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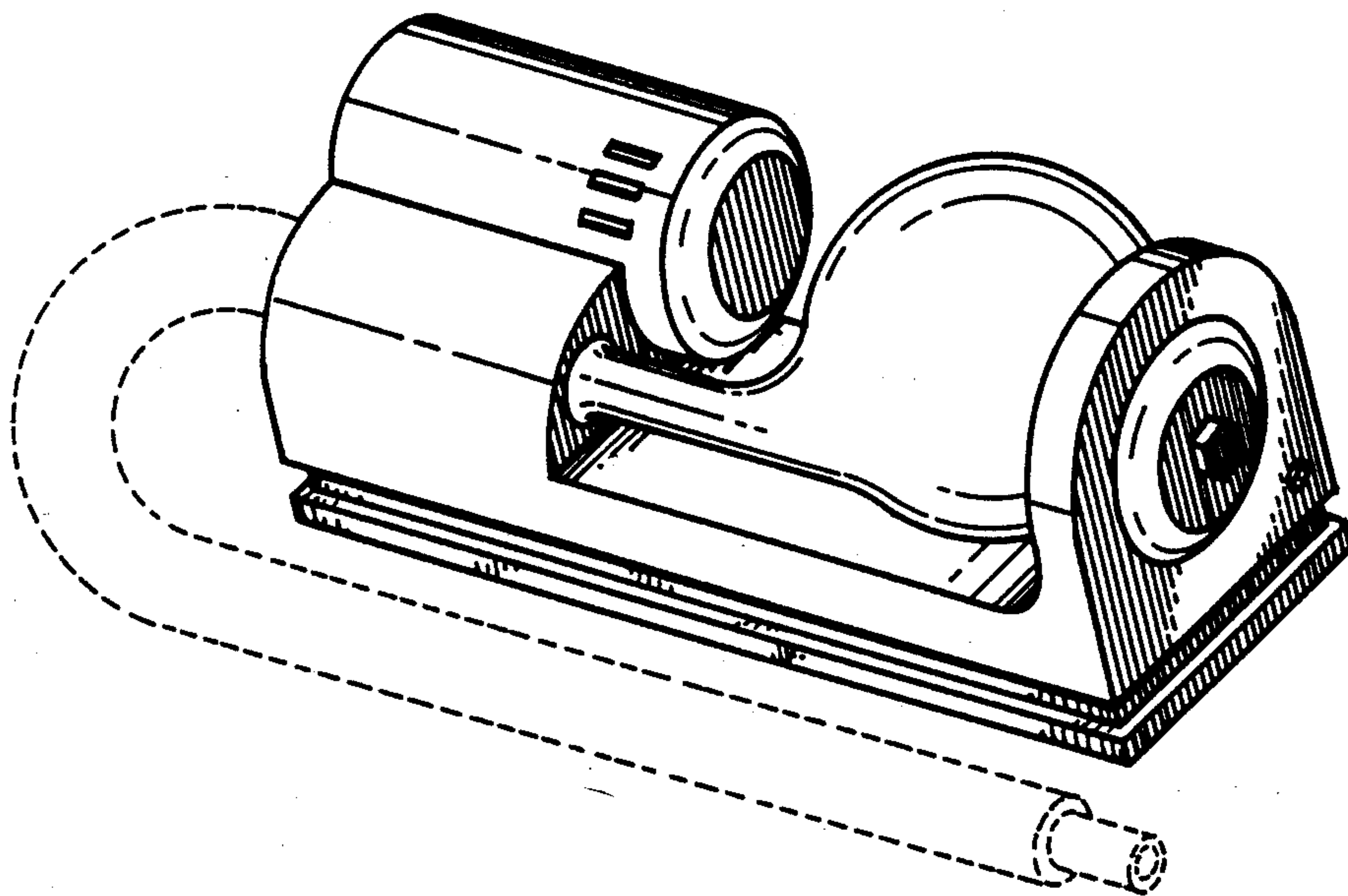

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view showing the top, front and right end of a flea vacuum illustrating my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof. The broken line representation of a hose in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed invention.



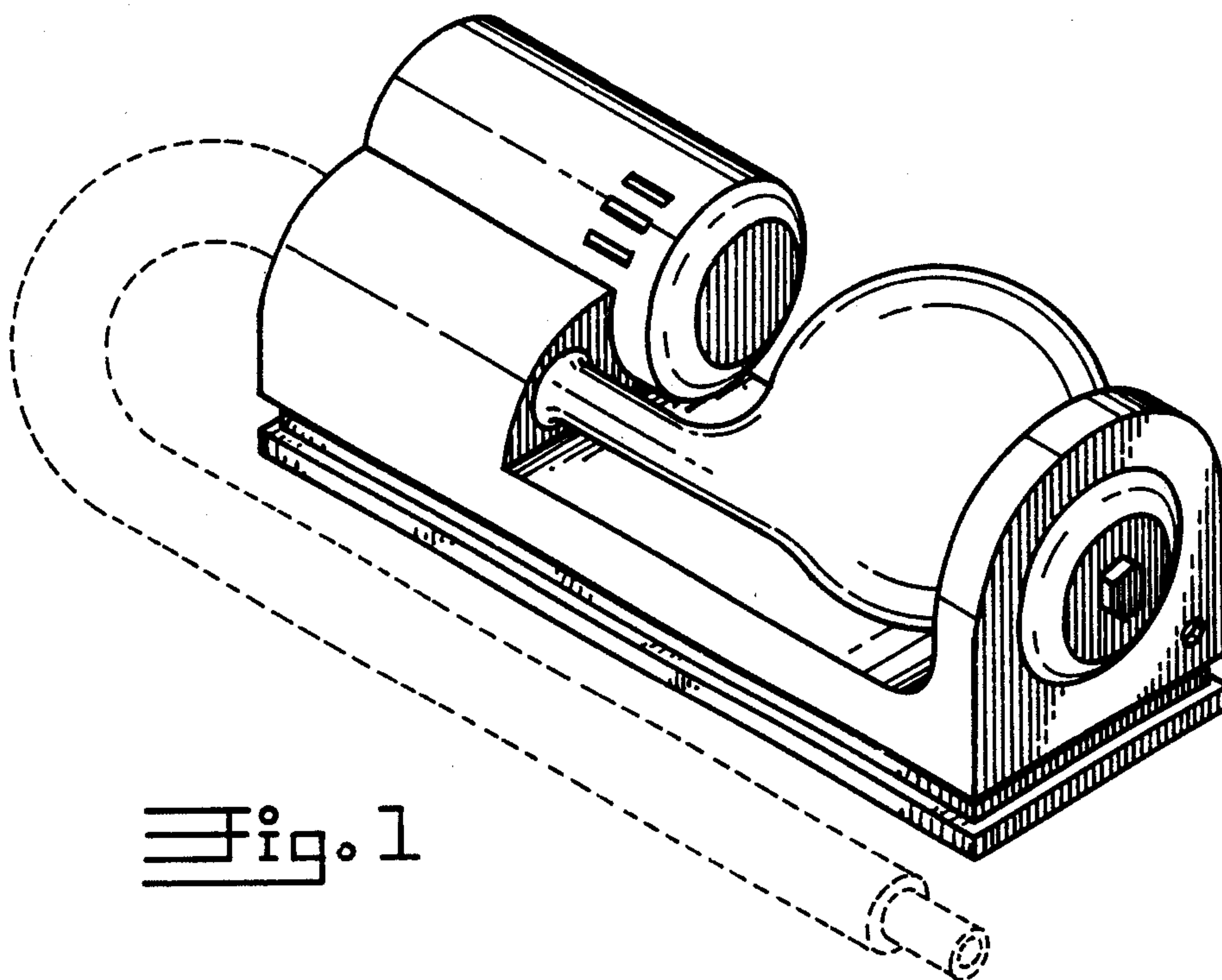

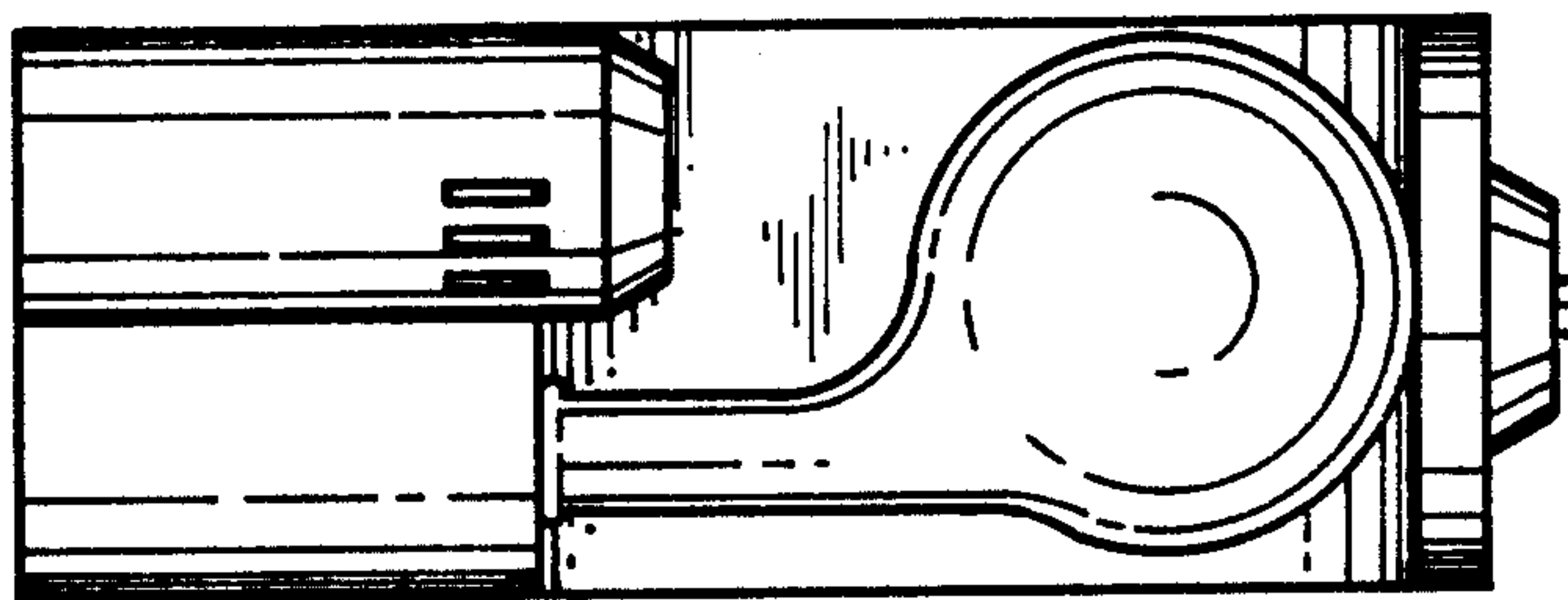
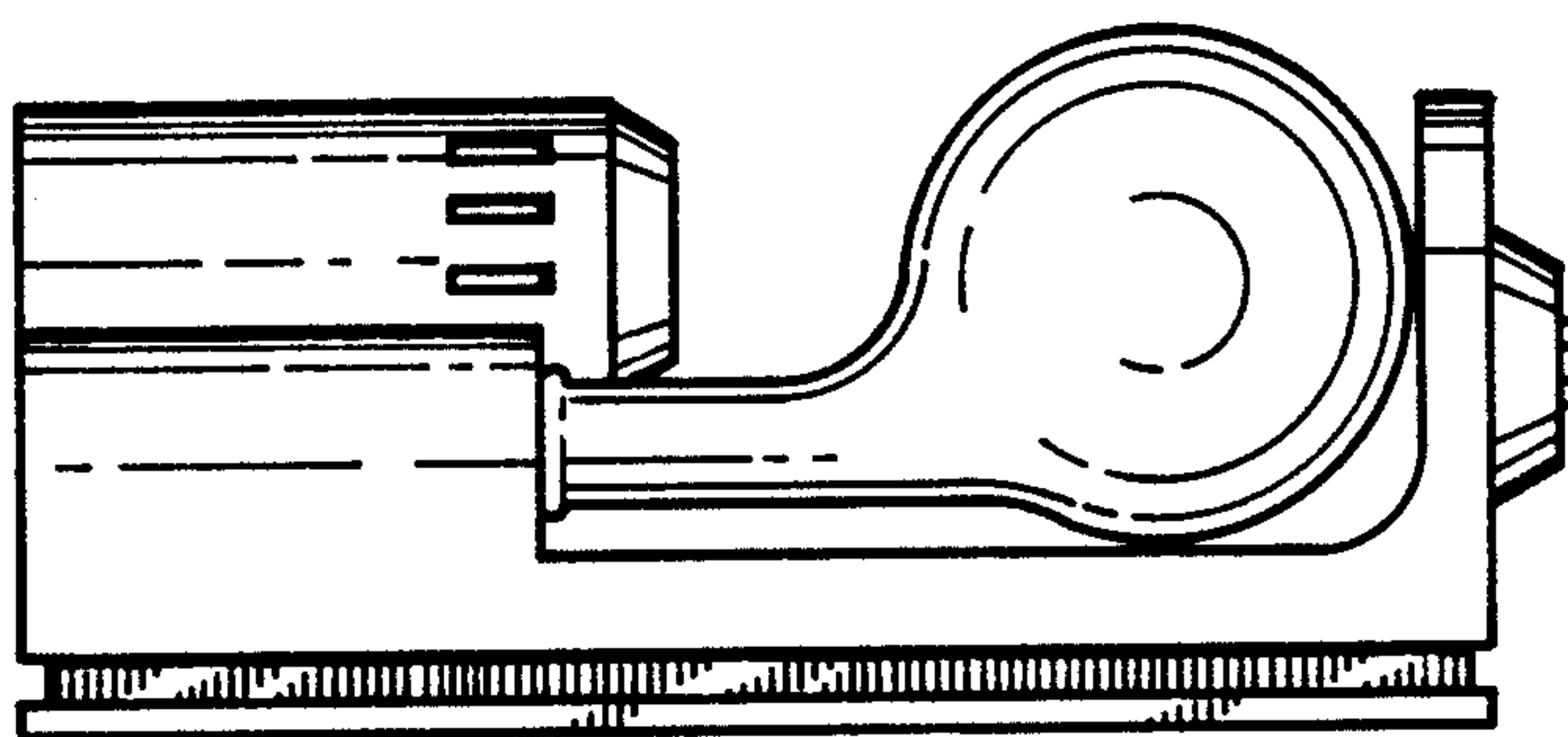

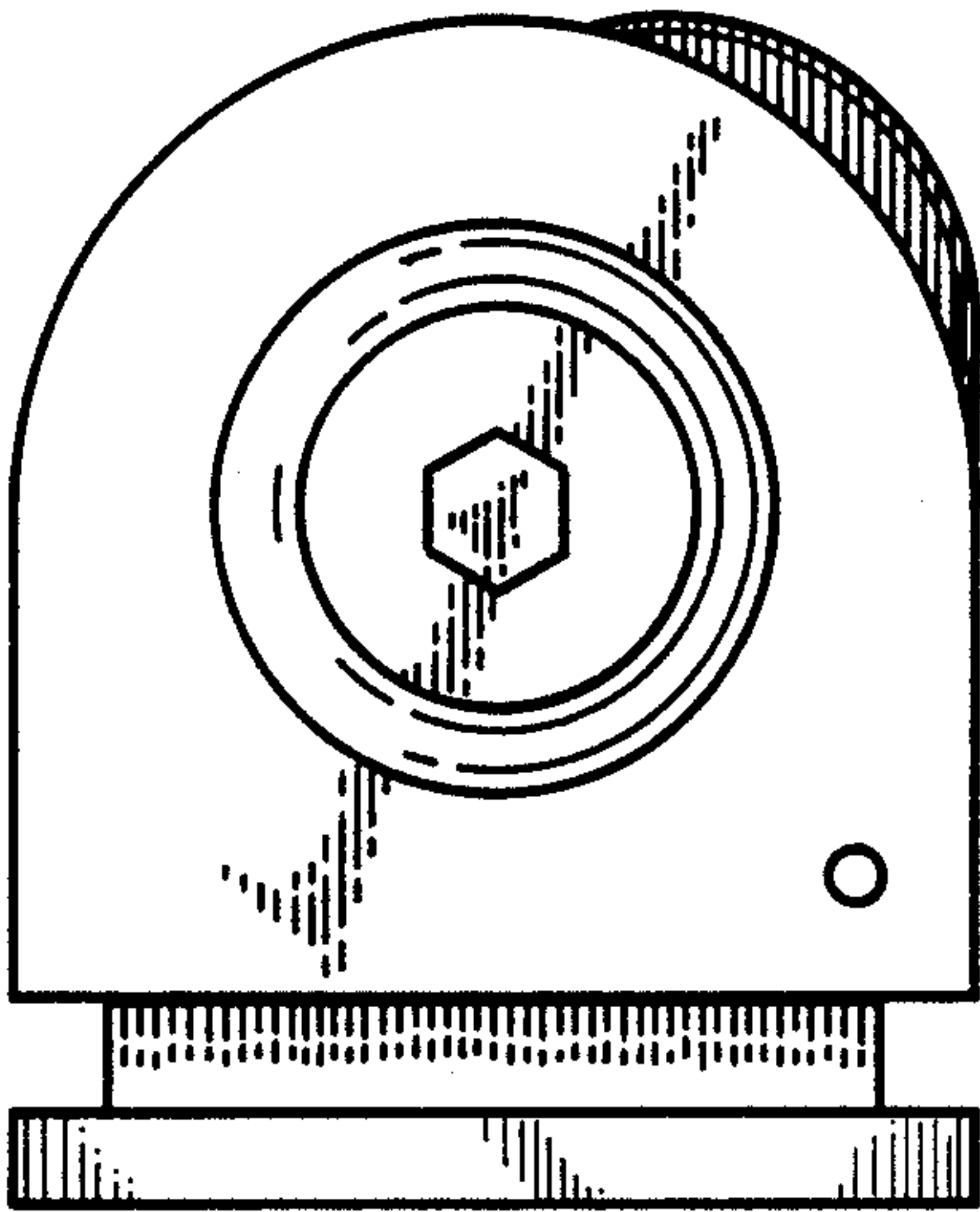

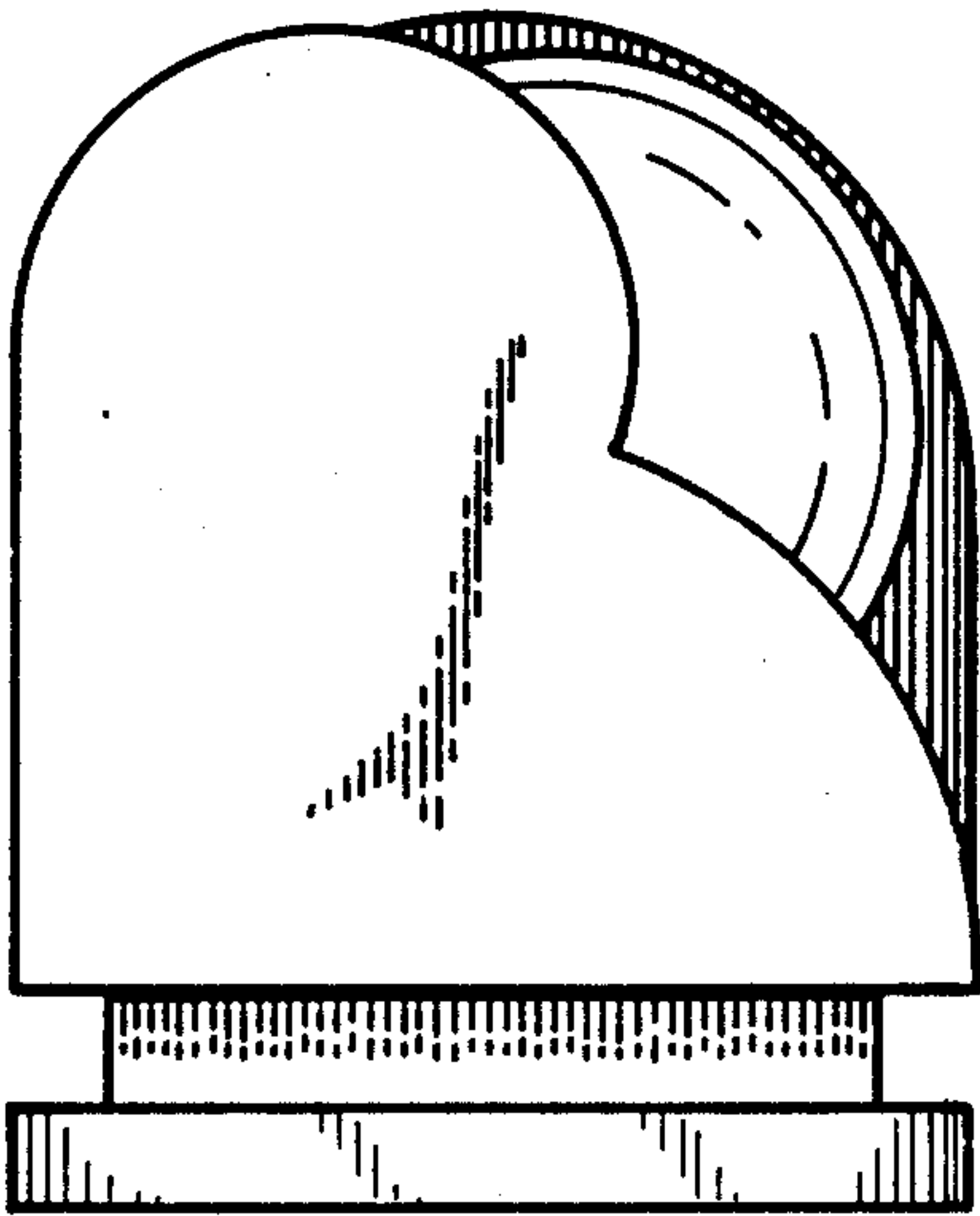

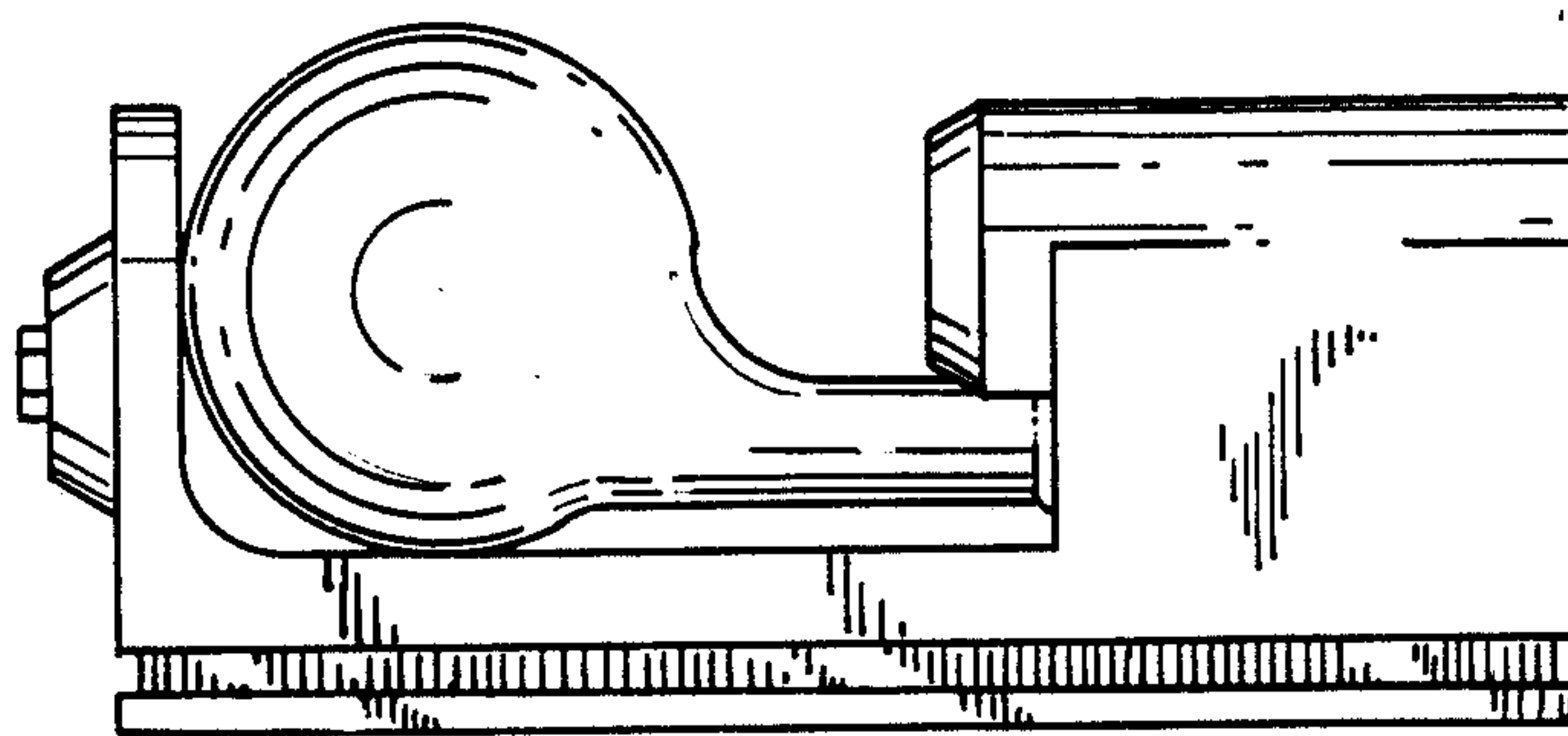
