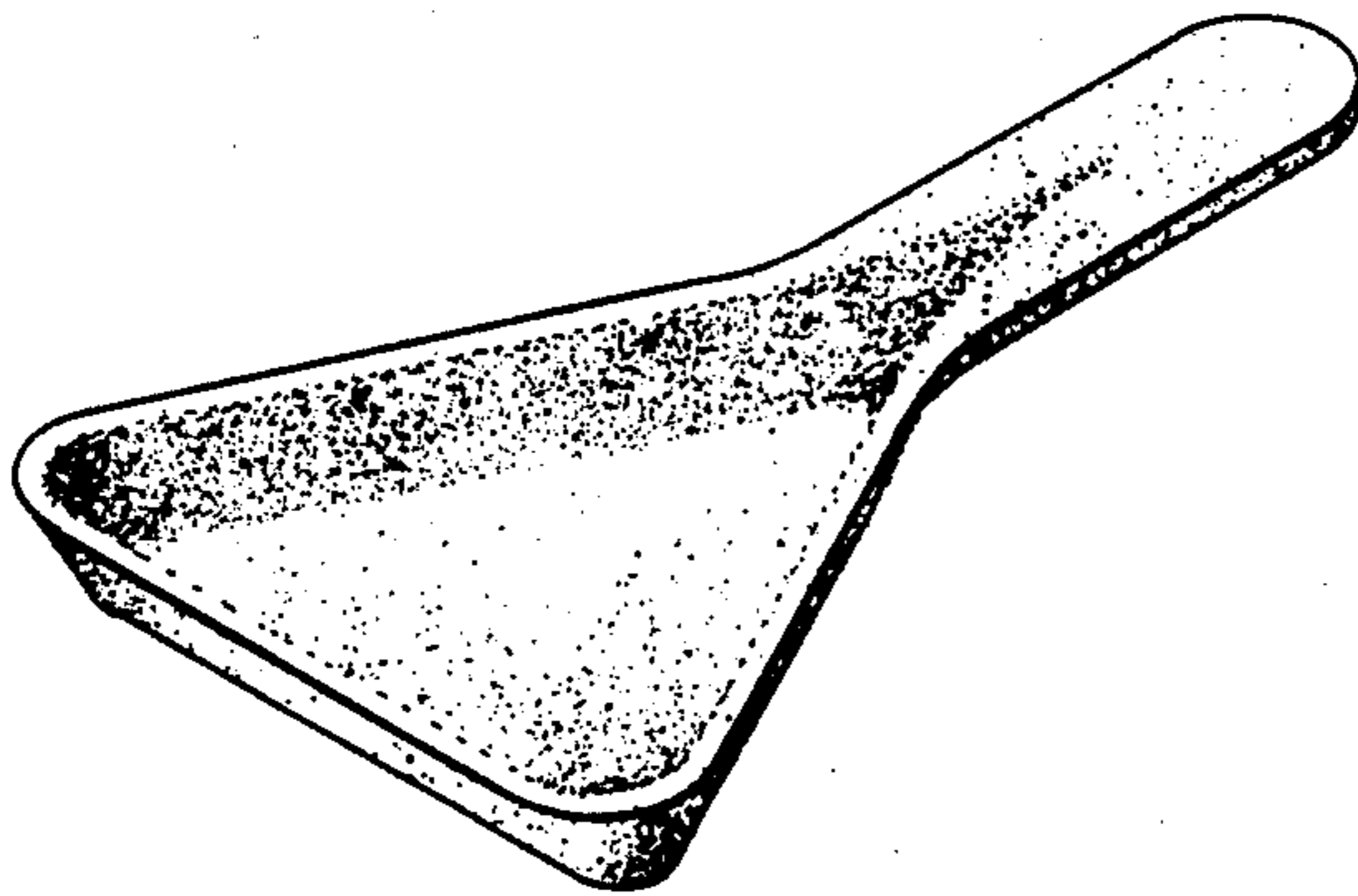

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a snack chip showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 2.



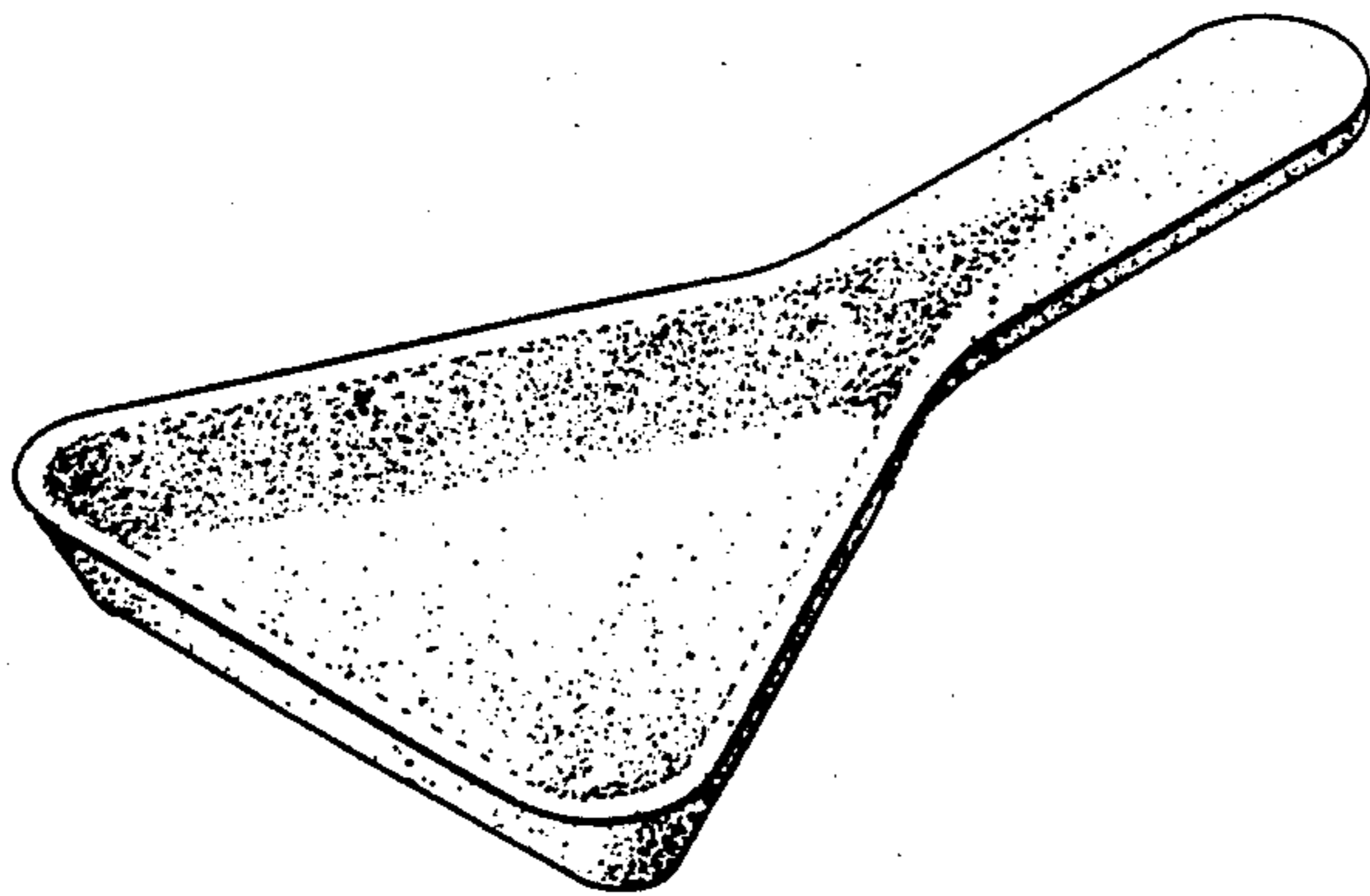

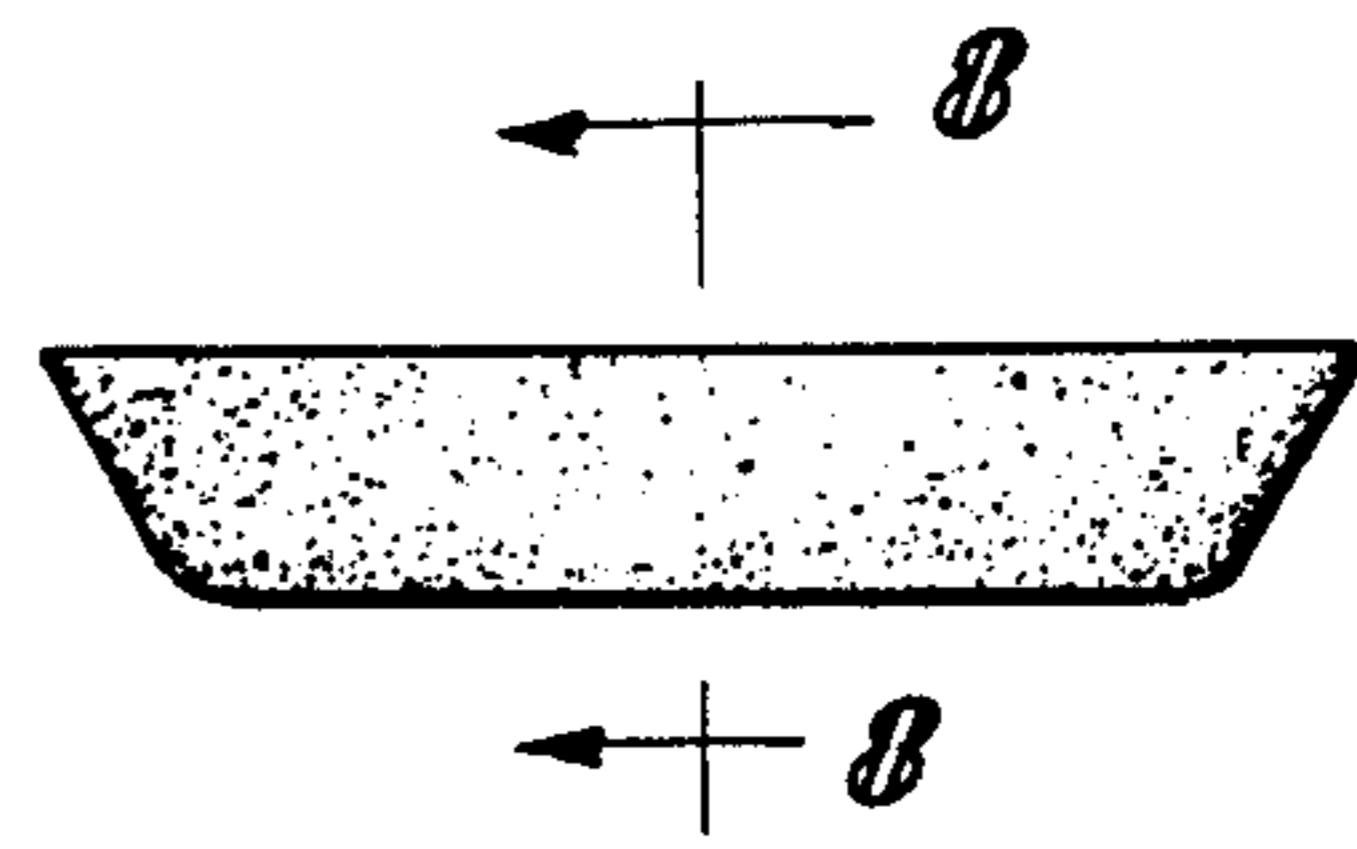

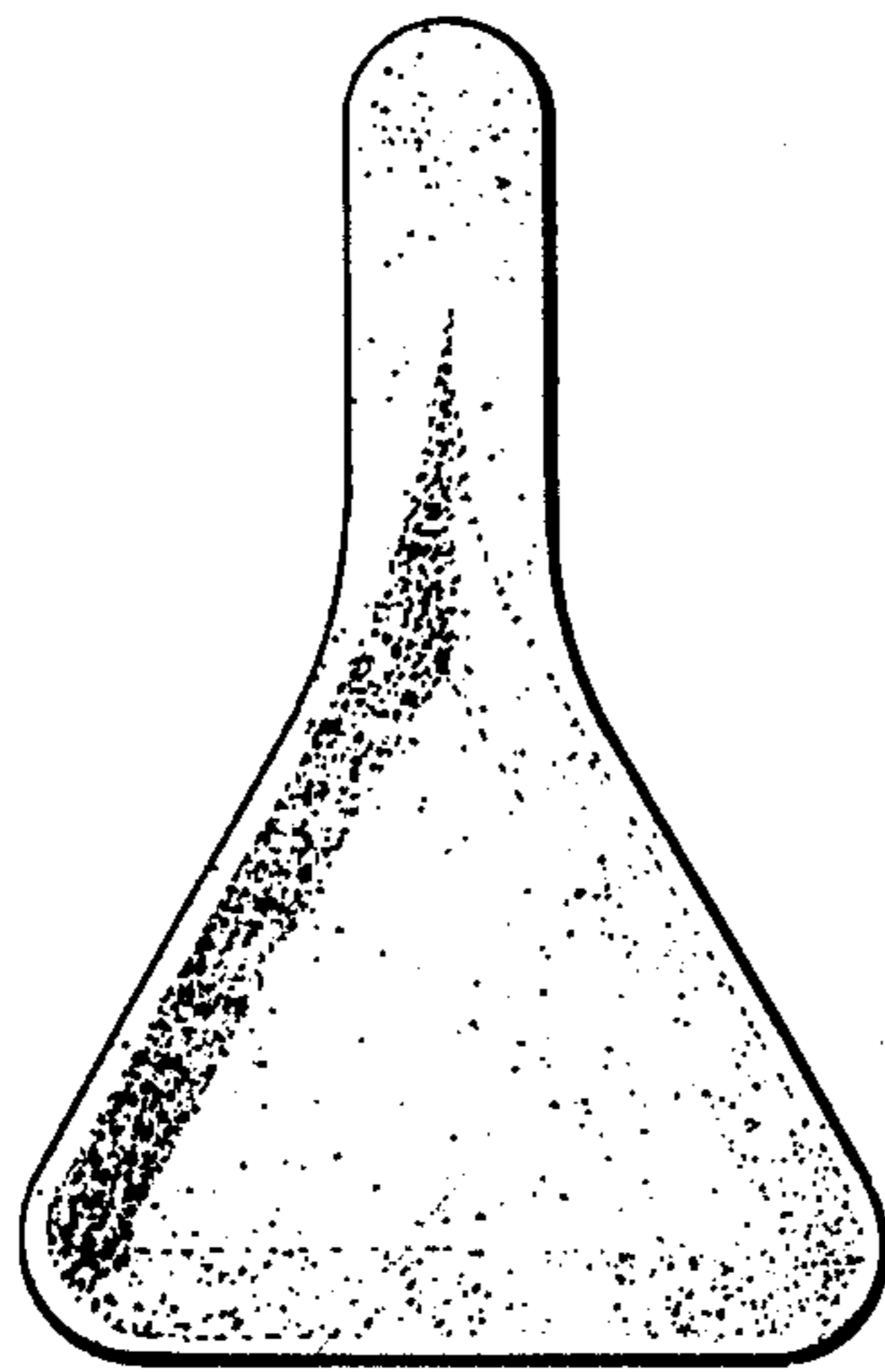

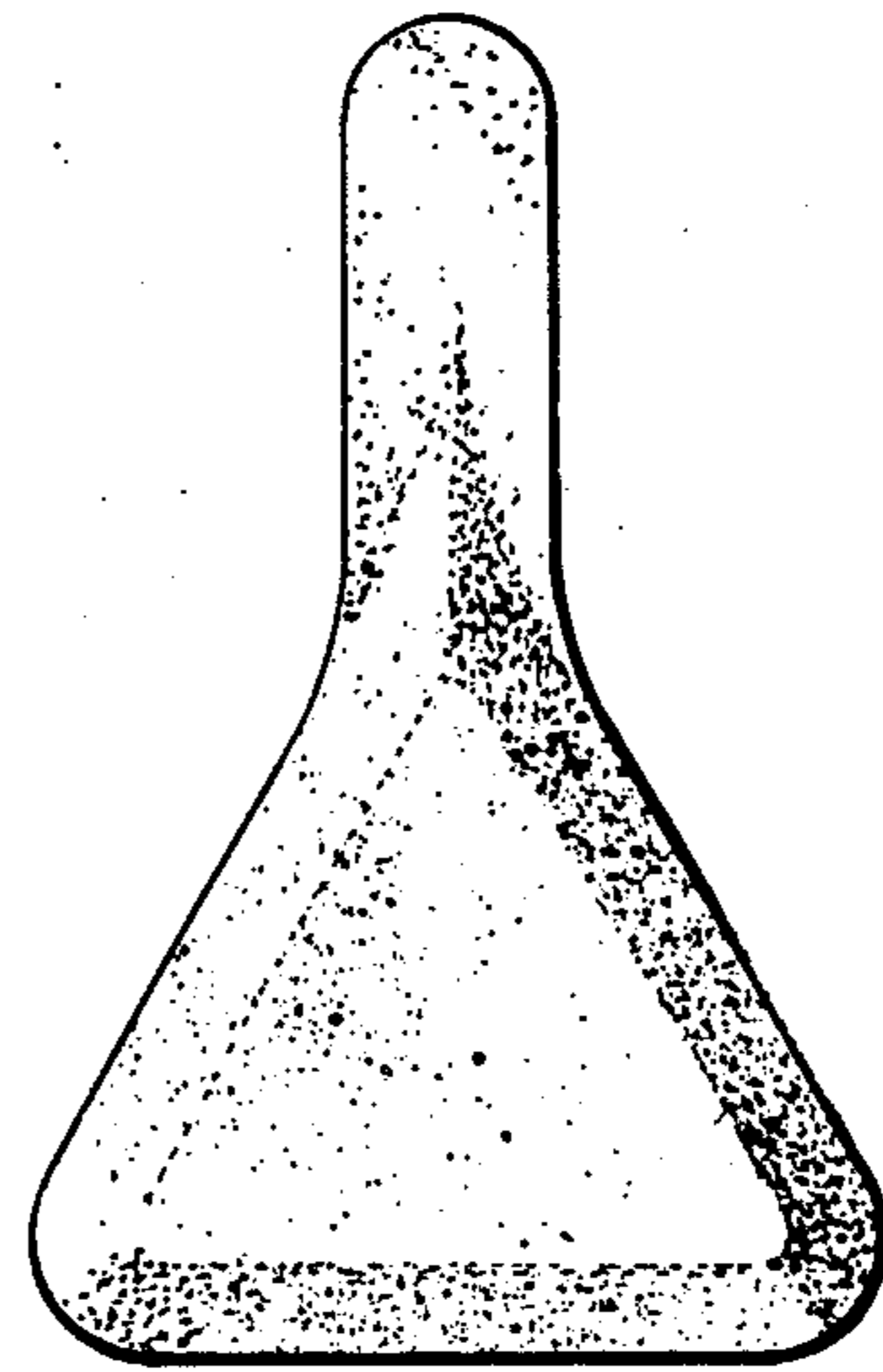
