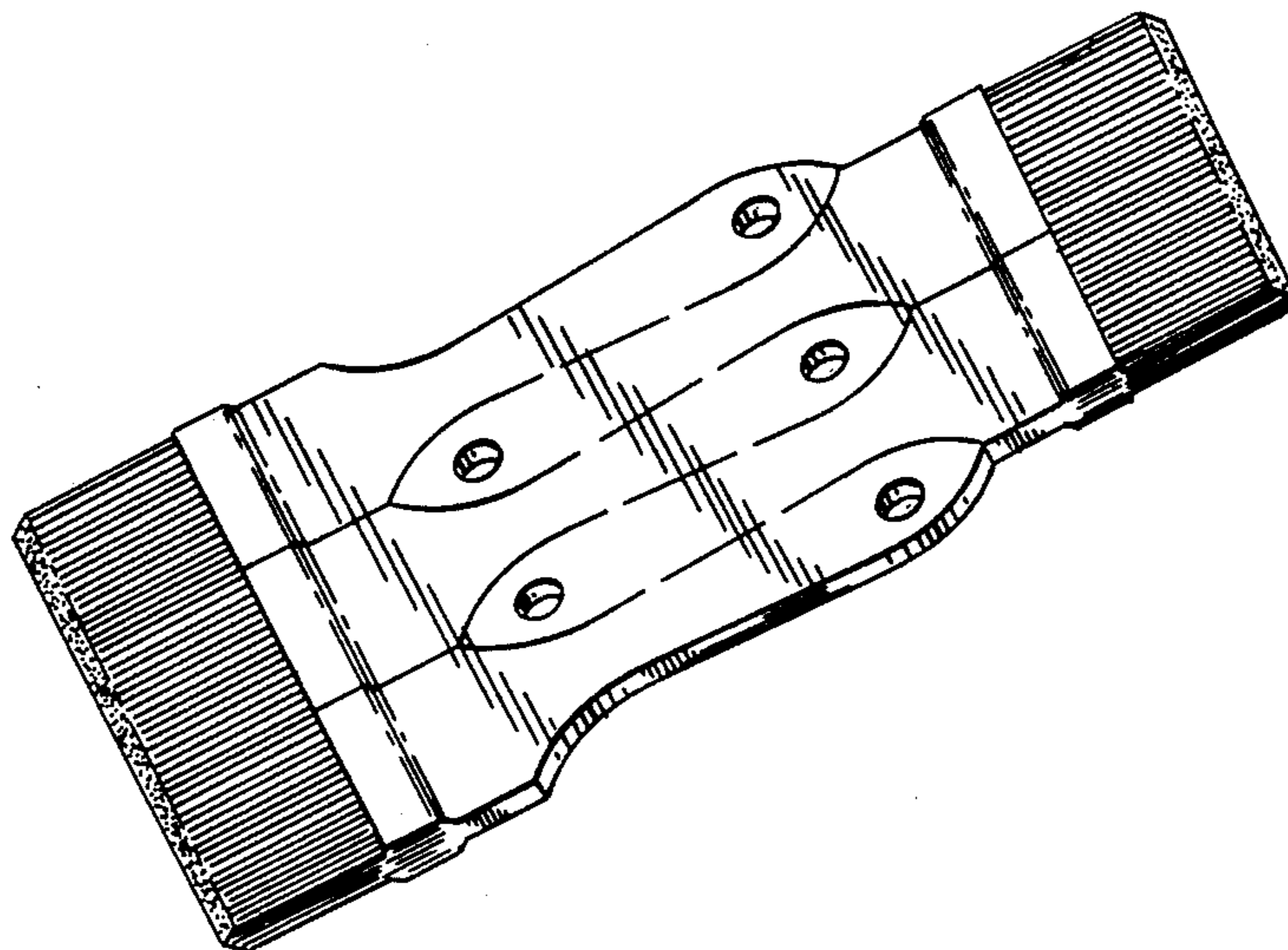

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a packaged unit for brushes, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a packaged unit for brushes showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view as seen from the bottom of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the opposite end thereof.



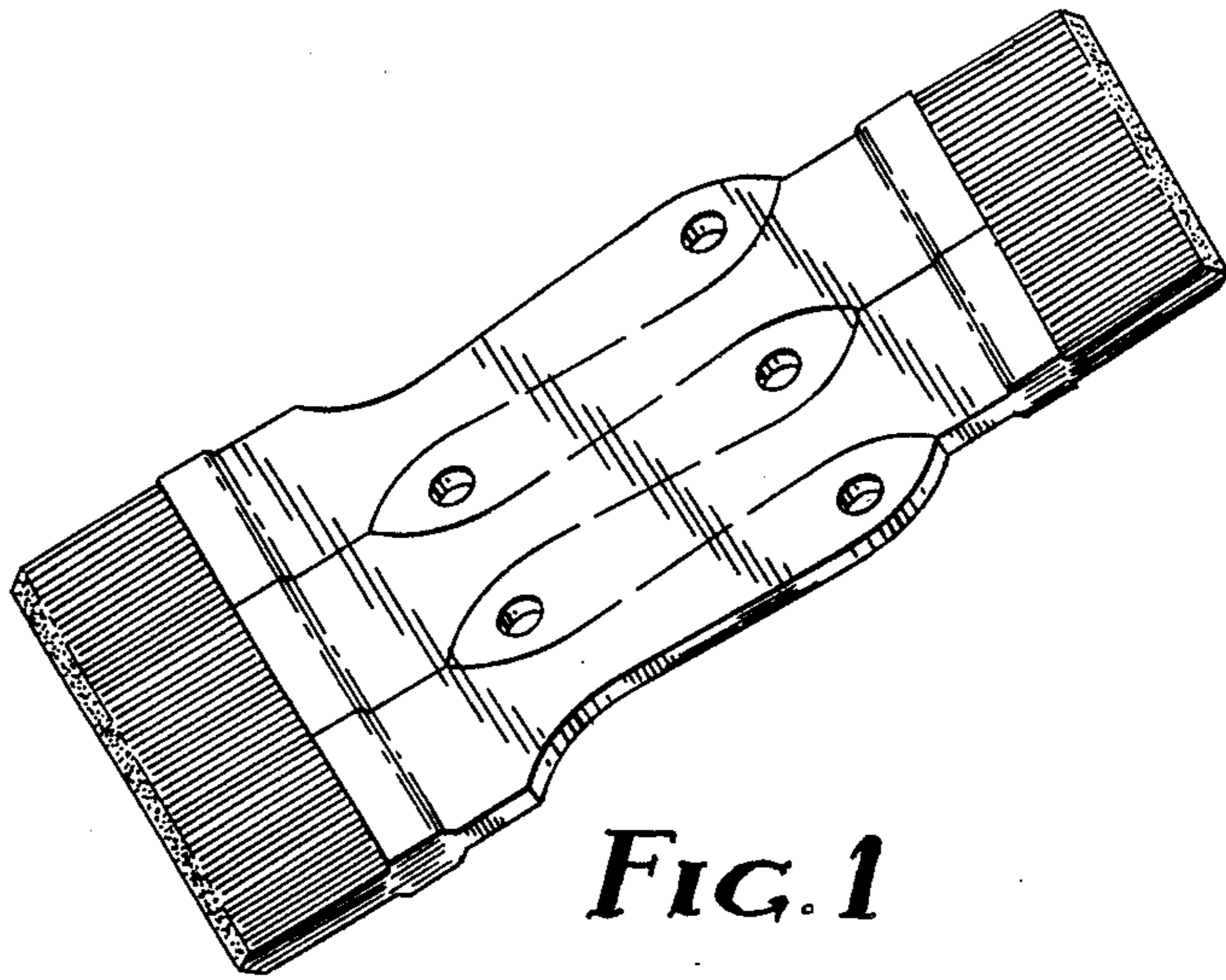

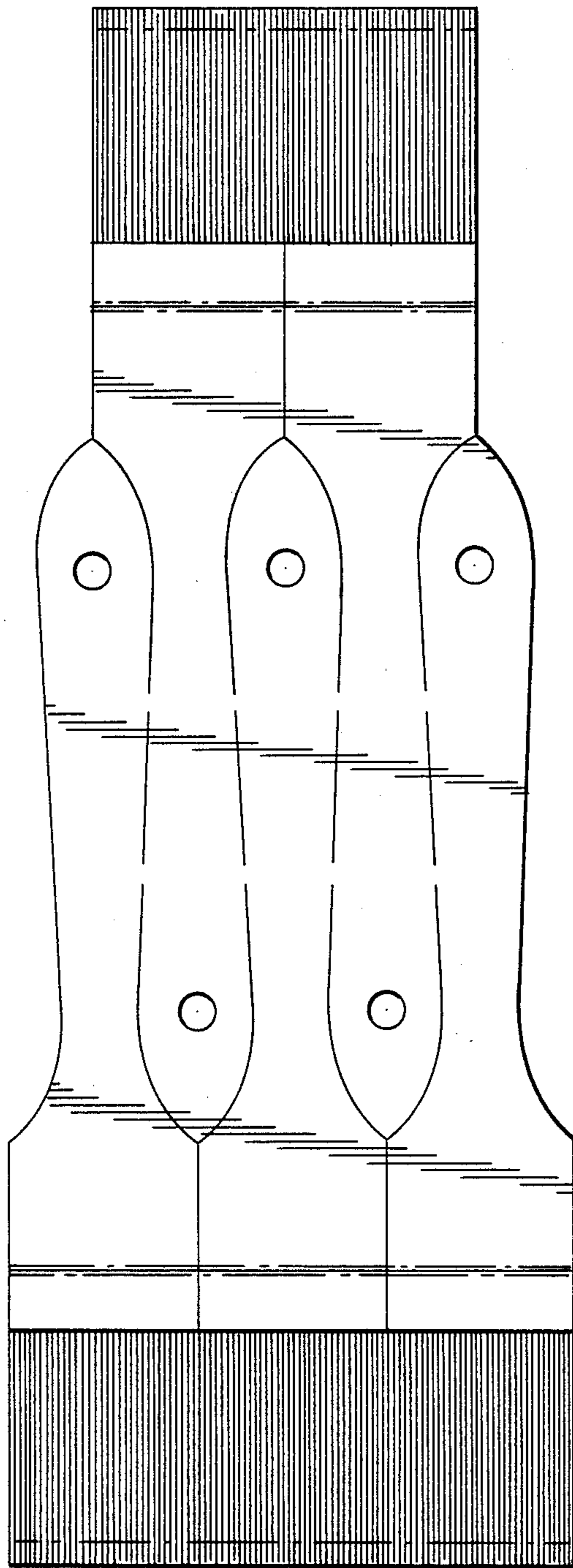
