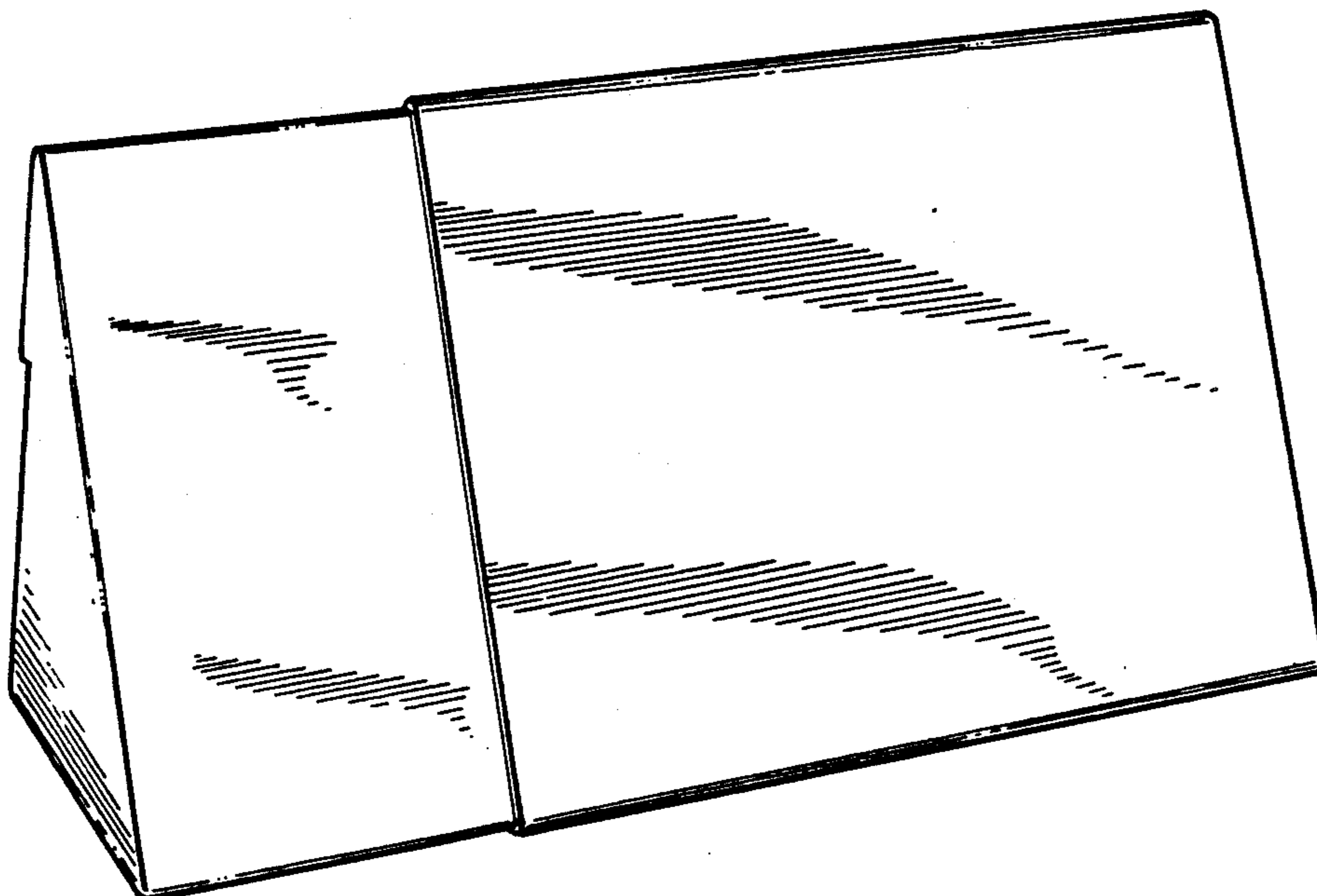

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined shipping and display container for sunglasses or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined shipping and display container for sunglasses or the like showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof, similar to FIG. 1 in partially open position;
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof, similar to FIG. 3 in partially open position;
FIG. 5 is an exploded view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view thereof.



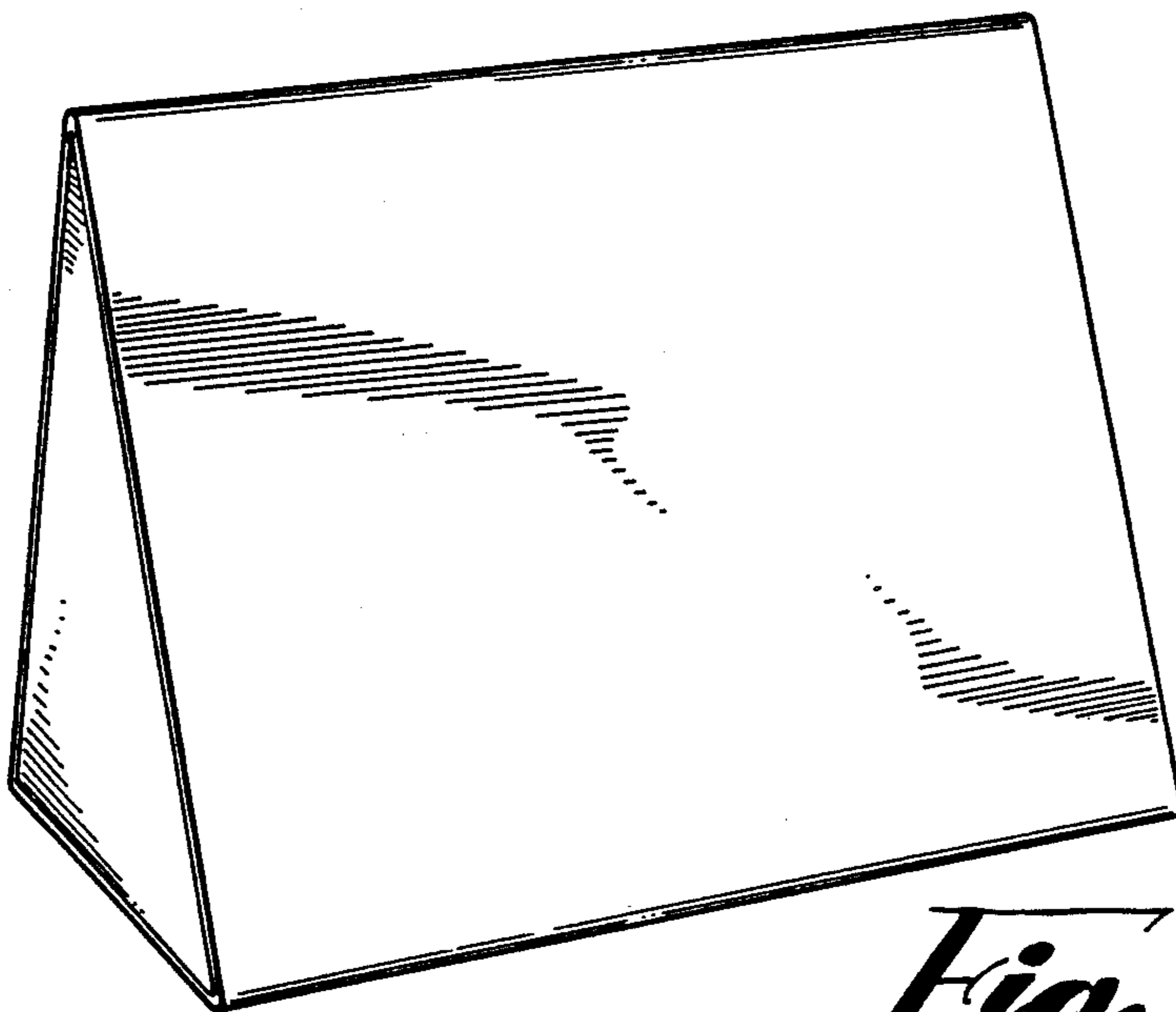

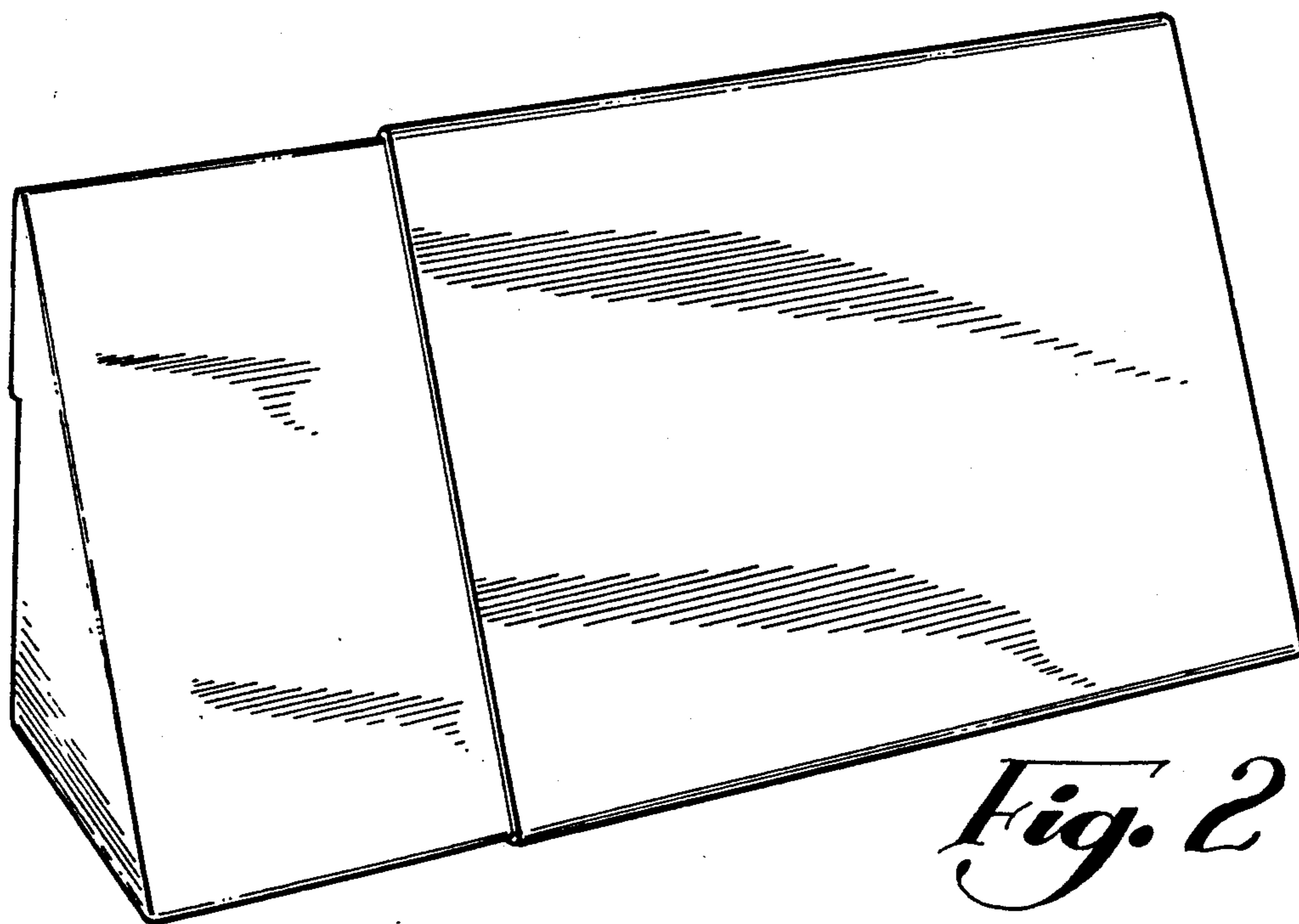

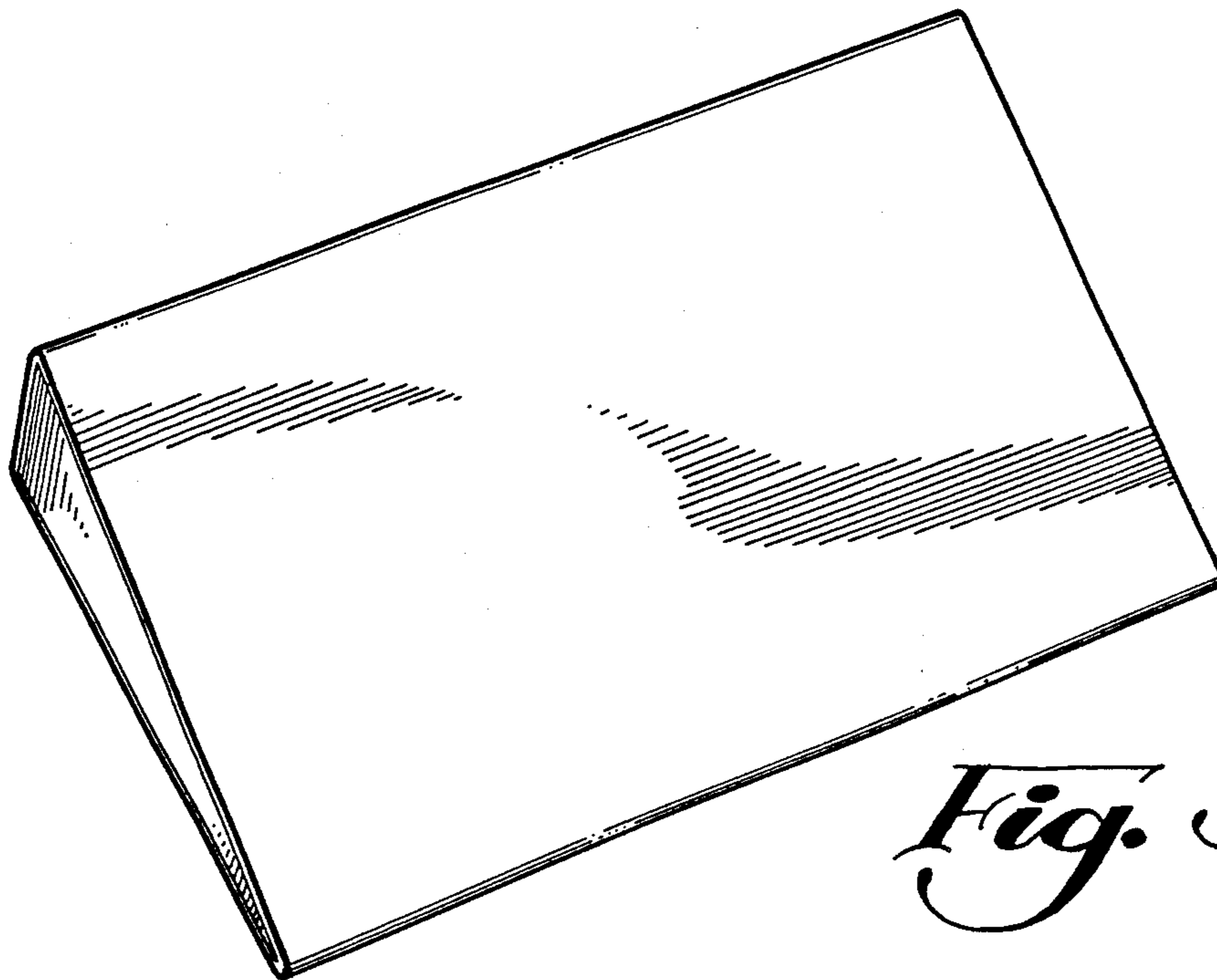

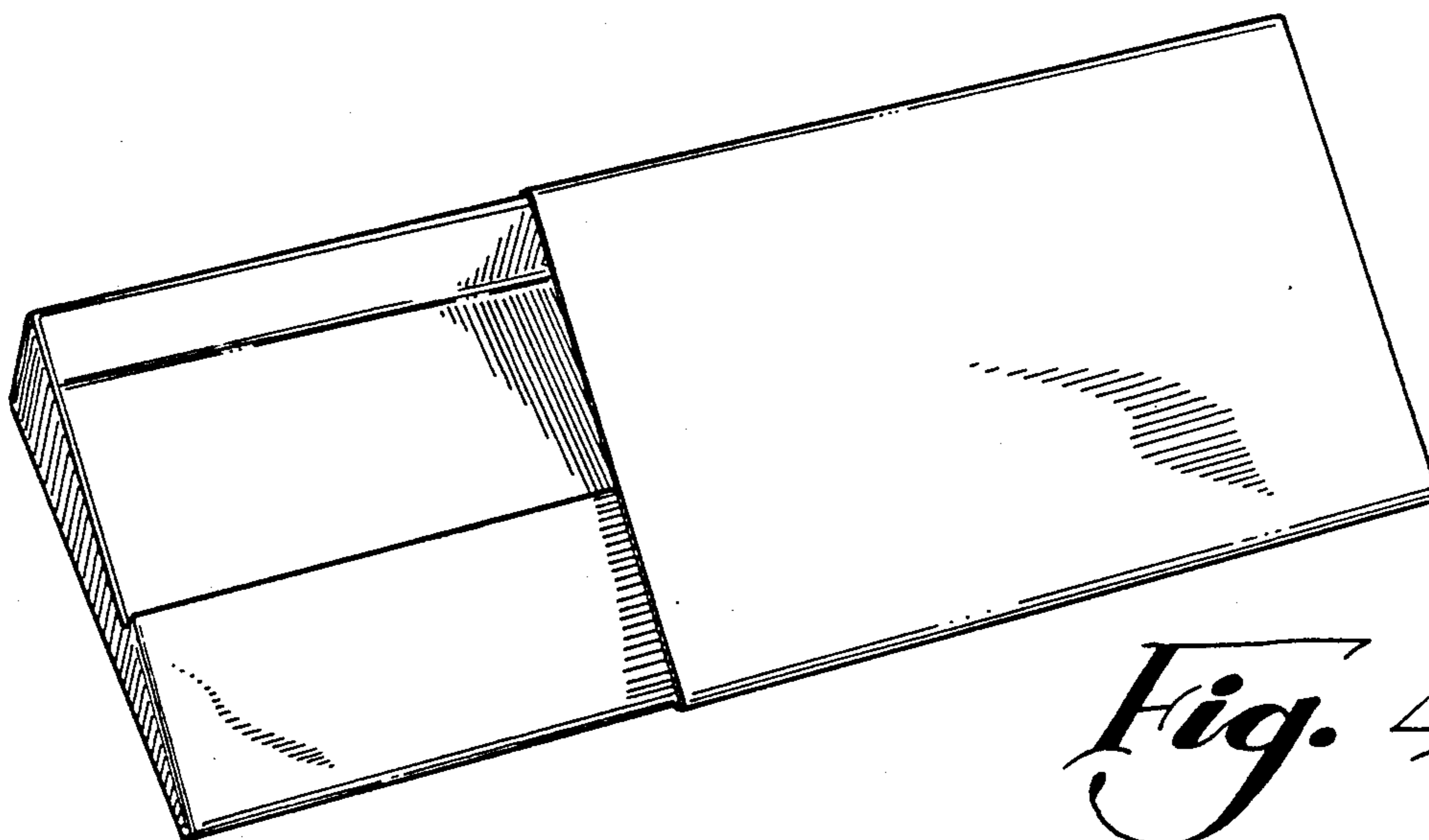

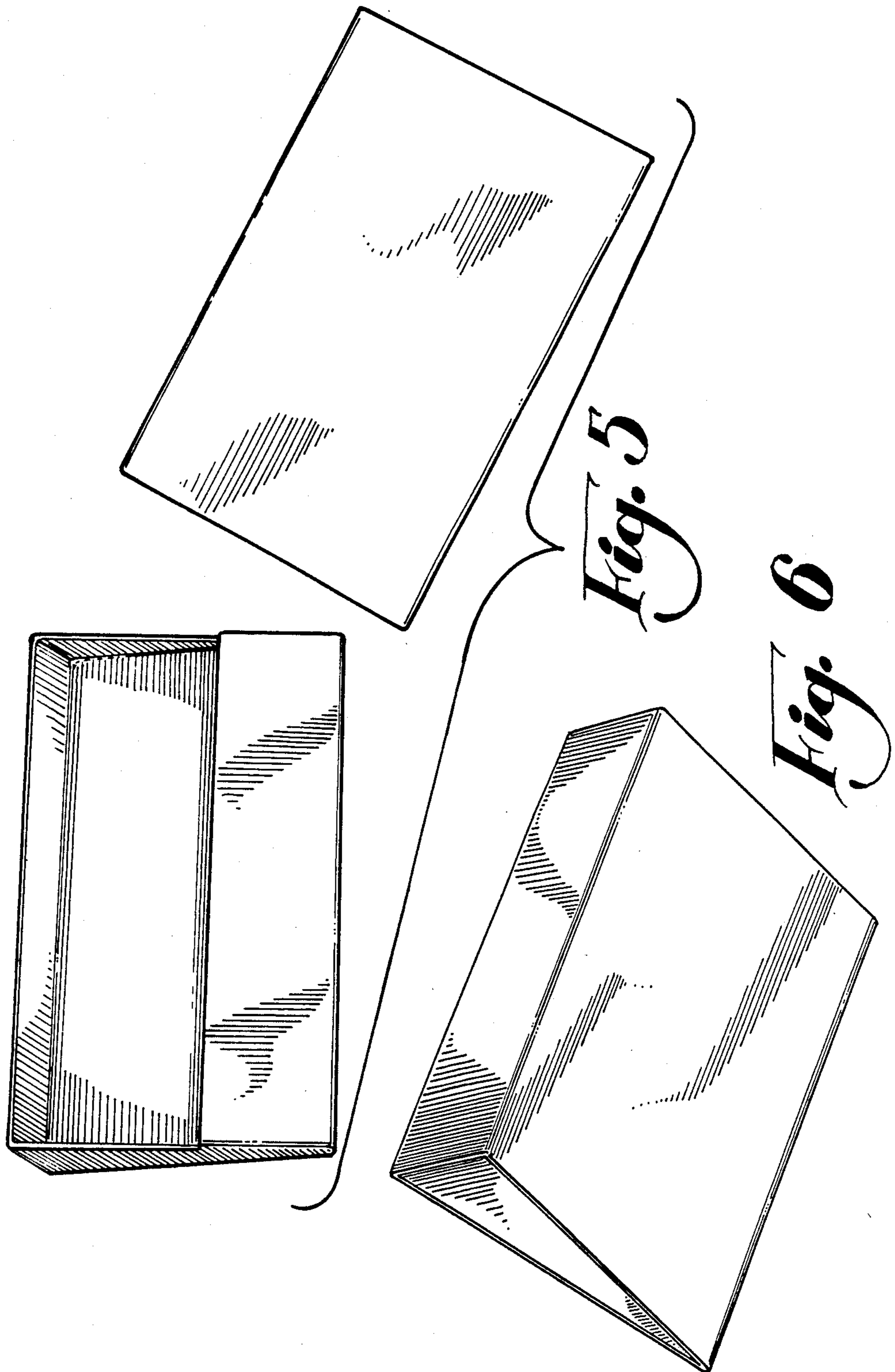
