

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adhesive dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an adhesive dispenser showing my new design in an exploded condition with the cap member partially fragmented for convenience of illustration;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view with the cap member removed for convenience of illustration;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view with the cap member in place; and
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of FIG. 2.






