FIG. 3 is a lower end elevation view thereof;

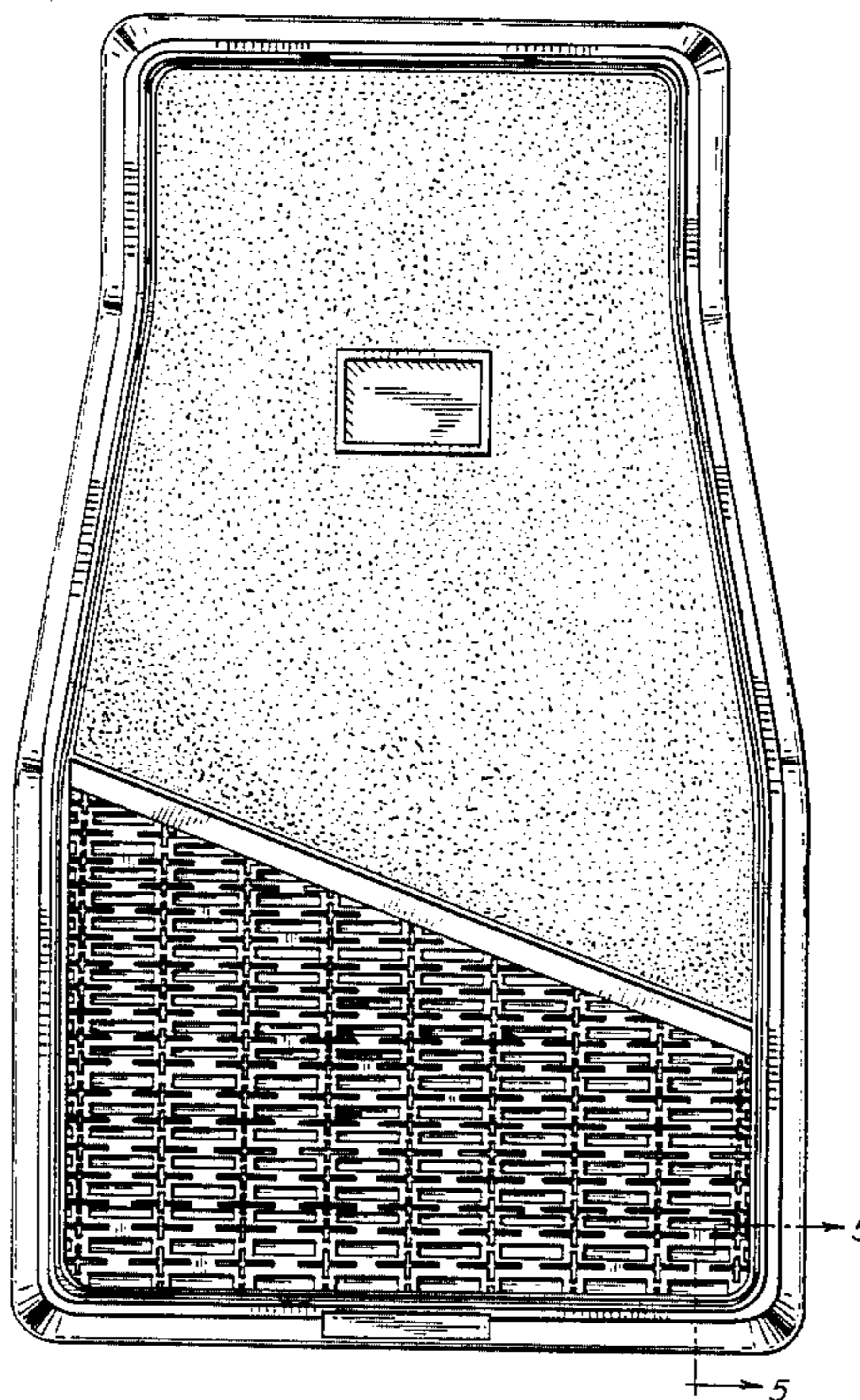
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

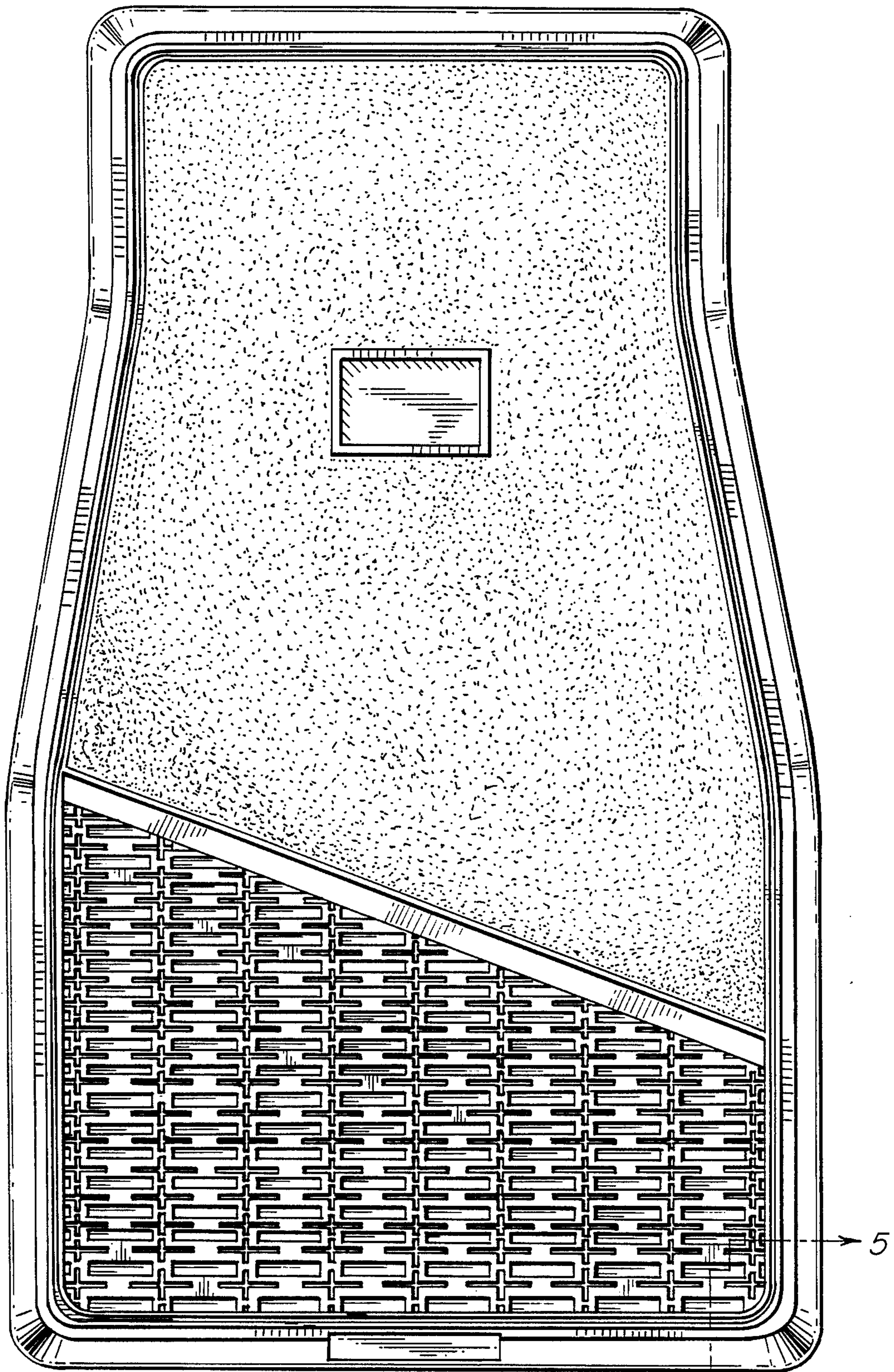

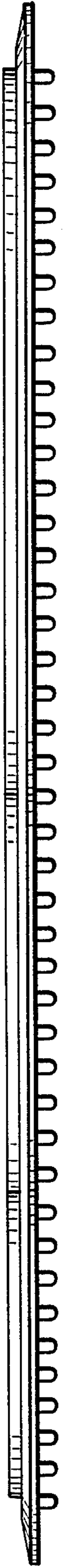

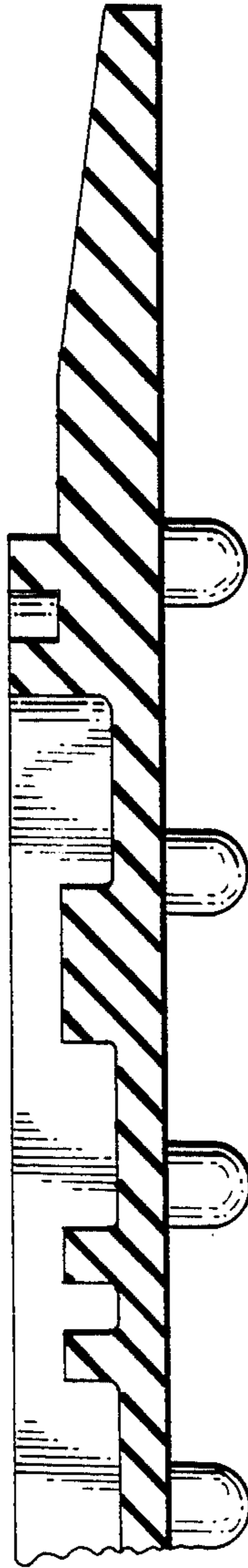

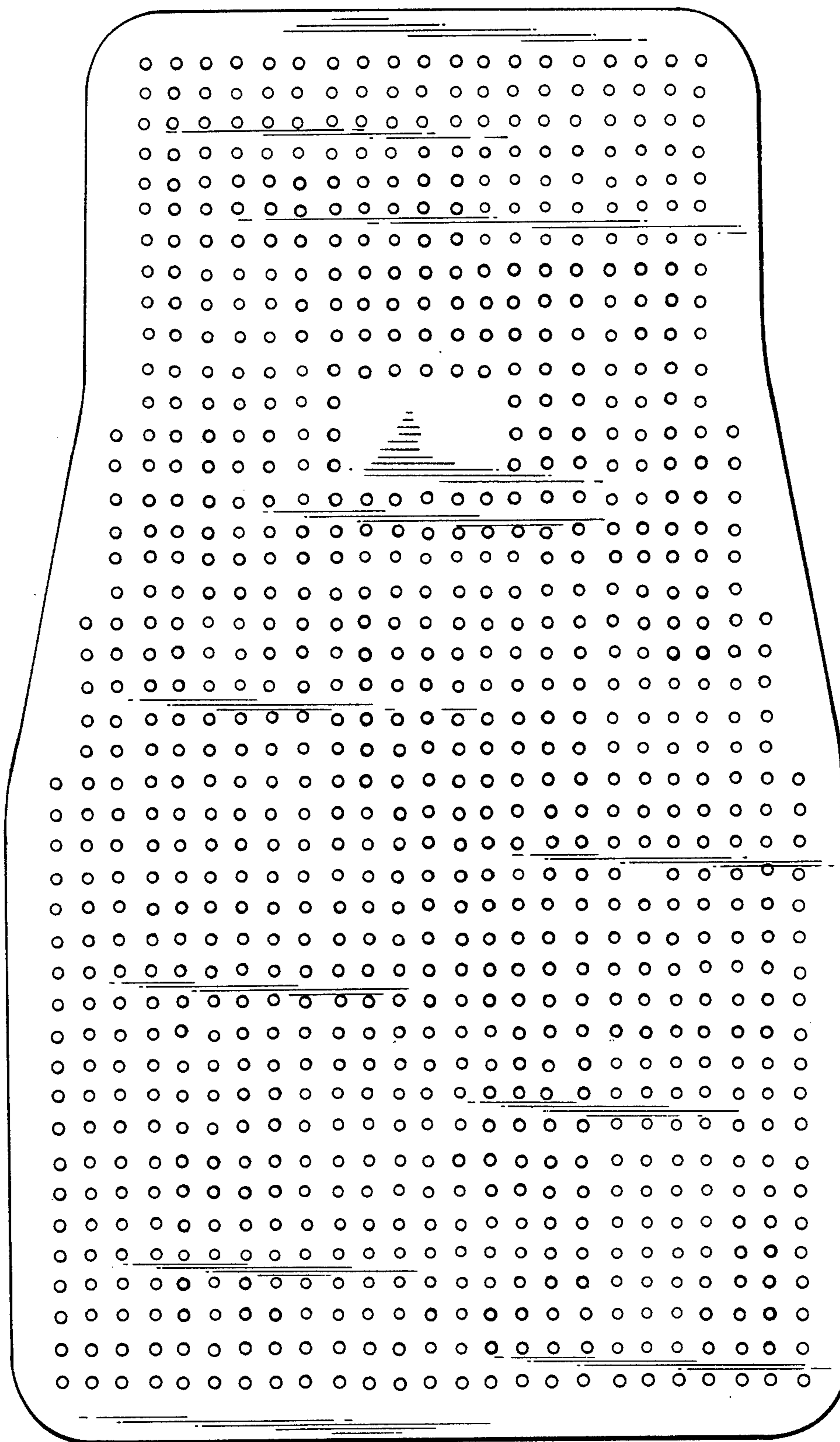
