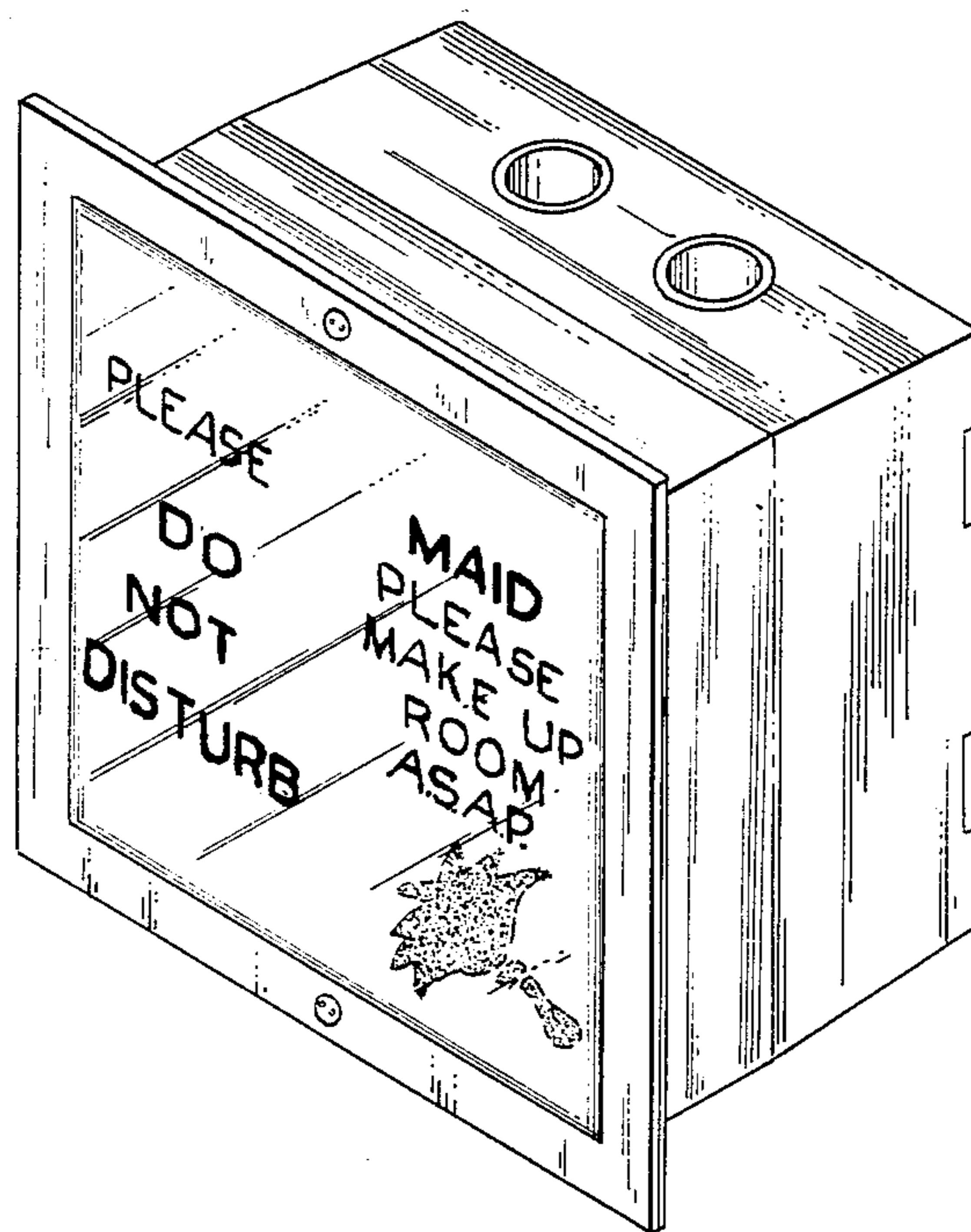

The ornamental design for an illuminated sign, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan elevational view of an illuminated sign showing the new design, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view with the right side being a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a perspective view as seen from the front and one side and end.



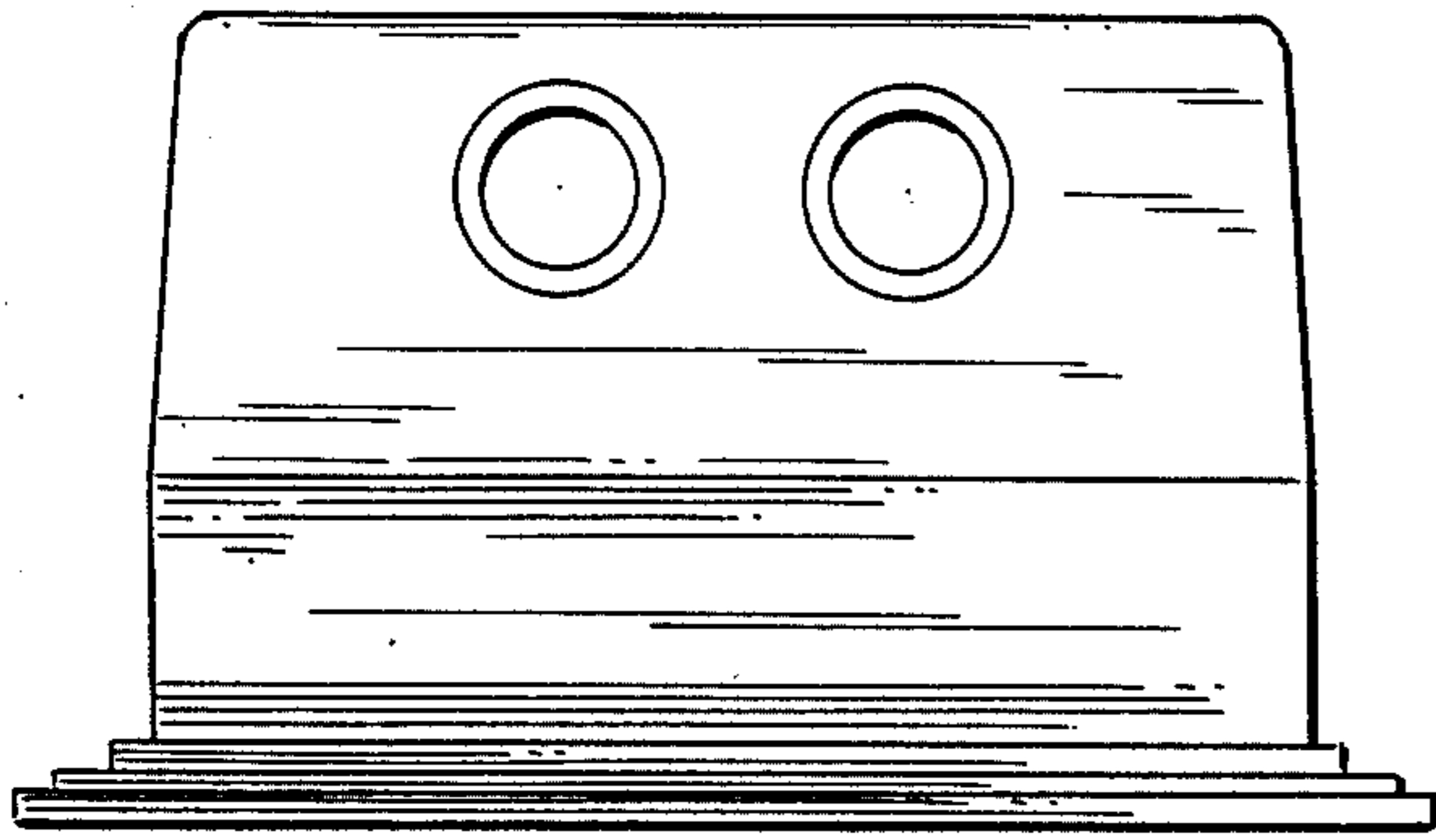

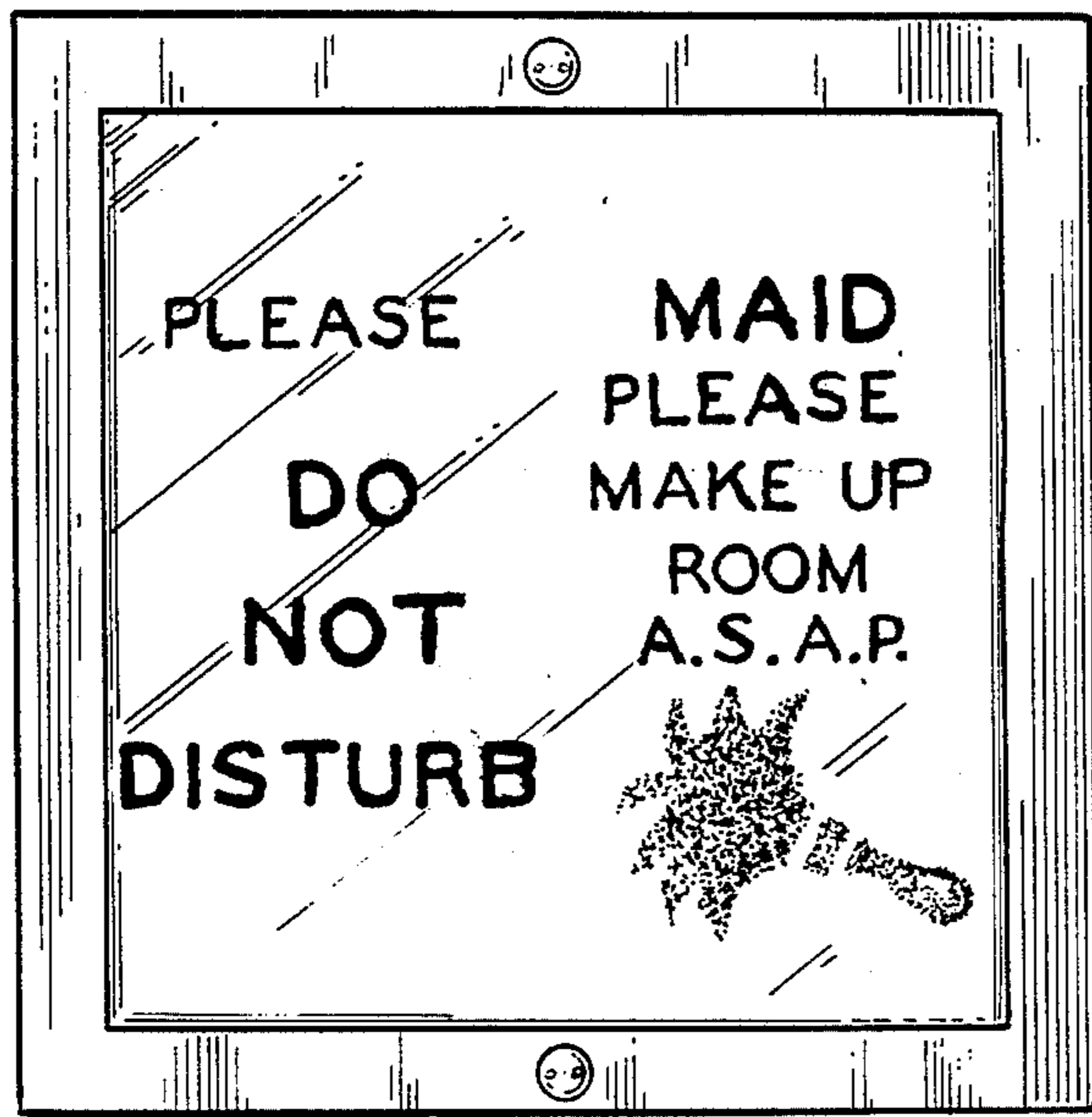

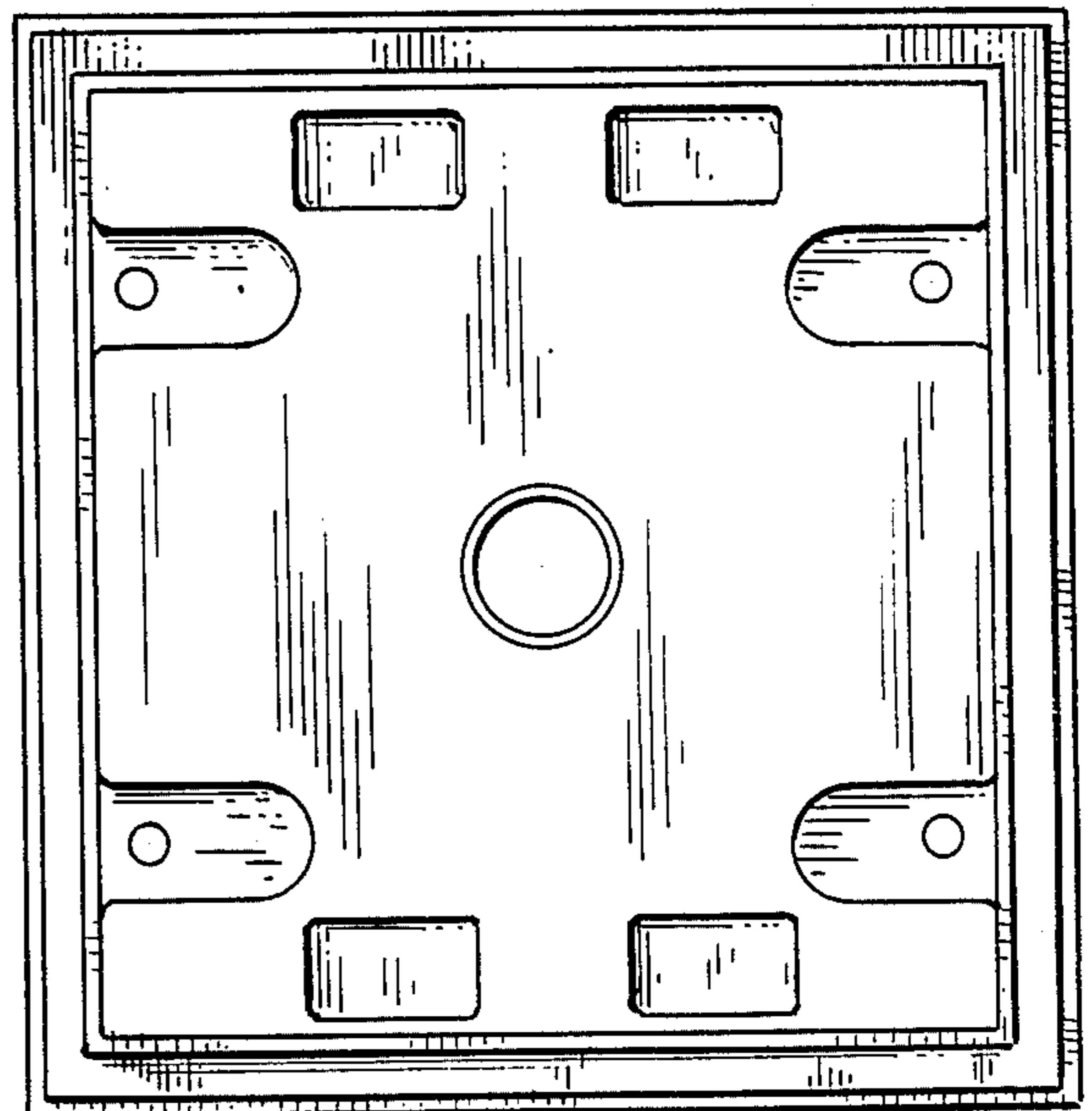

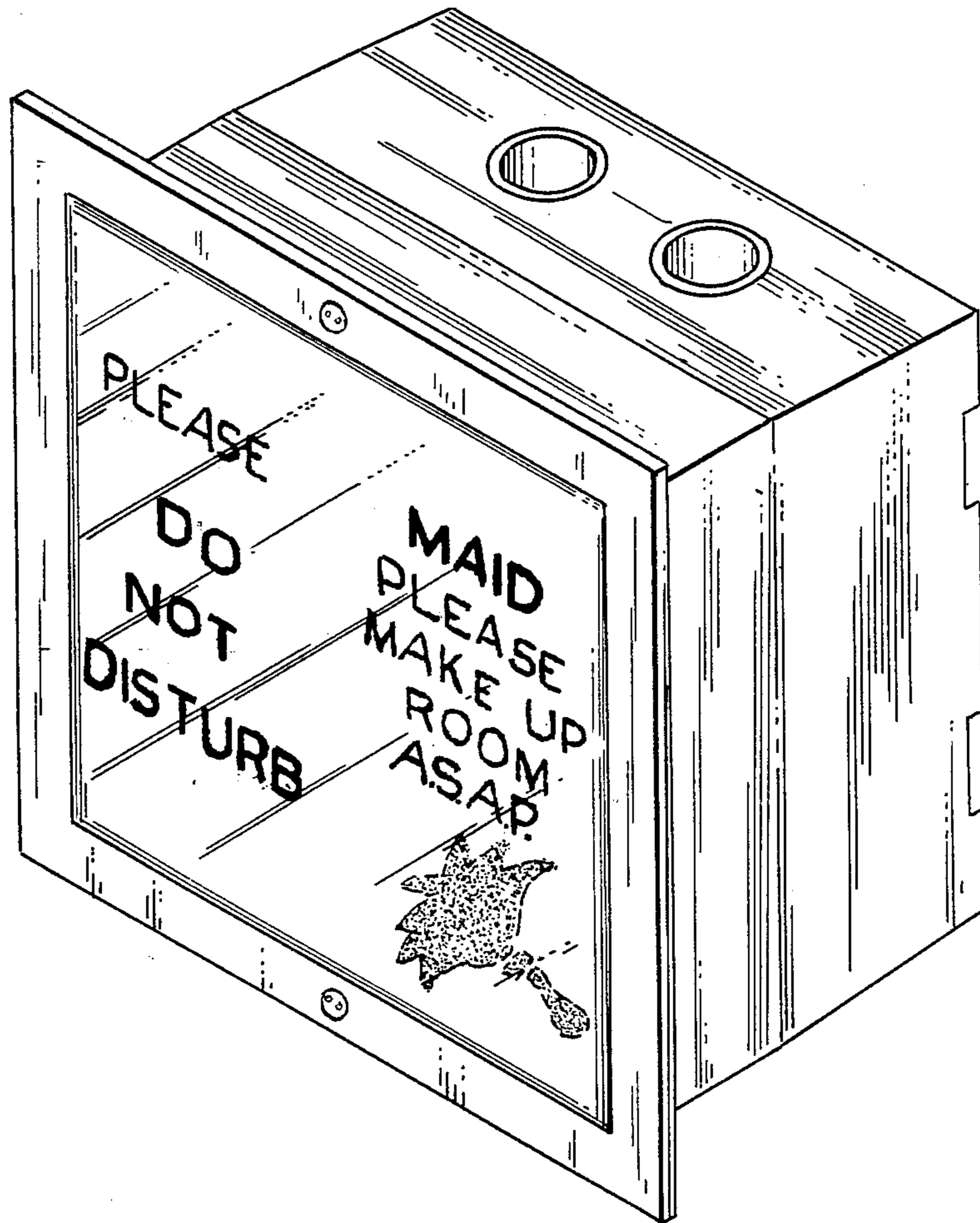
