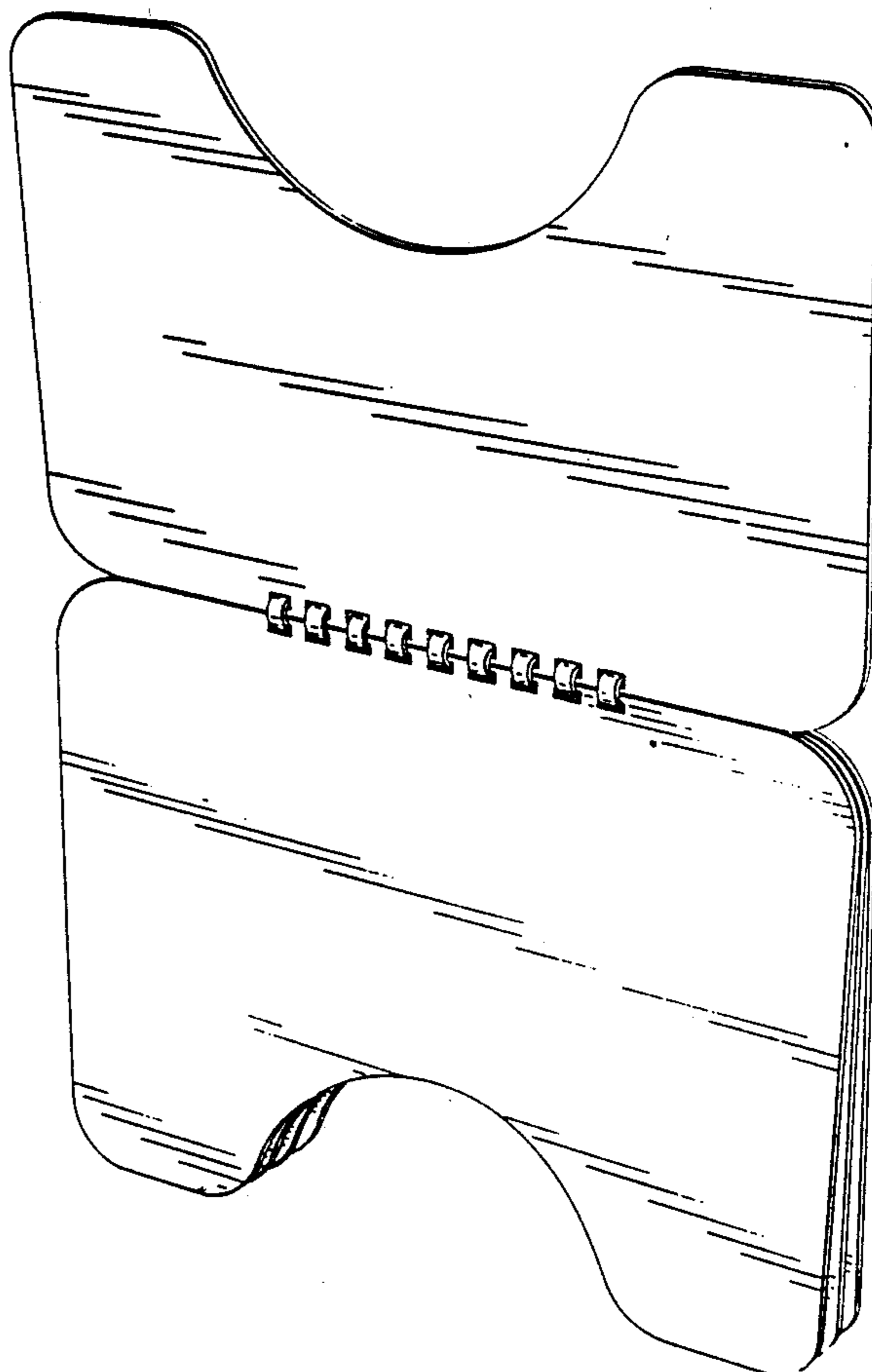
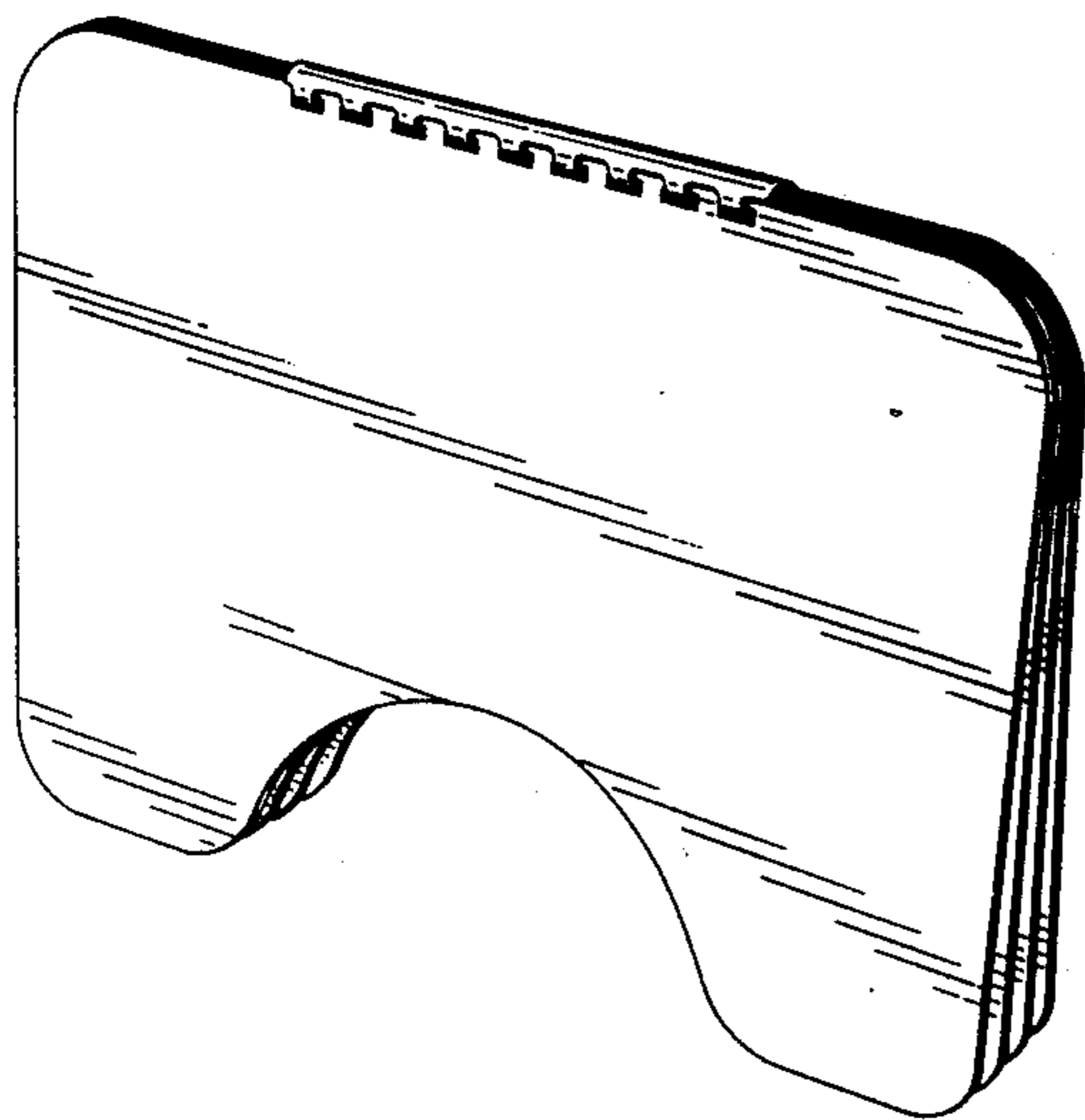

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a kit for teaching color coordination showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, shown in open condition.



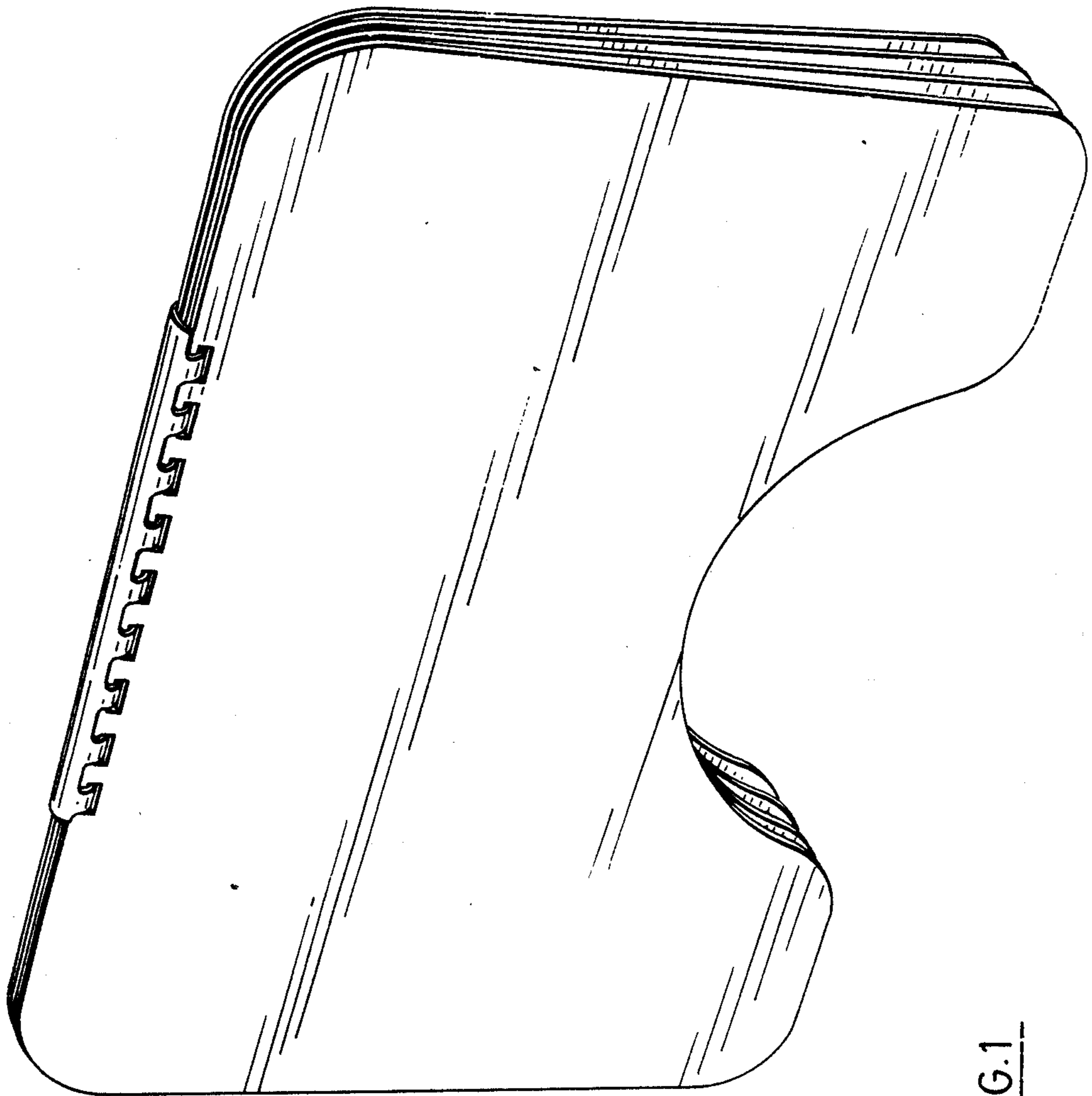

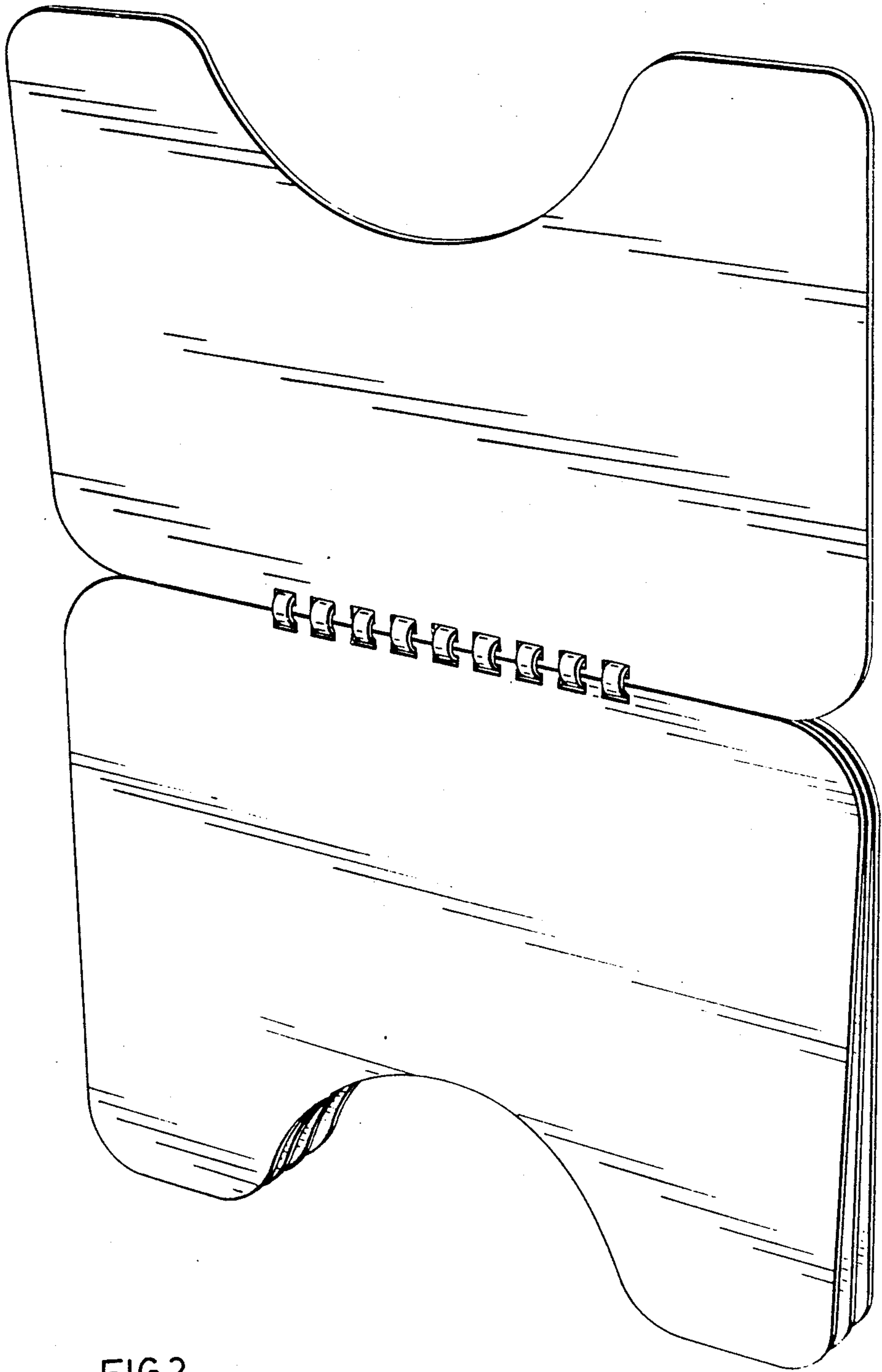
