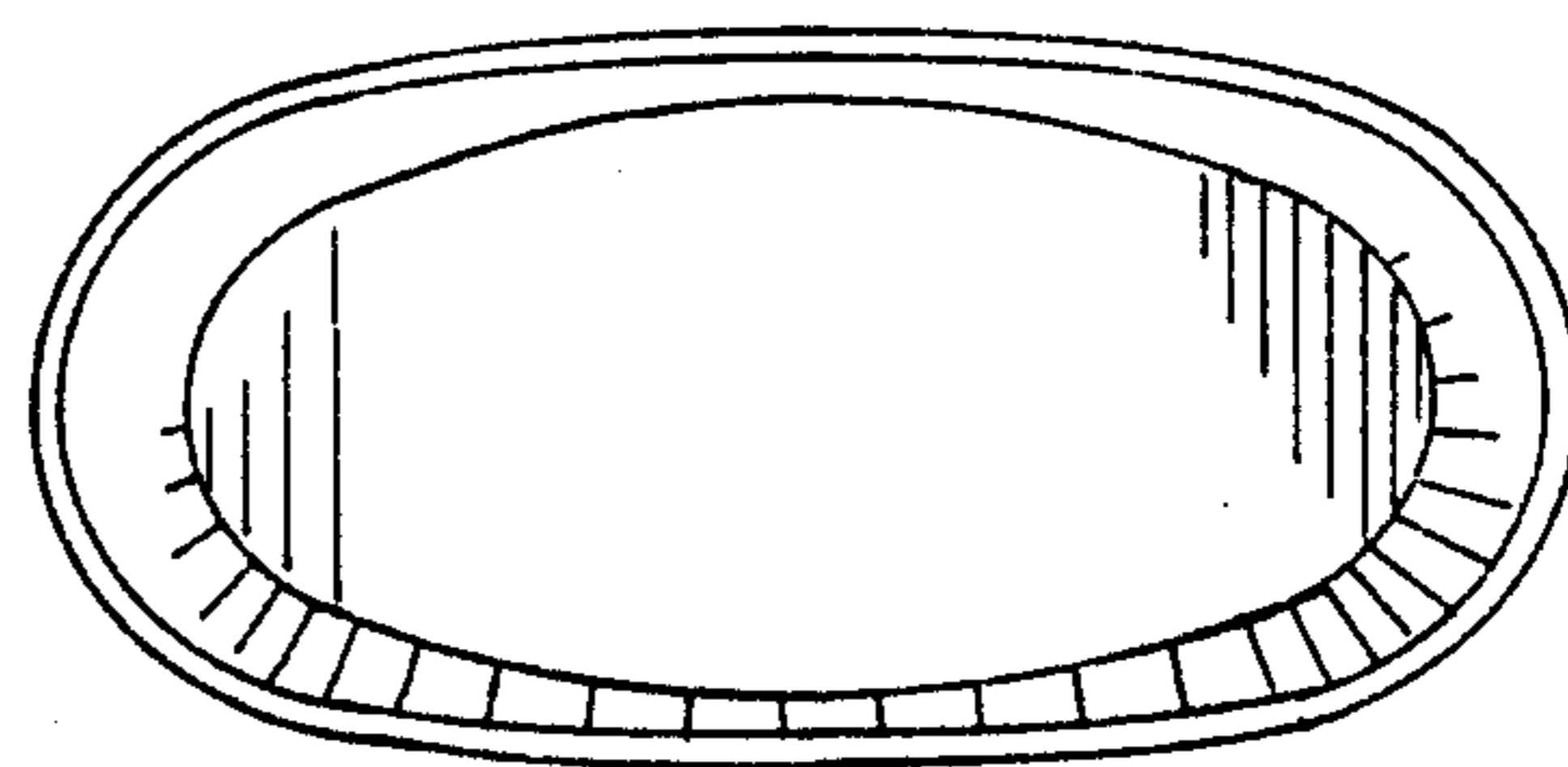

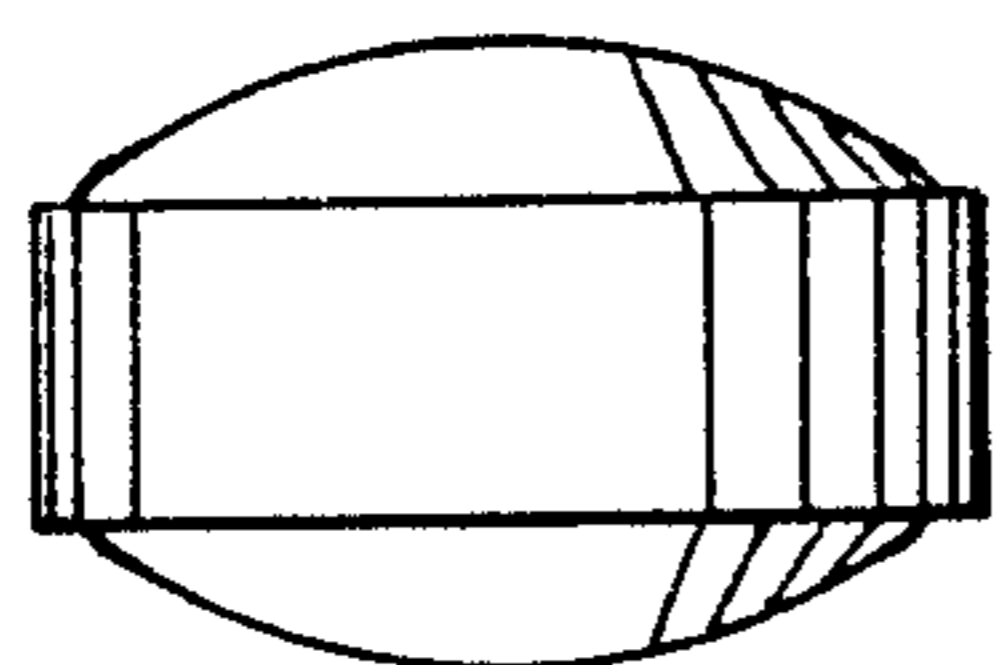

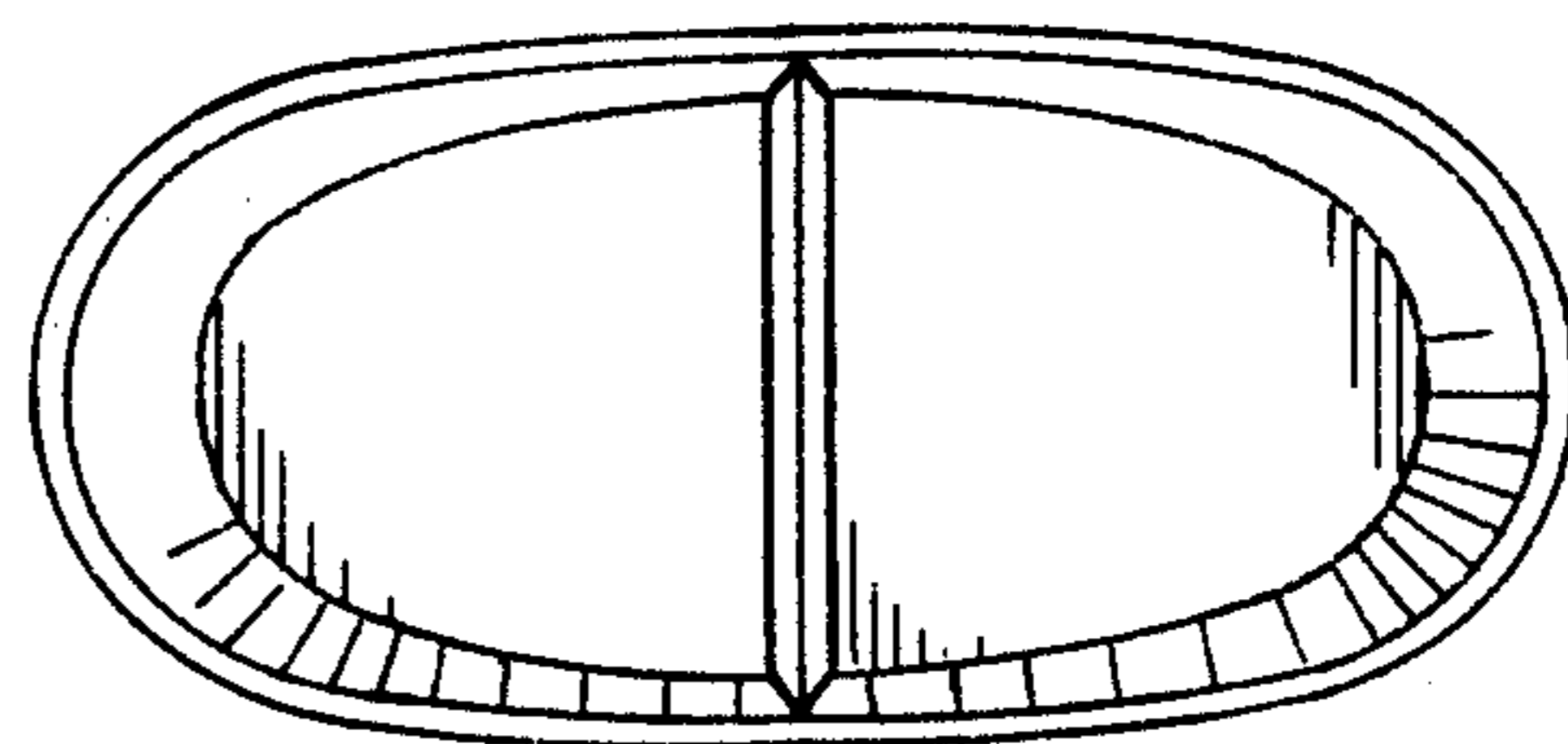
