[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined storage container and lid for lettuce or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined storage container and lid for lettuce or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

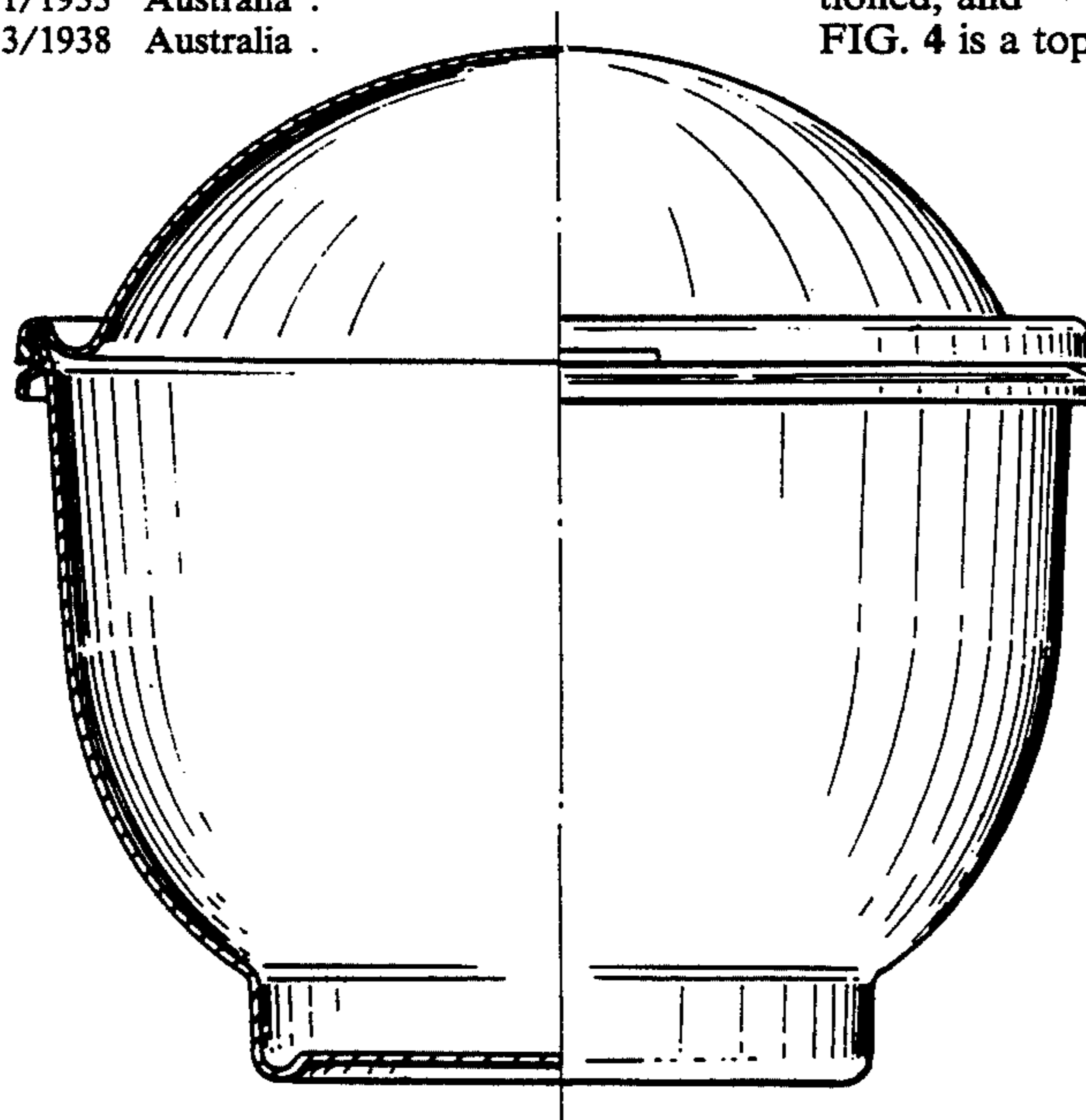

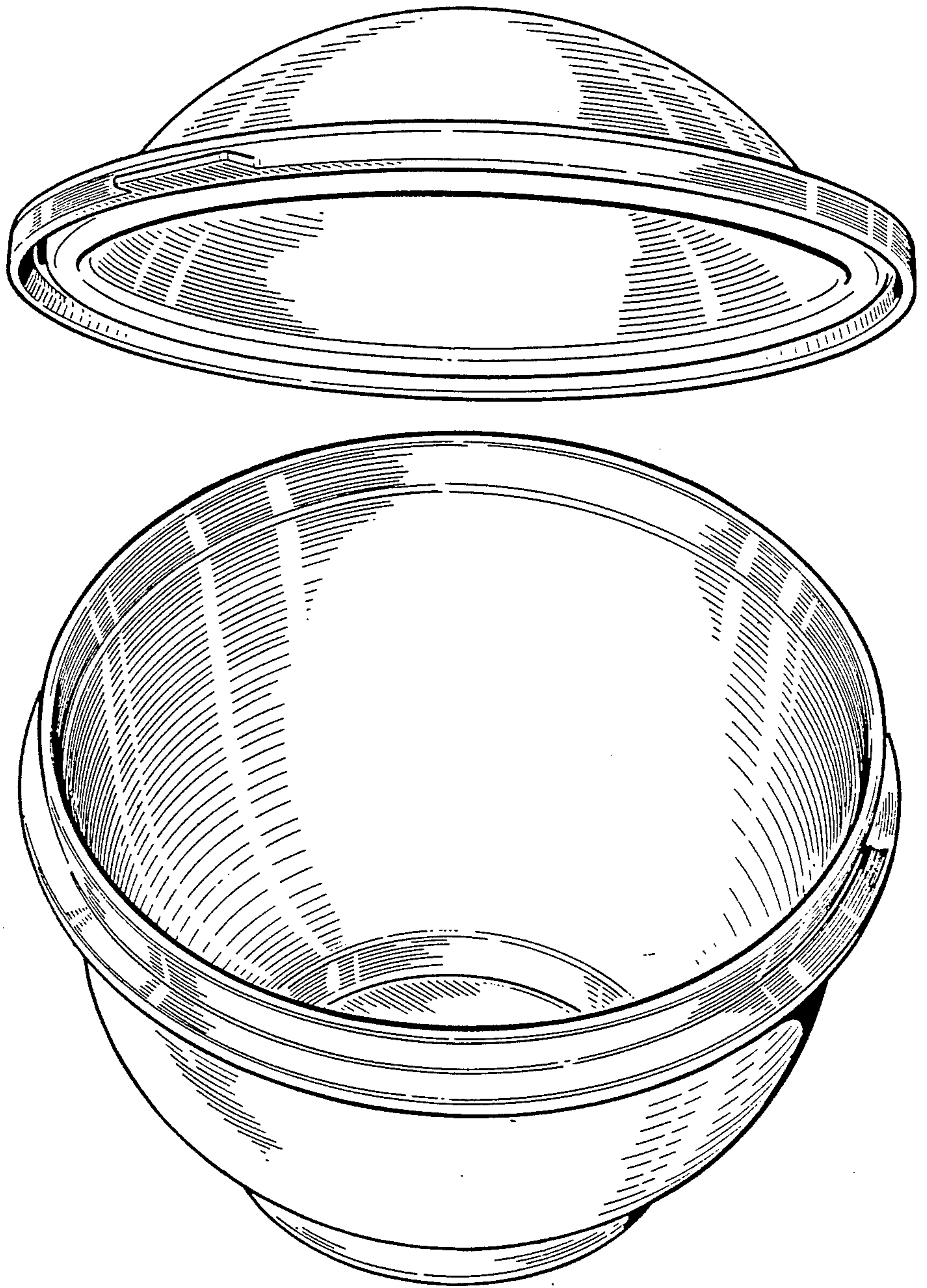

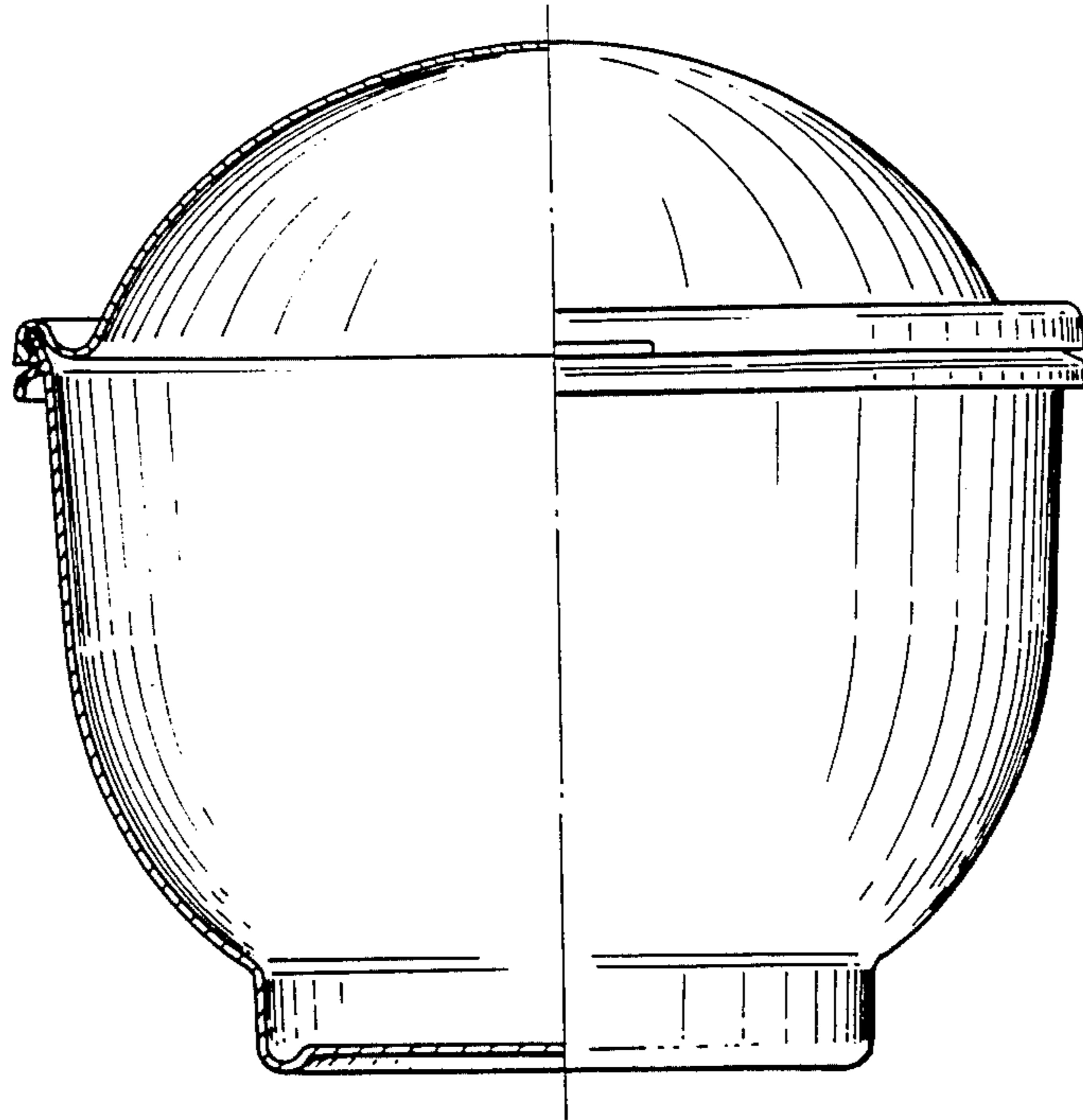

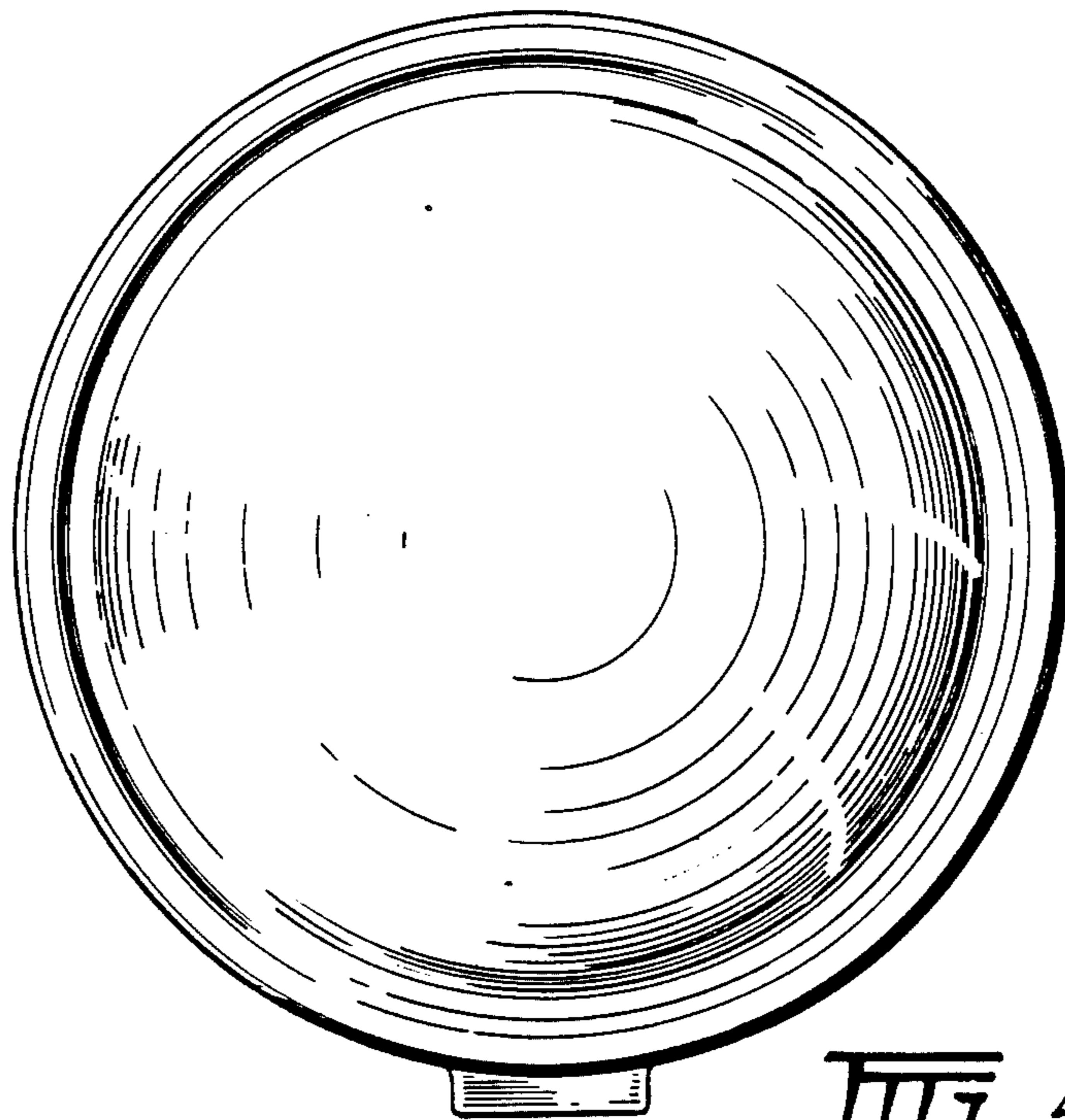
