[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined video tape recorder and television receiver, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, and right side perspective view of a combined video tape recorder and television receiver, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front, top and right side perspective view thereof, shown with antenna in an extended position;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

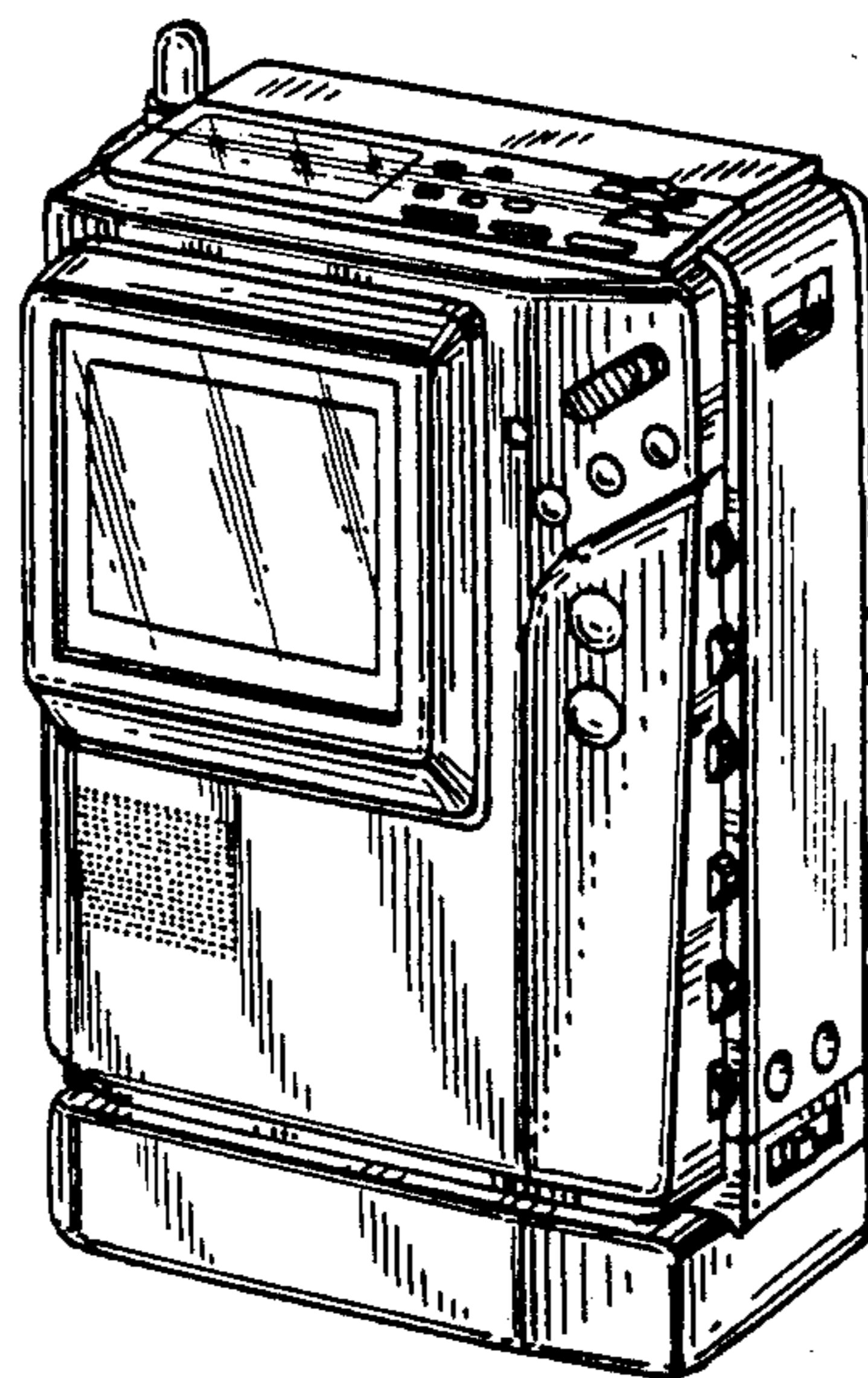

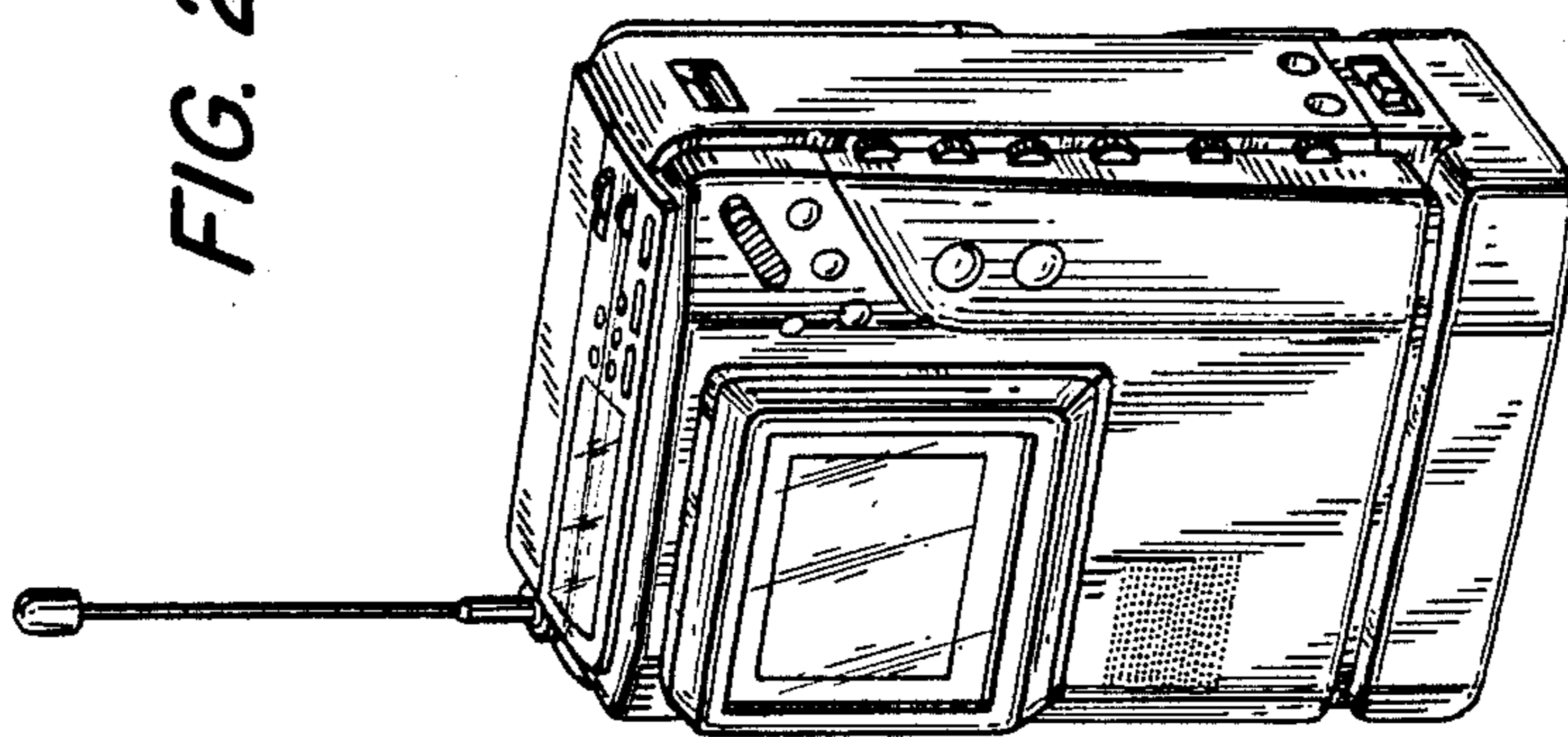

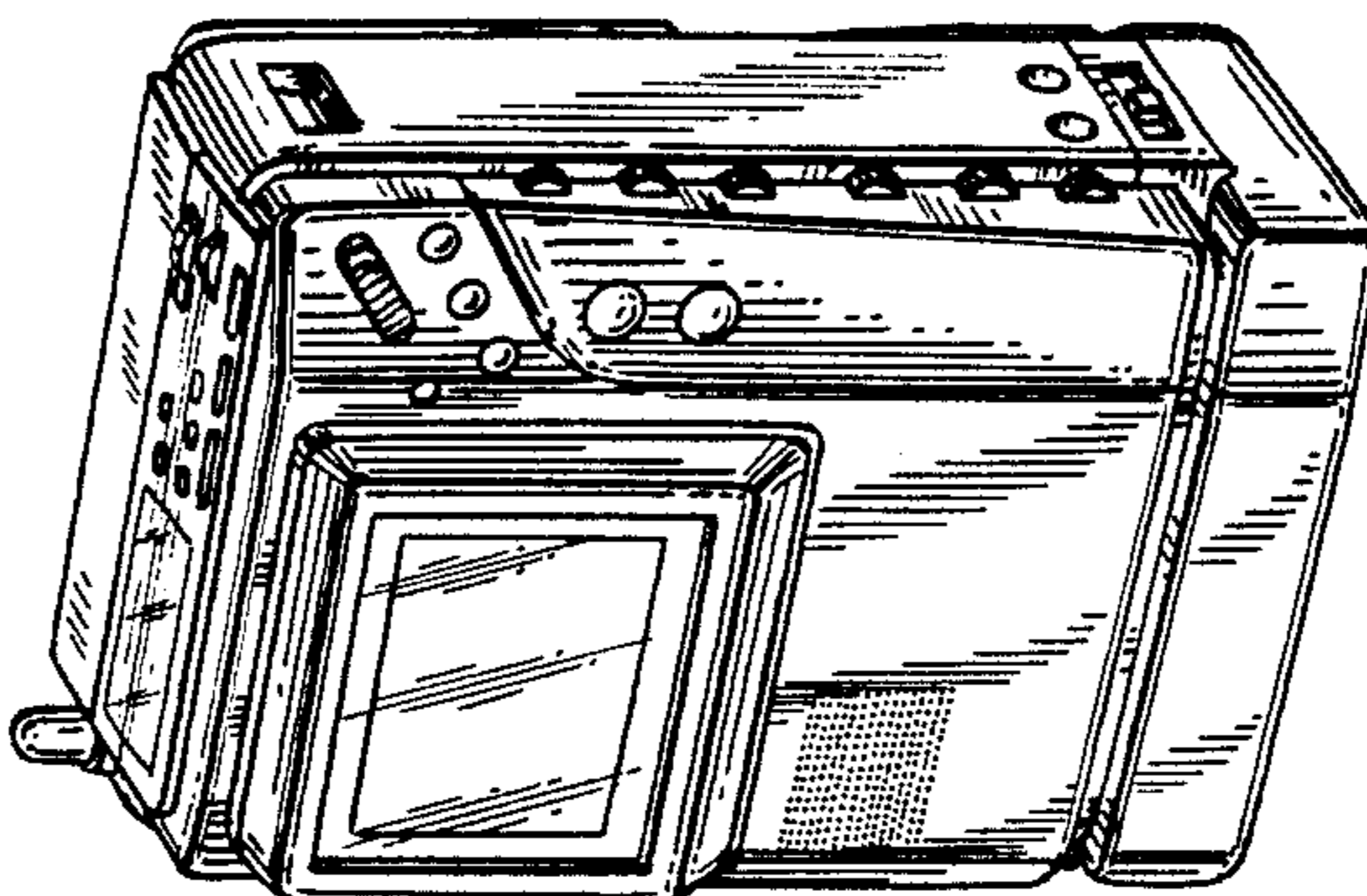

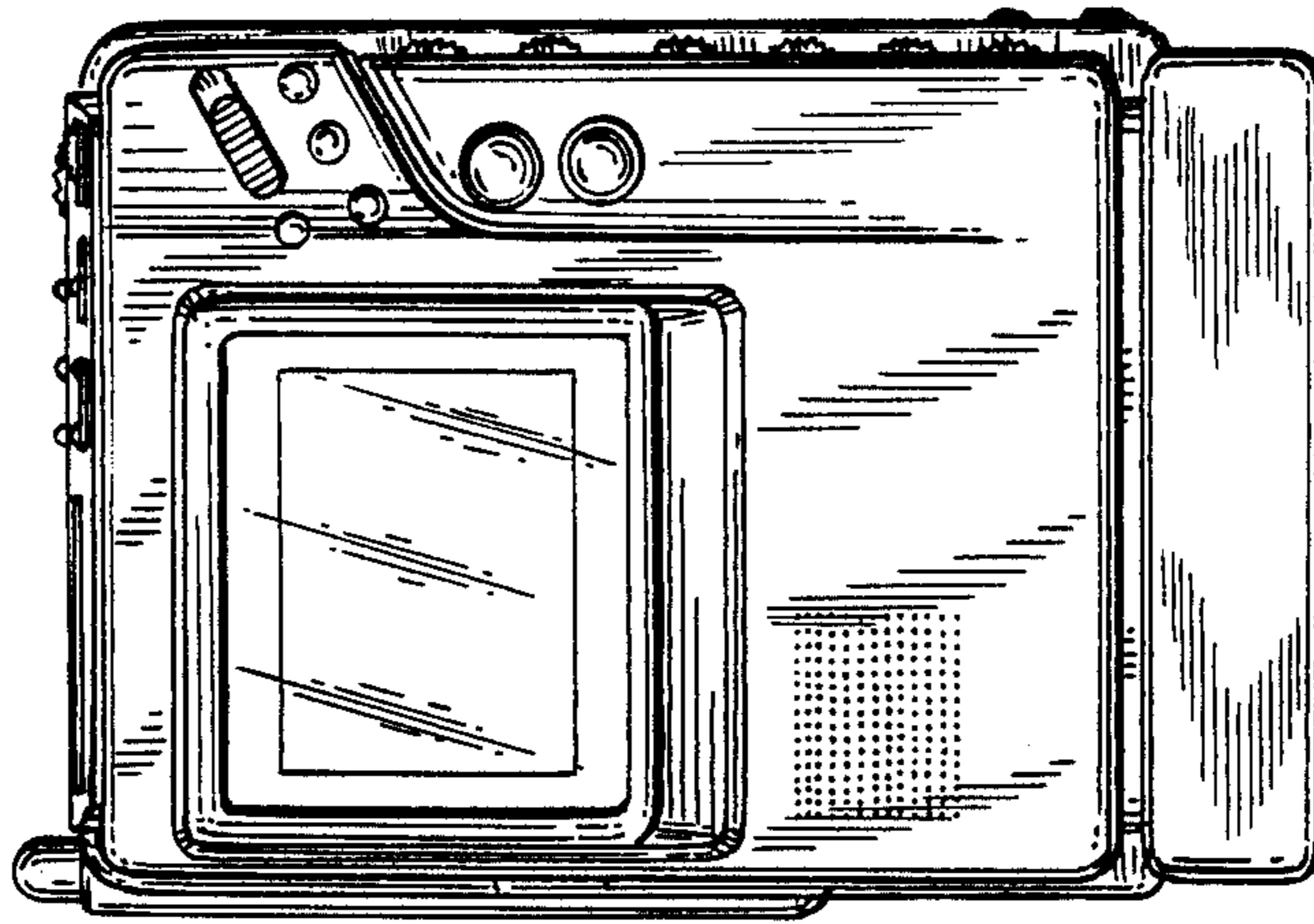

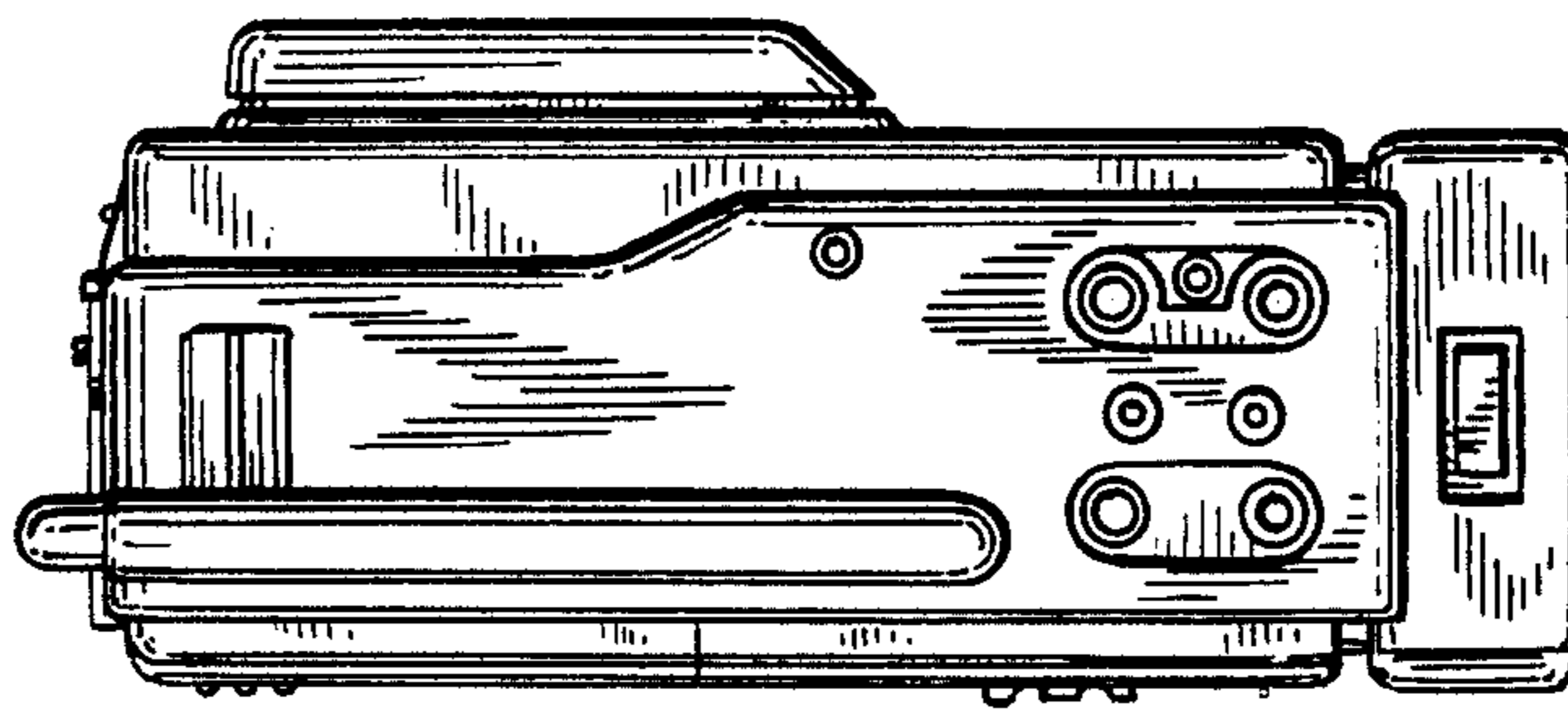

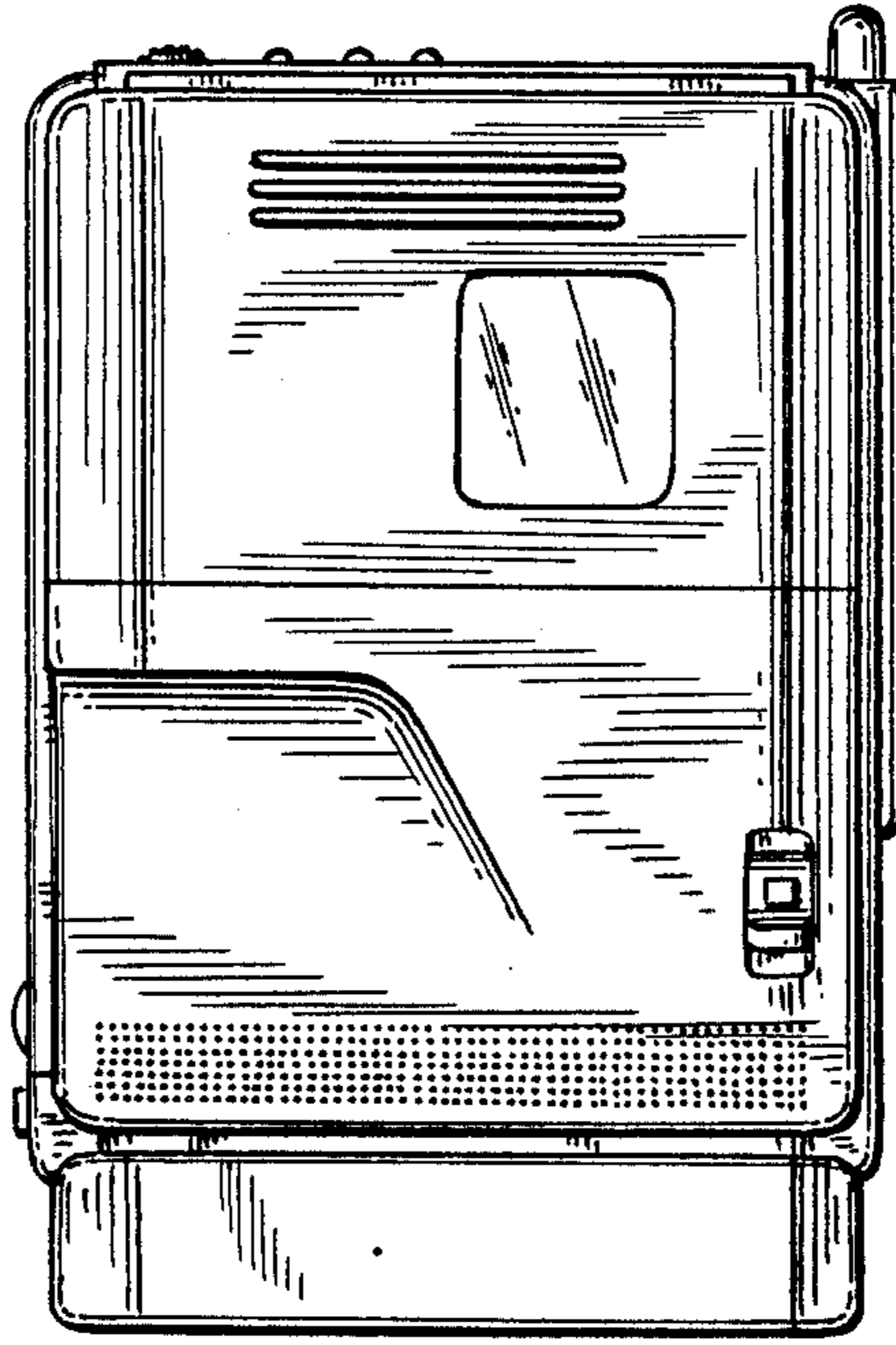

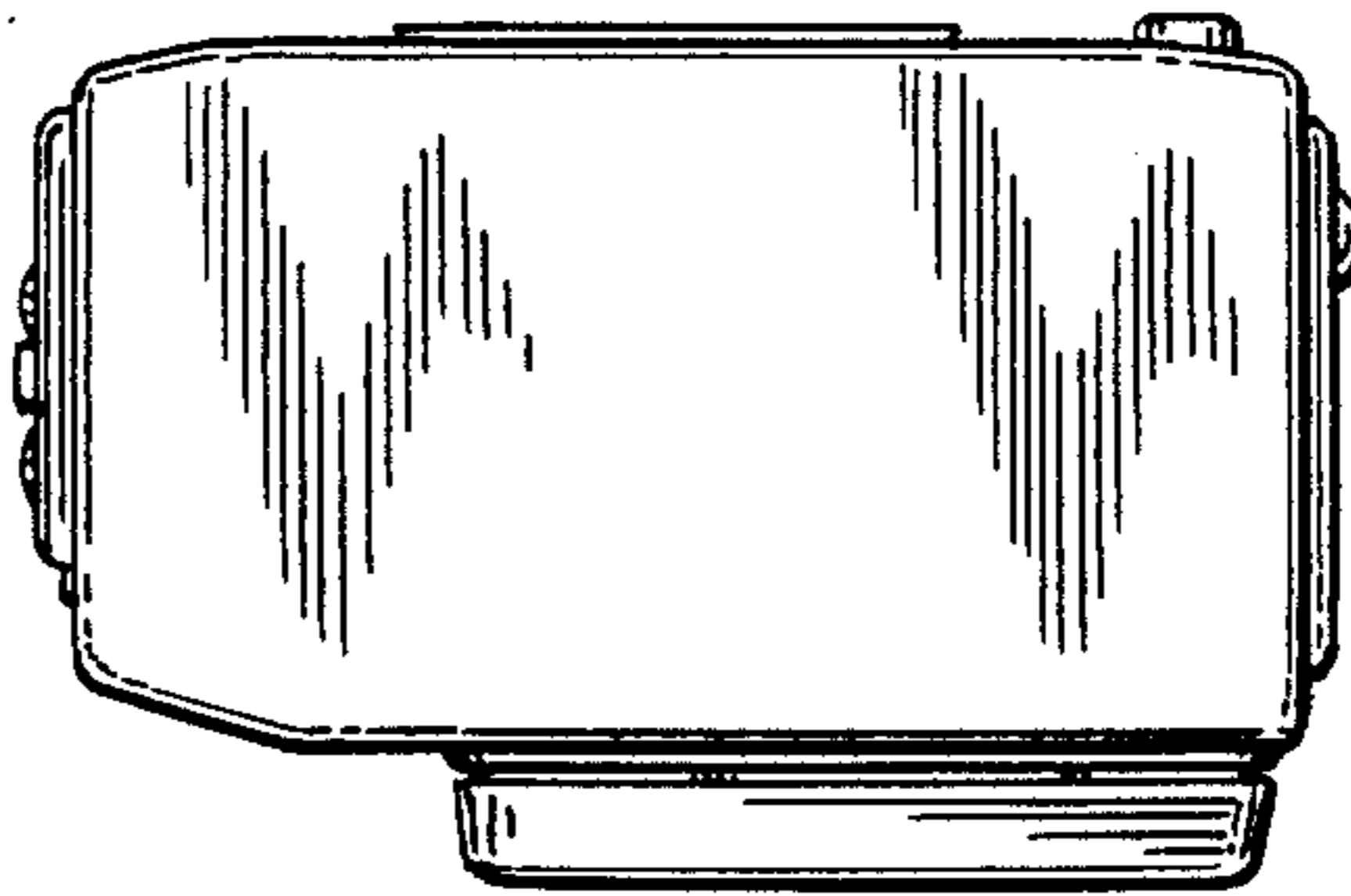

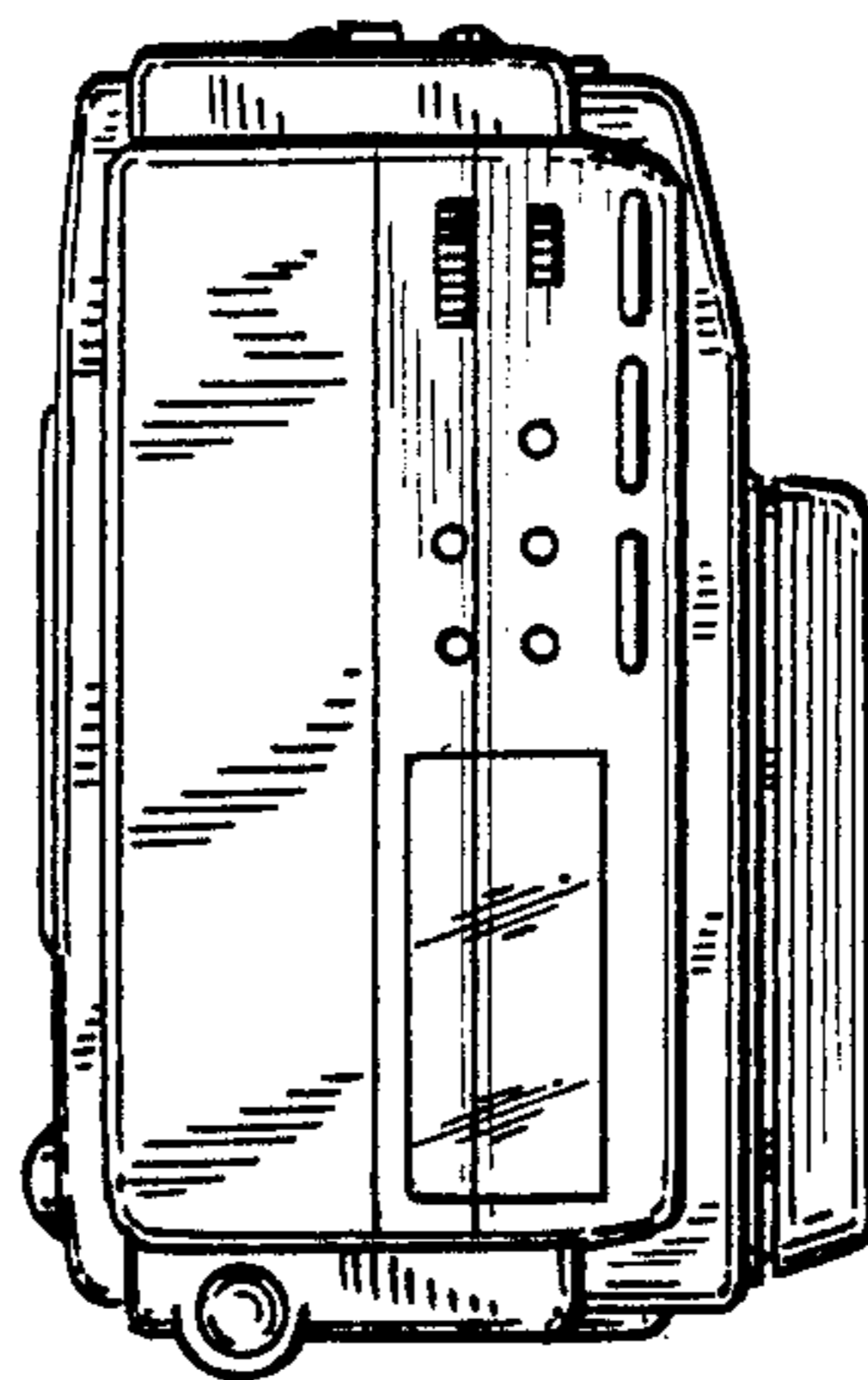
