The ornamental design for a lamp, as shown and de-  
scribed.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lamp, showing my new  
design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear ele-  
vational view being a mirror image thereof except for  
the representation of the bird;

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof, the left  
end elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of  
a lamp;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear ele-  
vational view being a mirror image thereof except for  
the representation of the bird;

FIG. 8 is a right end elevational view thereof, the left  
end elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

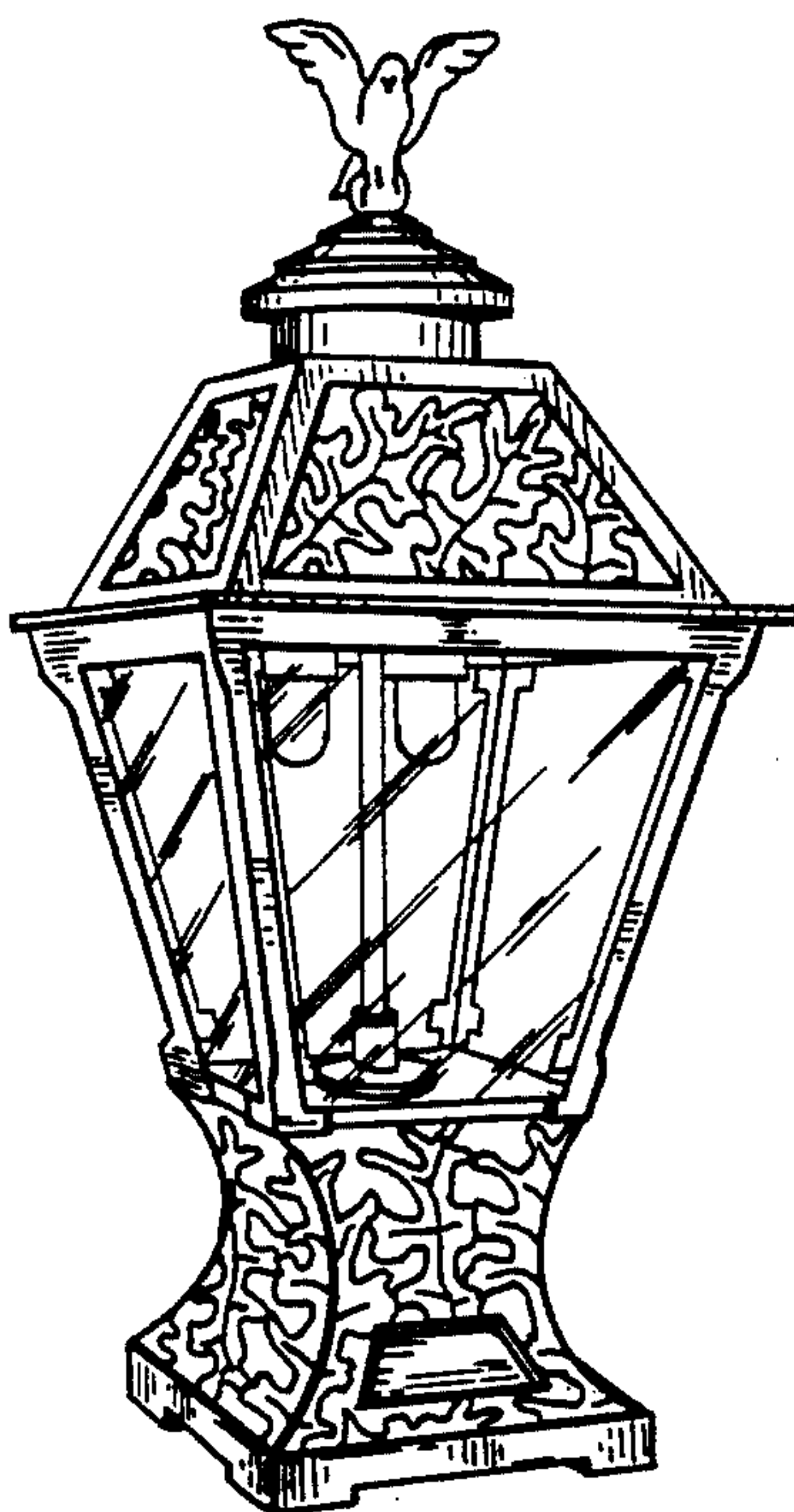
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of a

tration only.



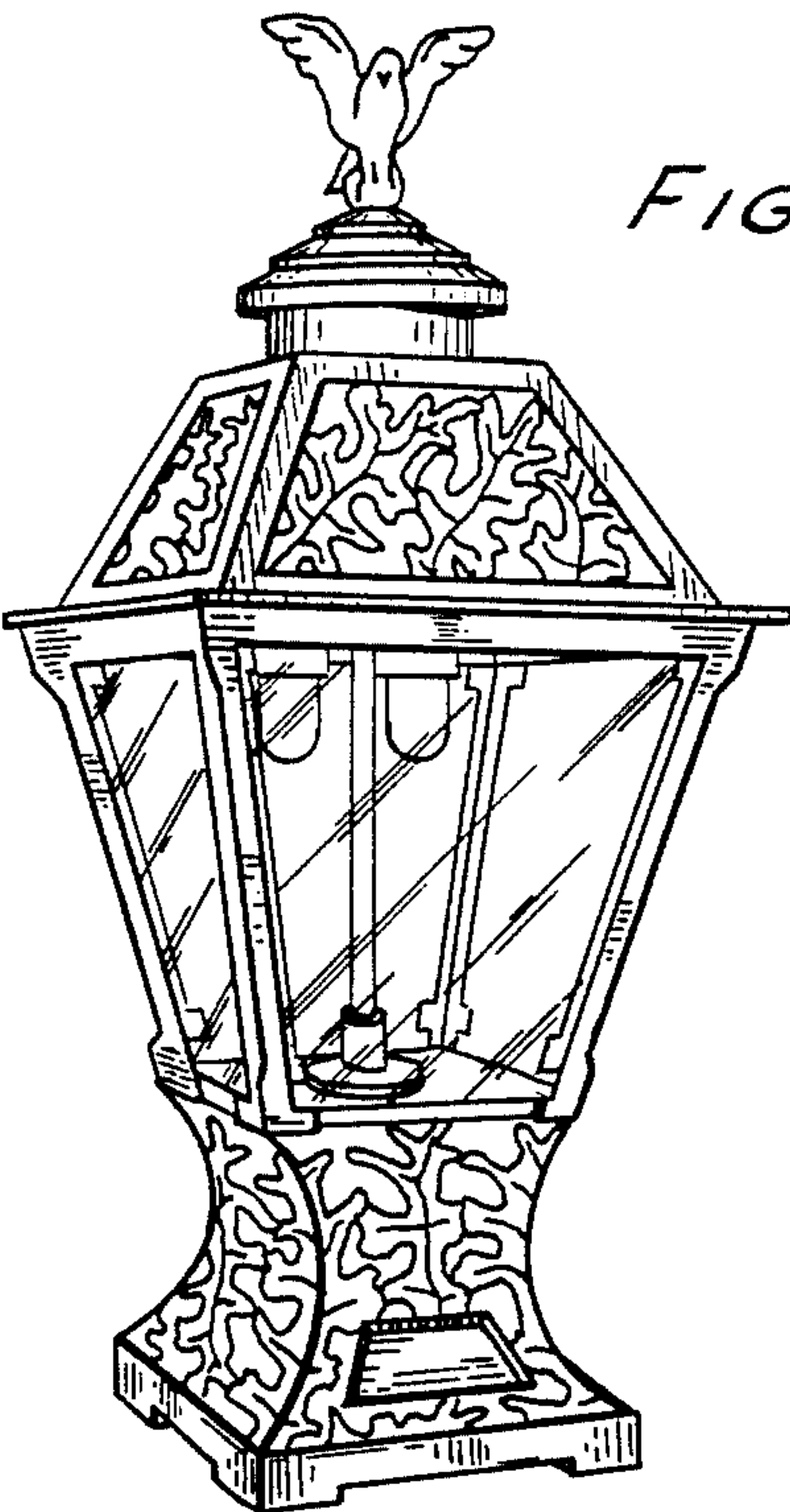

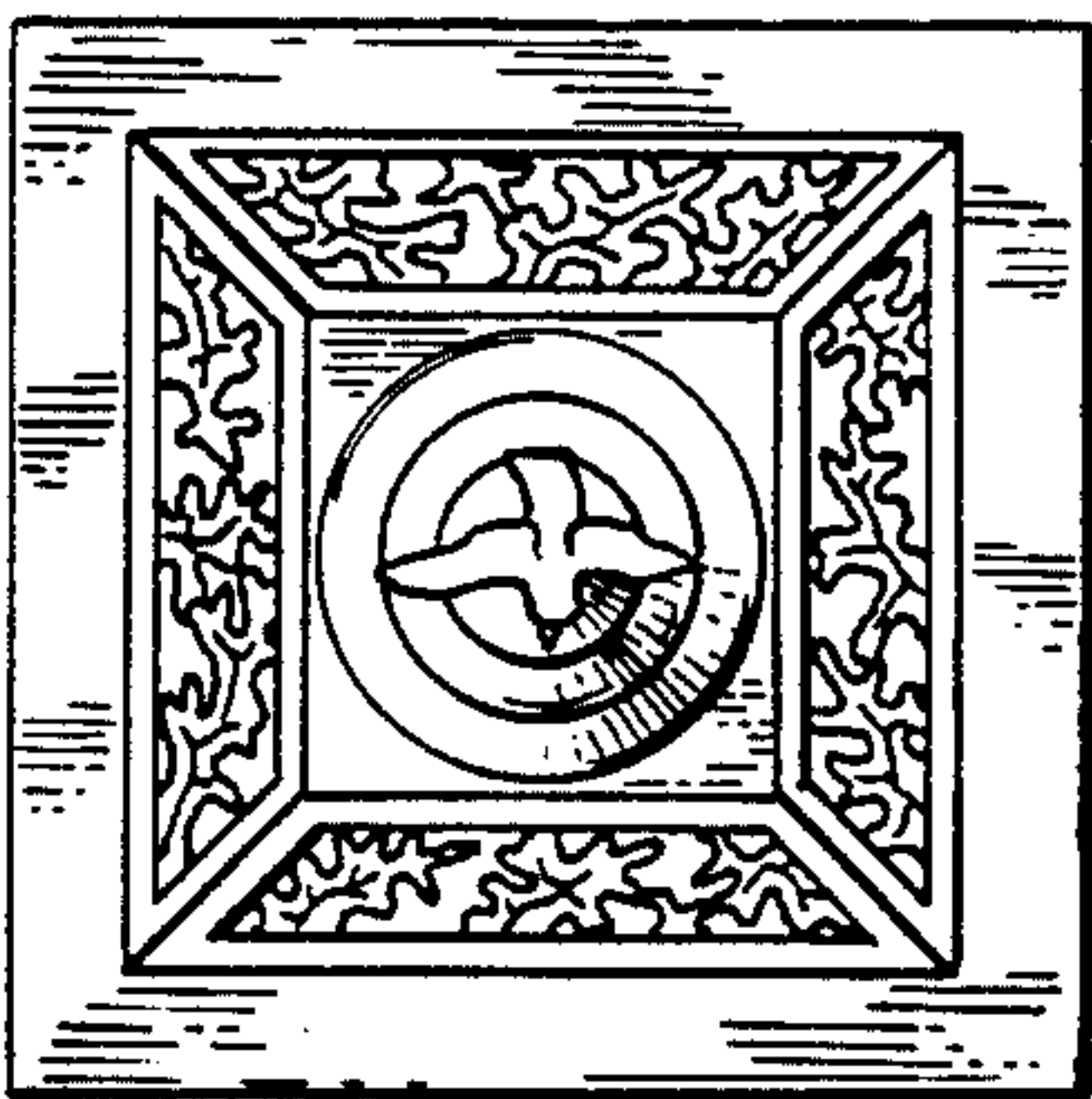

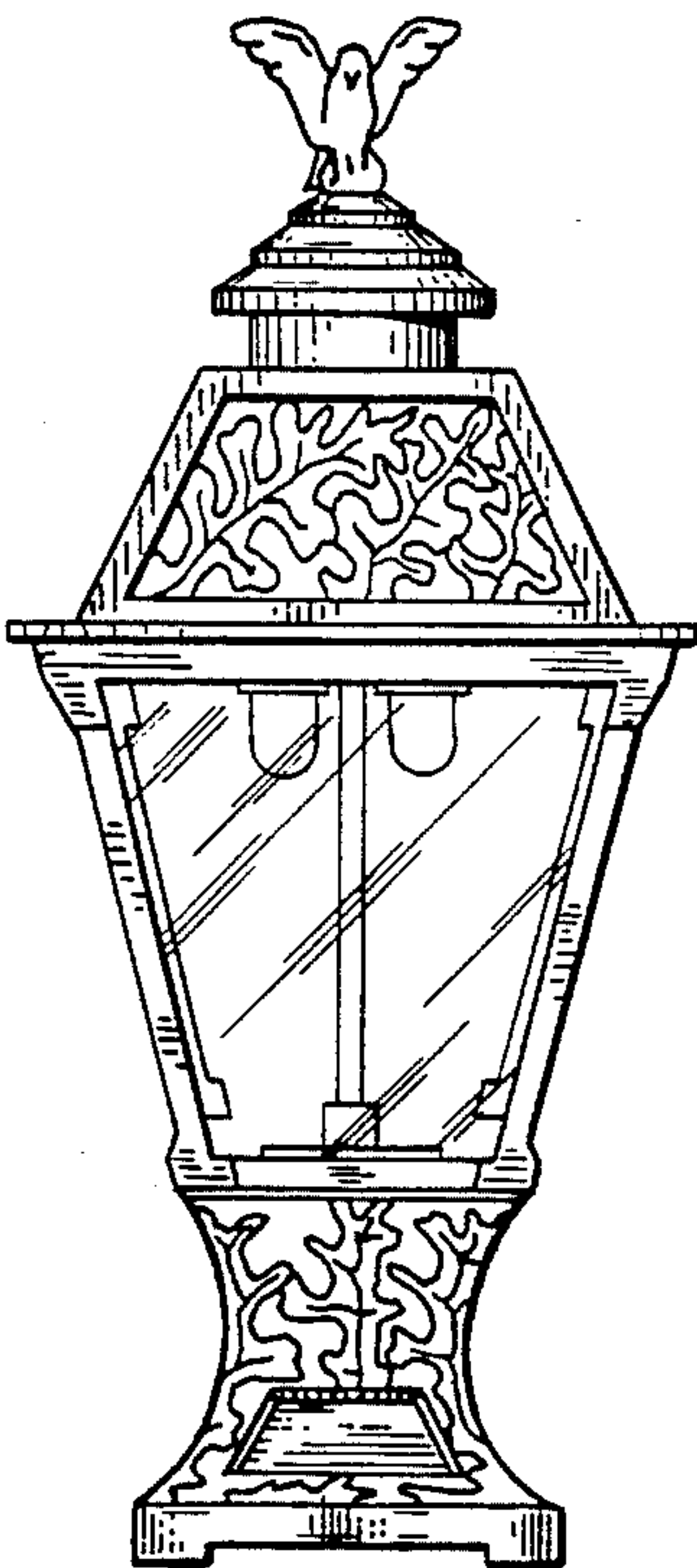

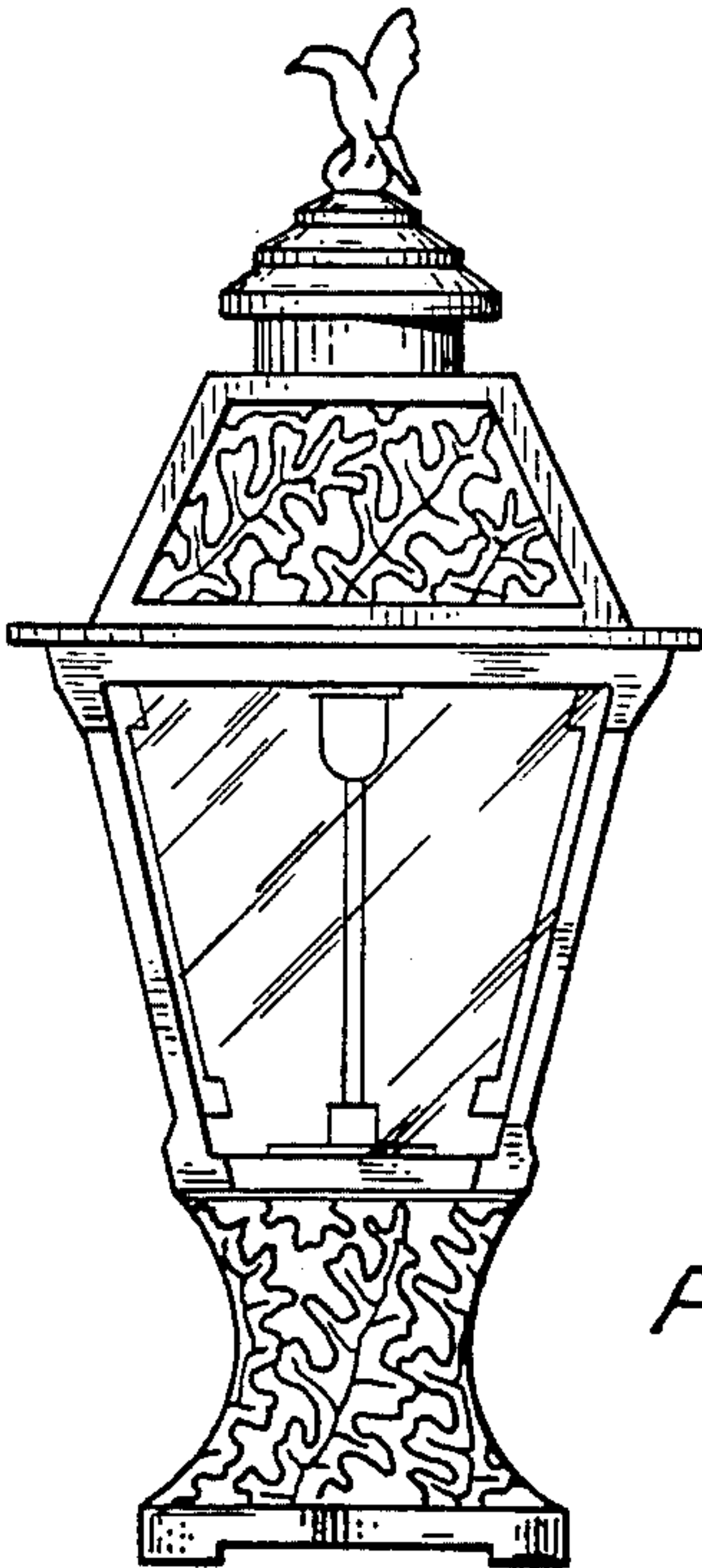

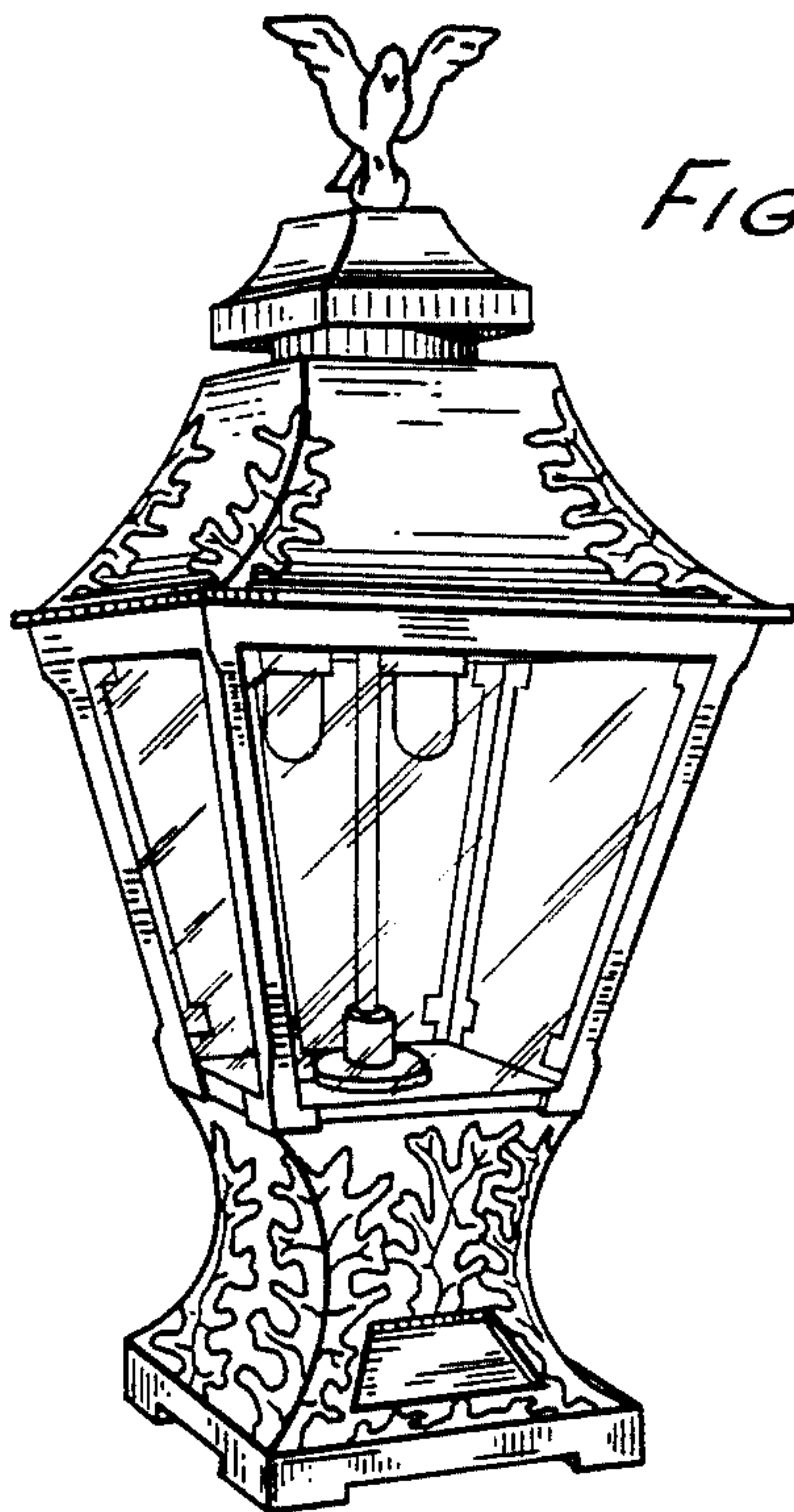

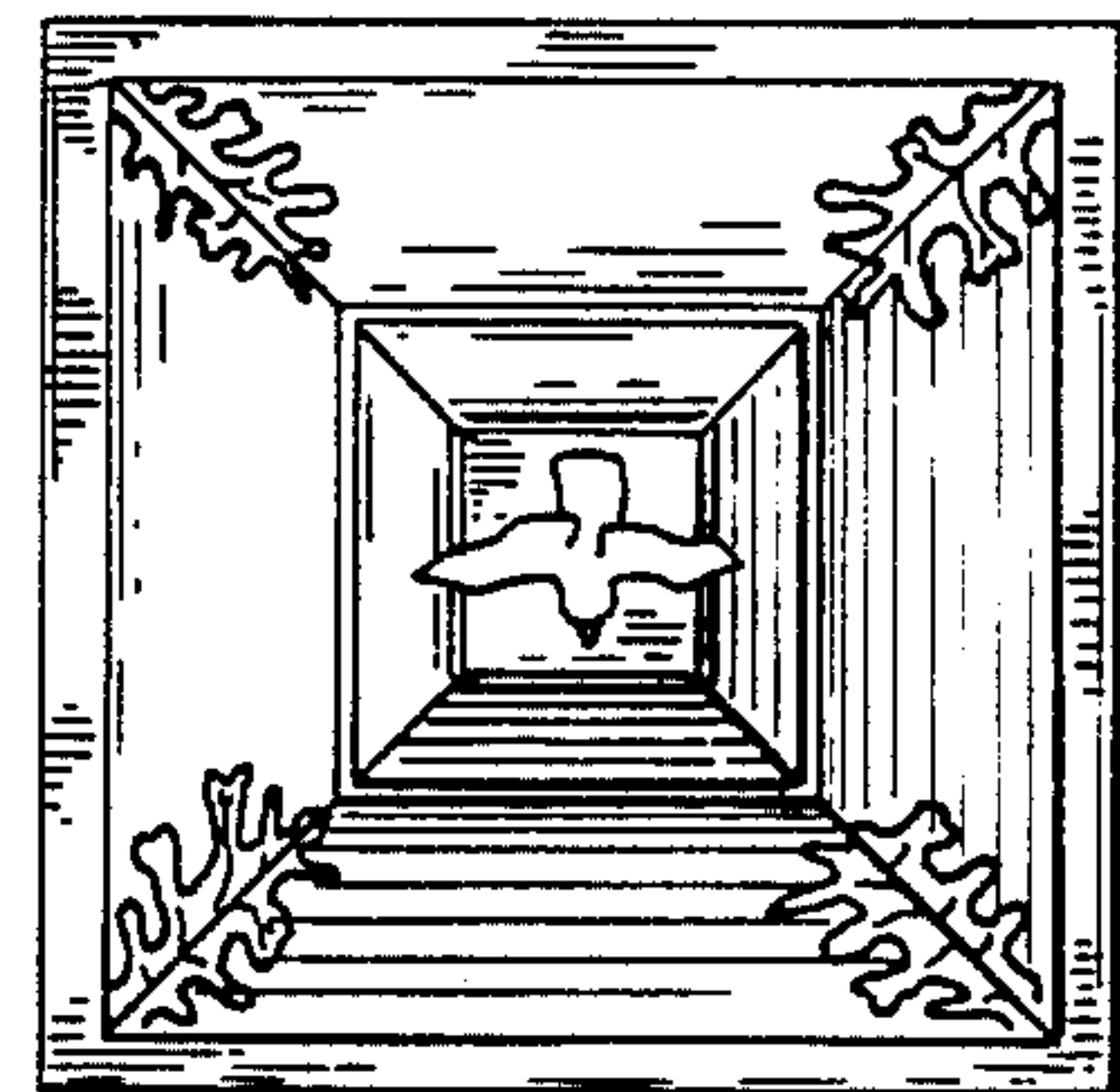

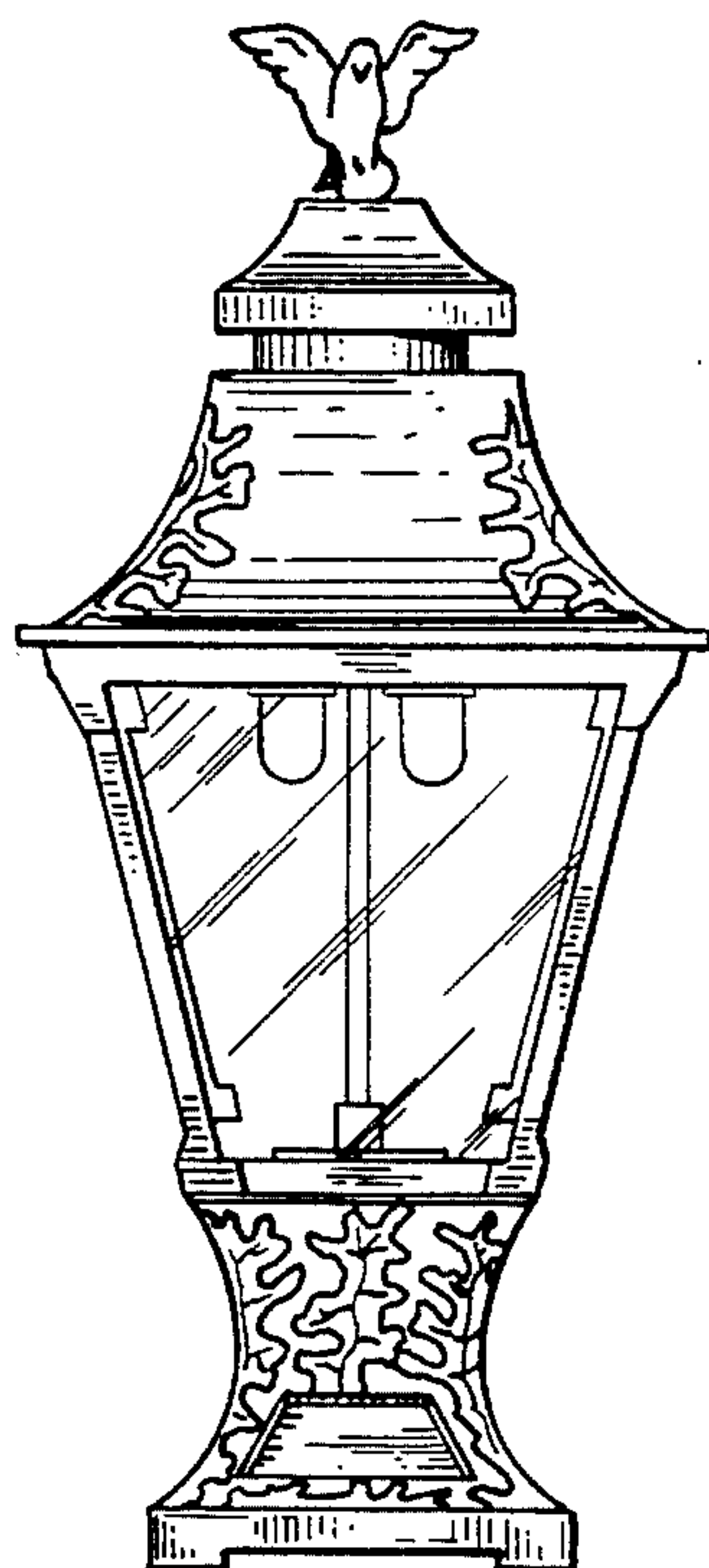

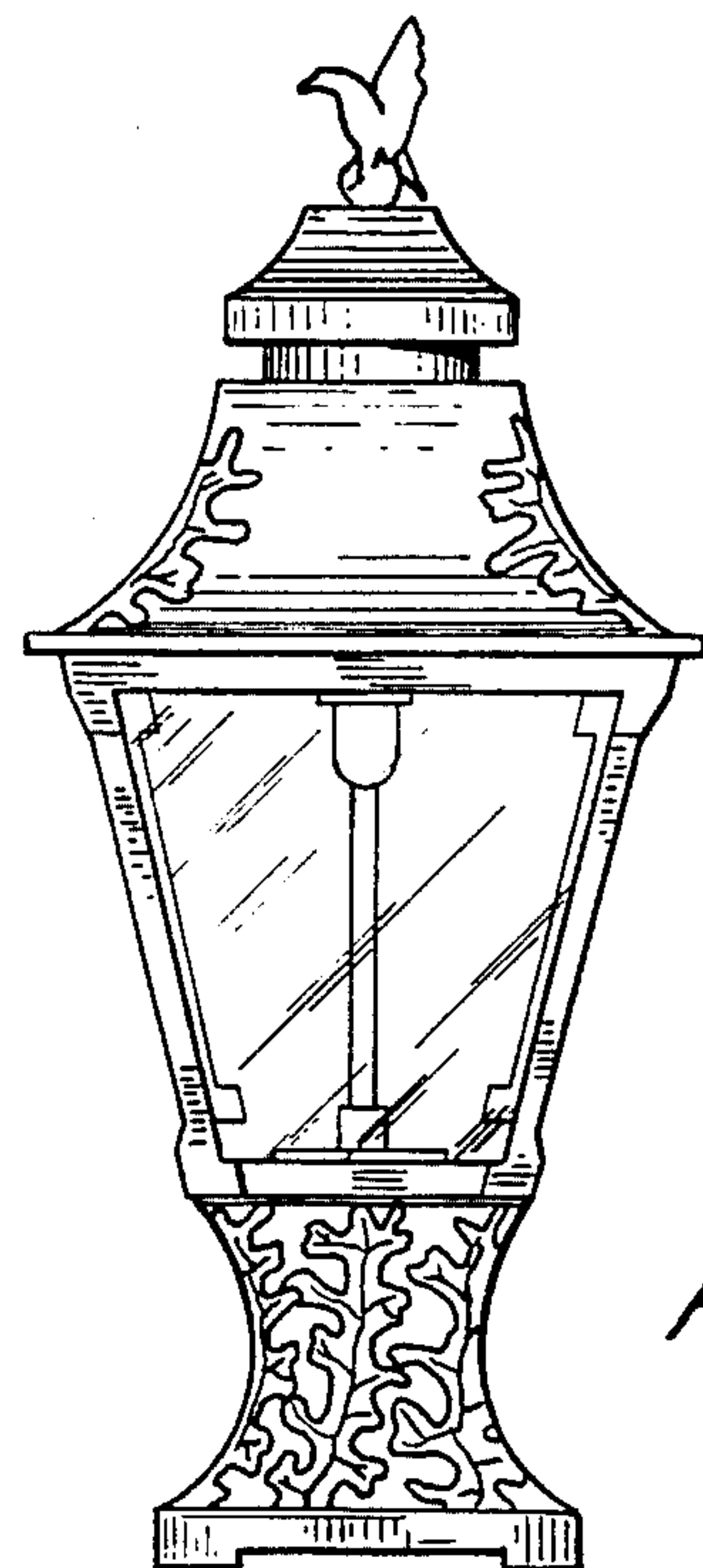

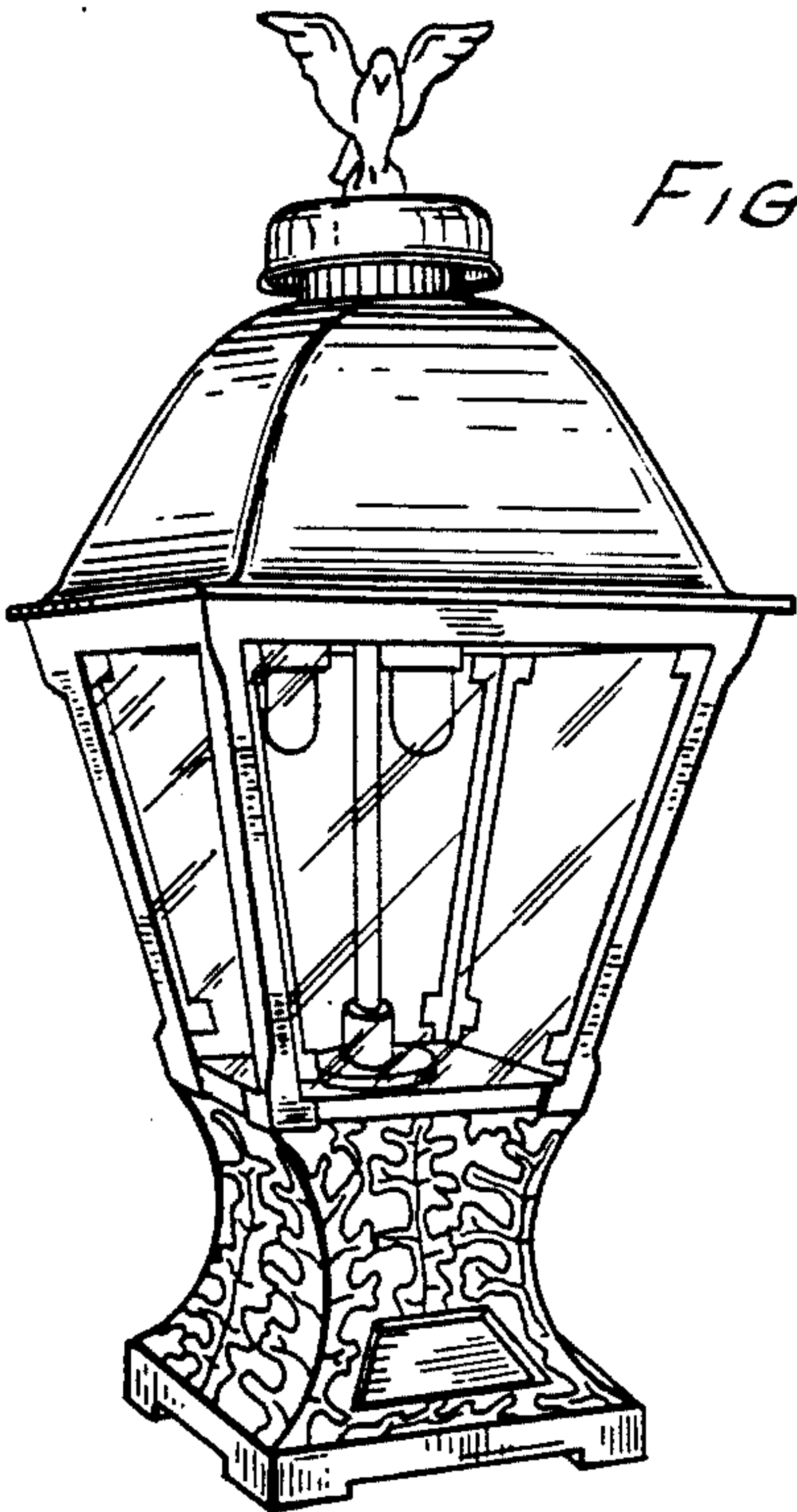

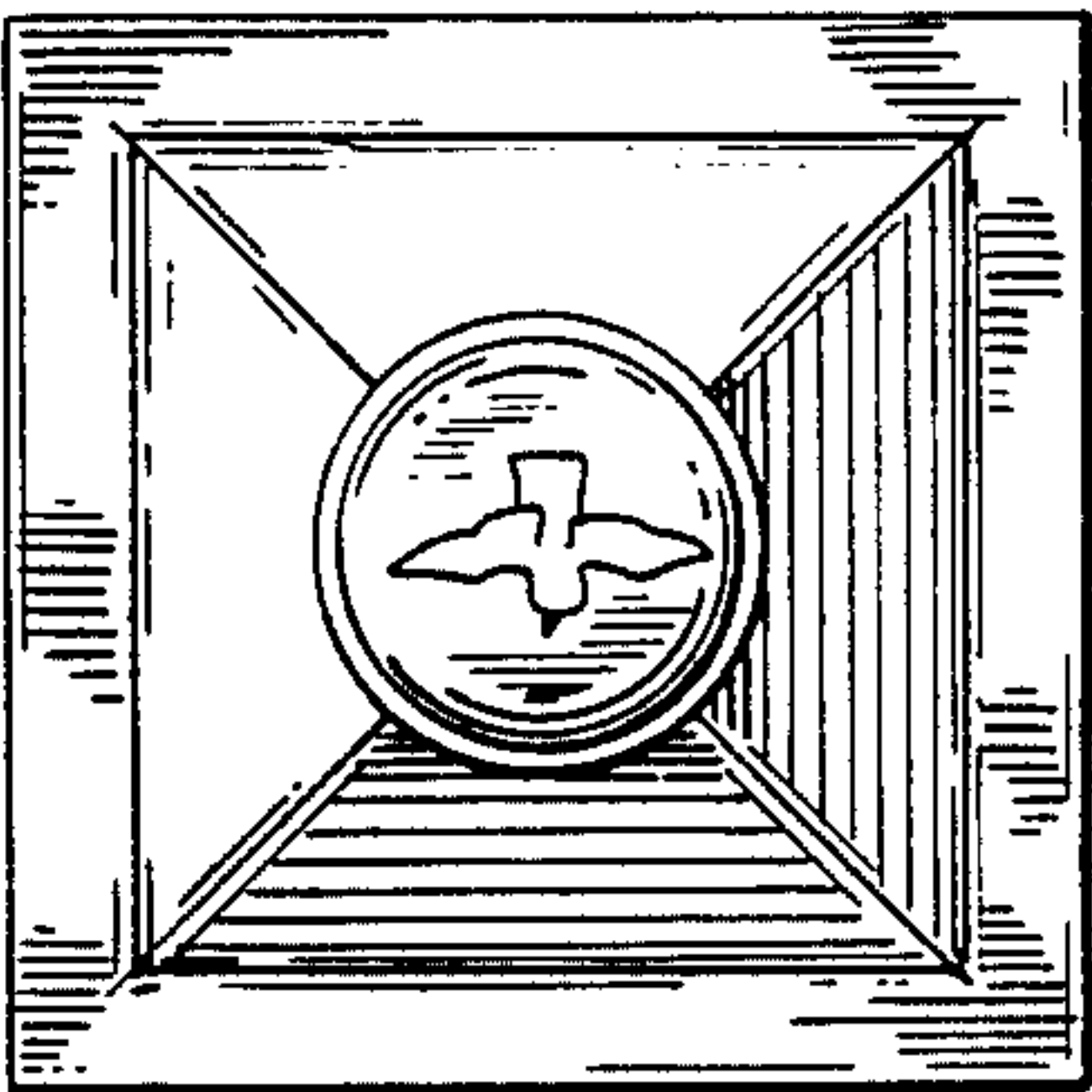

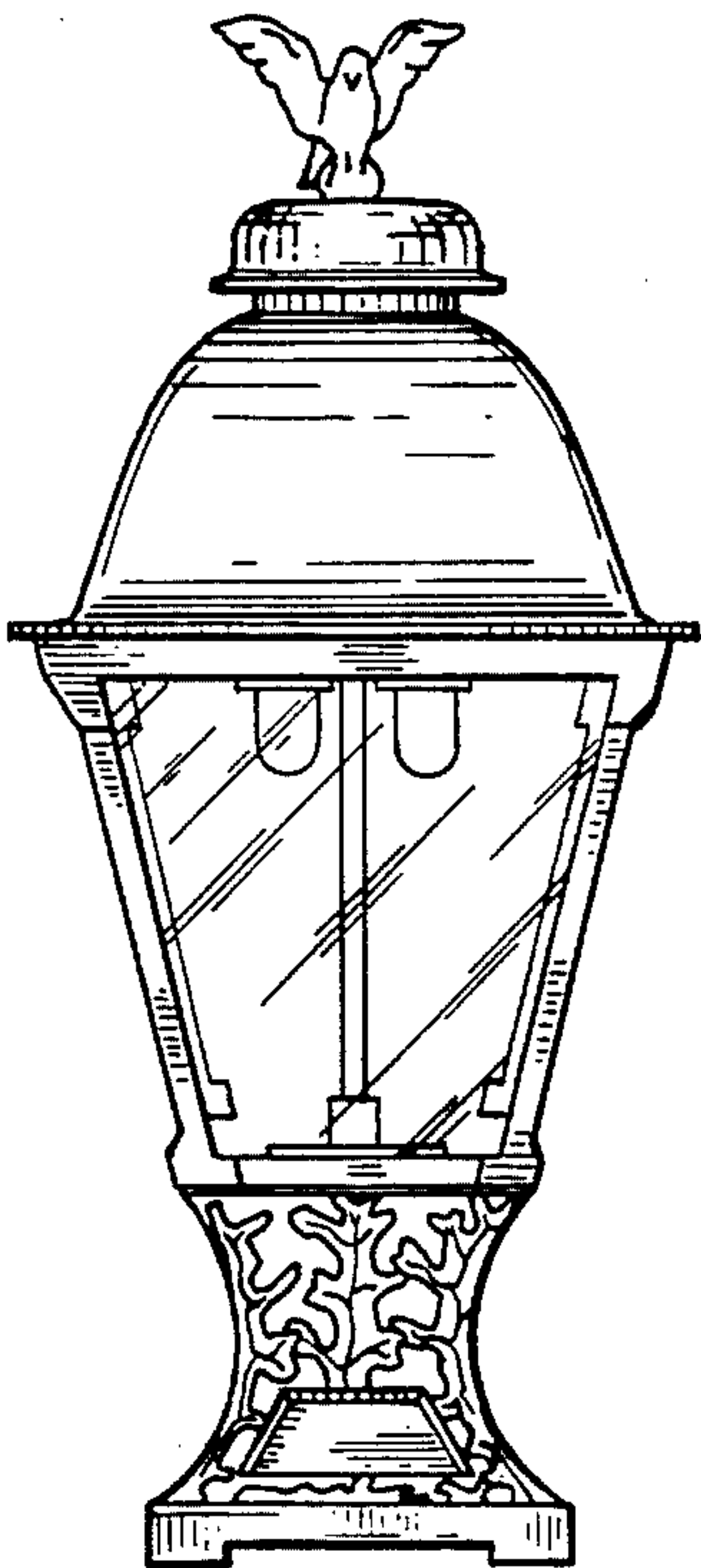

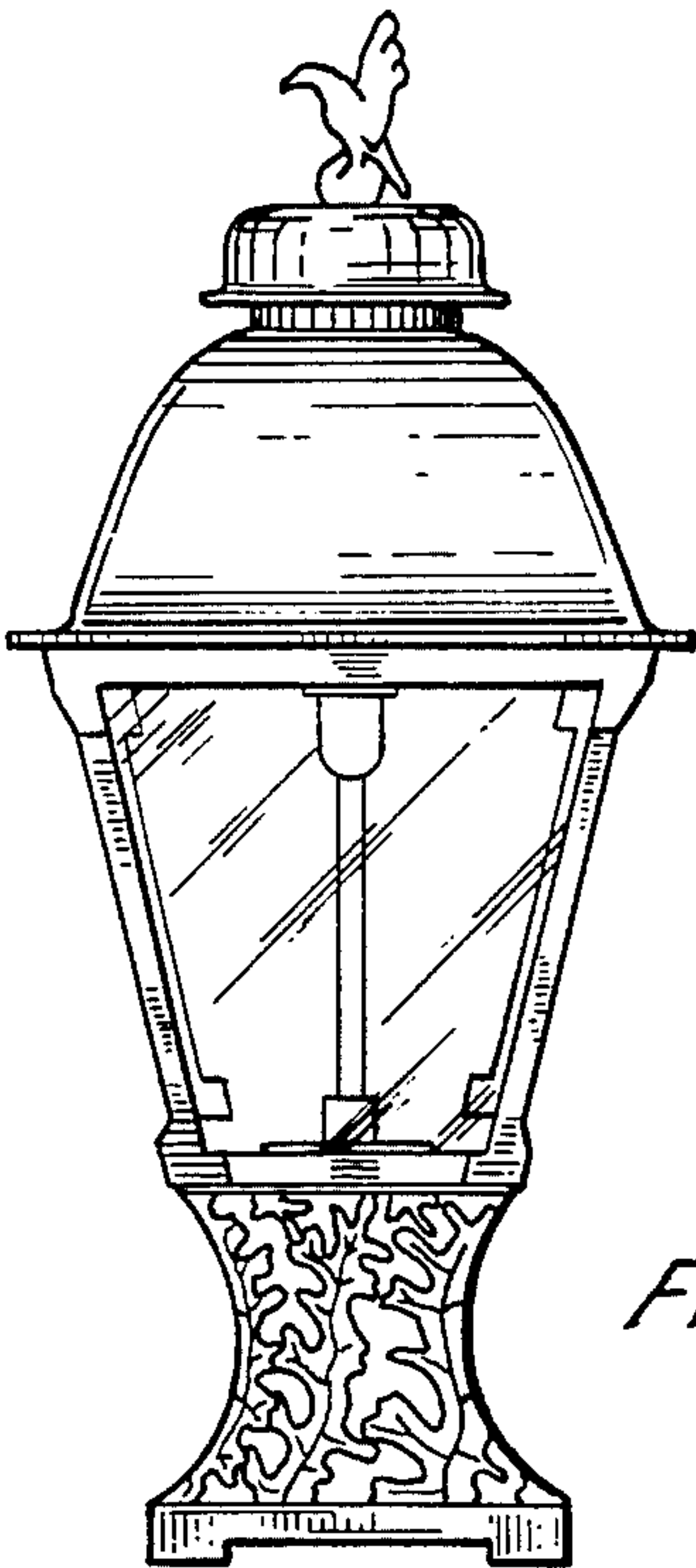
