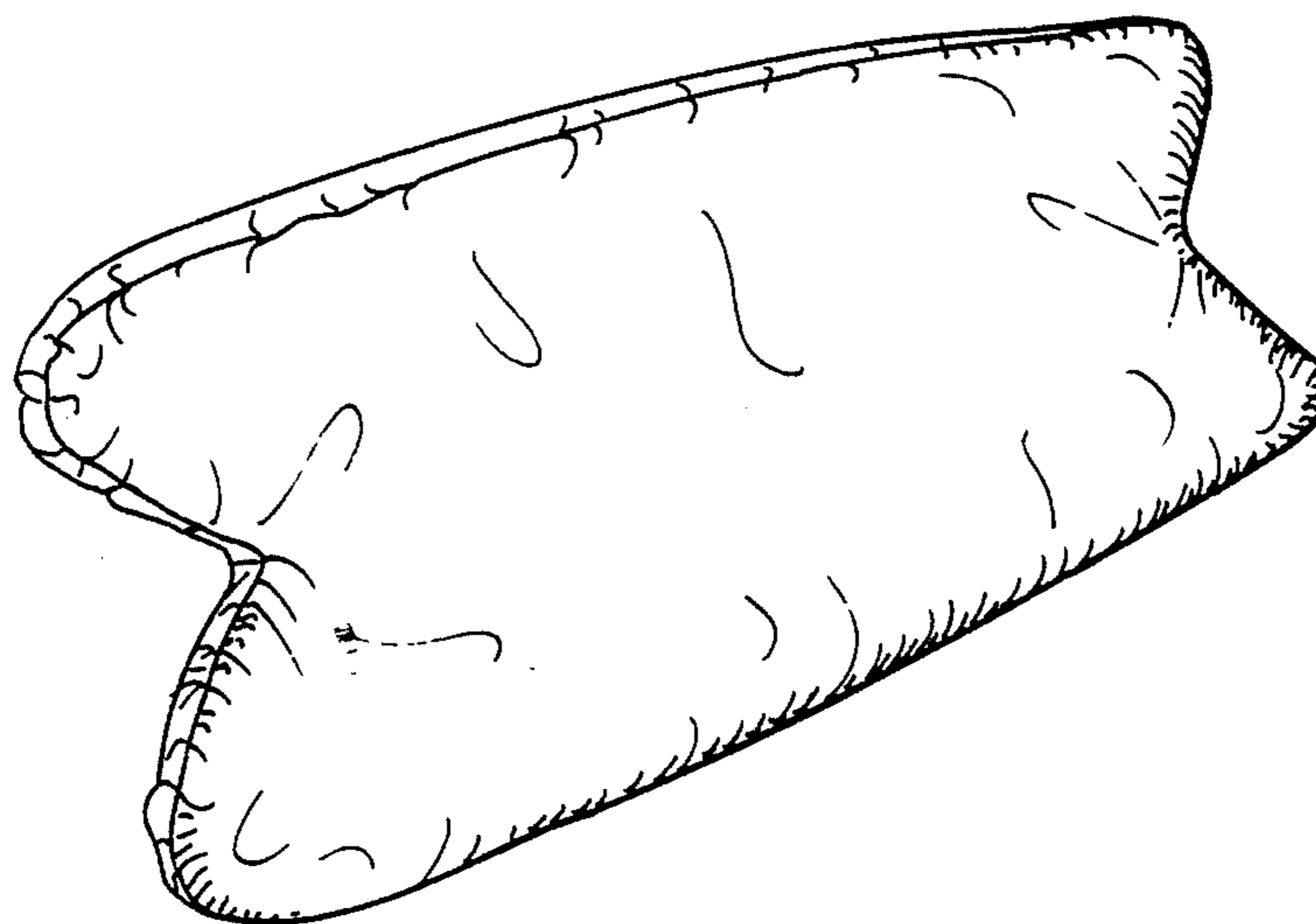

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a post-surgery pillow, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a post-surgery pillow showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, and right side perspective view thereof. FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side; and FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image of the front view.



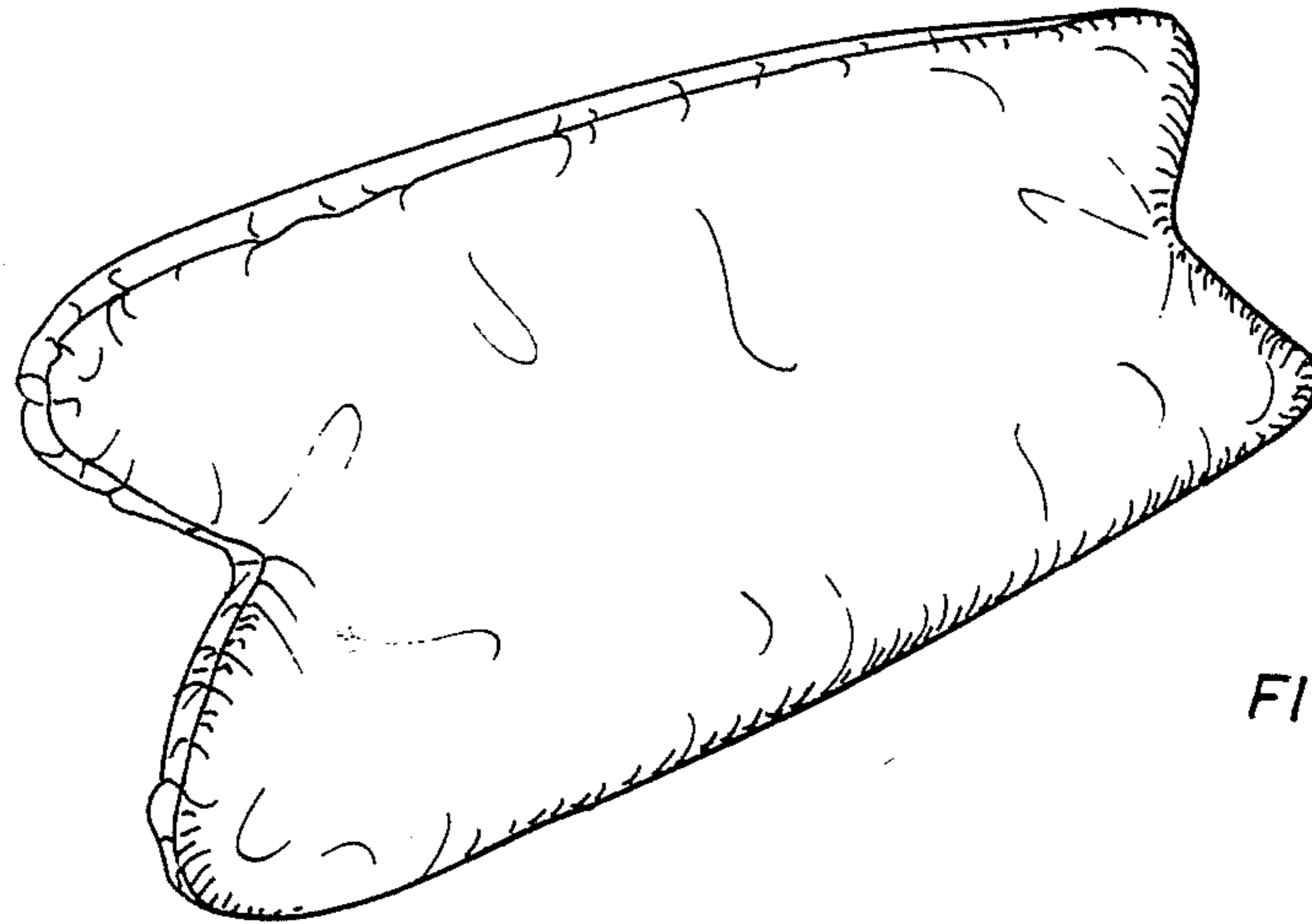

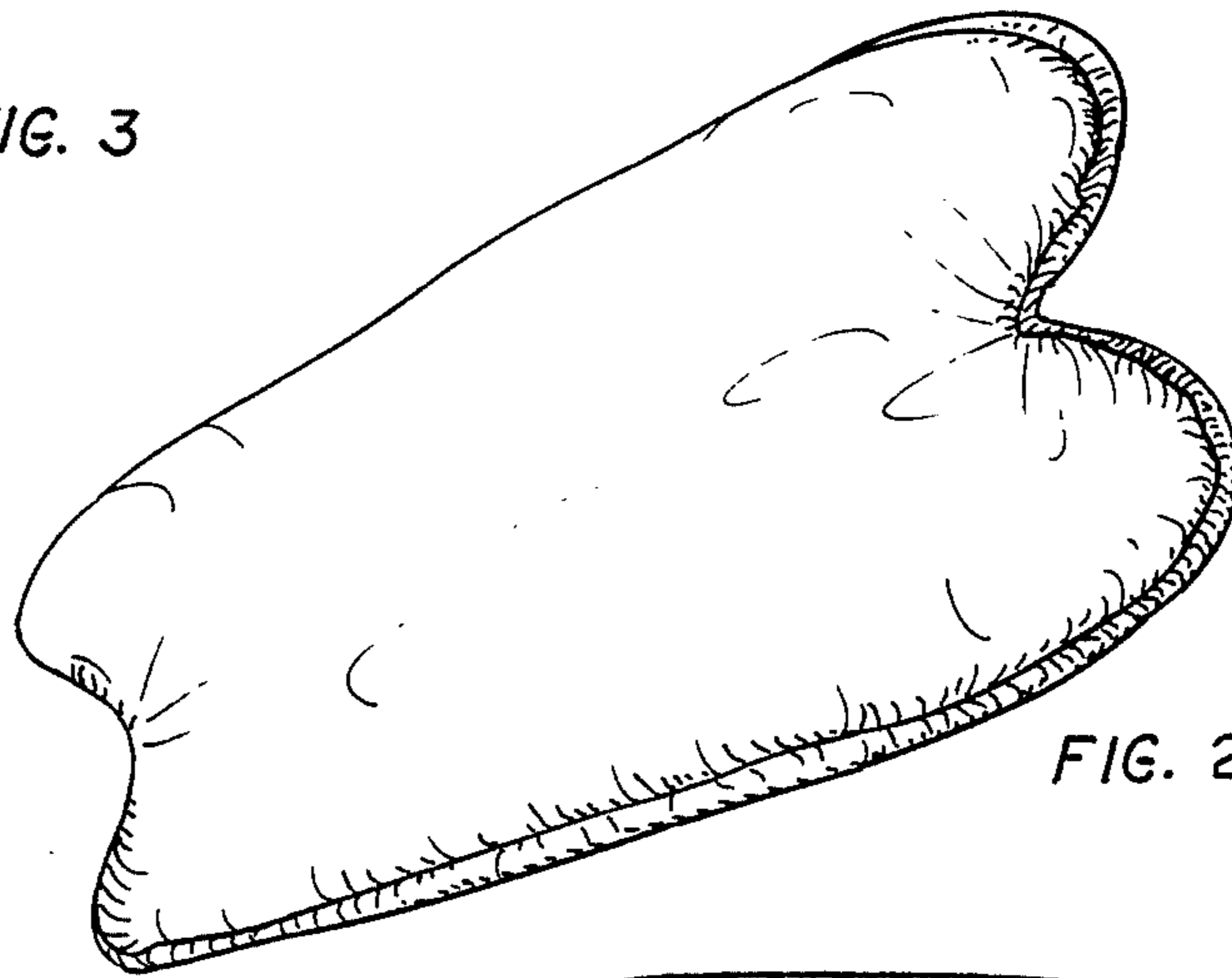

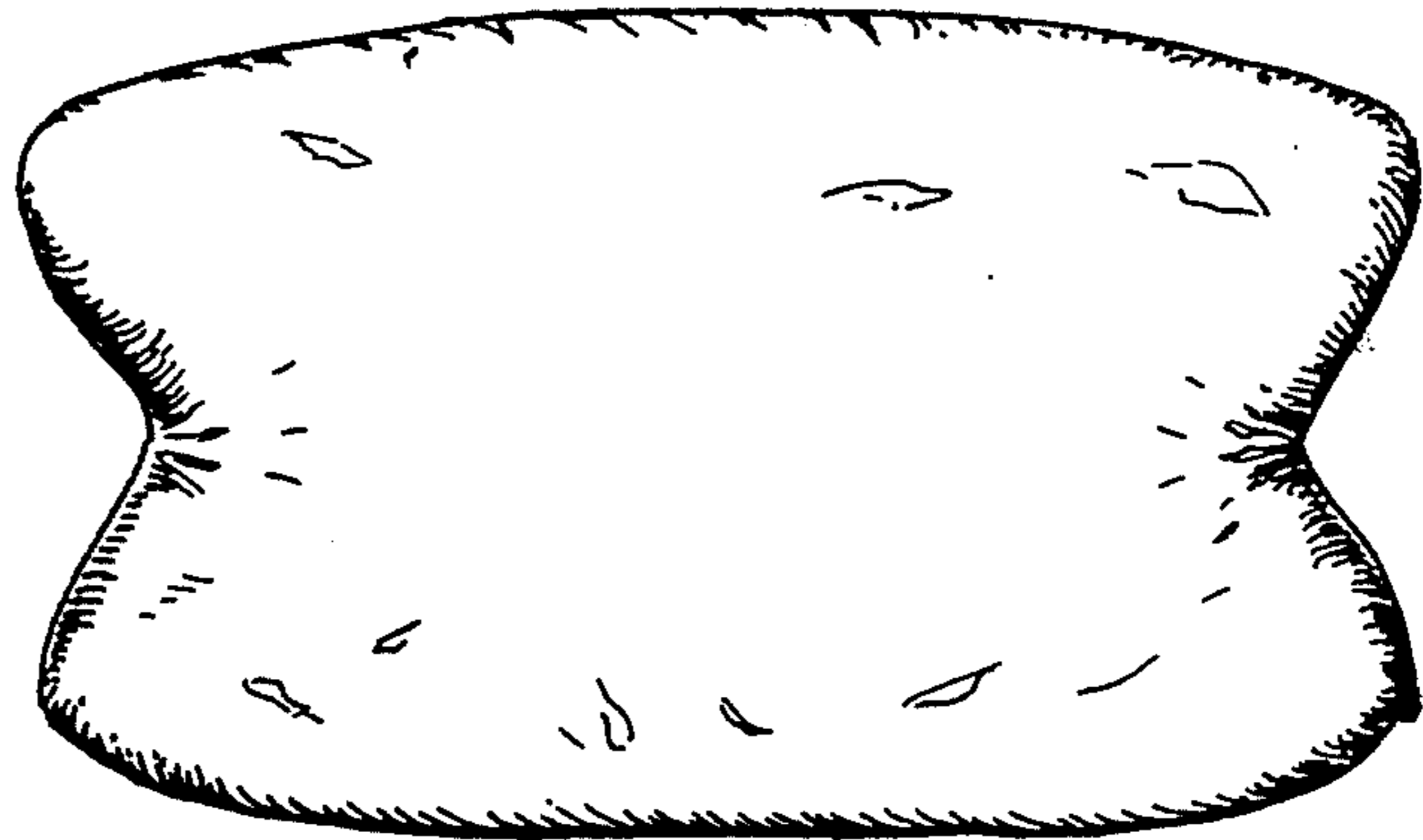
