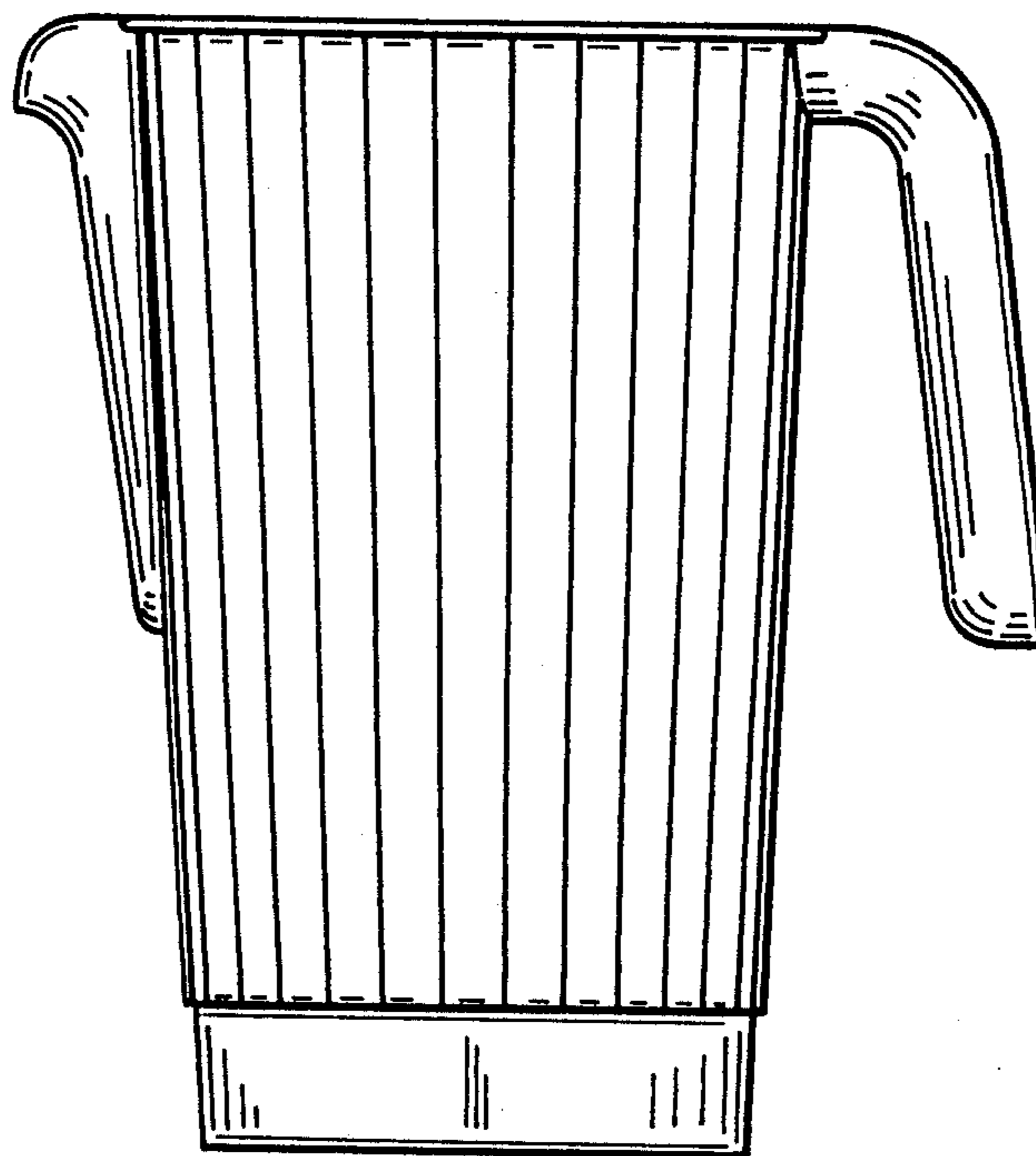

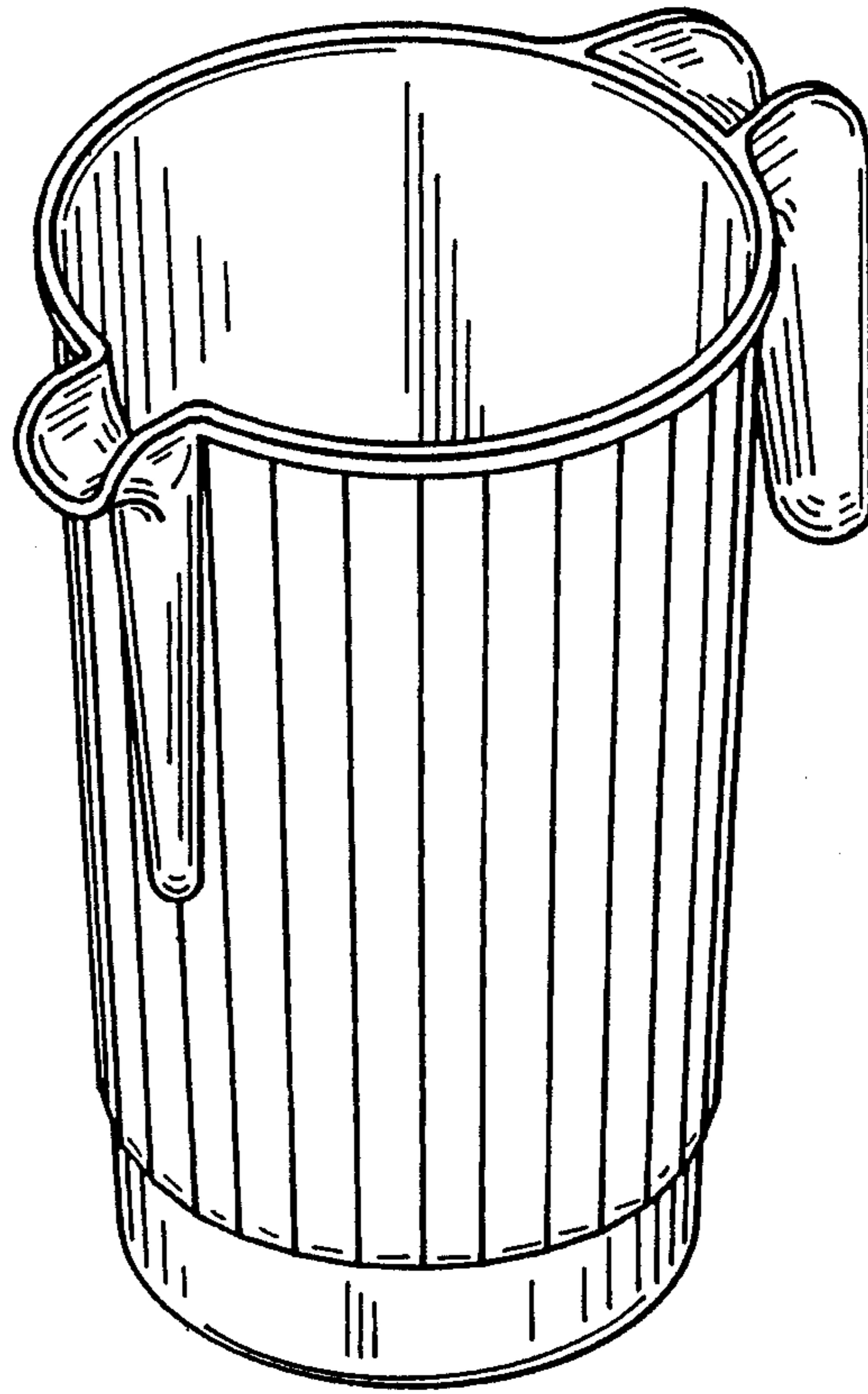
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pitcher, as shown and described.

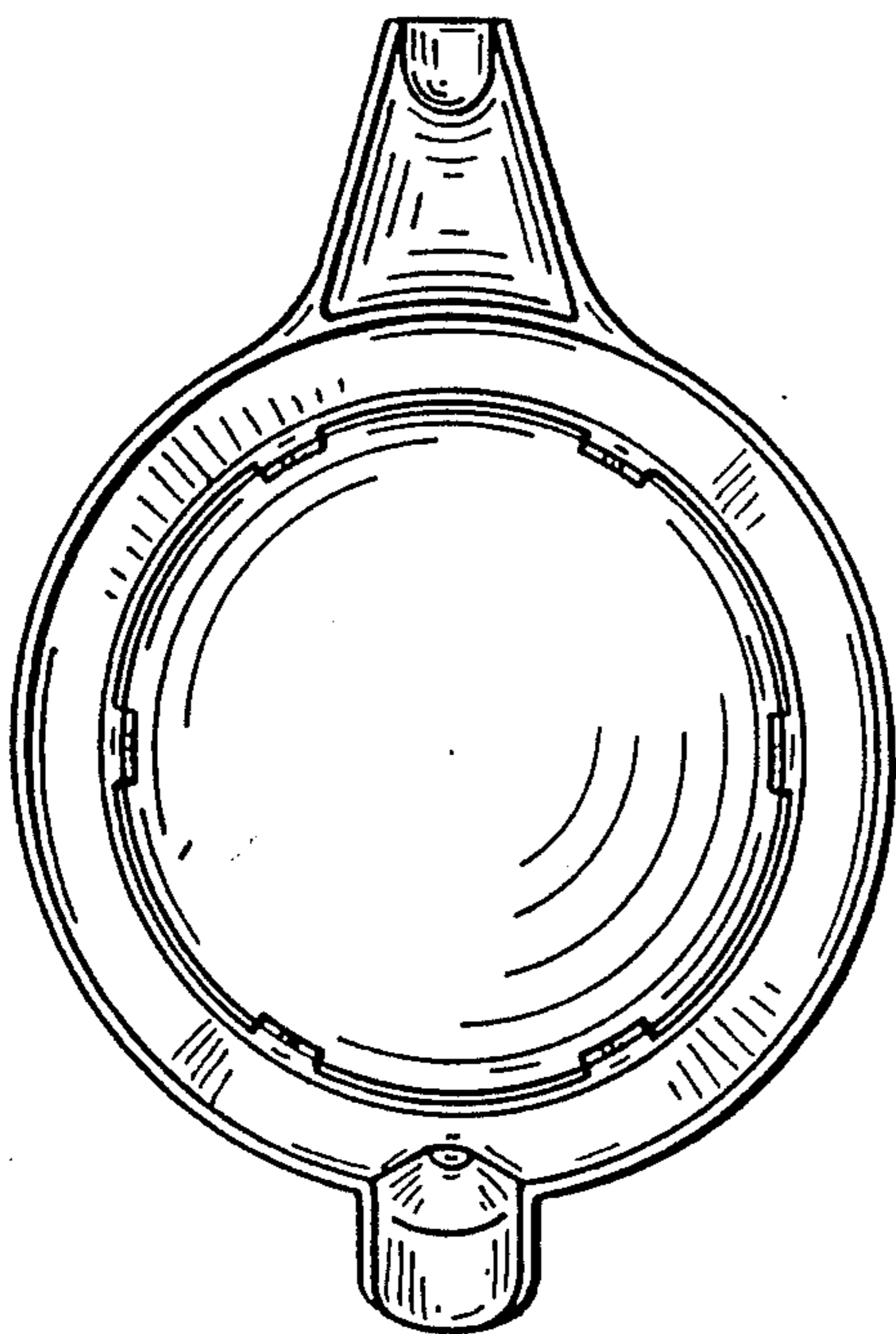
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right side isometric view of a pitcher showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

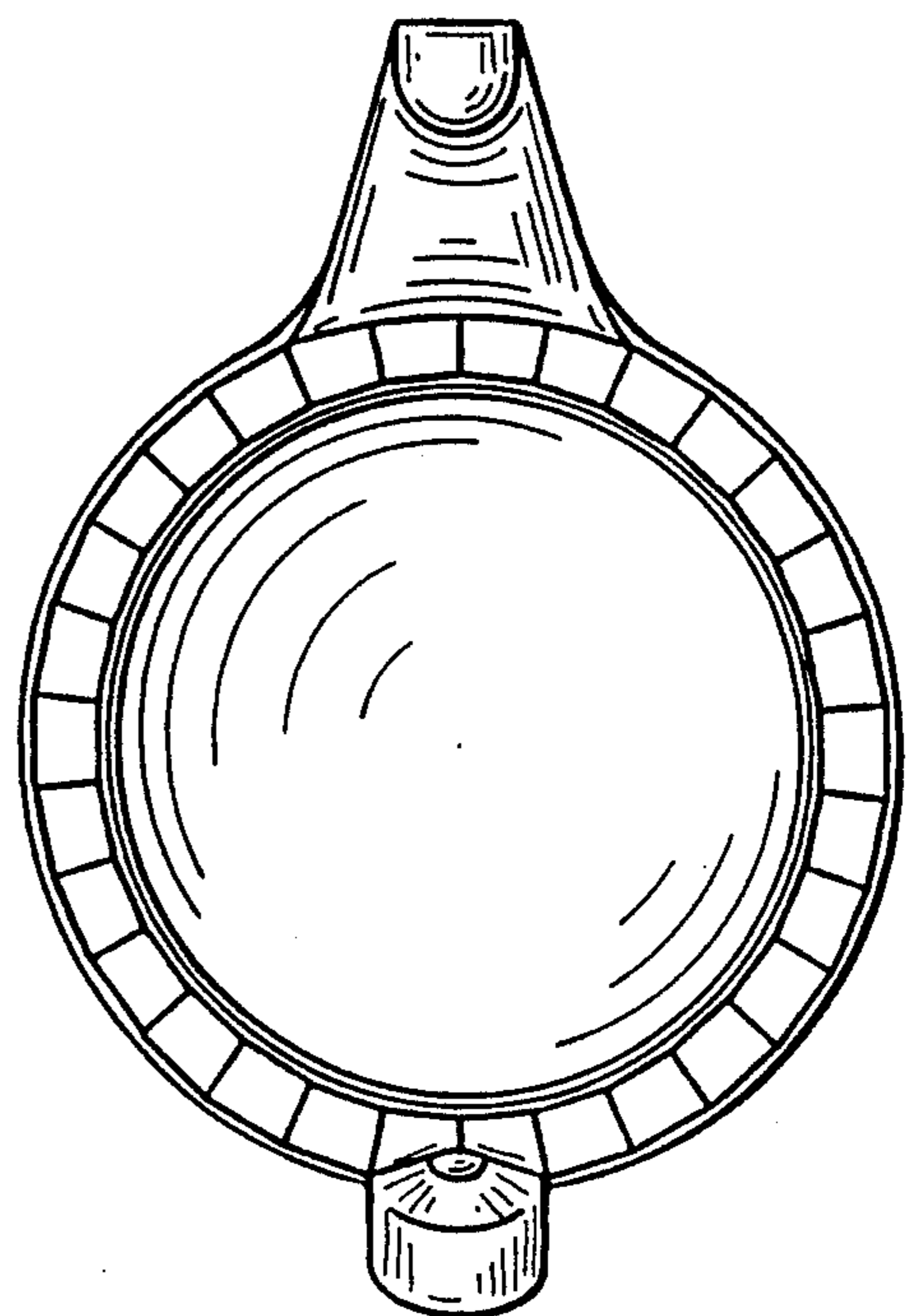




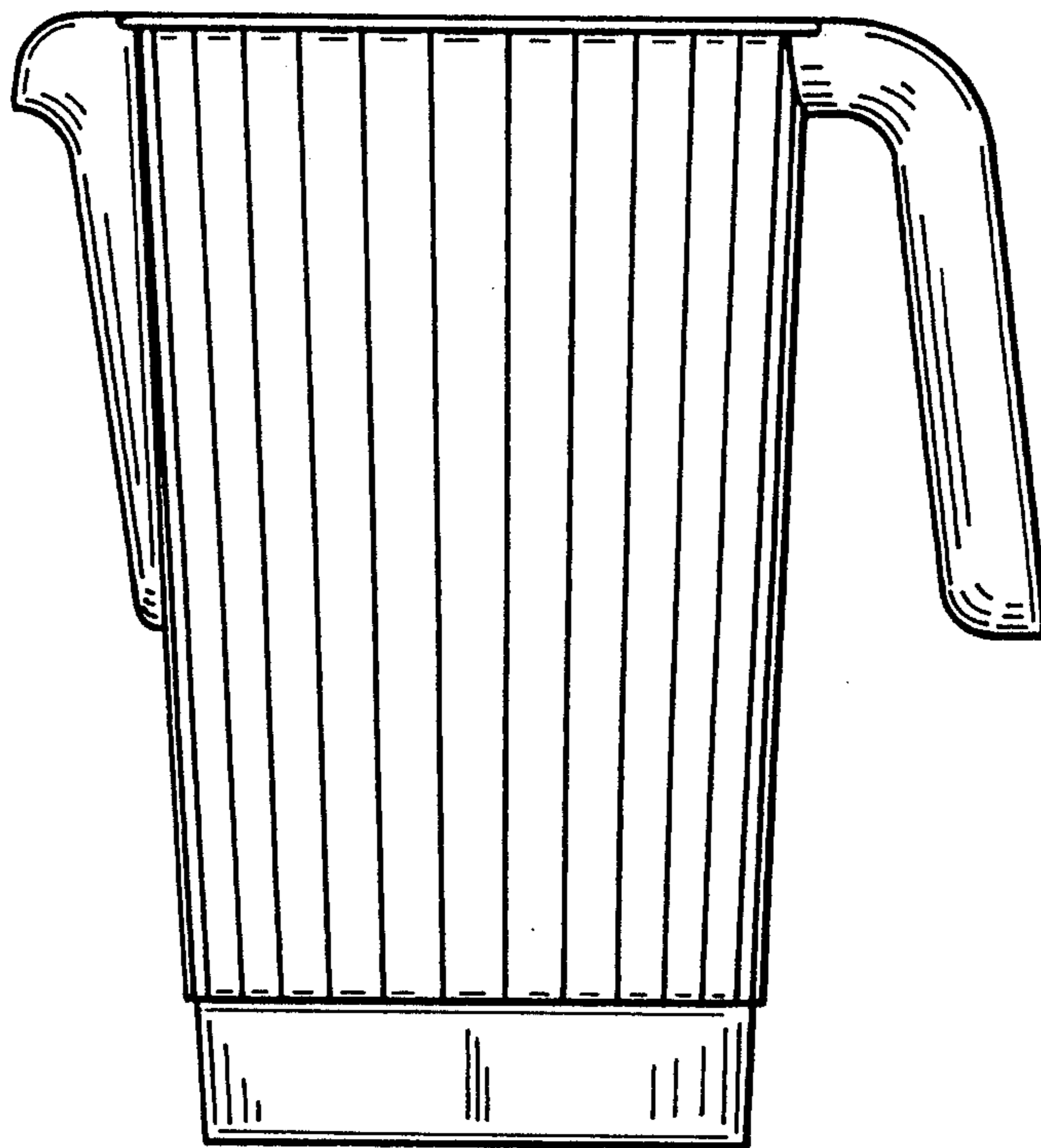

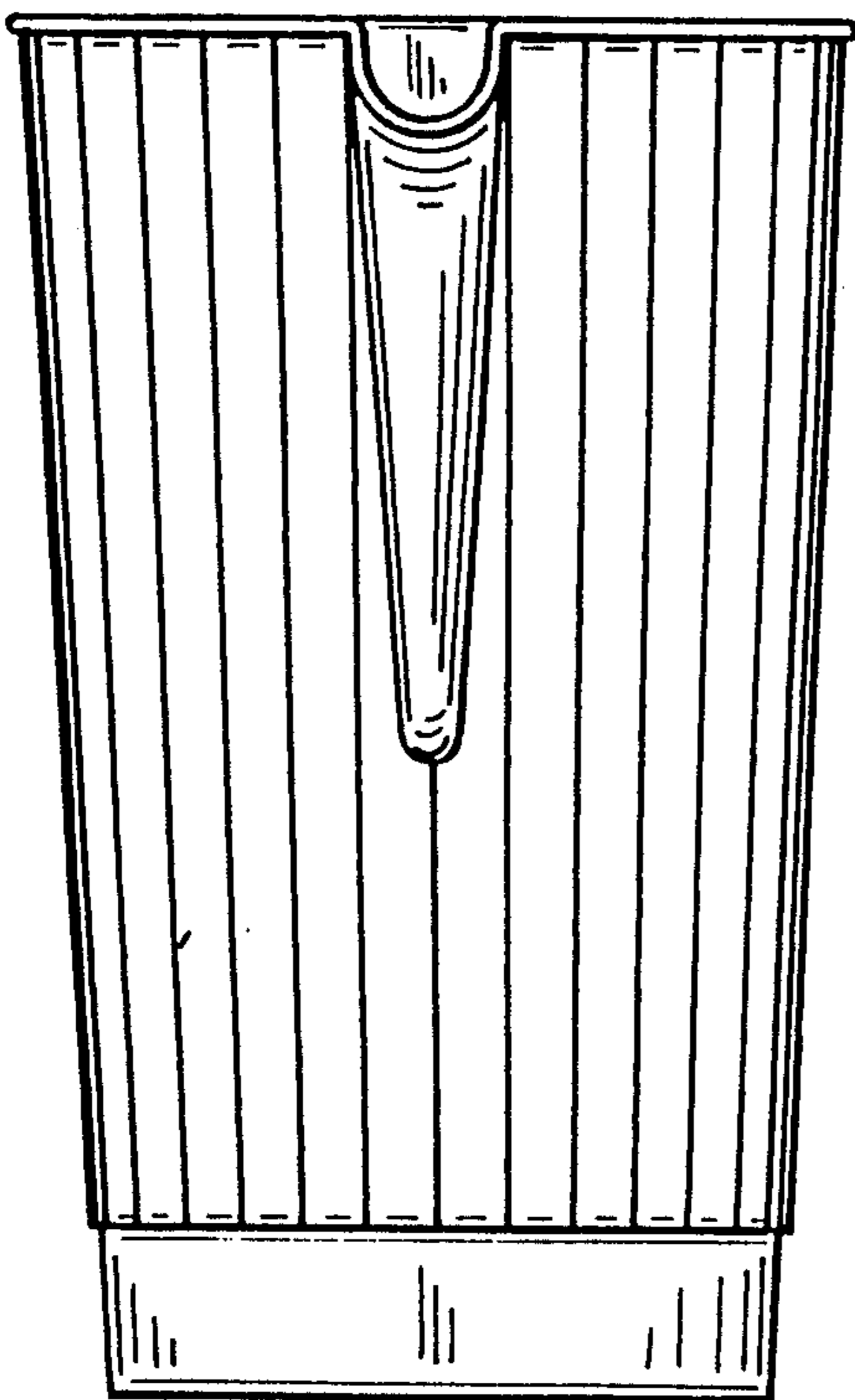

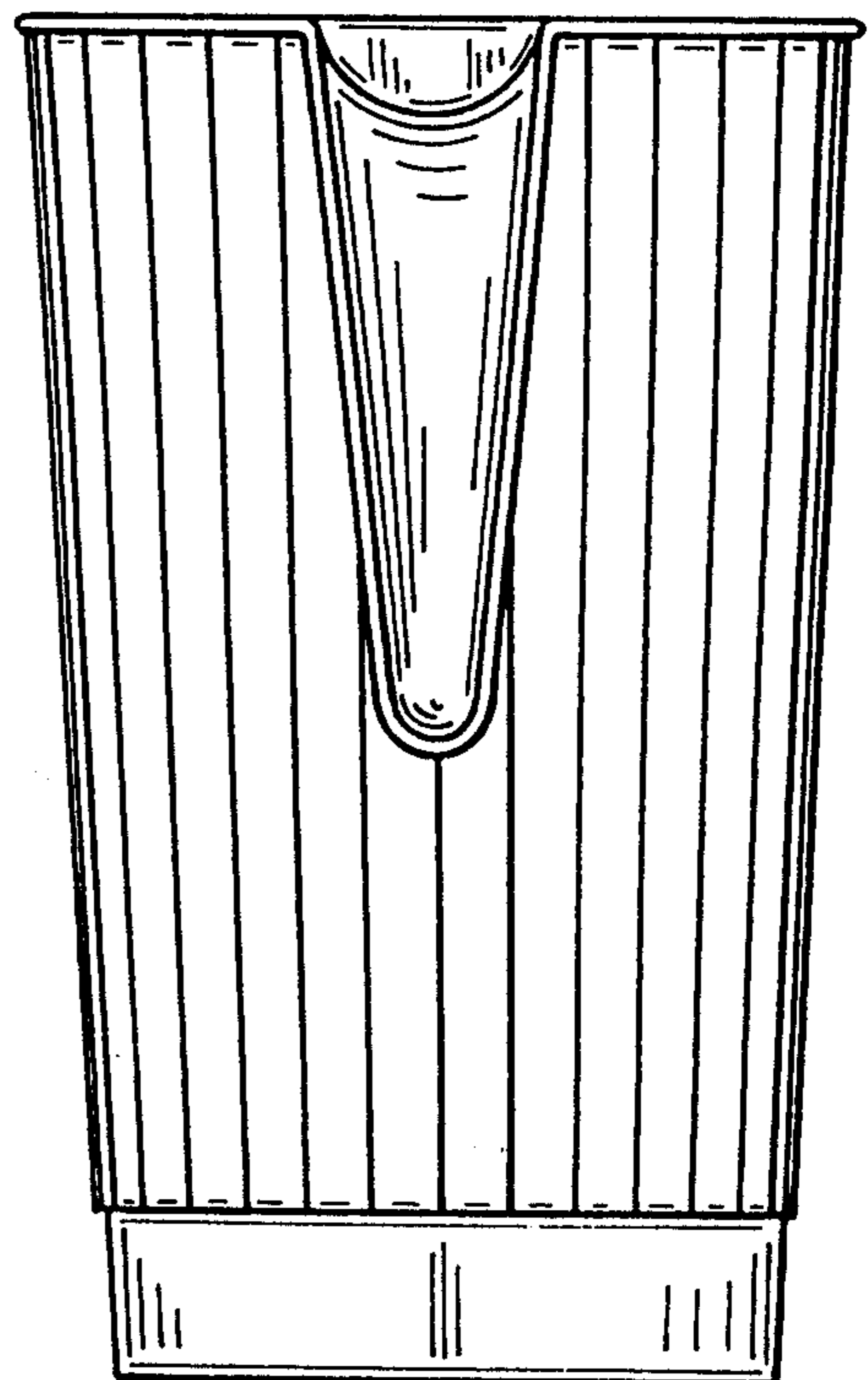
