[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a stick-in for floral arrangements, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a stick-in for floral arrangements, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left elevational side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The rear and right side of the floral stick-in are mirror images of the front and left side shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 respectively.

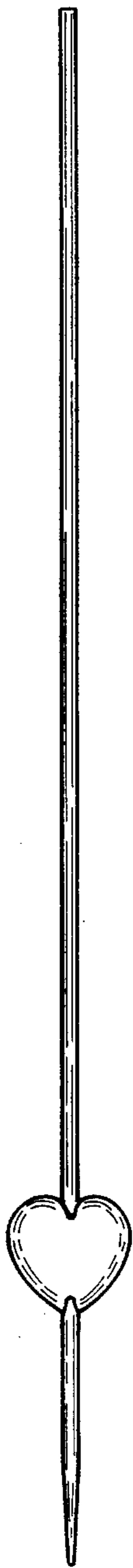
