[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined tape player, television sound and radio tuner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a combined tape player, television sound and radio tuner showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof, shown with the lid in an open position;
FIG. 3 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof, shown with the battery in a raised position;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left-side elevational thereof;
FIG. 7 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof.

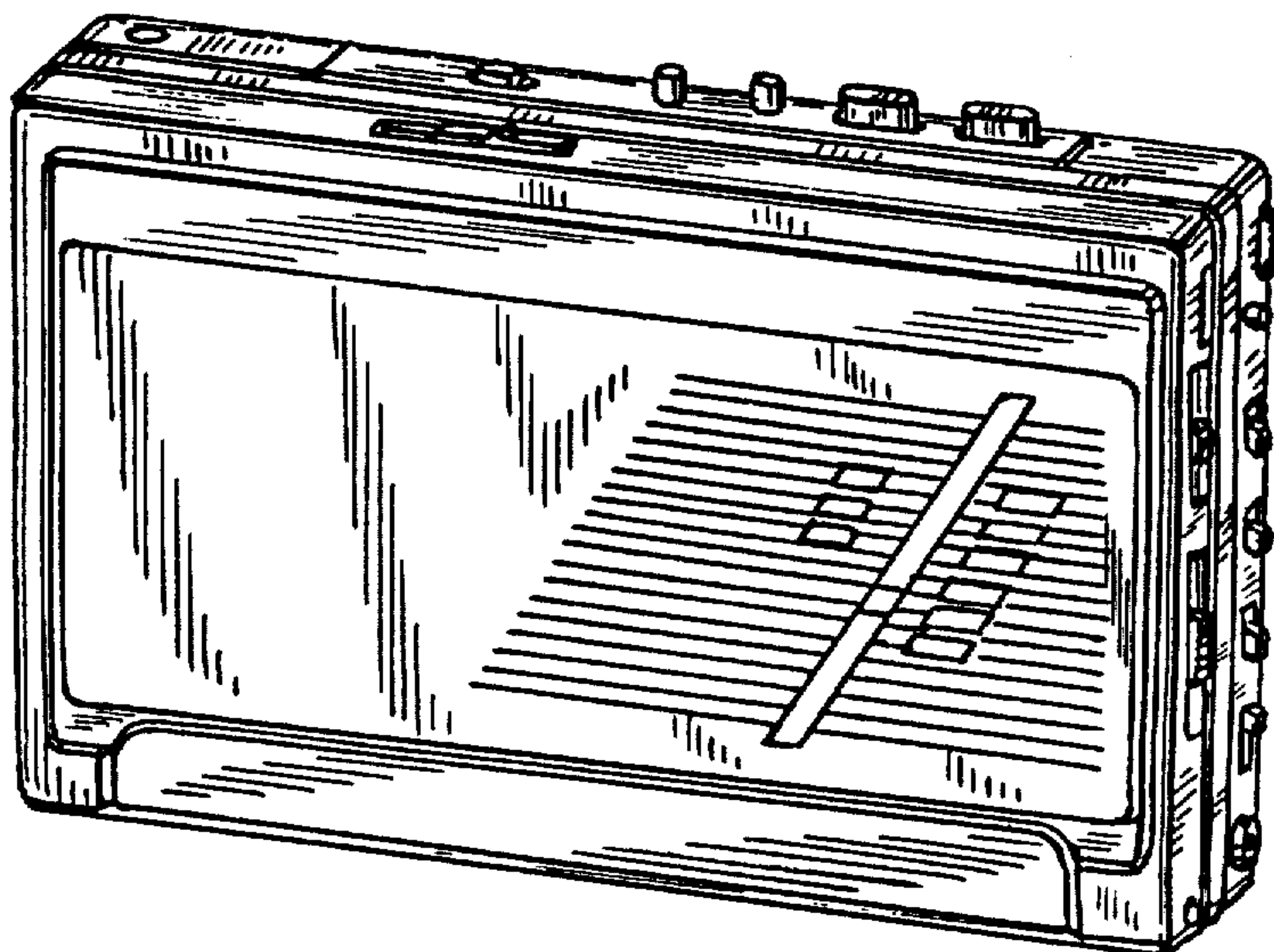

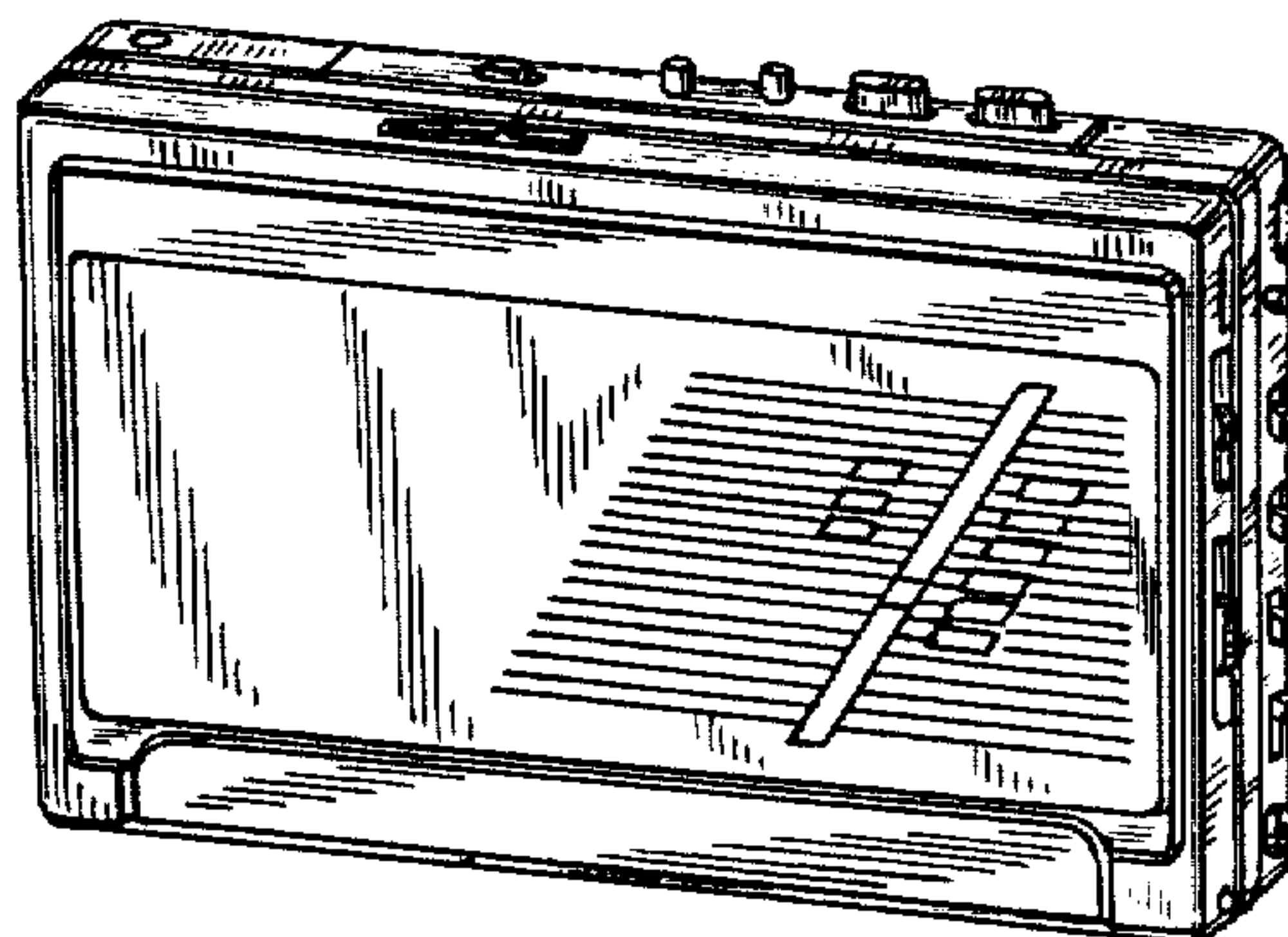

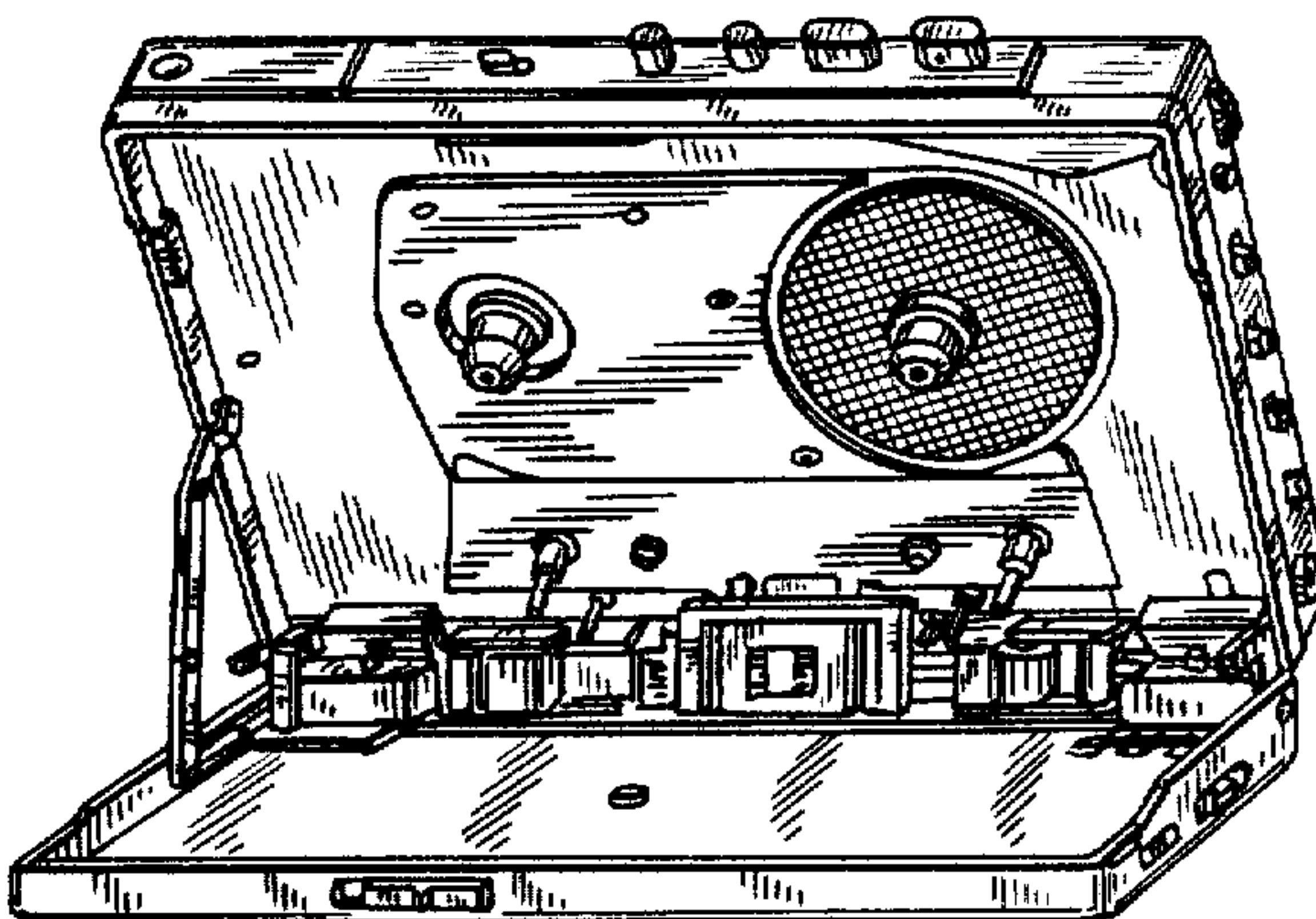

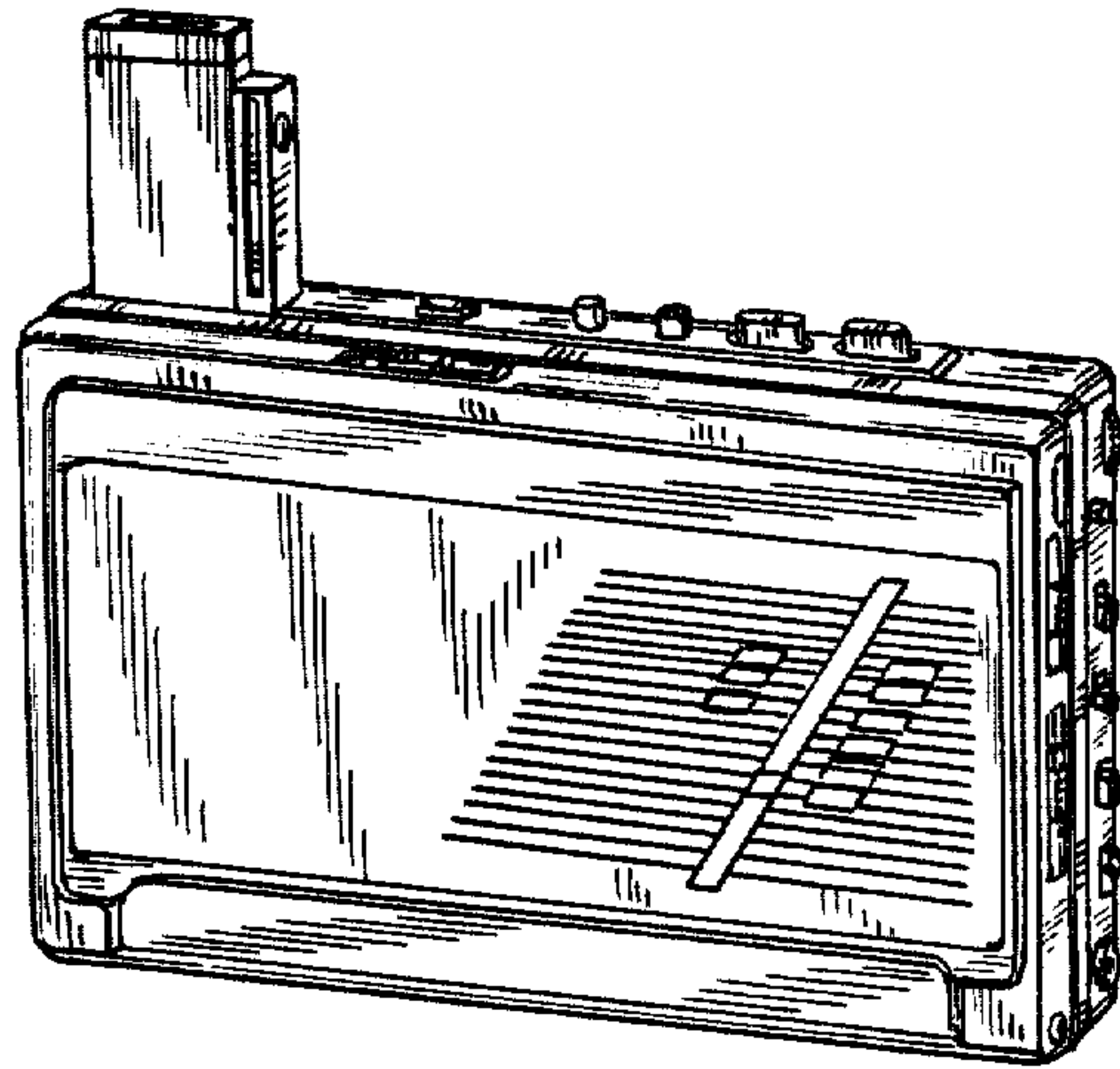

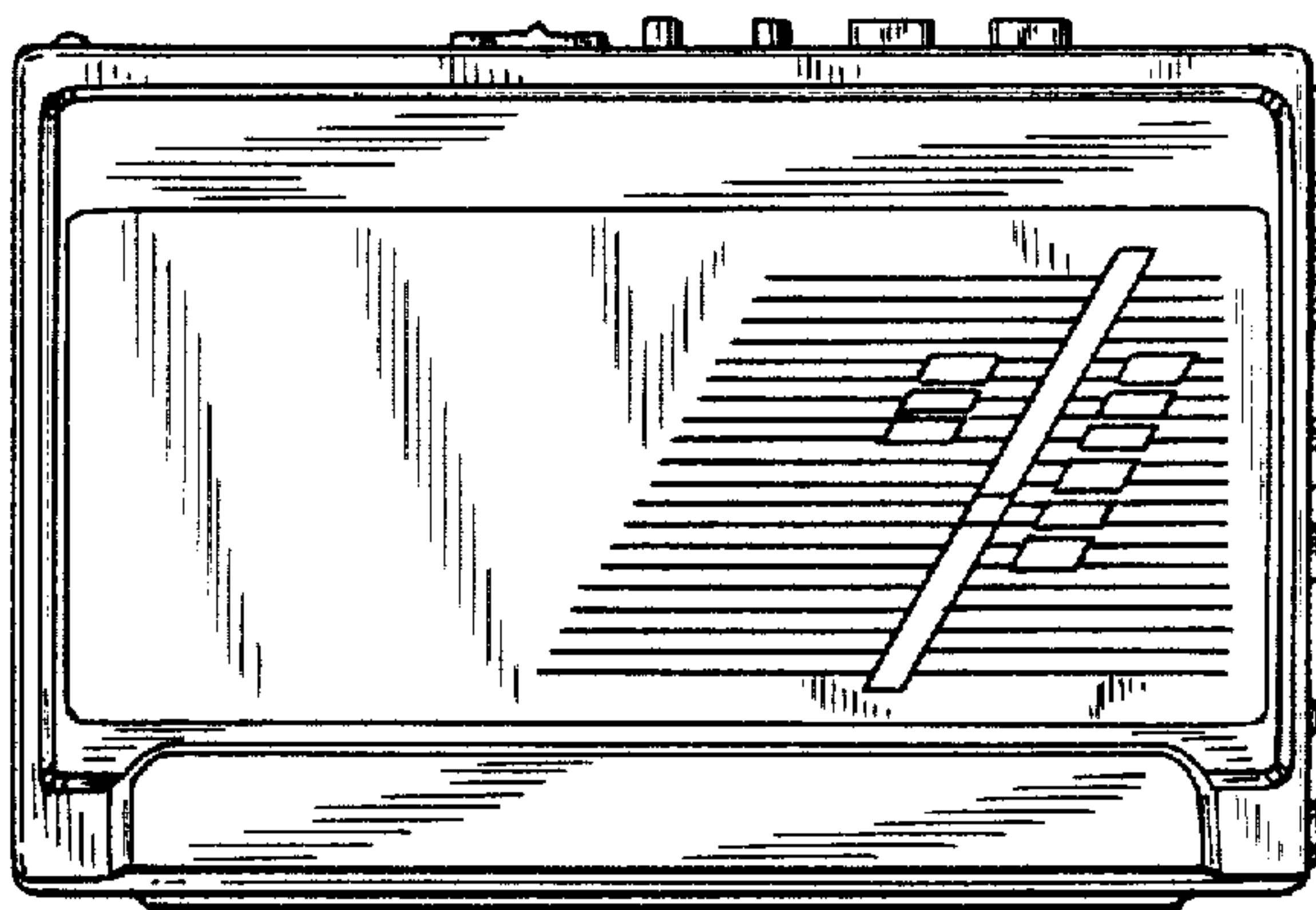

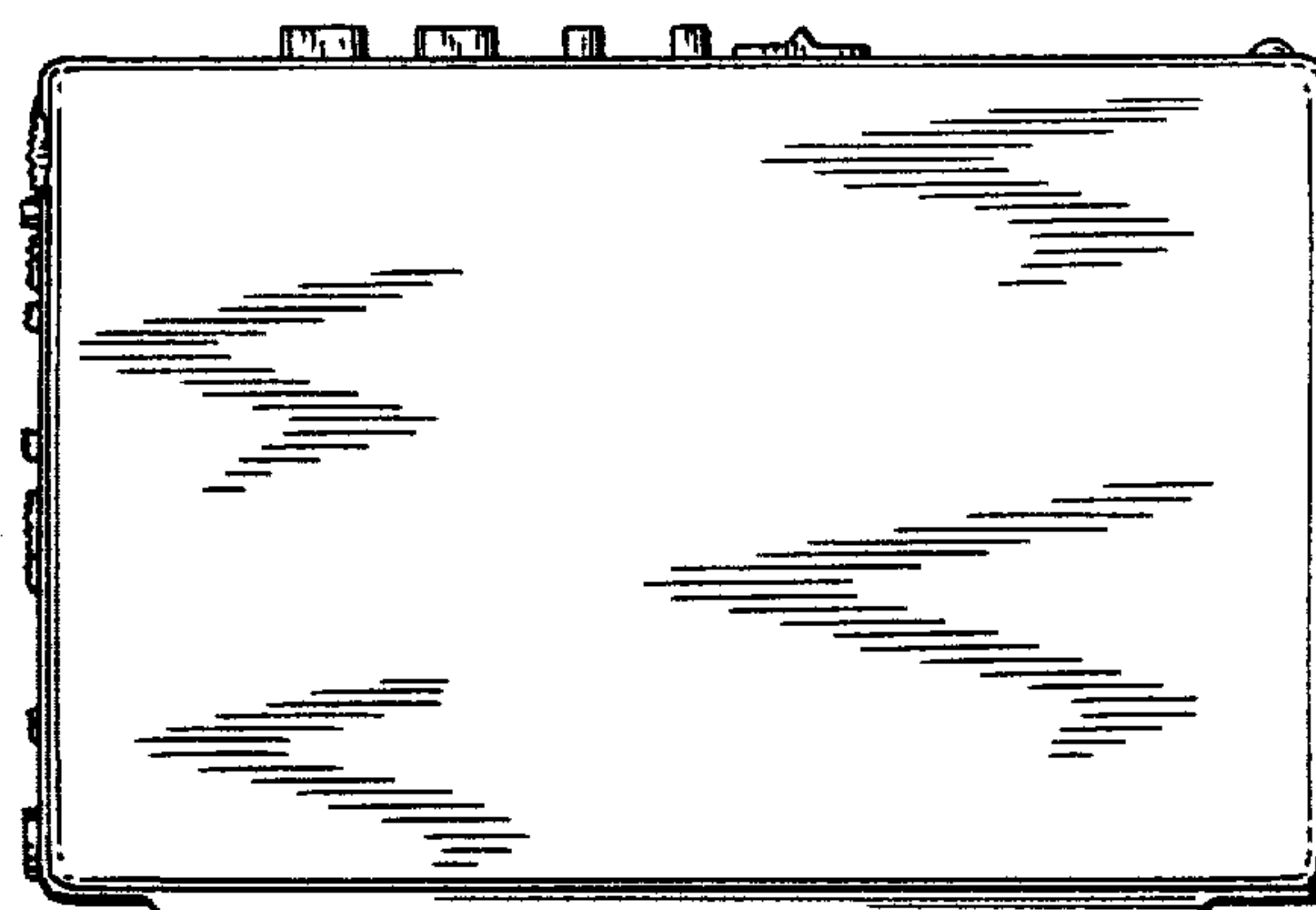

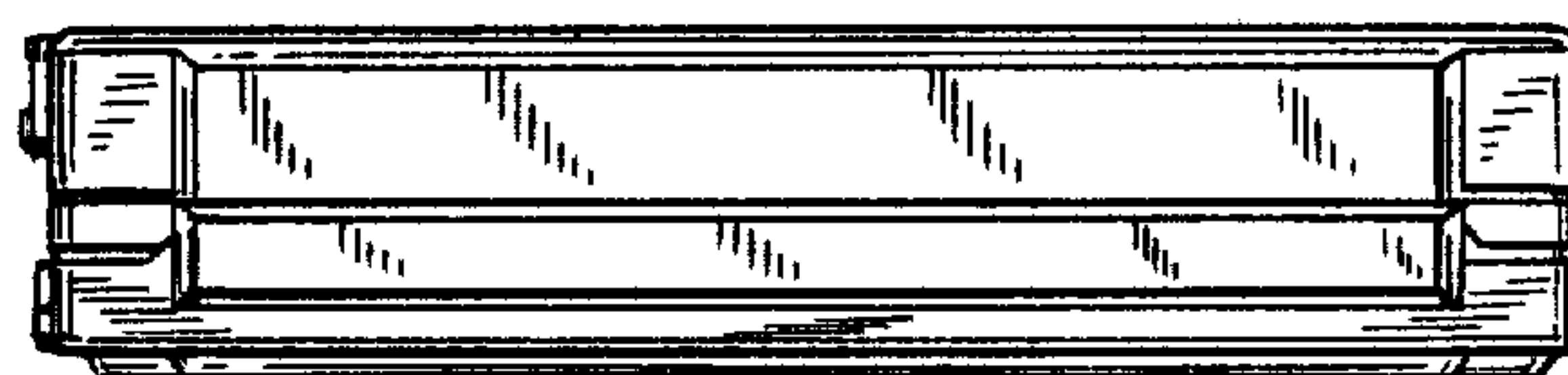

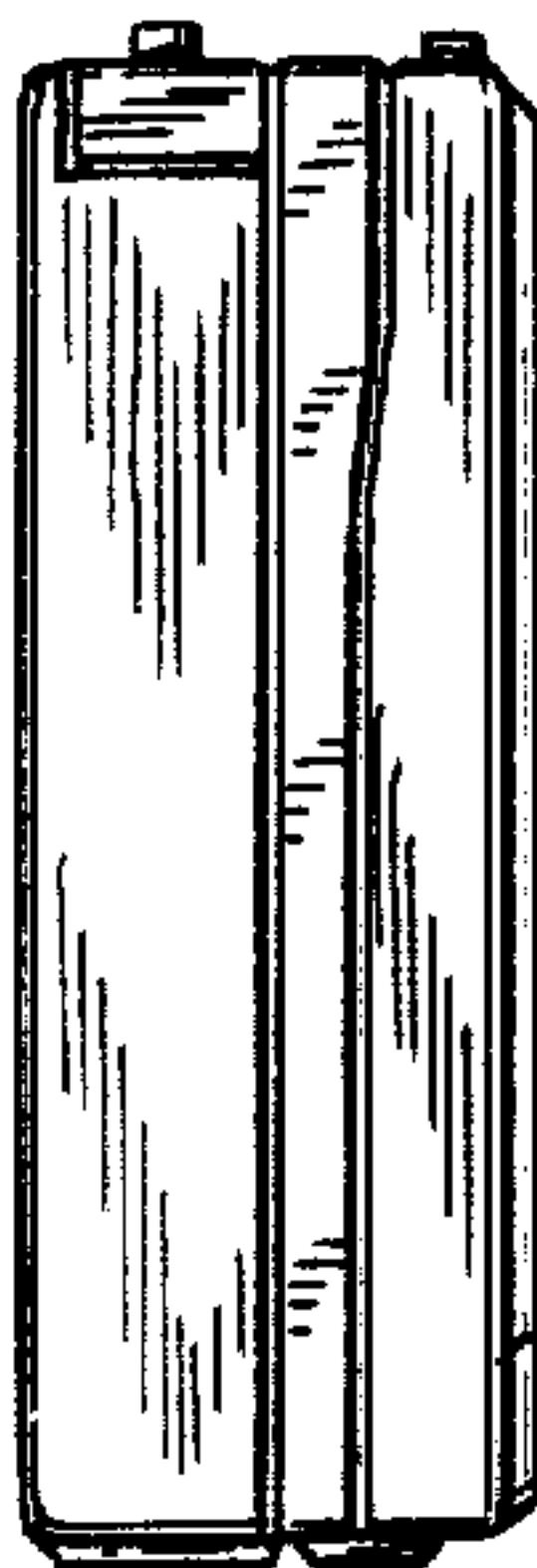

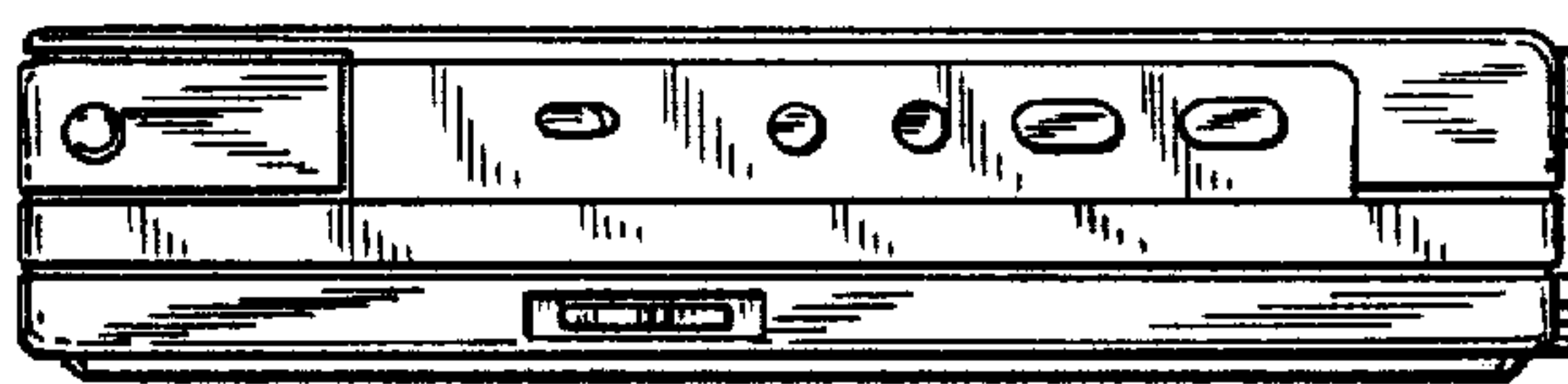
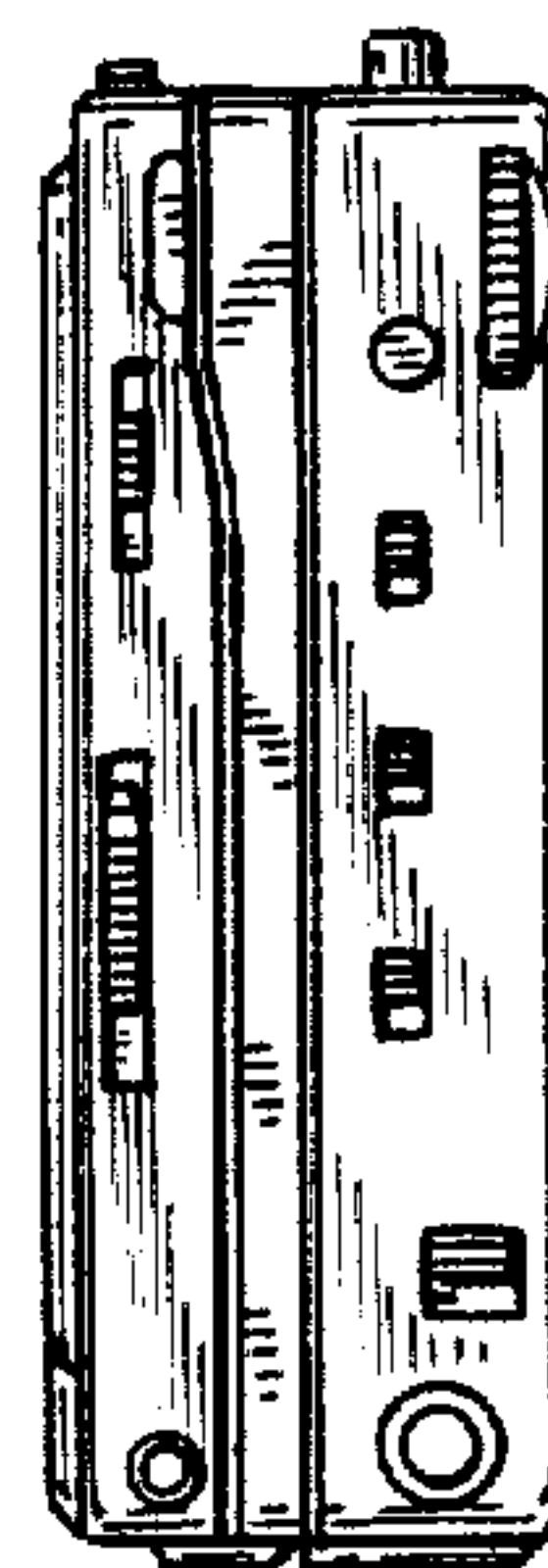
