DESCRIPTION

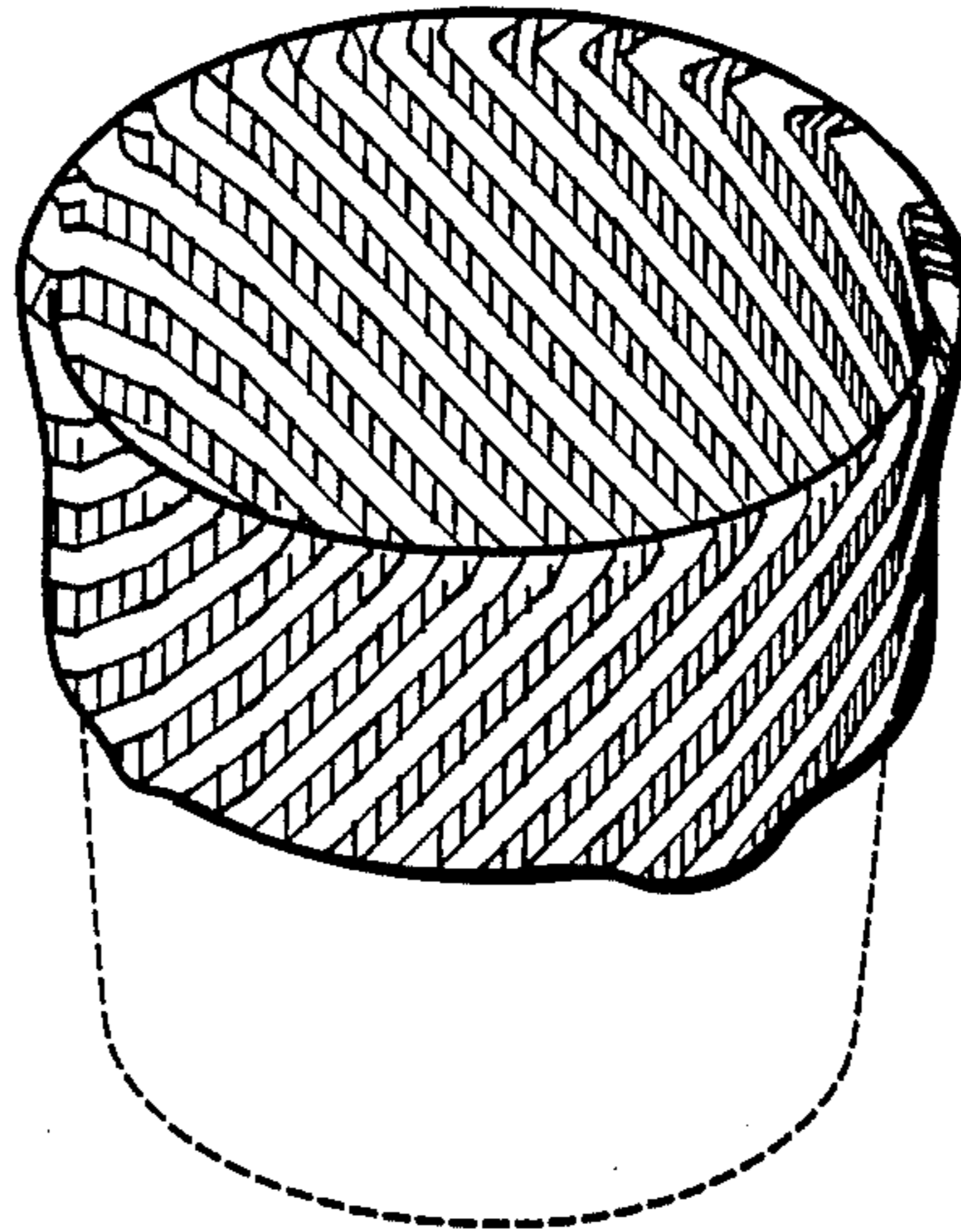

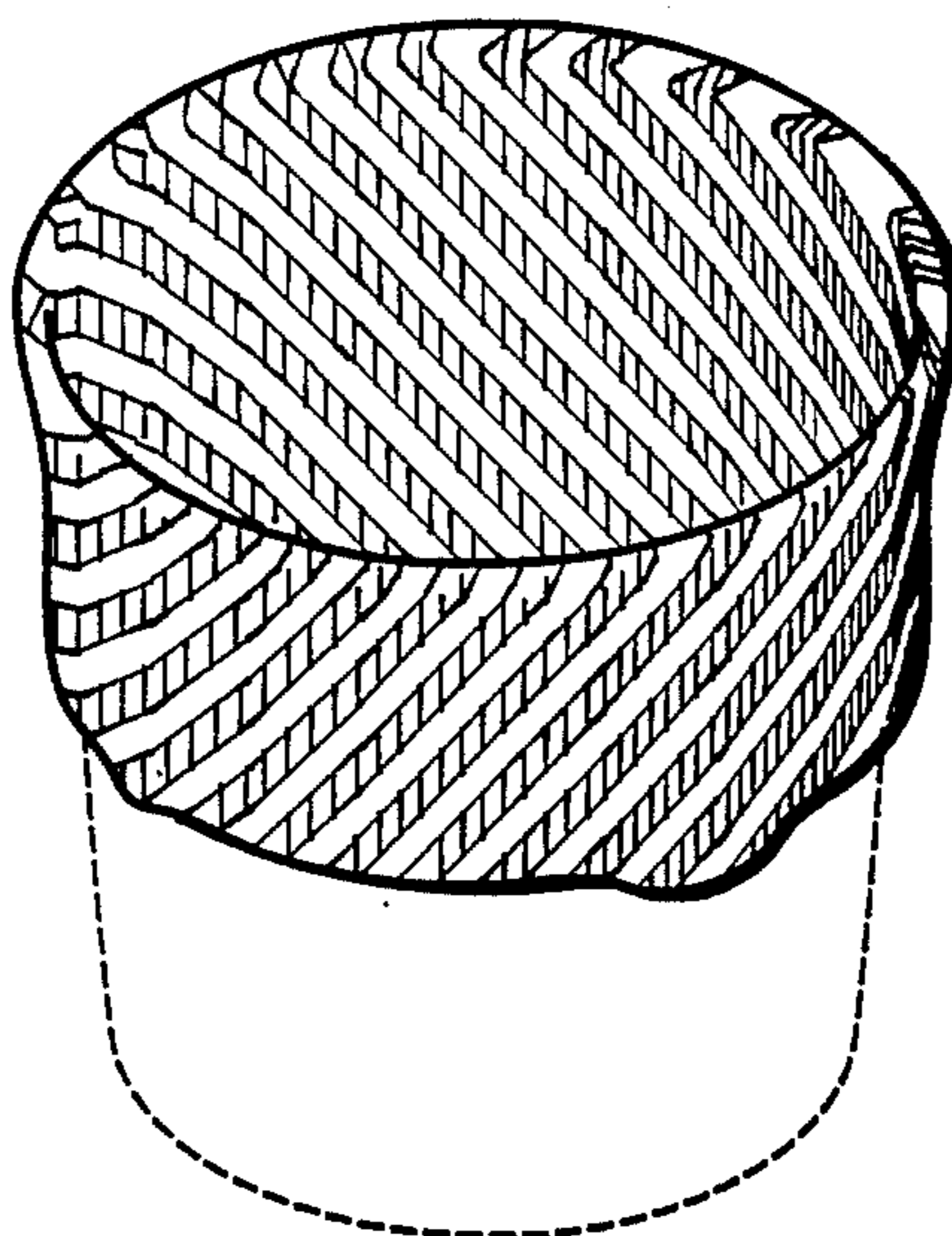

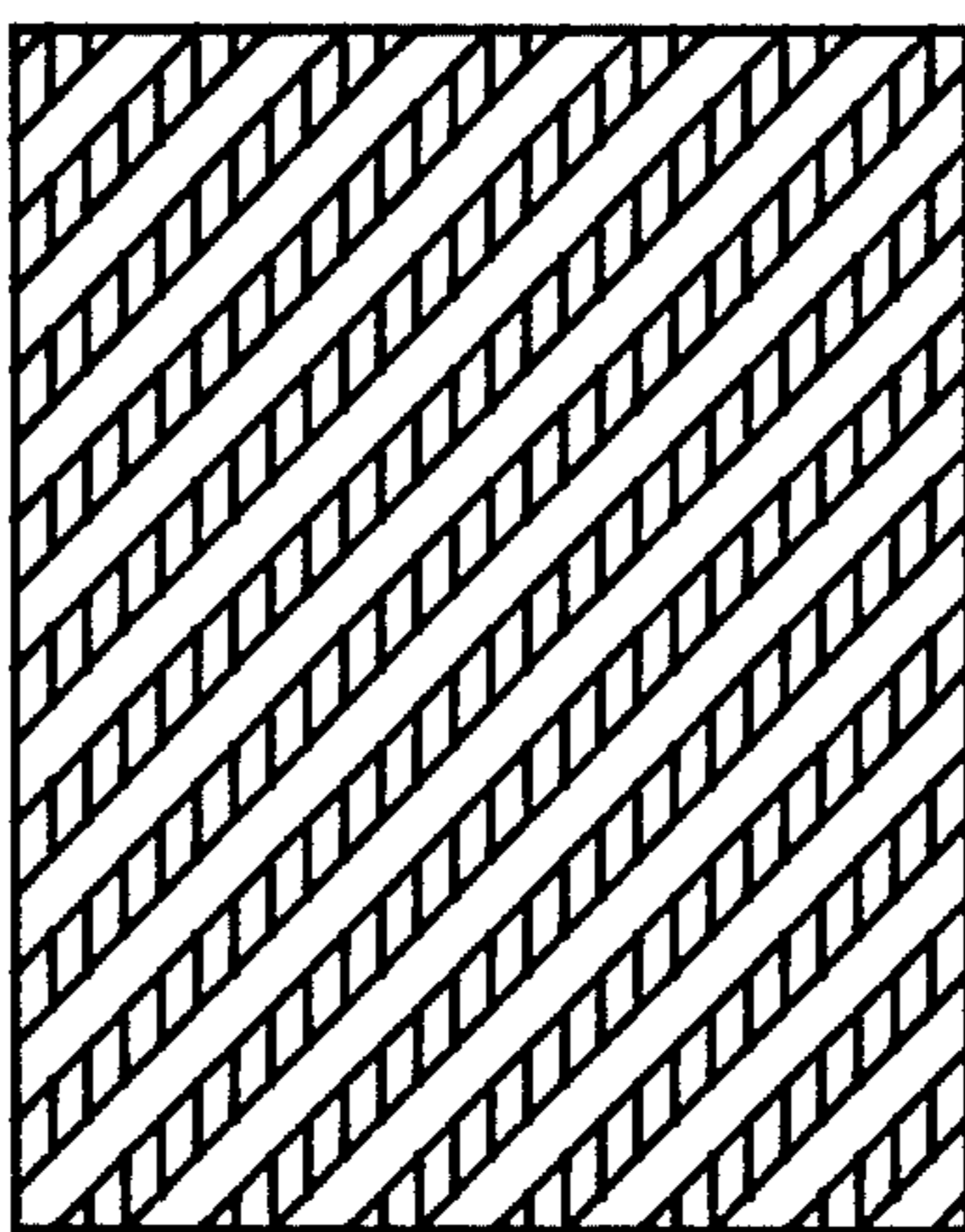
