DESCRIPTION

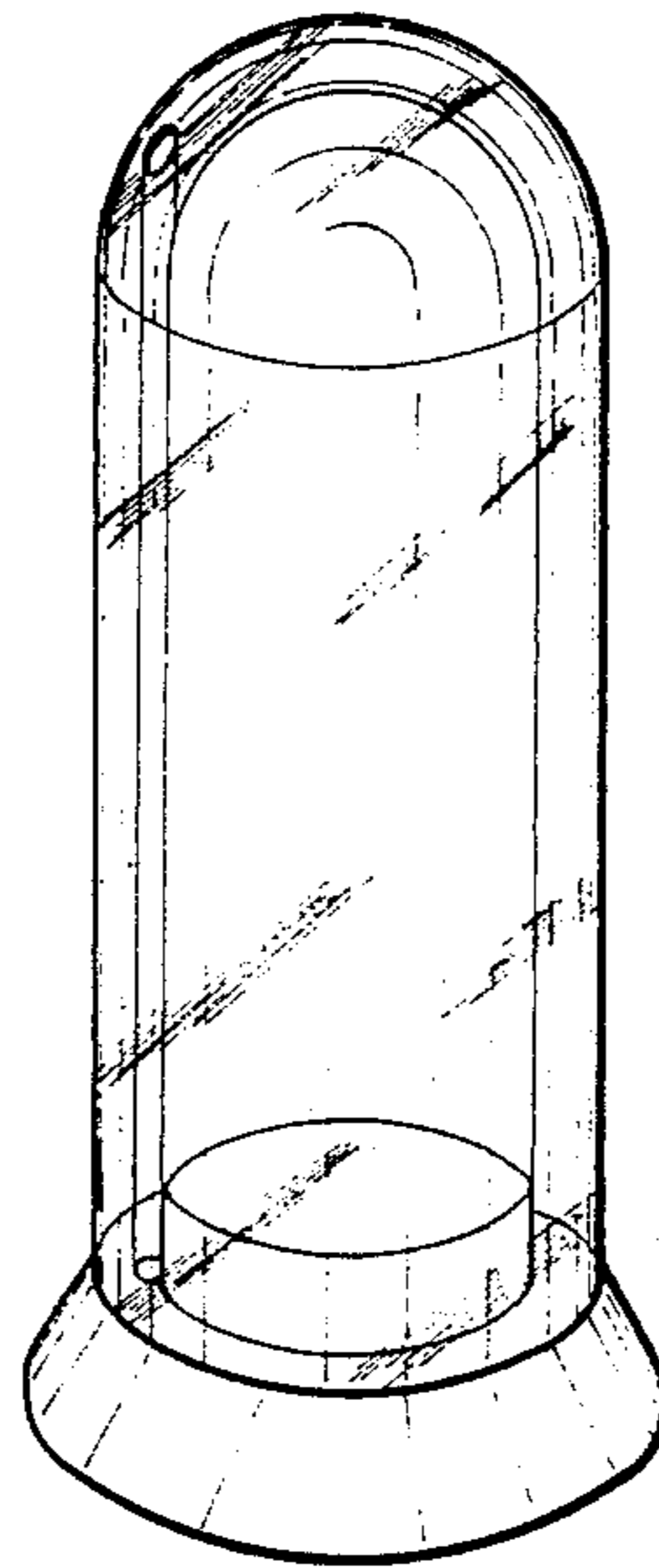
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toothpick case, showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



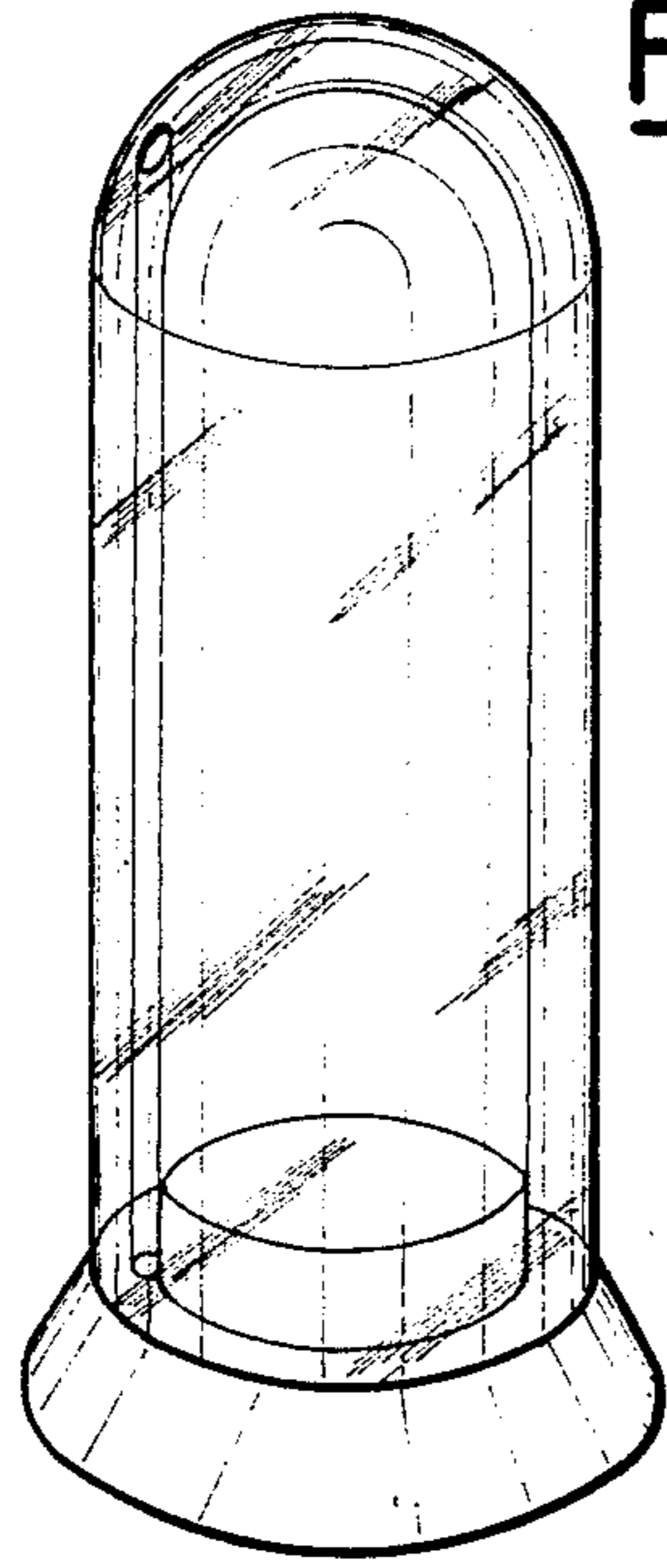

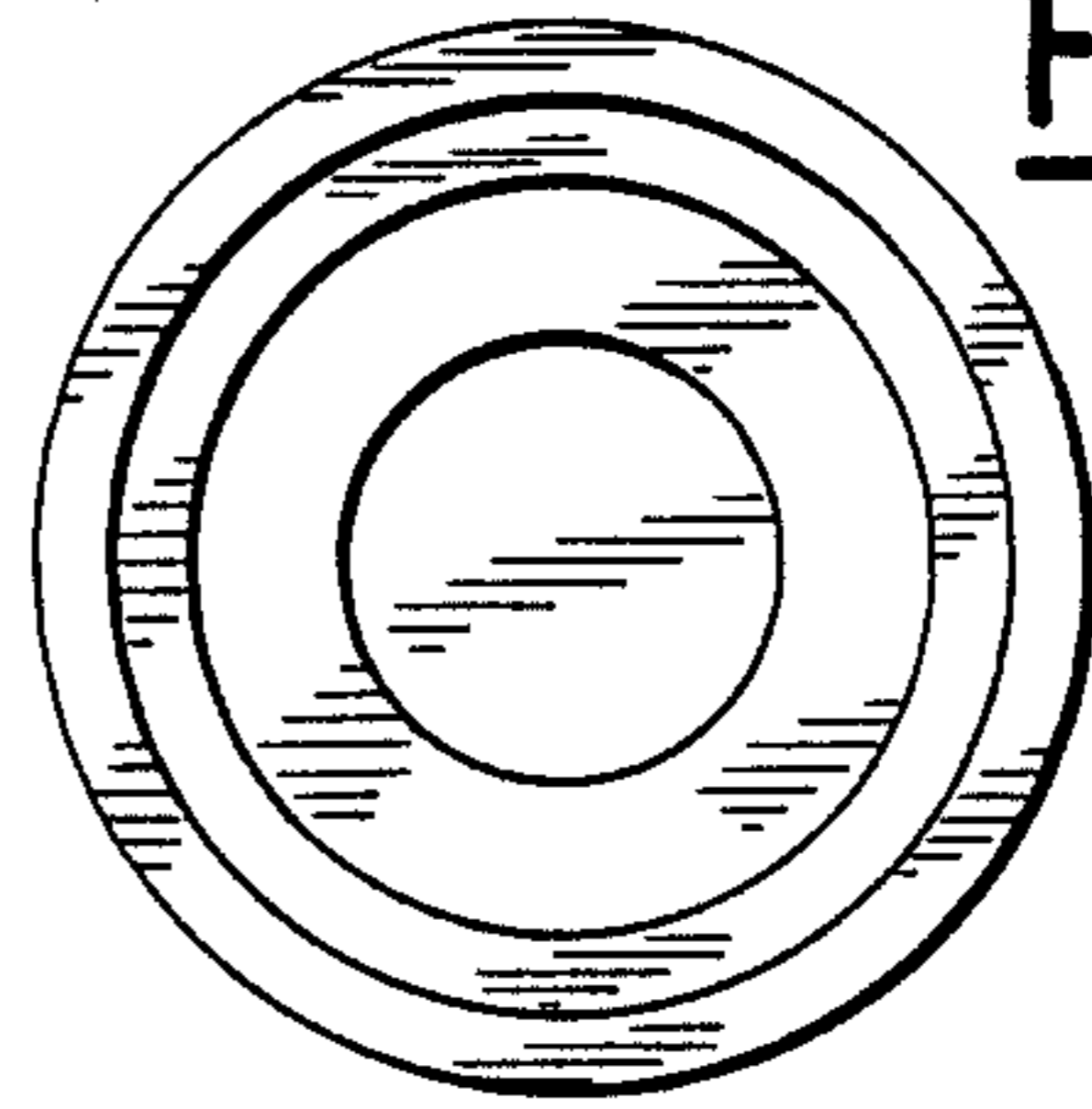

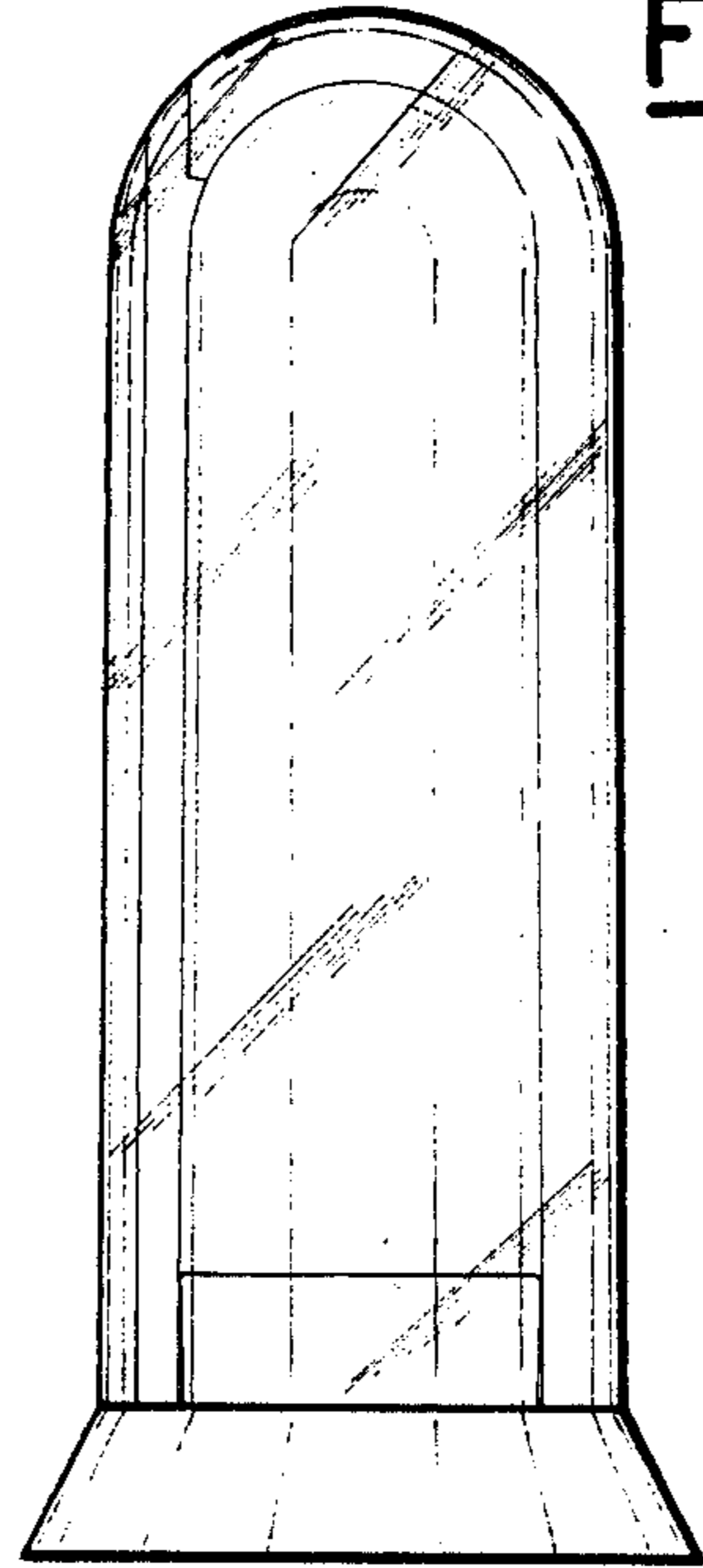

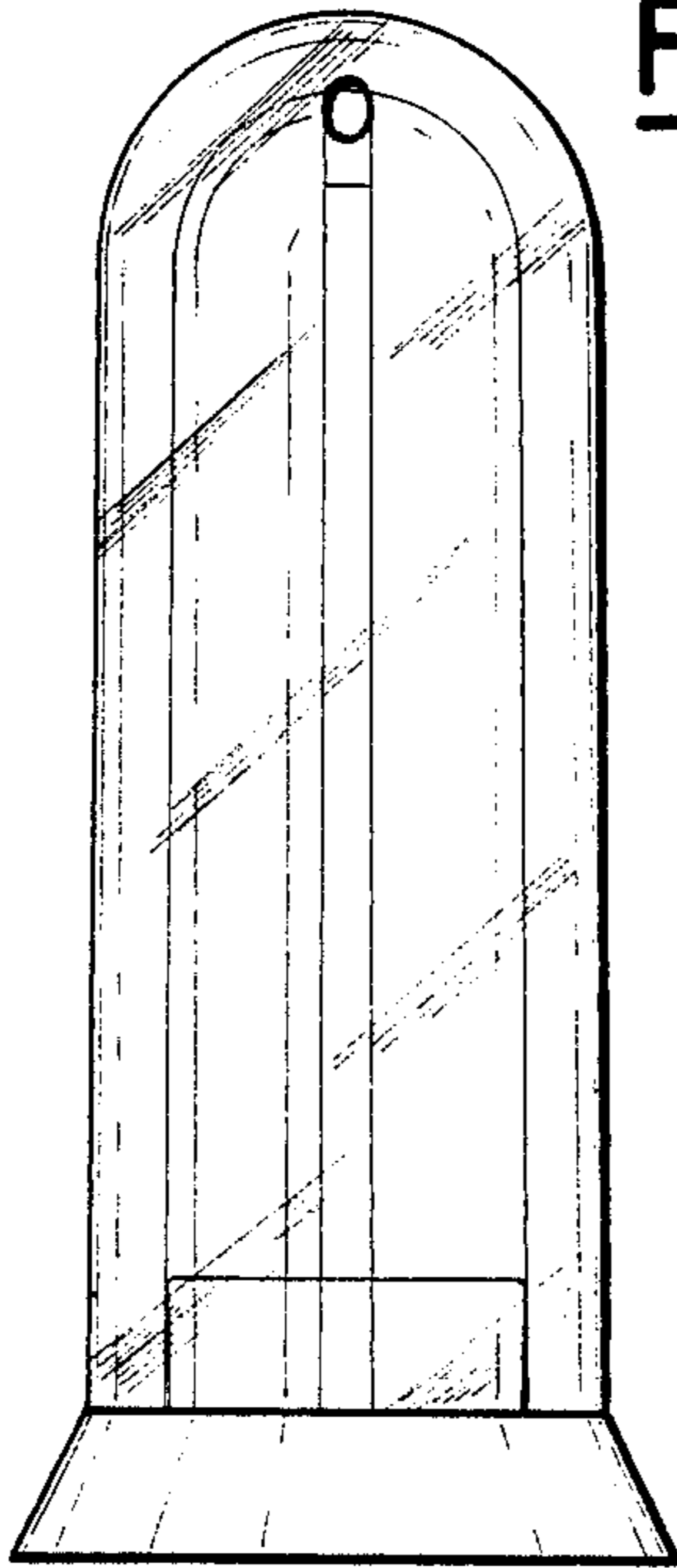

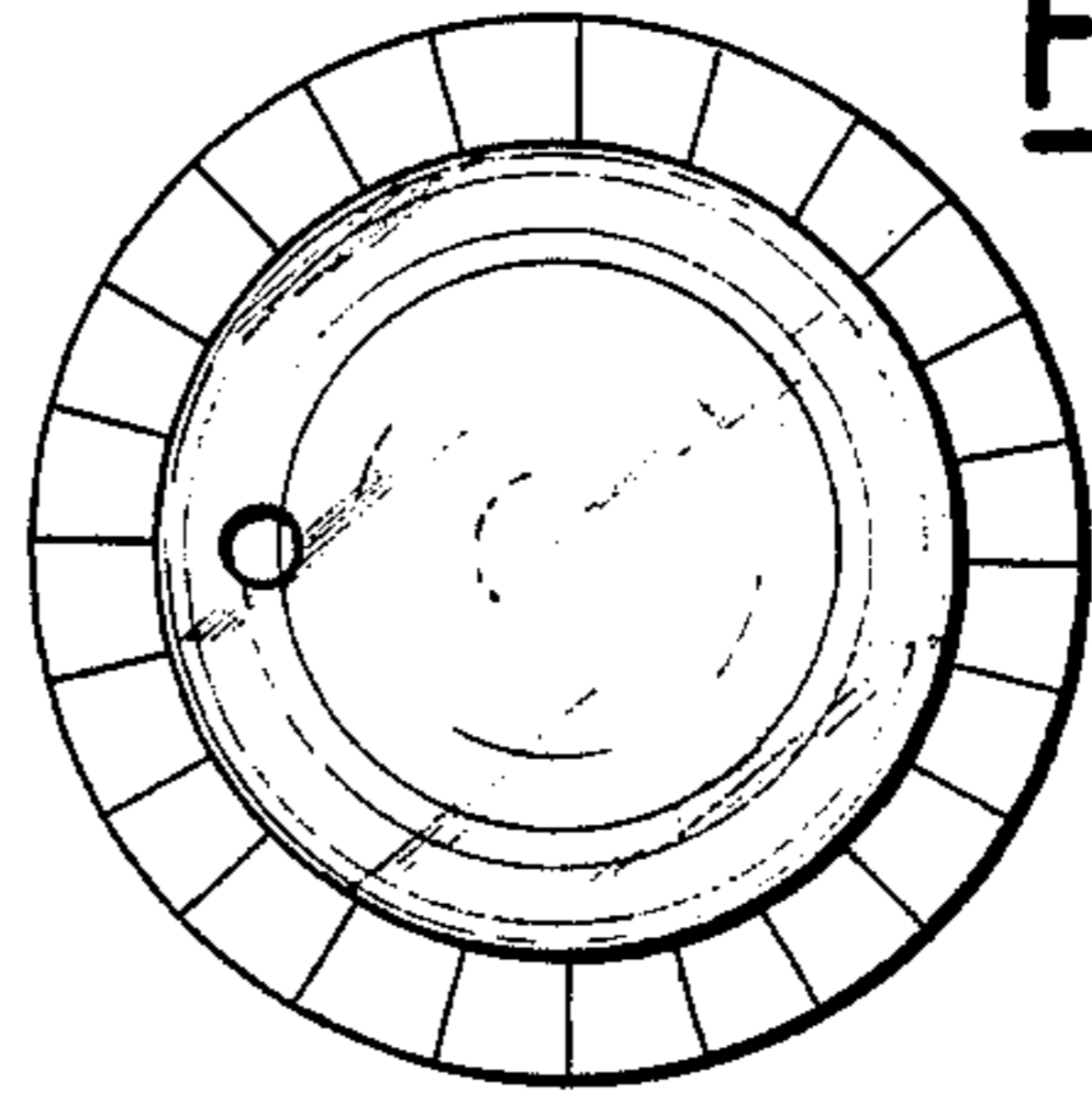
