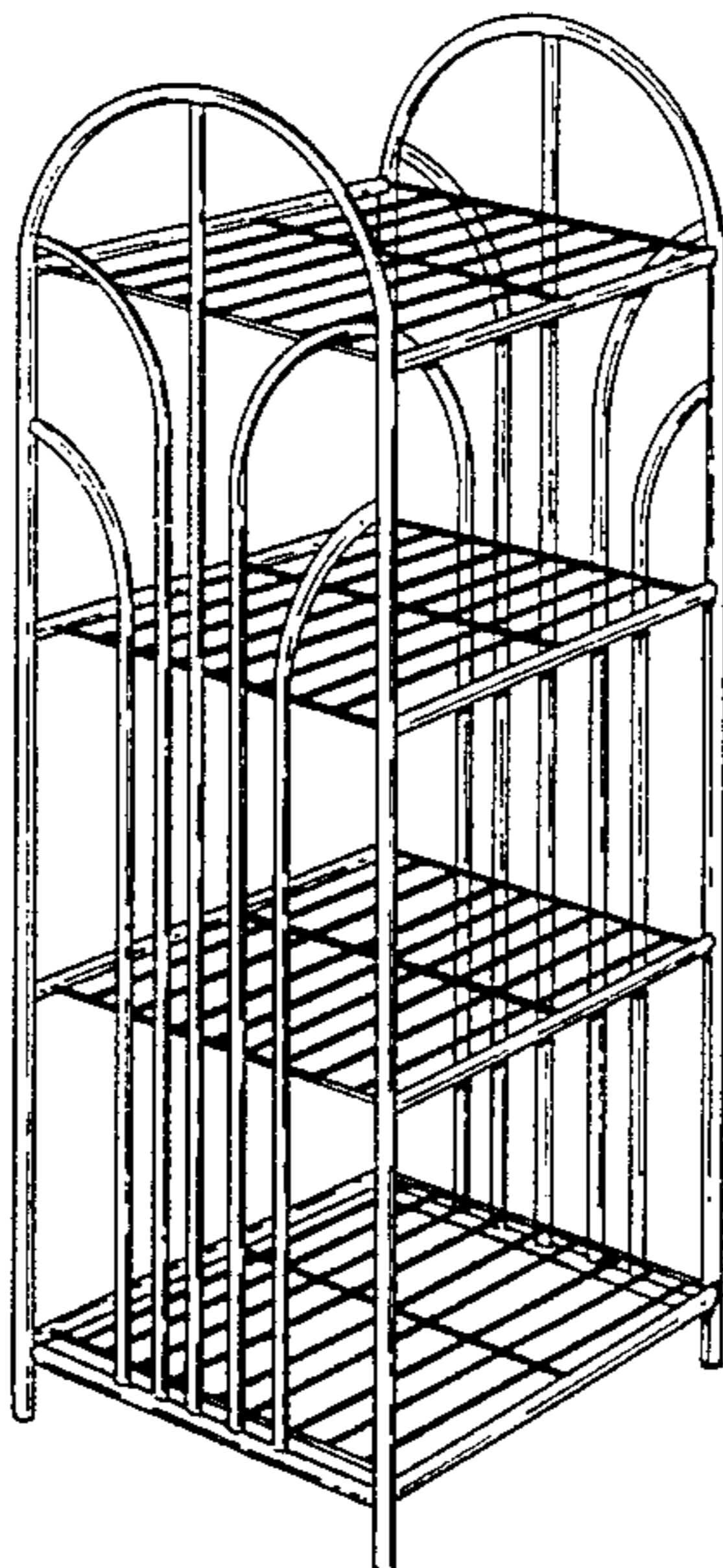

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an etagere showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear being a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.



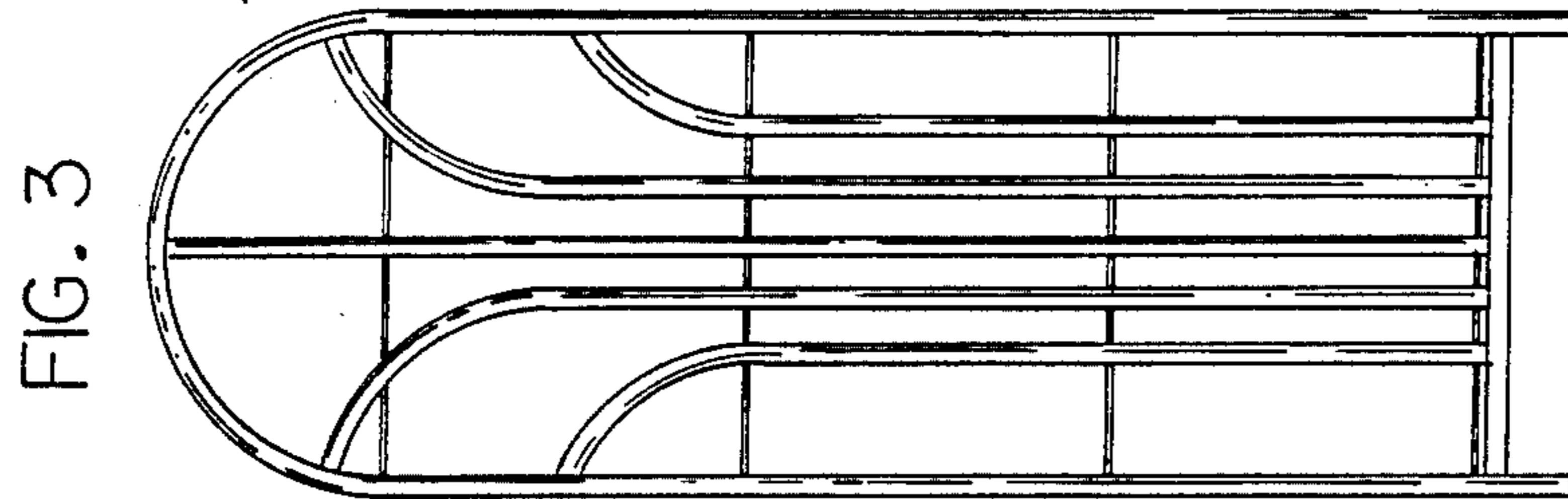

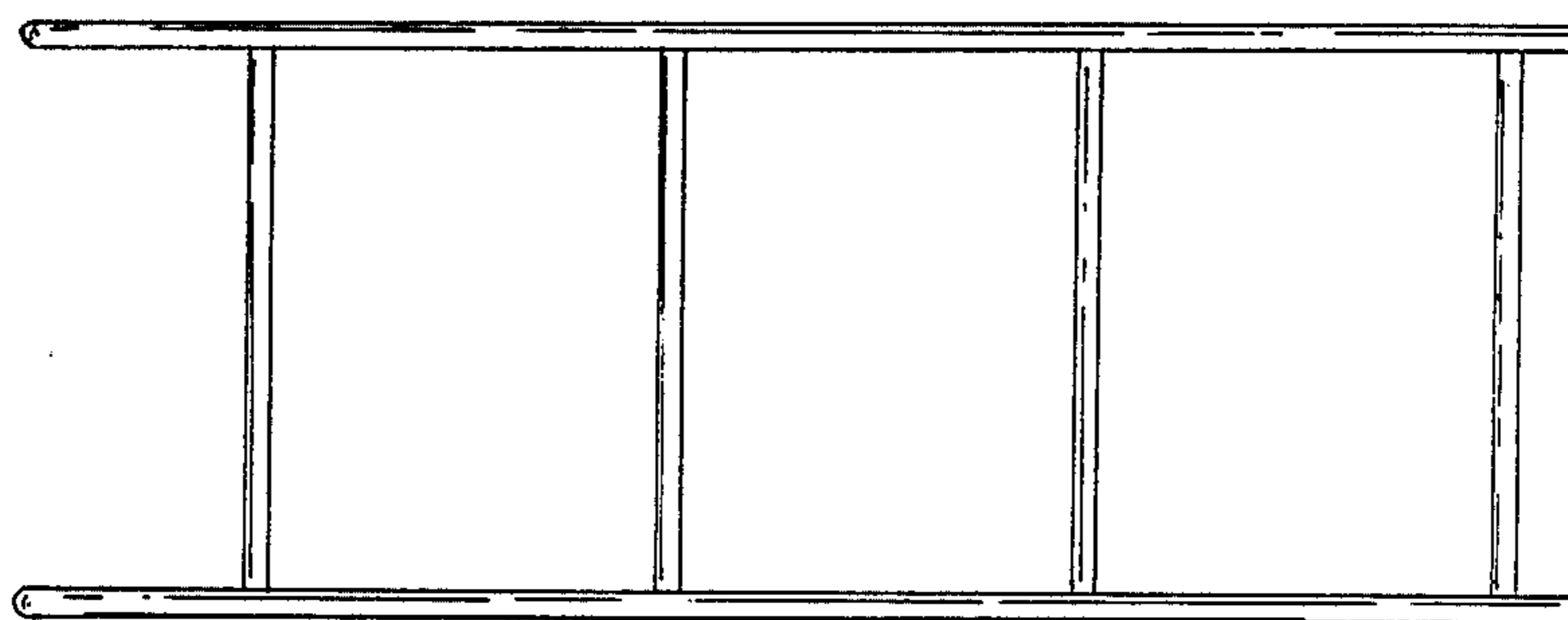

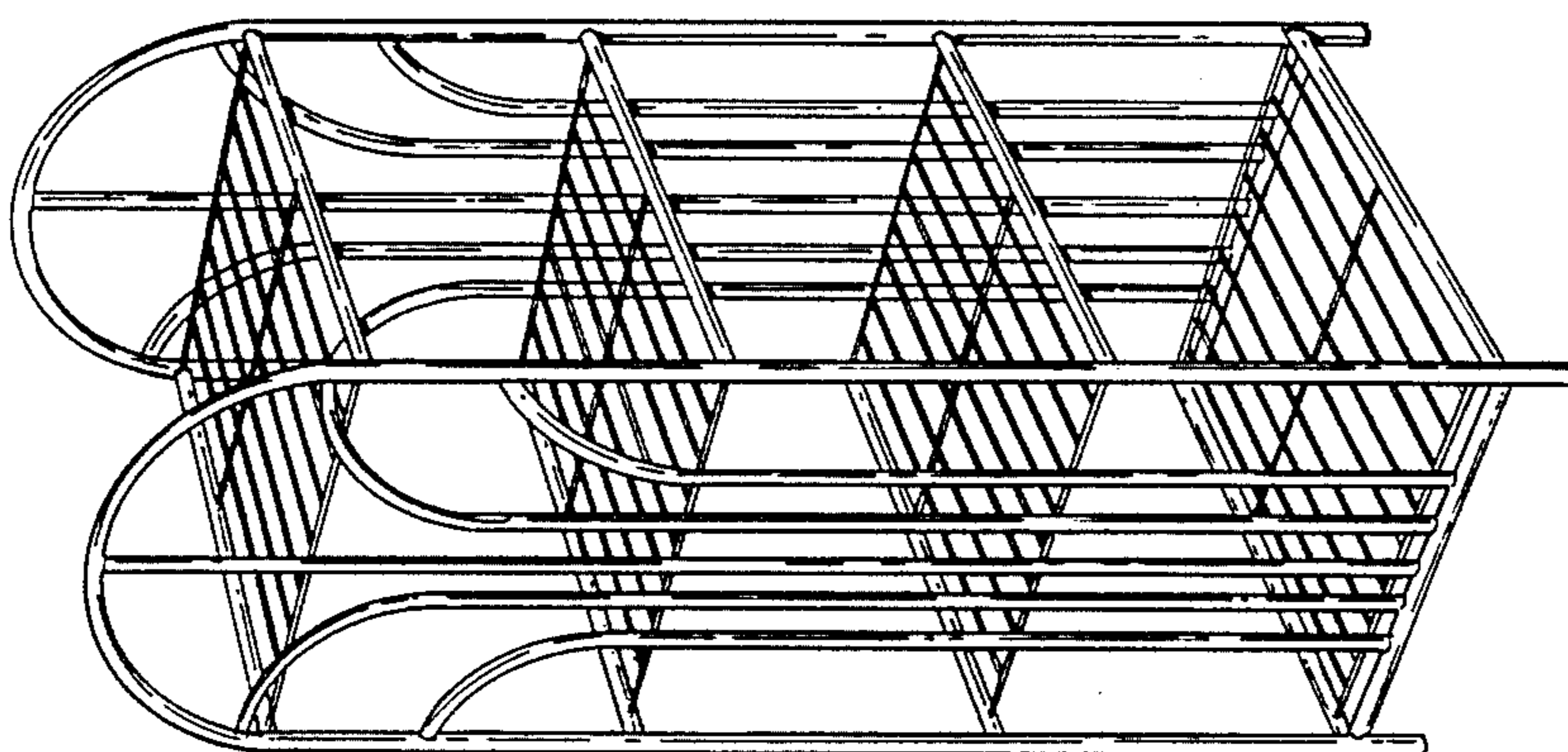
