The ornamental design for a cargo box door safety chain, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a cargo box door safety chain showing our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

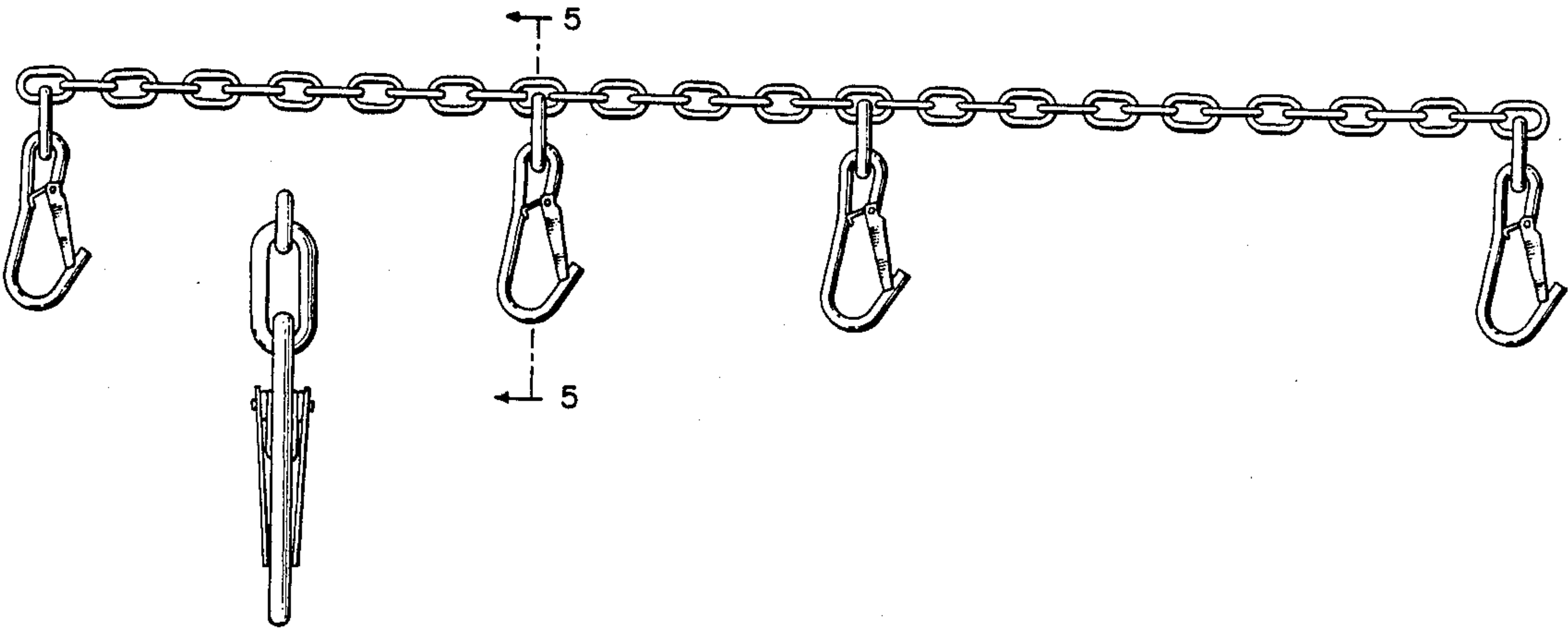

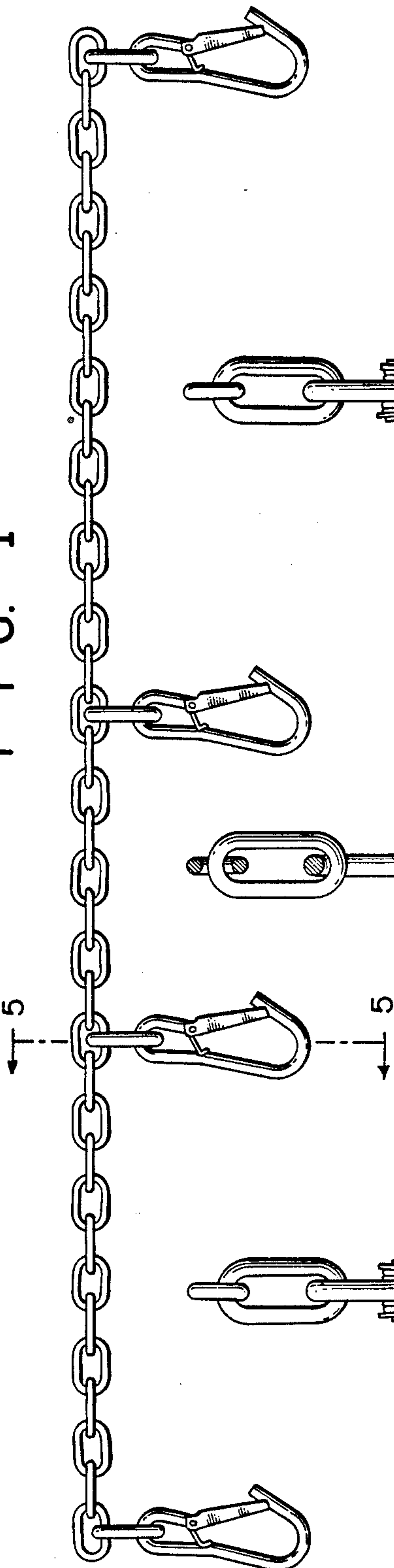

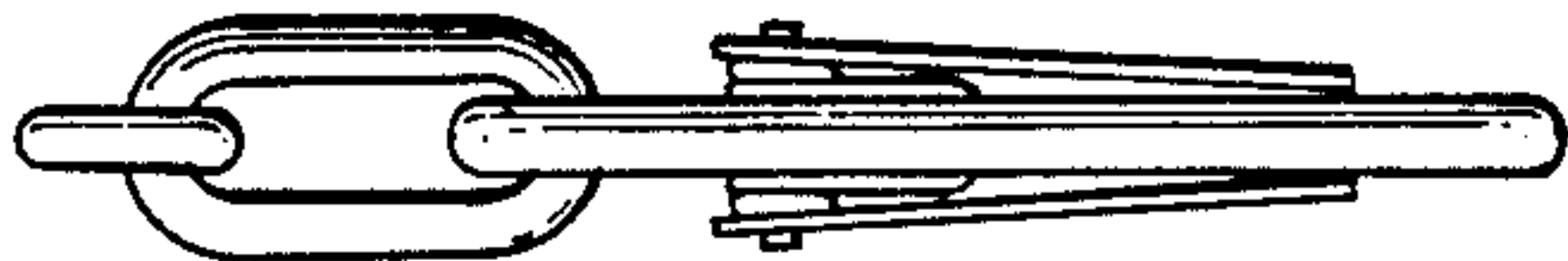

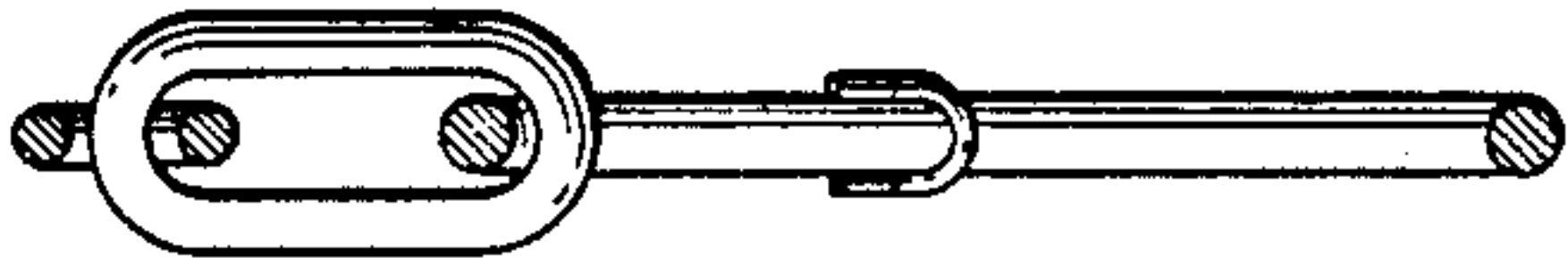
